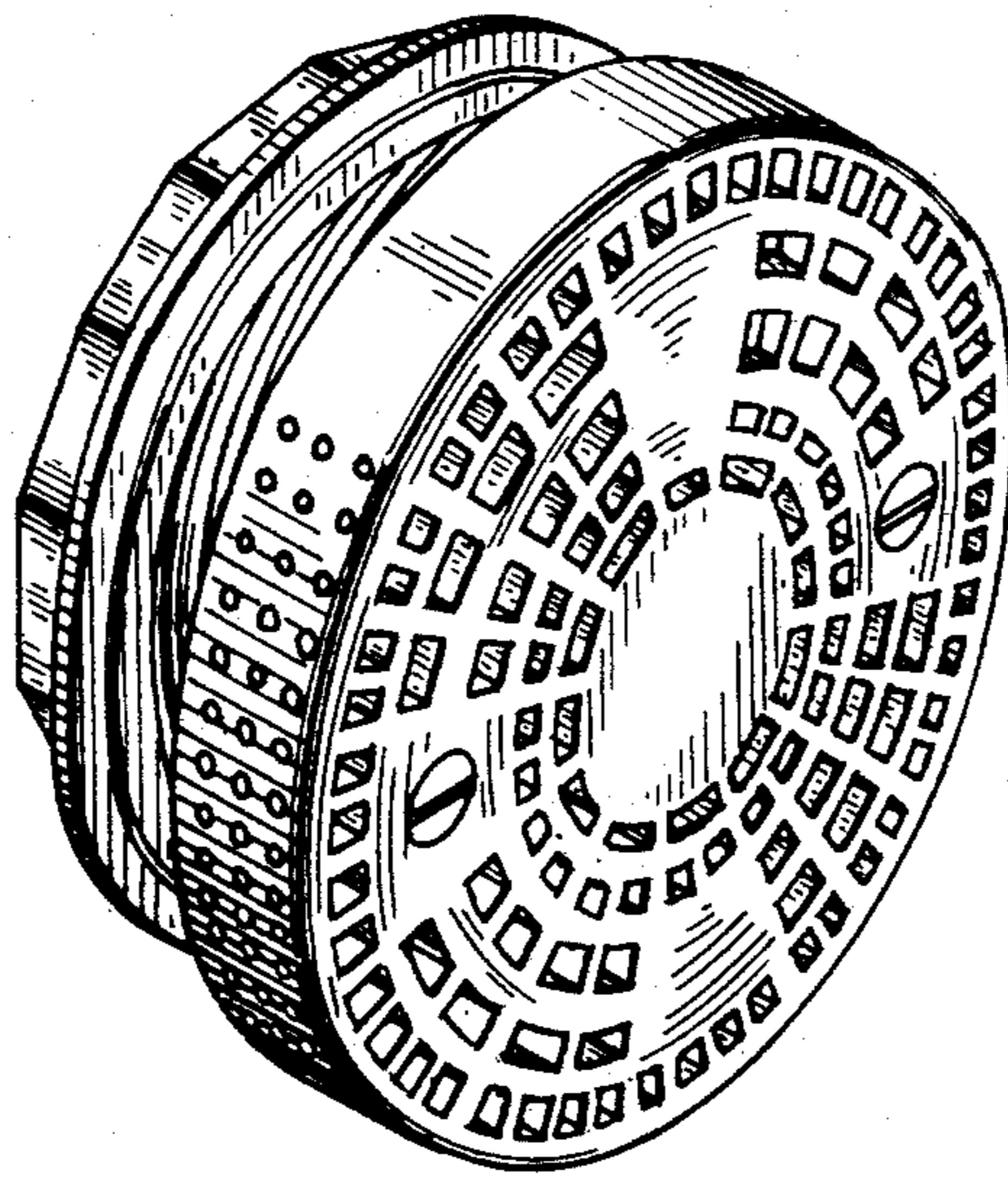

[57] CLAIM

The ornamental design for a suction fitting for a hydrotherapy spa and the like, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a perspective view taken from the top, front and left side of a suction fitting for a hydrotherapy spa and the like showing my new design; FIG. 2 is a rear, elevational view thereof; FIG. 3 is a front, elevational view thereof; FIG. 4 is a right side elevational view thereof, the left side being a mirror image of the right side shown; and FIG. 5 is an exploded perspective view thereof.



