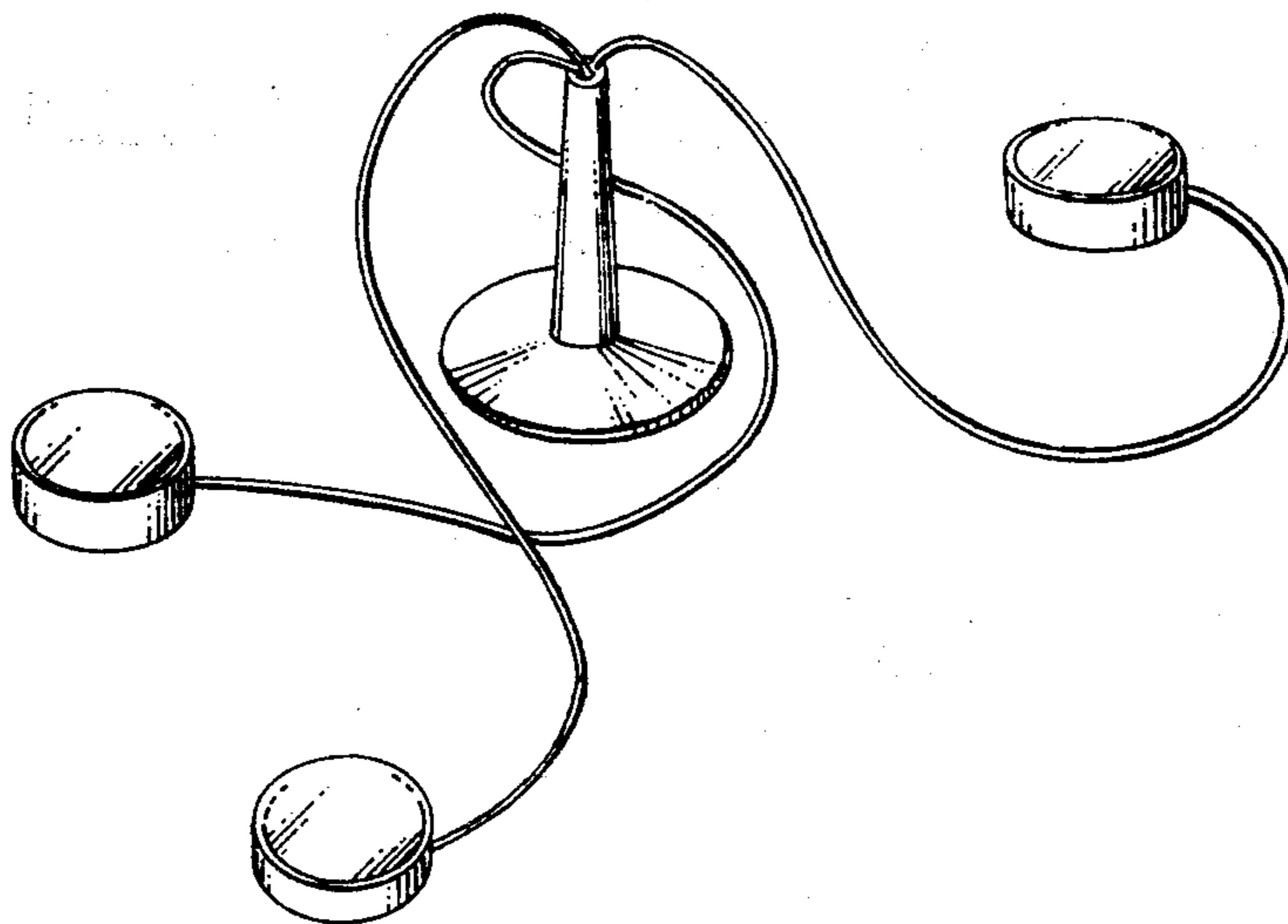

The ornamental design for a toy retaining device, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a front elevational view of a toy retaining device embodying my new design; FIG. 2 is a front plan view thereof; and FIG. 3 is a bottom plan view. Portions of the string members have been shown in fragment in FIGS. 2 and 3 for ease of illustration.



