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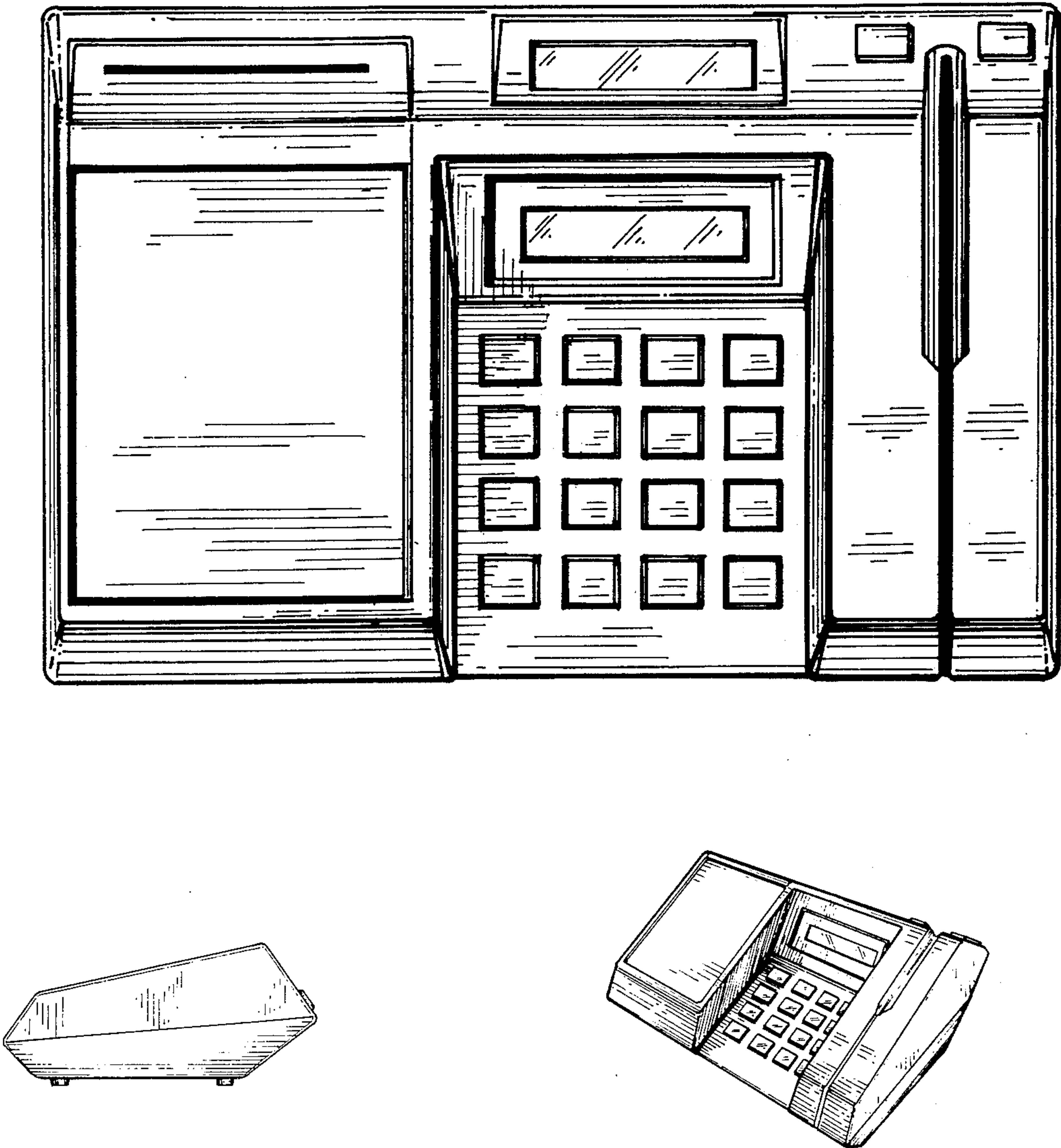
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[57] CLAIM

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a top plan view of an electronic funds transfer terminal or similar article showing my new design; FIG. 2 is a front elevational view thereof; FIG. 3 is a rear elevational view thereof; FIG. 4 is a right side elevational view thereof, the left side elevational view not shown is a mirror image; FIG. 5 is a top, front and right side perspective view thereof; and FIG. 6 is a bottom plan view thereof.



