[57] CLAIM

The ornamental design for a filter housing for aquariums, substantially as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a perspective view of a filter housing for aquariums showing our new design.

FIG. 2 is a top plan view thereof;

FIG. 3 is a front elevational view thereof;

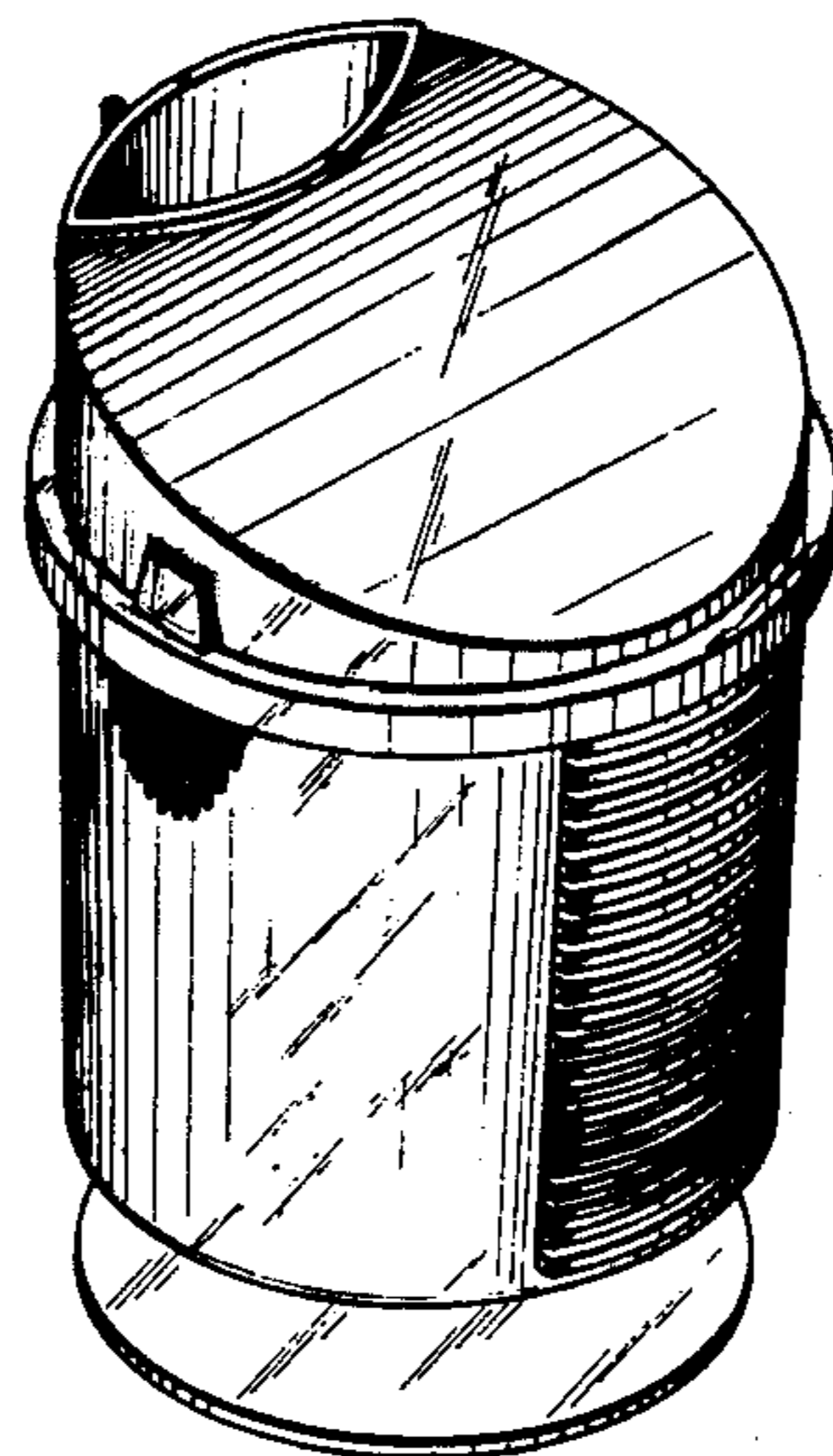
FIG. 4 is a side view thereof, the other side being the same;

FIG. 5 is a rear elevational view thereof;

FIG. 6 is a bottom view thereof; and

FIG. 7 is a perspective view of an alternate embodiment of the filter housing for aquariums shown in FIG. 1, wherein the only difference resides in the appearance of the face screen member.

