The ornamental design for a goblet or similar article, substantially as shown and described.

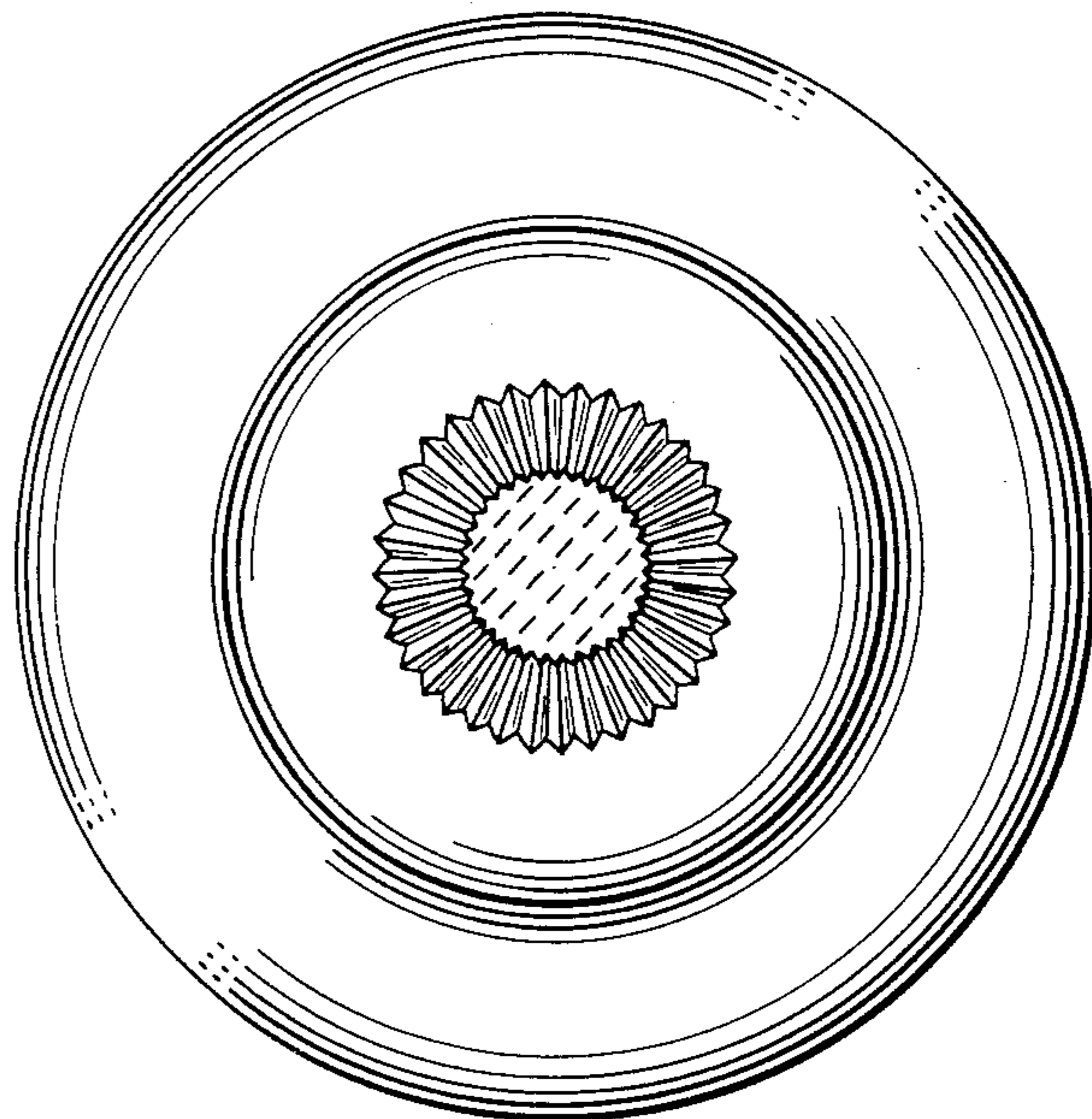
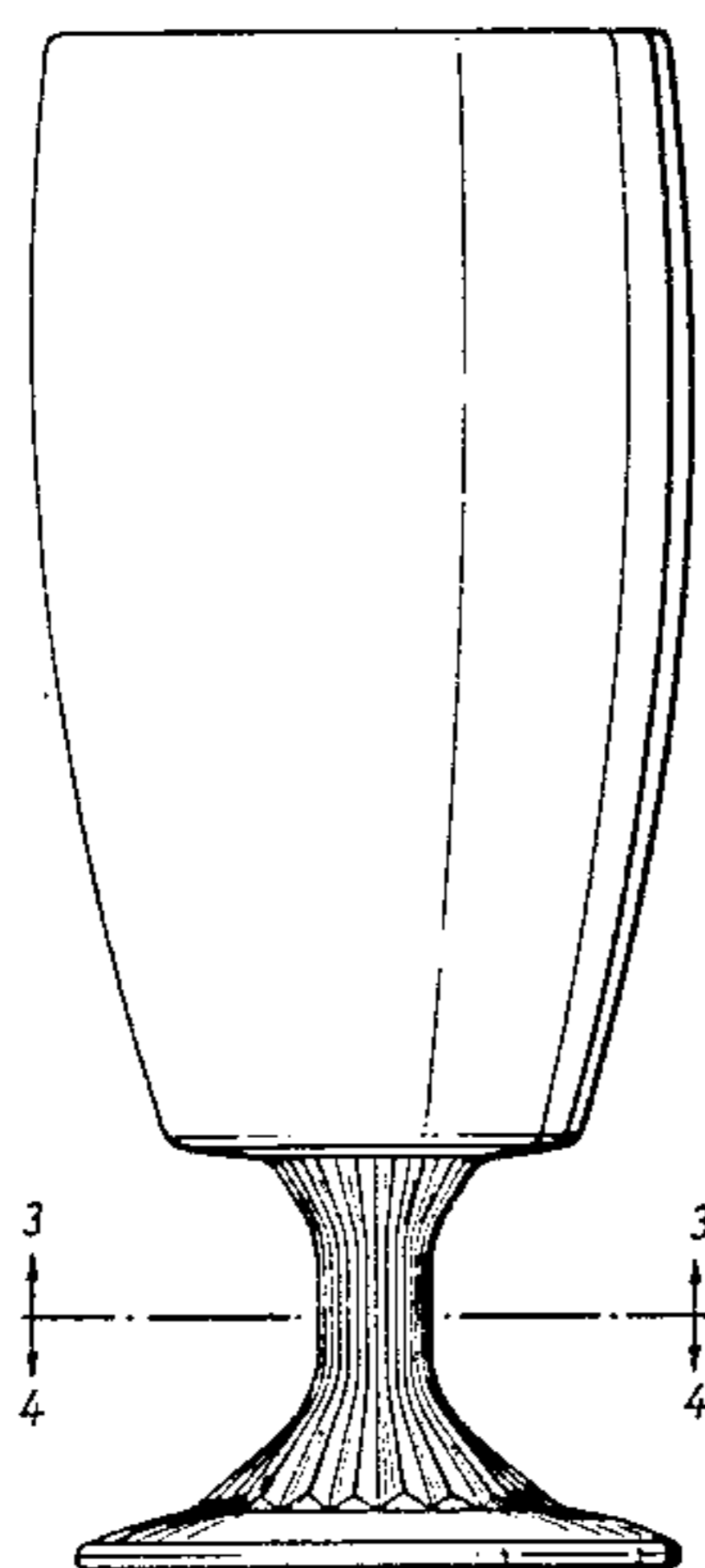
DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a side elevational view of a goblet or similar article showing my new design, the bottom of the goblet being flat and unornamented;

FIG. 2 is a top view thereof;

FIG. 3 is a sectional view on an enlarged scale taken along line 3—3 of FIG. 1; and

FIG. 4 is a sectional view on an enlarged scale taken along line 4—4 of FIG. 1.



