as shown and described.

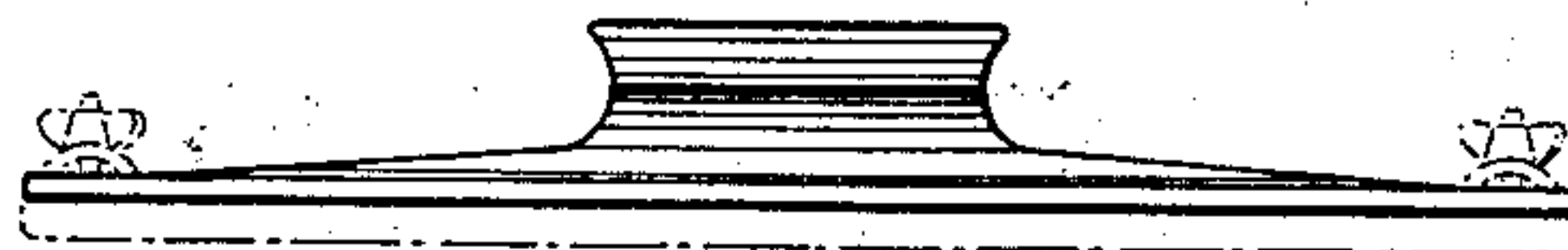
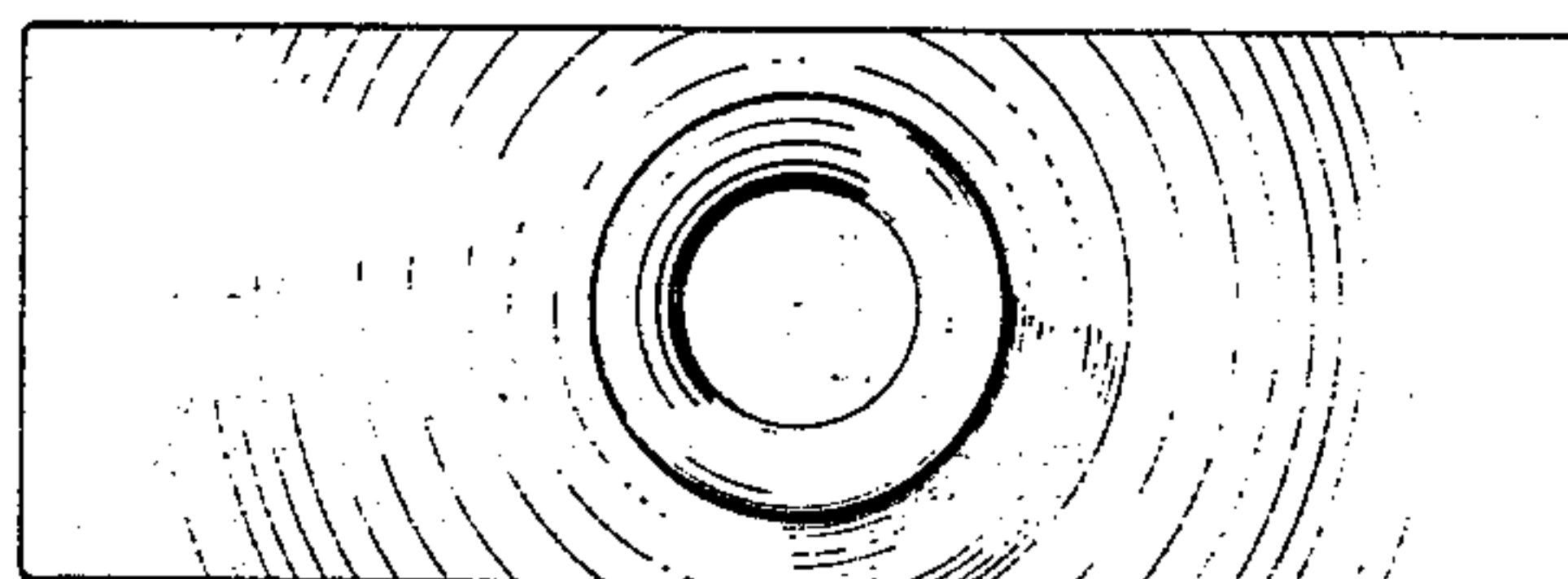
DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a top plan view of a vacuum sander head plate
showing my new design;

FIG. 2 is an end elevational view thereof; and

FIG. 3 is a side elevational view thereof, the broken line
showing of the fasteners and abrasive pad is for illustra-
tive purposes only.

