DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a front perspective view of a chair embodying my new design;

FIG. 2 is a side elevational view thereof at a reduced scale;

FIG. 3 is a top plan view thereof at the same scale as FIG. 1;

FIG. 4 is a front elevational view thereof at a reduced scale;

FIG. 5 is a rear elevational view thereof at a reduced scale;

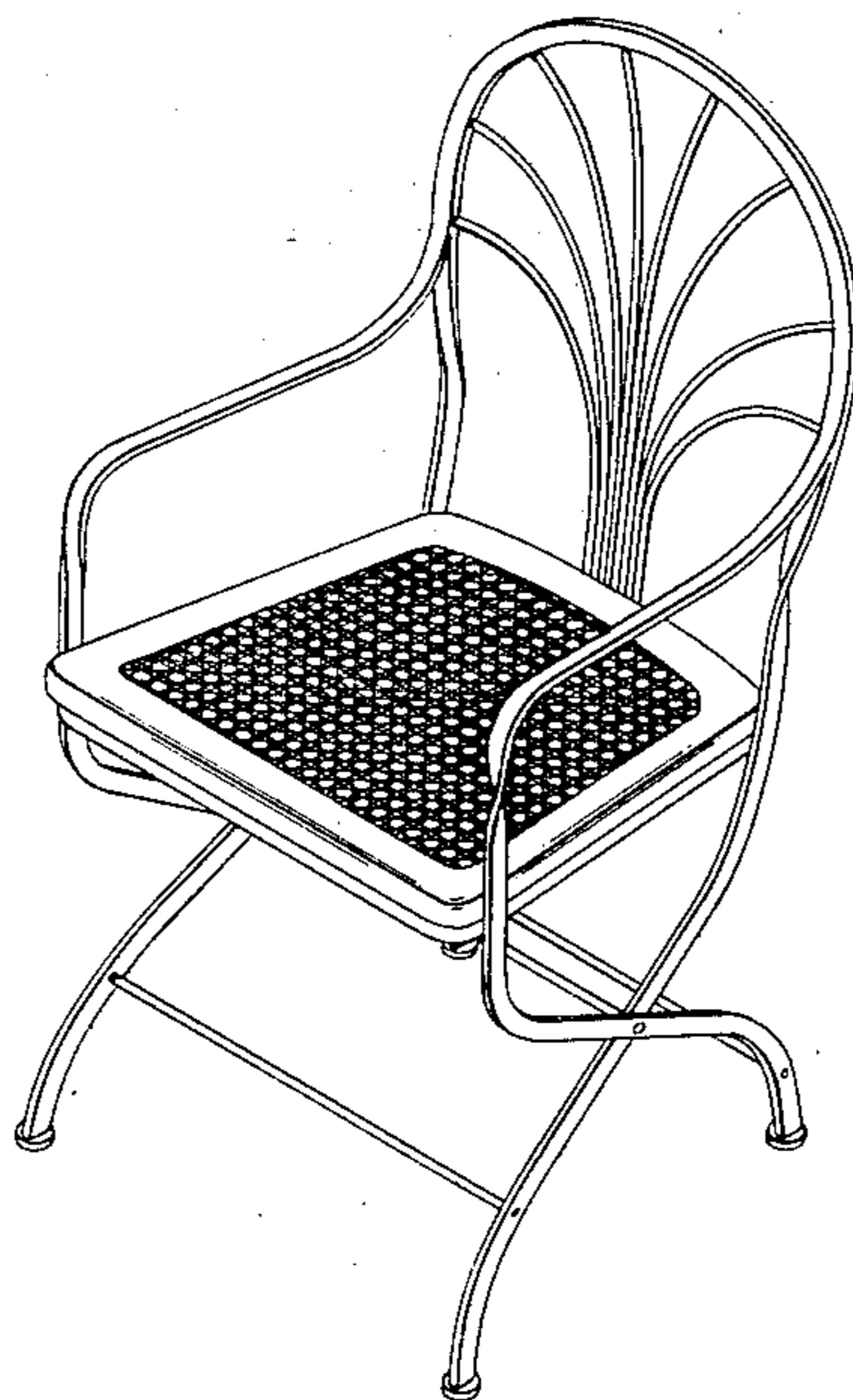
FIG. 6 is a front perspective view of a second embodiment of the chair embodying my new design;

FIG. 10 is a rear elevational view thereof at a reduced scale.



