[57] CLAIM

The ornamental design for a two instrument dive console, substantially as shown.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a front and bottom-left perspective view of a three instrument dive console showing my new design; FIG. 2 is a right side elevational view thereof; FIG. 3 is a rear elevational view thereof; FIG. 4 is a top plan view of FIG. 2; FIG. 5 is a bottom plan view of FIG. 2; FIG. 6 is a front and bottom-left perspective view thereof, the broken-line showings of instruments within being environmental only, and form no part of the claimed design.

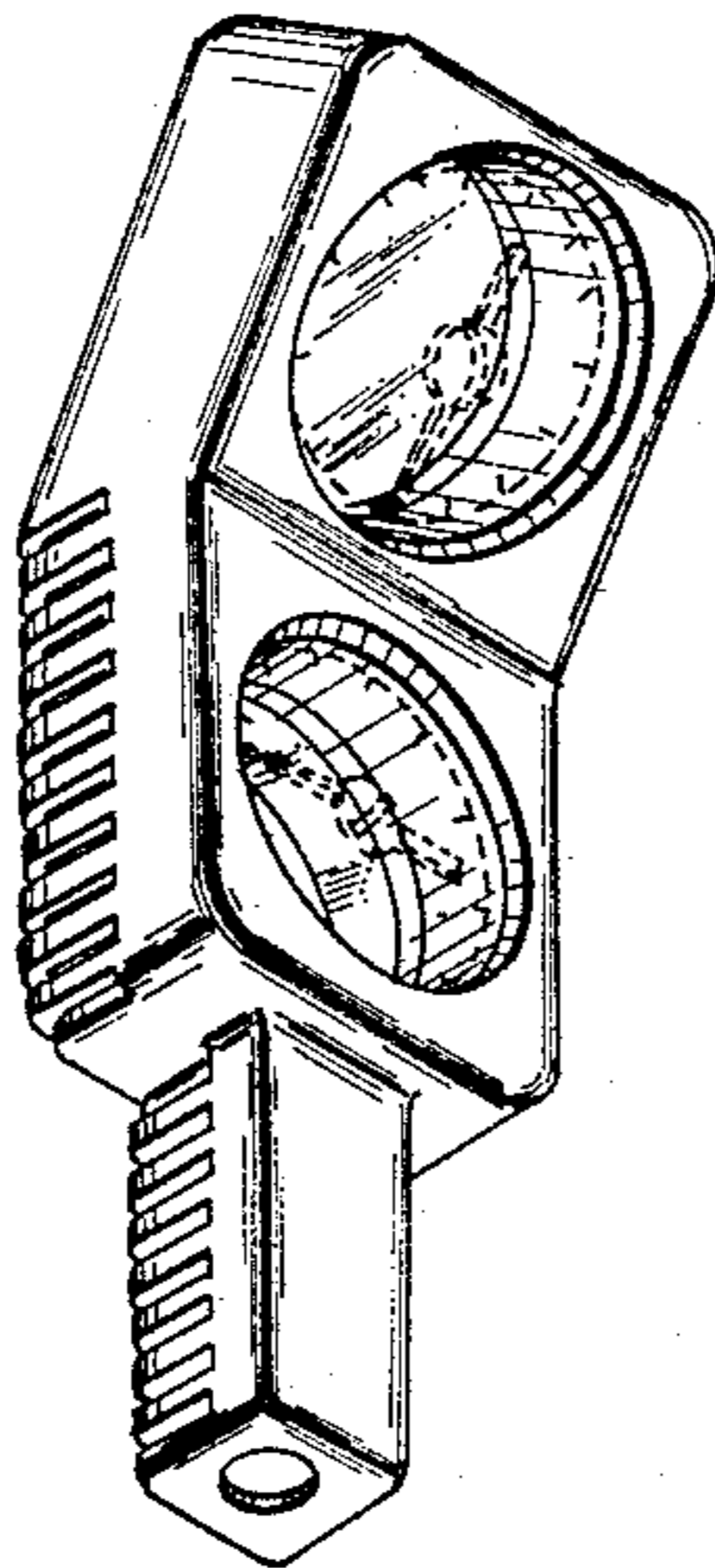

