DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a perspective view of a telephone booth showing my new design with the pivotable seat in position for use;

FIG. 2 is a perspective view thereof with the pivotable seat in retracted condition it being understood that the broken lines depicting a telephone are for illustrative purposes only;

FIG. 3 is a top plan view thereof;

FIG. 4 is a front elevation view thereof; and

FIG. 5 is a left side elevation view thereof;

FIG. 6 is a right side elevation view thereof; and

FIG. 7 is a rear elevation view thereof.

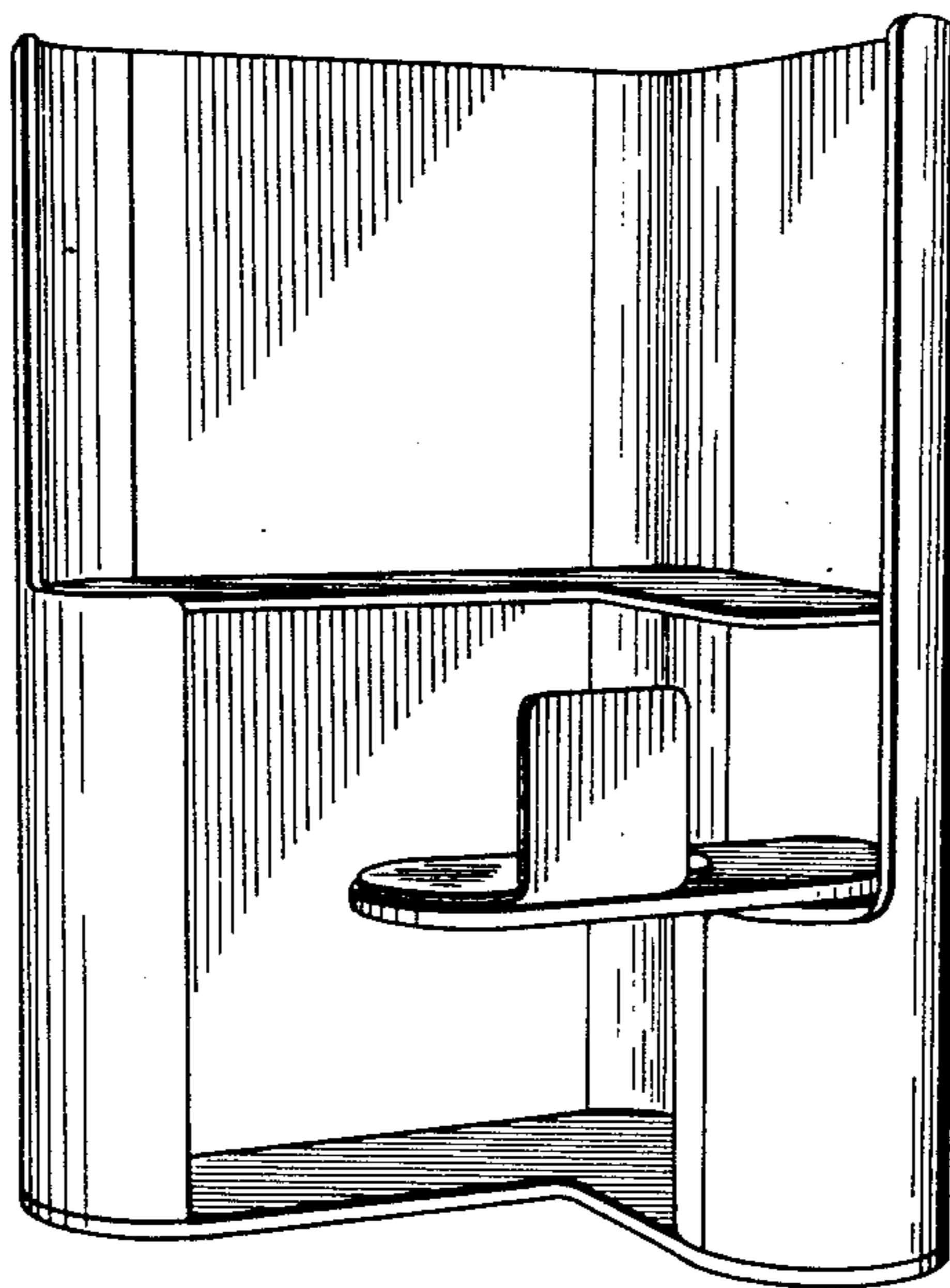

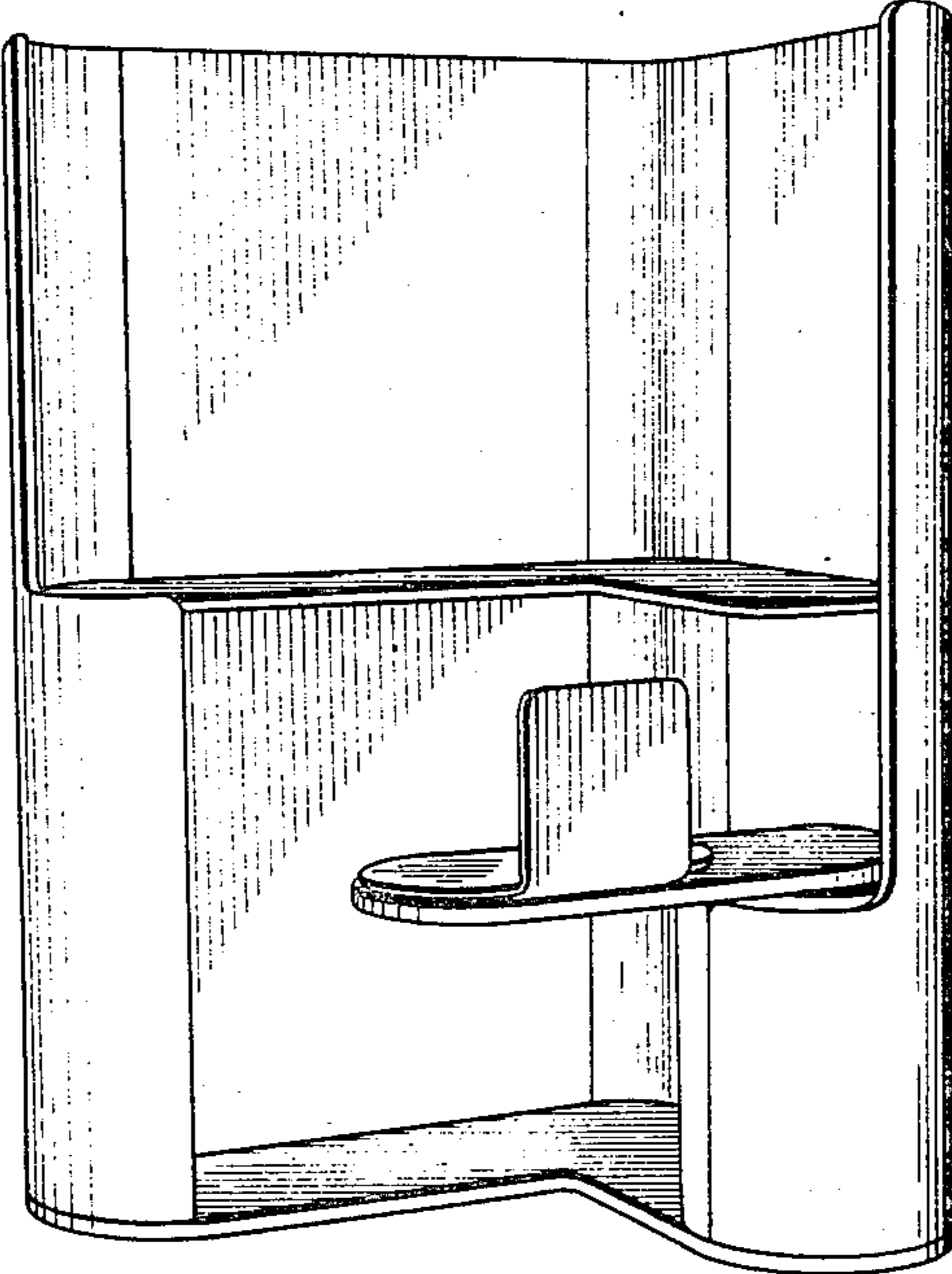
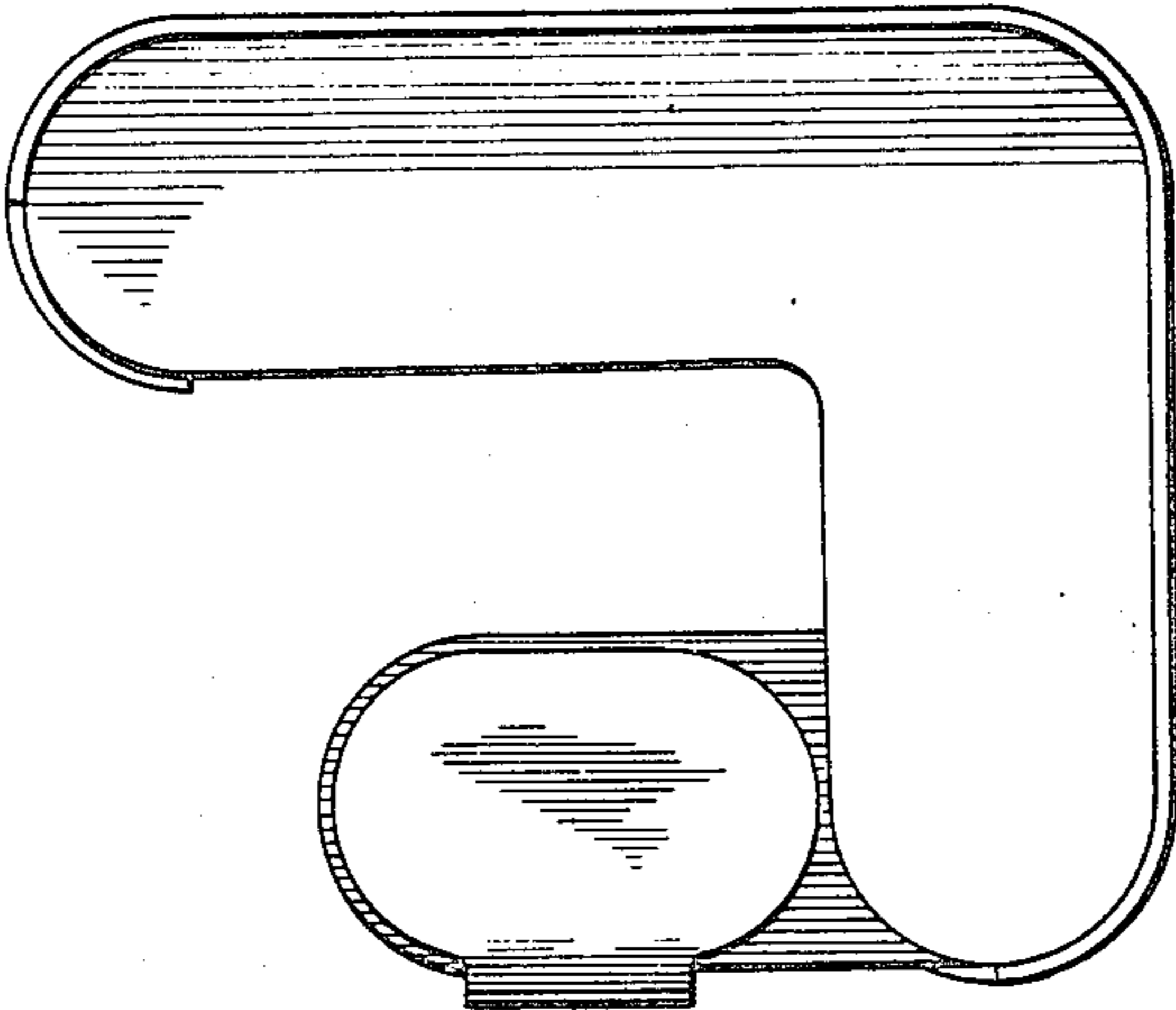

