FIG. 1 is a front elevational view of a spectacle frame showing my new design;

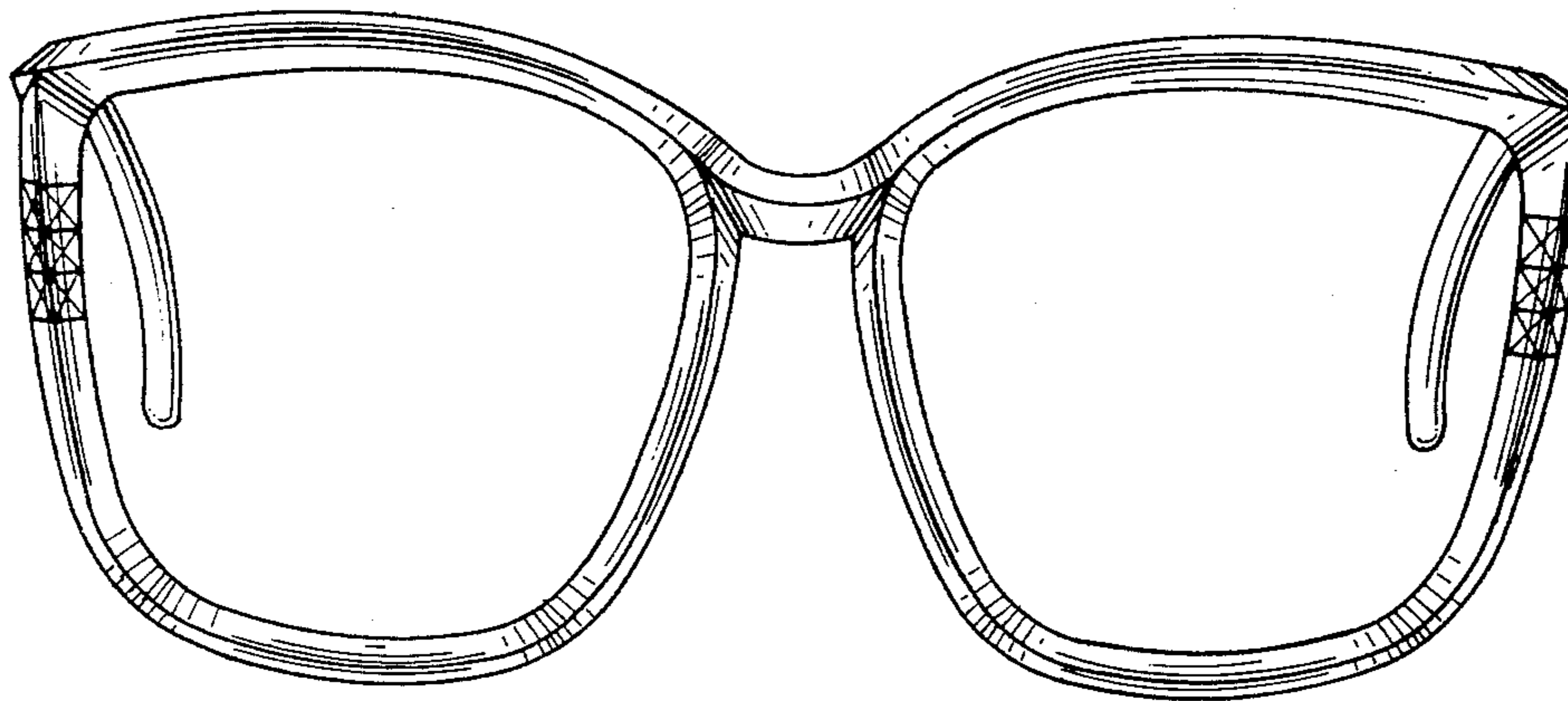
FIG. 2 is a perspective view thereof;

FIG. 6 is a top plan view thereof.



