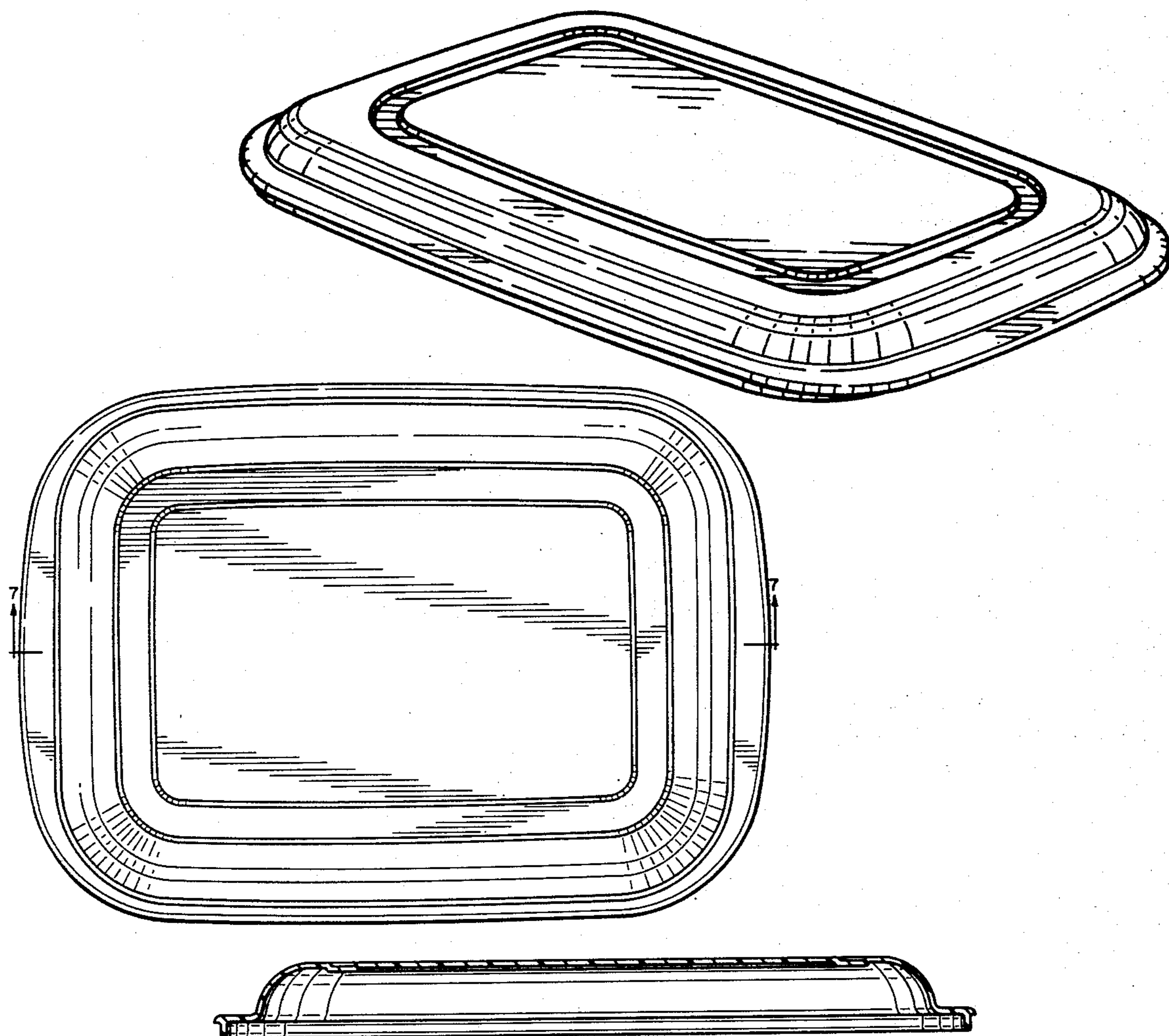

[57] CLAIM

The ornamental design for a casserole dish cover, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a top perspective view of the casserole dish cover or the like showing our new design; FIG. 2 is a bottom perspective view thereof; FIG. 3 is a side elevational view thereof, the opposite side being identical thereto; FIG. 4 is an end elevational view thereof, the opposite end being identical thereto; FIG. 5 is a top plan view thereof; FIG. 6 is a bottom plan view thereof; FIG. 7 is a cross-sectional view taken along line 7—7 of FIG. 5.



