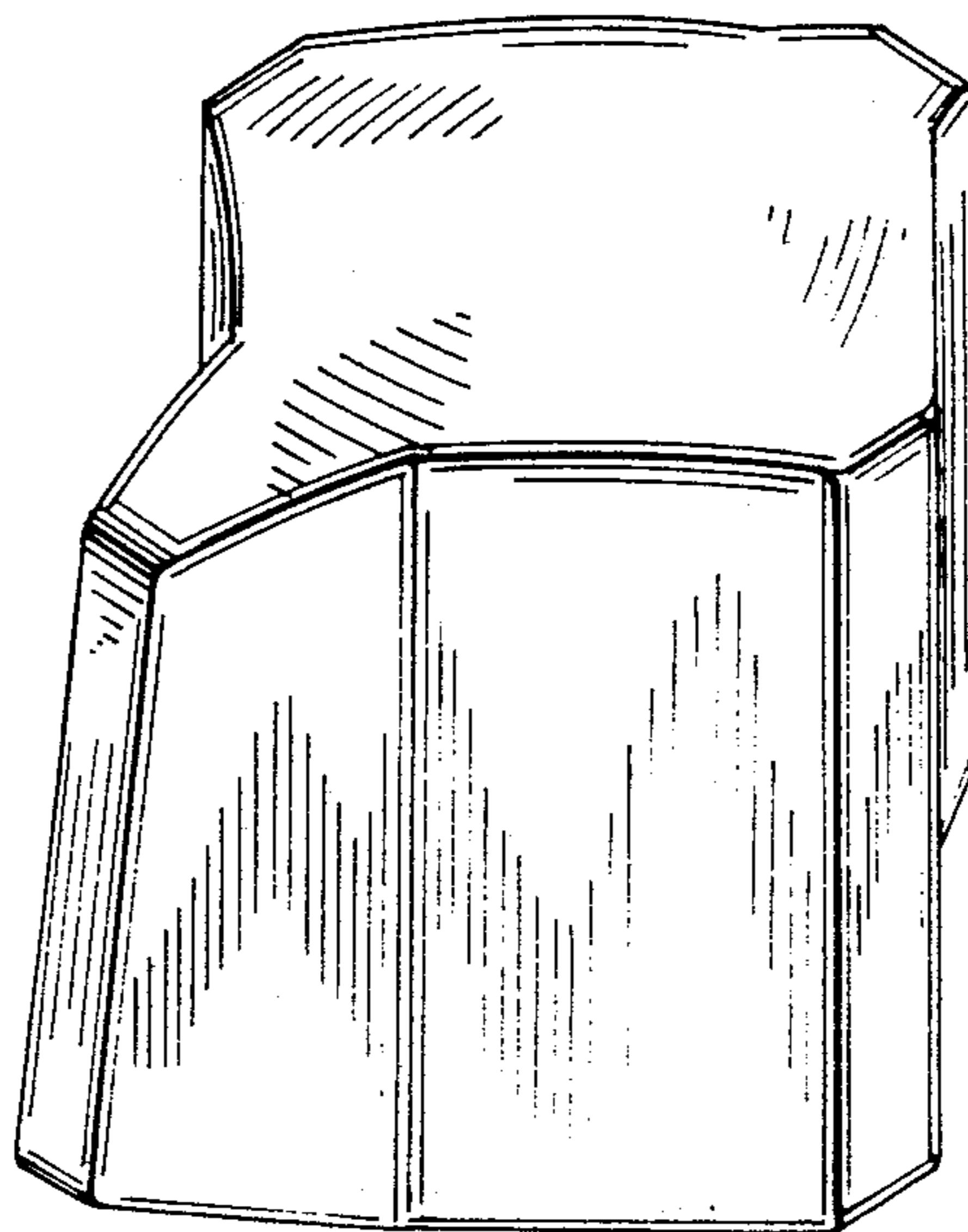

[57] CLAIM

The ornamental design for a plumbing fitting handle, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a top perspective view of a plumbing fitting handle showing our new design;  
FIG. 2 is a top plan view thereof;  
FIG. 3 is a front elevational view thereof;  
FIG. 4 is a left side elevational view thereof;  
FIG. 5 is a right side elevational view thereof;  
FIG. 6 is a rear elevational view thereof;  
FIG. 7 is a bottom plan view thereof; and  
FIG. 8 is a top perspective view of a modified form of the plumbing fitting handle shown in FIG. 1.



