The ornamental design for a trash receptacle, substantially as shown and described.

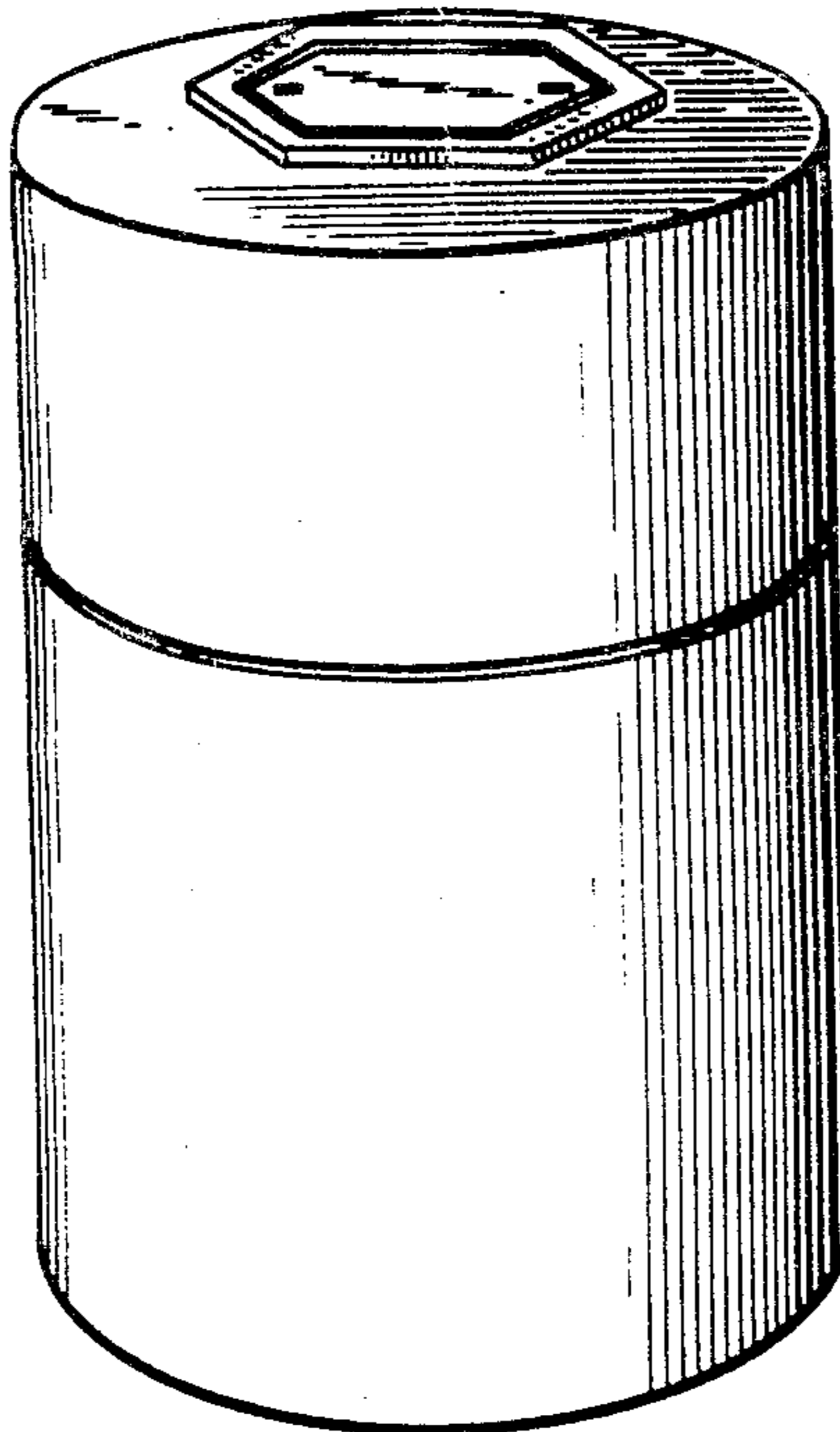

FIG. 4 is a bottom plan view thereof.



