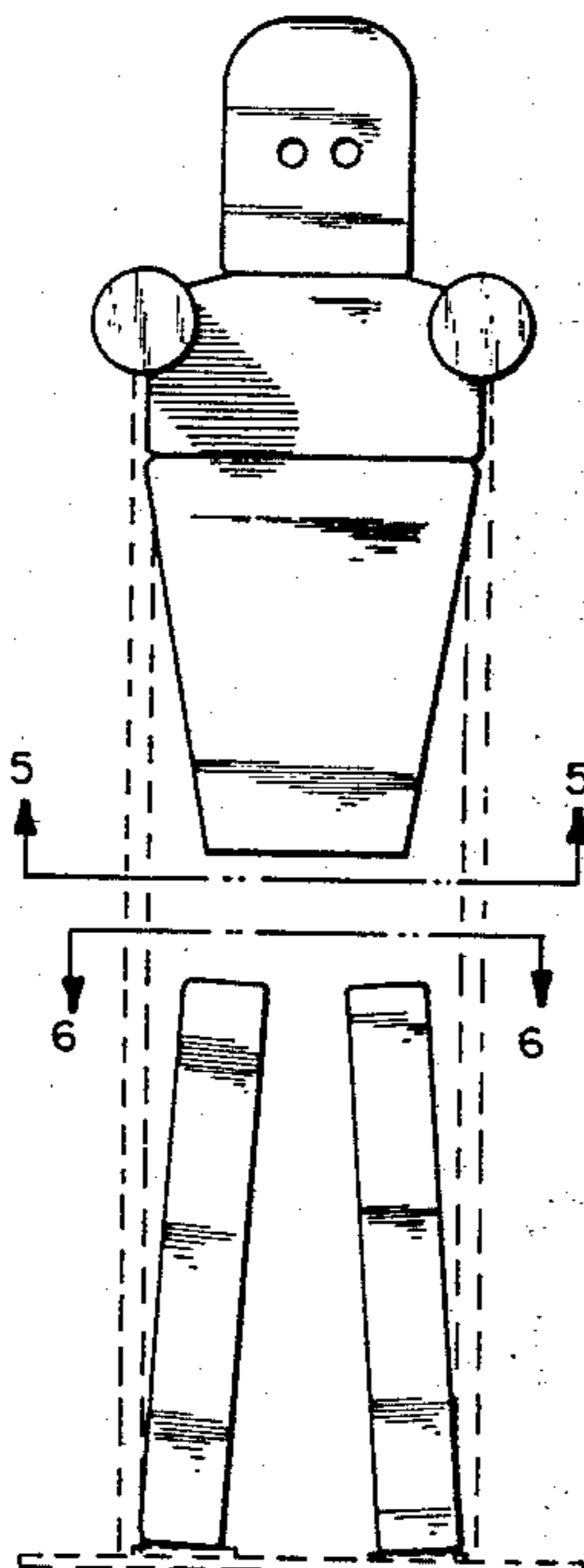

The ornamental design for a karate training device, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a front elevational view of a karate training device showing my new design.  
FIG. 2 is a side elevational view thereof.  
FIG. 3 is a top plan view thereof.  
FIG. 4 is a rear elevational view thereof.  
FIG. 5 is a view taken at line 5—5 in FIG. 1 and viewed in the direction of the arrows.  
FIG. 6 is a view thereof taken at line 6—6 in FIG. 1 and viewed in the direction of the arrows.  
The broken lines show environment and are not a part of the design.



