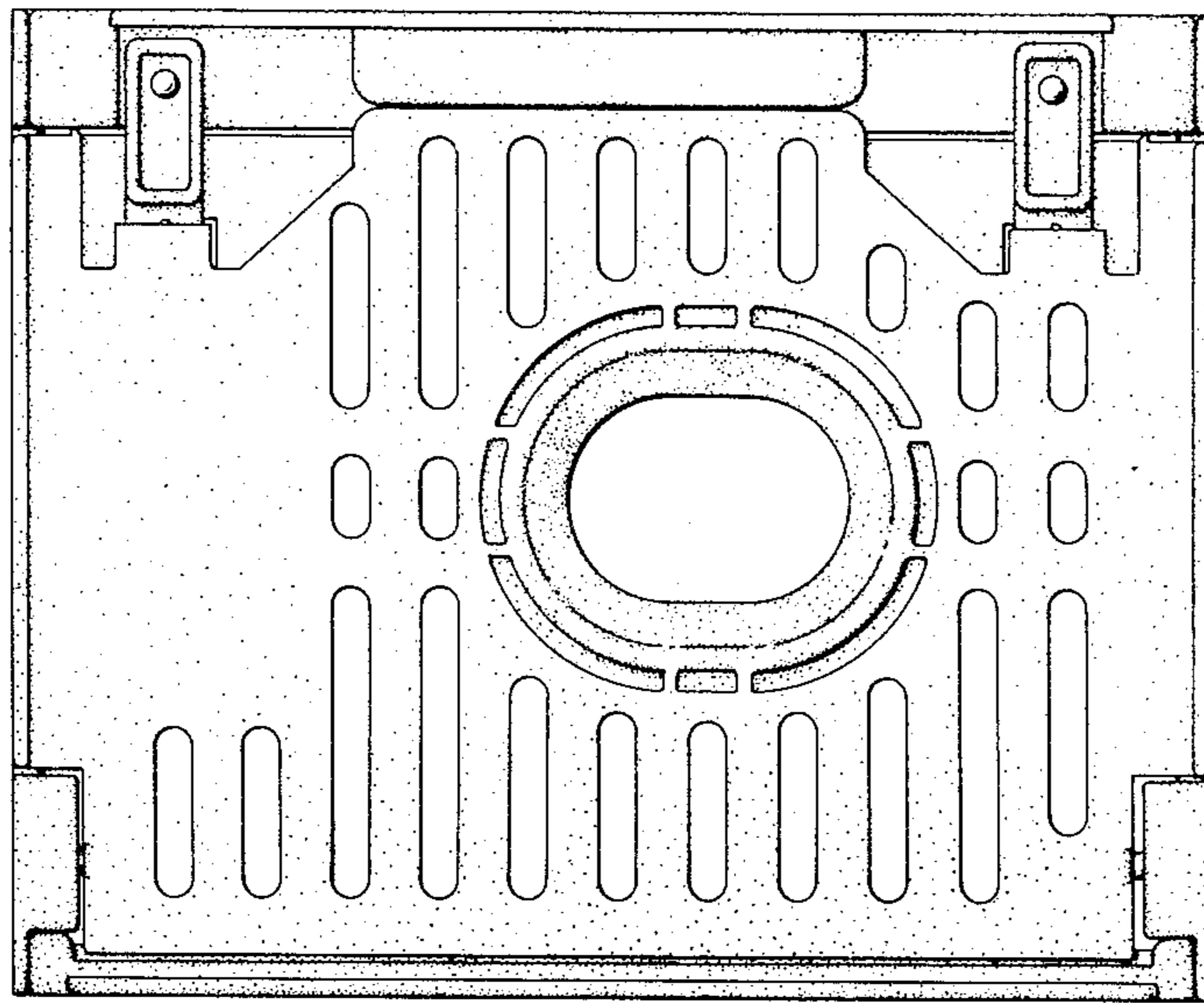

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a top plan view of a crustacean trap showing our new design;
FIG. 2 is a front elevational view thereof;

FIG. 6 is a bottom plan view thereof.