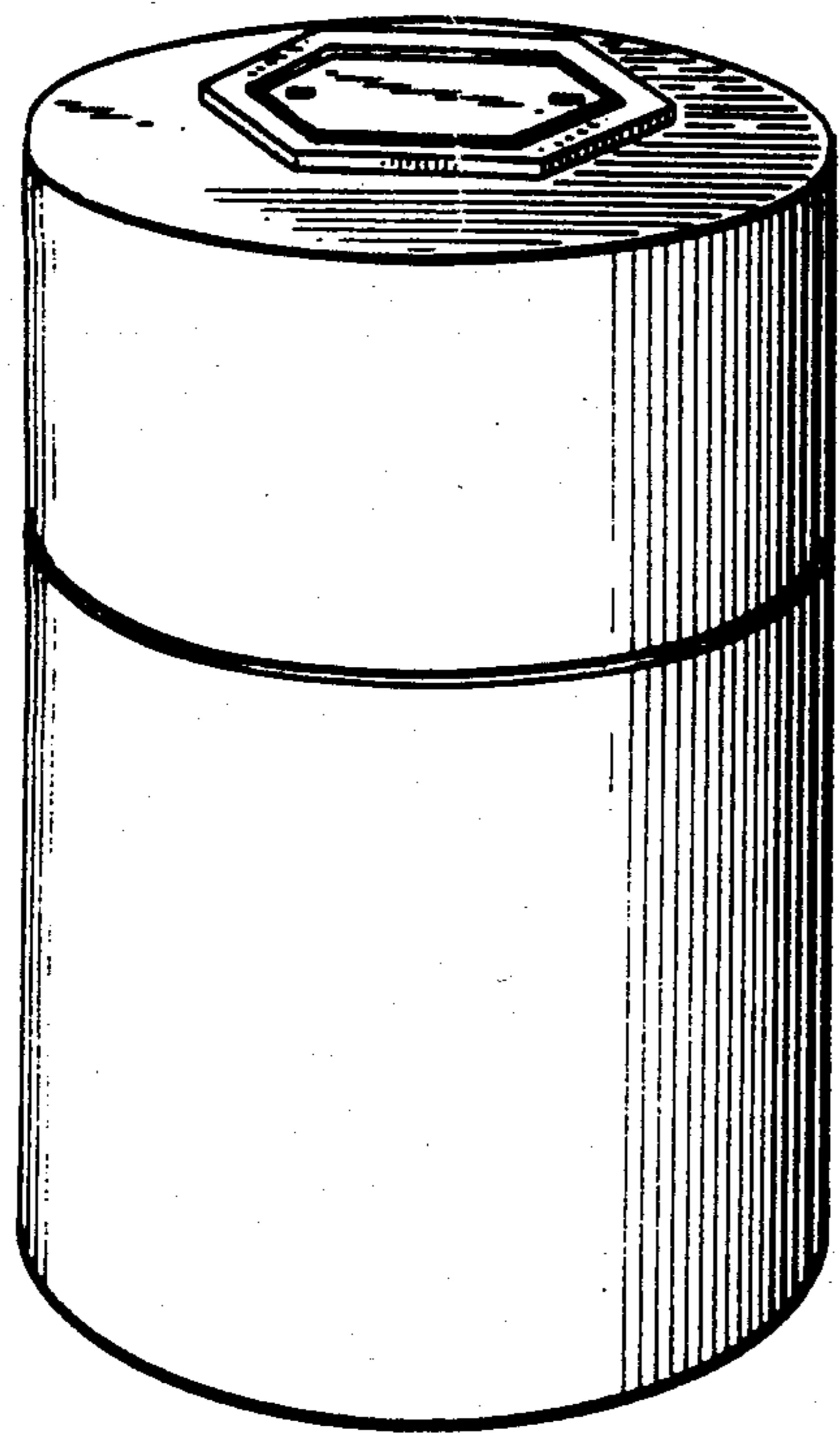

