[57] CLAIM

The ornamental design for a desk-top electronic calculator, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a front elevational view of a desk-top electronic calculator showing our new design;

FIG. 2 is a rear elevational view thereof;

FIG. 3 is a top plan view thereof;

FIG. 4 is a bottom plan view thereof;

FIG. 5 is a side elevational view as seen from the left of FIG. 1;

FIG. 6 is a side elevational view as seen from the right of FIG. 1;

FIG. 7 is a perspective view of the desk-top electronic calculator and

FIG. 8 is a left side elevational view with the leg extended; and

FIG. 9 is a front elevational view with the leg extended.

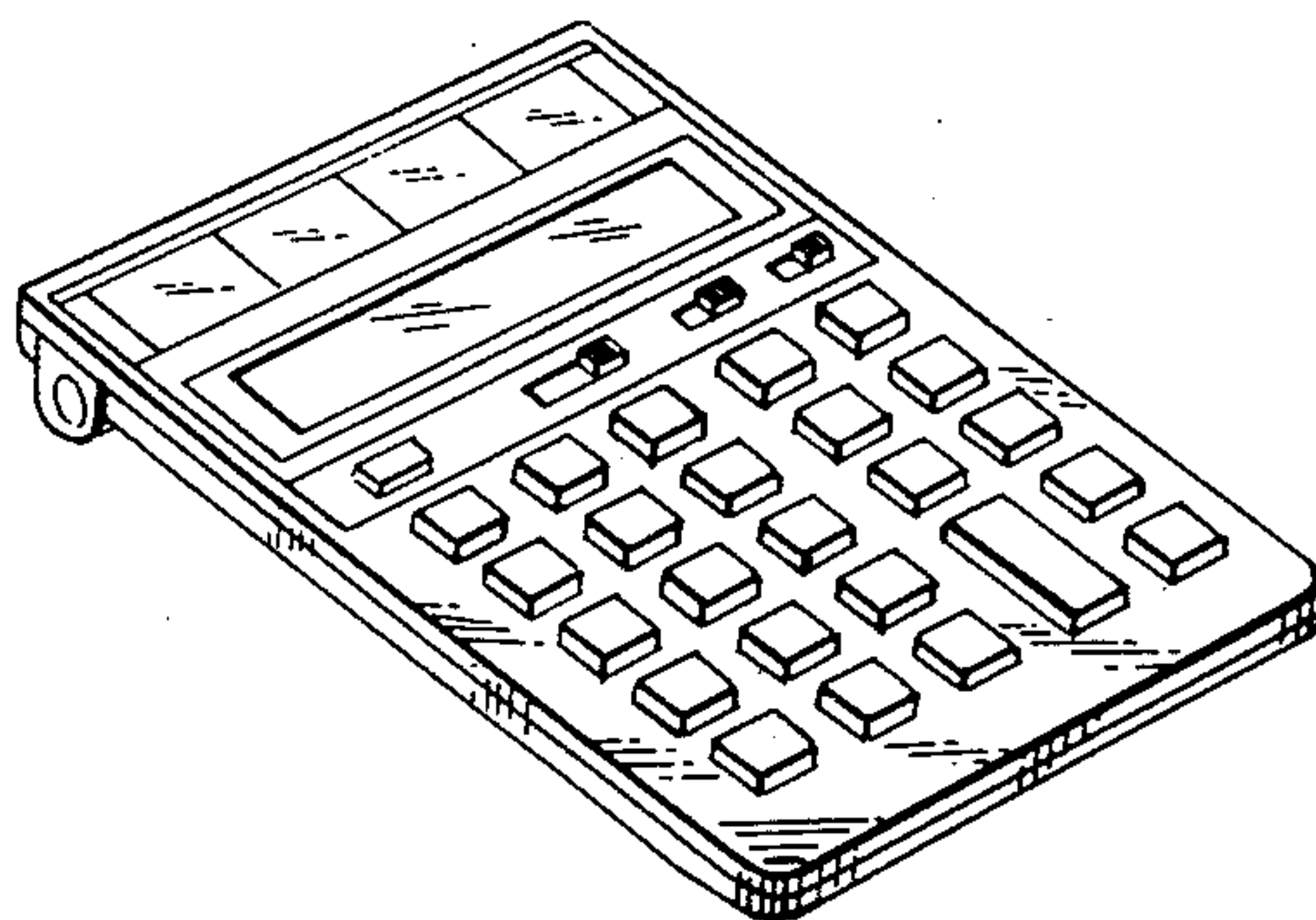