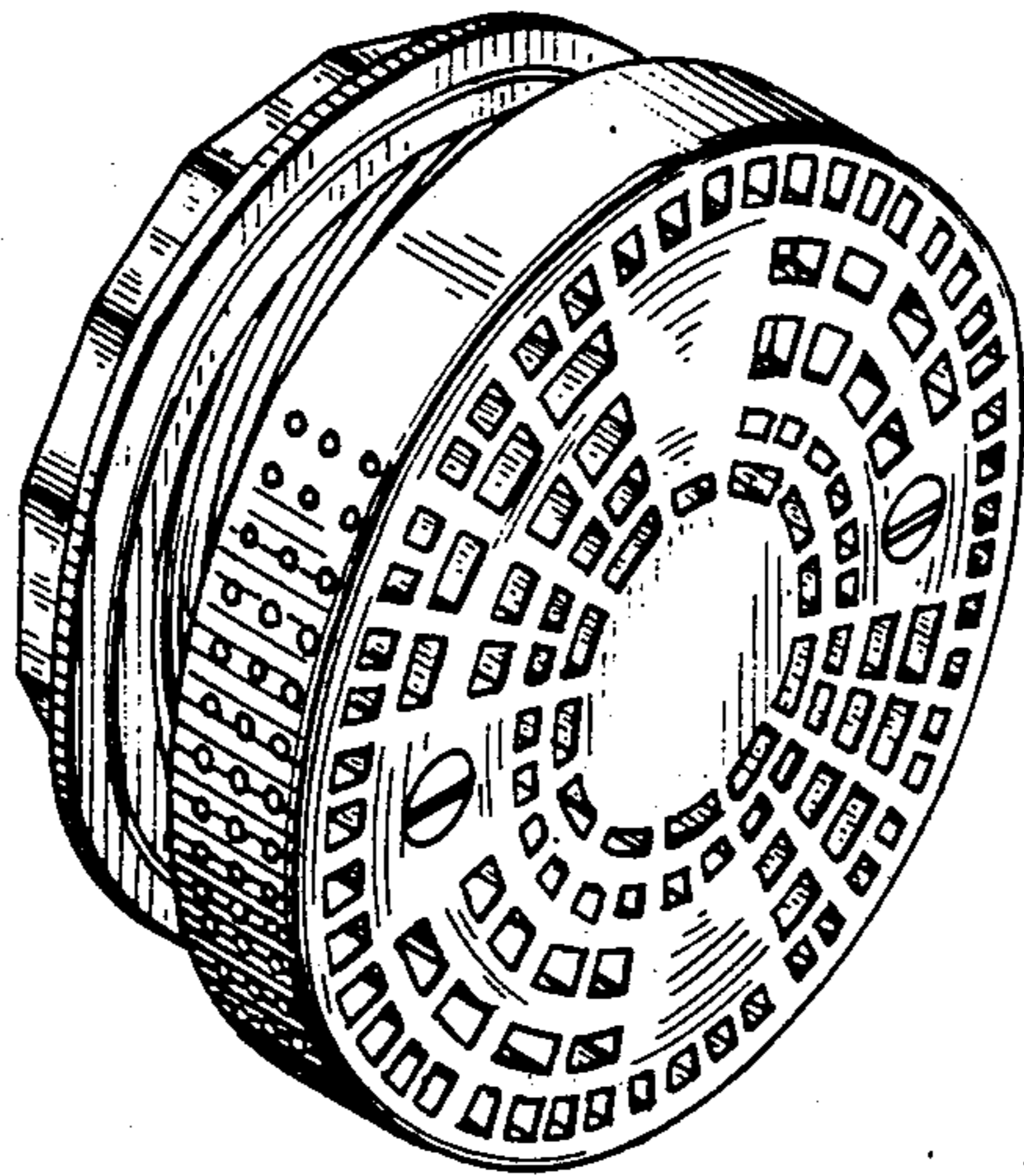