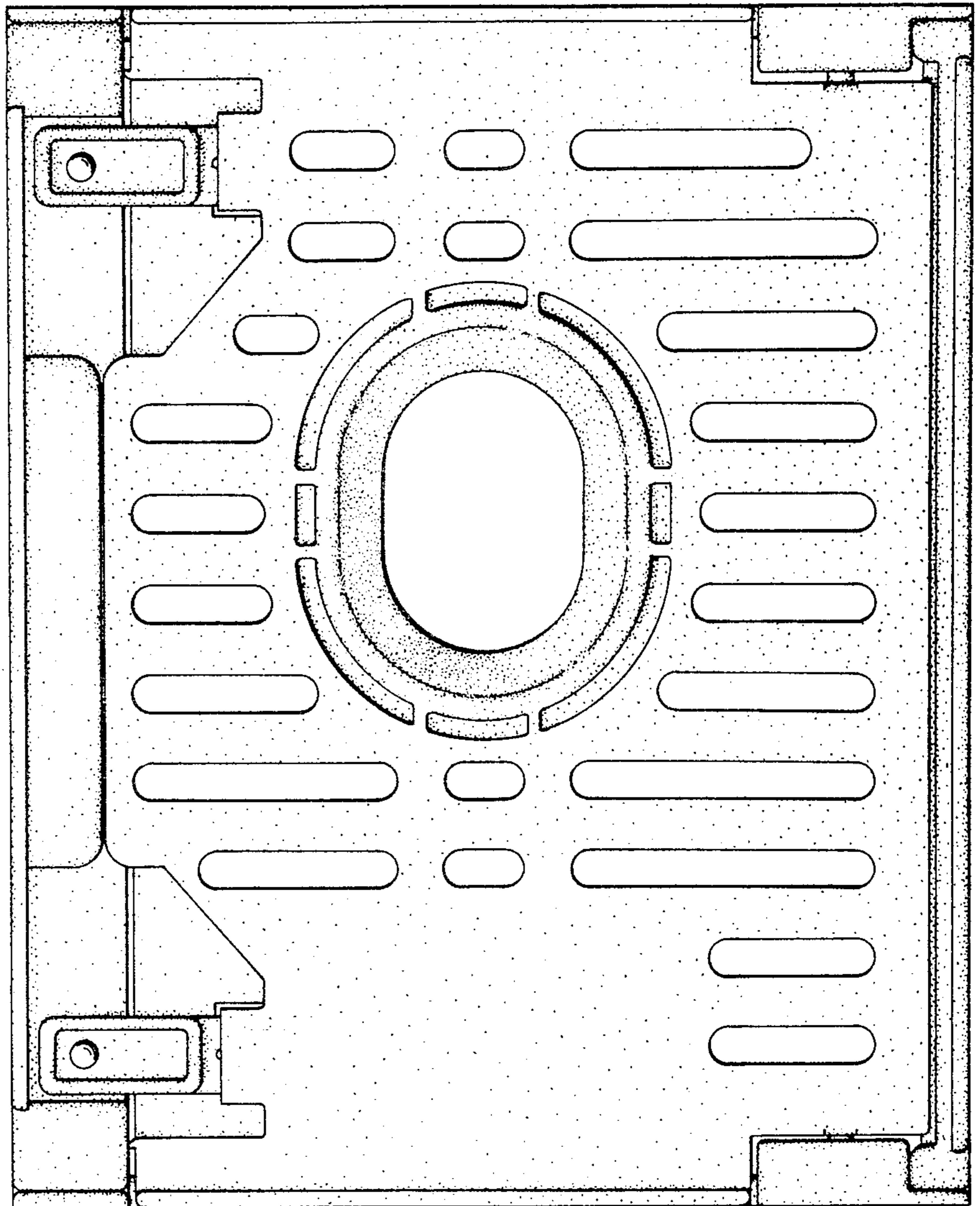

