DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a front elevational view of a tape player showing our new design;
FIG. 2 is a right side elevational view thereof;
FIG. 3 is a top plan view thereof;

FIG. 7 is a top, front and right side perspective view thereof.

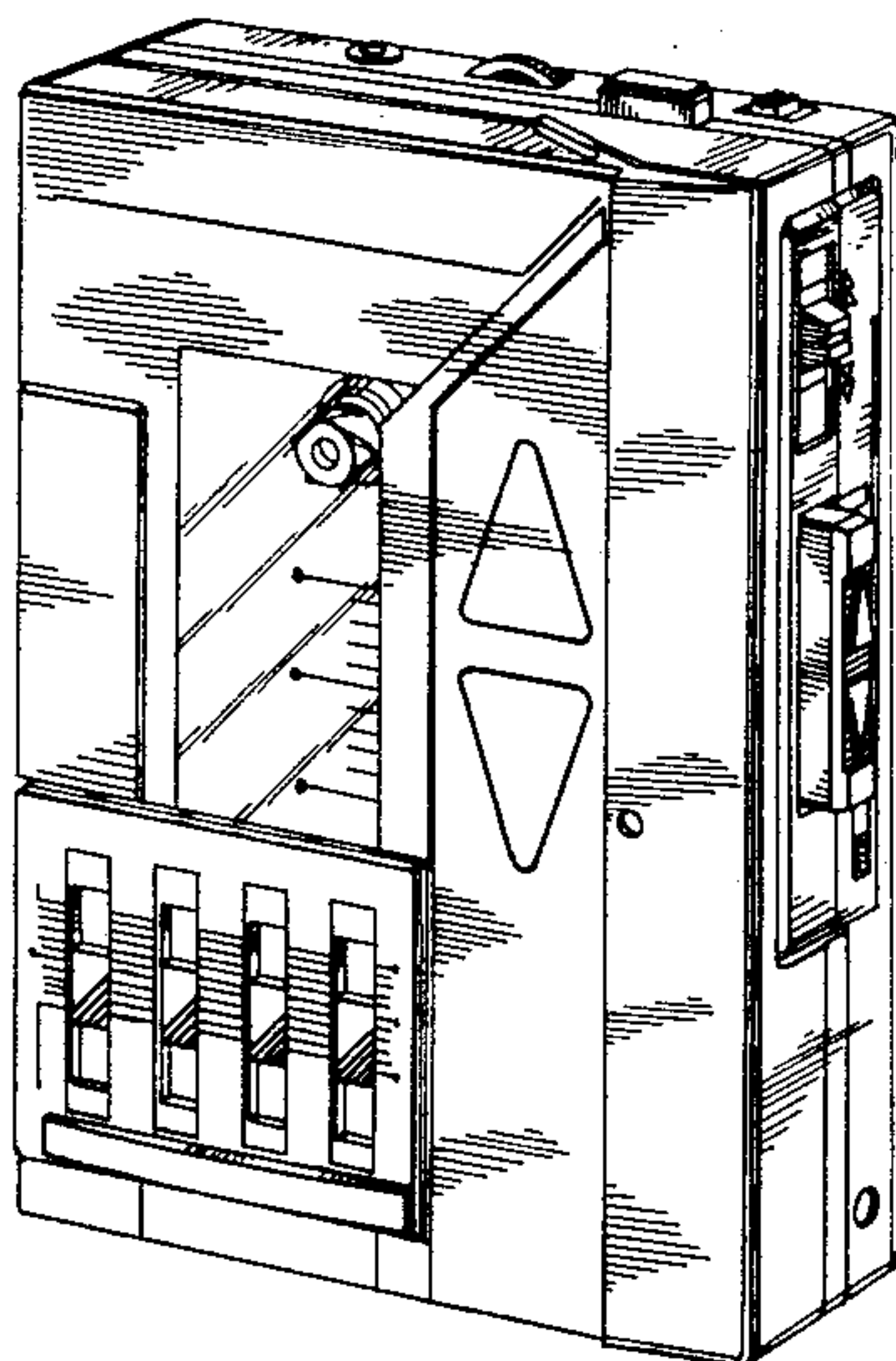

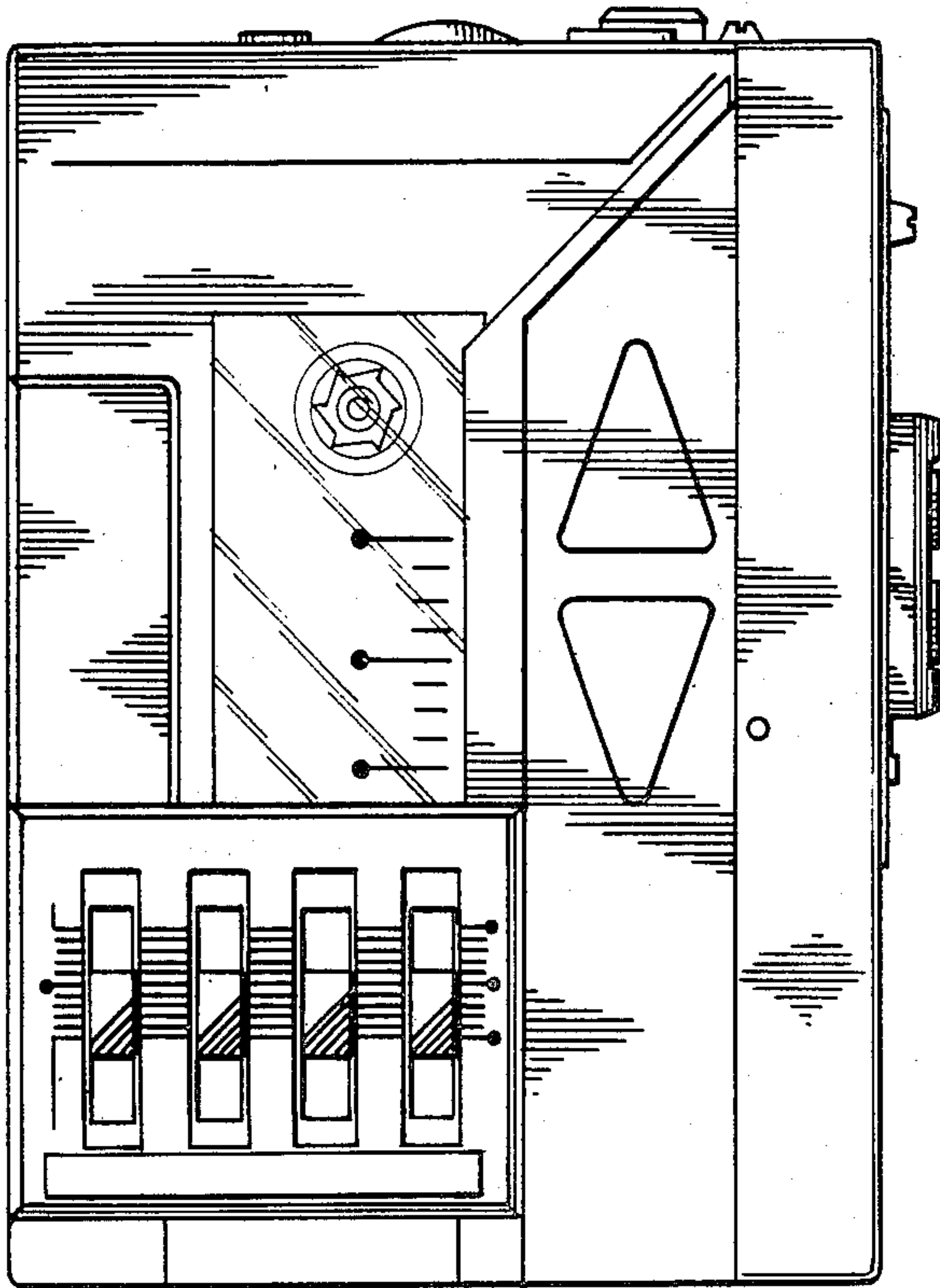

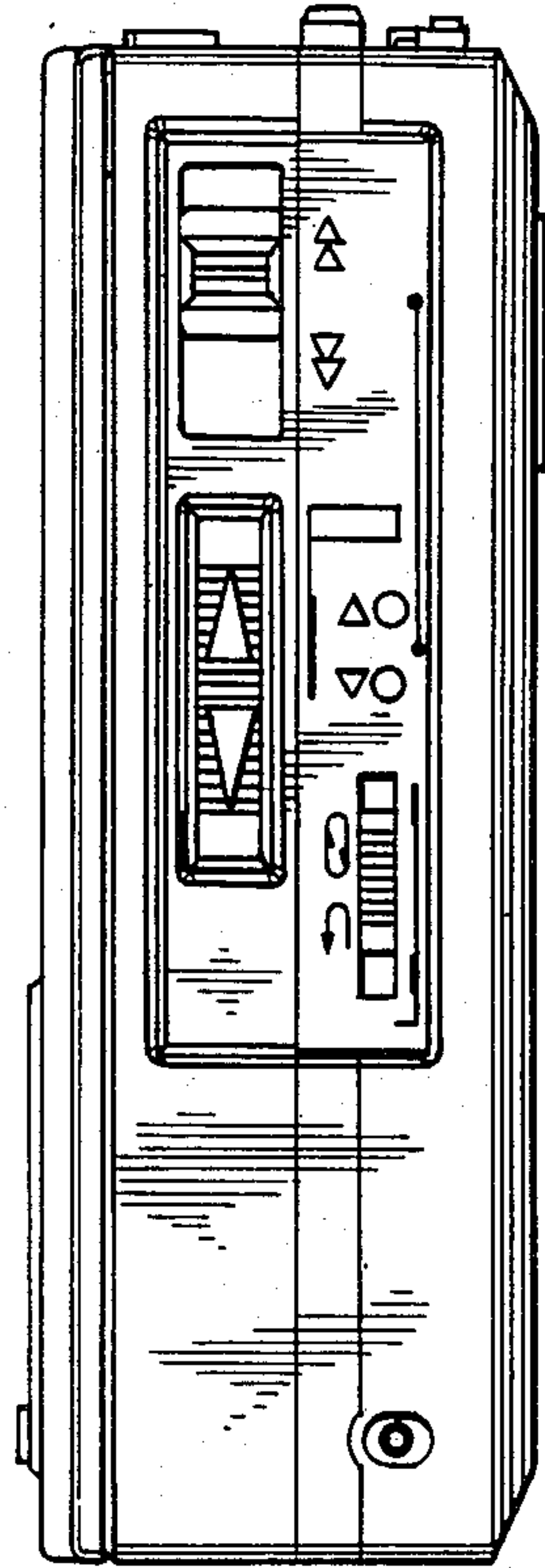