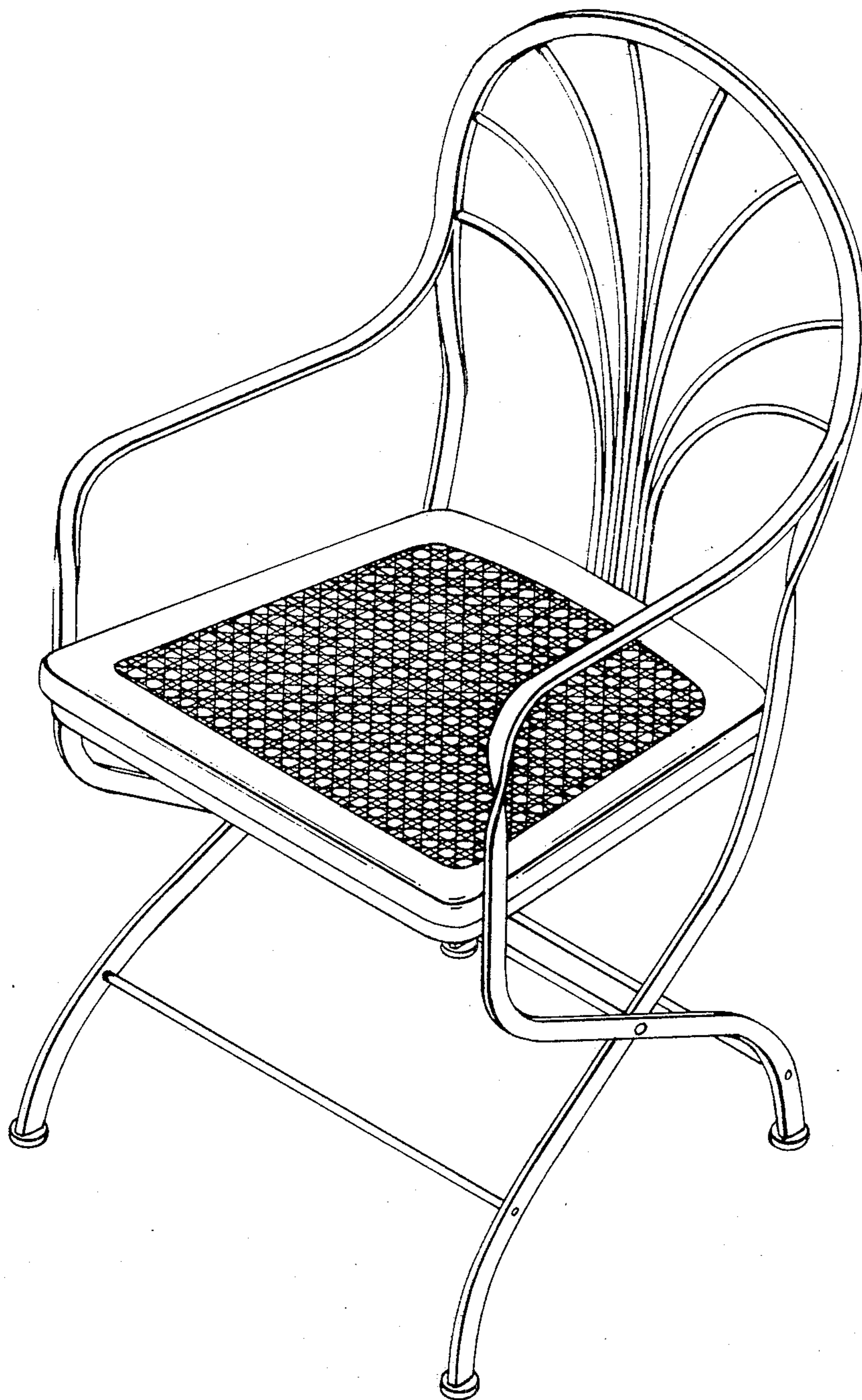