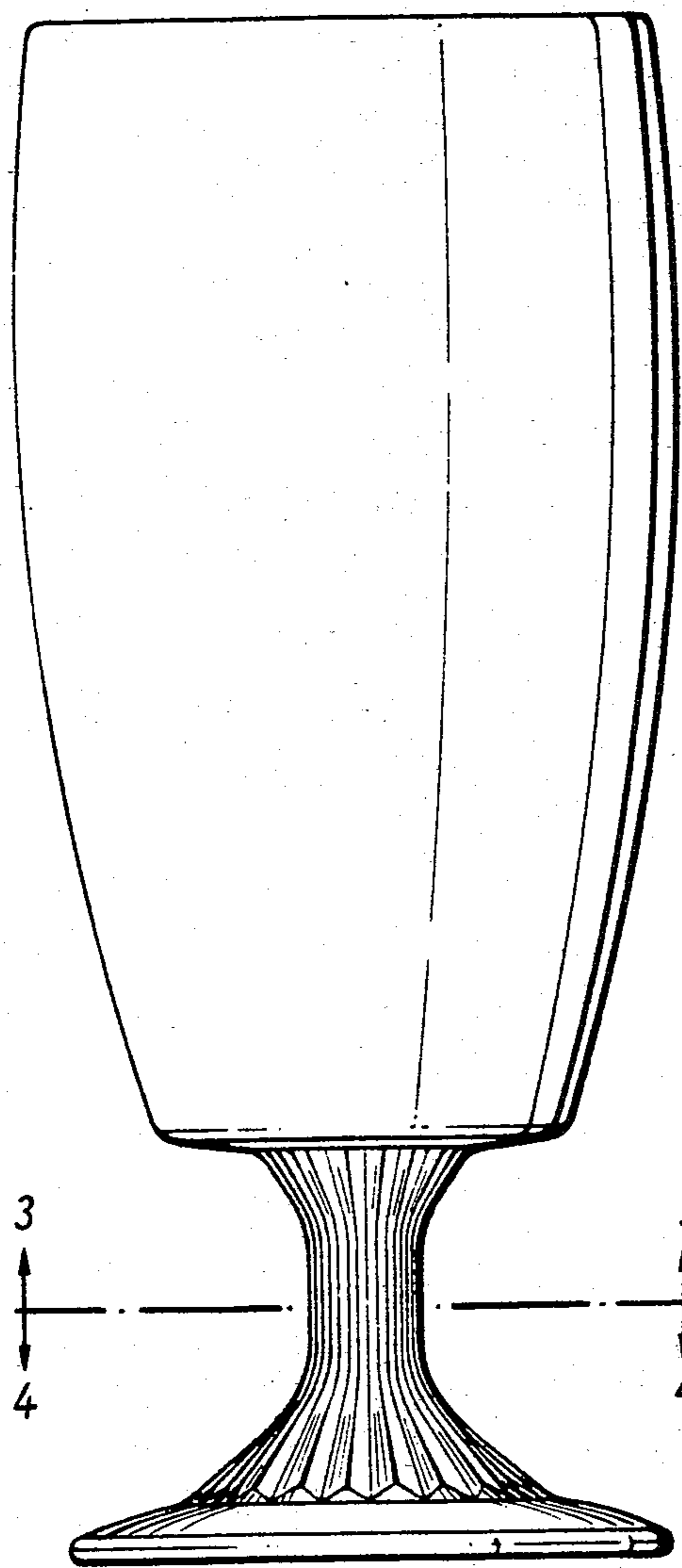