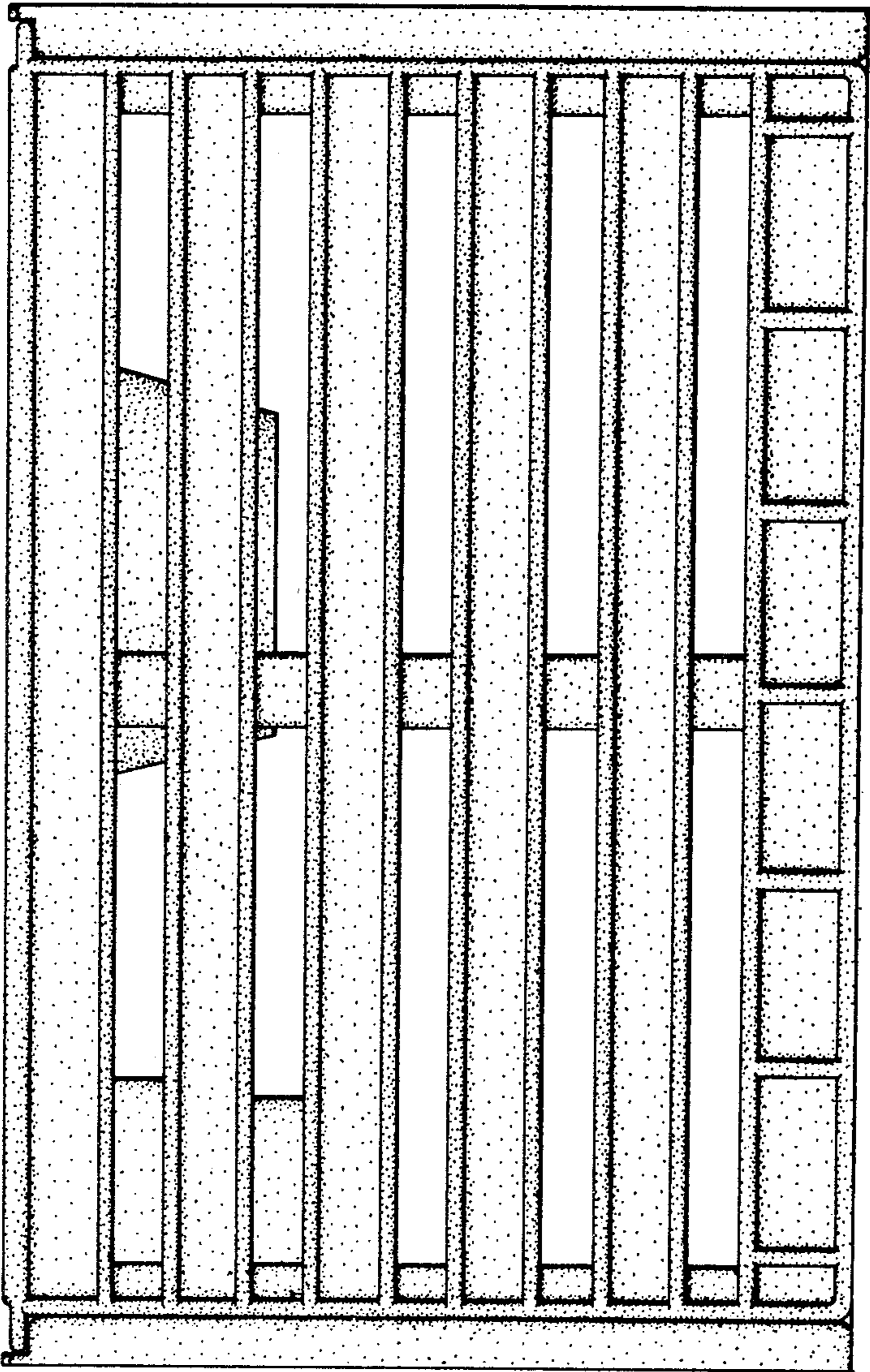

