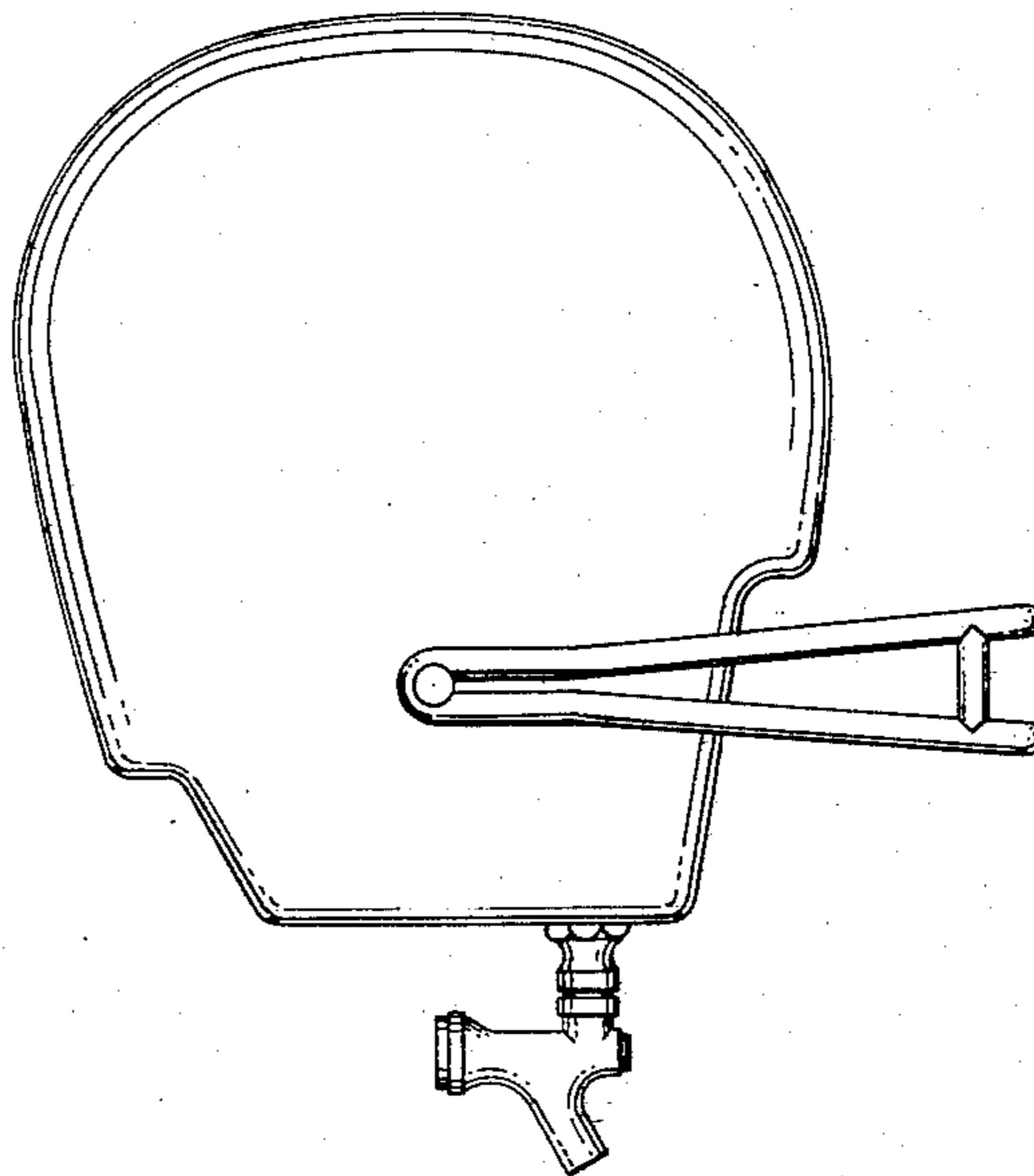

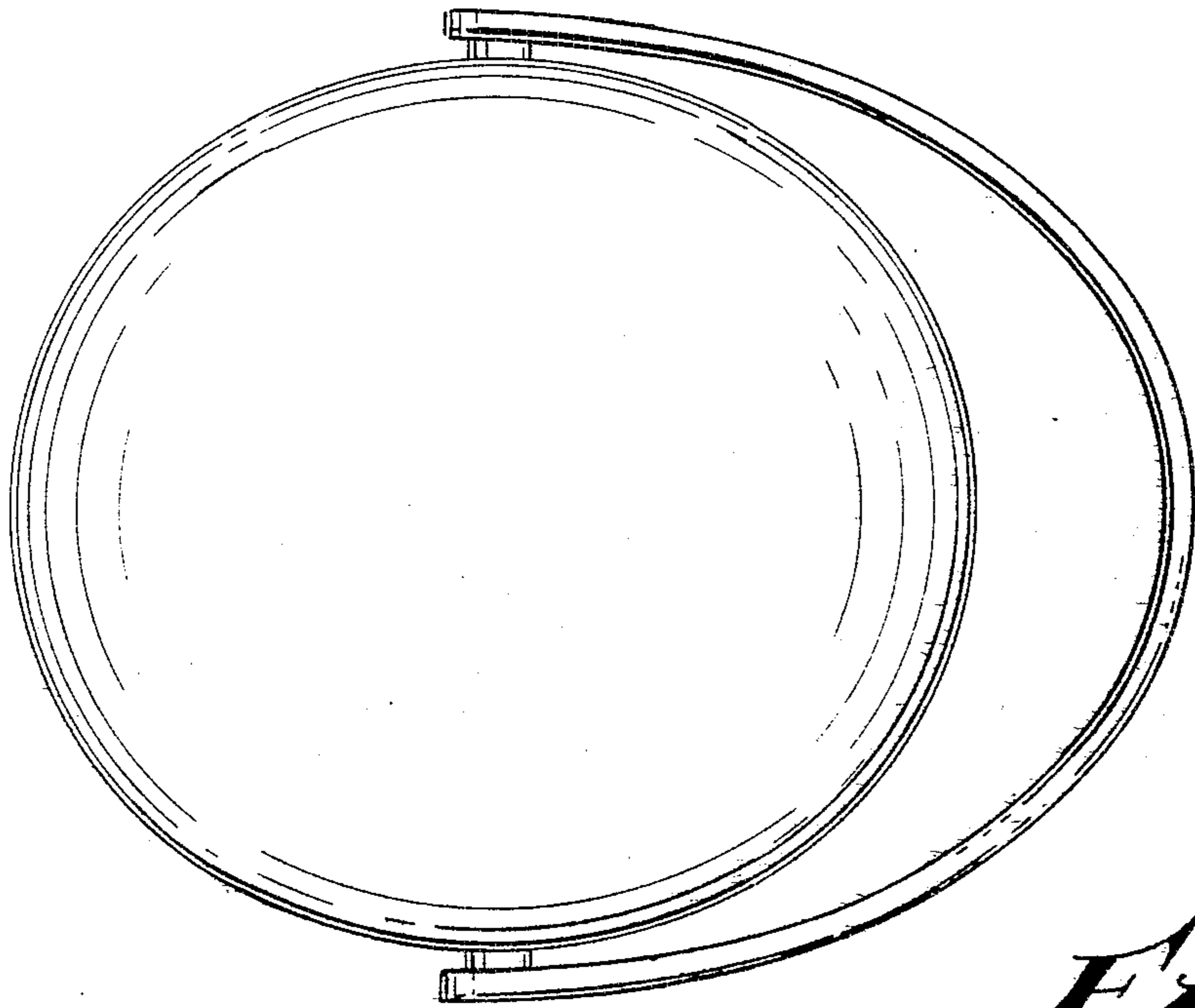
[57] CLAIM

The ornamental design for a liquid dispenser, as shown and described.