The internal configuration detail which is visible through the transparent housing has been omitted for ease of illustration.



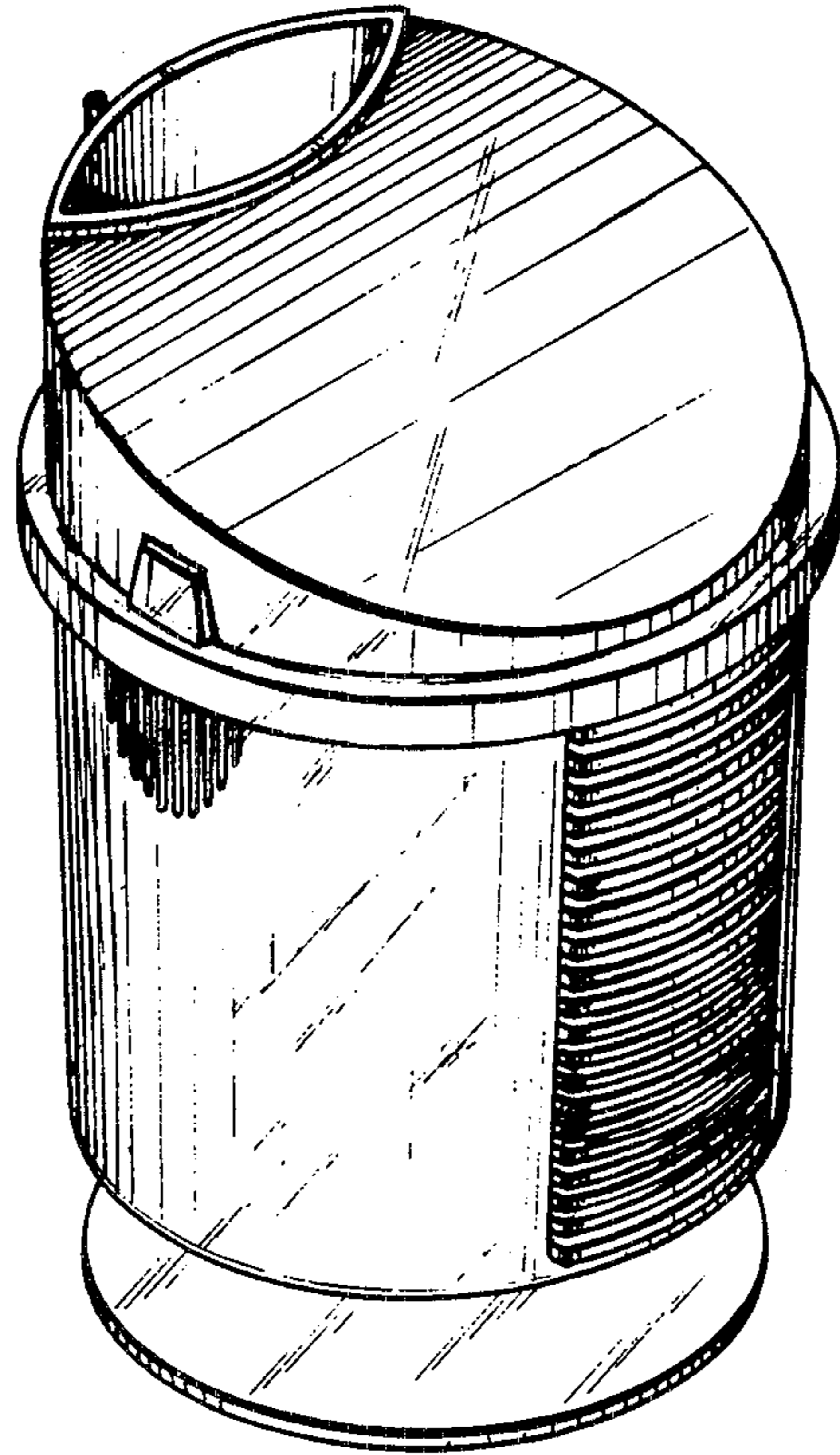