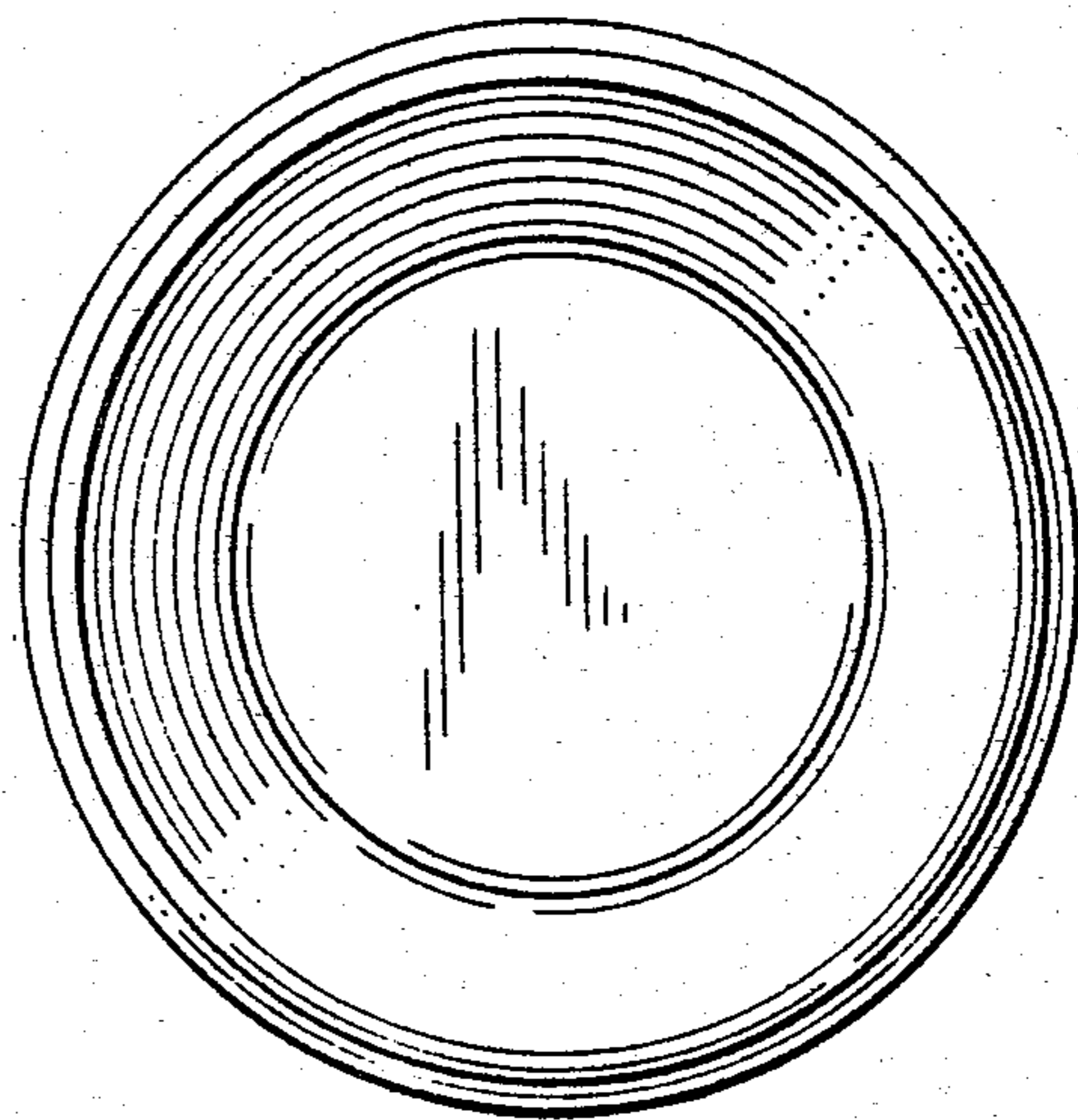

