FIG. 1 is a front, top and partial right side perspective view of a telephone support stand showing my new design;

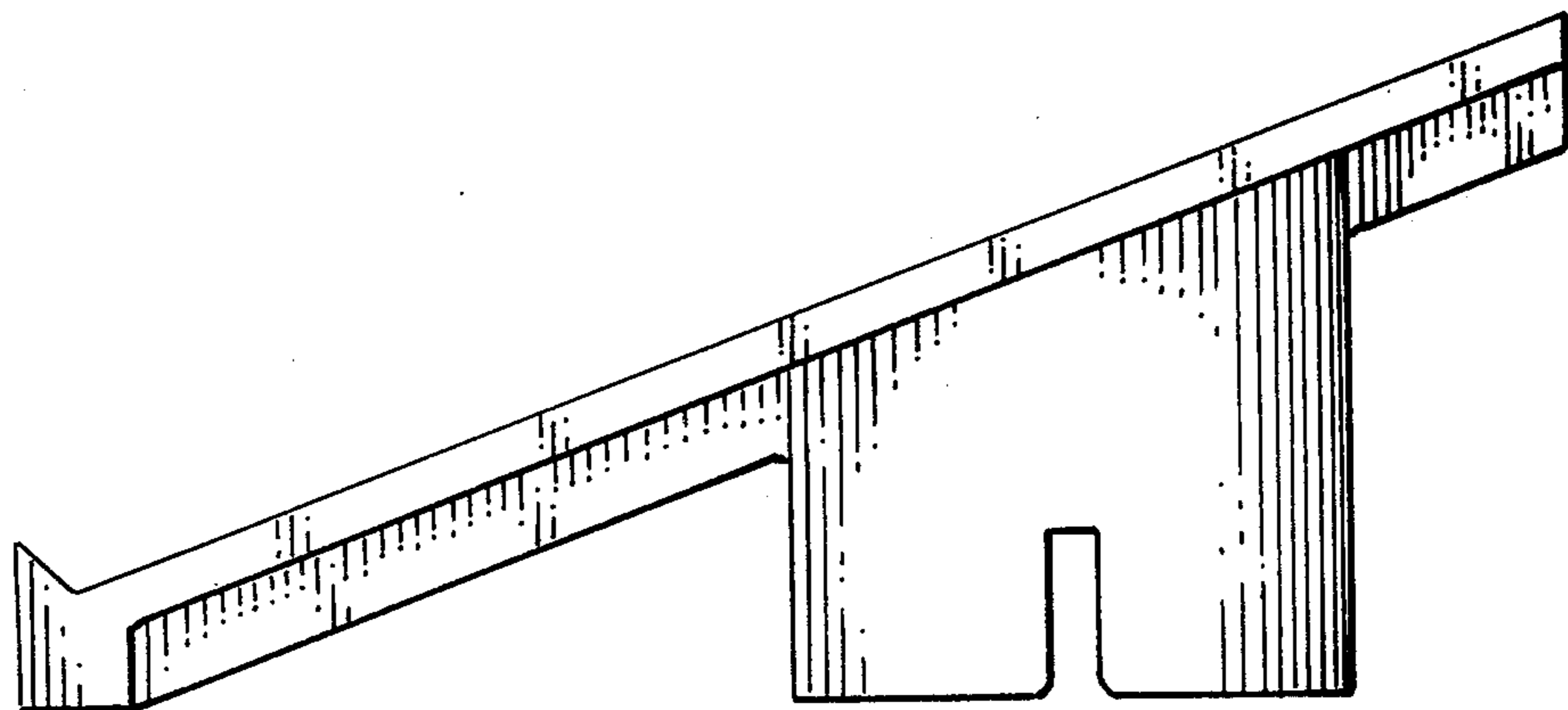
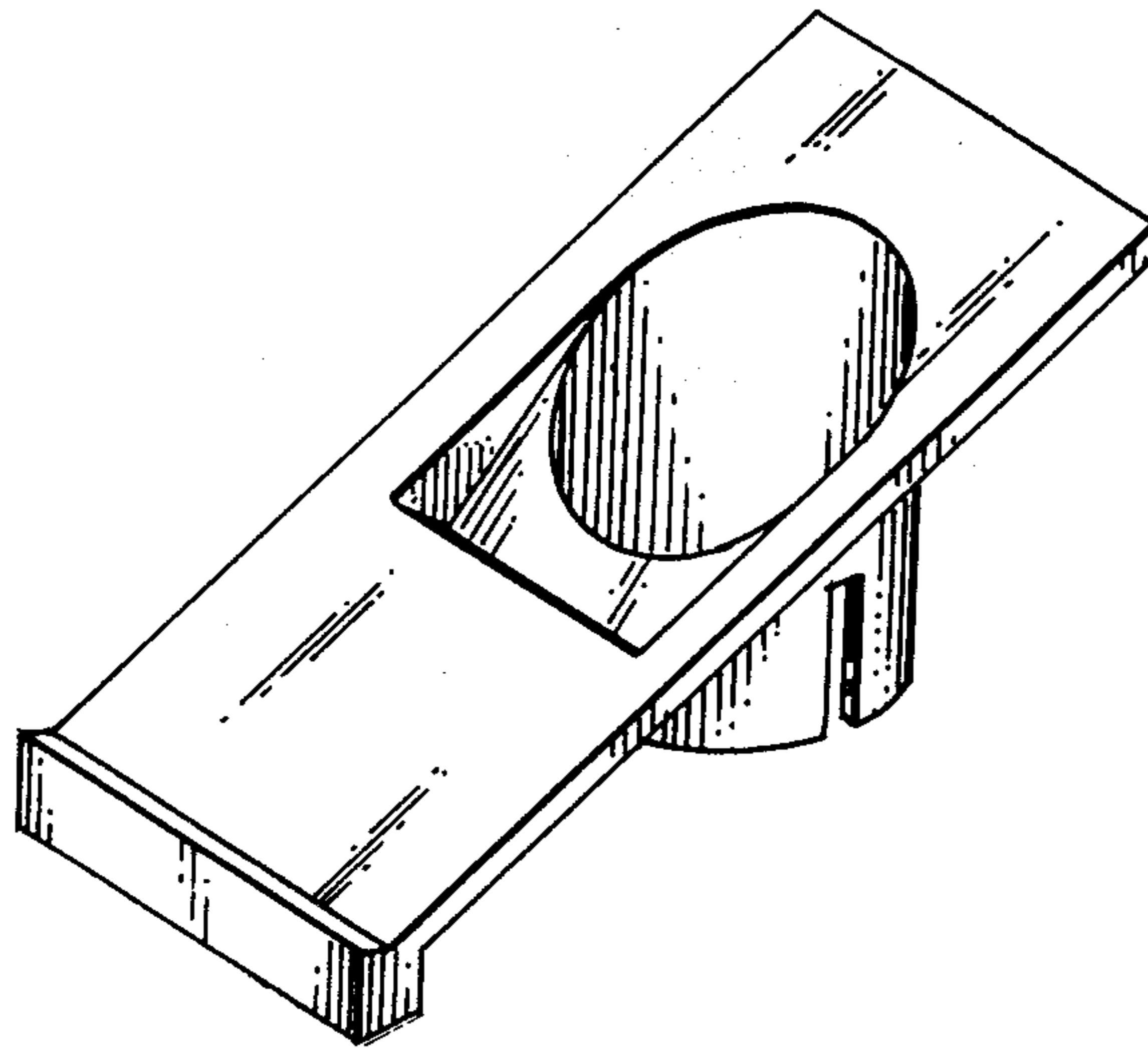
FIG. 2 is a front elevation thereof;

FIG. 6 is a rear elevation thereof.