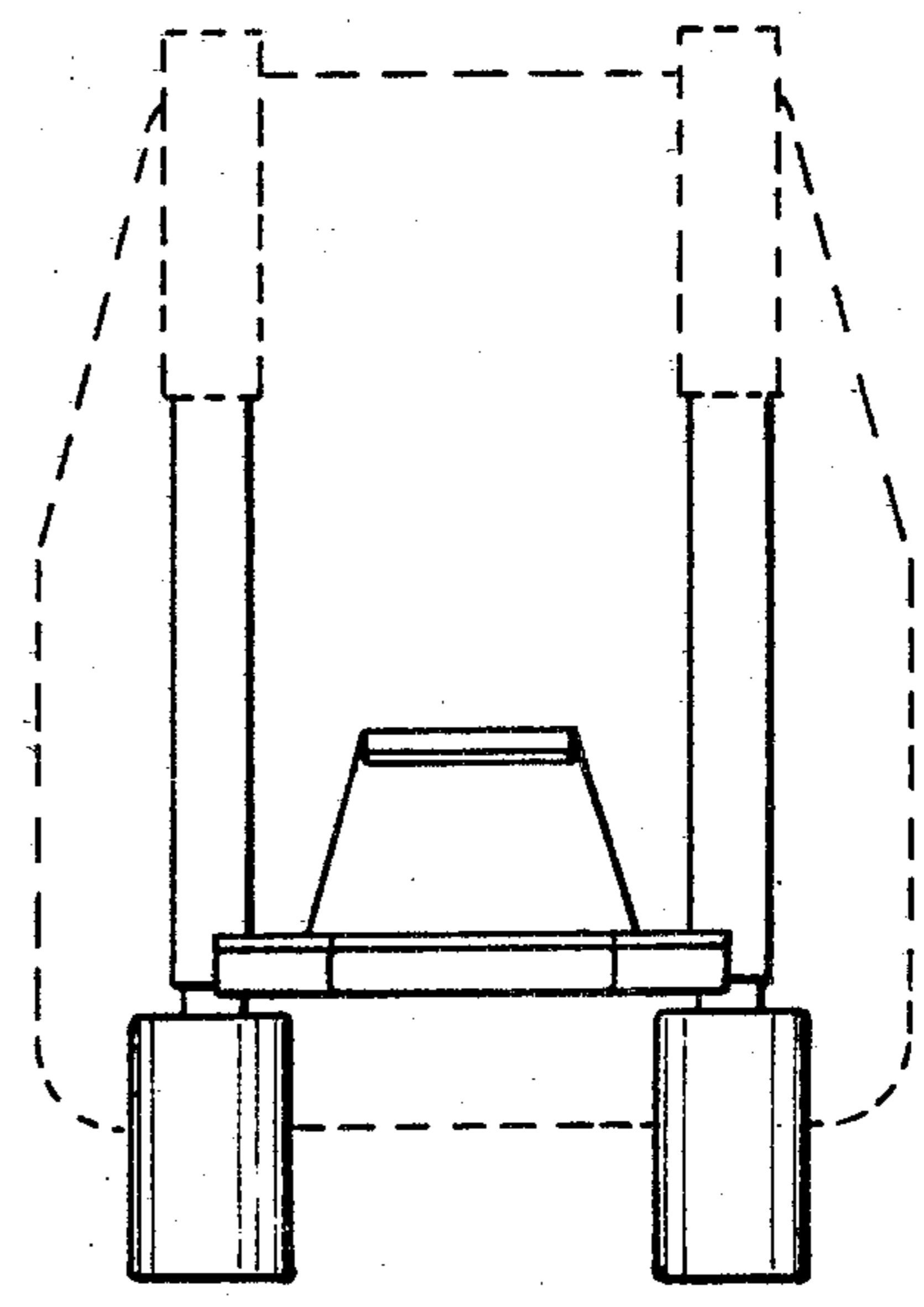

