my design;

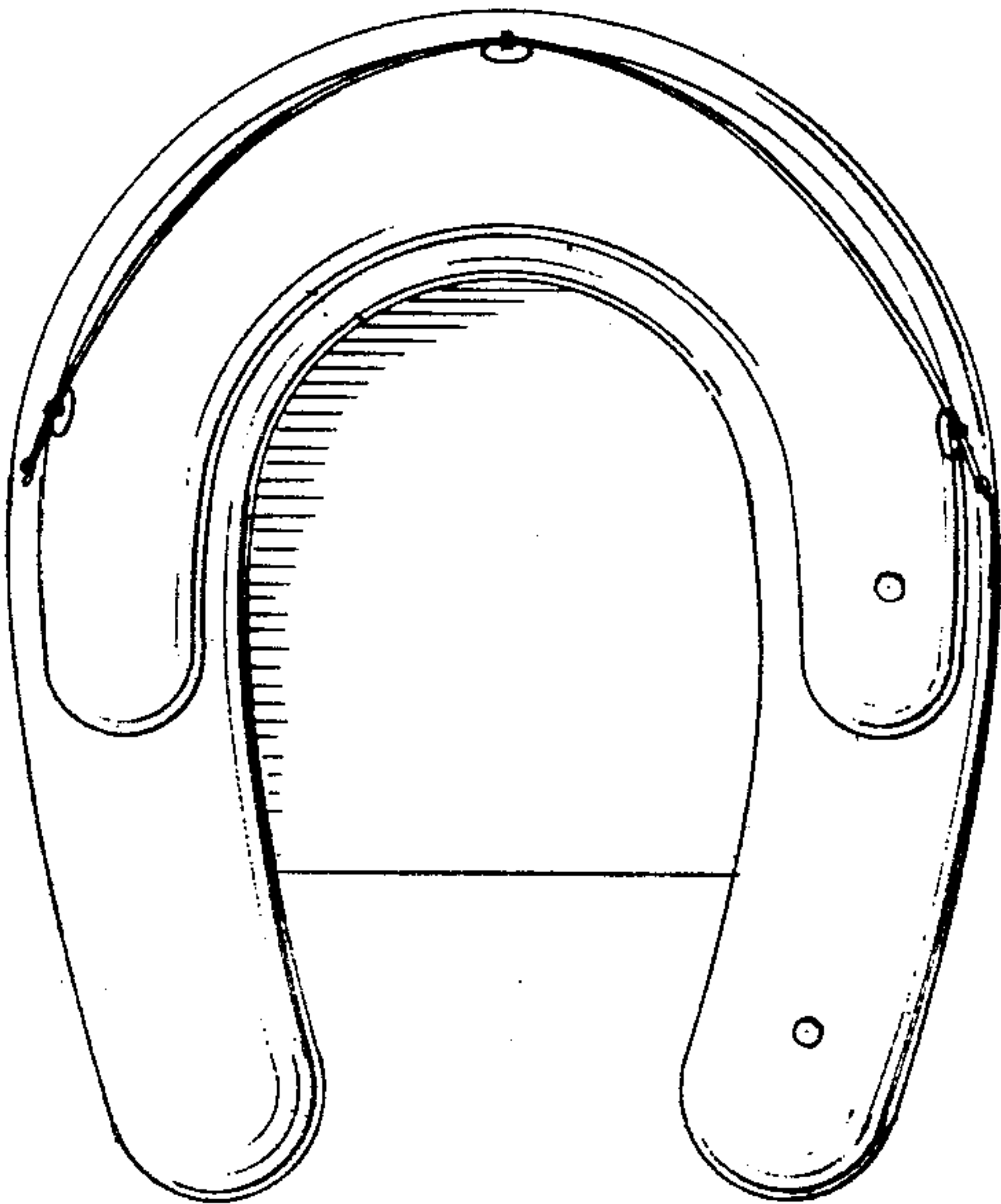
FIG. 2 is a bottom plan view;

image of the side shown in FIG. 5.