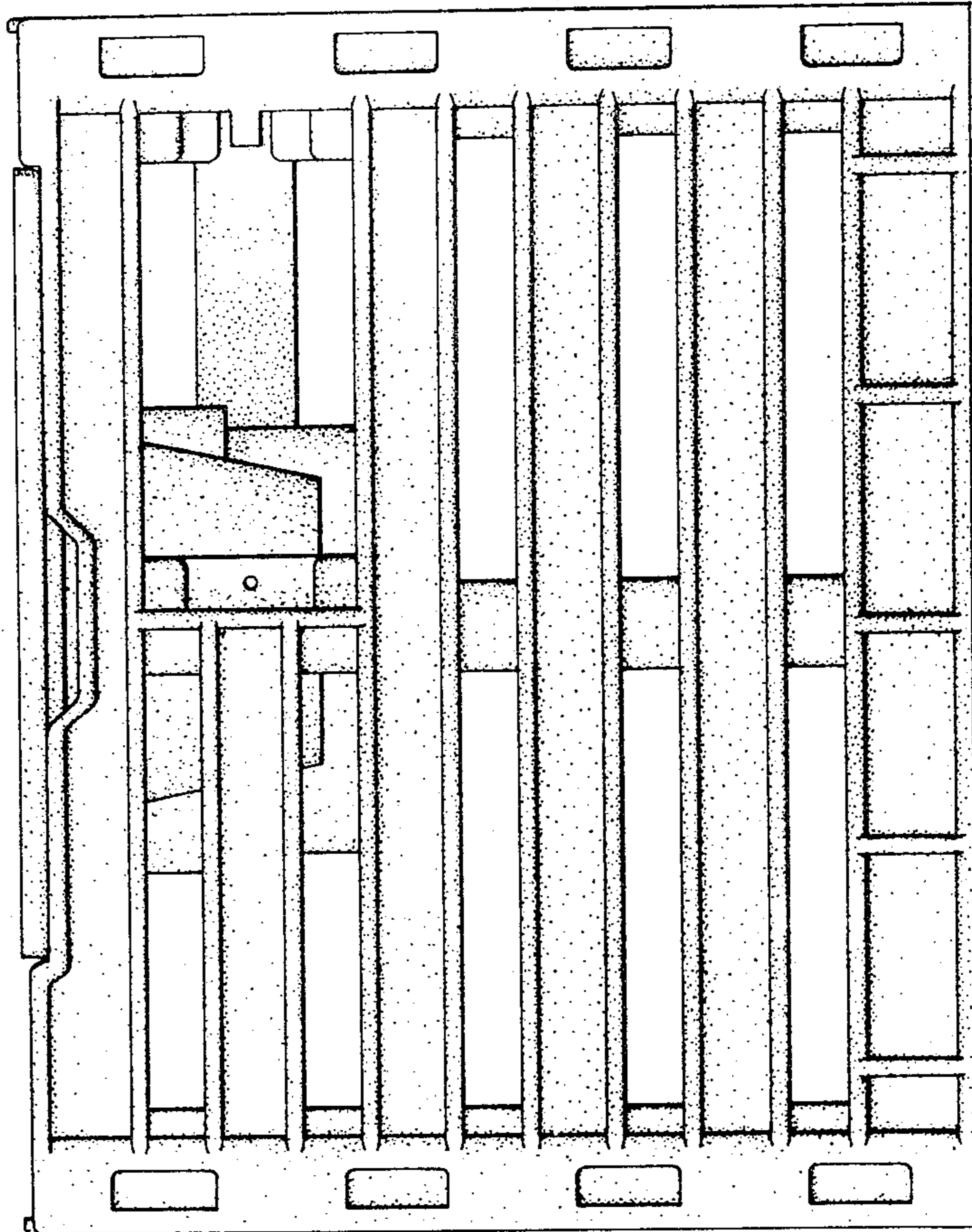