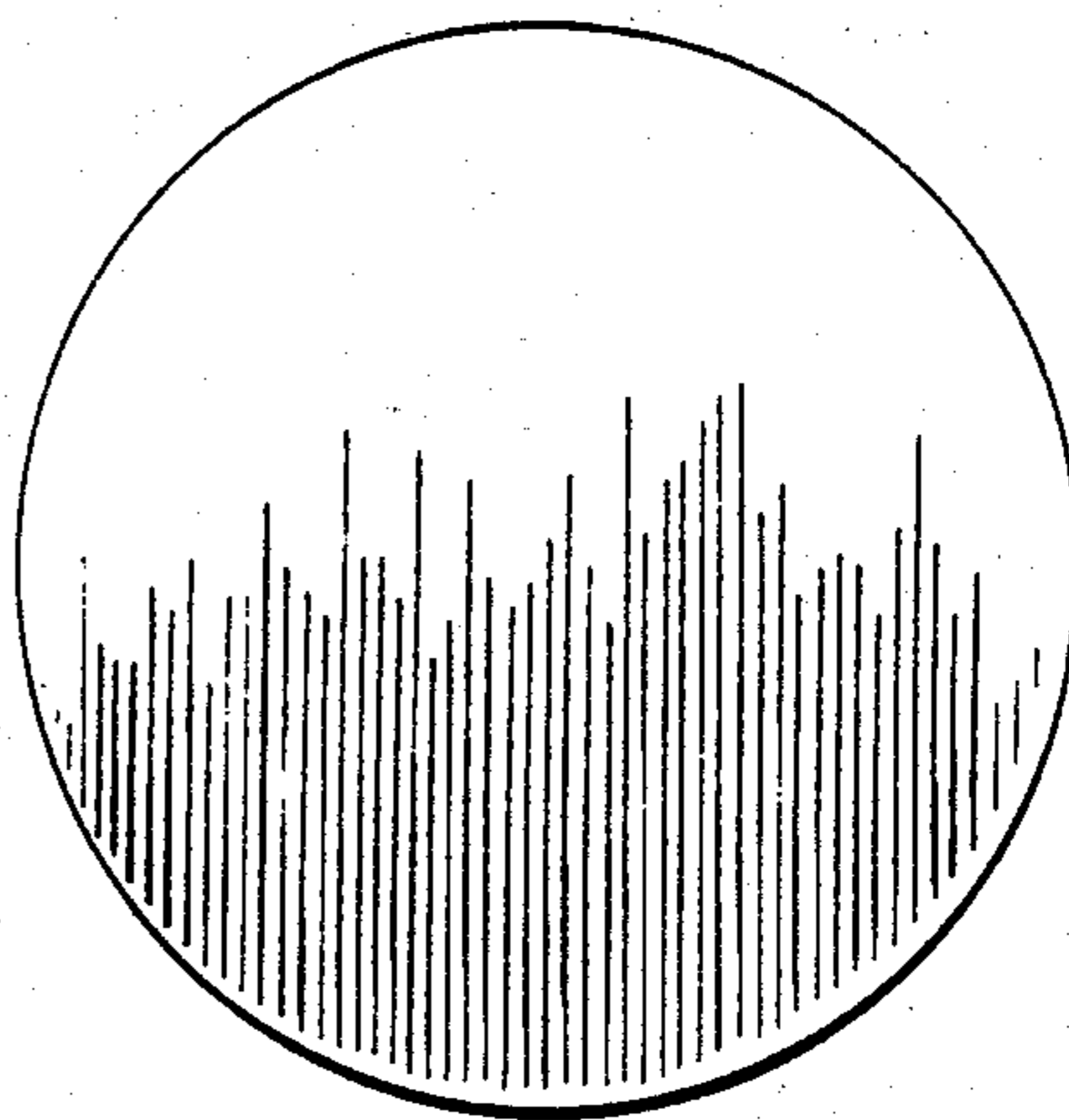