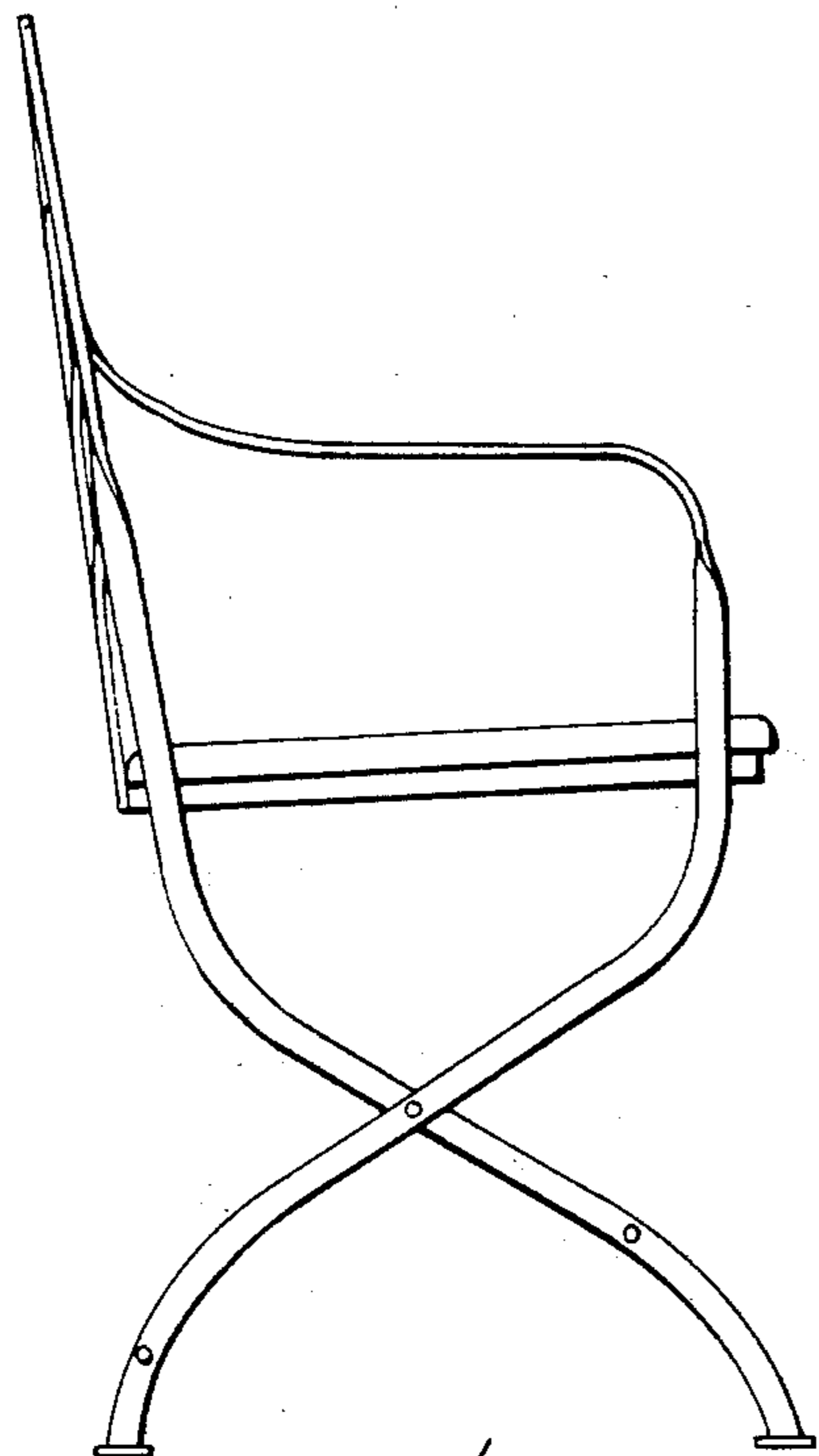

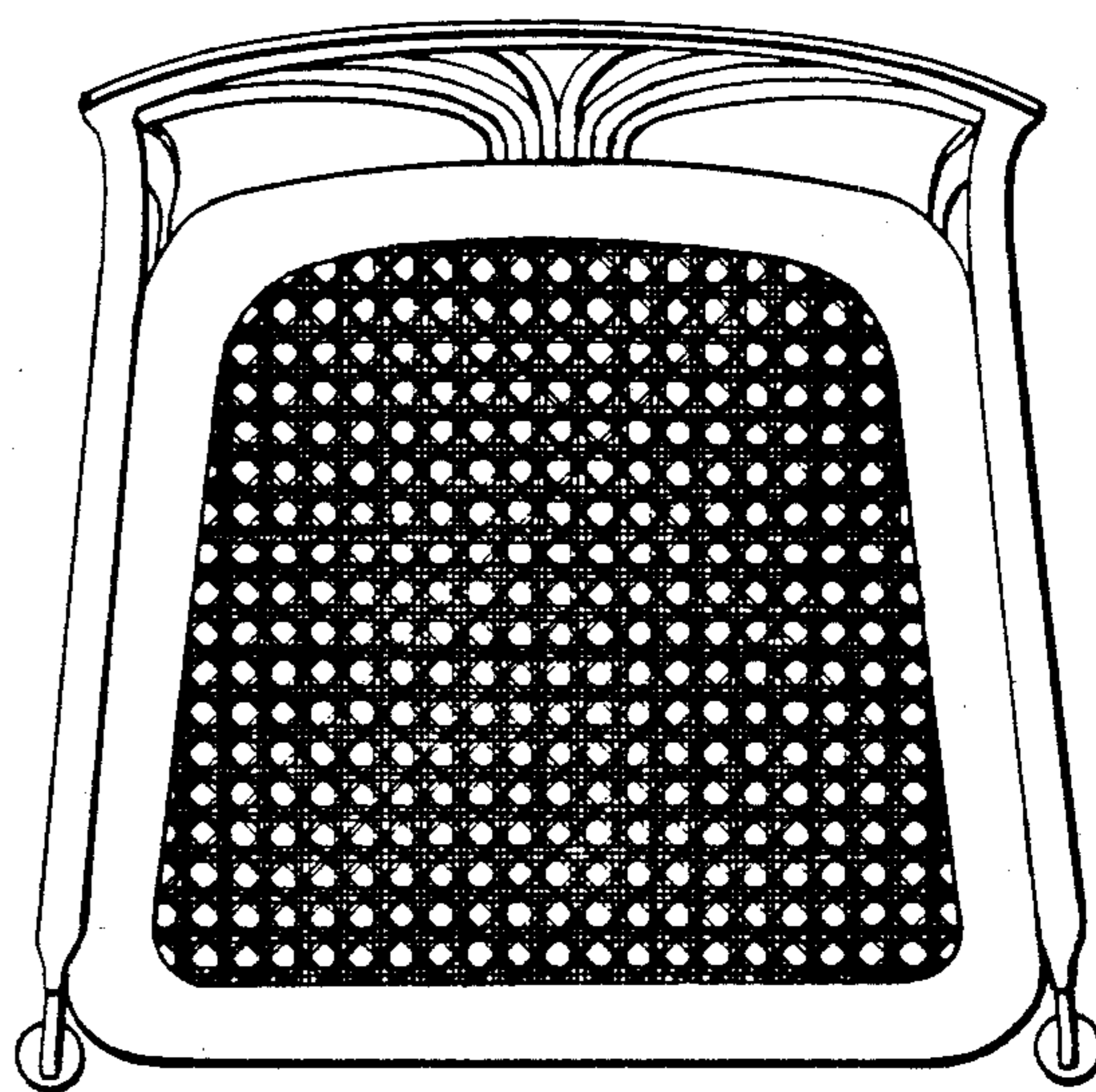

