[57] CLAIM

The ornamental design for a hanging hook or similar article for attachment to a carrying case, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a left side elevational view of a hanging hook or similar article for attachment to a carrying case showing my new design;

FIG. 2 is a front elevational view thereof;

FIG. 3 is a right side elevational view thereof;

FIG. 4 is a top plan view thereof;

FIG. 5 is a bottom plan view thereof;

FIG. 6 is a fragmentary cross-sectional view thereof along the line A—A of FIG. 2;

FIG. 7 is a fragmentary cross-sectional view thereof along the line B—B of FIG. 2; and

FIG. 8 is a front elevational view thereof shown attached to a carrying case shown in broken lines for environmental association purposes only.

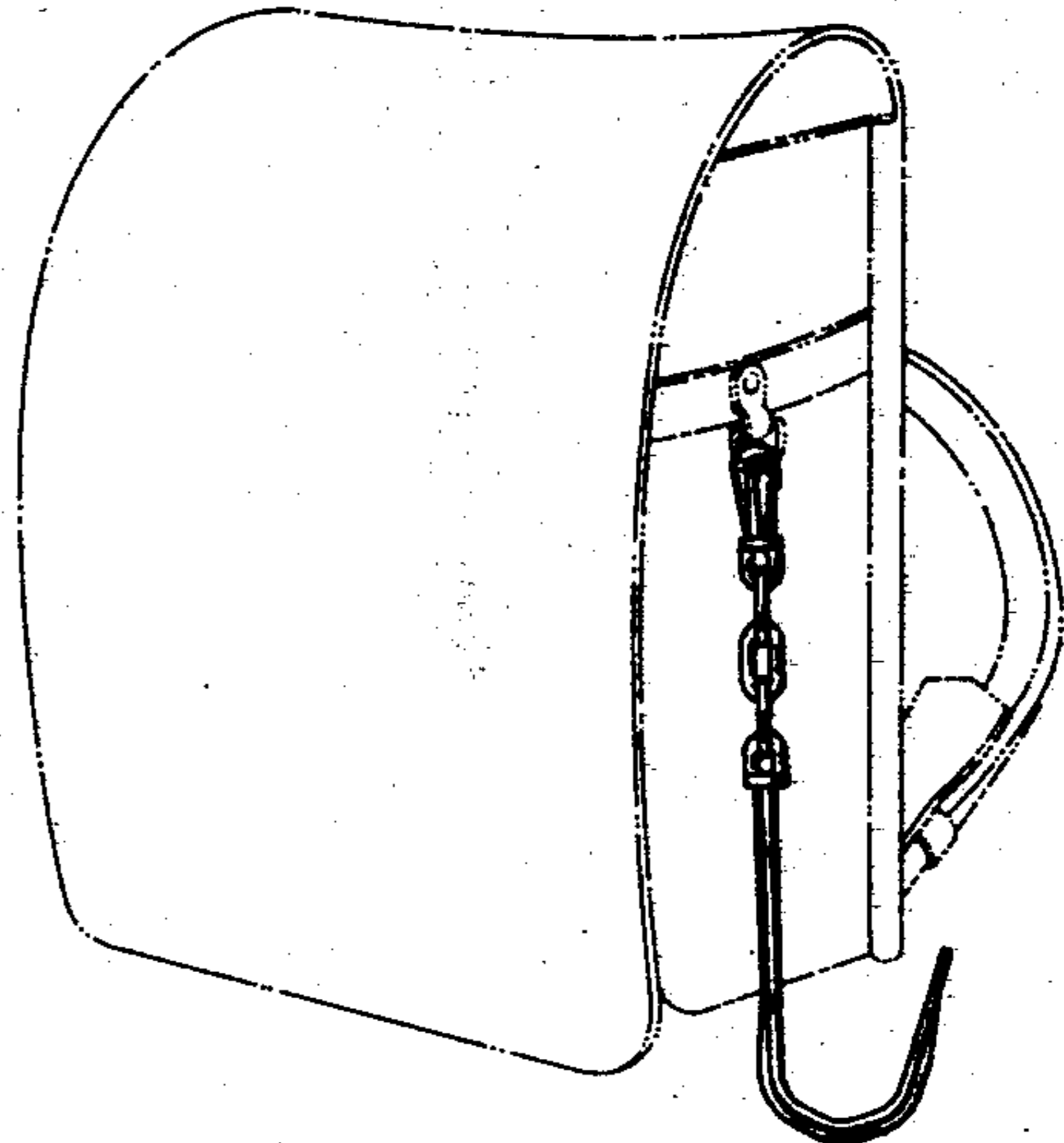
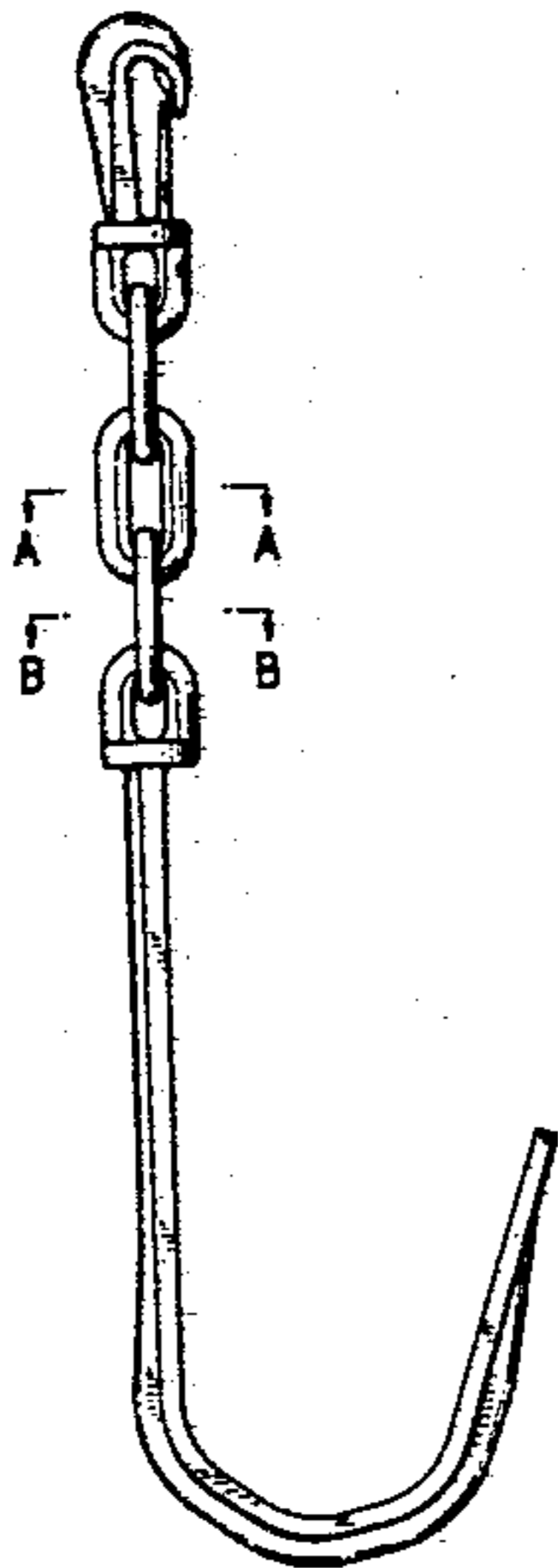