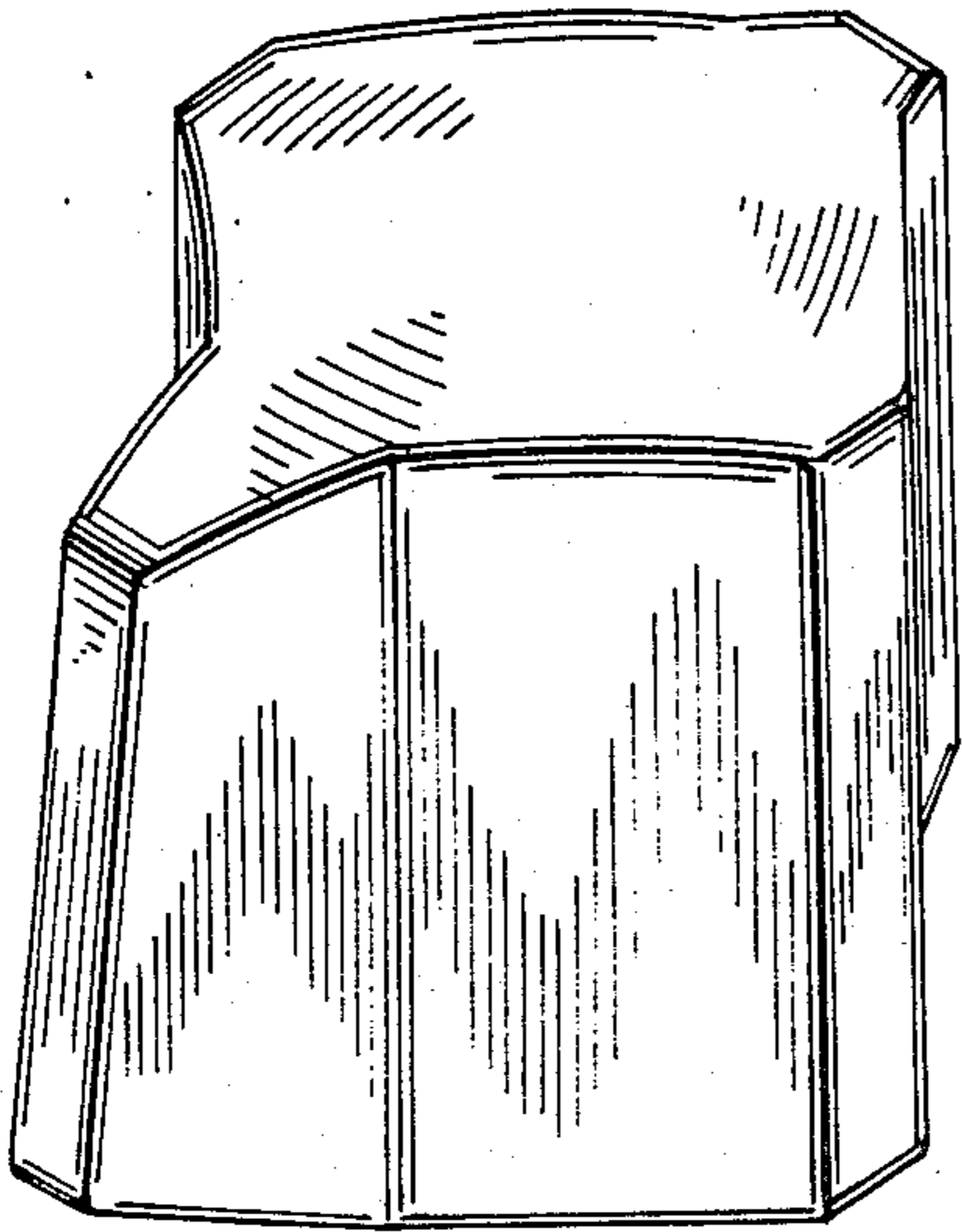