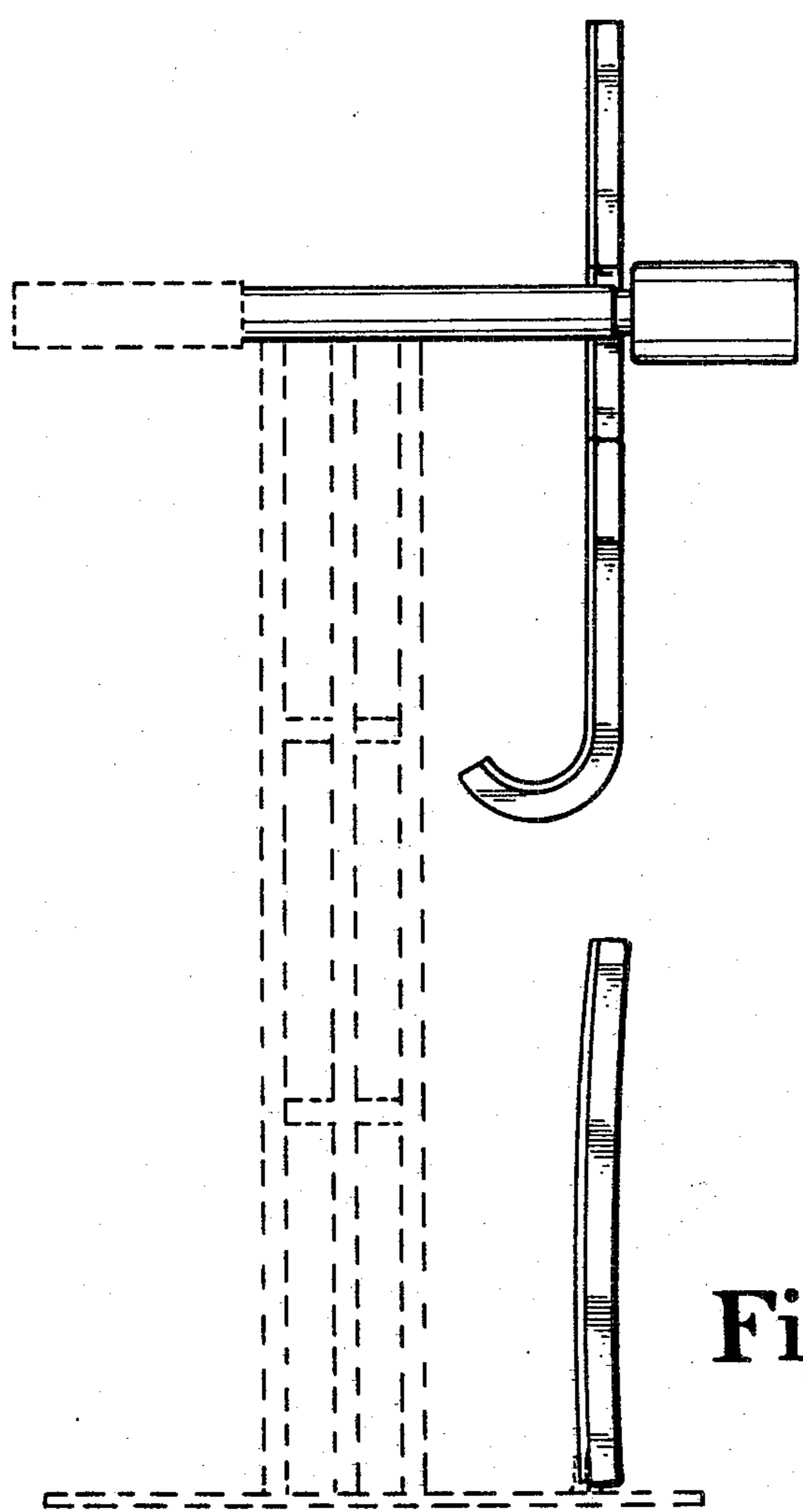