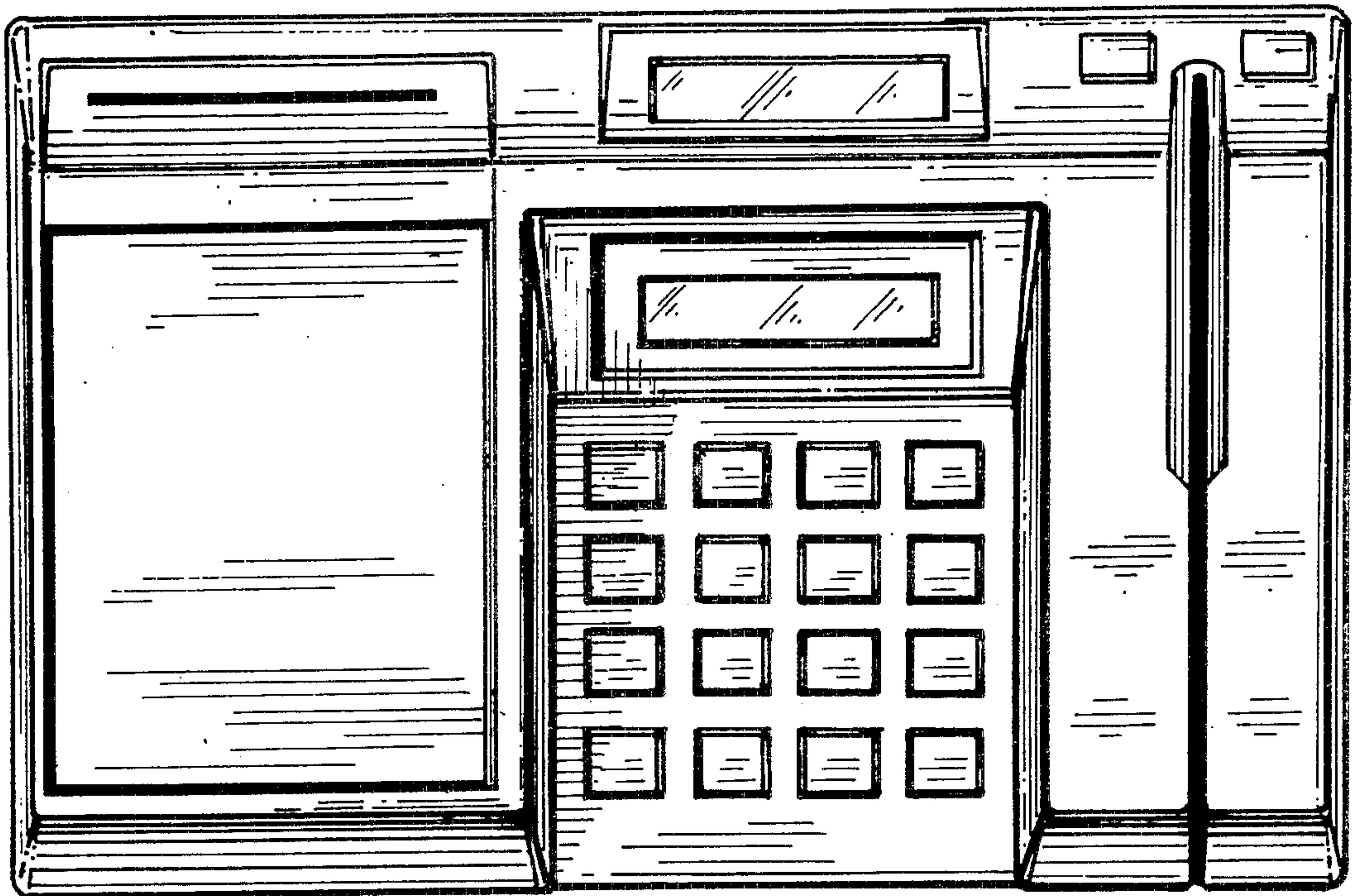

