The ornamental design for a dish, substantially as shown.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a top perspective view of a dish showing my new design;
FIG. 2 is a side elevational view thereof, all four sides being substantially the same;
FIG. 3 is a top plan view thereof;
FIG. 4 is a bottom plan view thereof; and
FIG. 5 is a cross-sectional view thereof taken along the line 5—5 of FIG. 3.

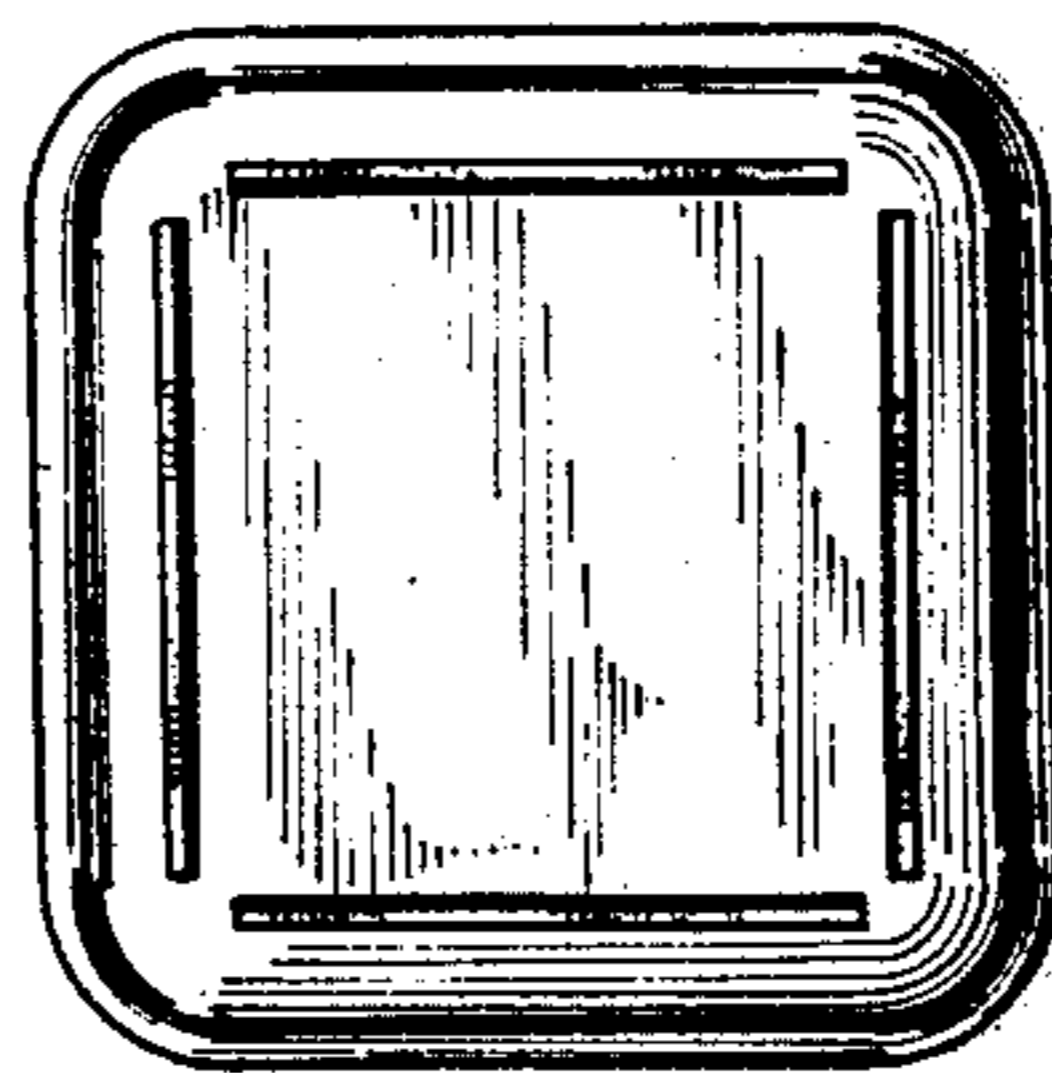
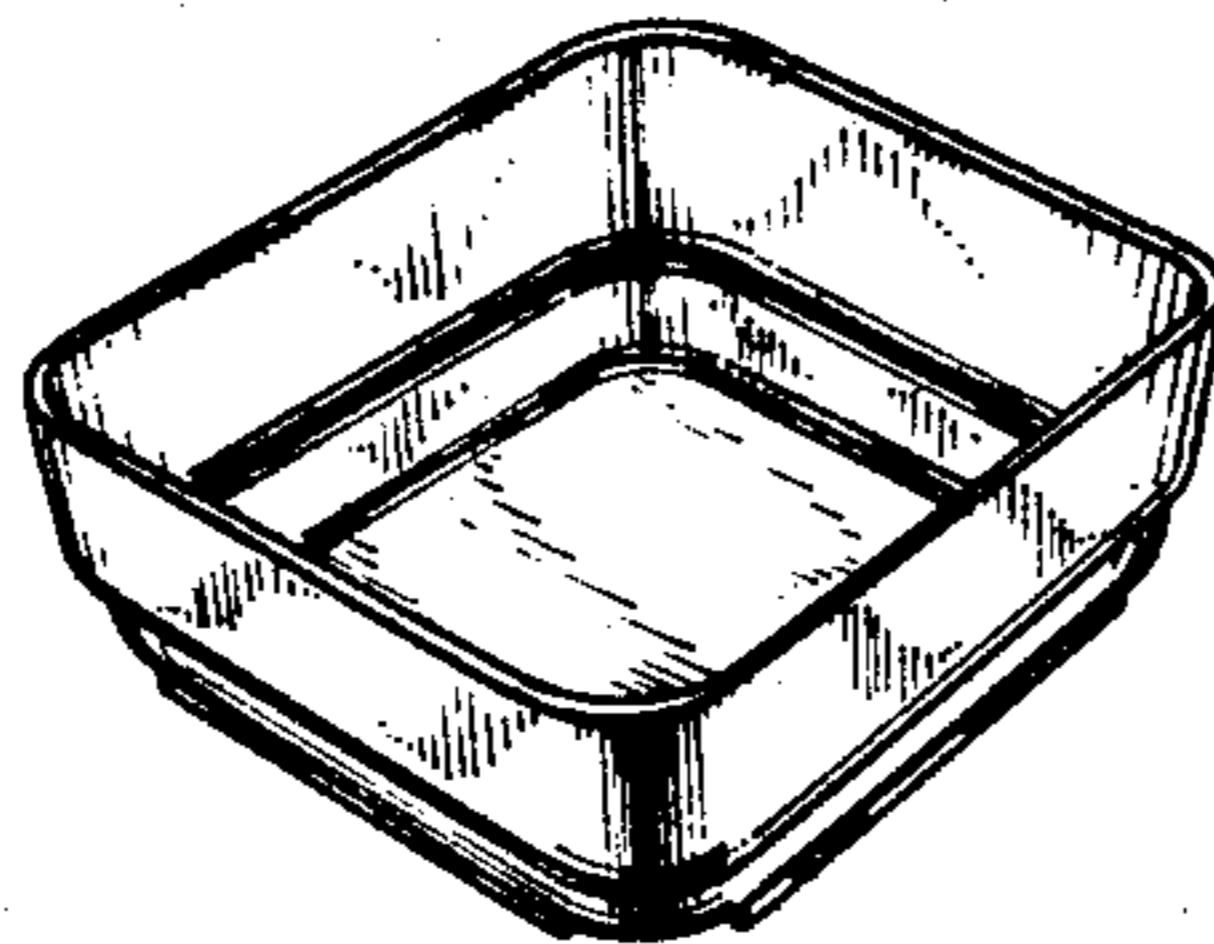

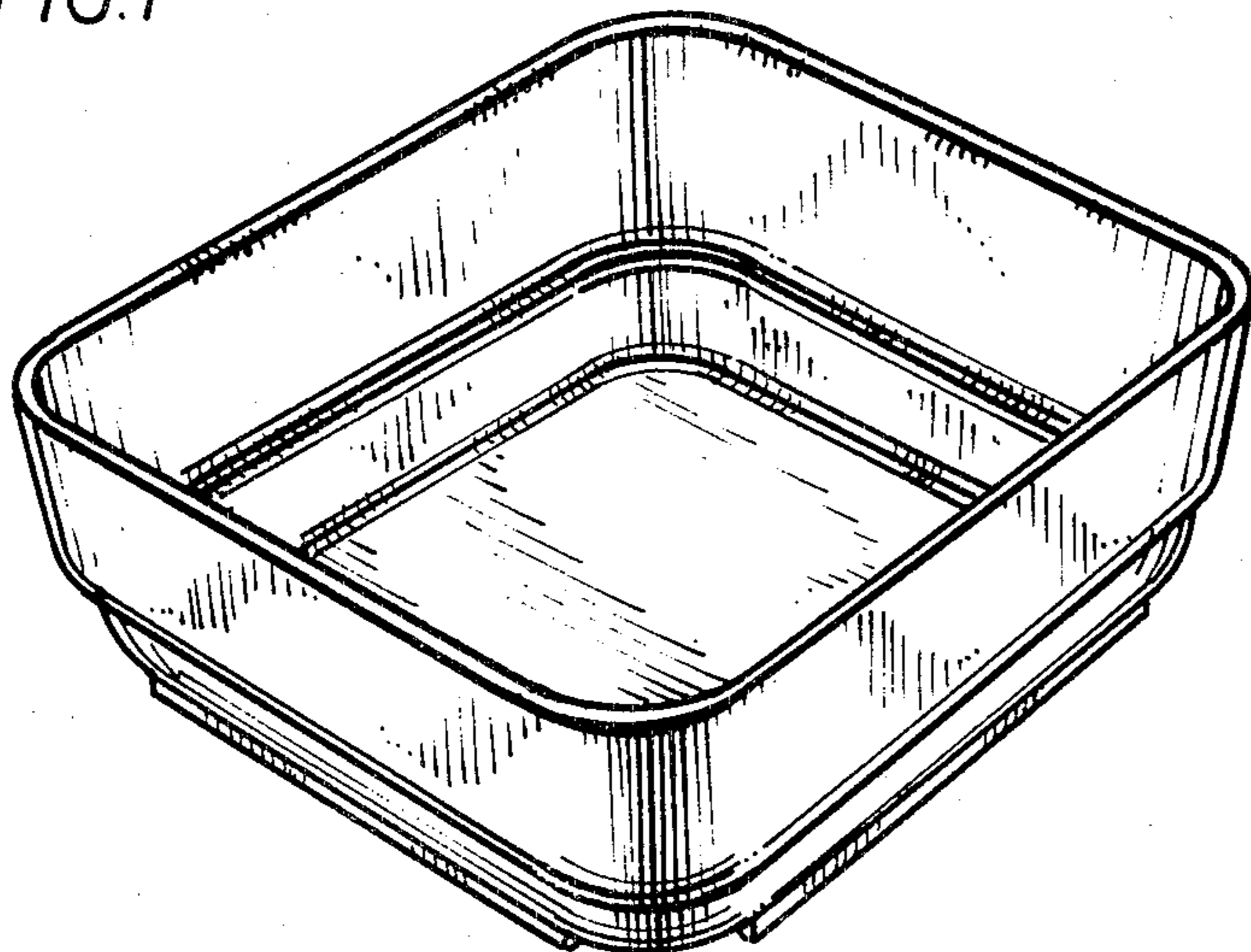