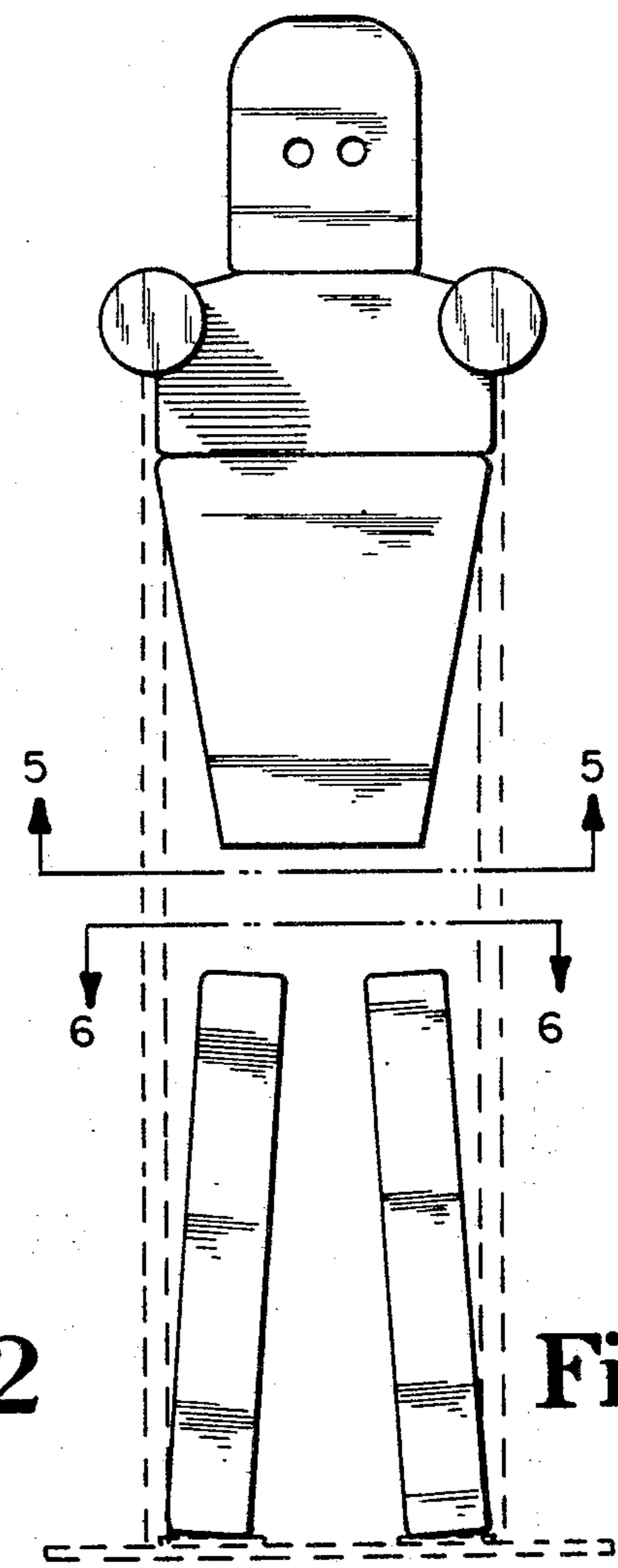

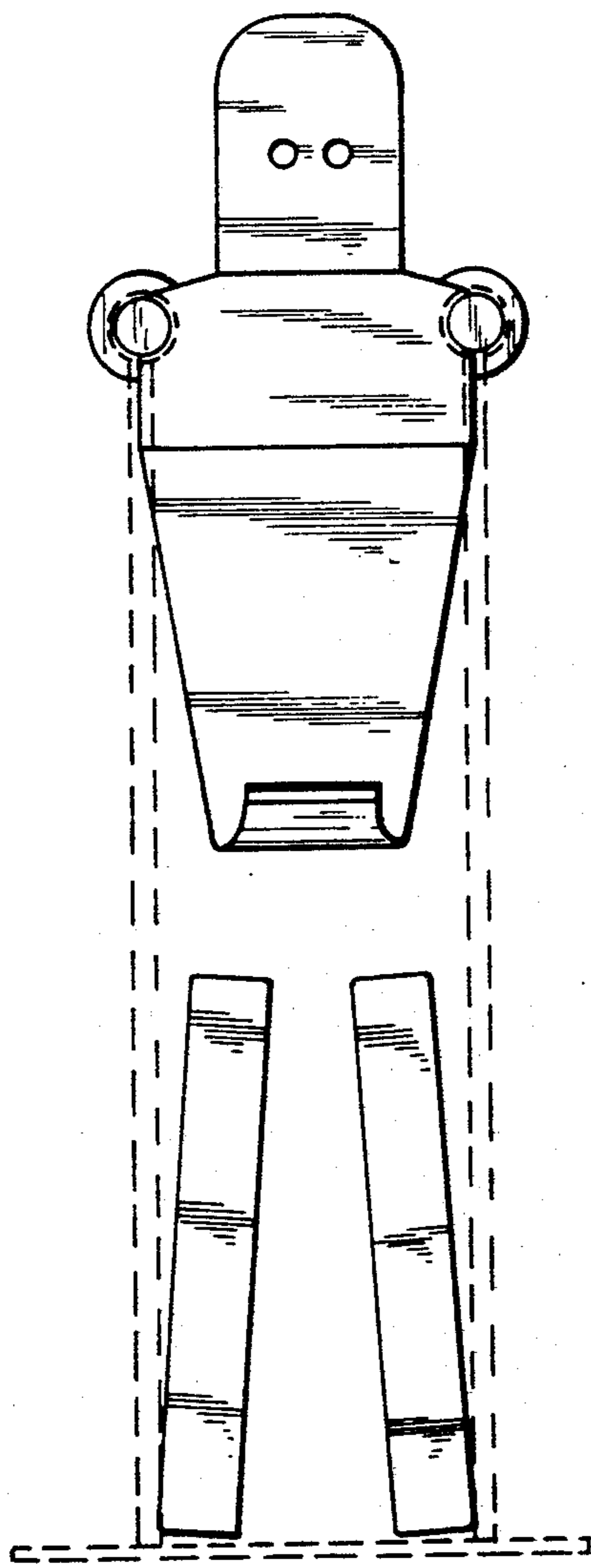

