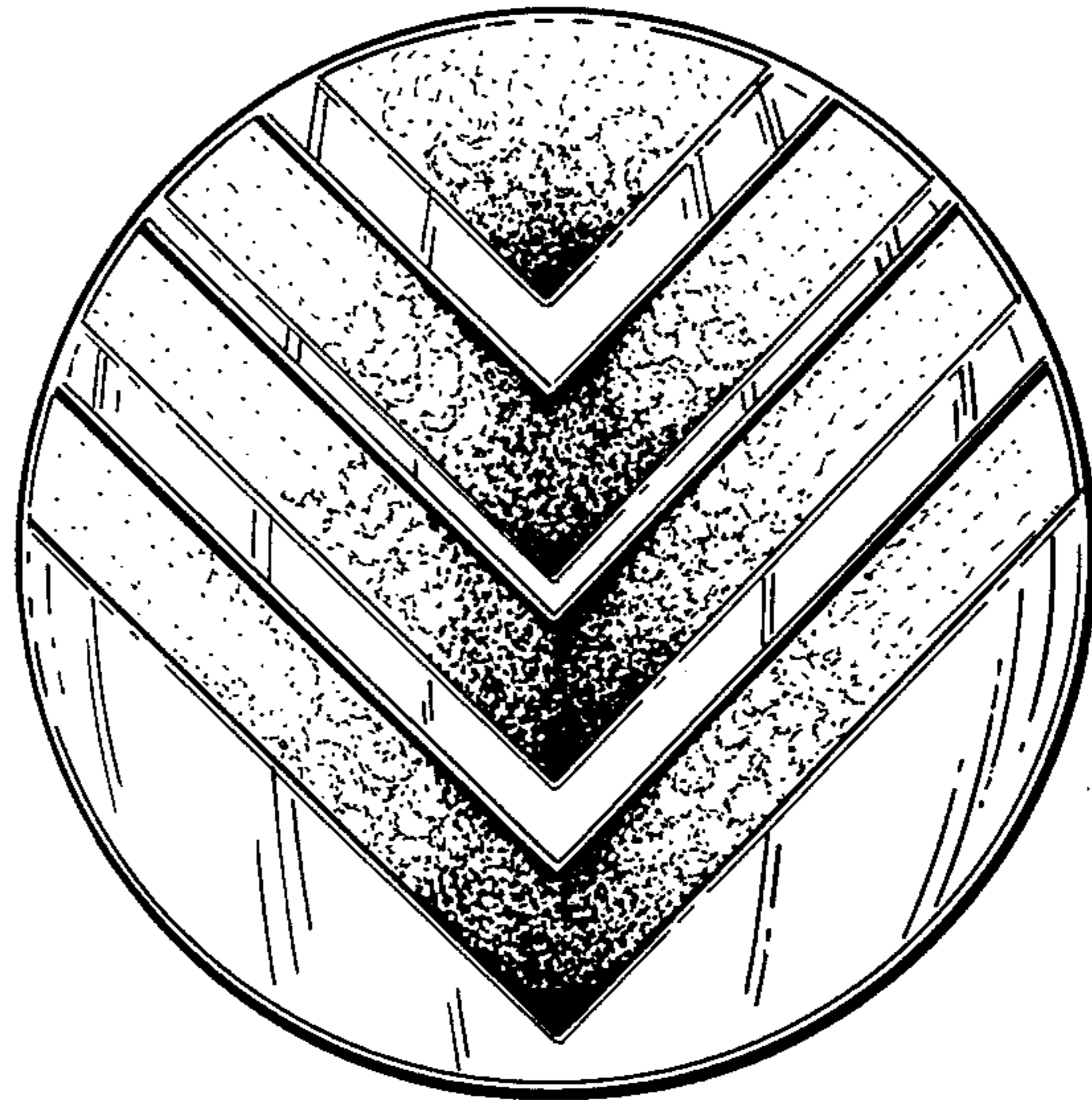
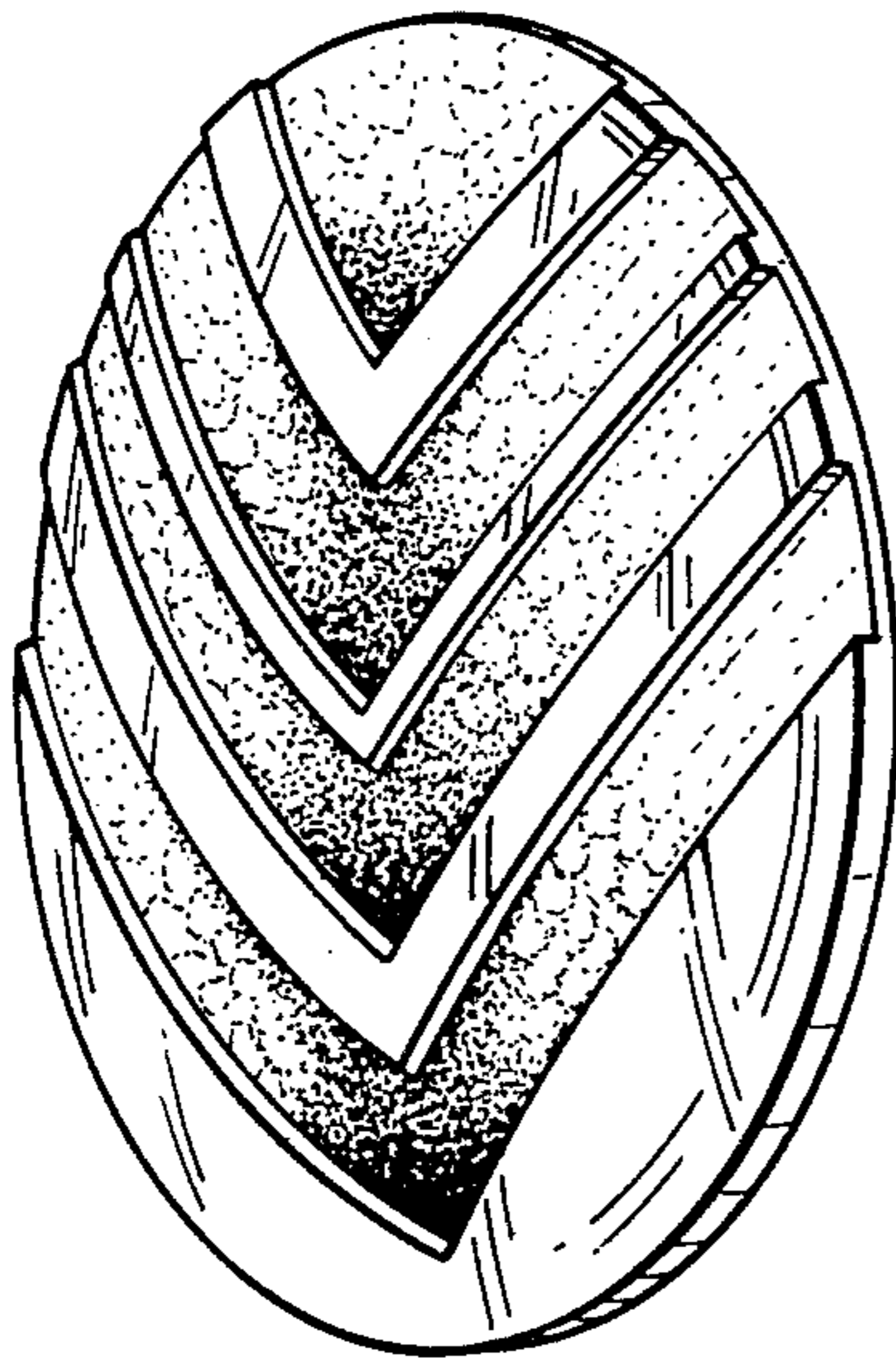

[57] **CLAIM**

The ornamental design for a belt buckle, substantially as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a three quarter front perspective view of a belt buckle showing our new design;
FIG. 2 is a front elevational view thereof;
FIG. 3 is a left side elevational view thereof, the right side constituting a mirror image;
FIG. 4 is a rear elevational view thereof;
FIG. 5 is a top plan view thereof; and,
FIG. 6 is a bottom plan view thereof.