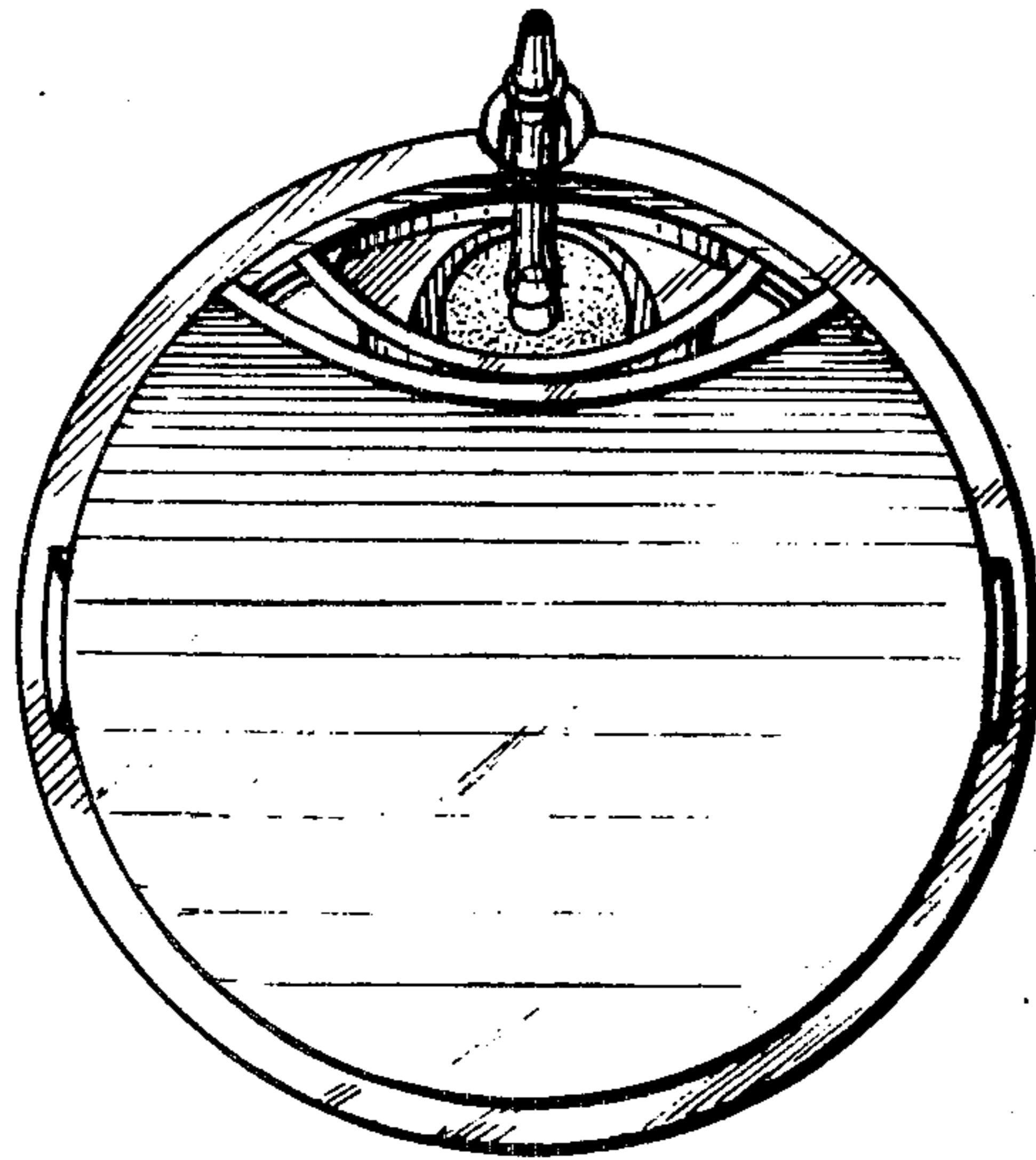

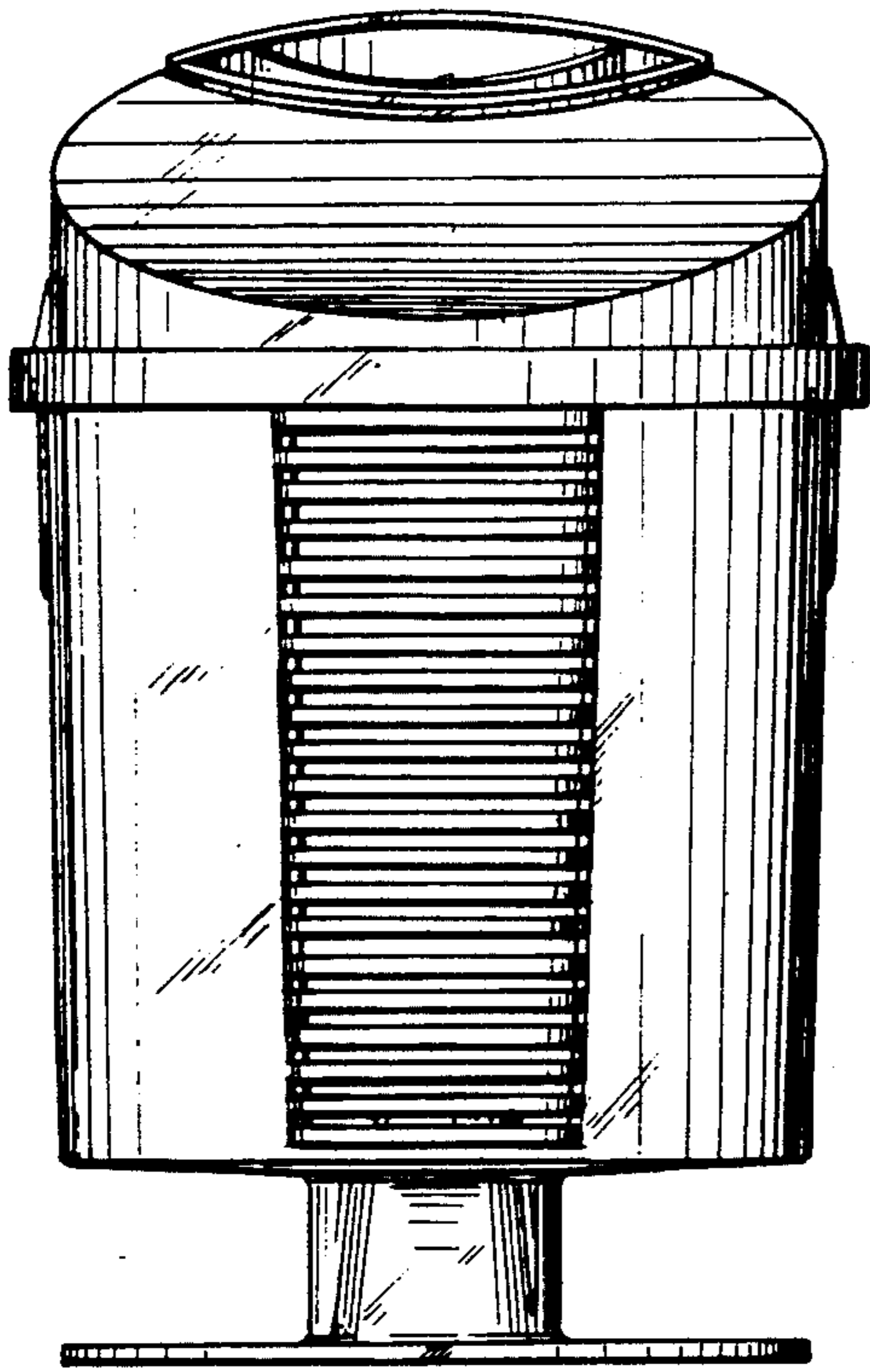