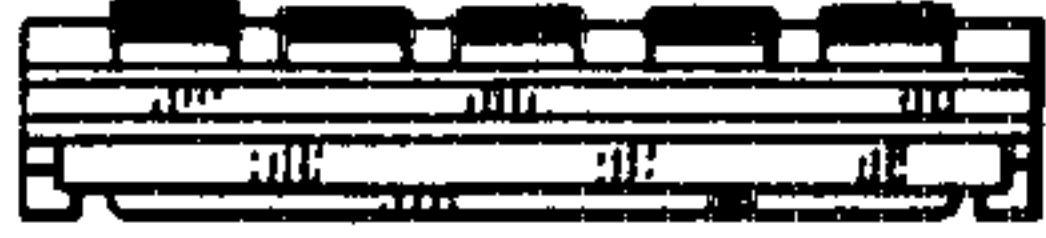

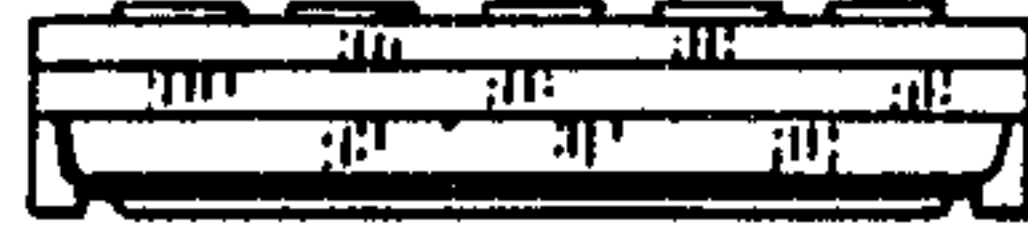

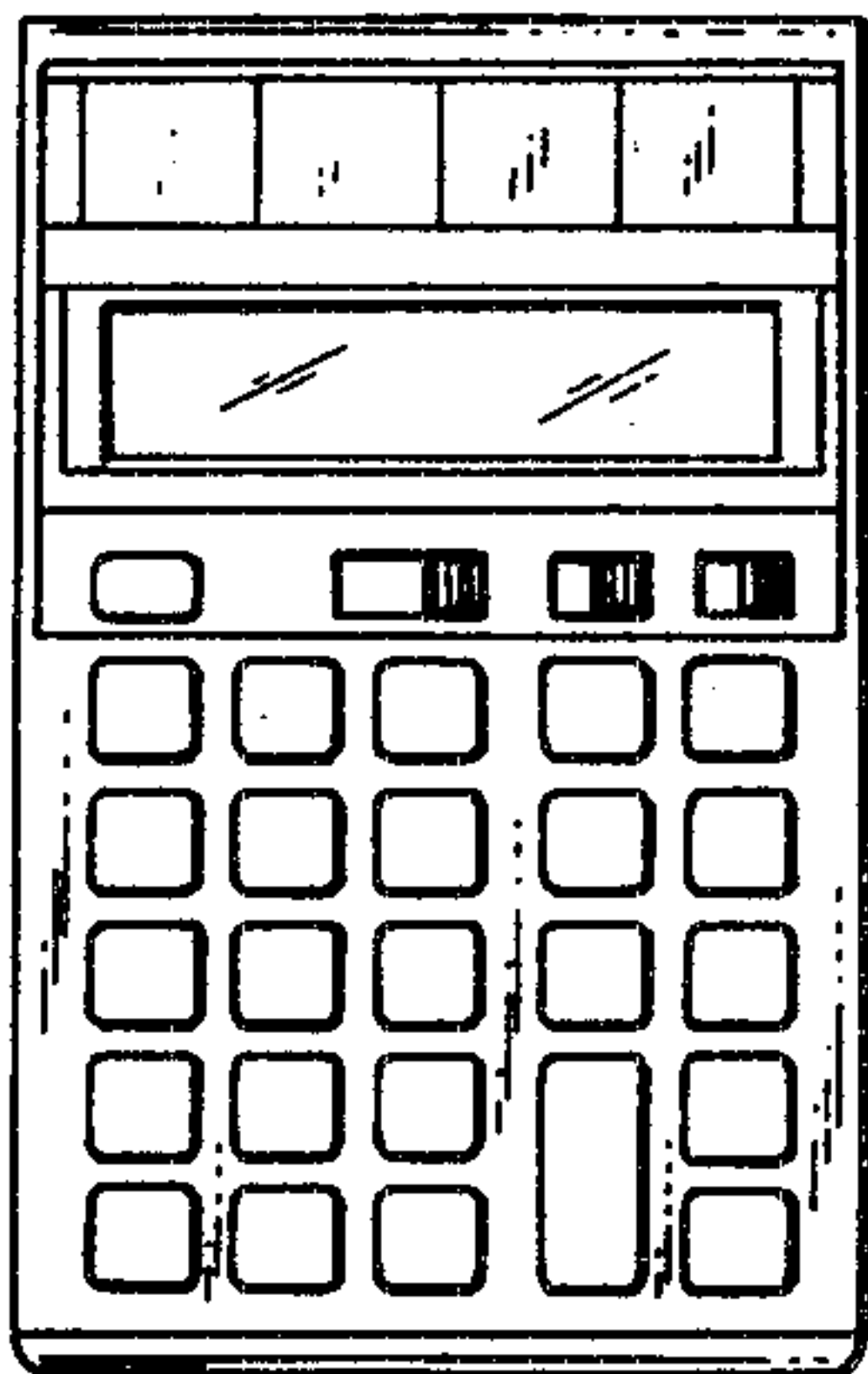

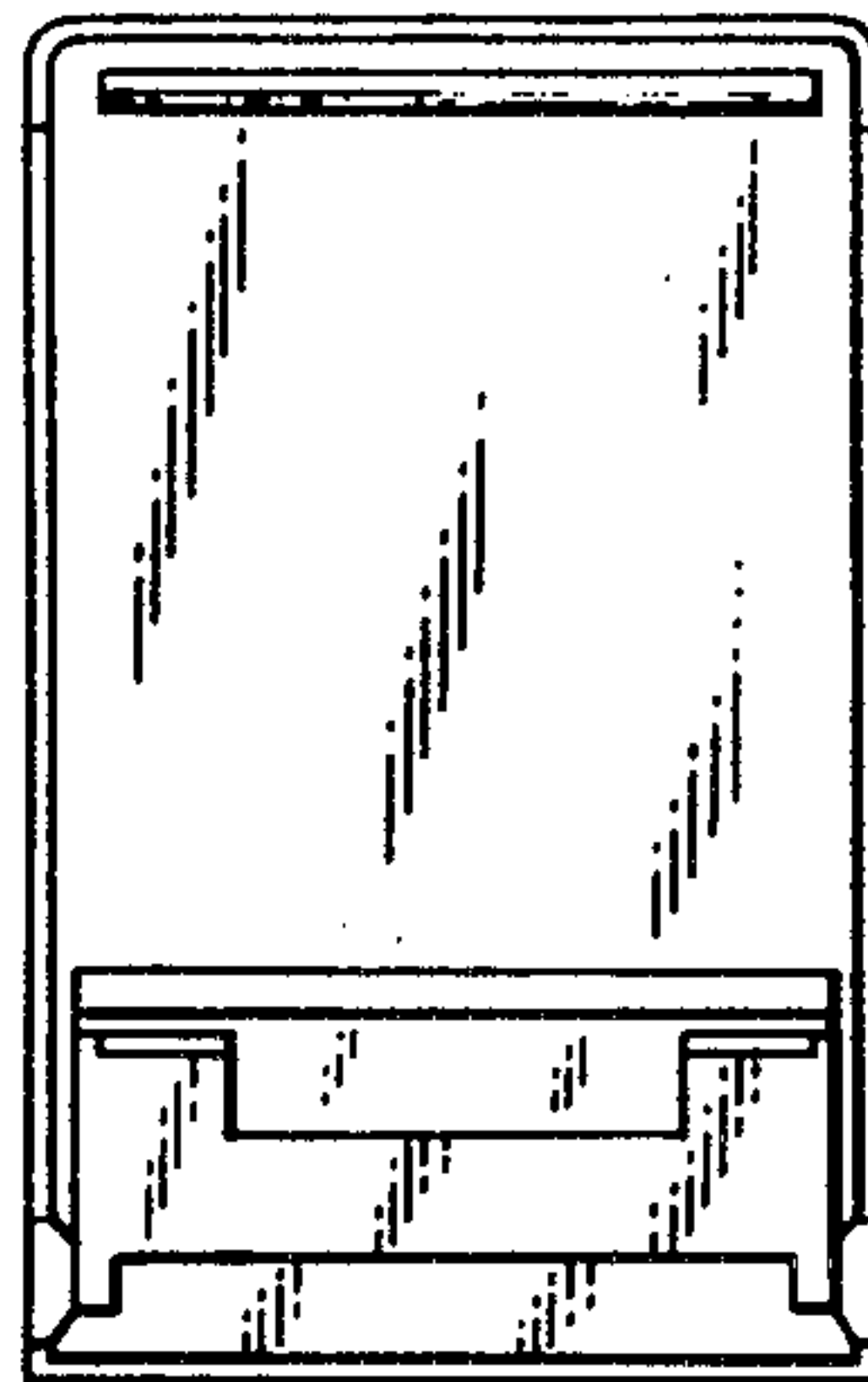

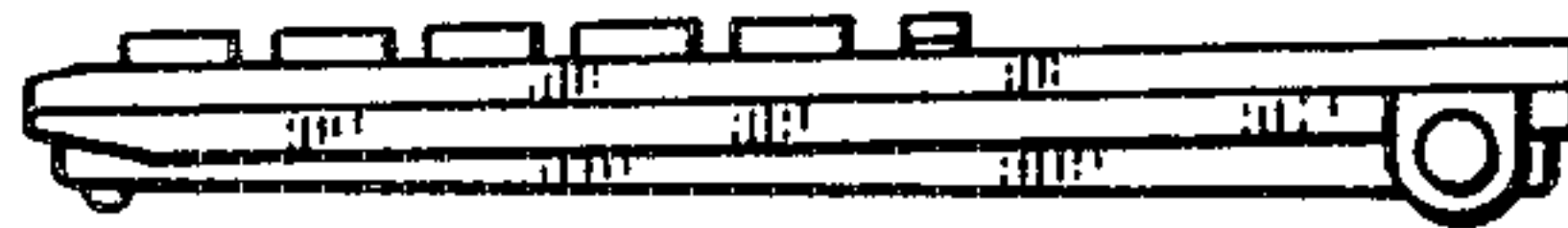

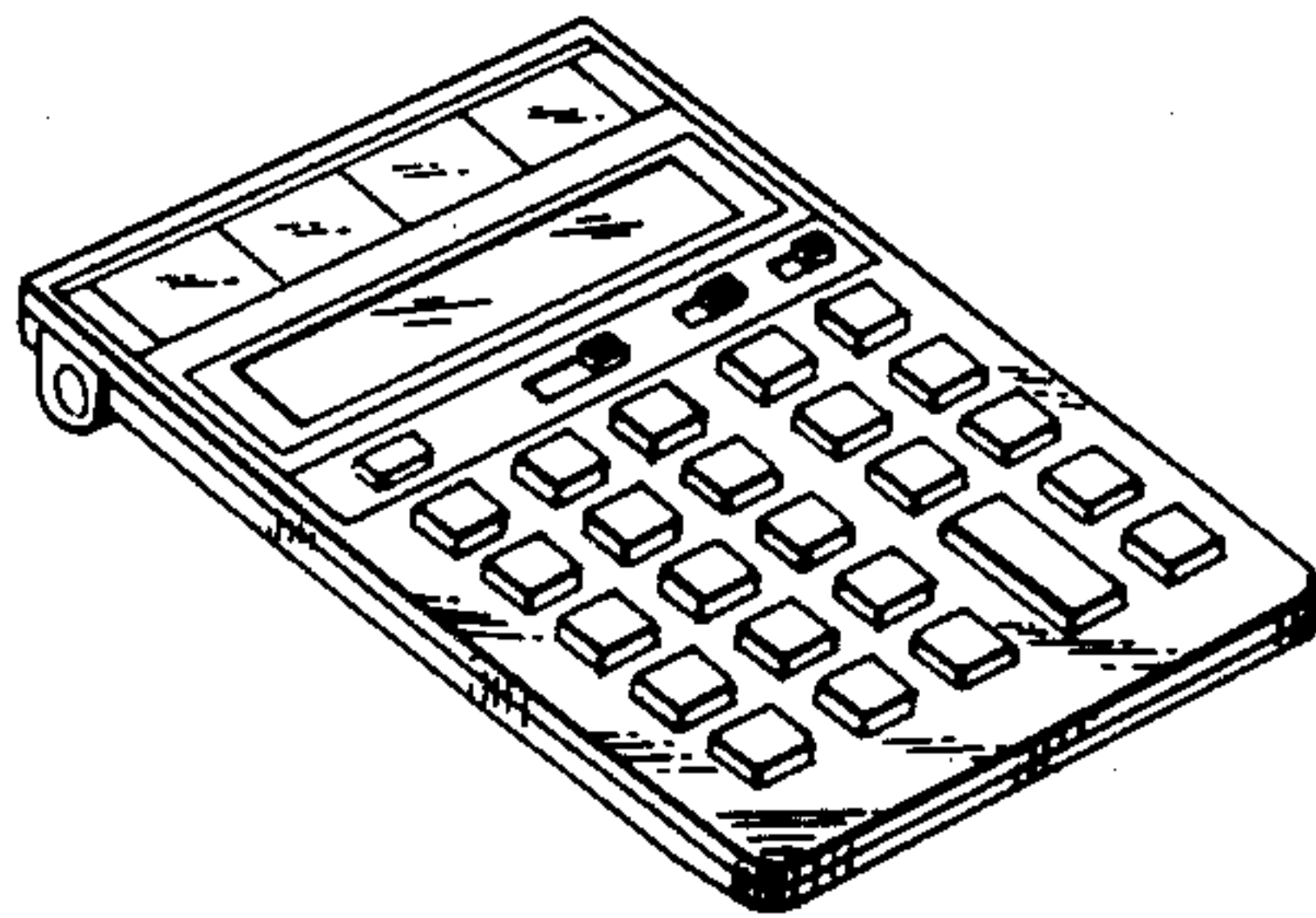