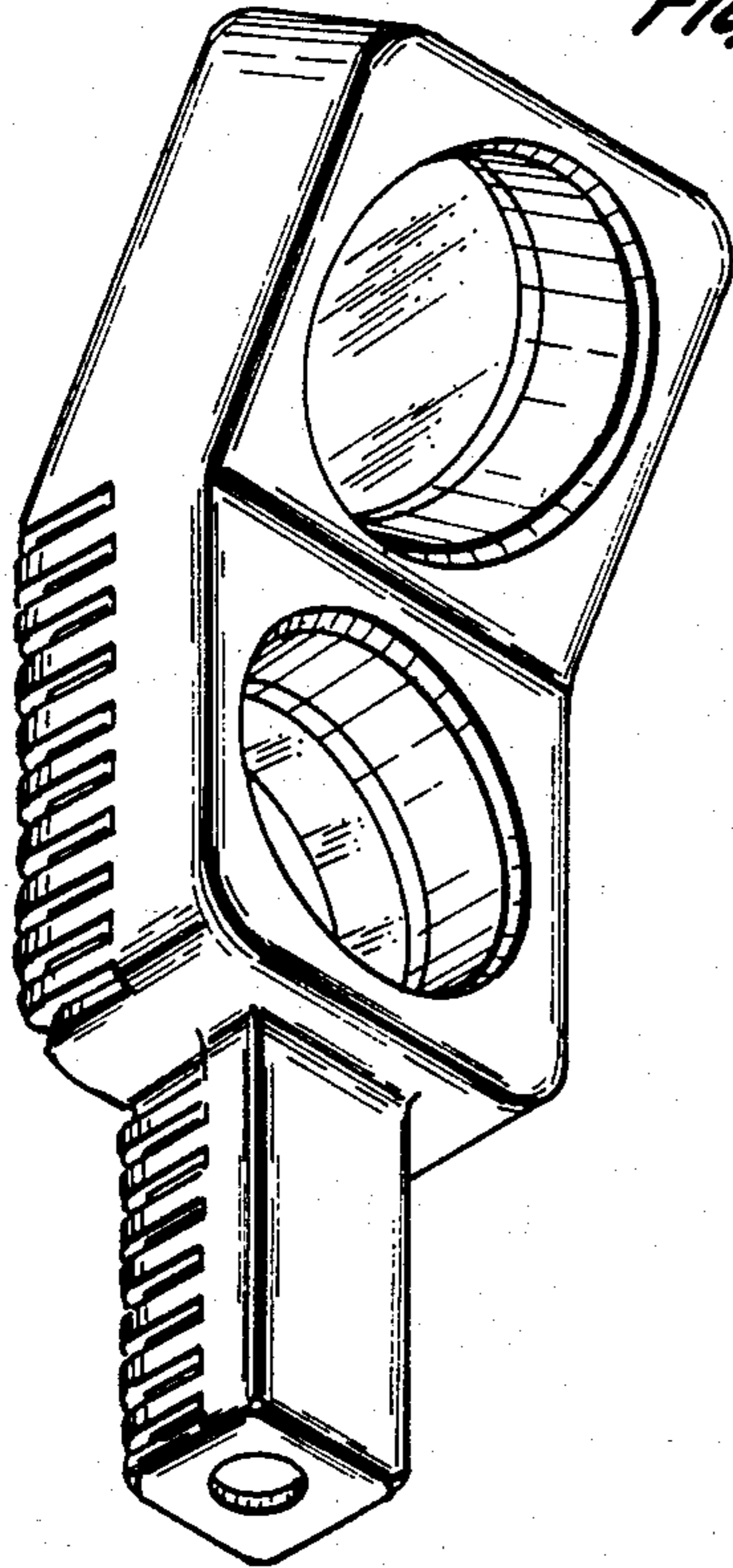

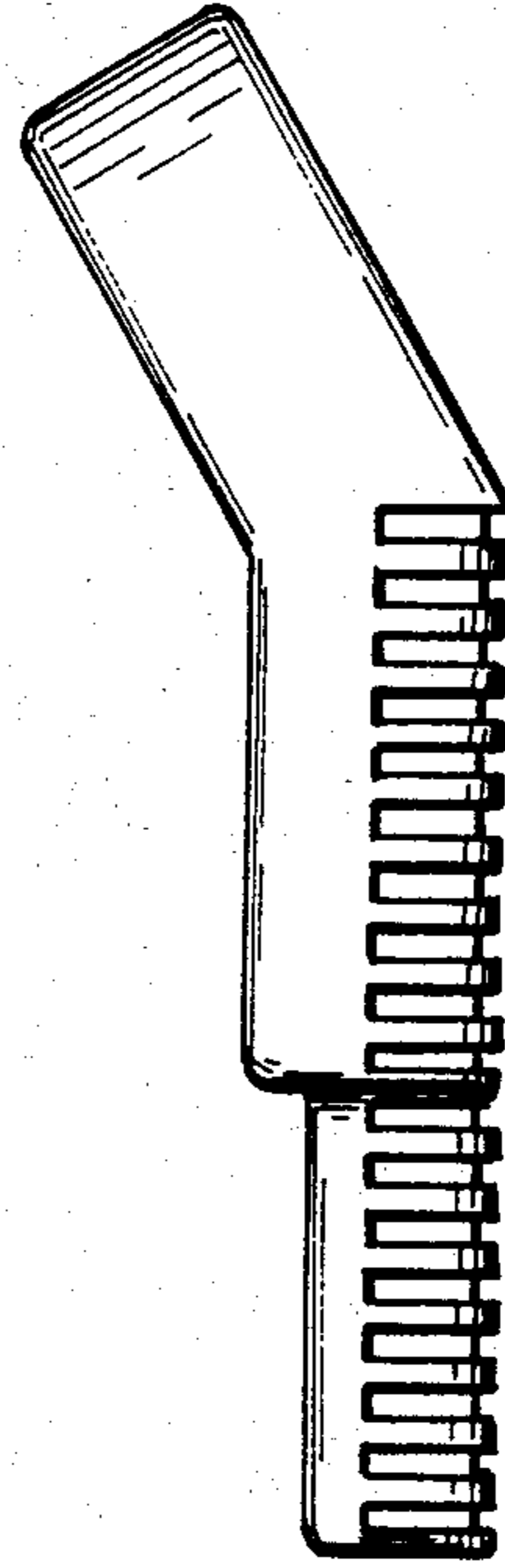

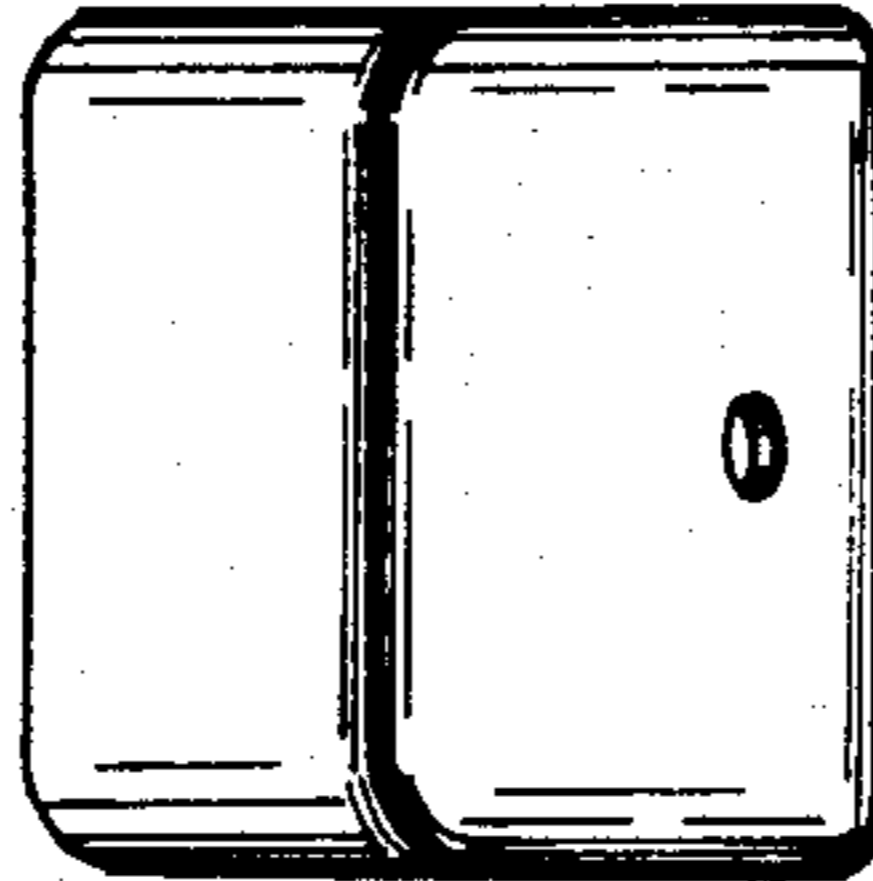

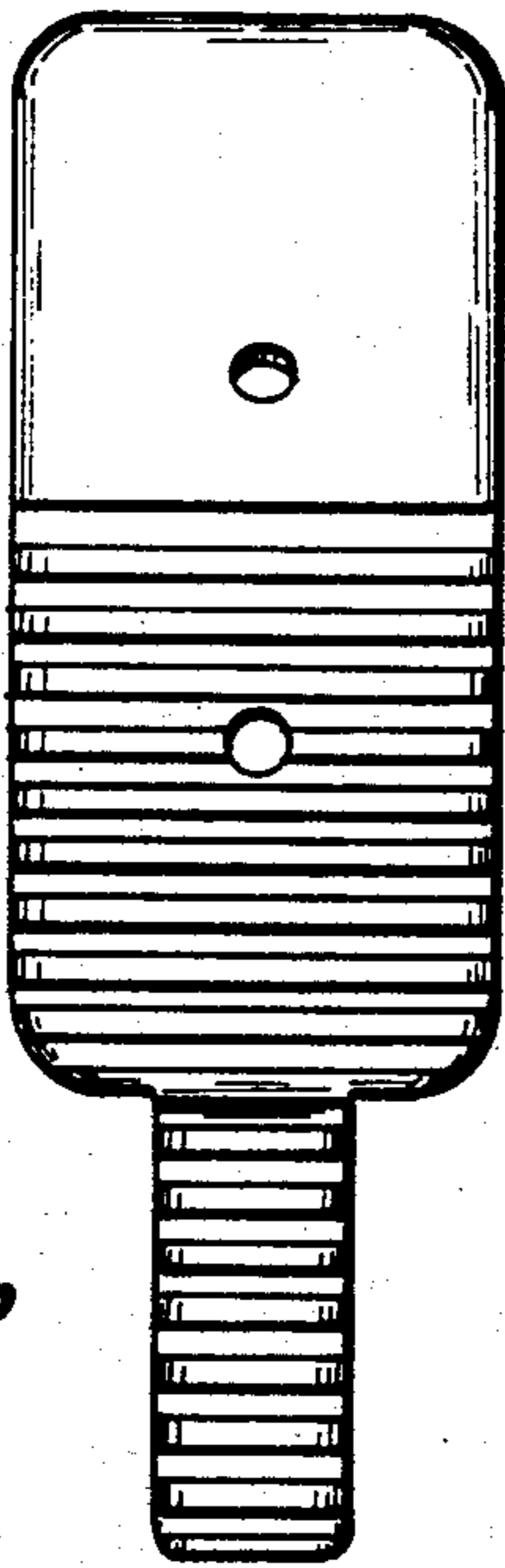

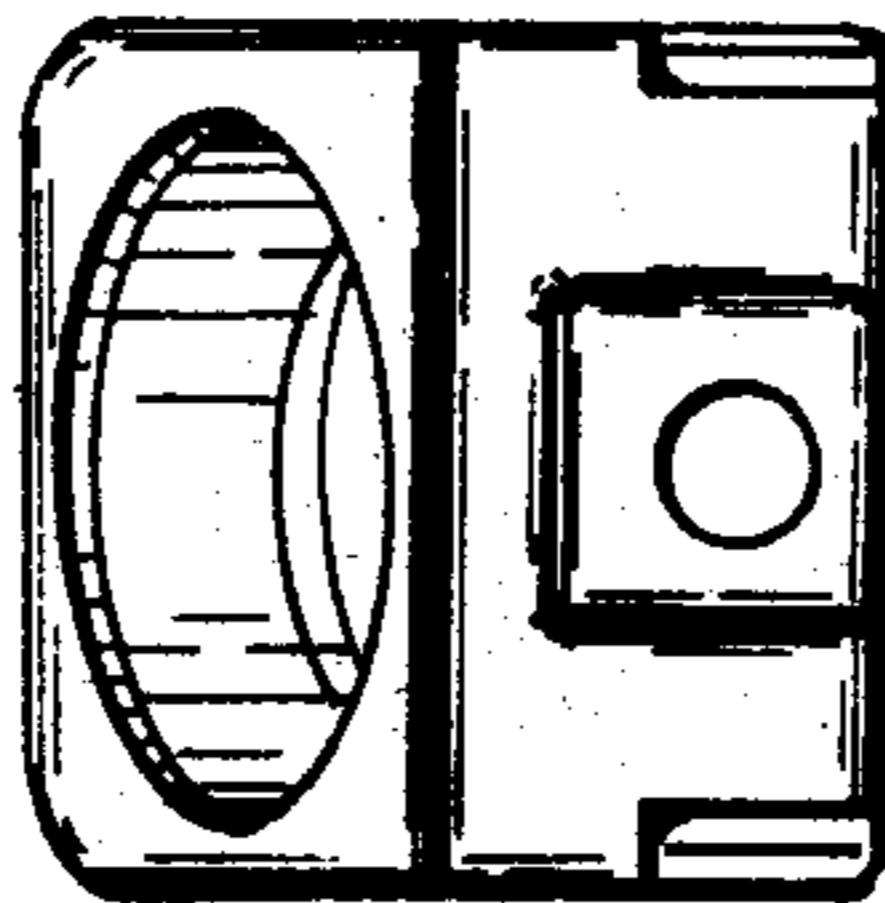