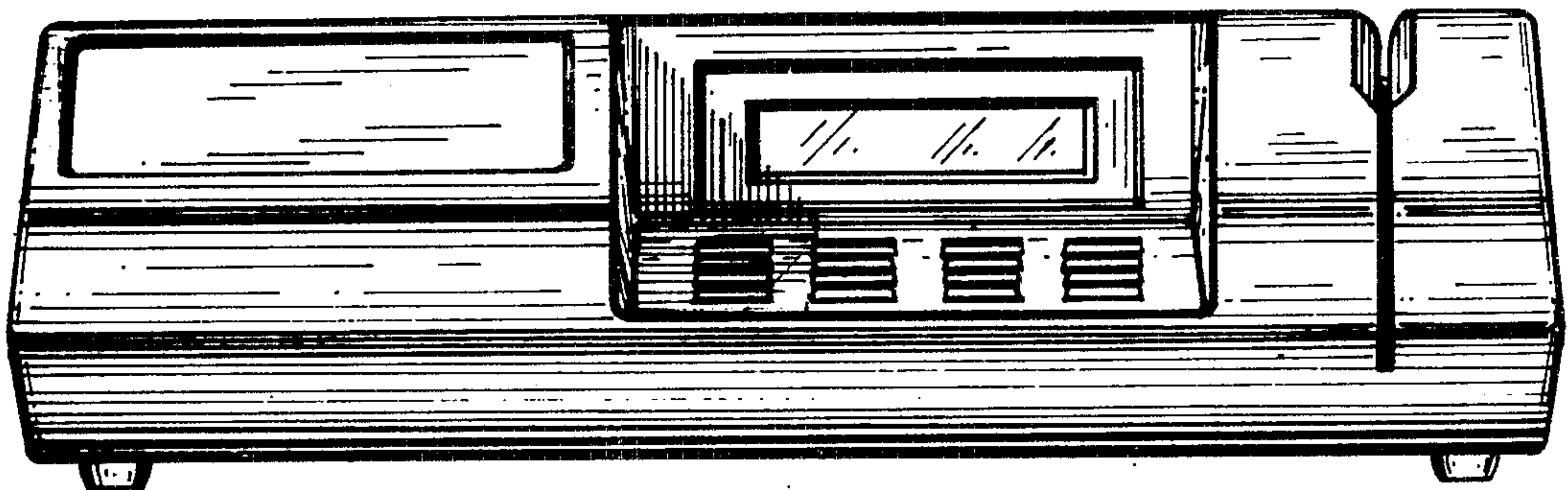