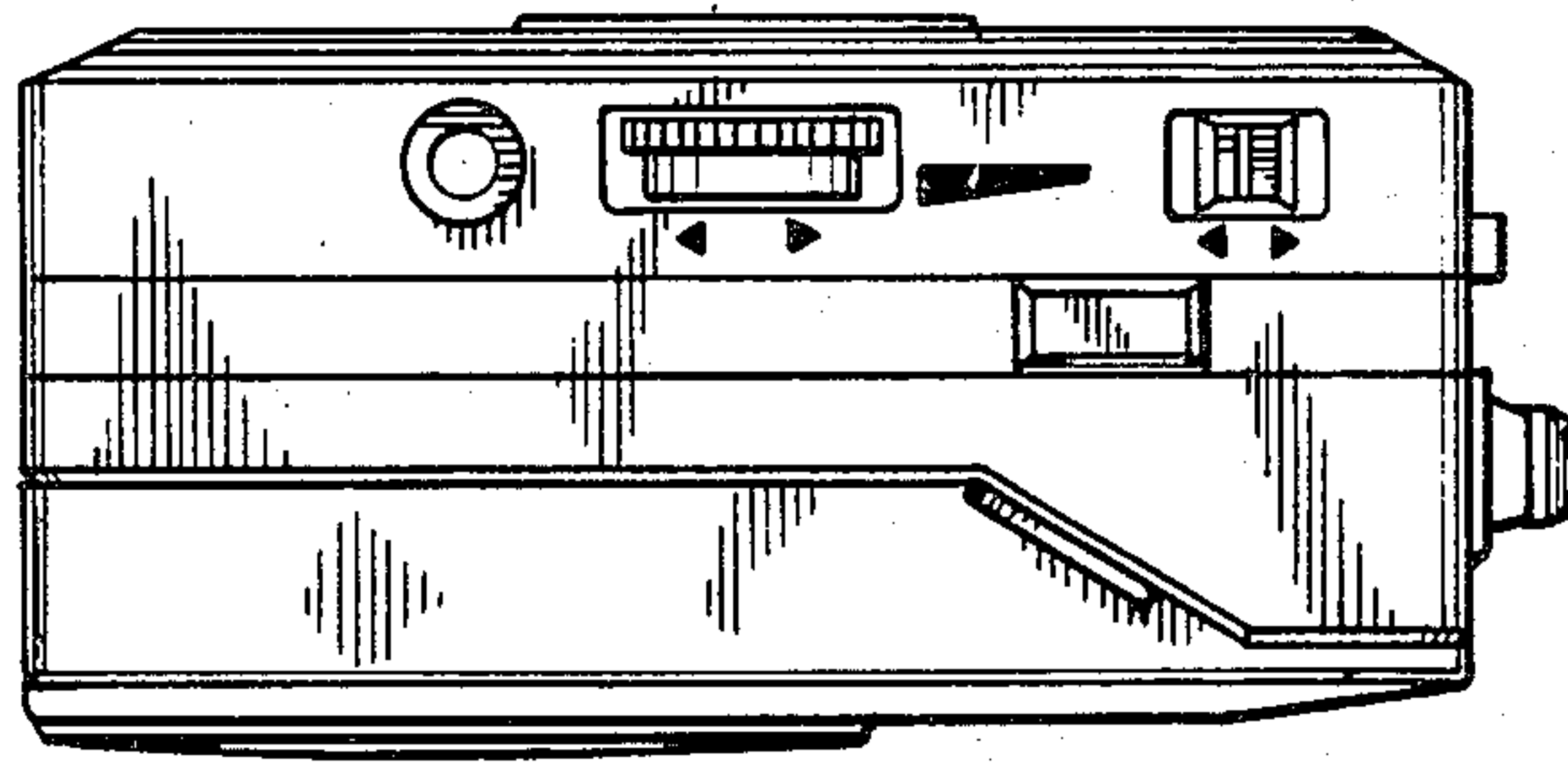

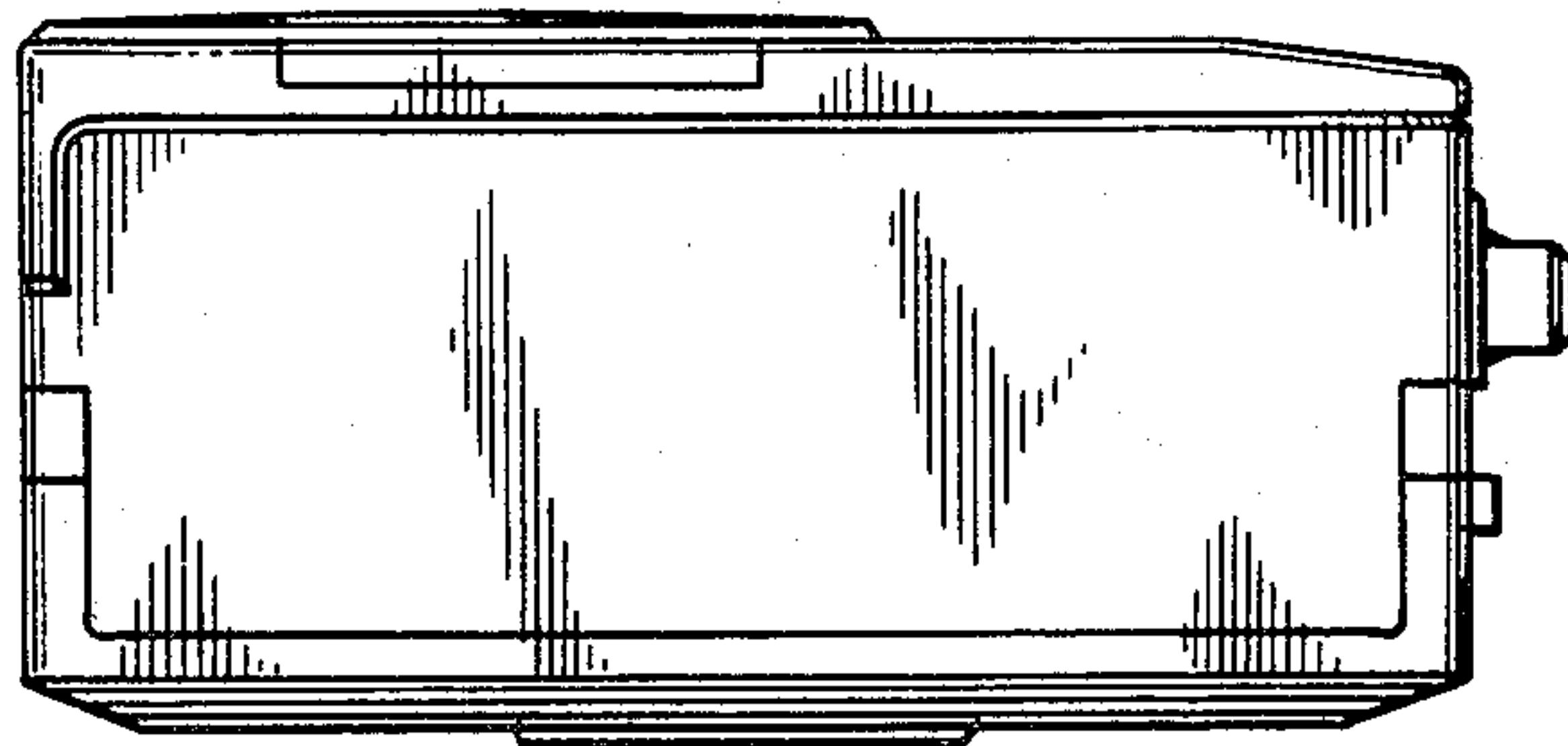