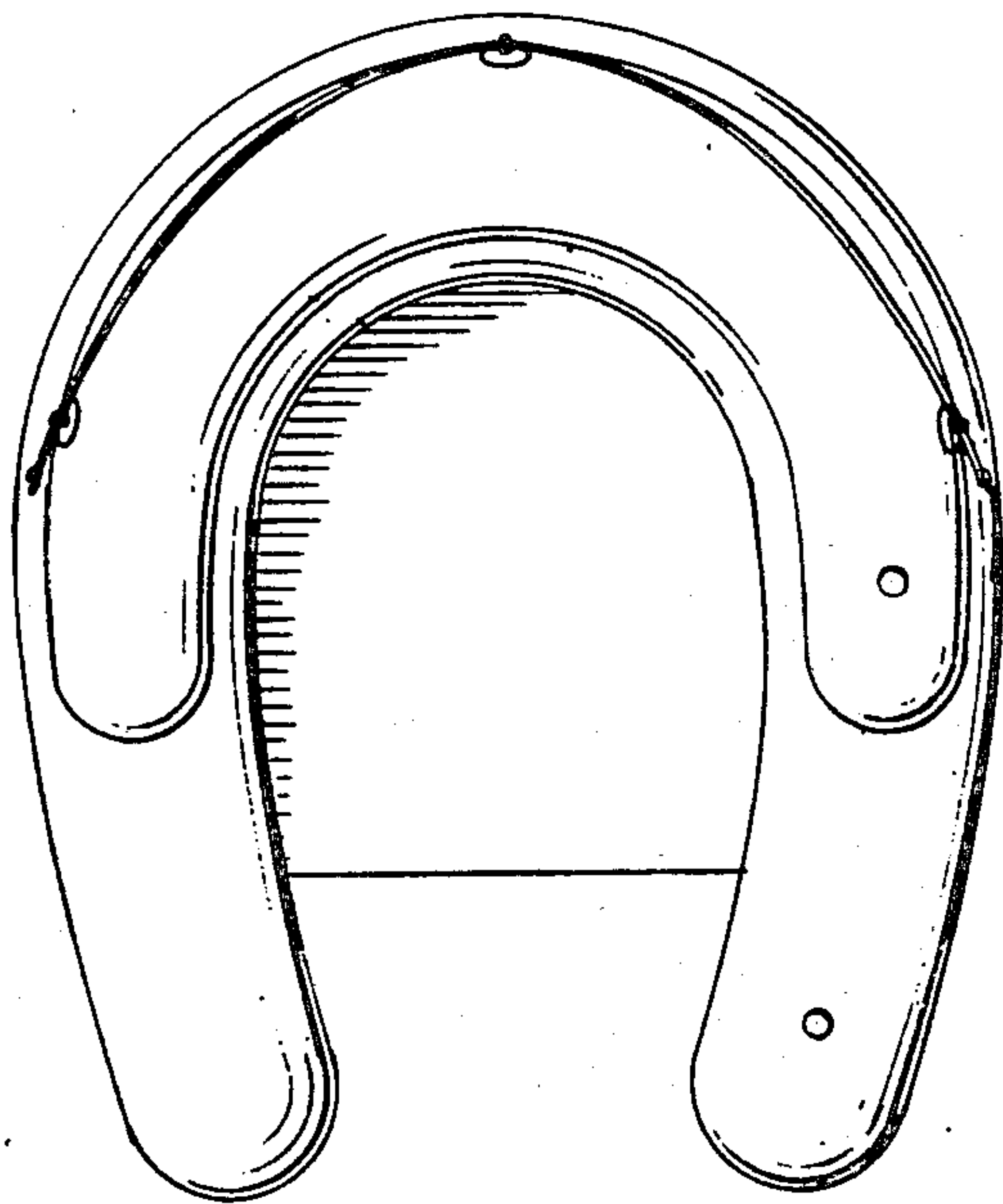