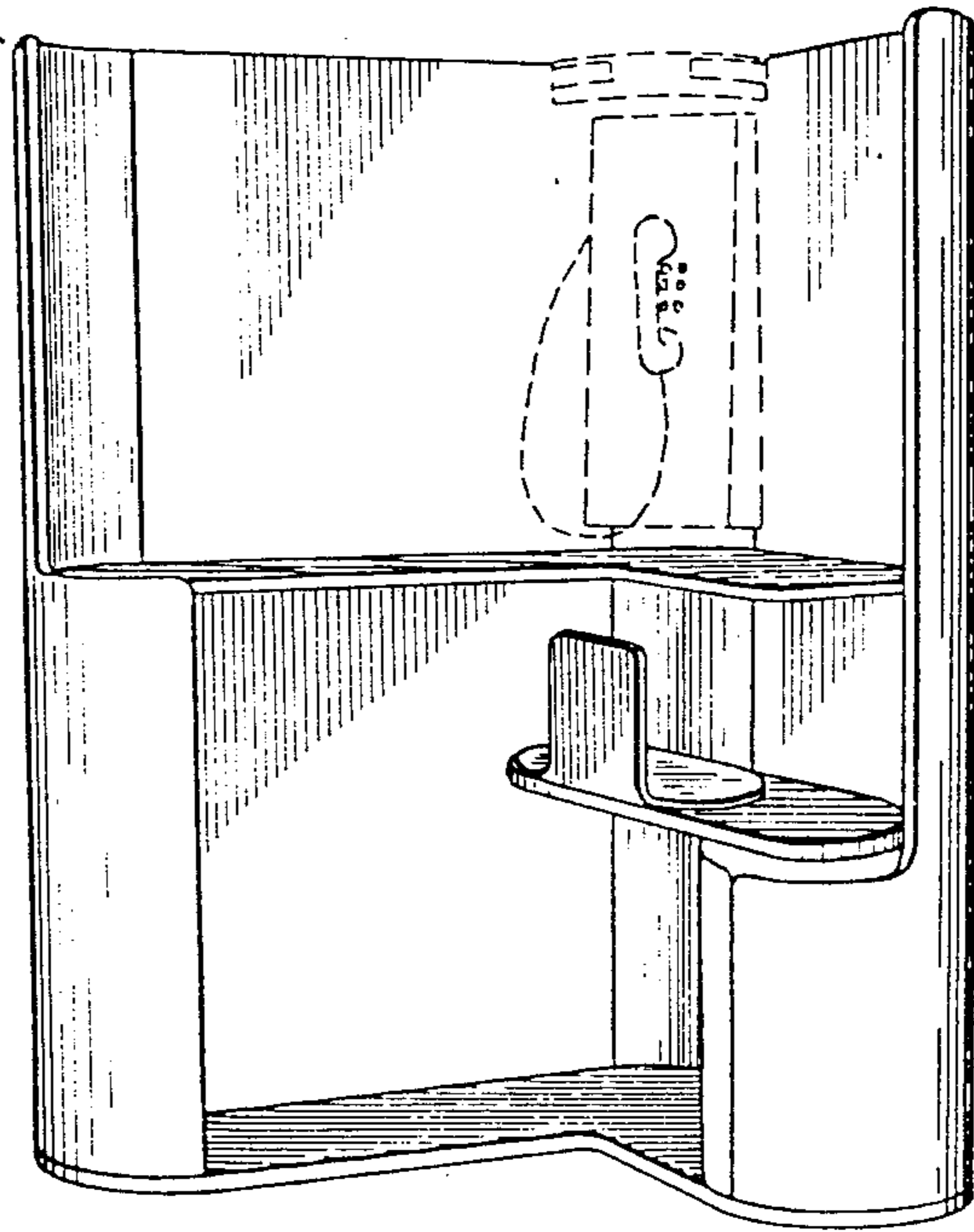

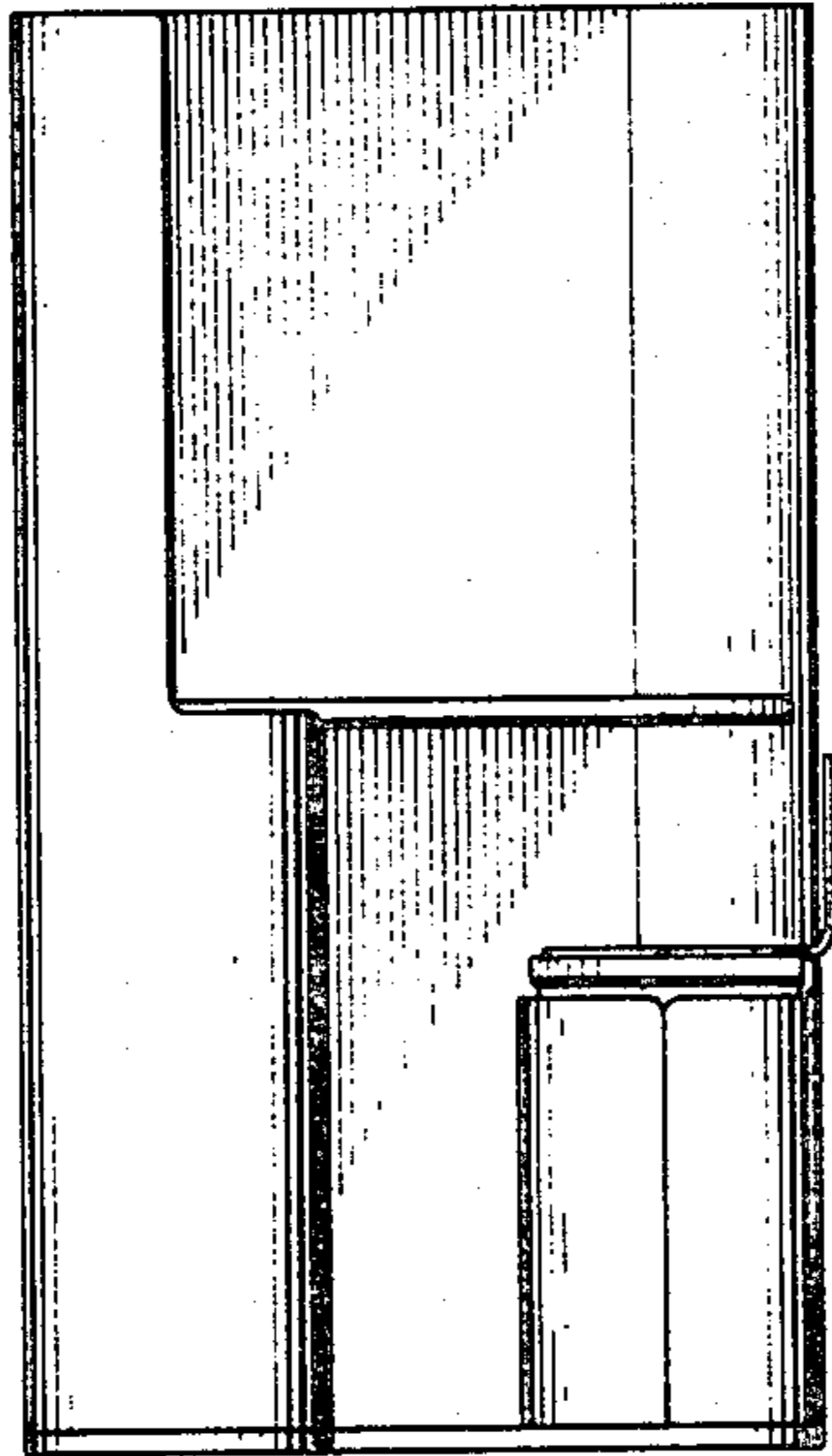