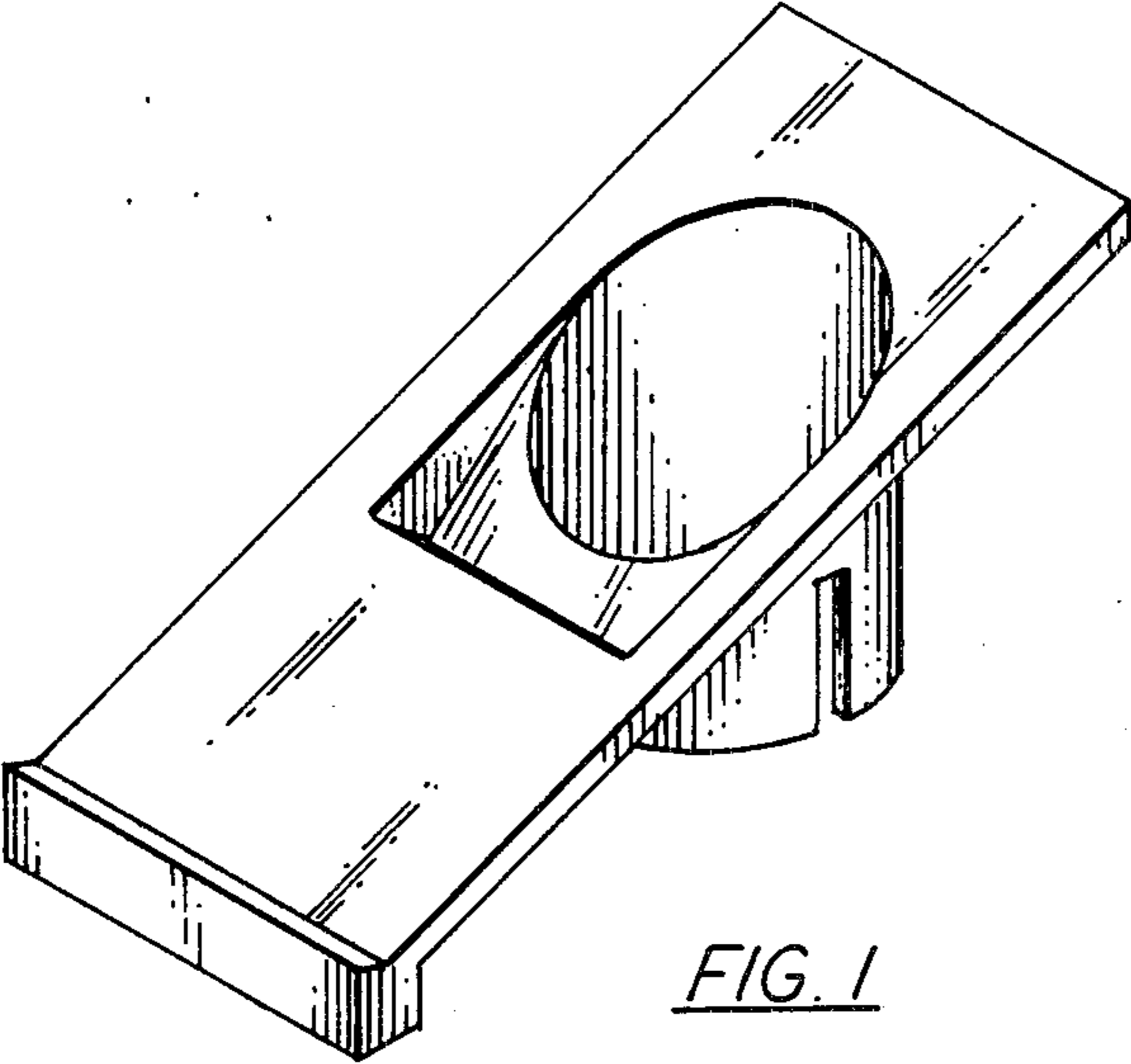