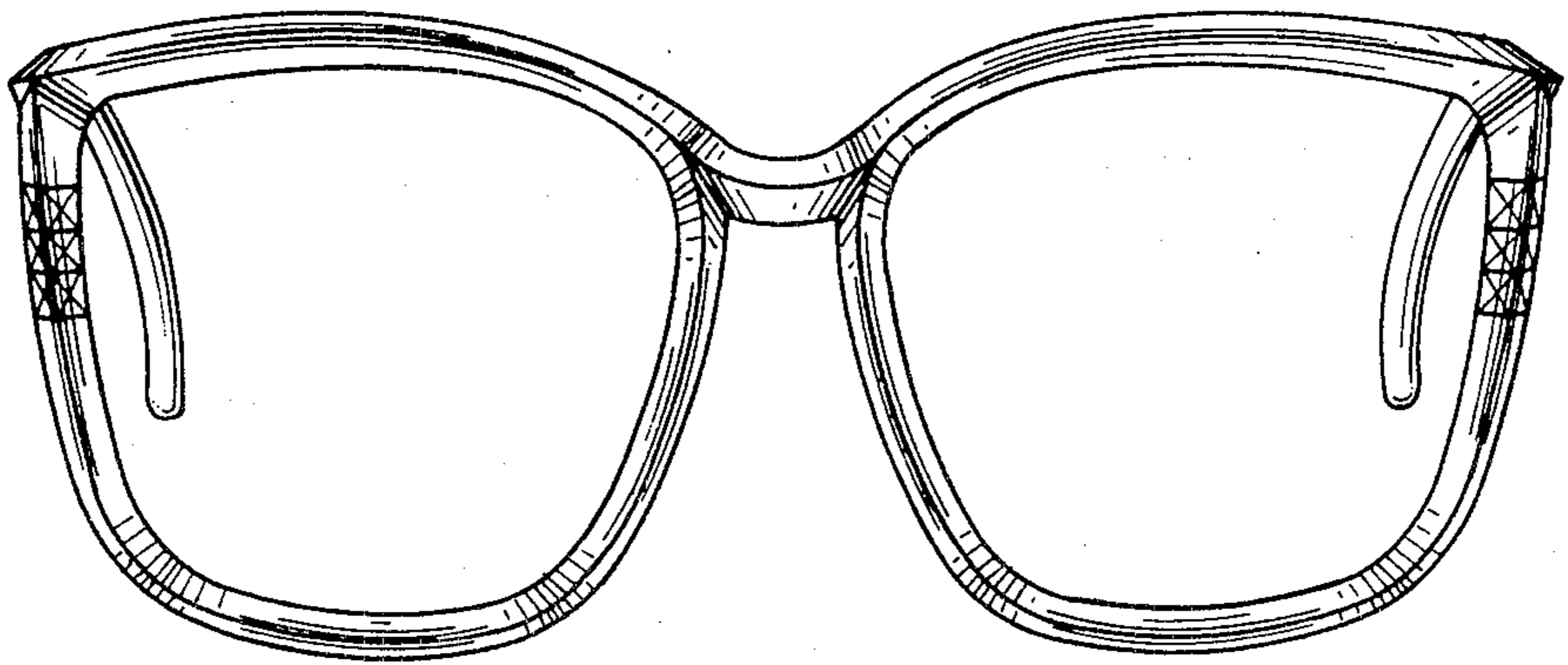