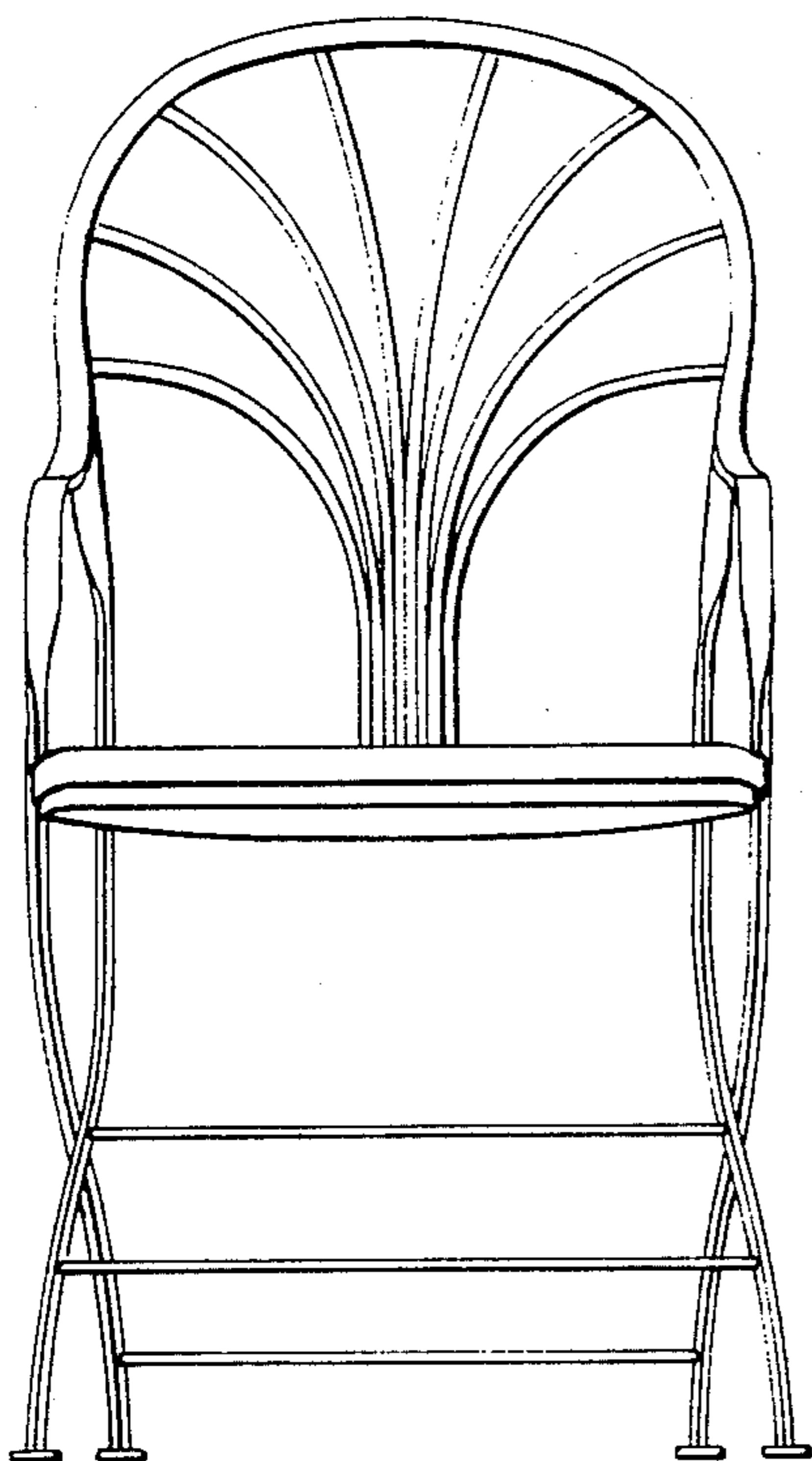