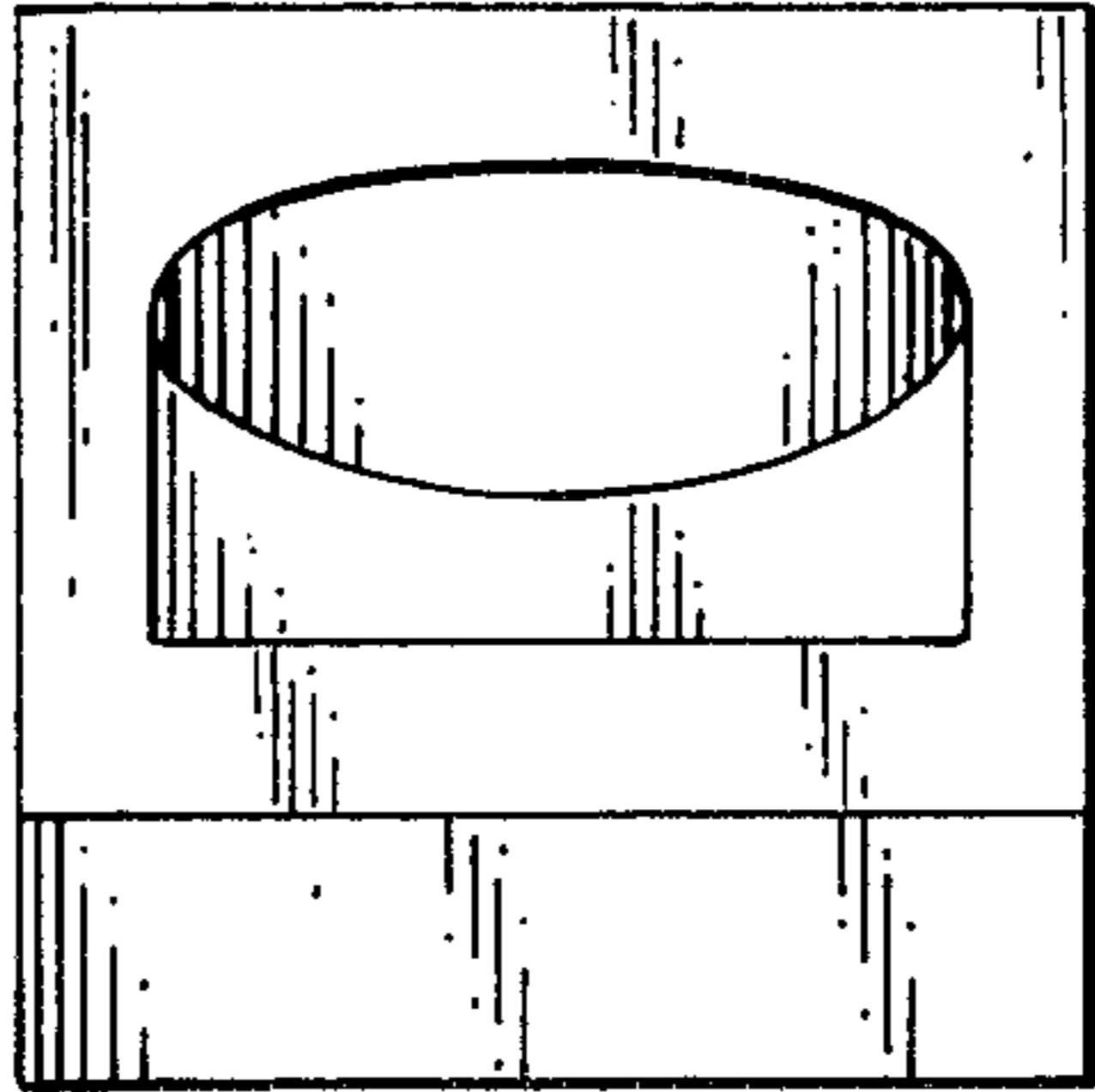

