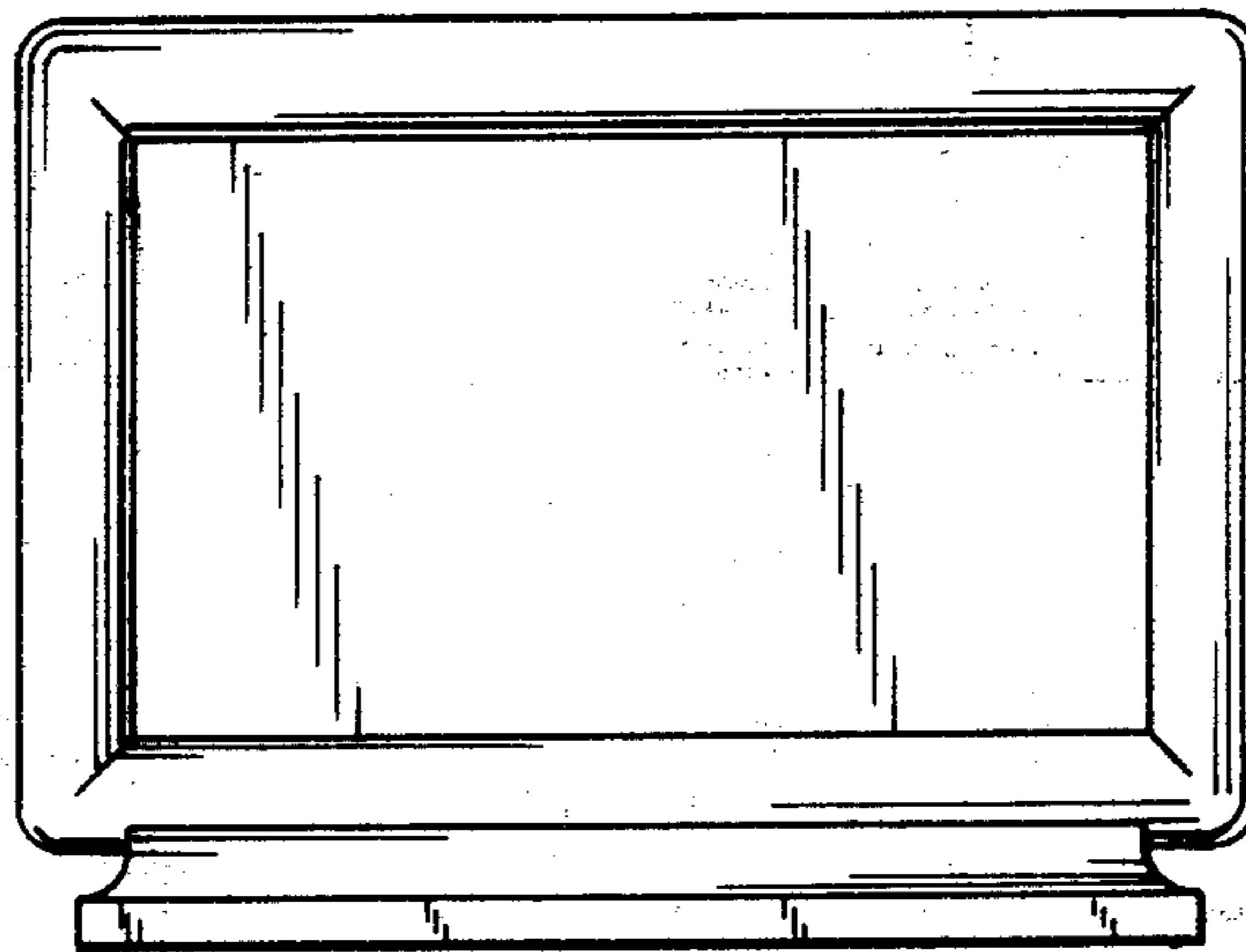

DESCRIPTION

- FIG. 1 is a side elevational view of a television program scheduler stand showing my new design;
- FIG. 2 is an elevational view of the opposite side thereof;

- FIG. 4 is an elevational view of the opposite end thereof;

- FIG. 6 is a top plan view thereof.