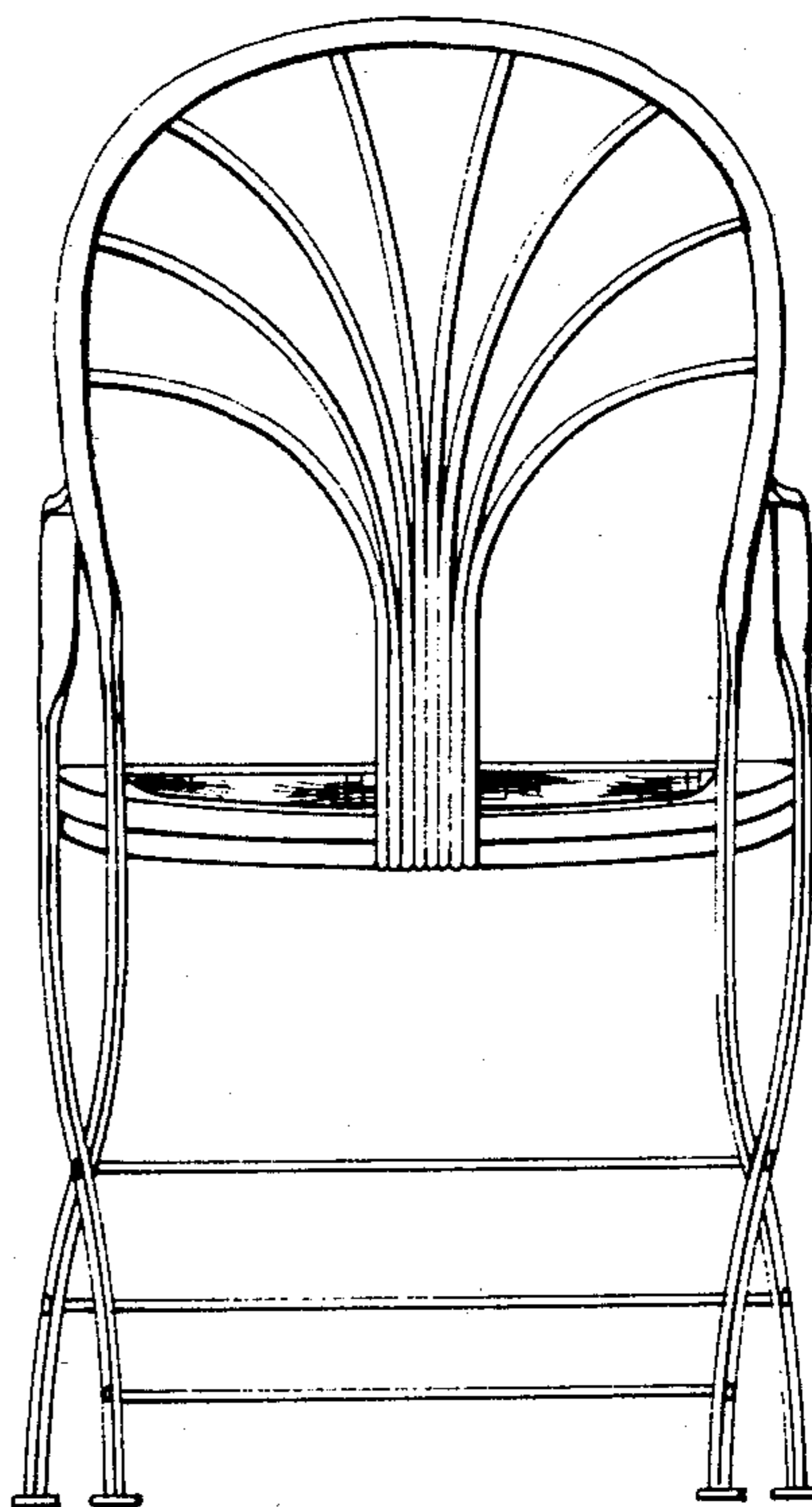

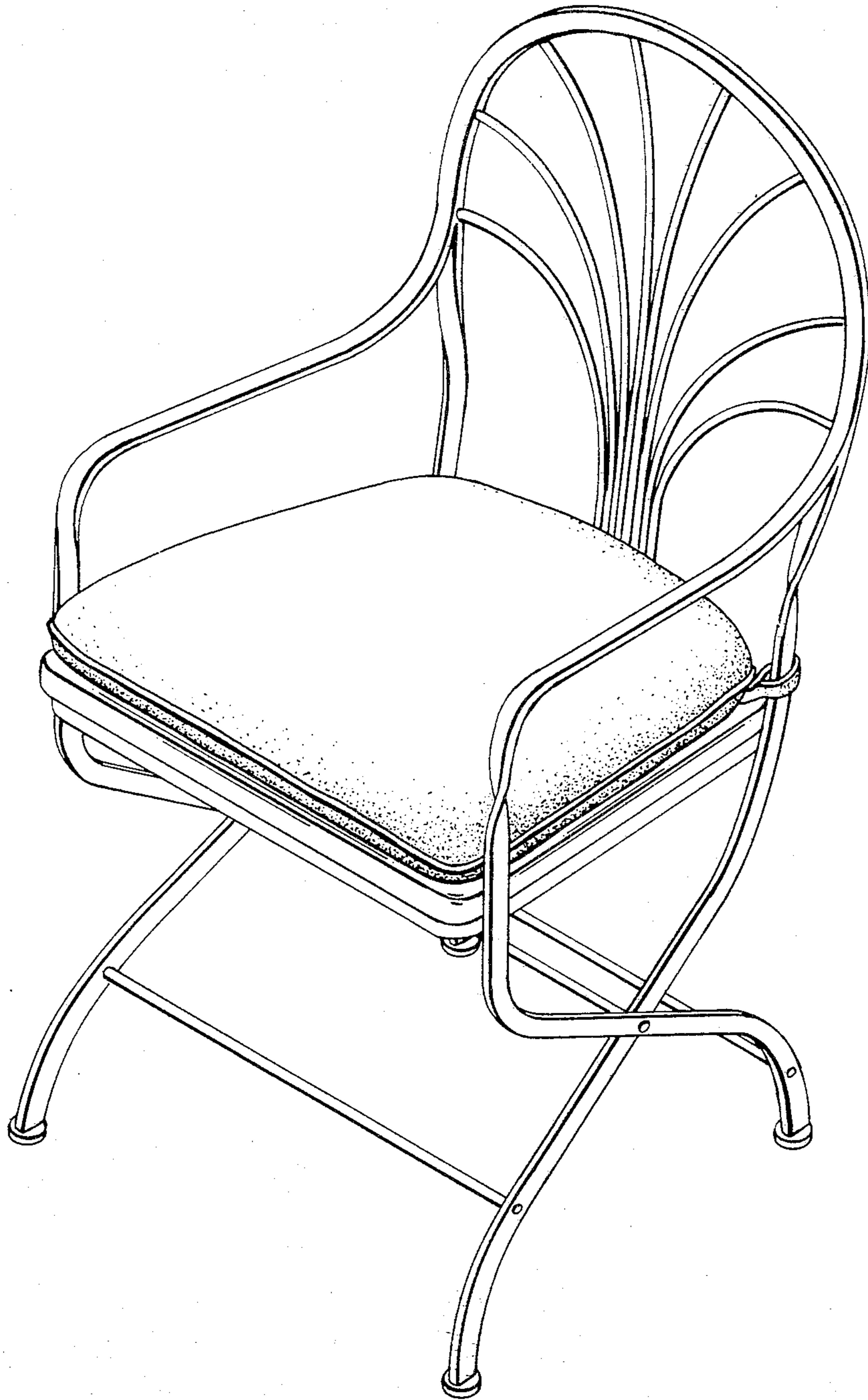