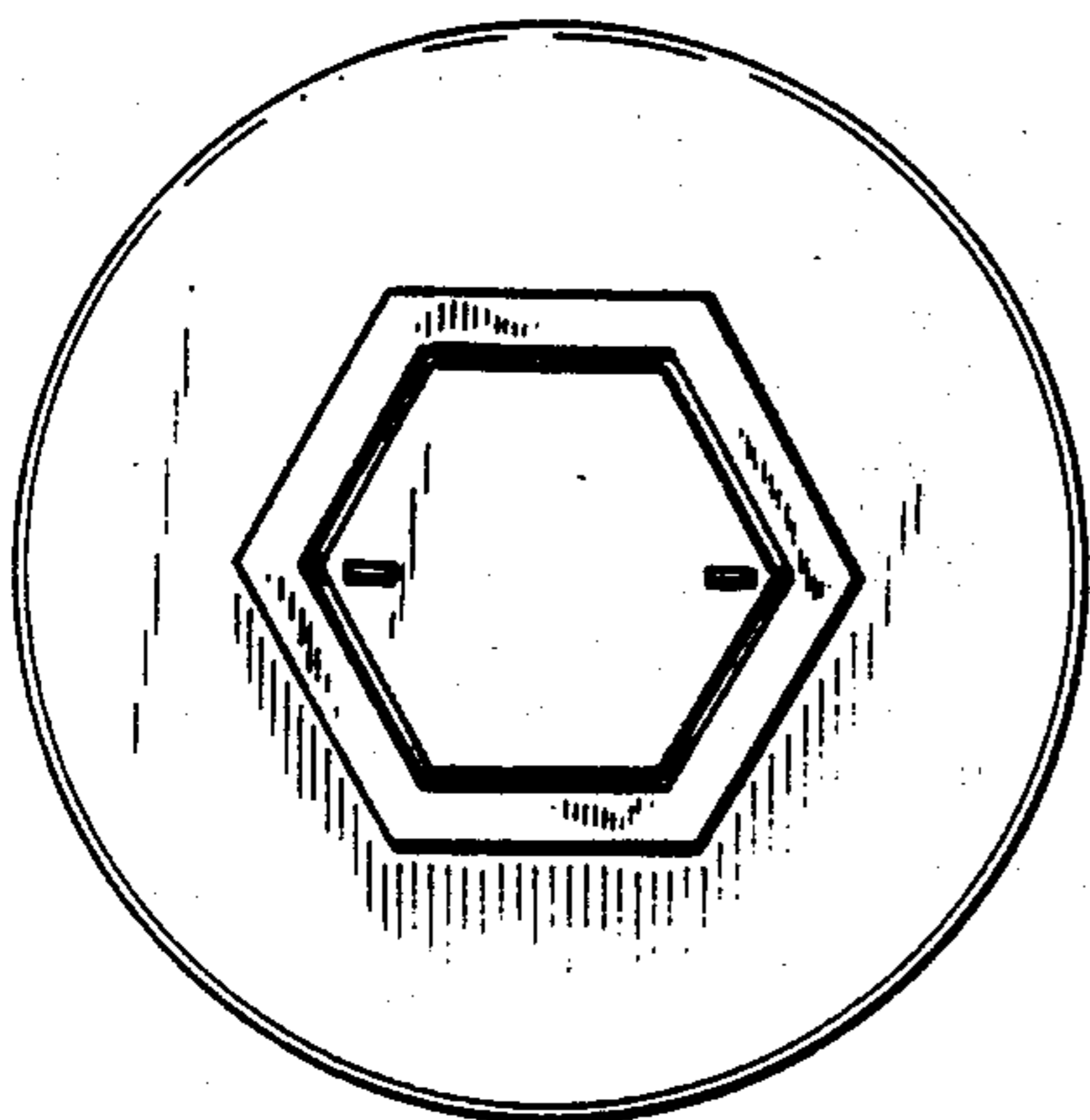