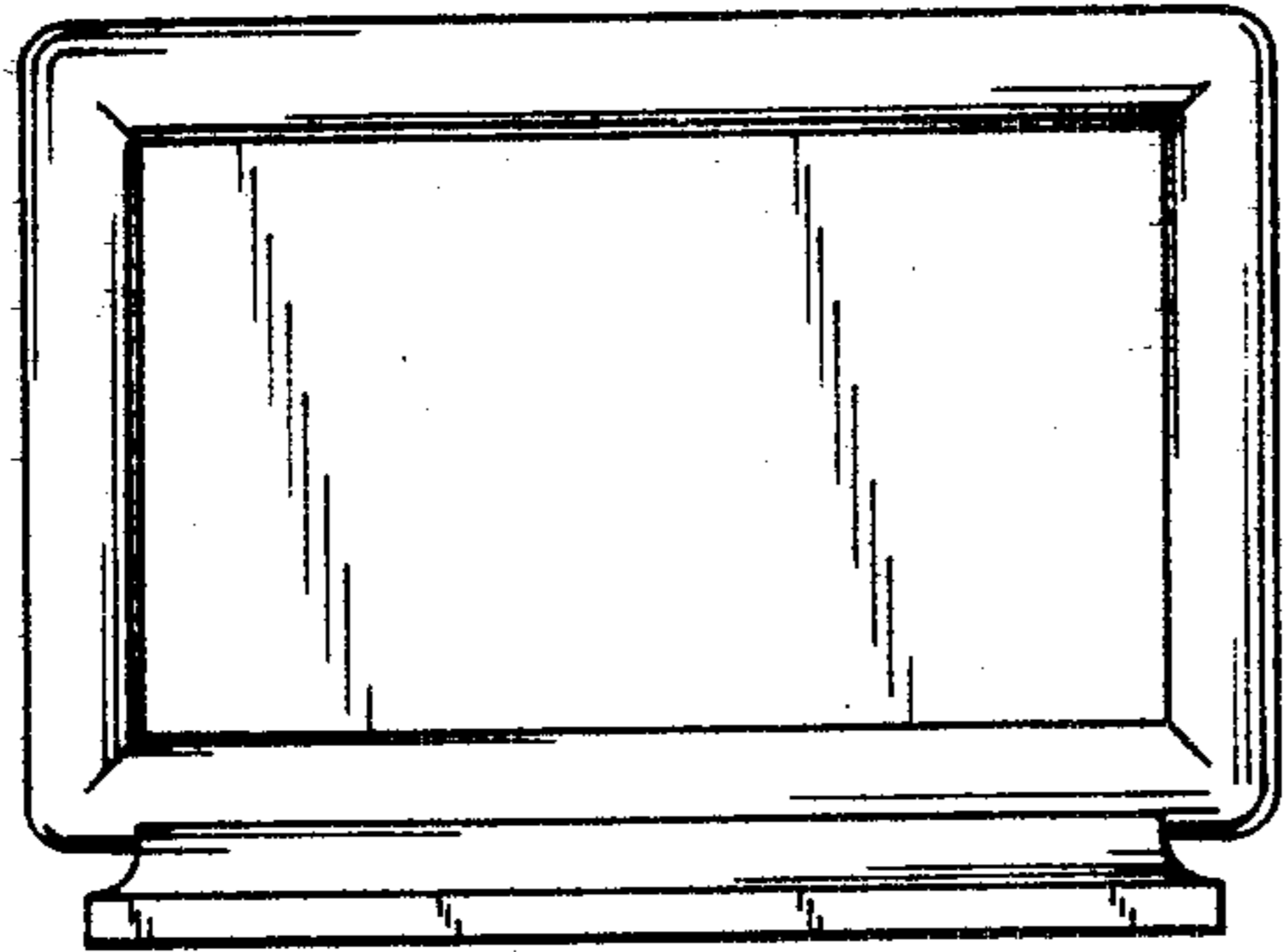

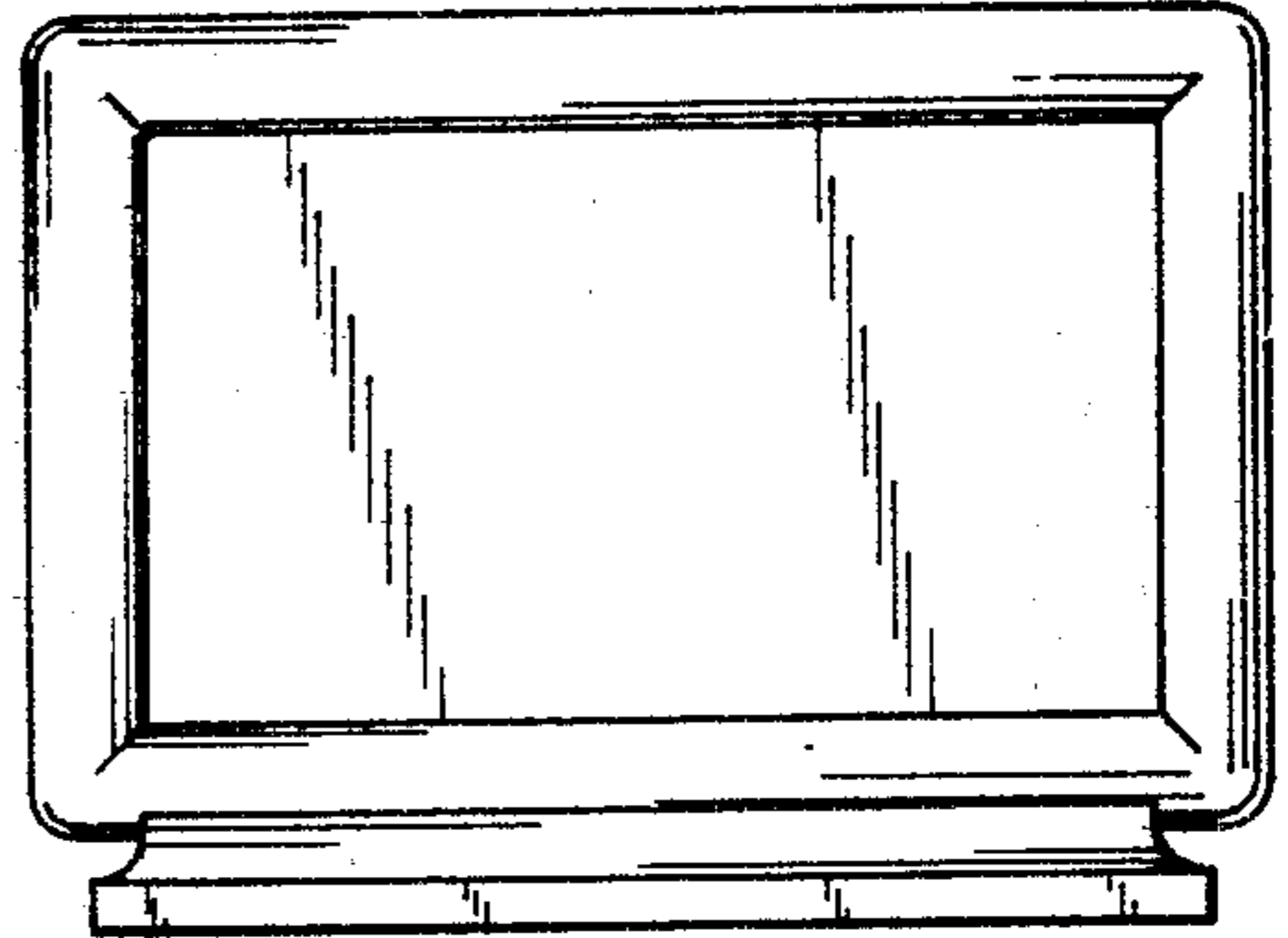