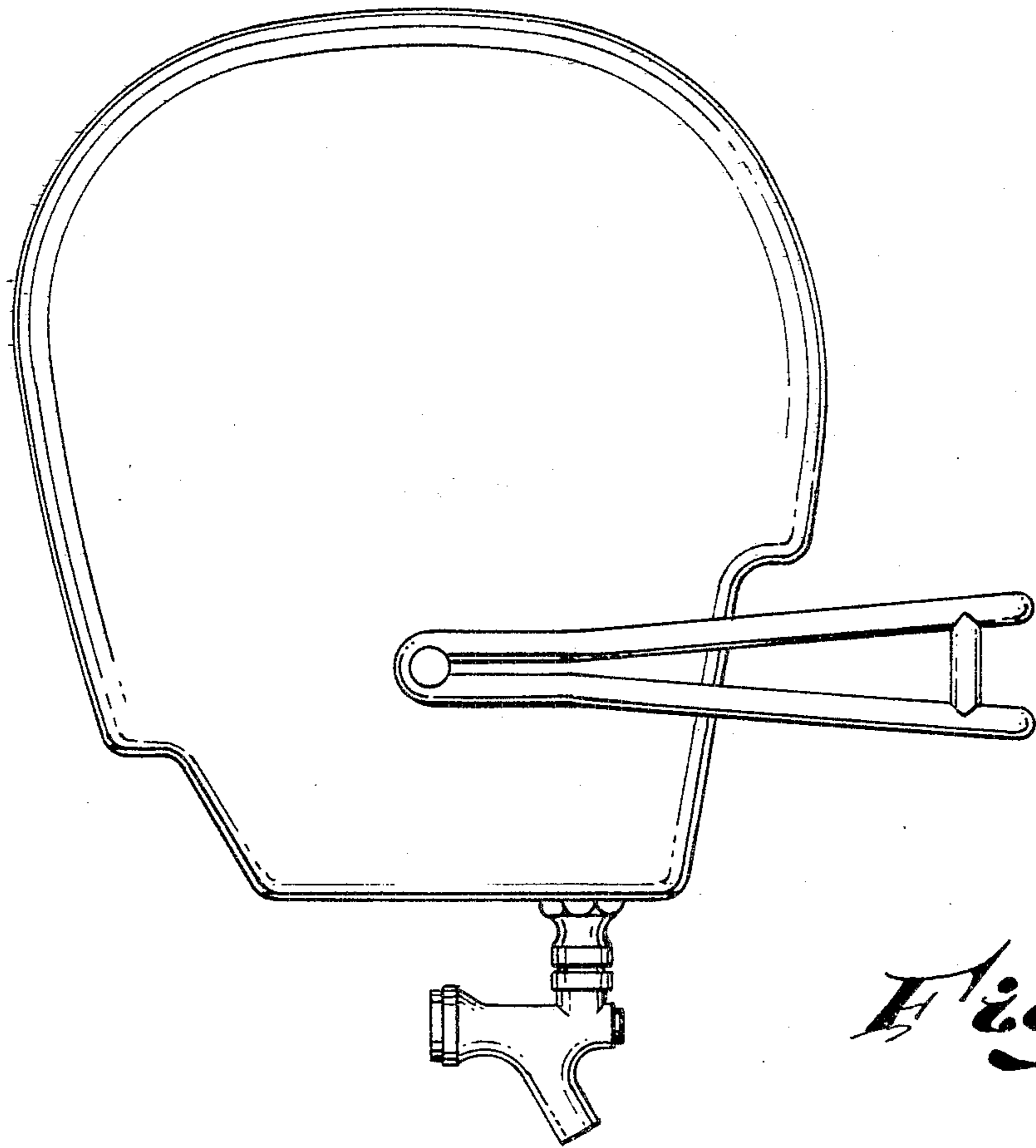
DESCRIPTION

 The bottom is plain and unornamented except for the presence of the spout.