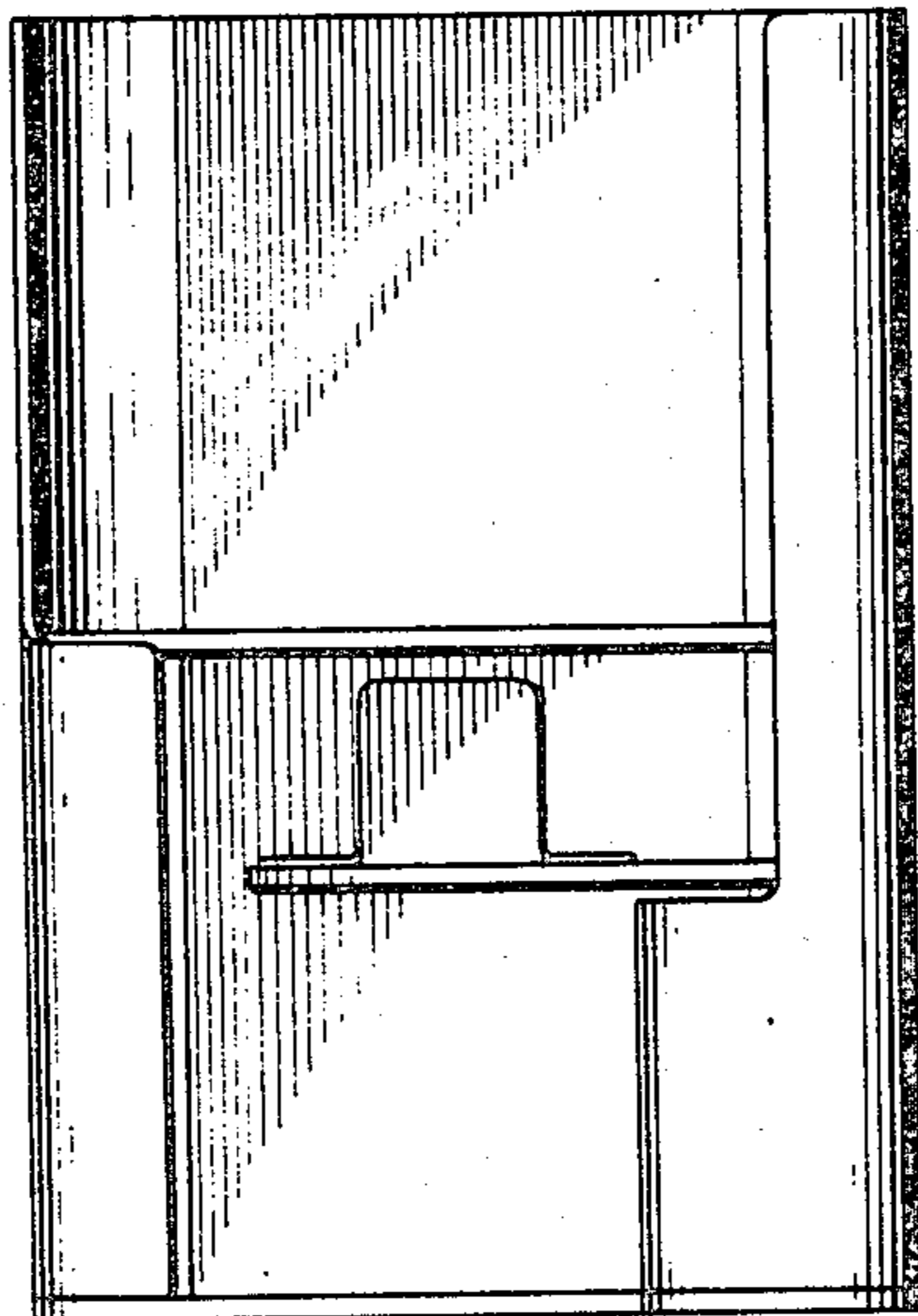

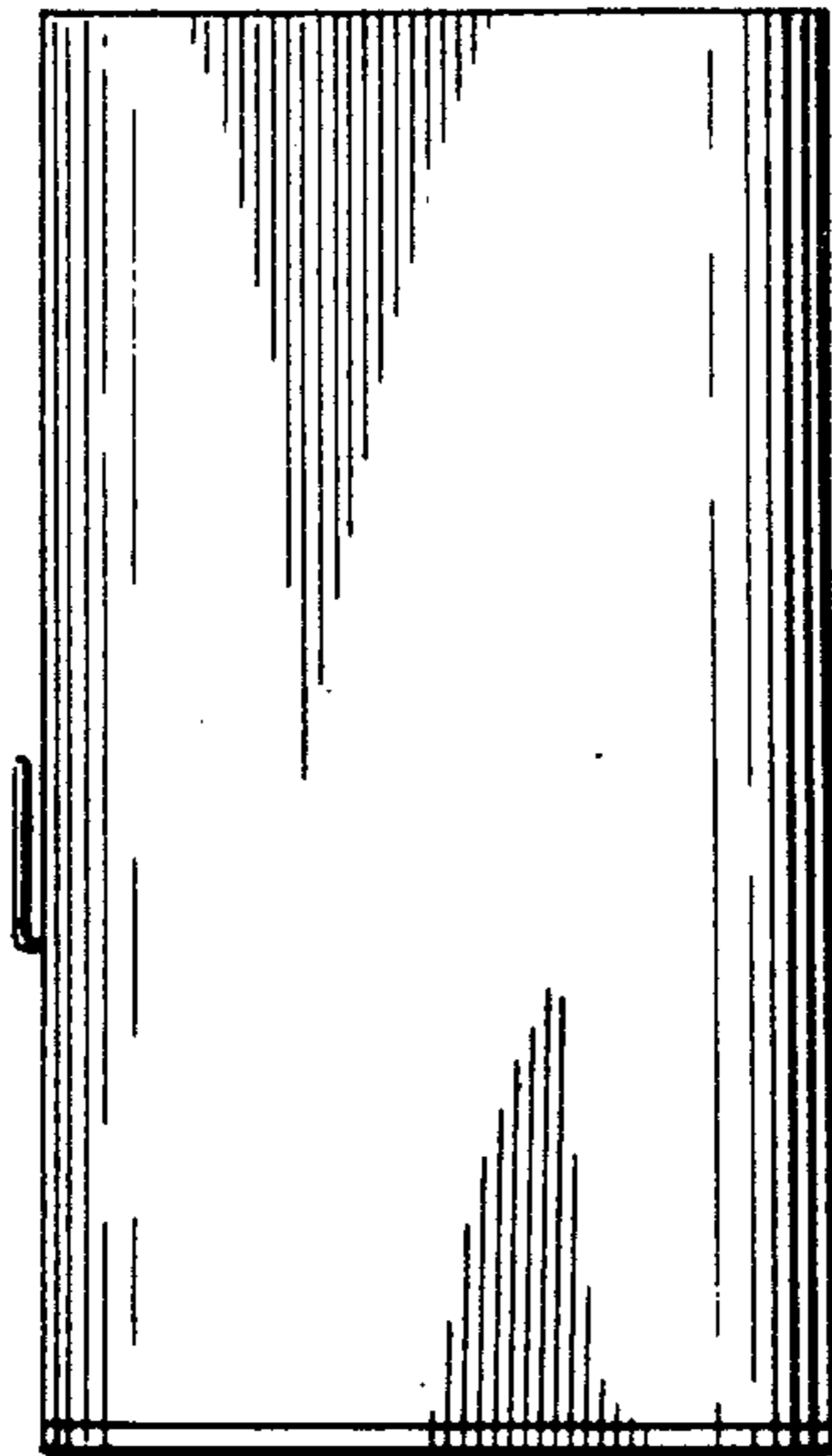

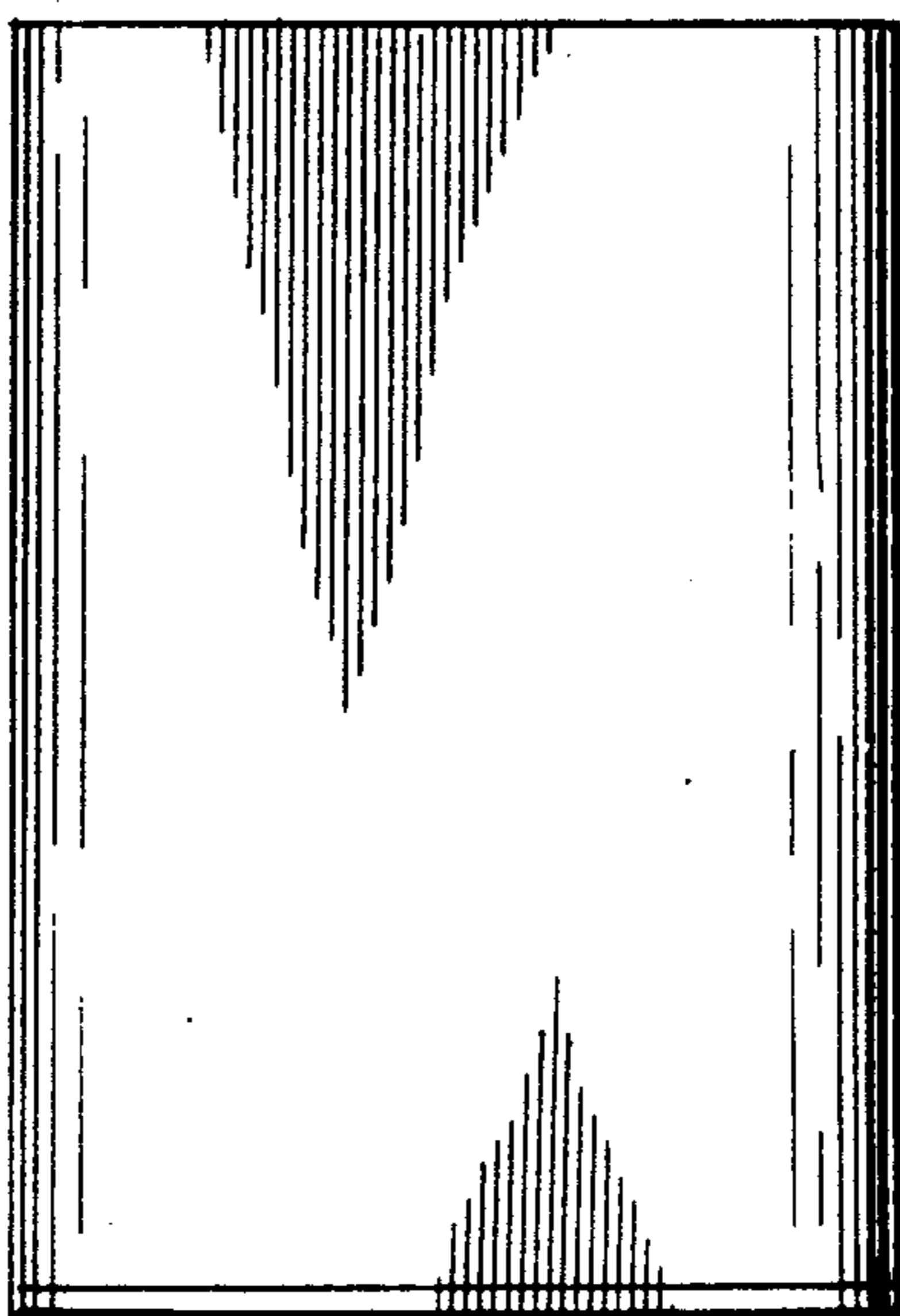