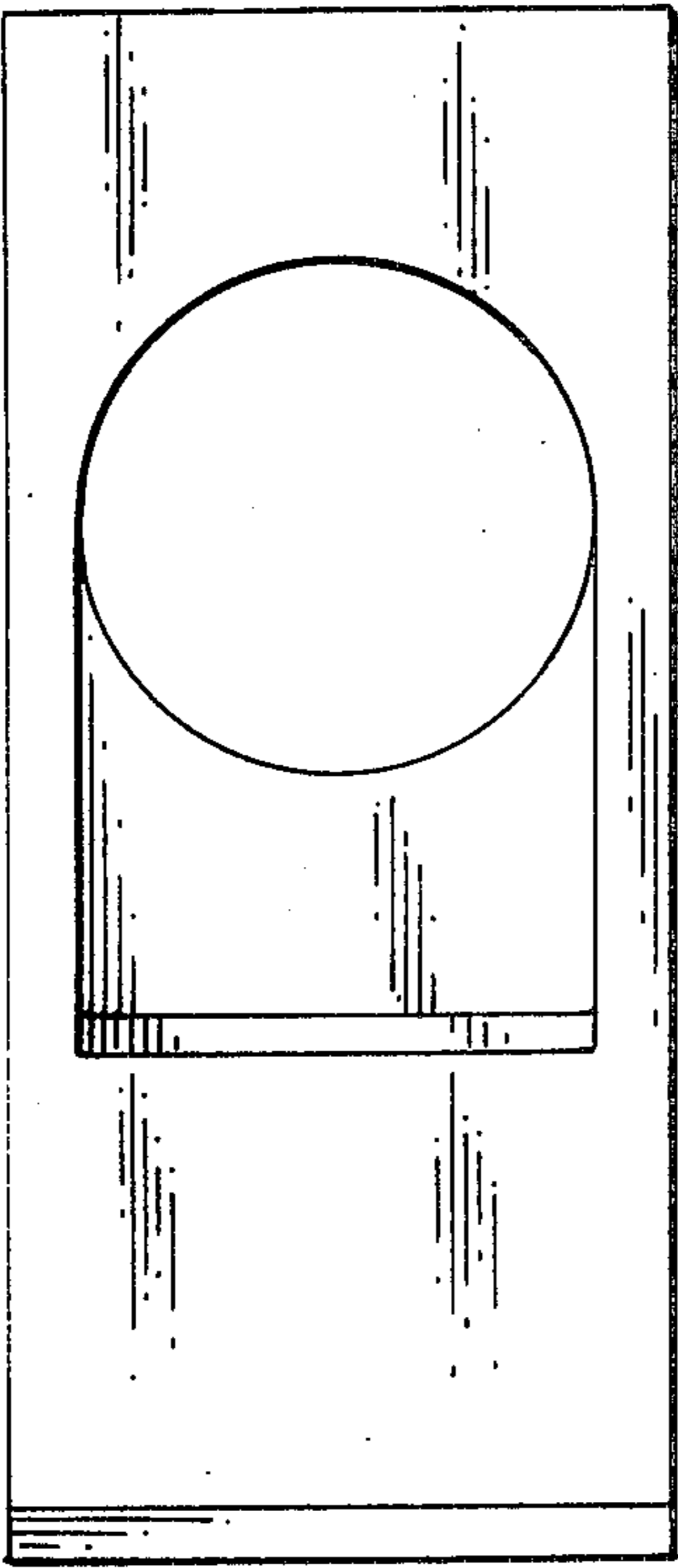

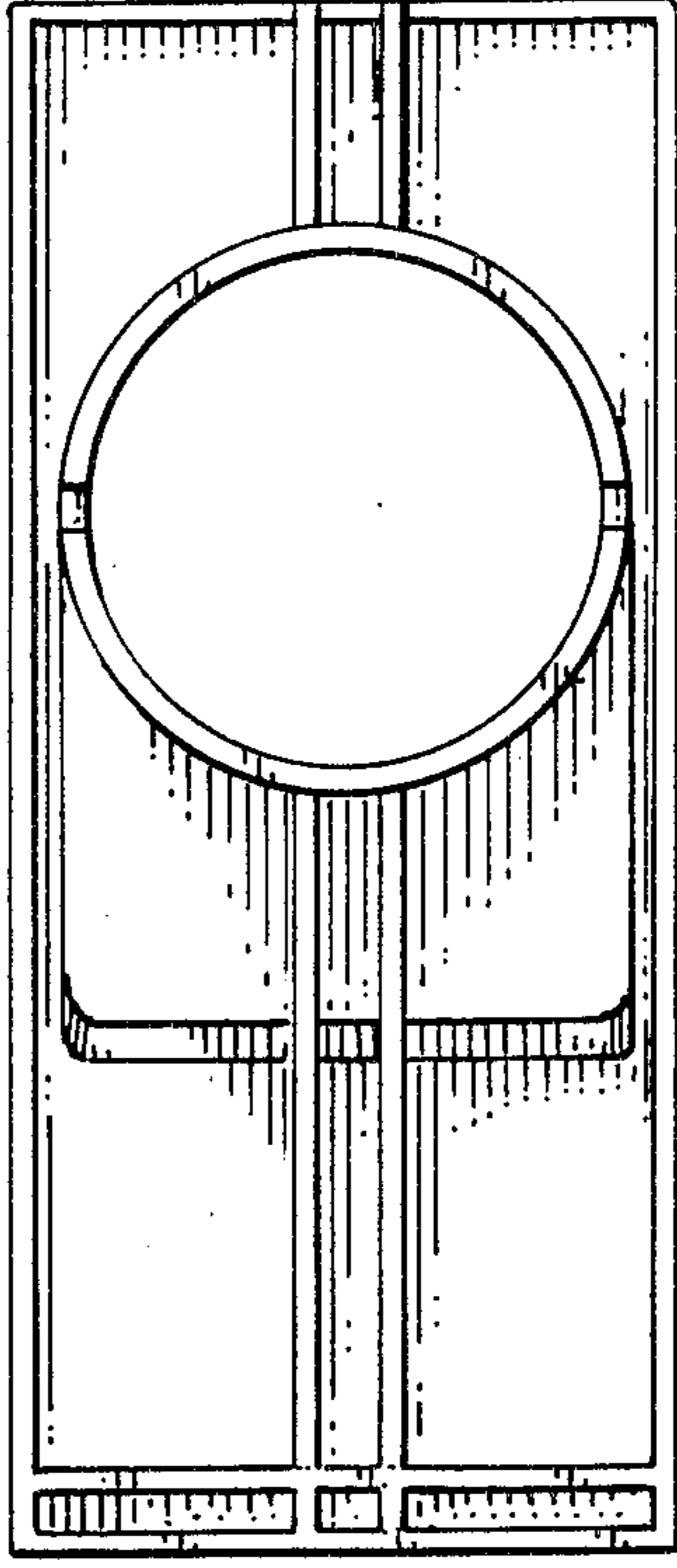