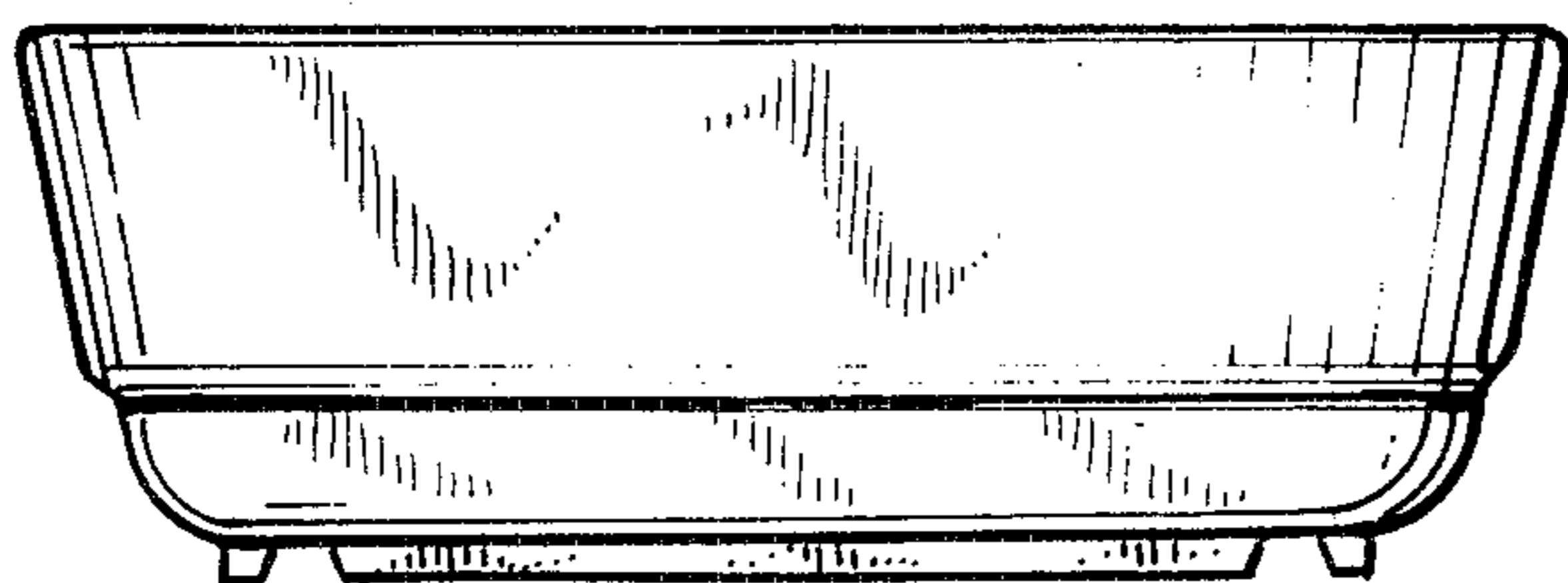

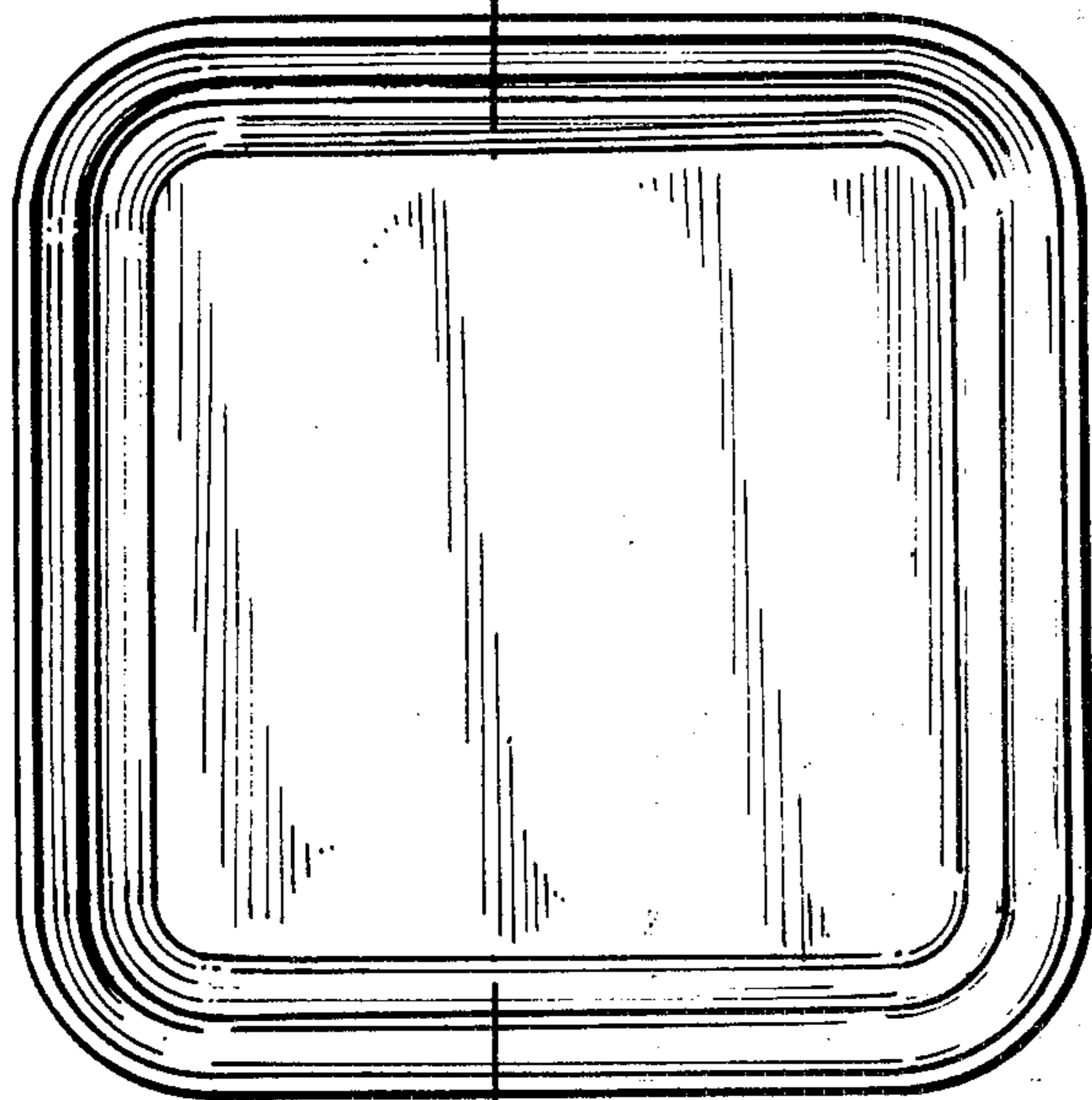

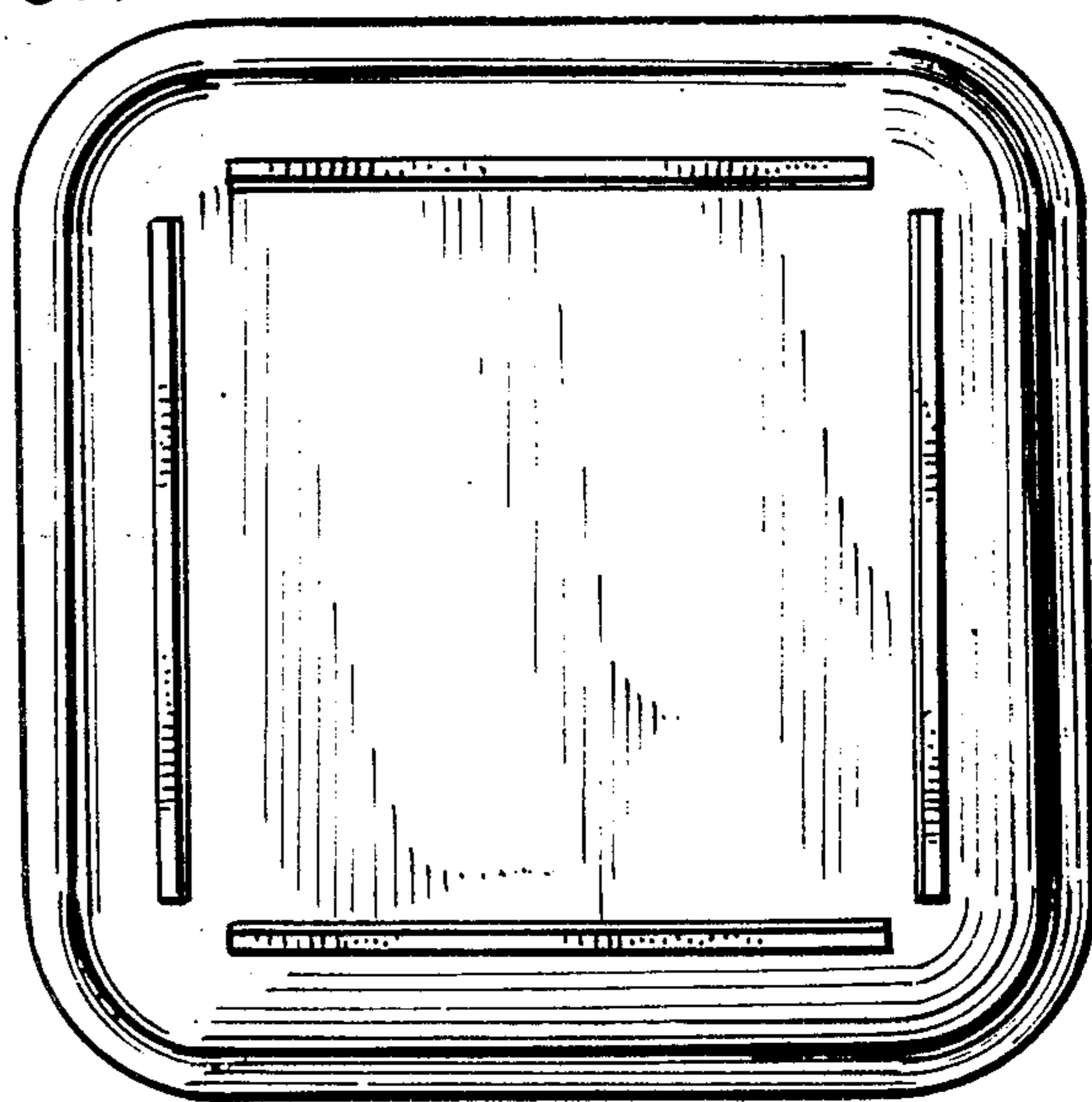