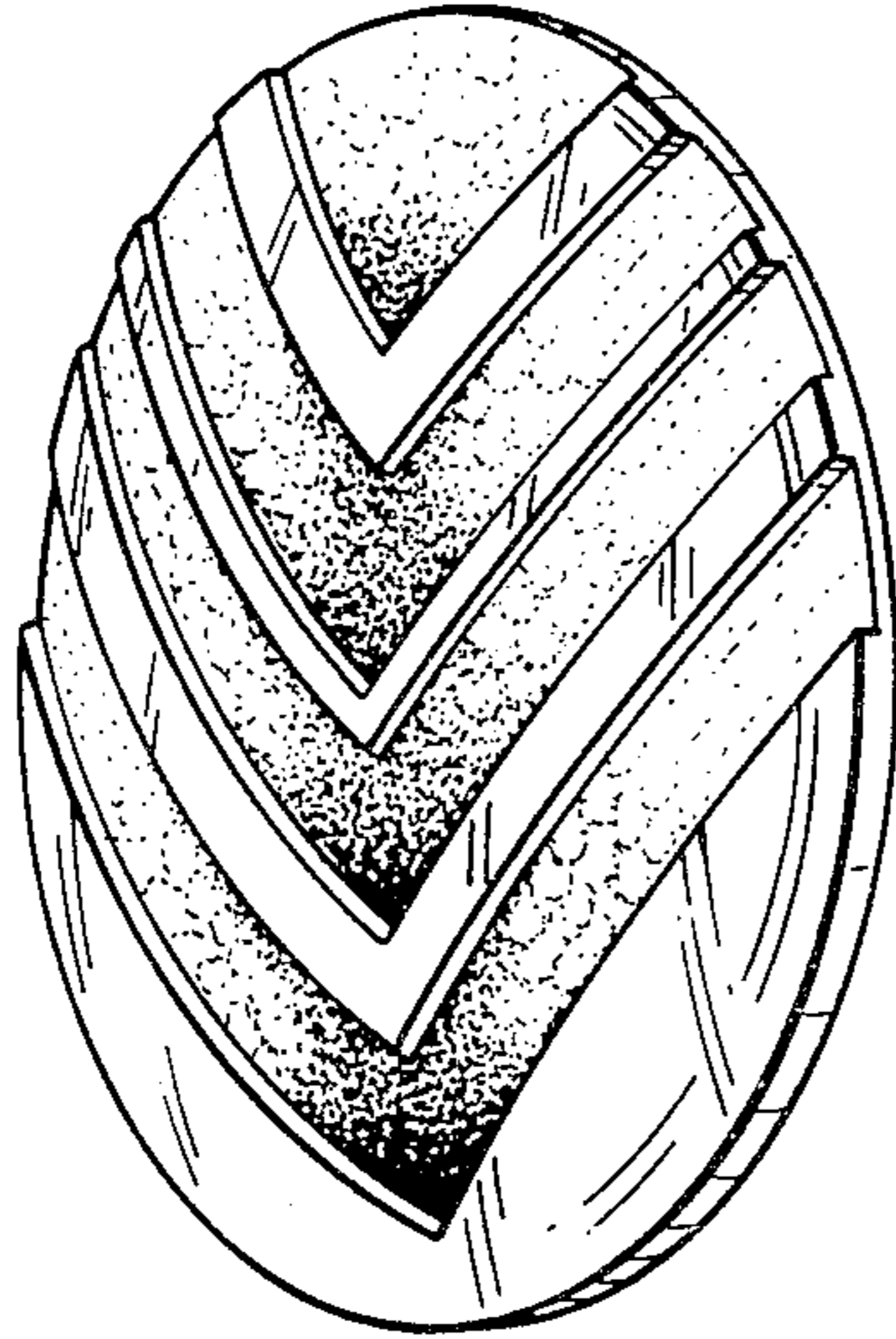

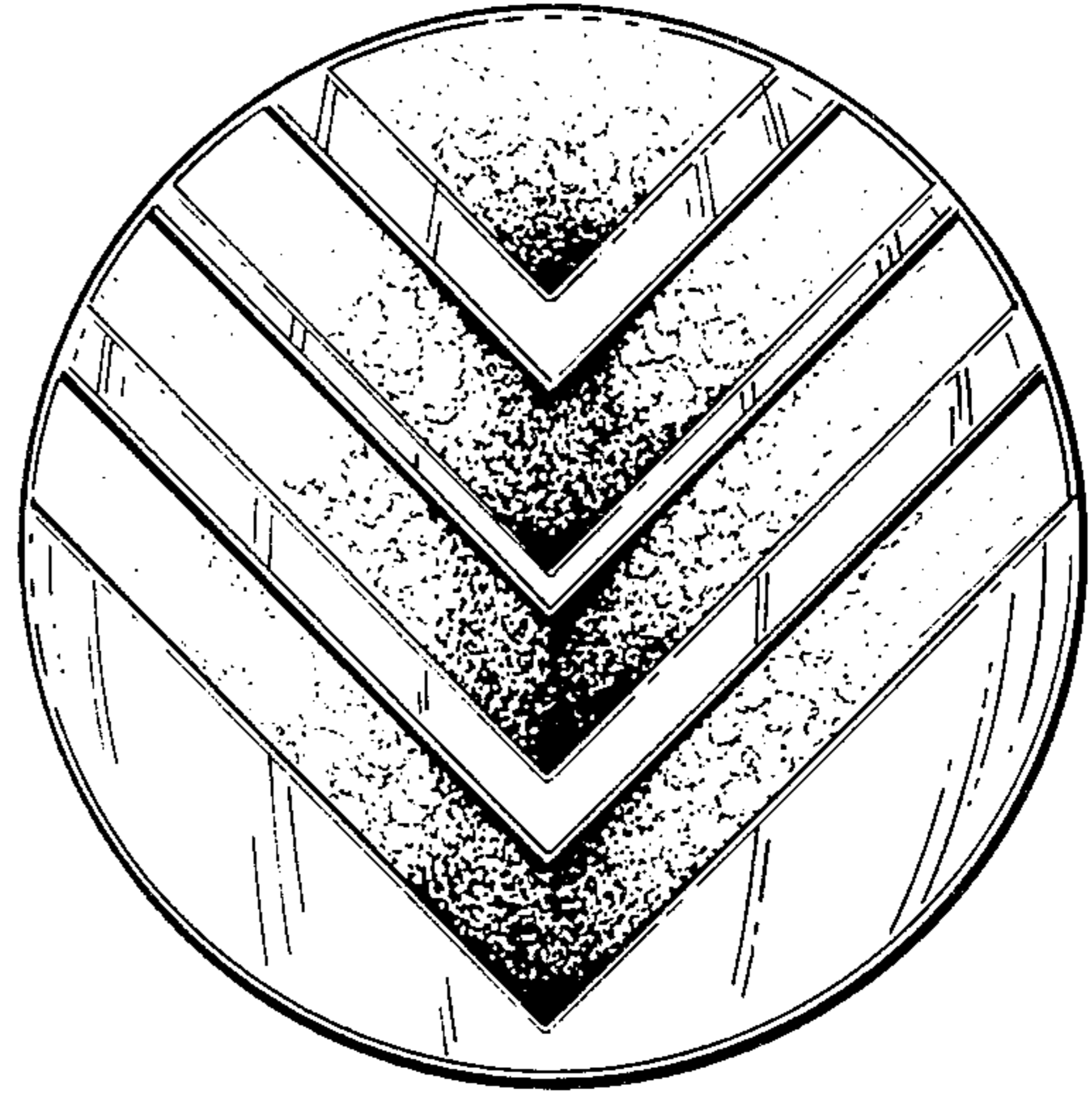