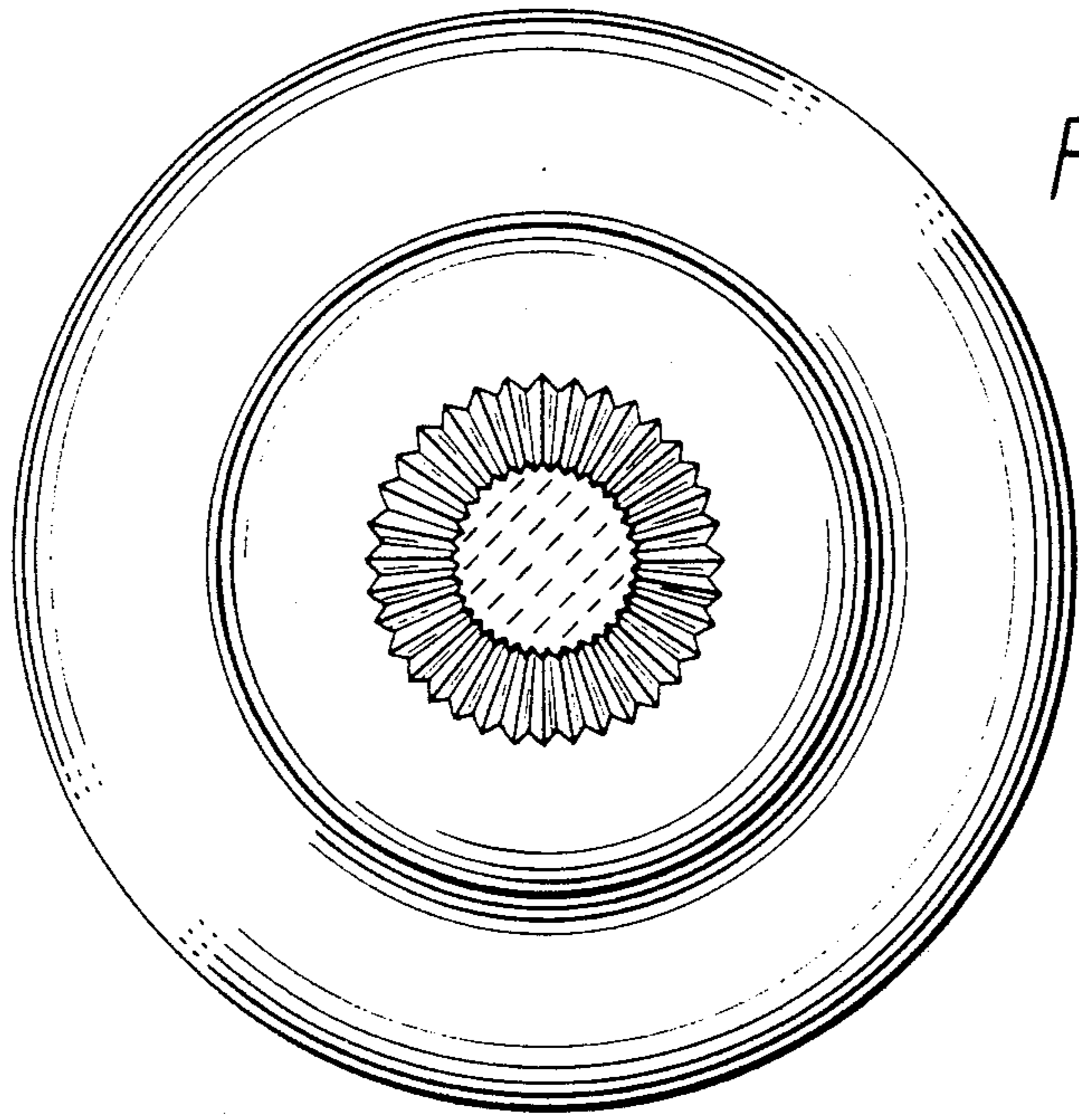