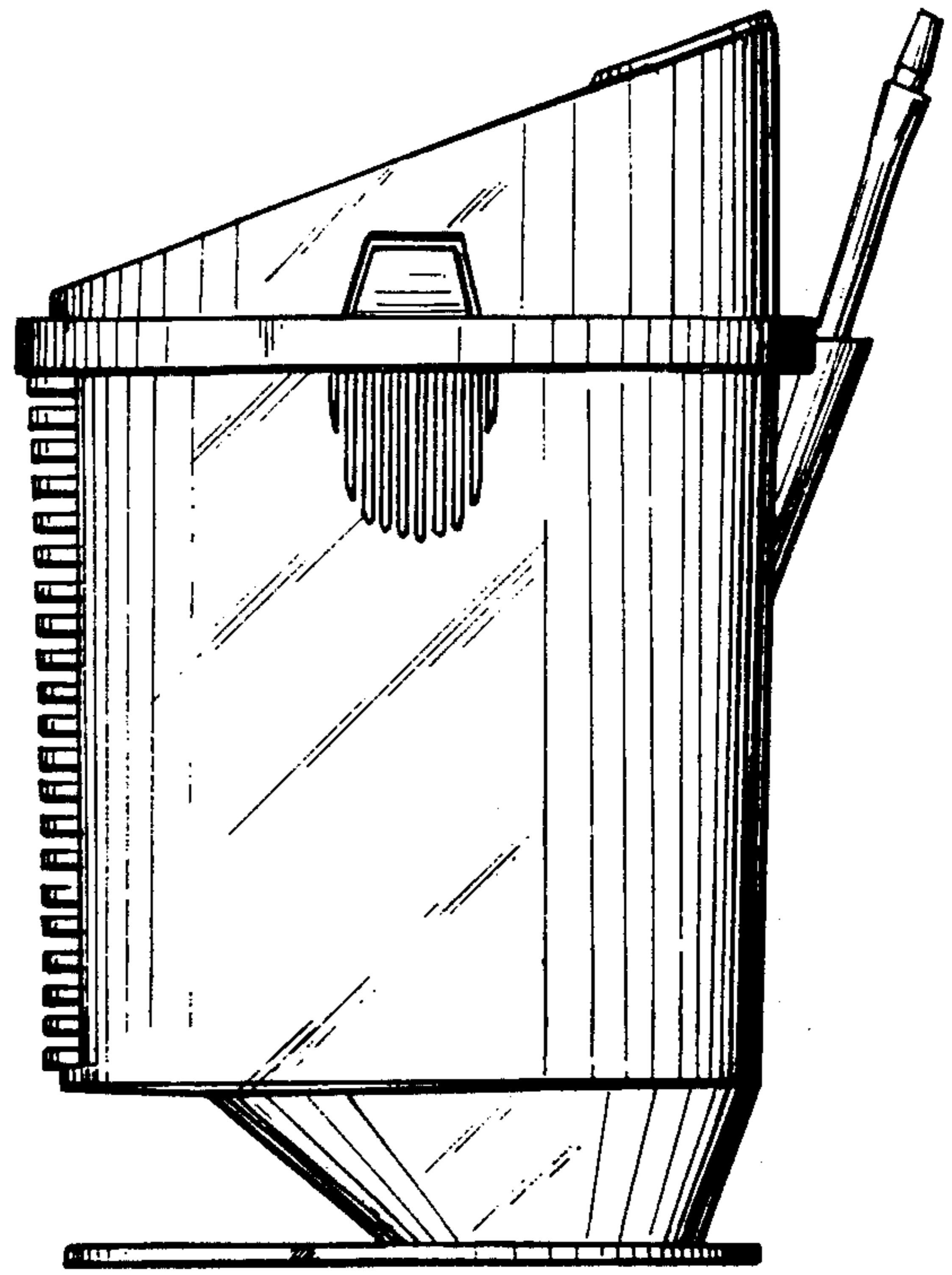