The bottom surface of the vacuum sander head plate is
substantially planar and unornamented.



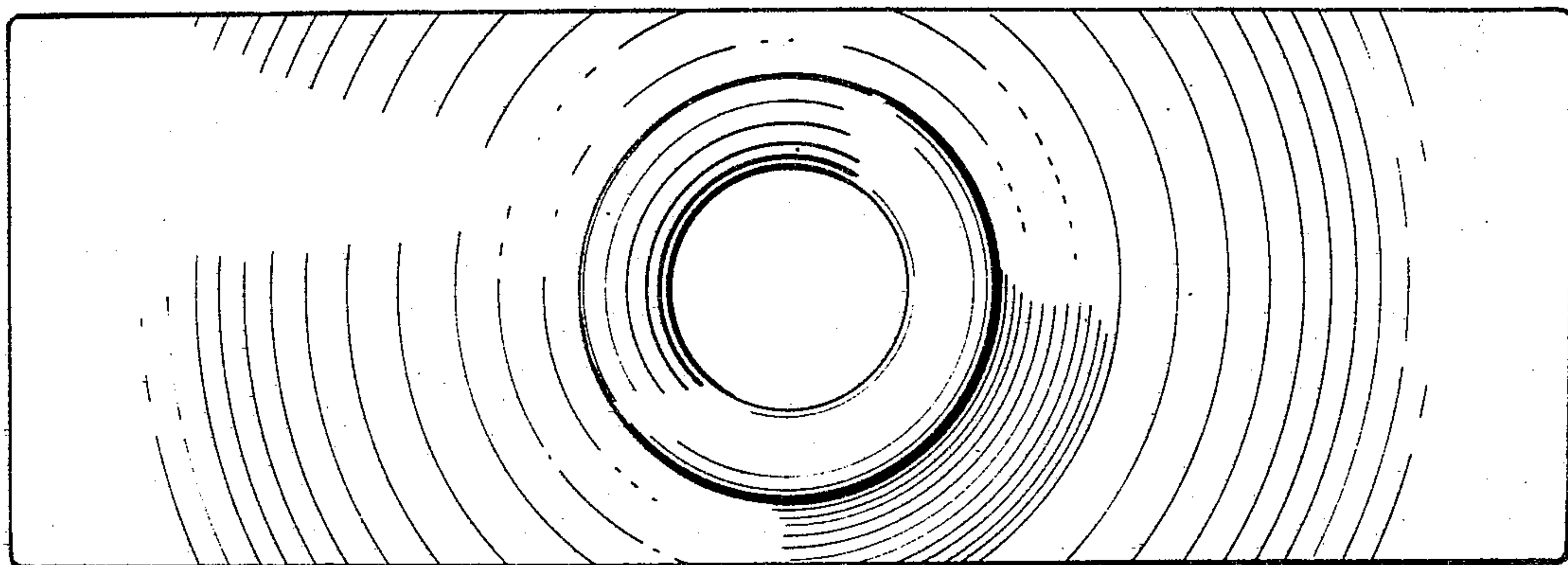

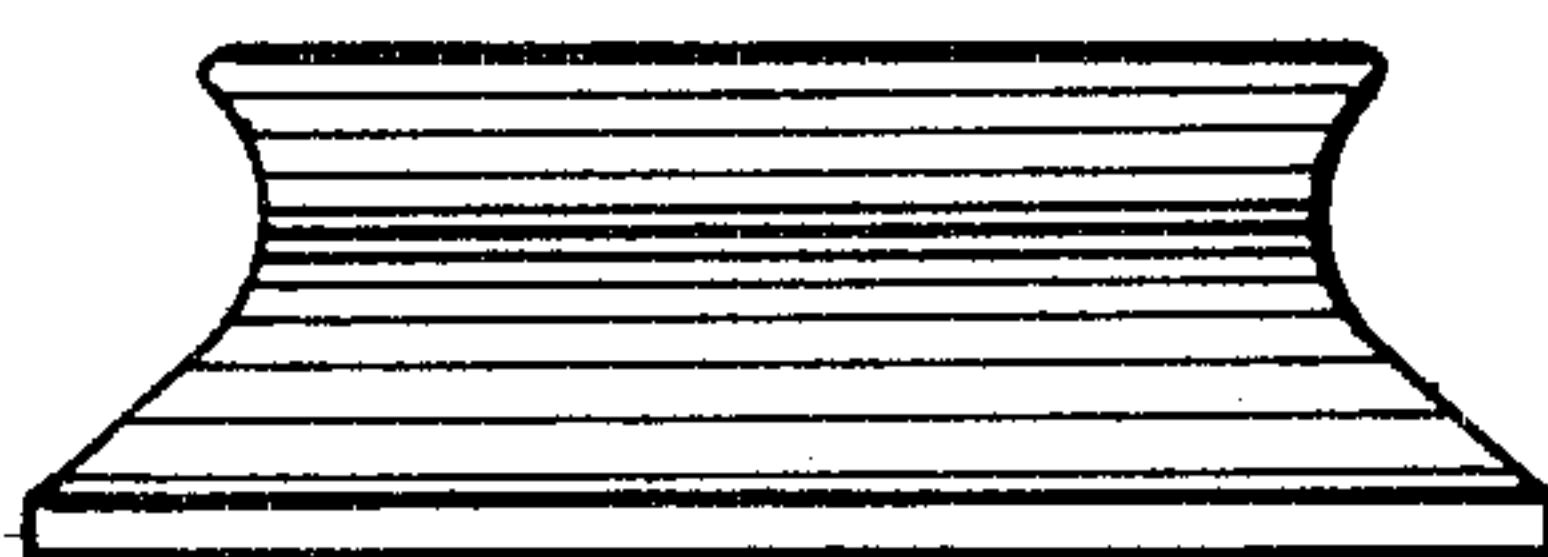

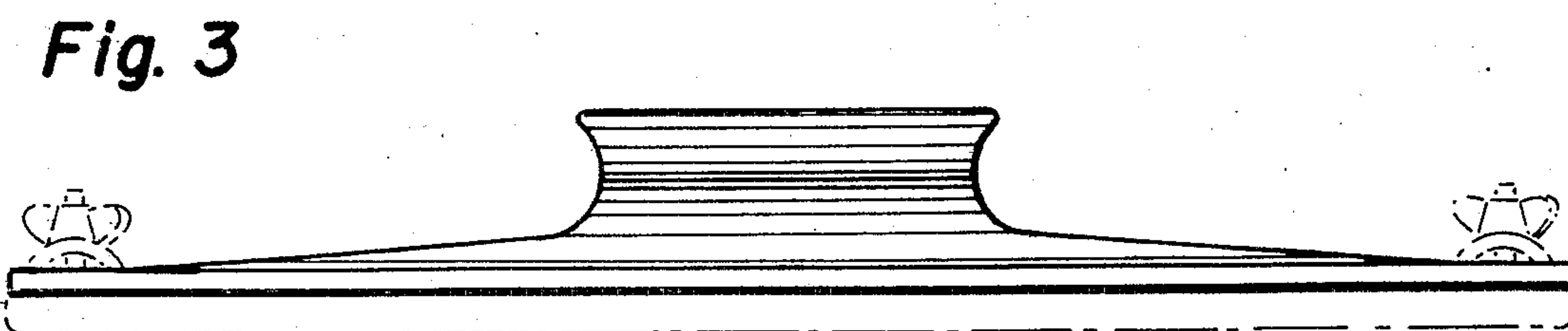