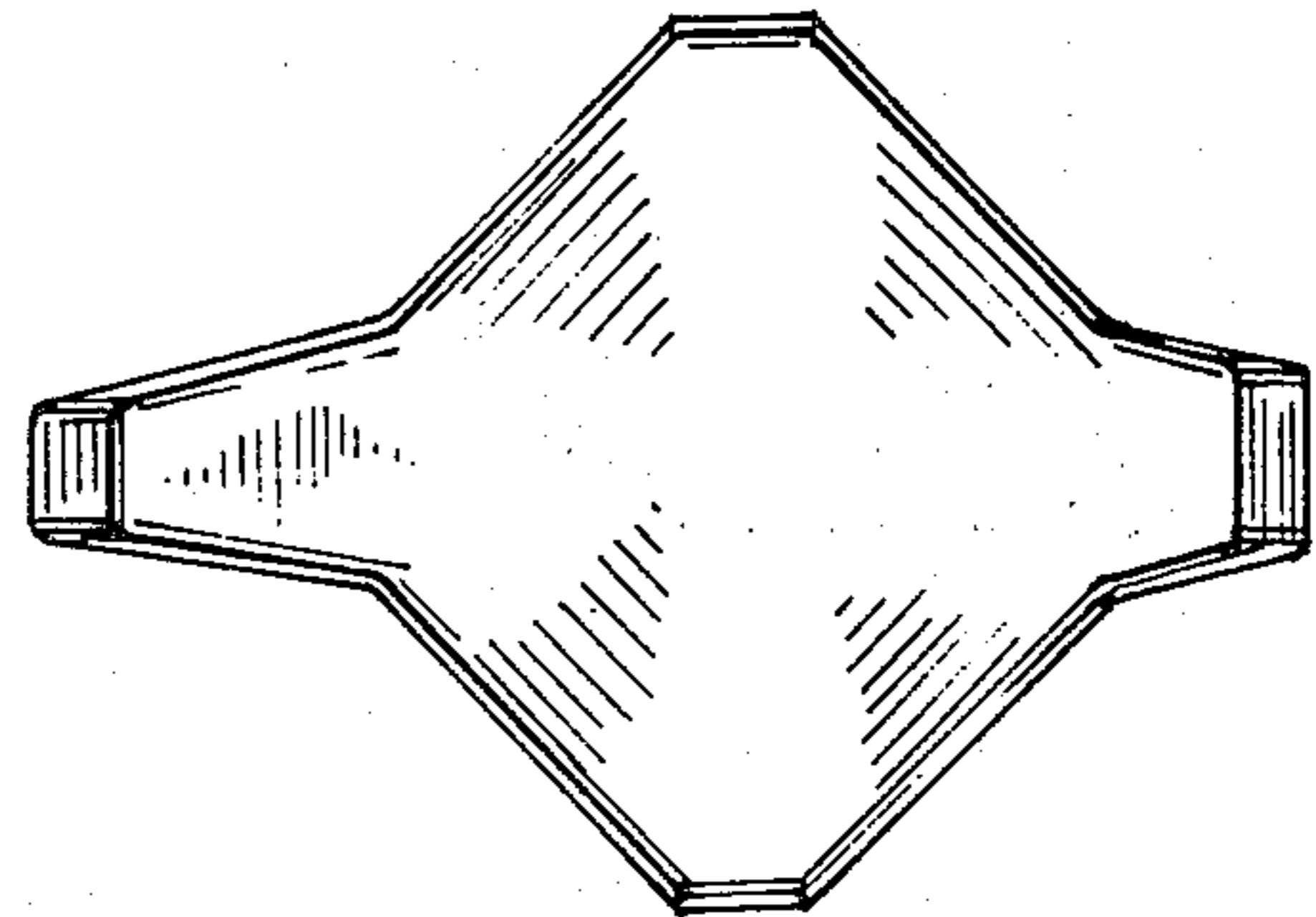