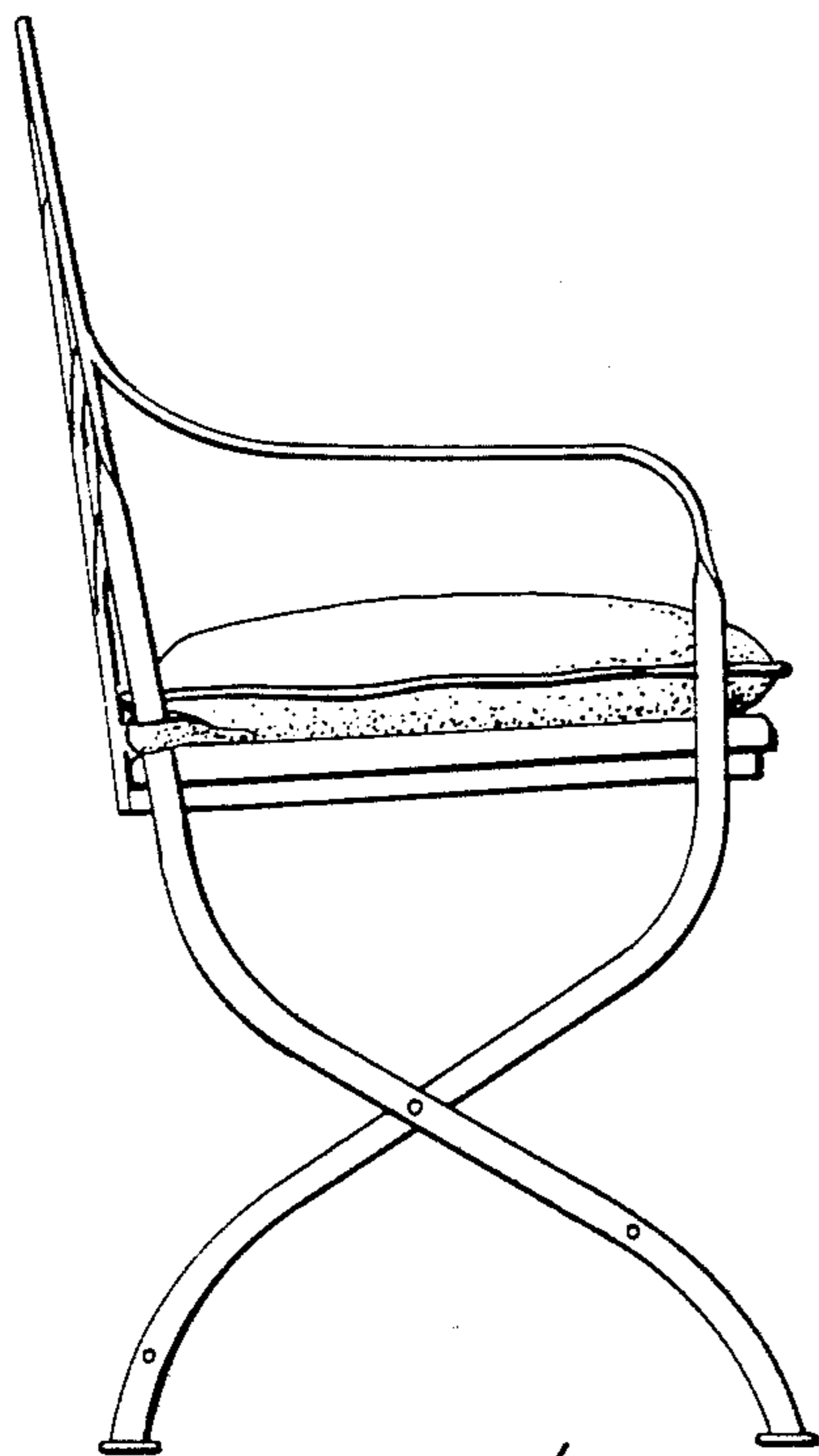