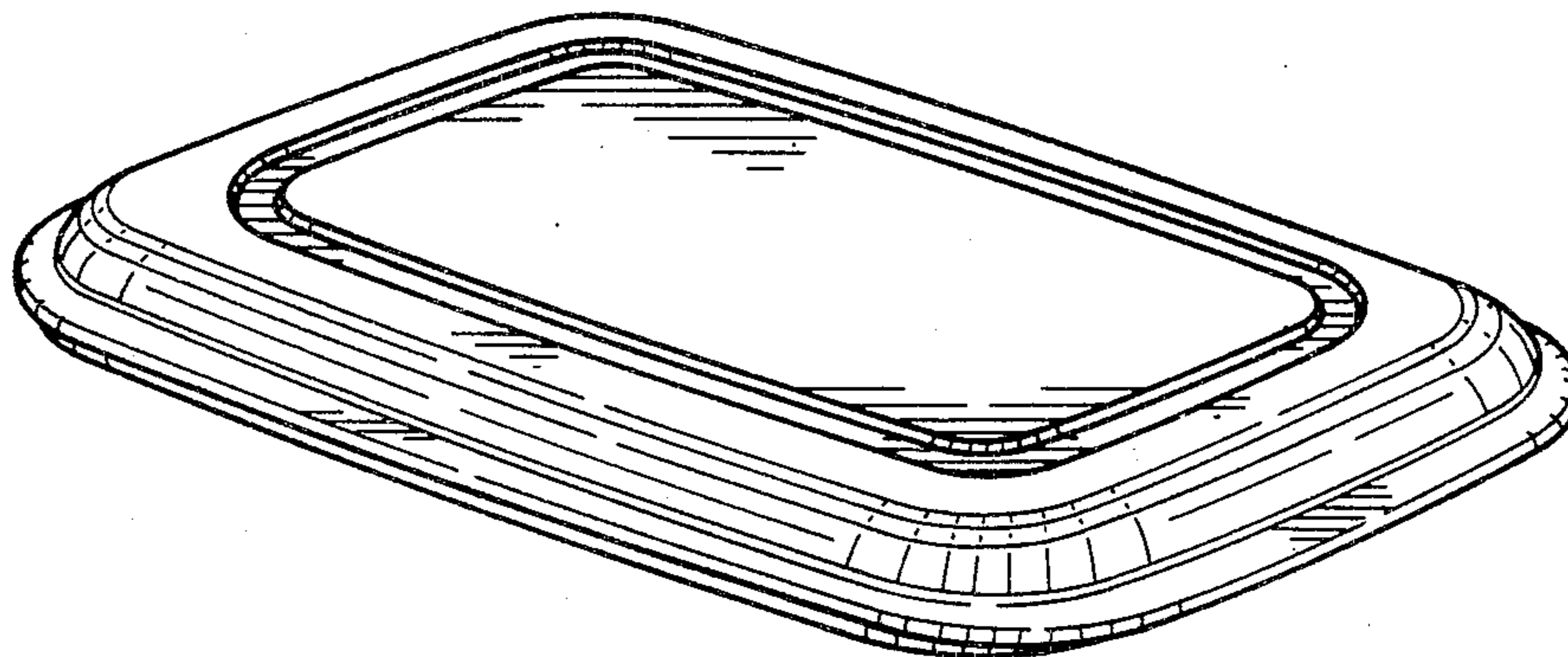

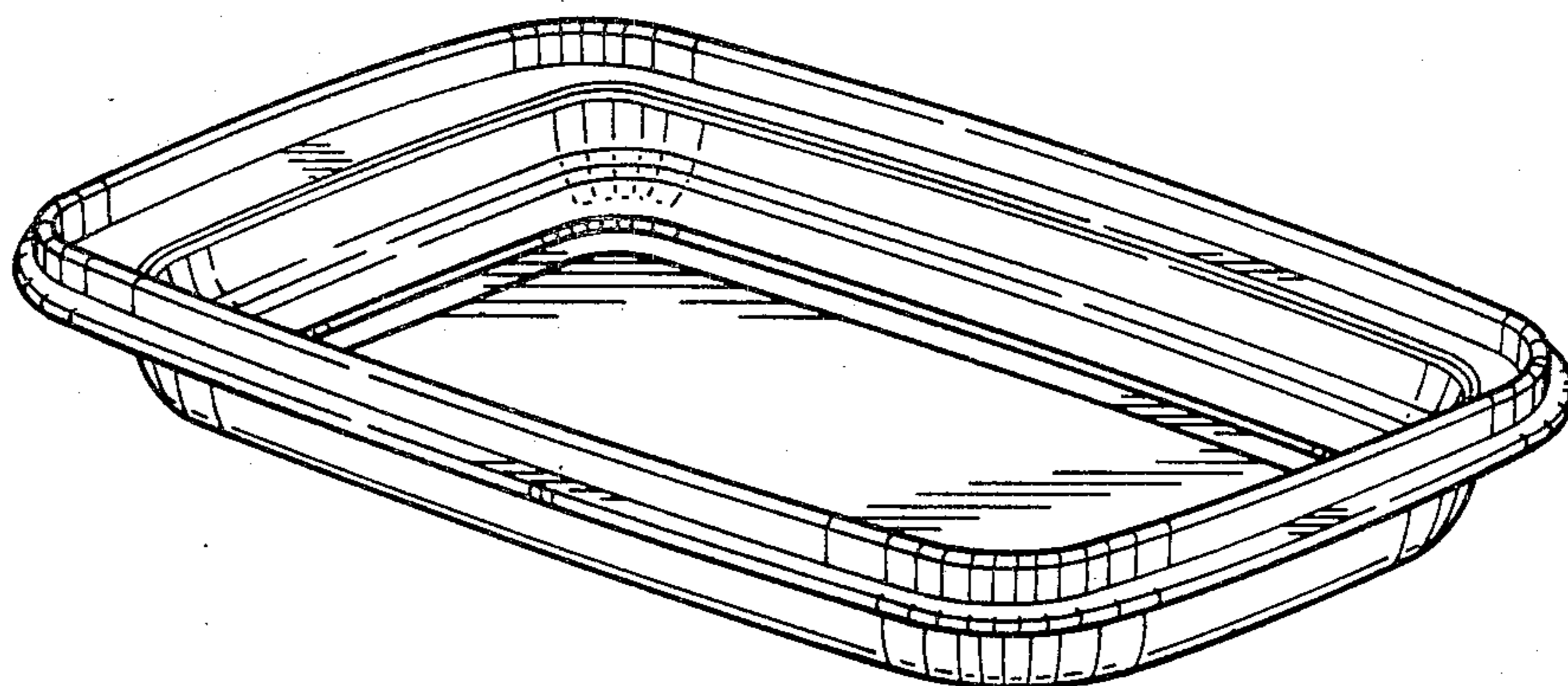