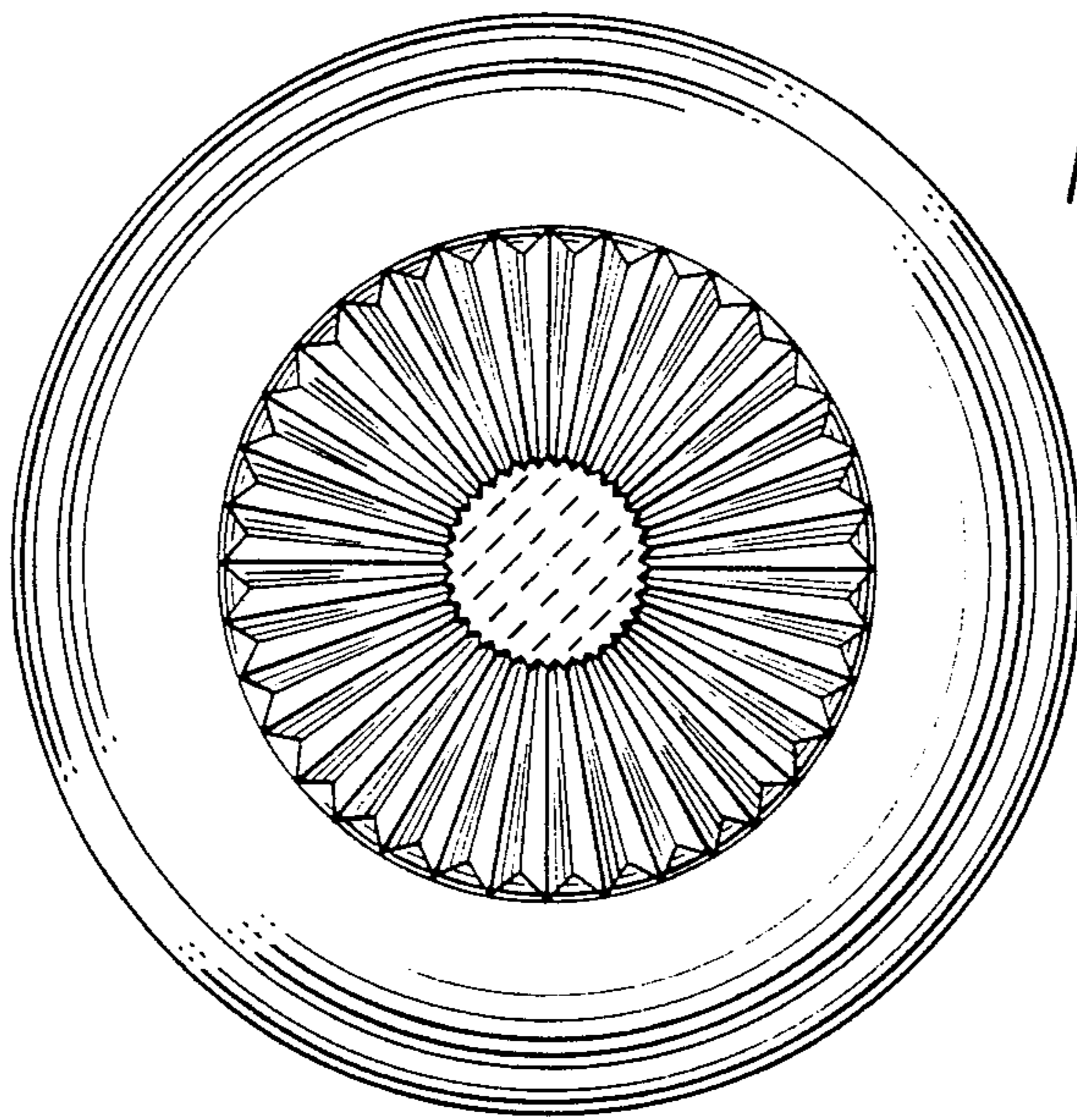
