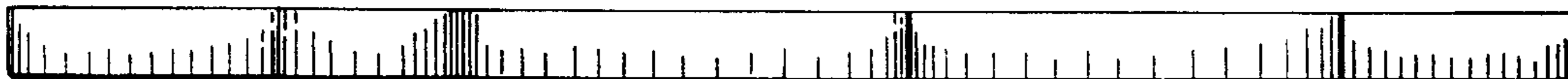

[57] **CLAIM**

The ornamental design for an engraved lottery ticket scraper, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a top plan view of an engraved lottery ticket scraper showing my new design;
FIG. 2 is a front elevational view thereof;
FIG. 3 is a right end view thereof;
FIG. 4 is a left end view thereof; and
FIG. 5 is a bottom plan view thereof.
The rear elevational view not shown is plain.



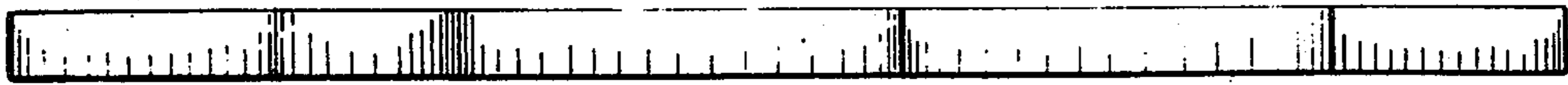

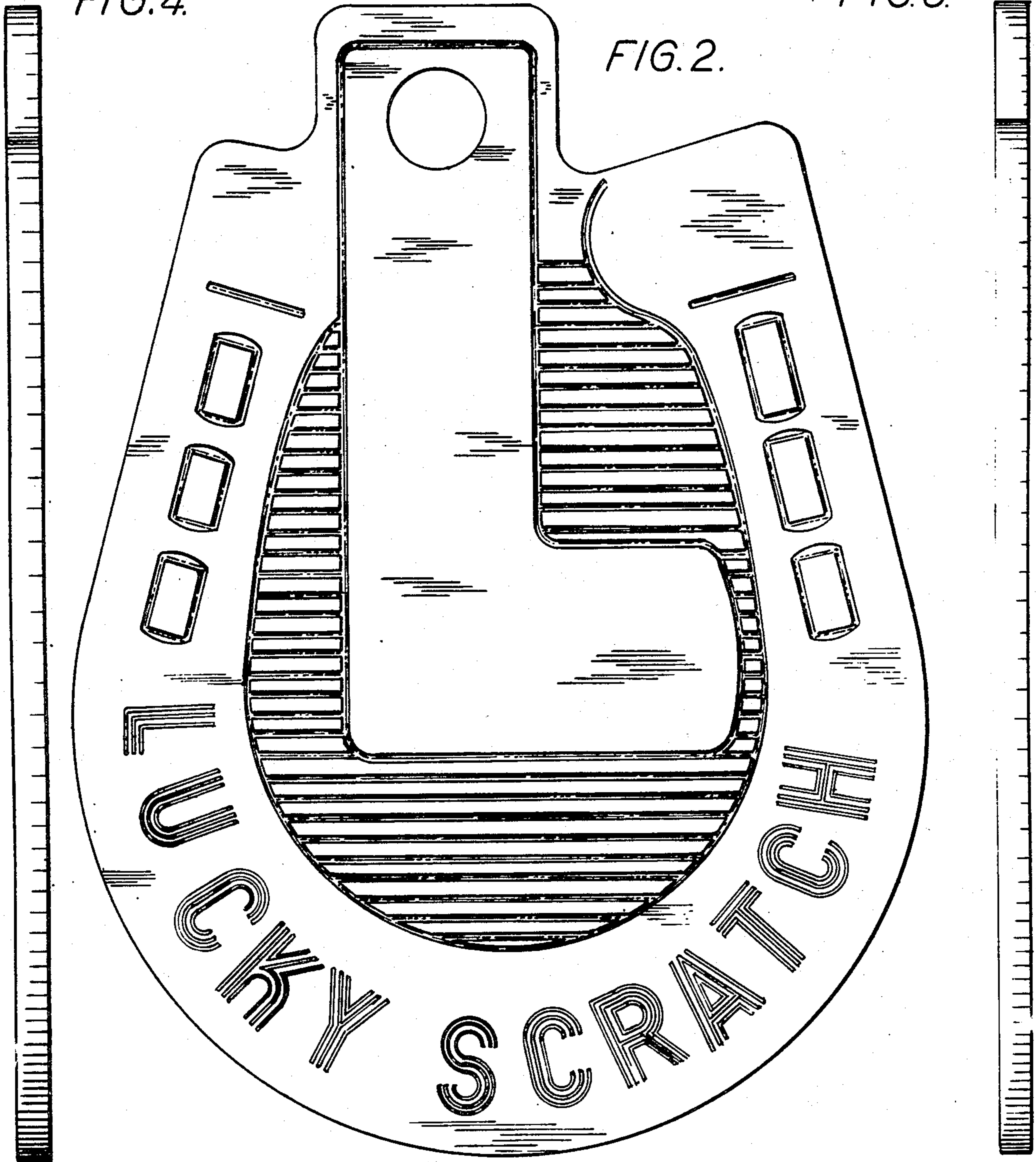