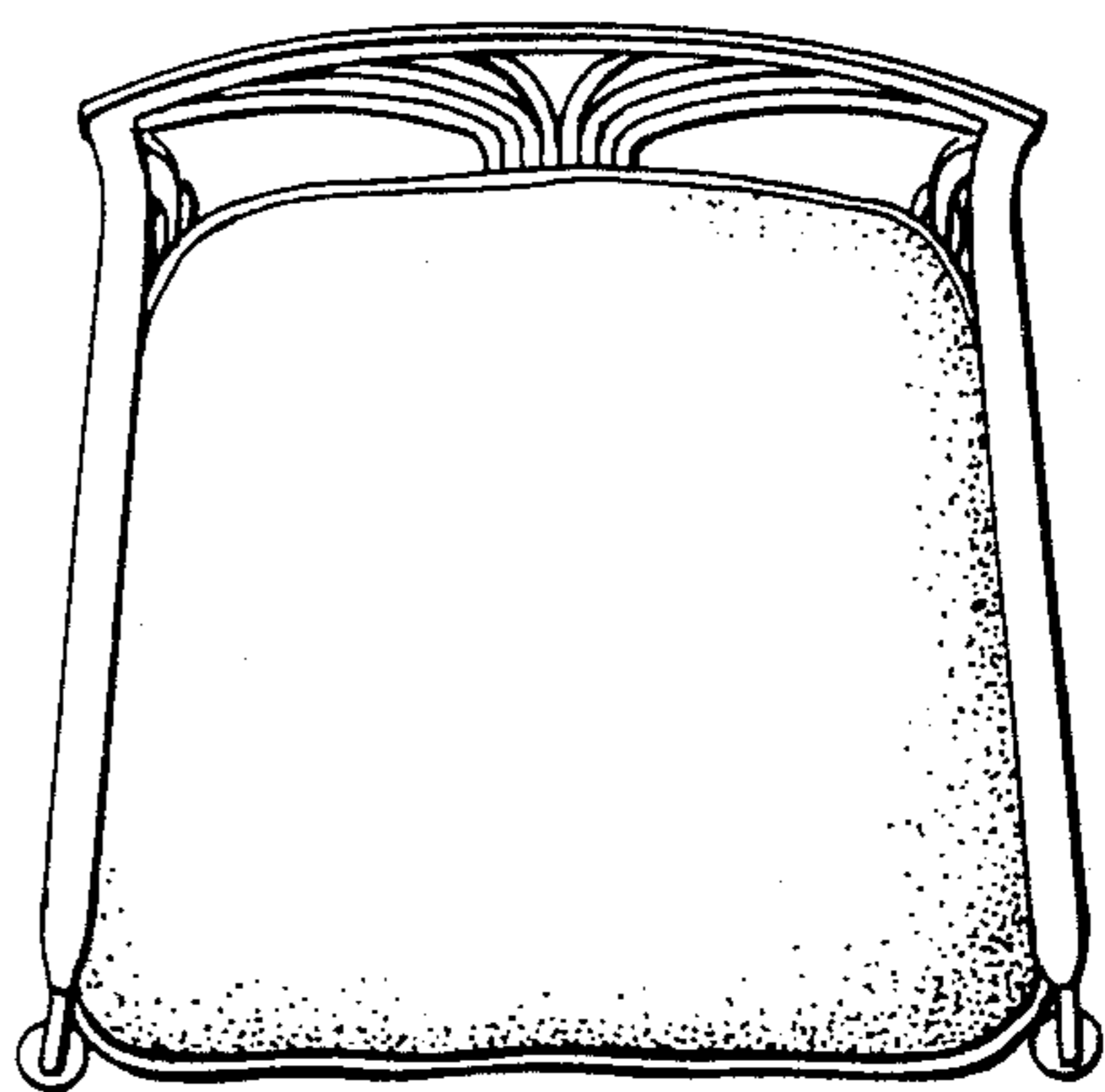

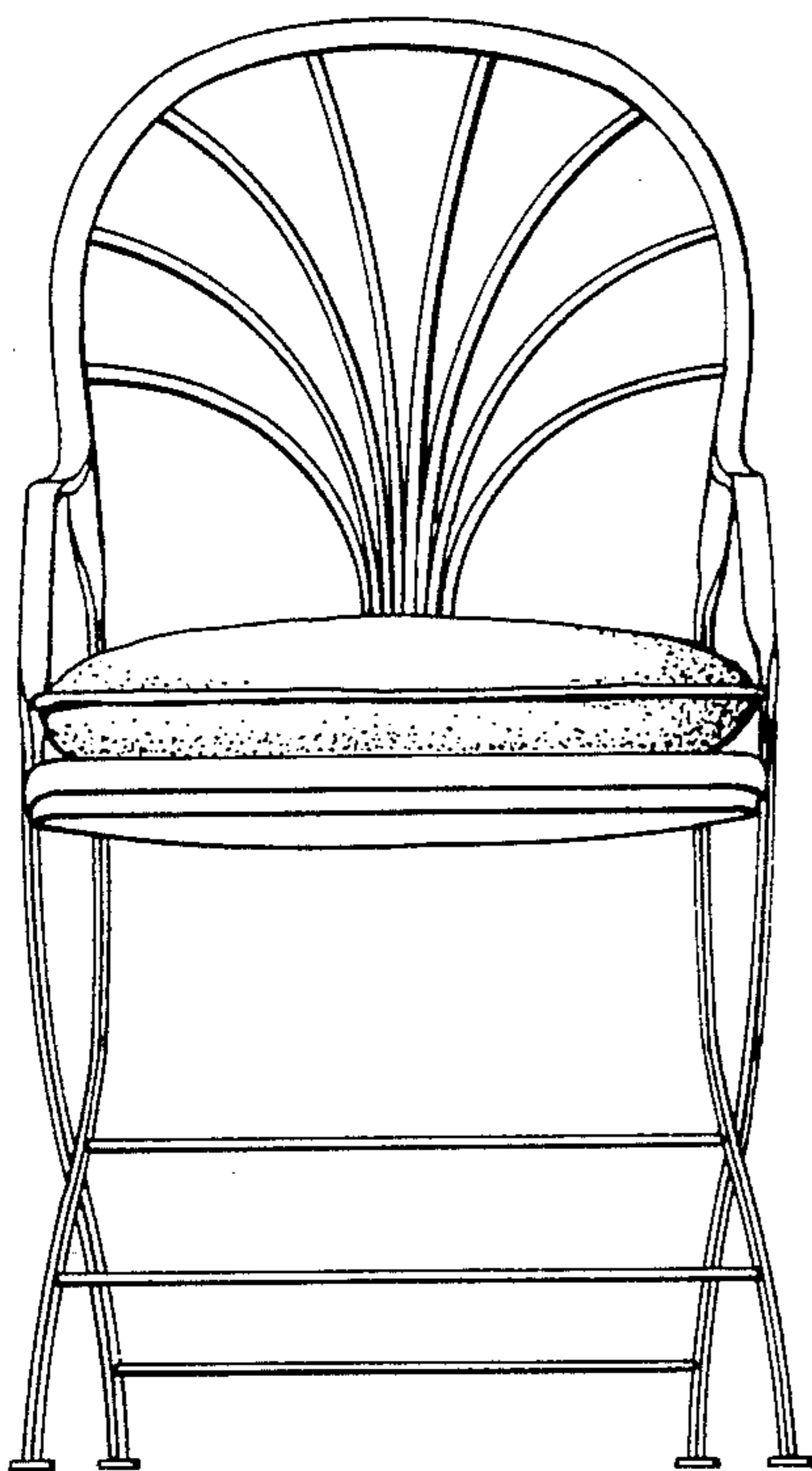