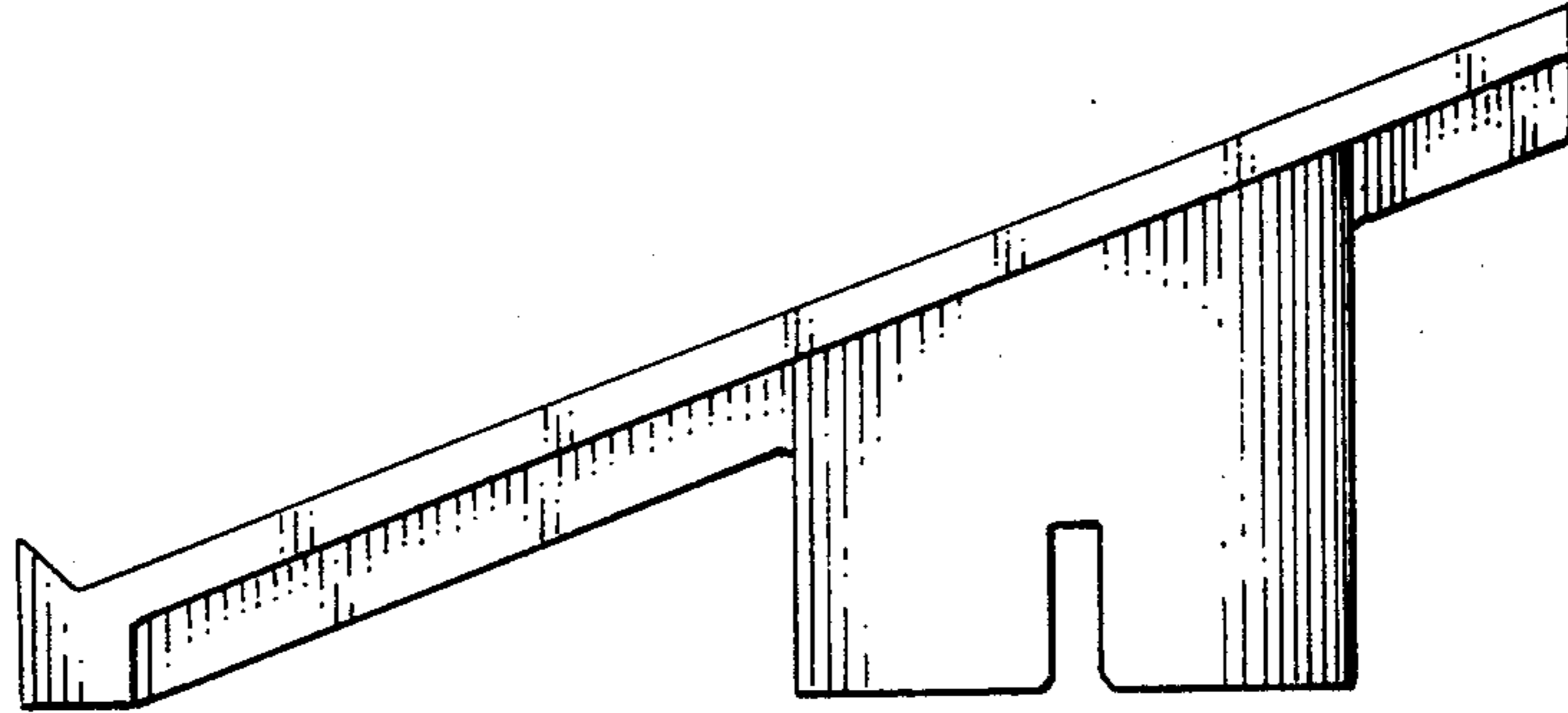