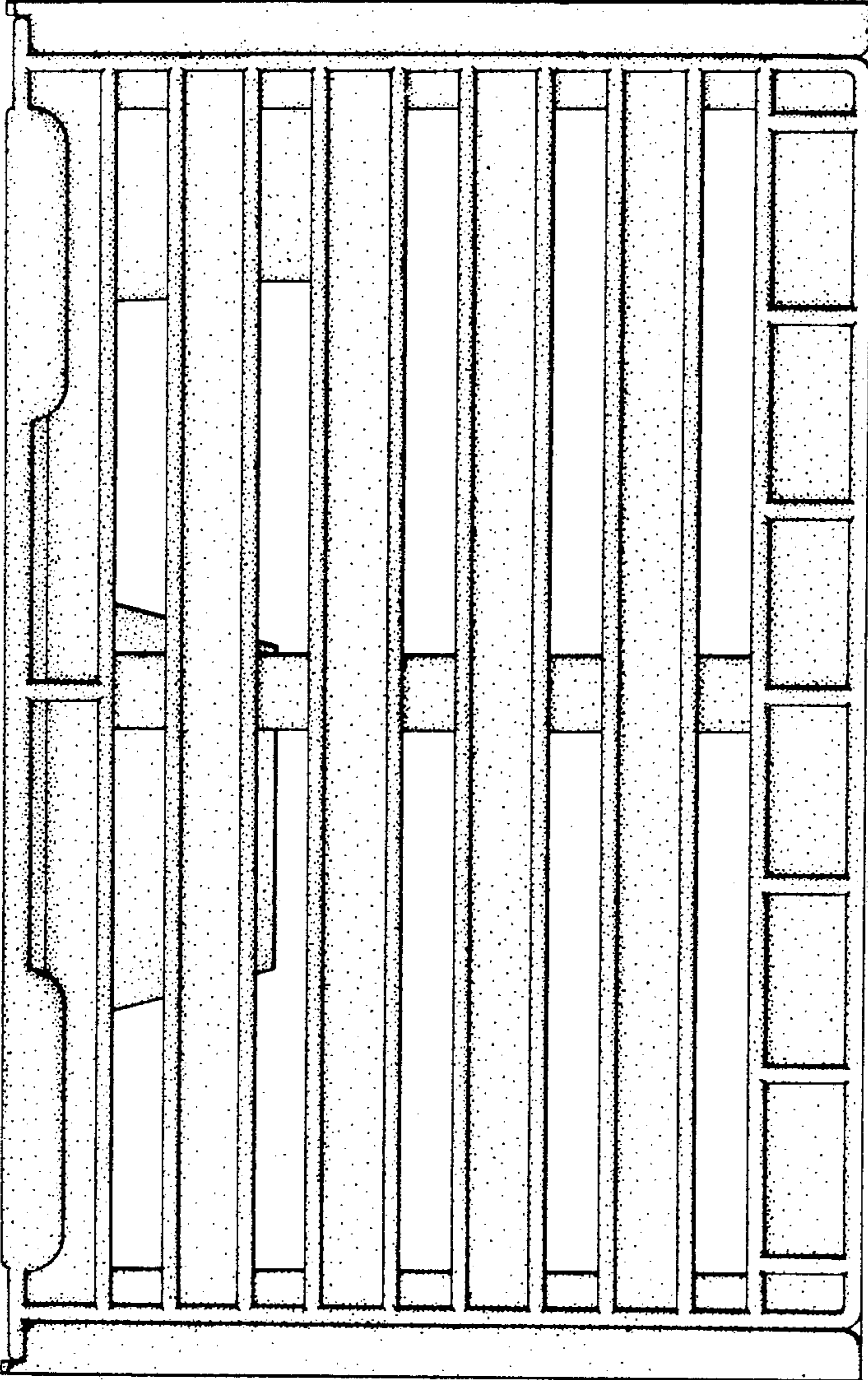