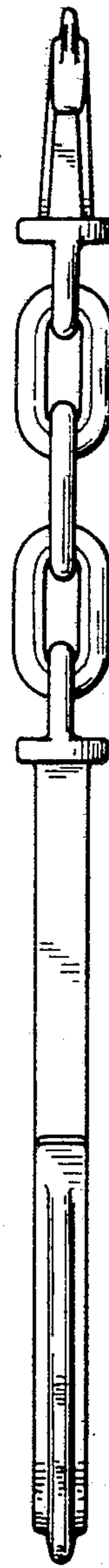
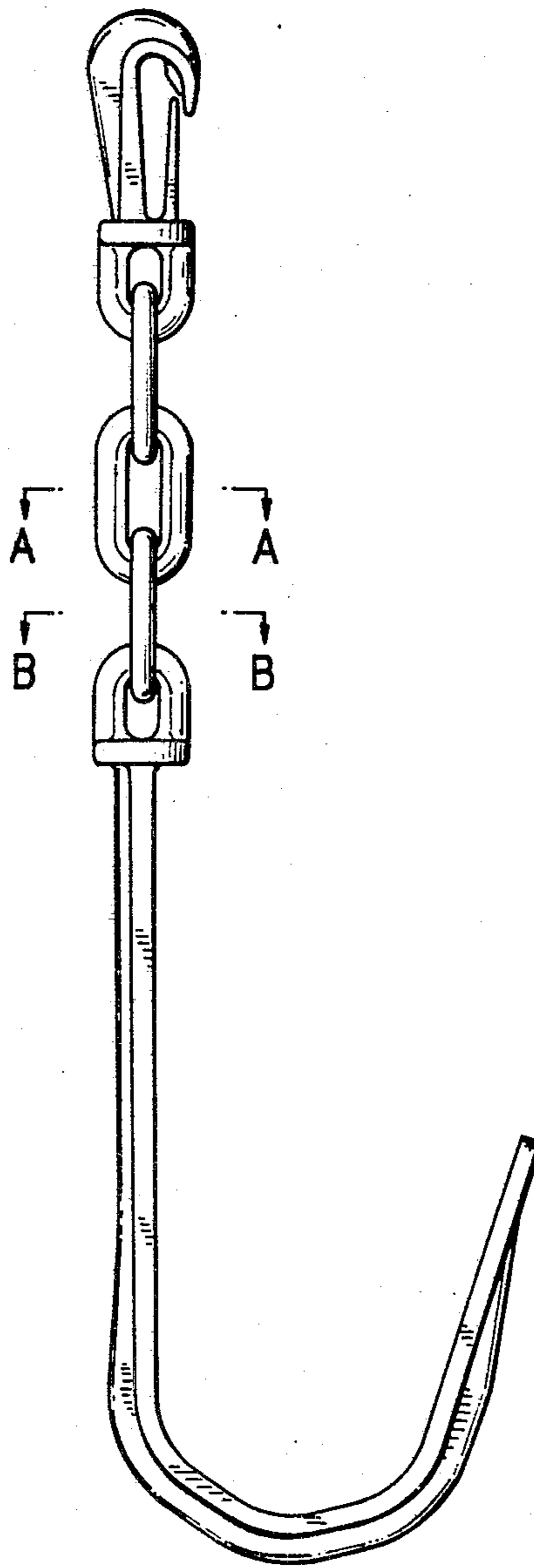
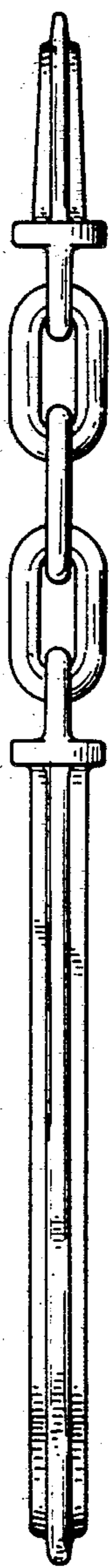