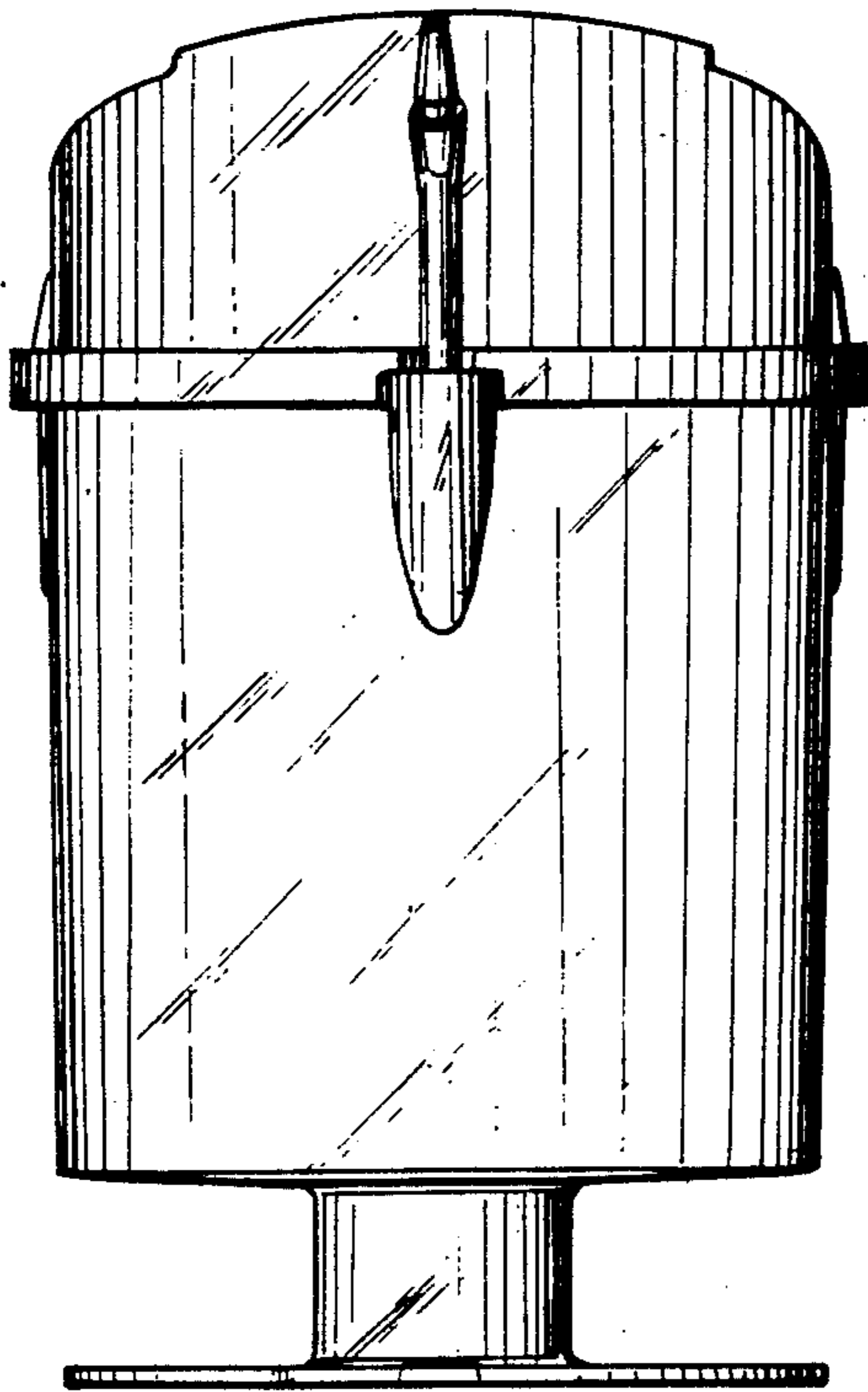

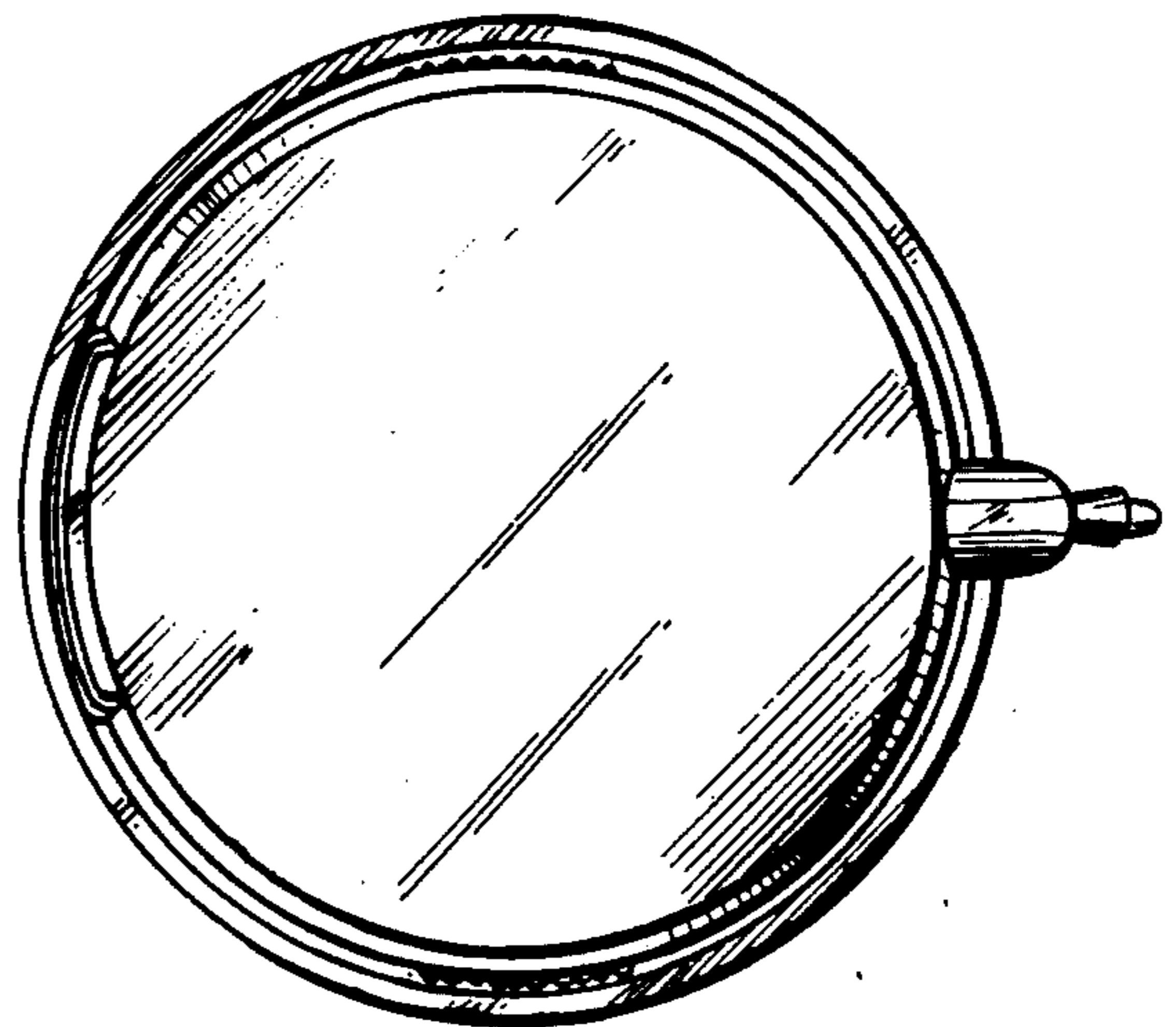