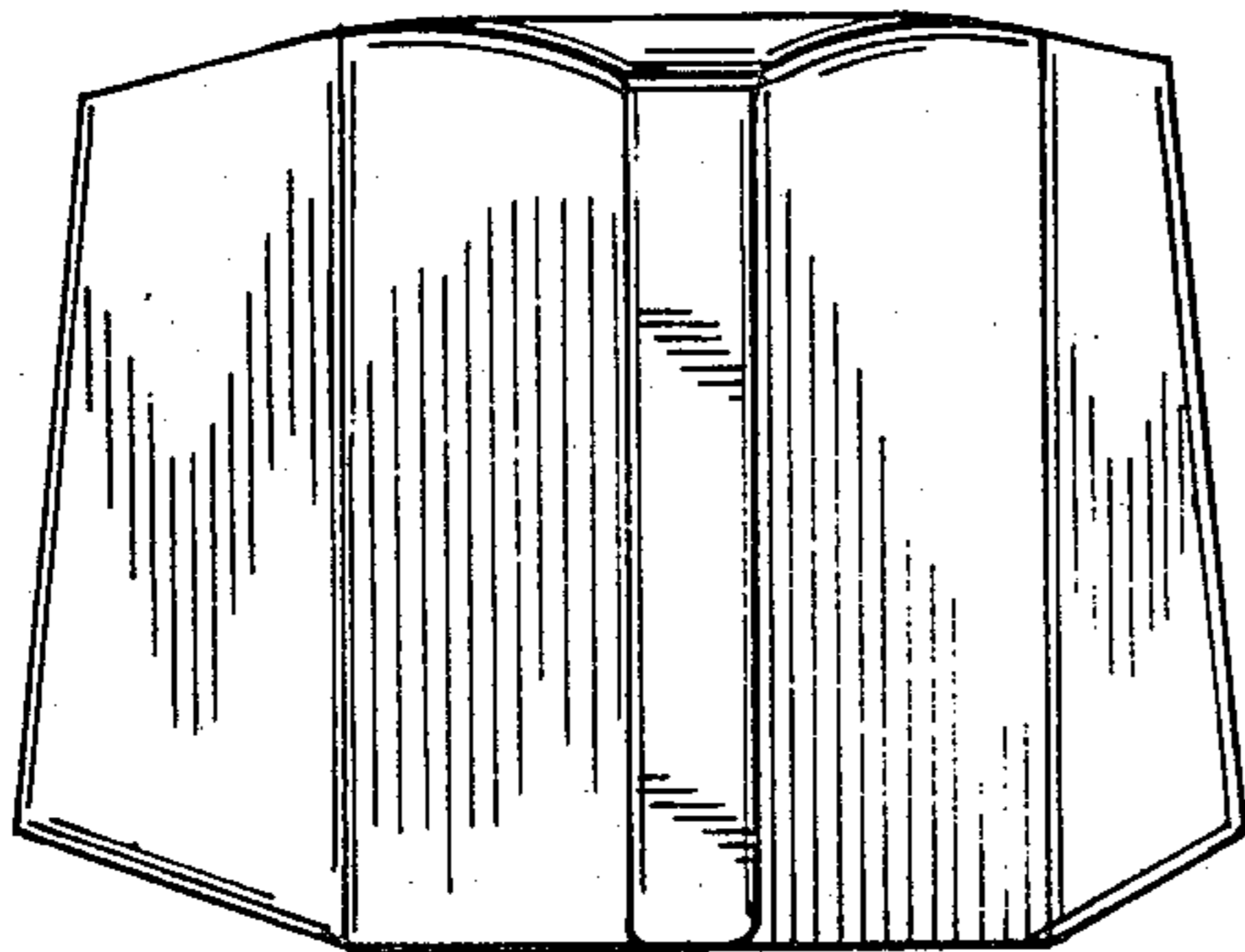