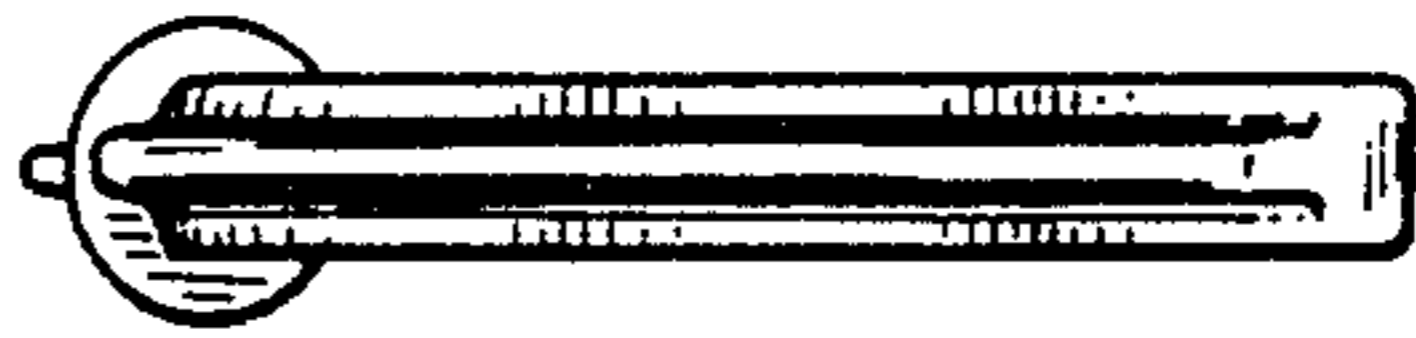