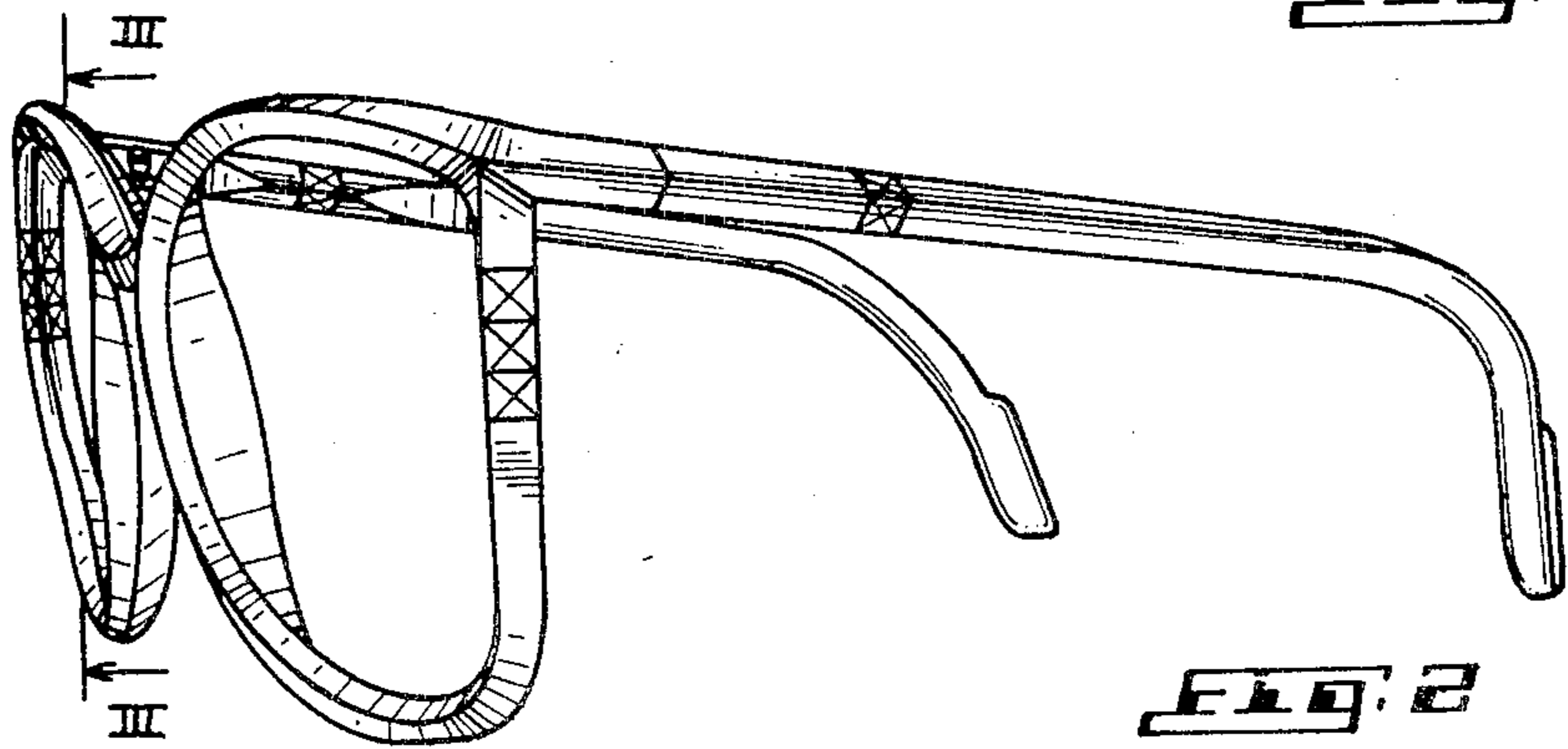

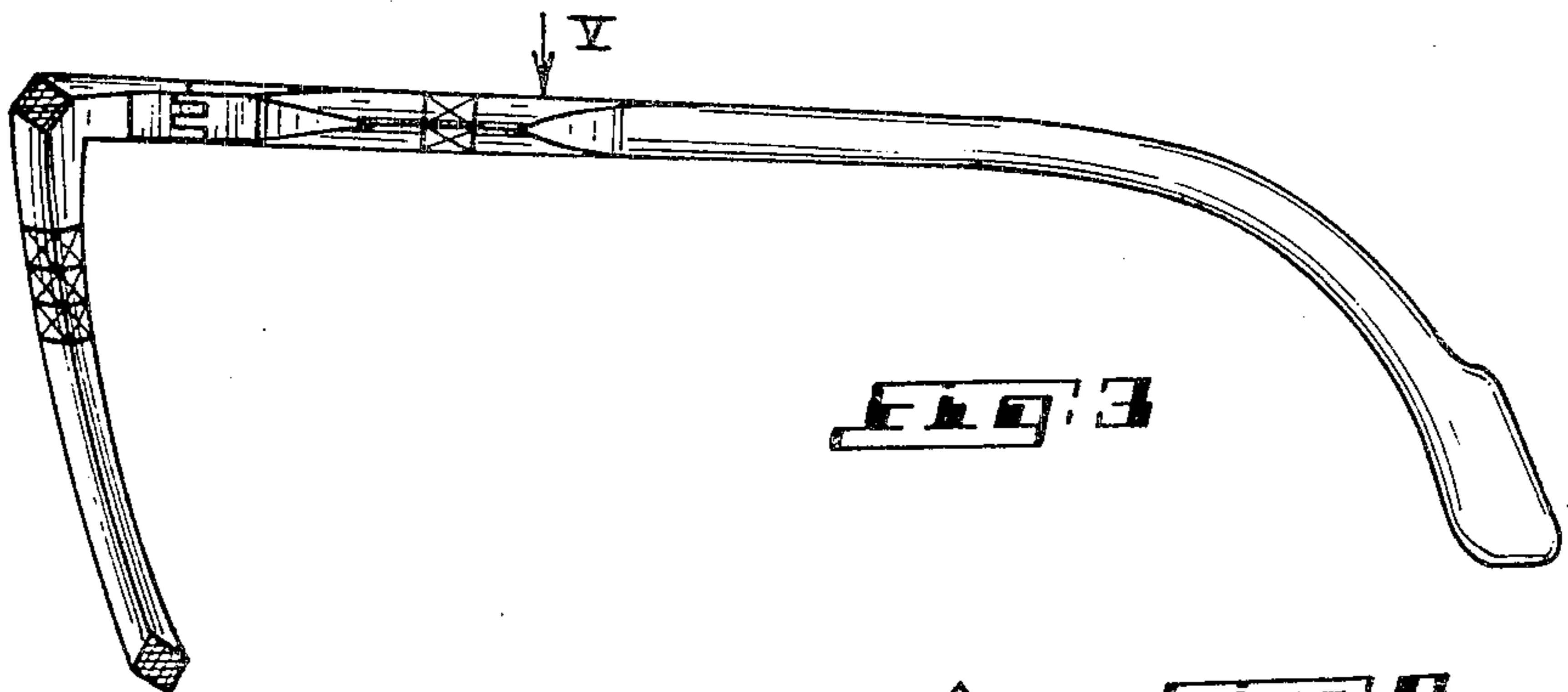