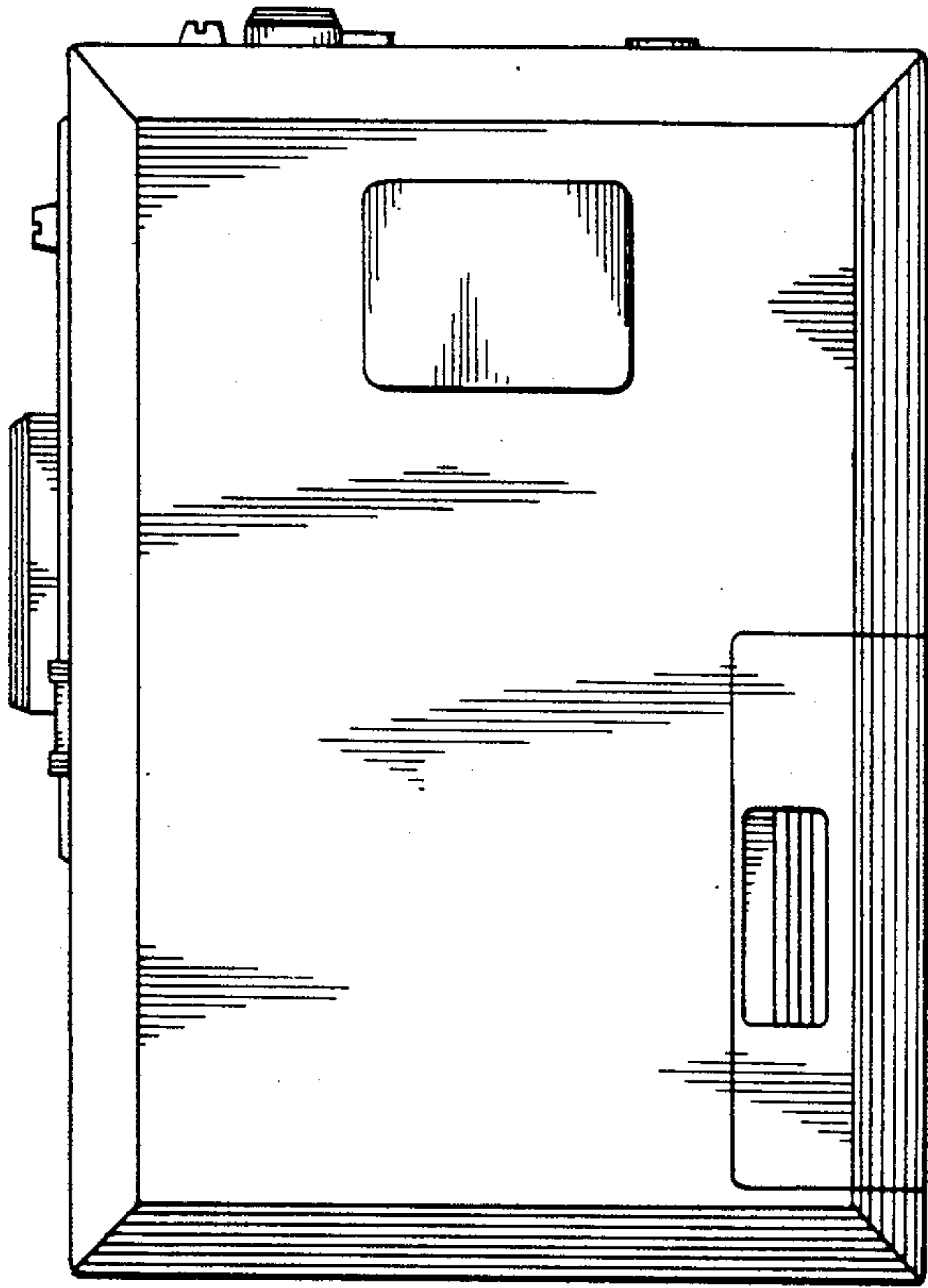

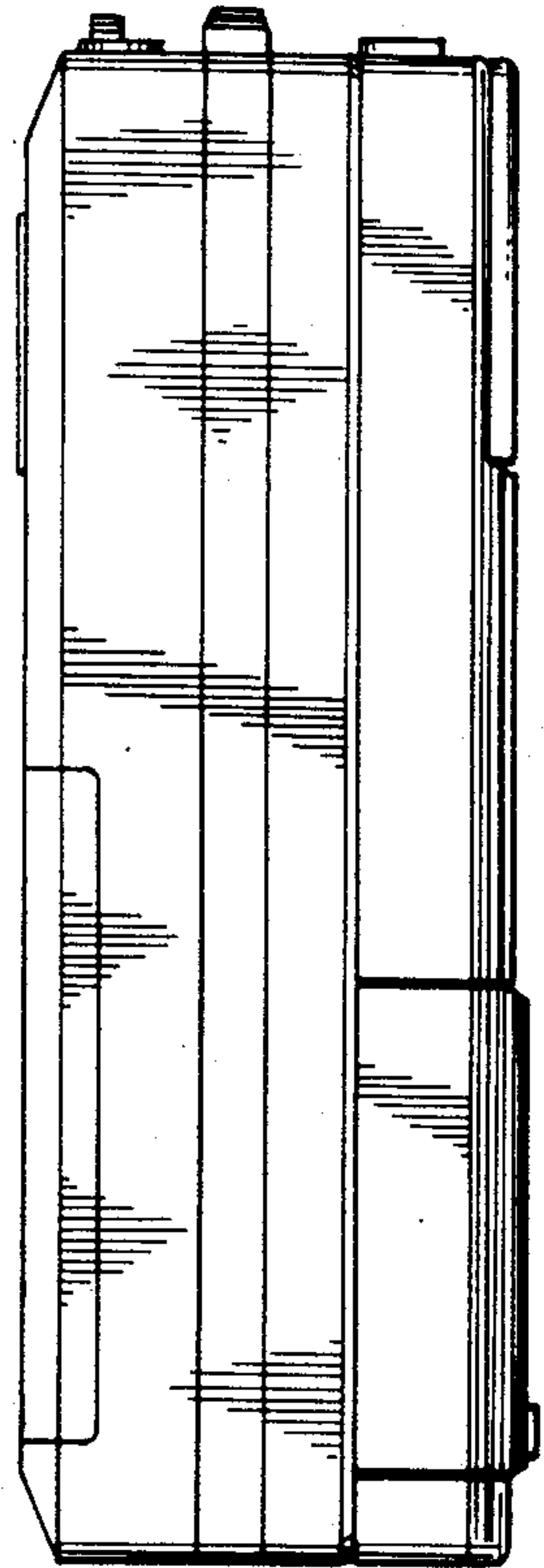