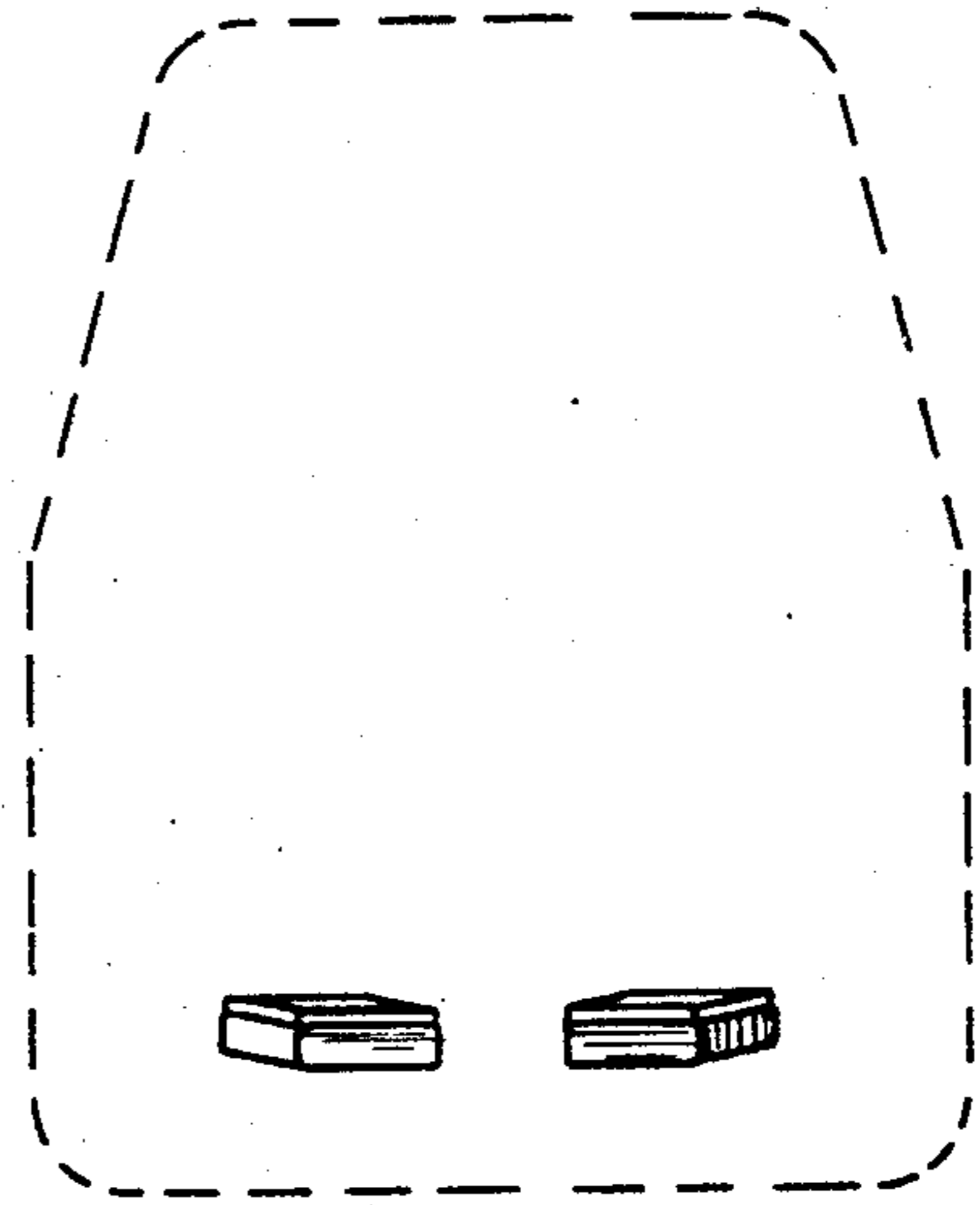