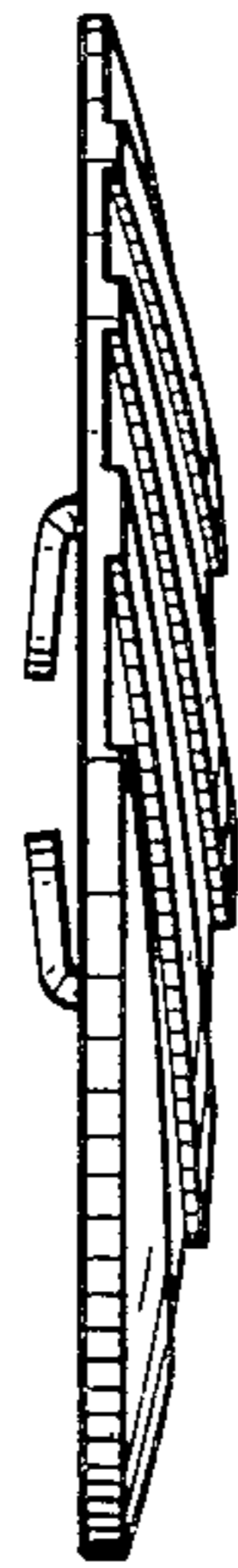

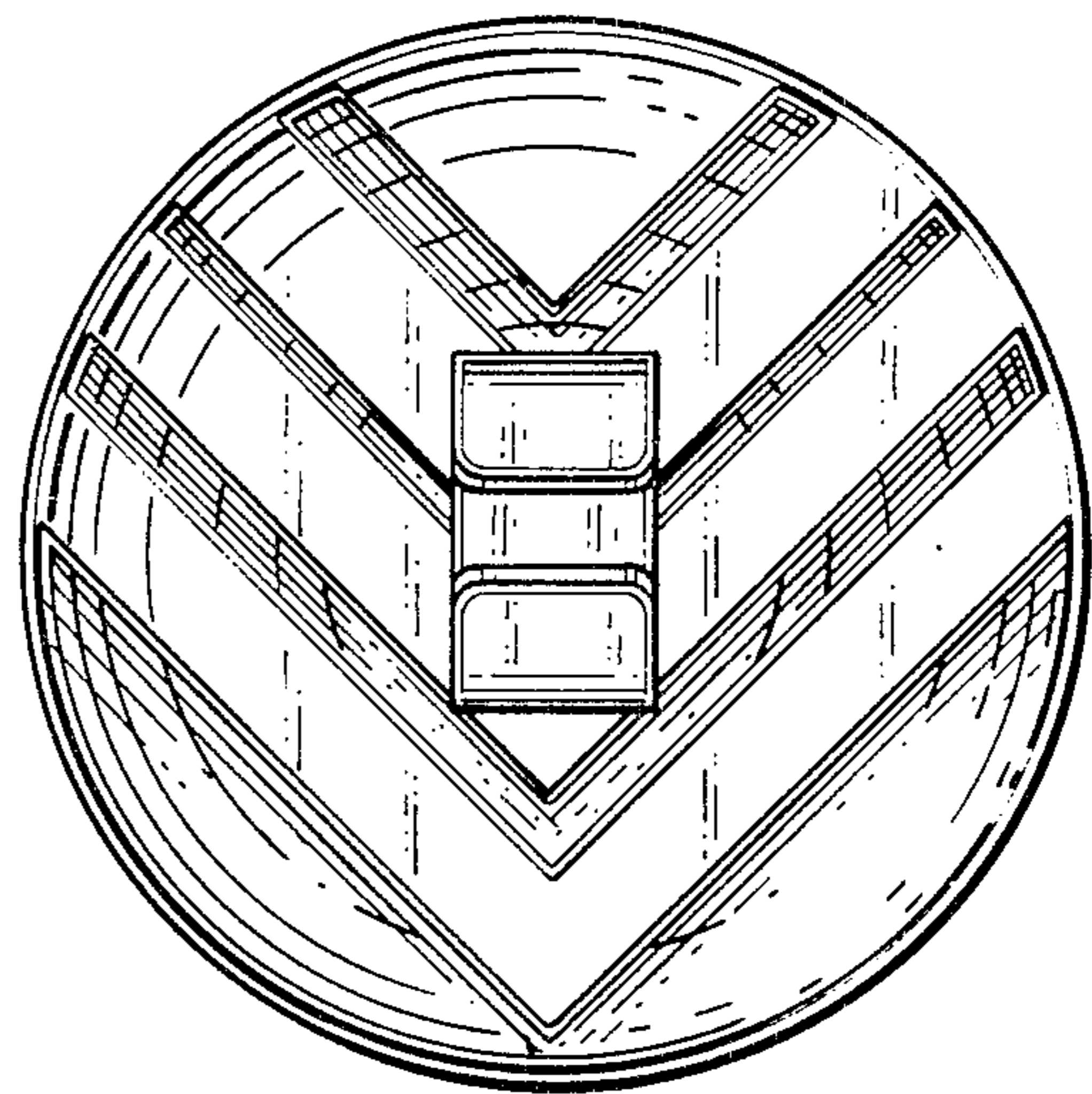

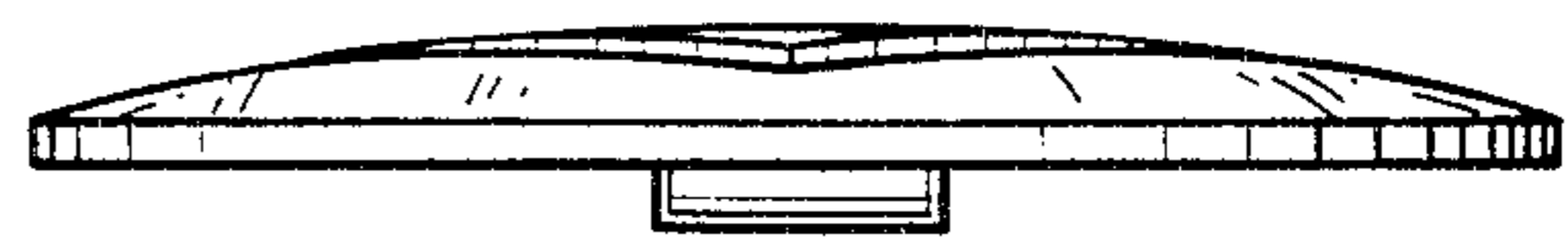