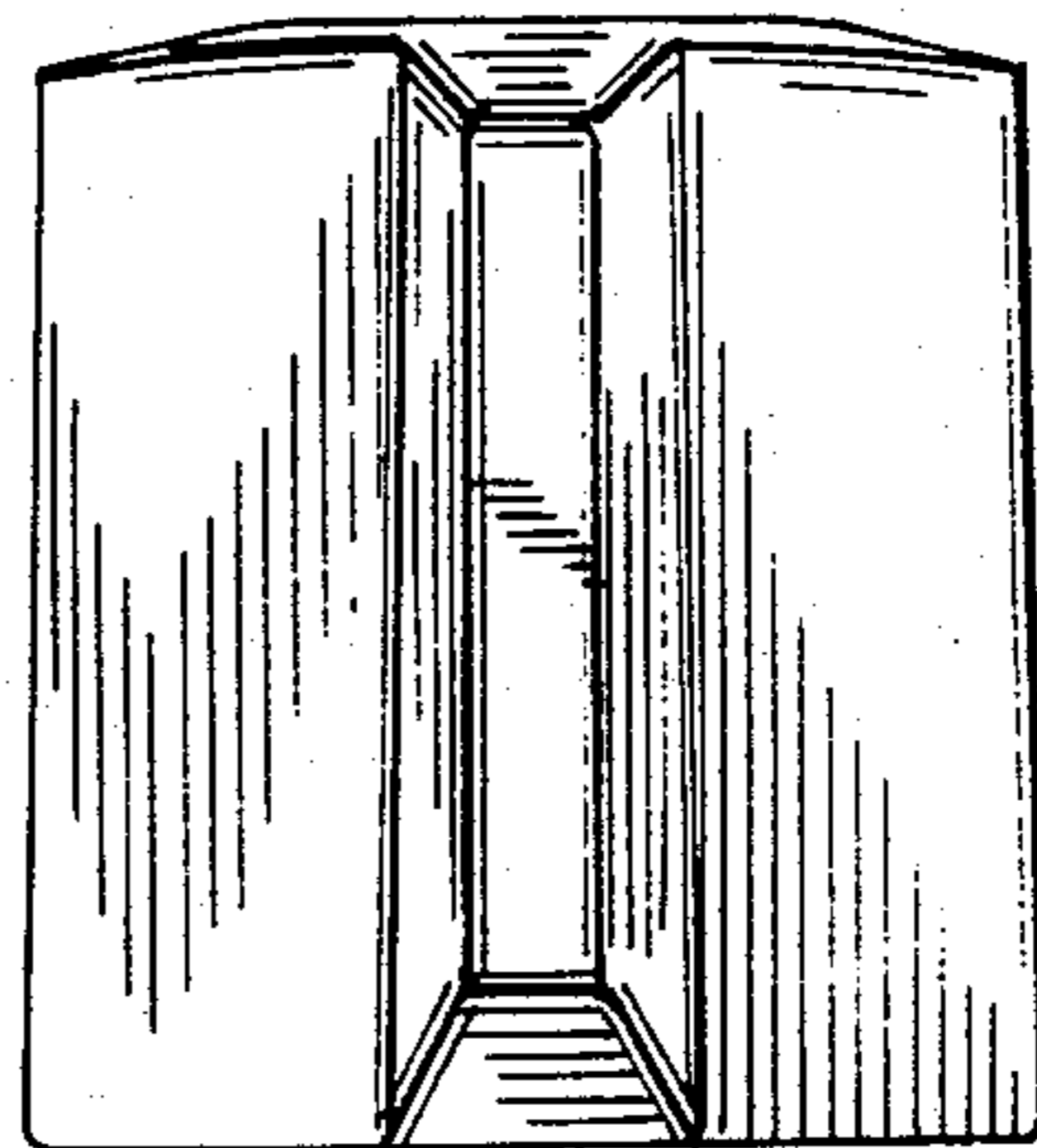

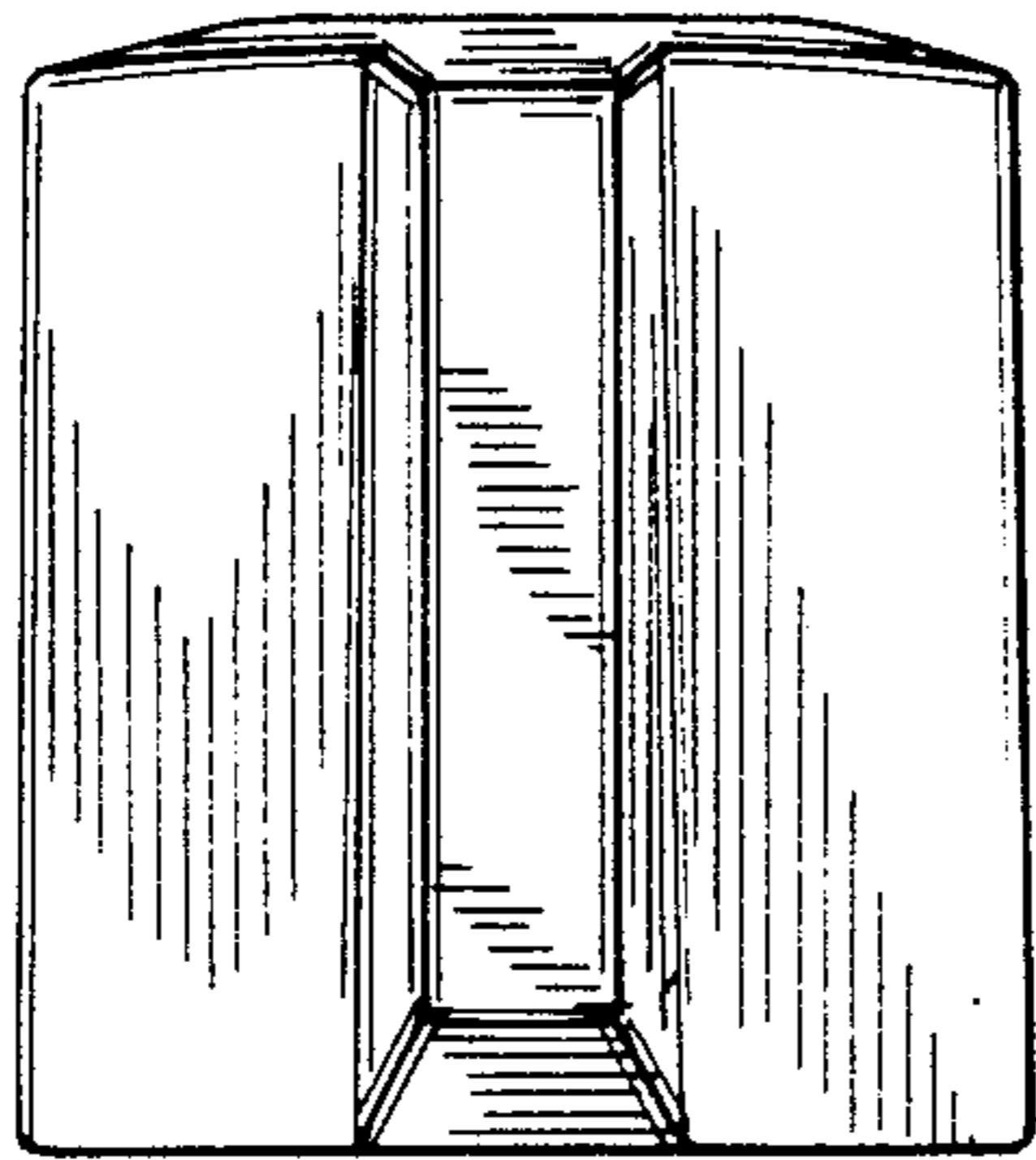