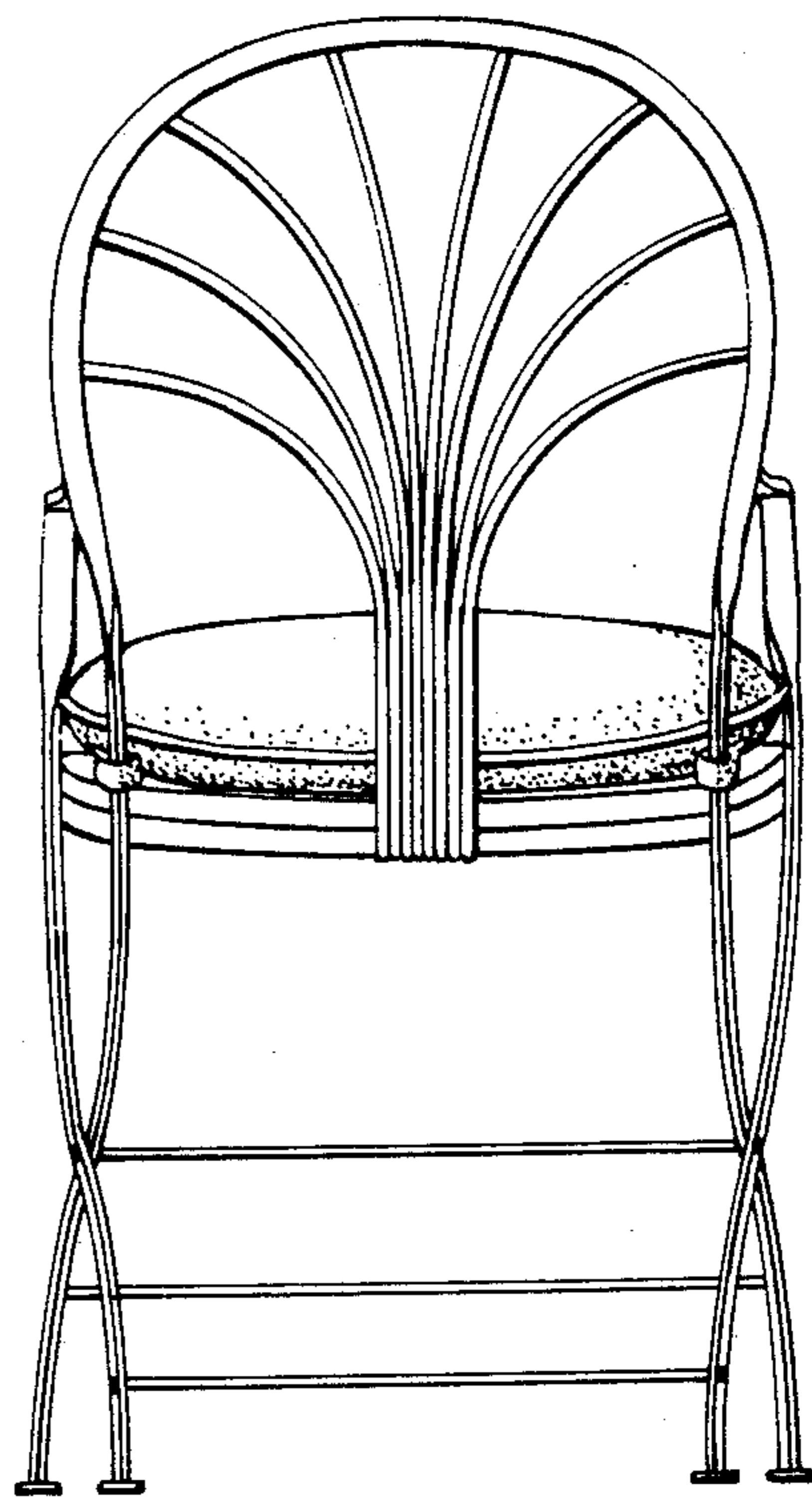