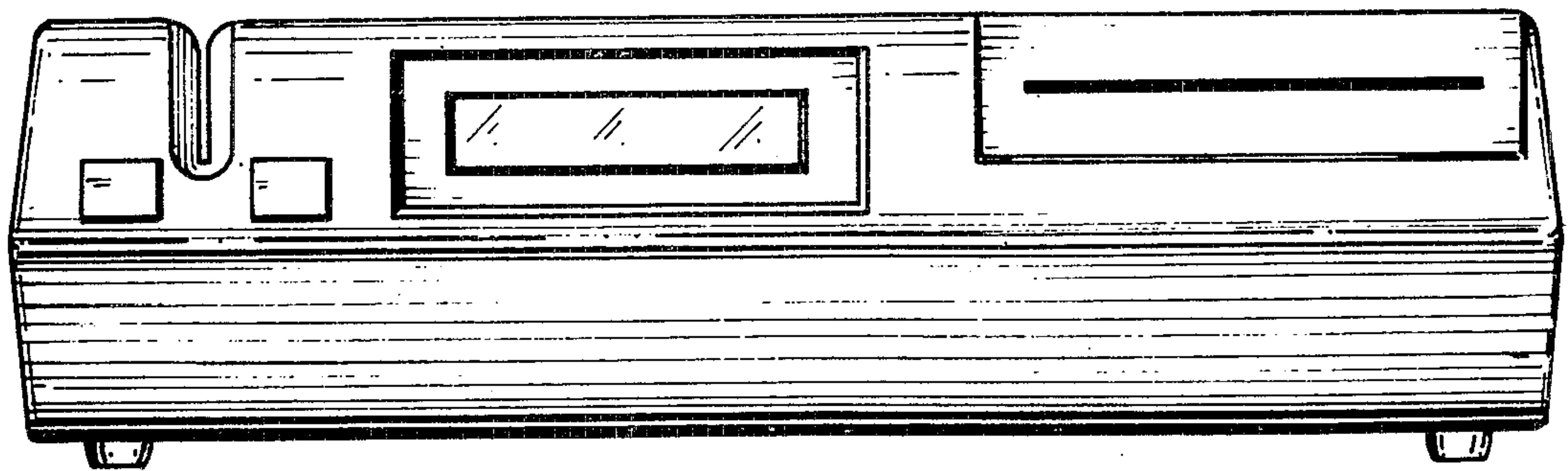

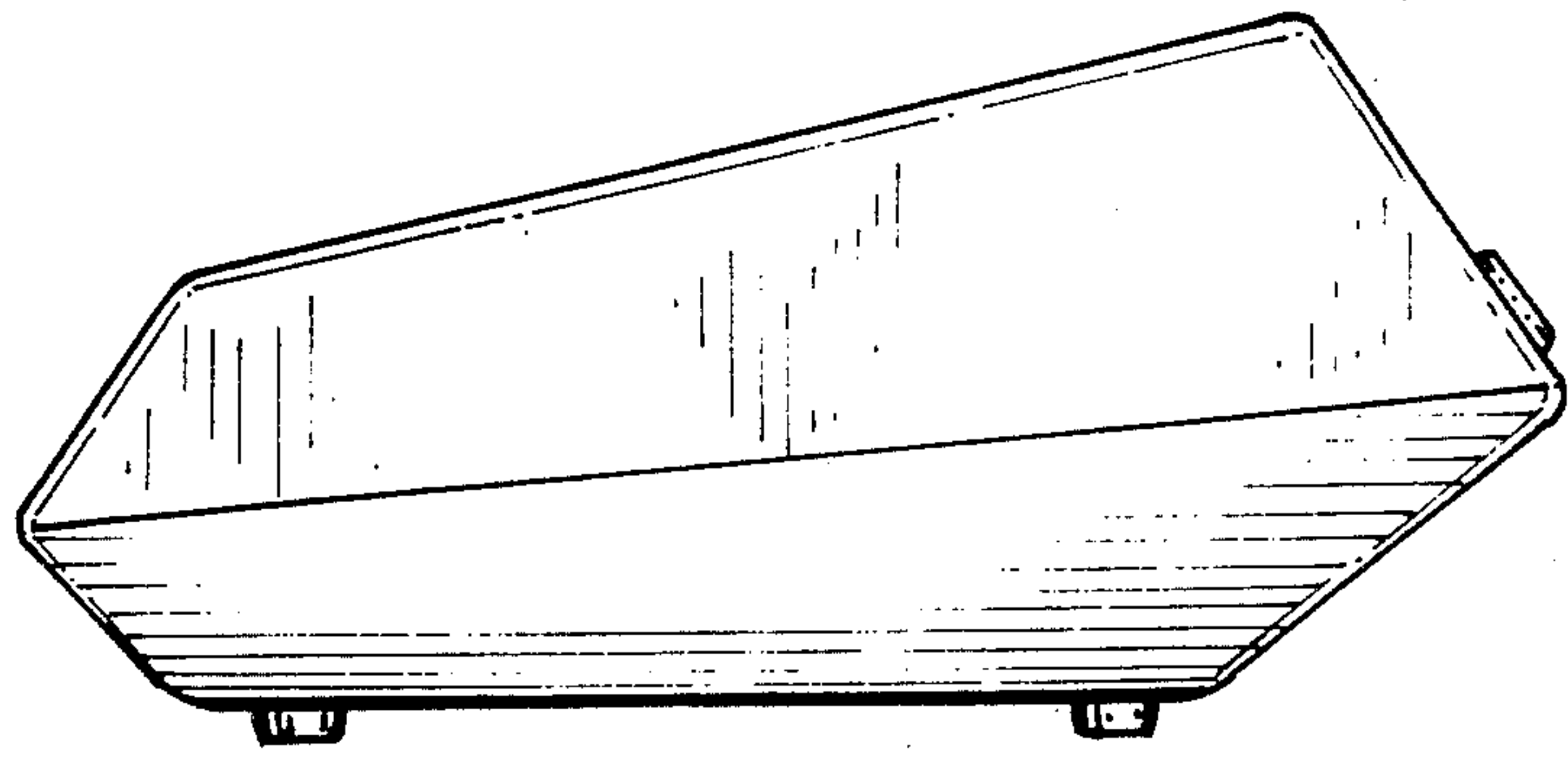