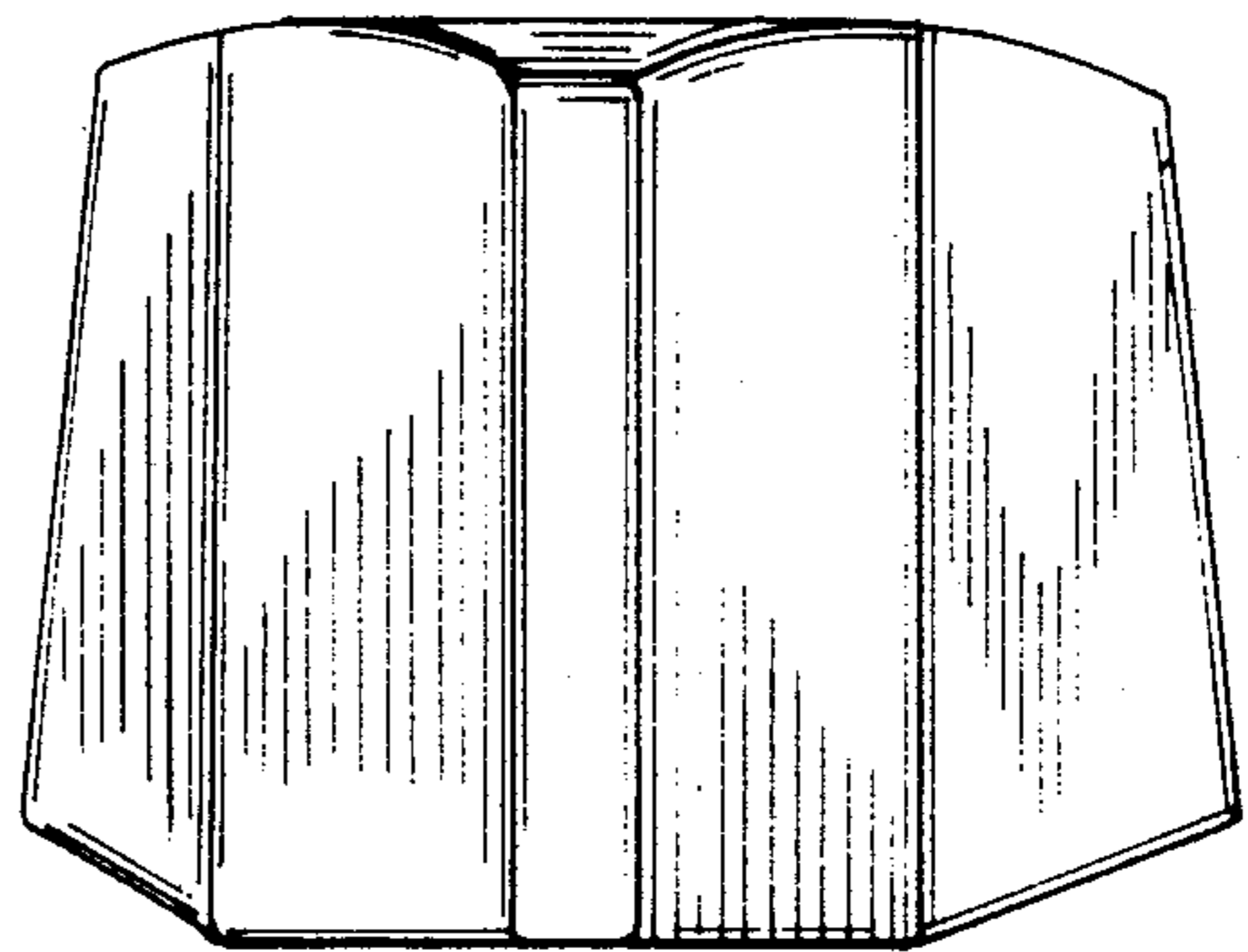