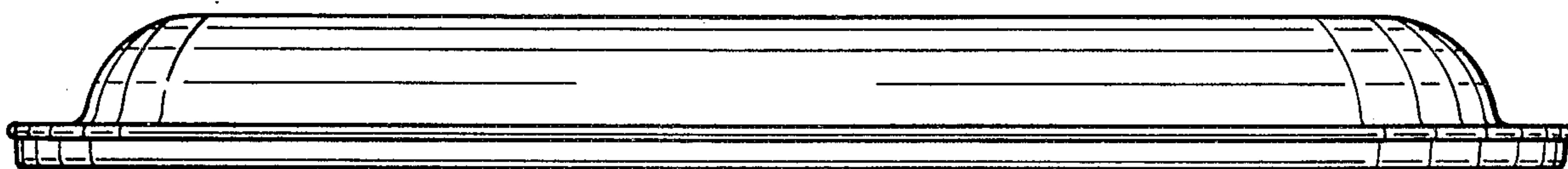

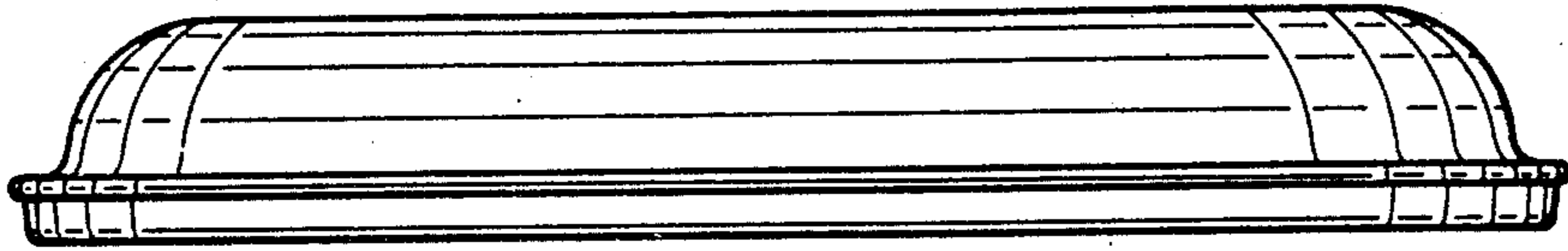

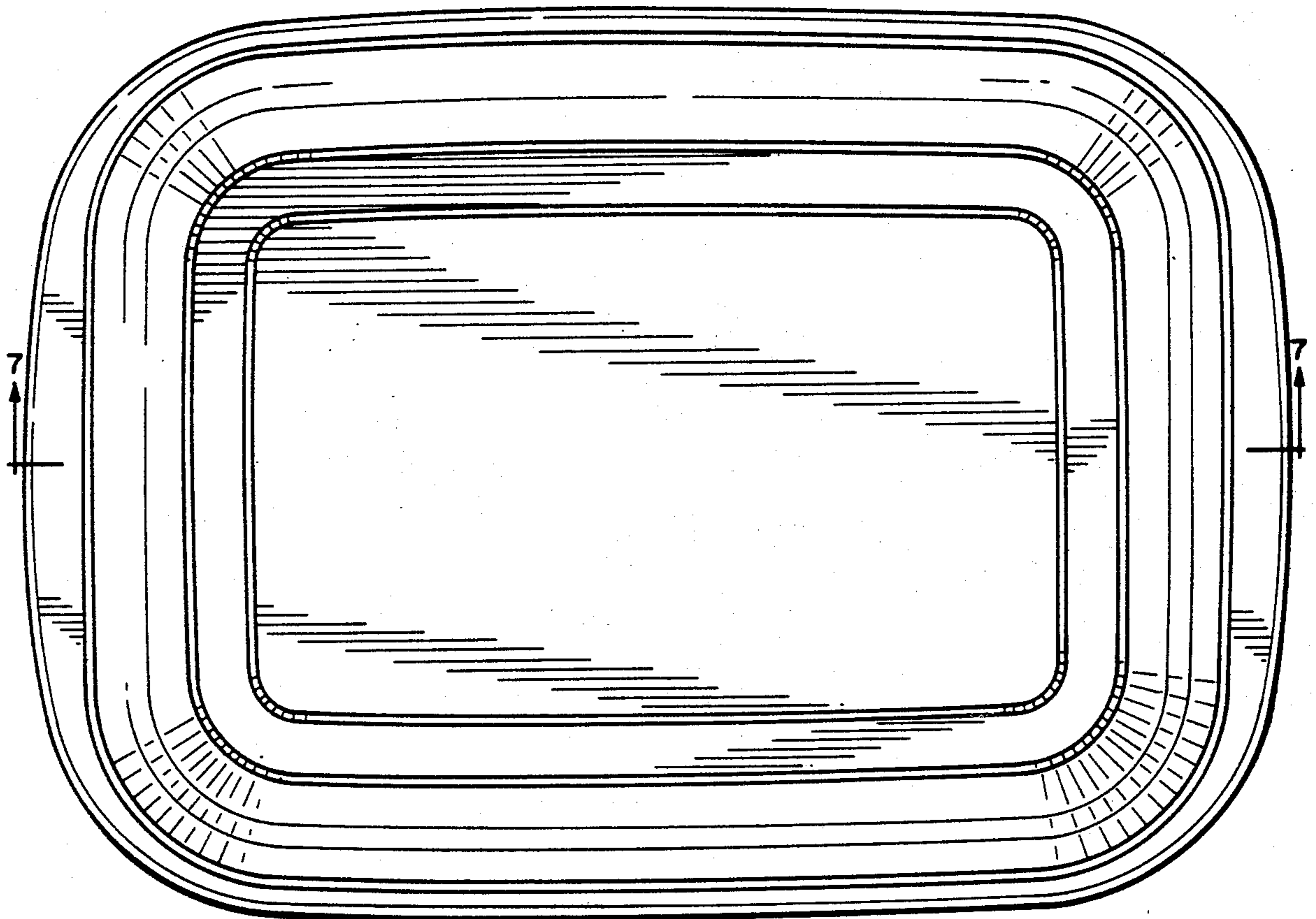