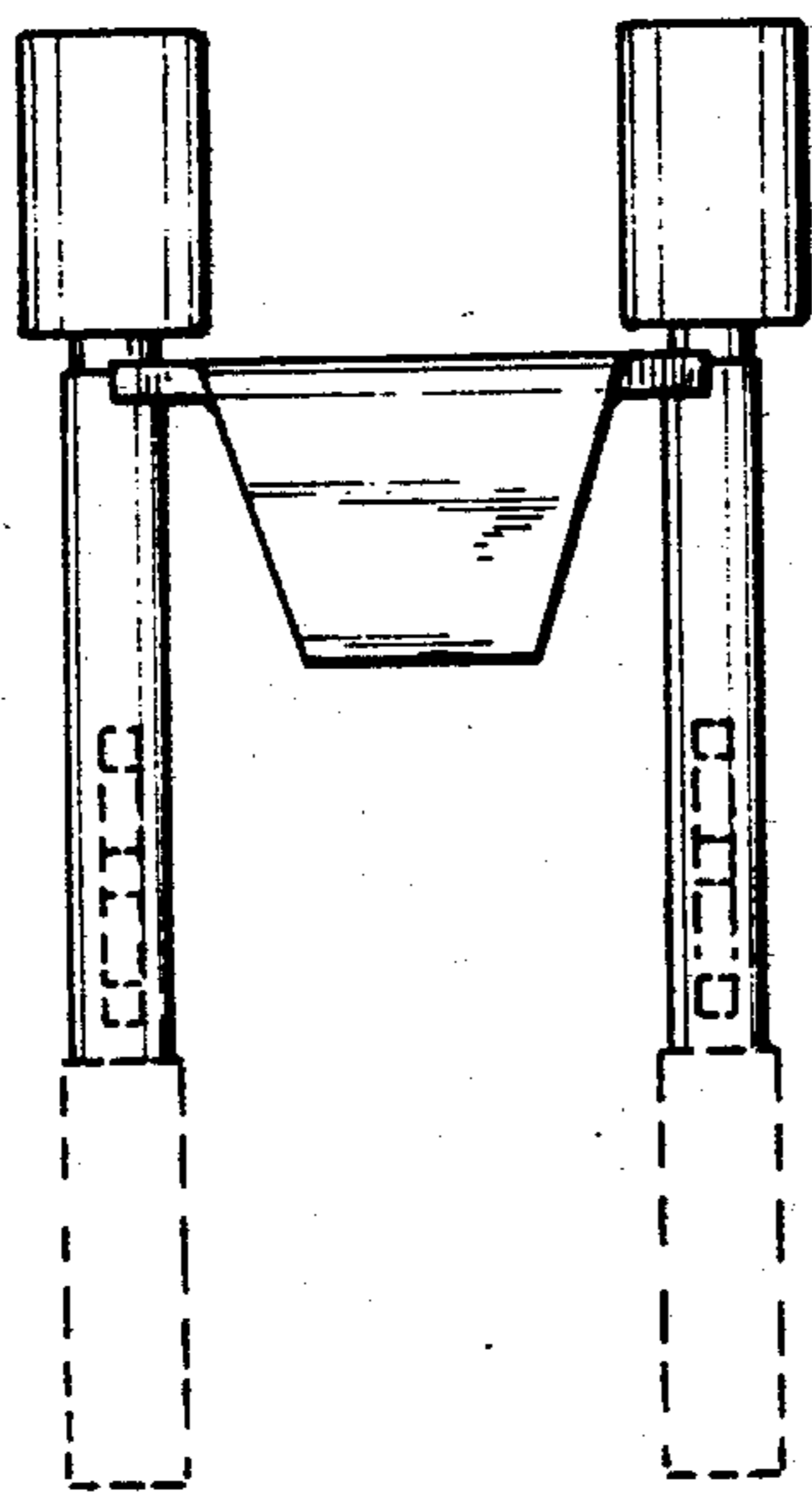