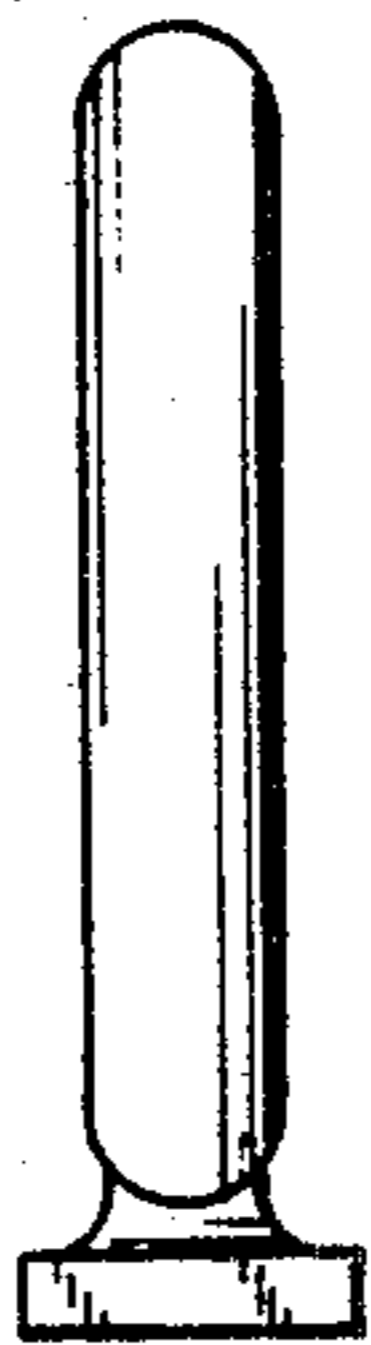

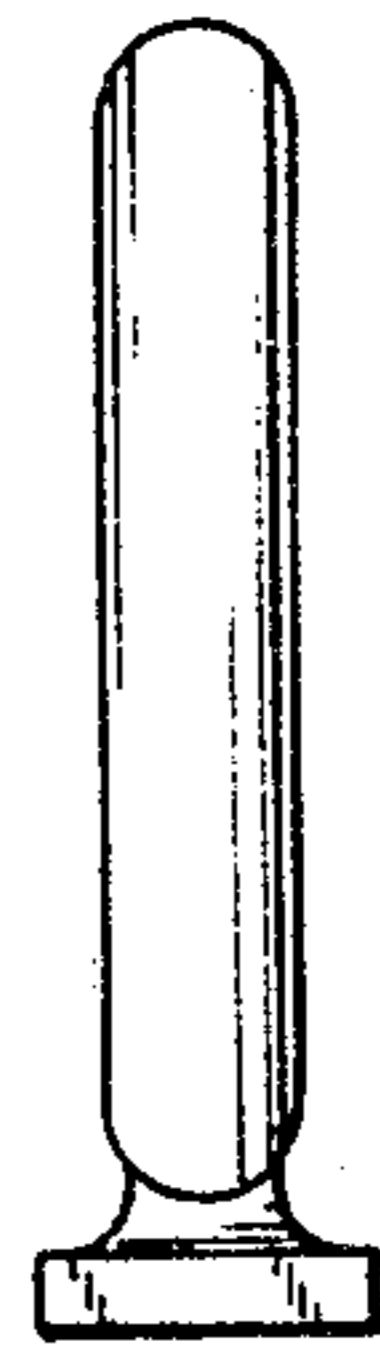