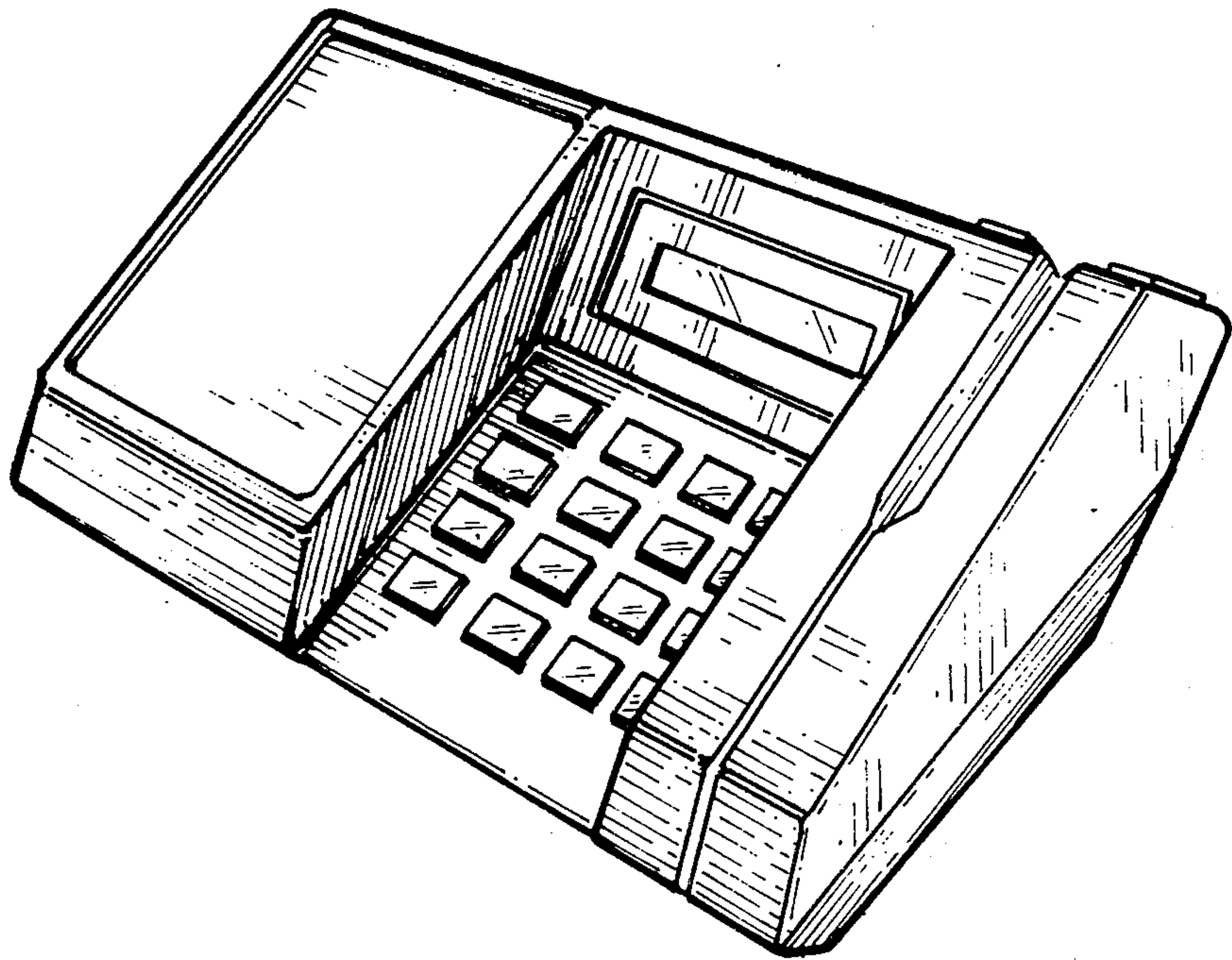