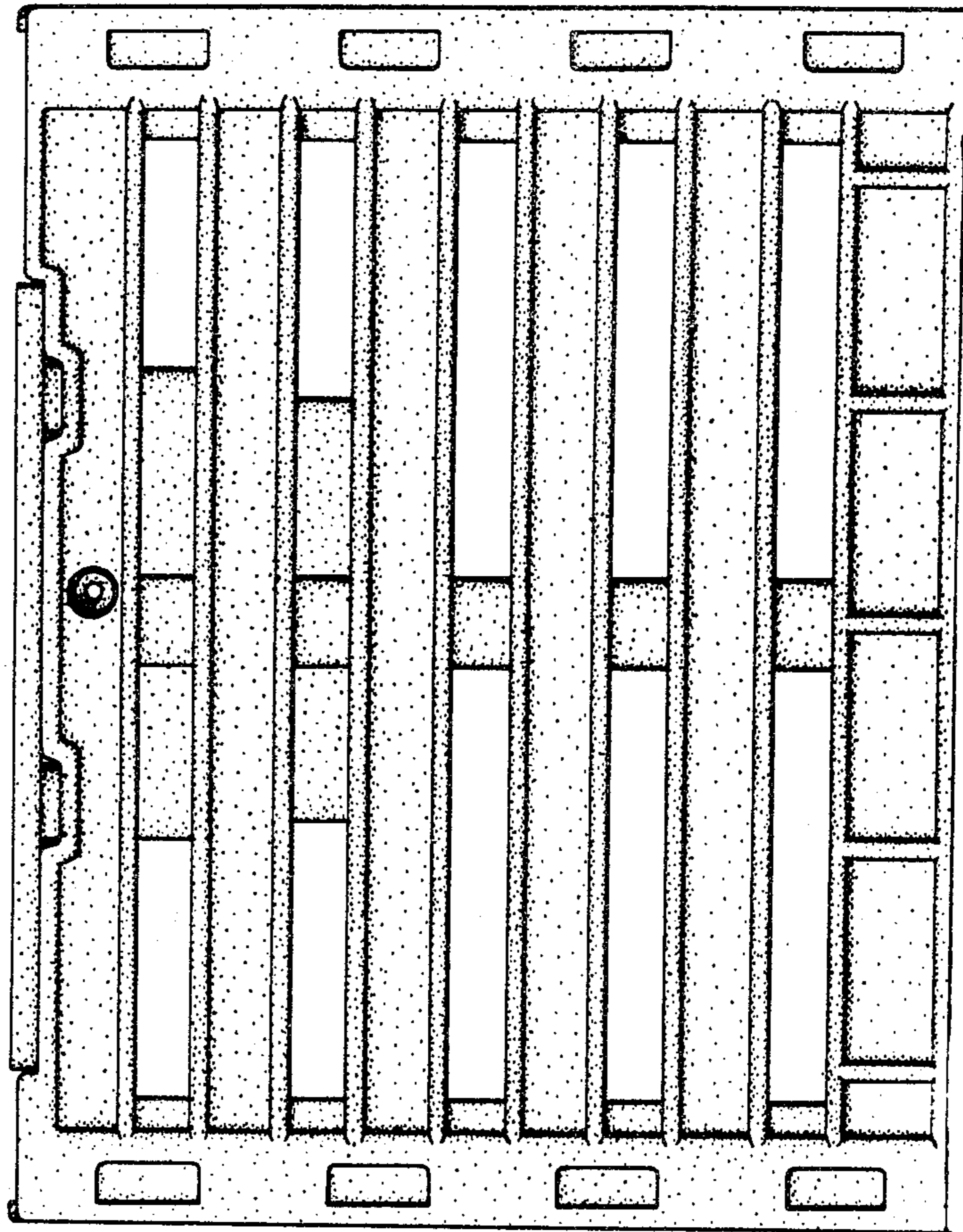