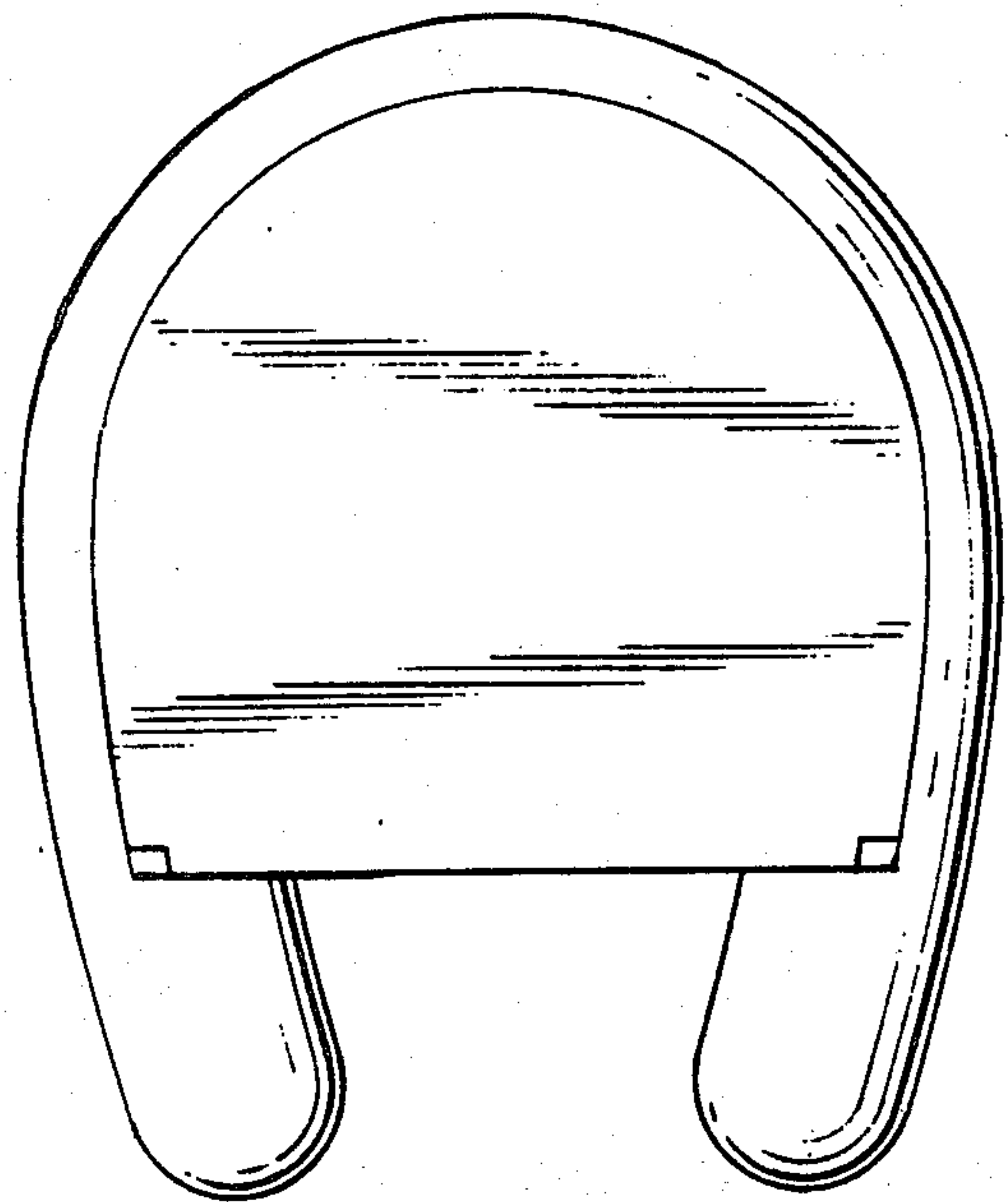

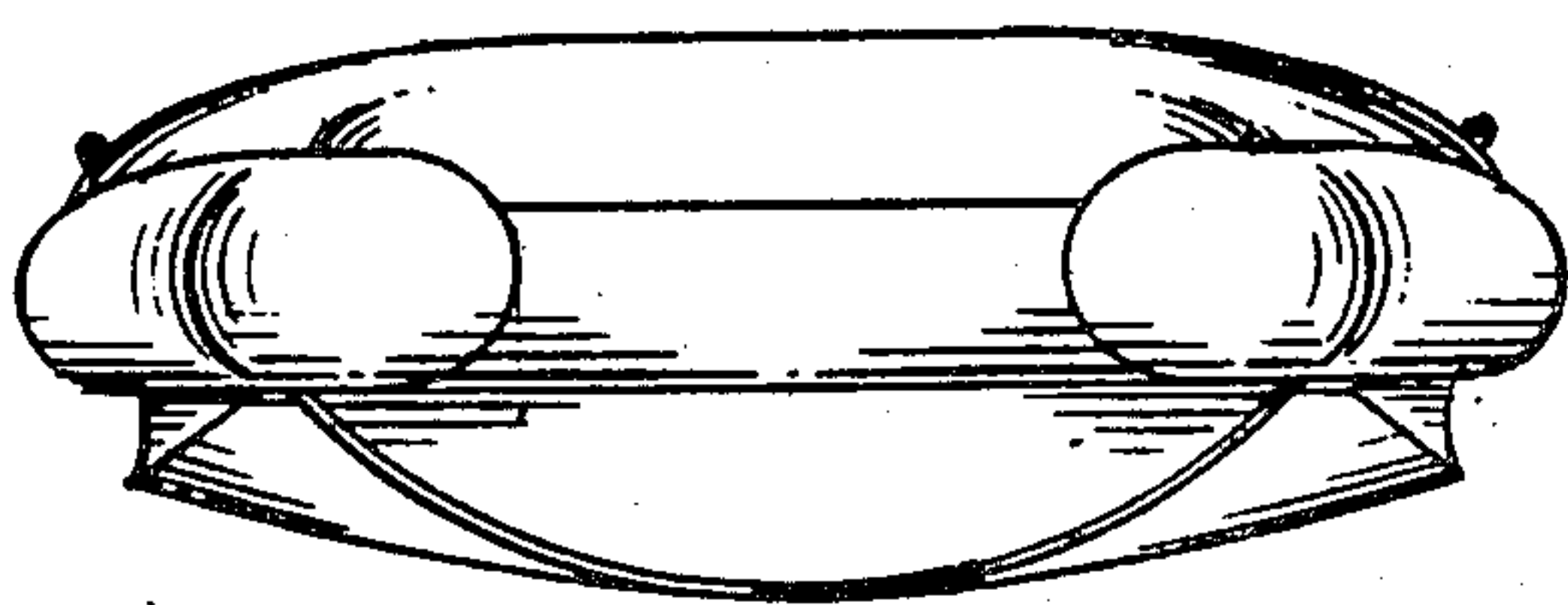