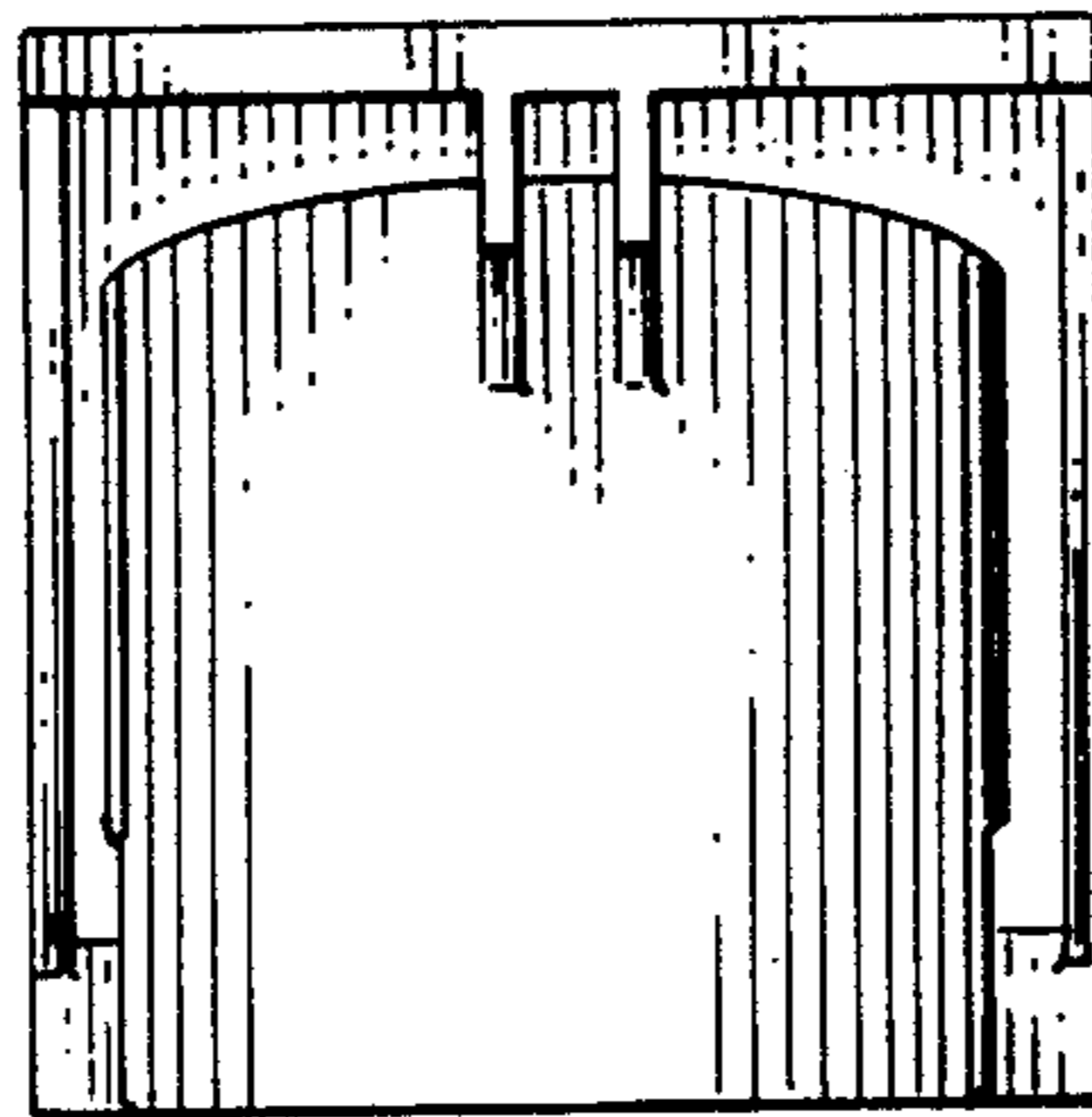