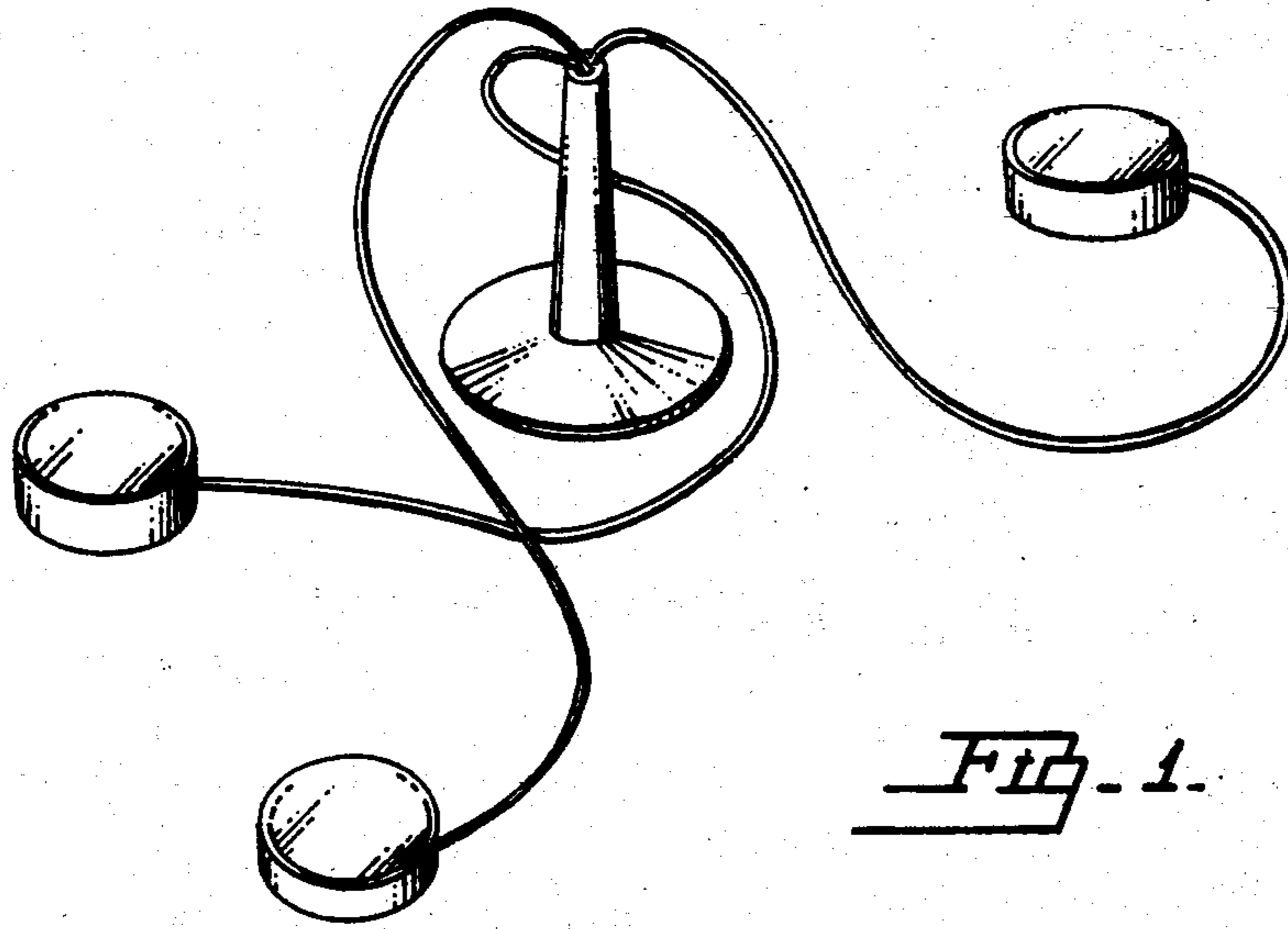