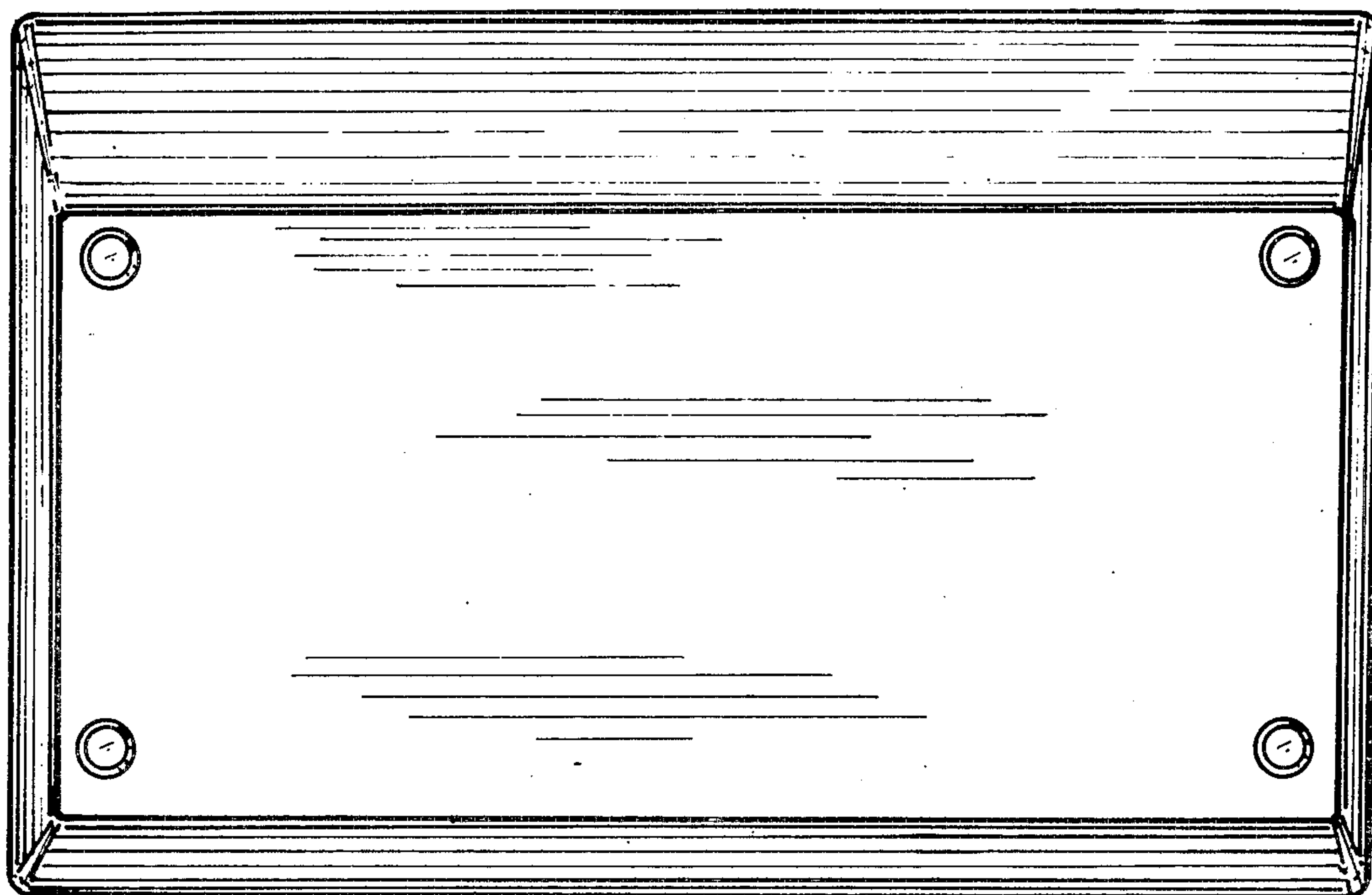