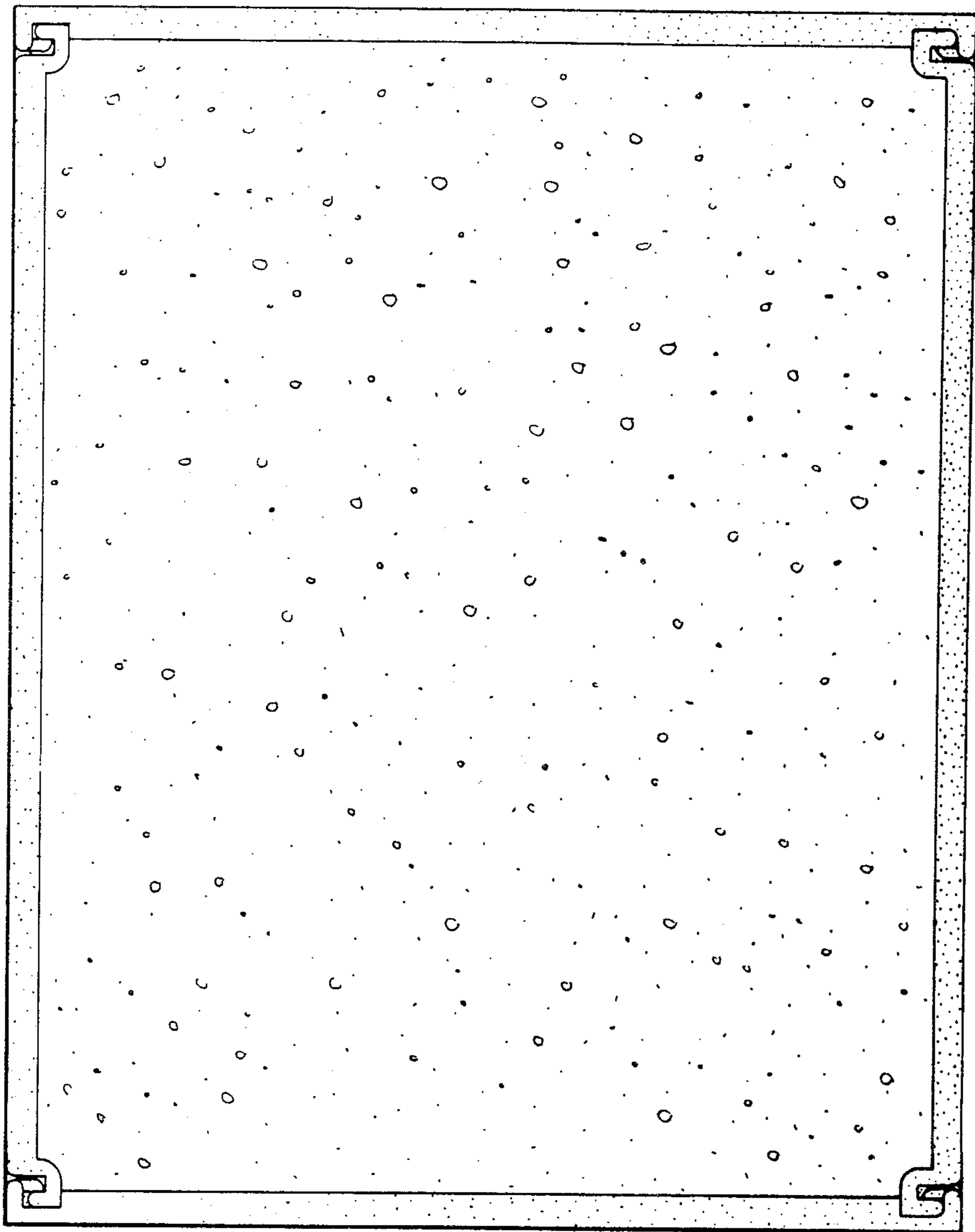