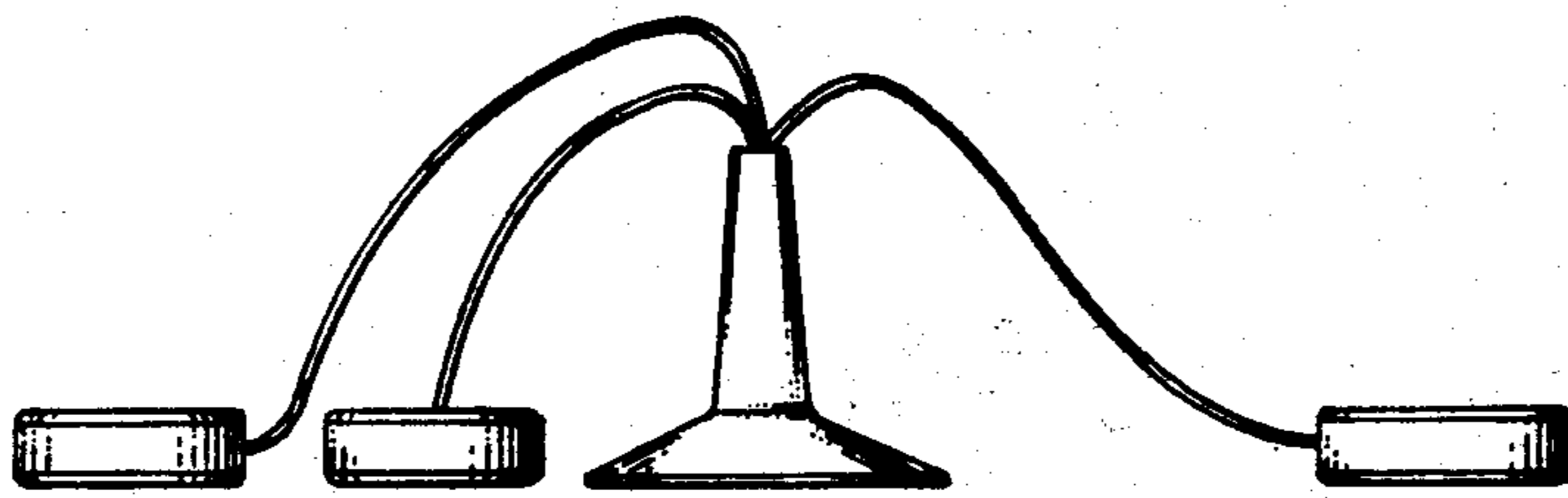

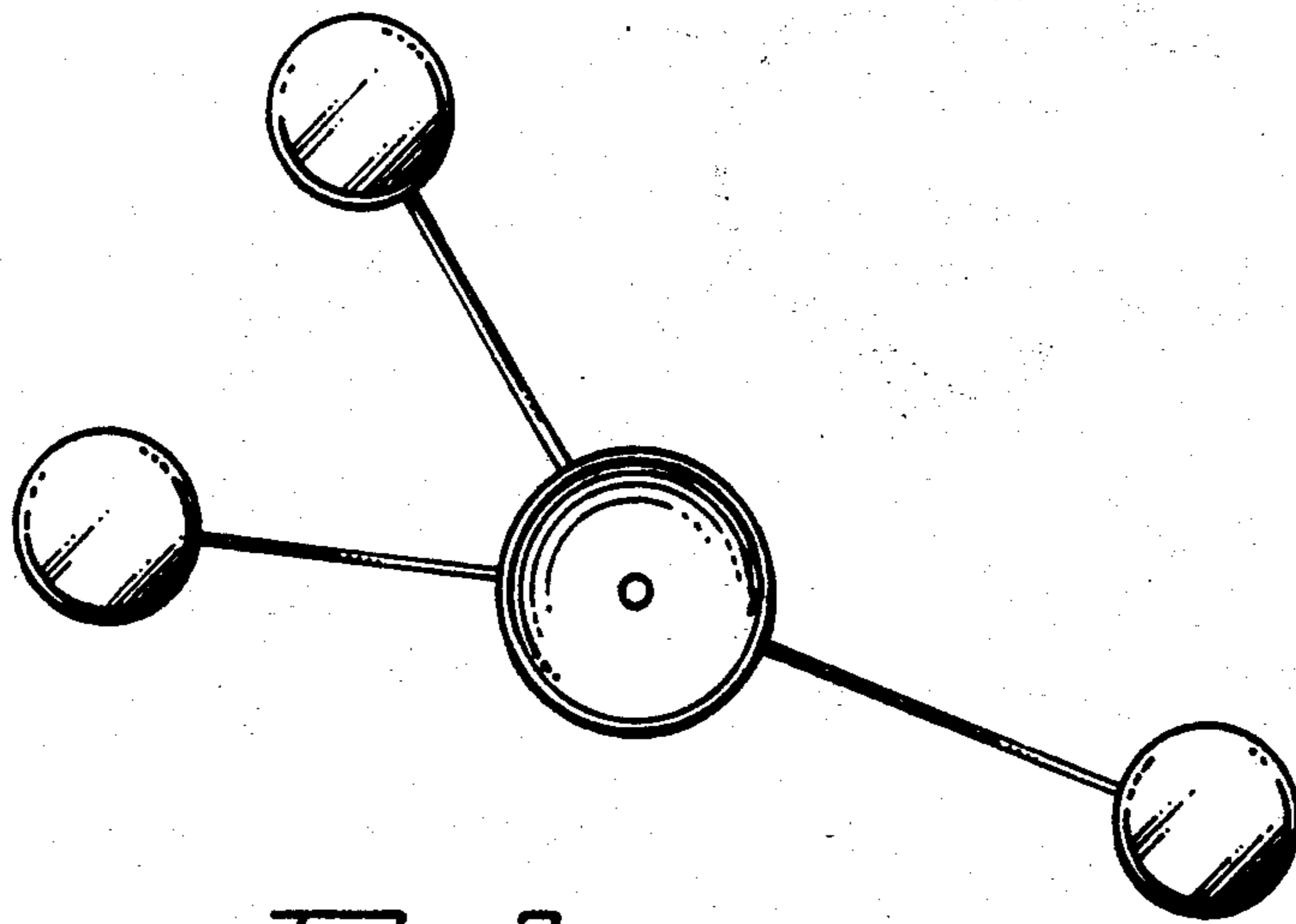