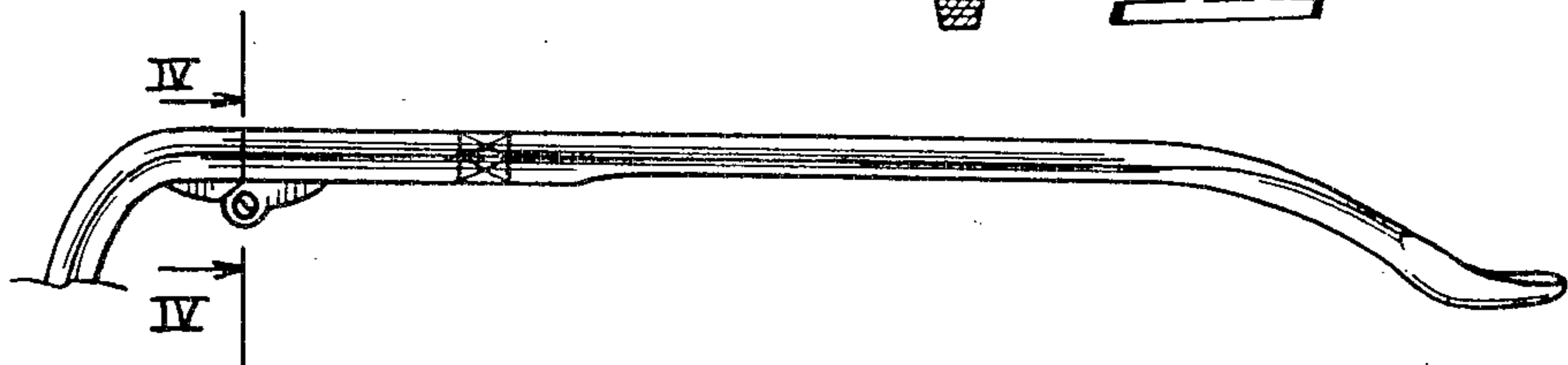