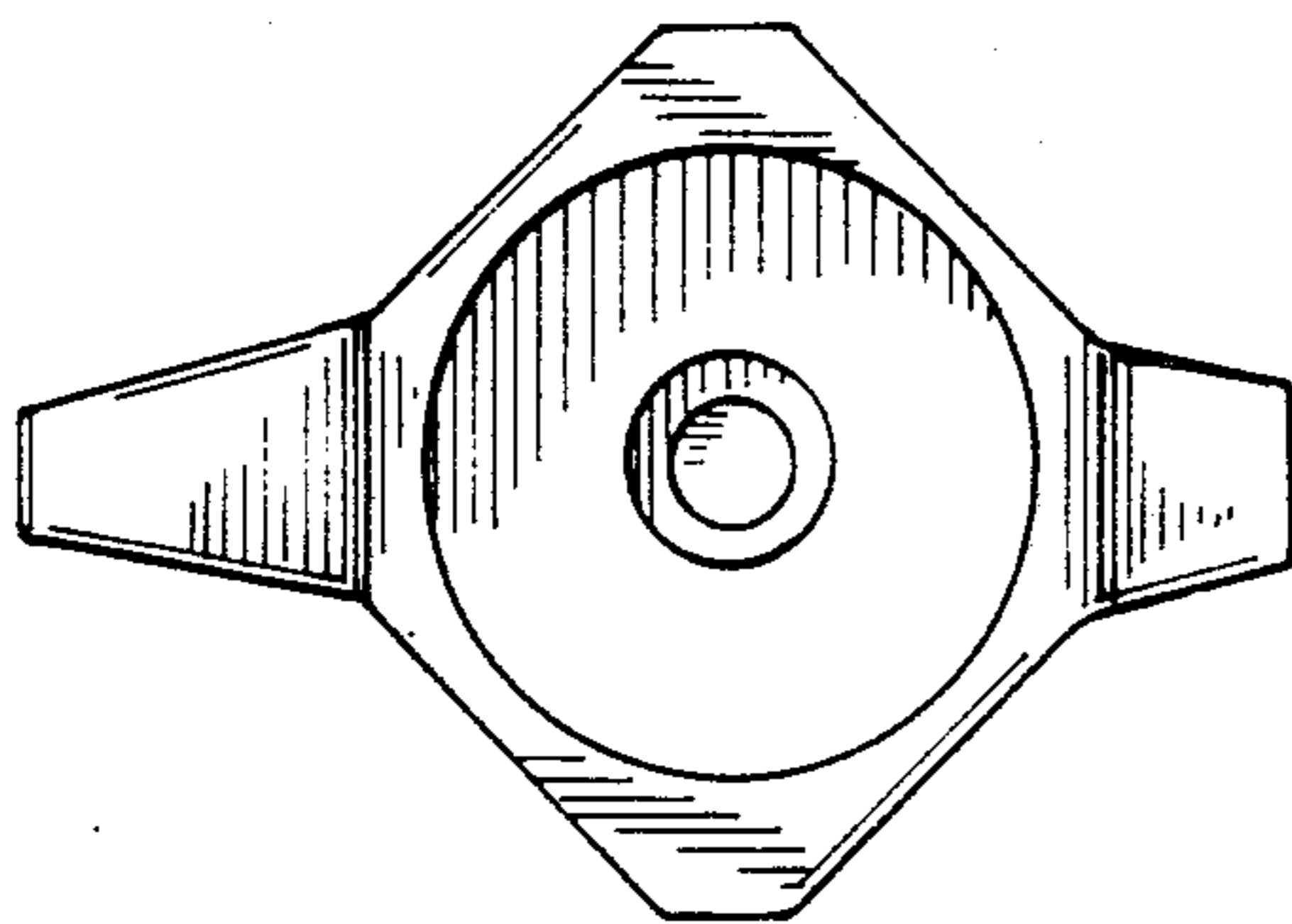