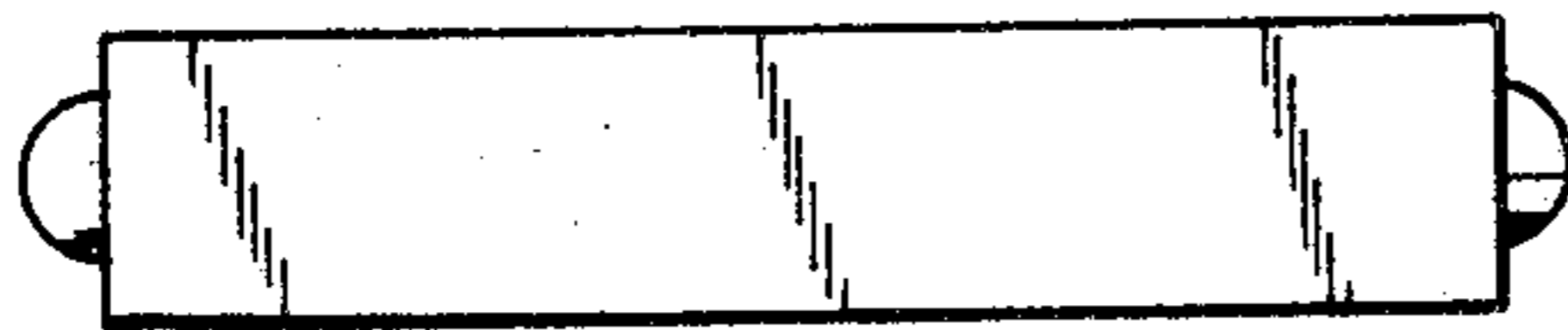

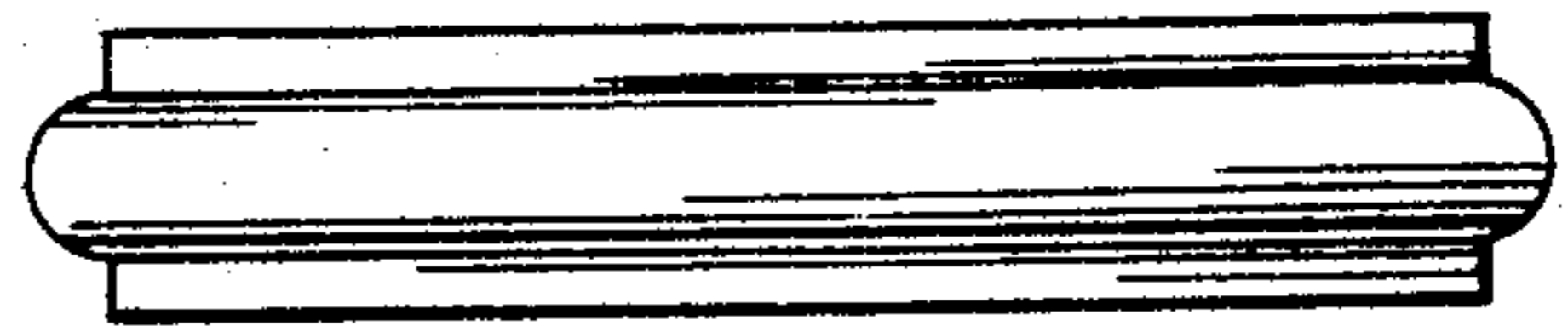