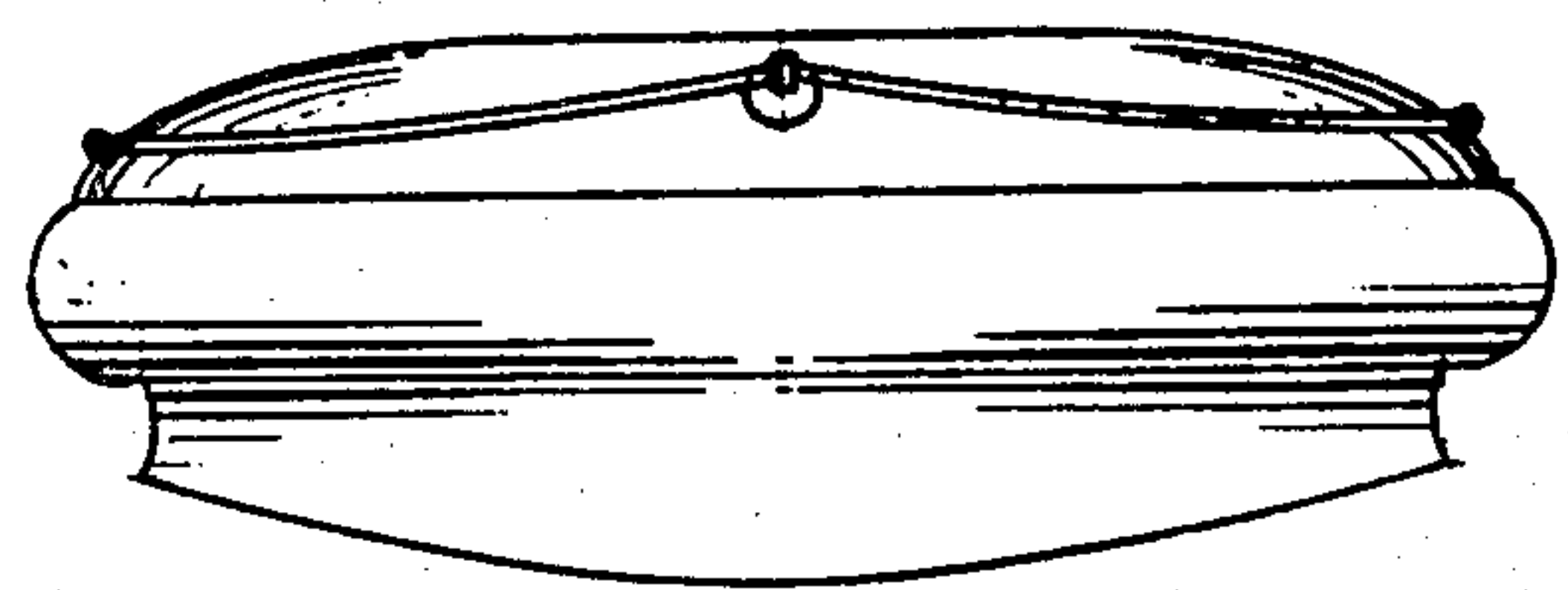