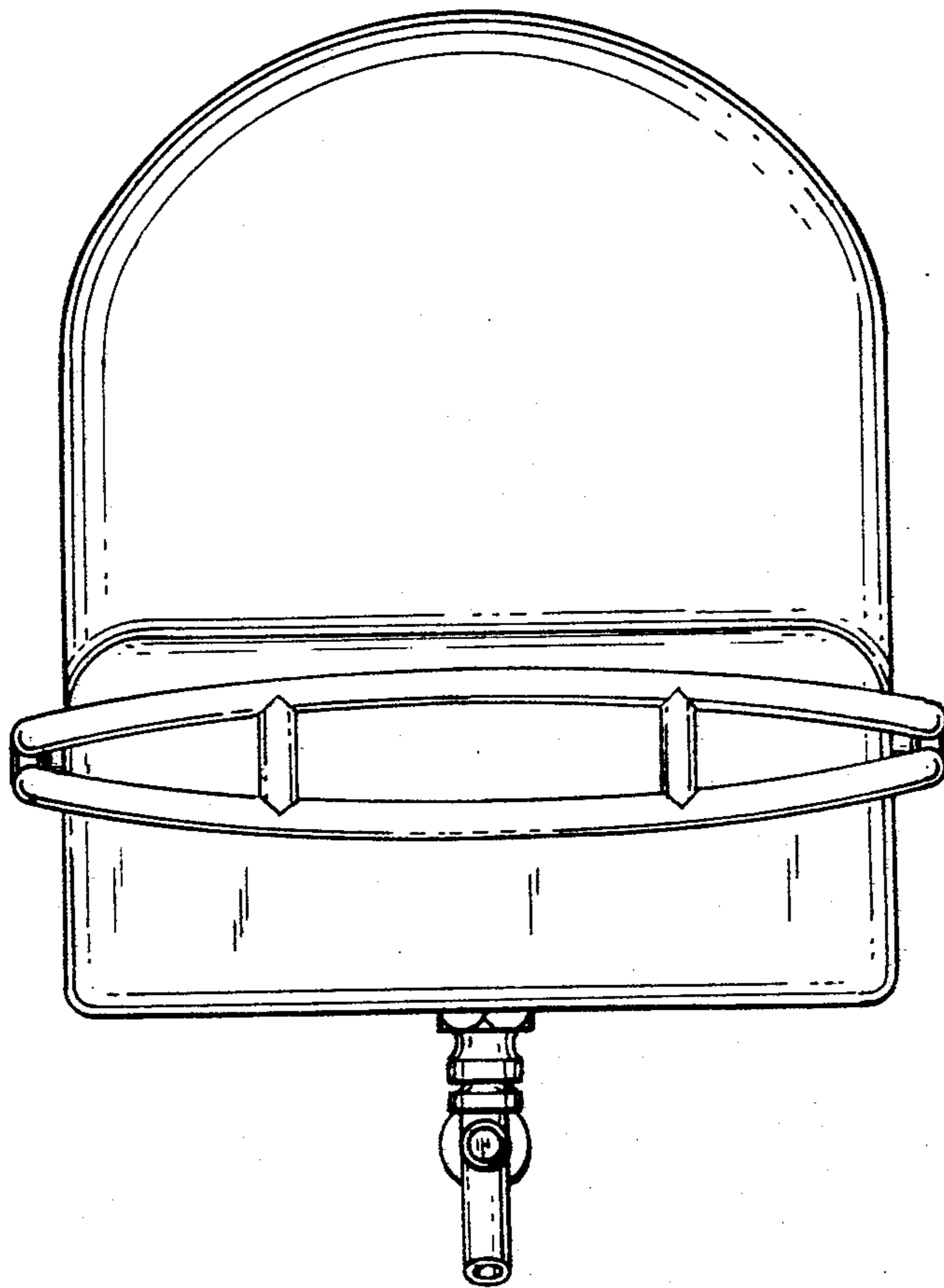