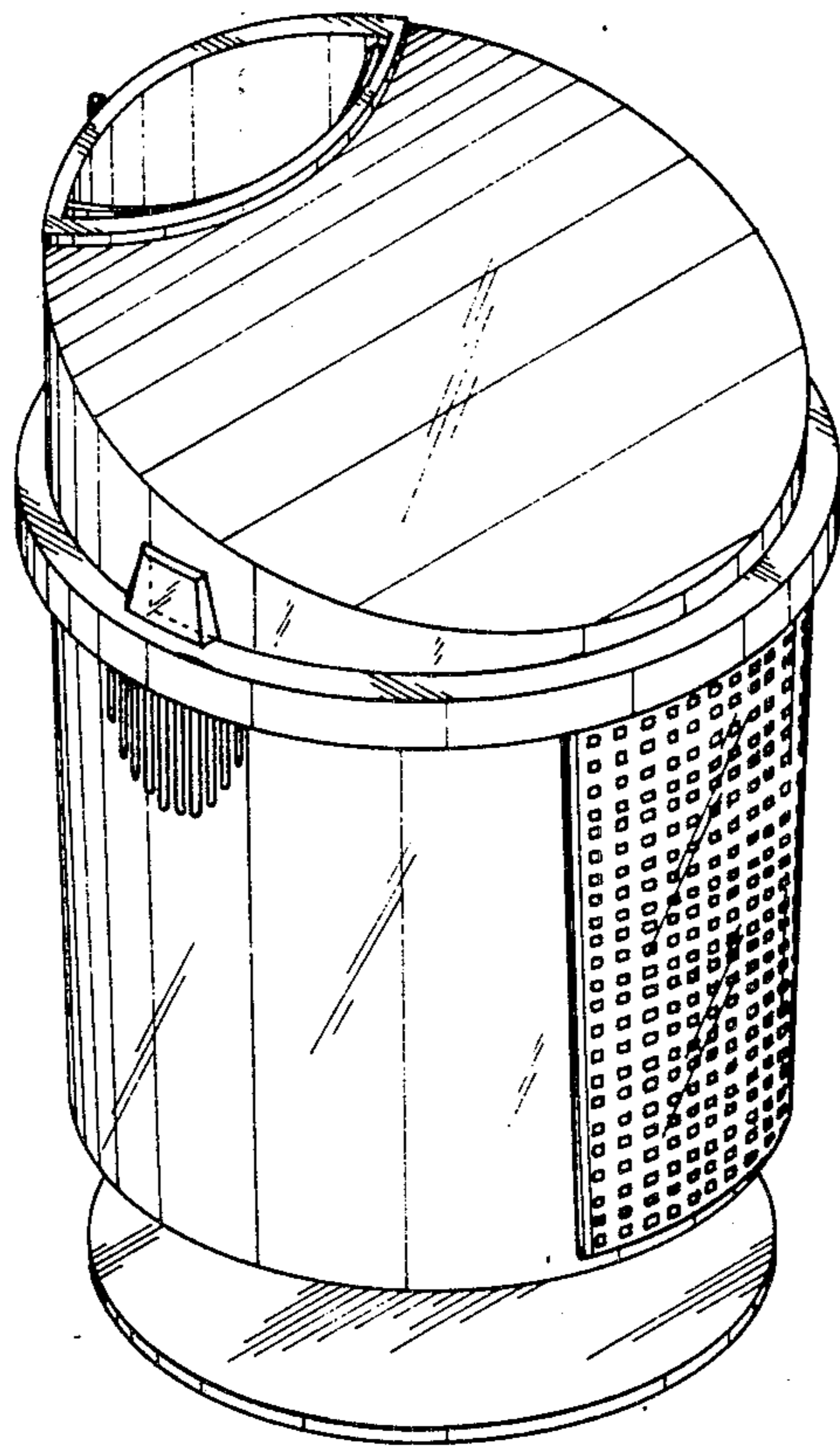