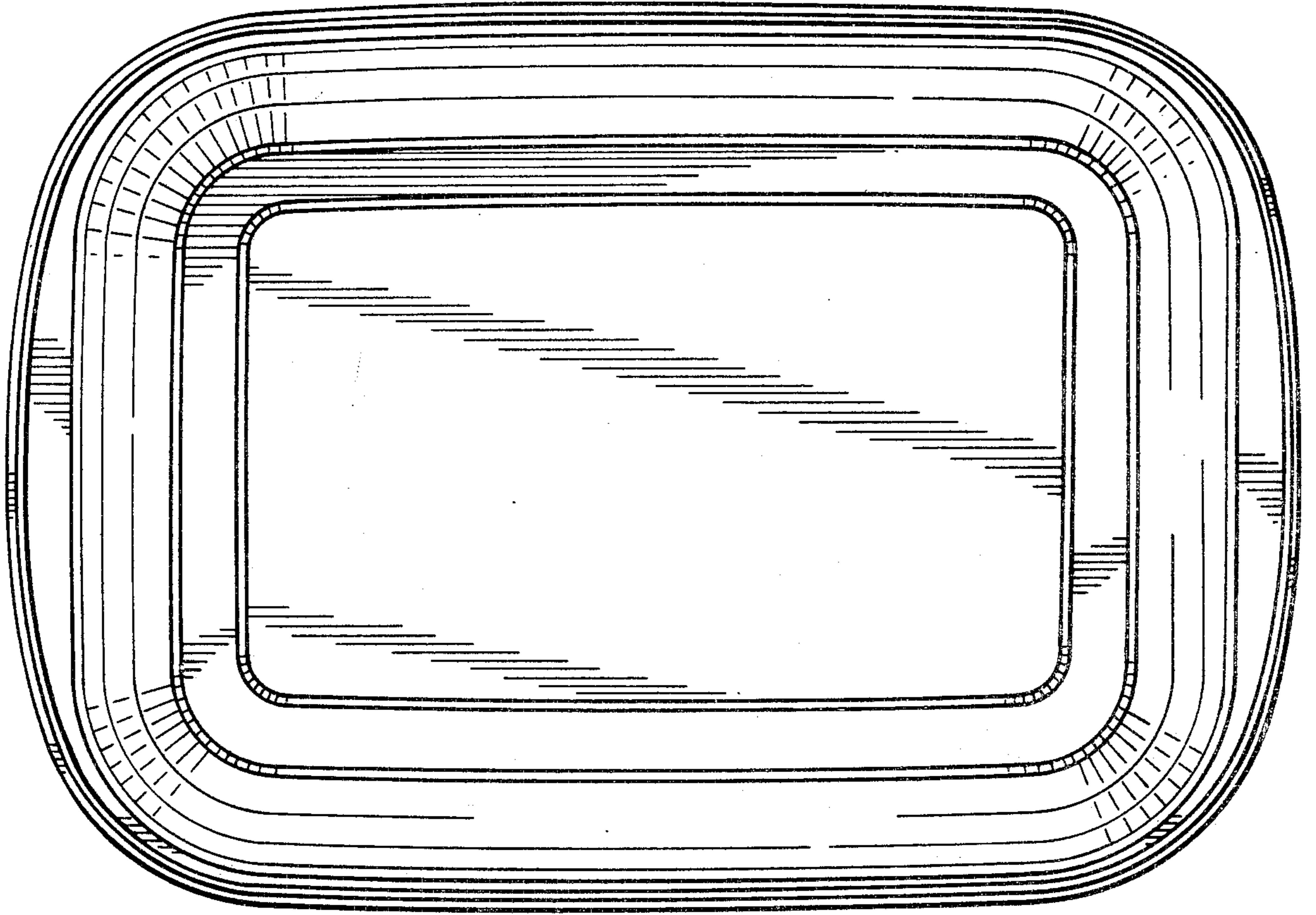

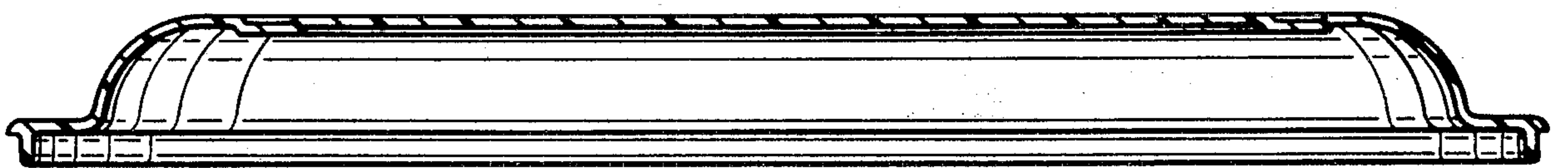