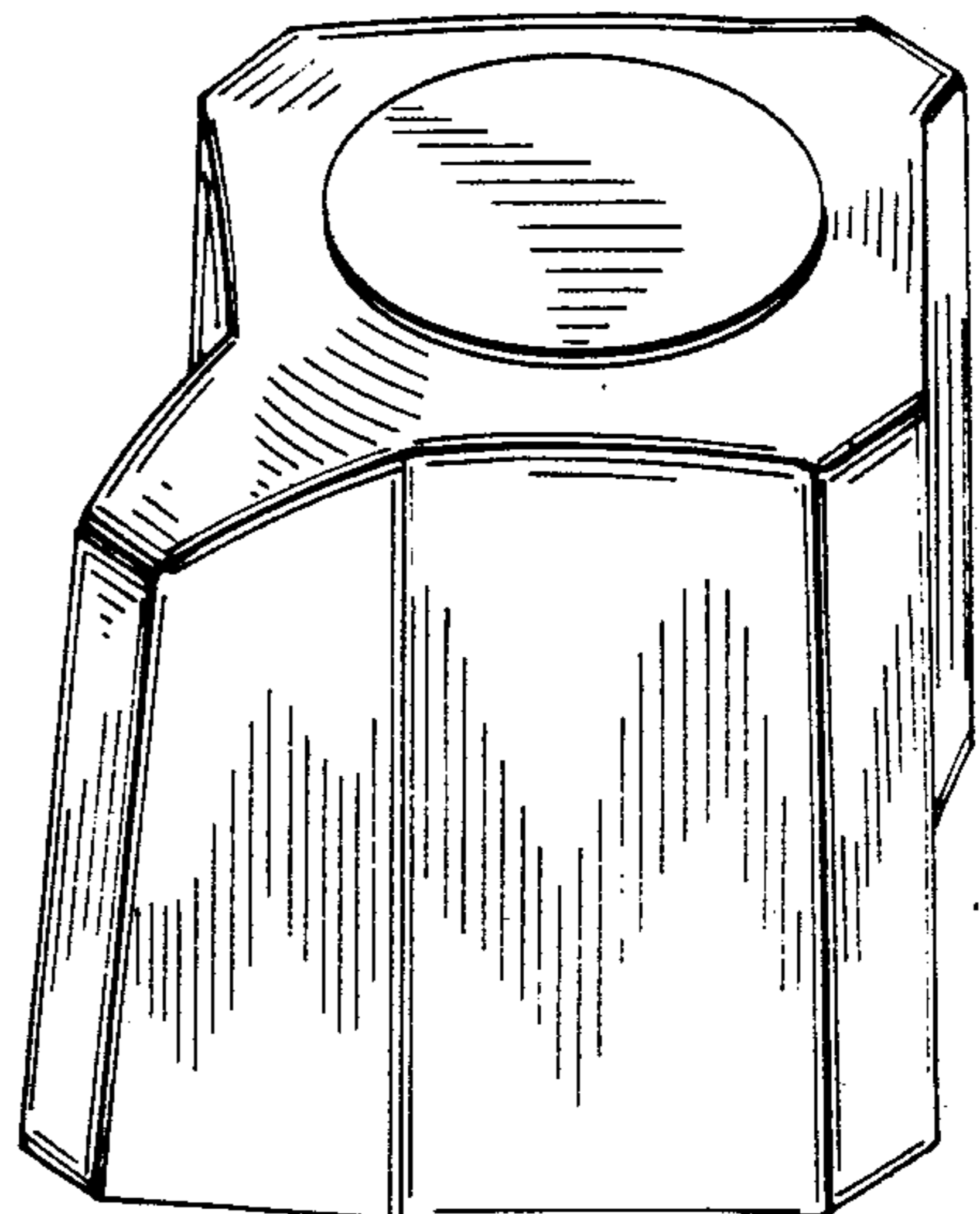