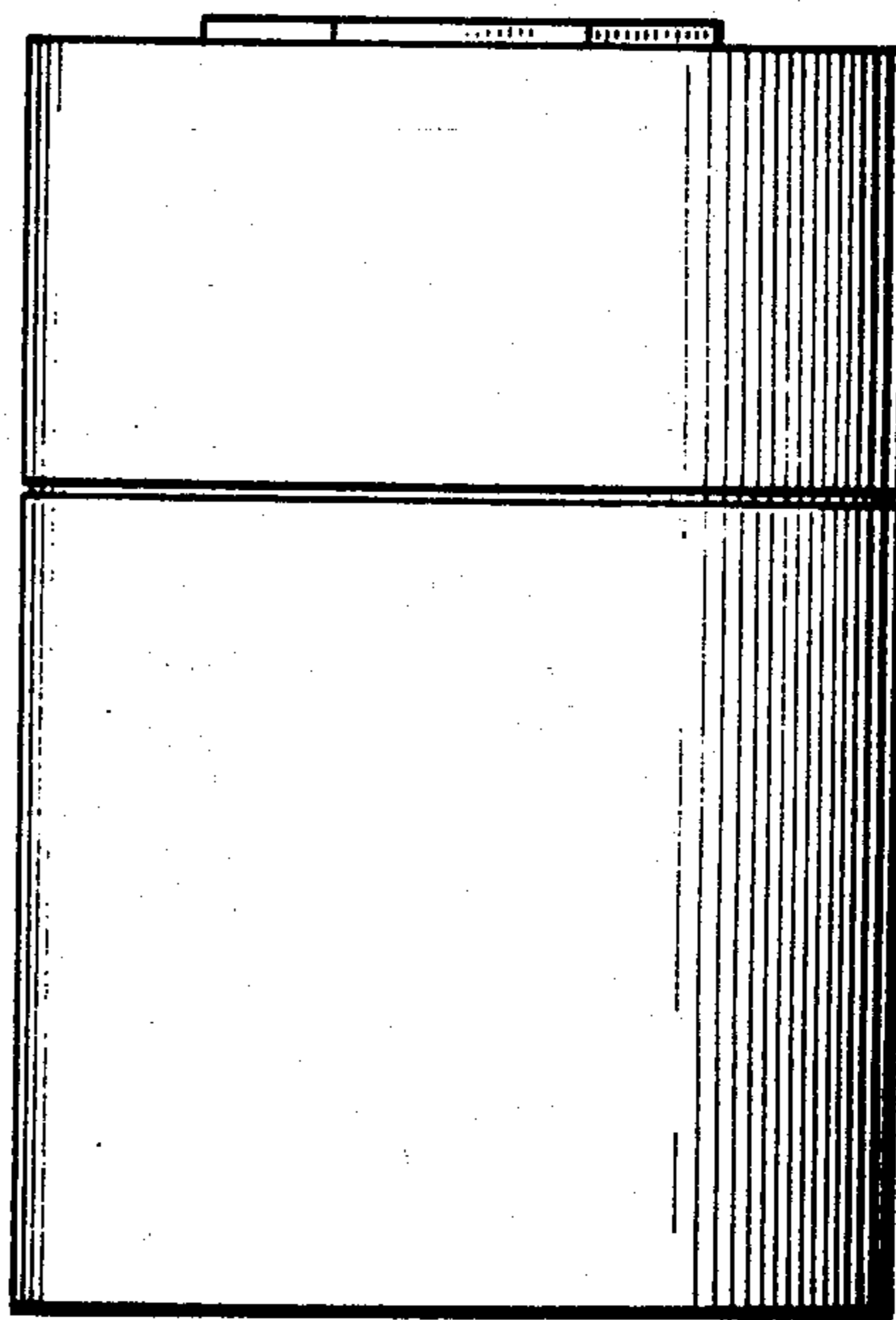