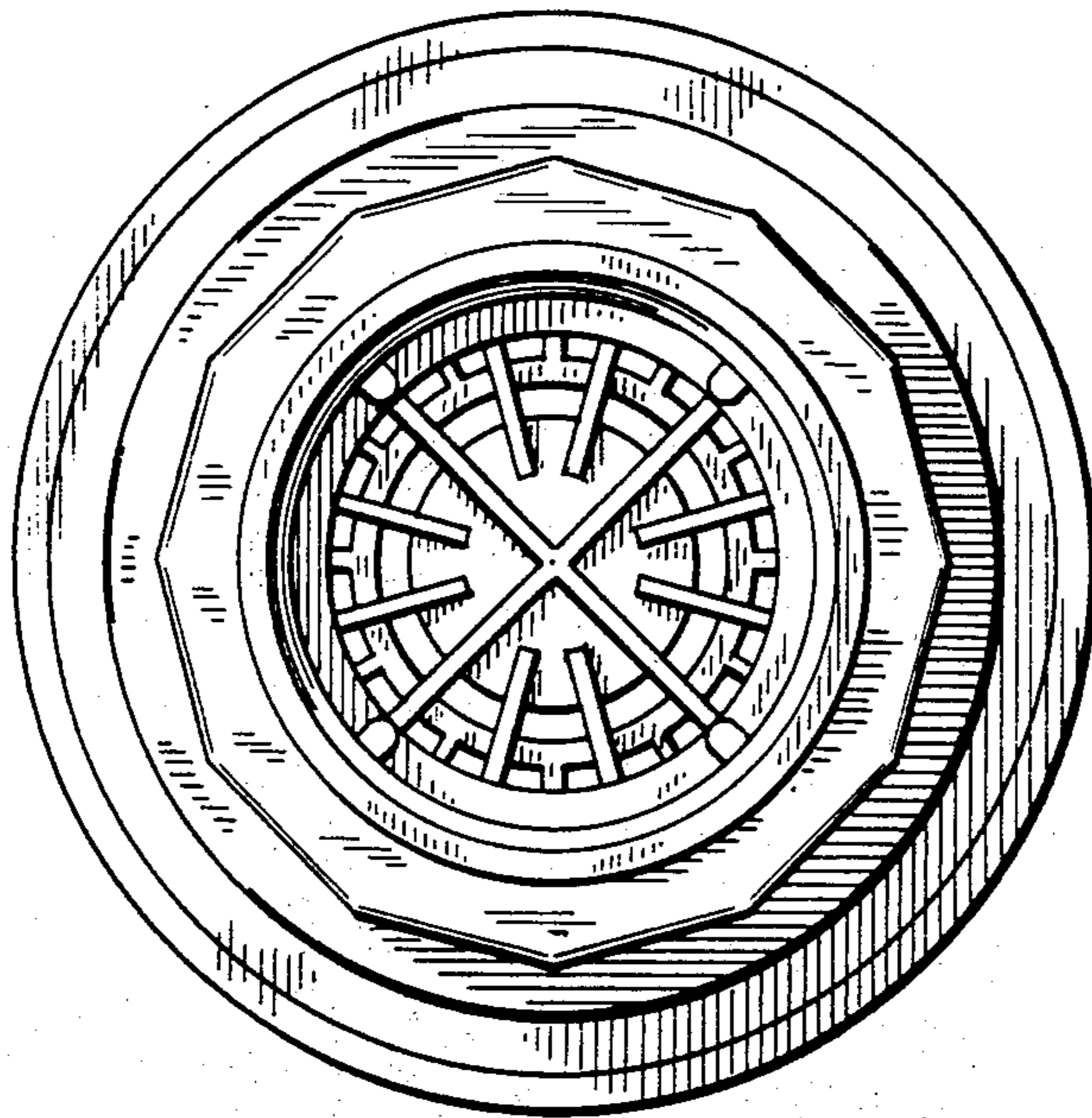

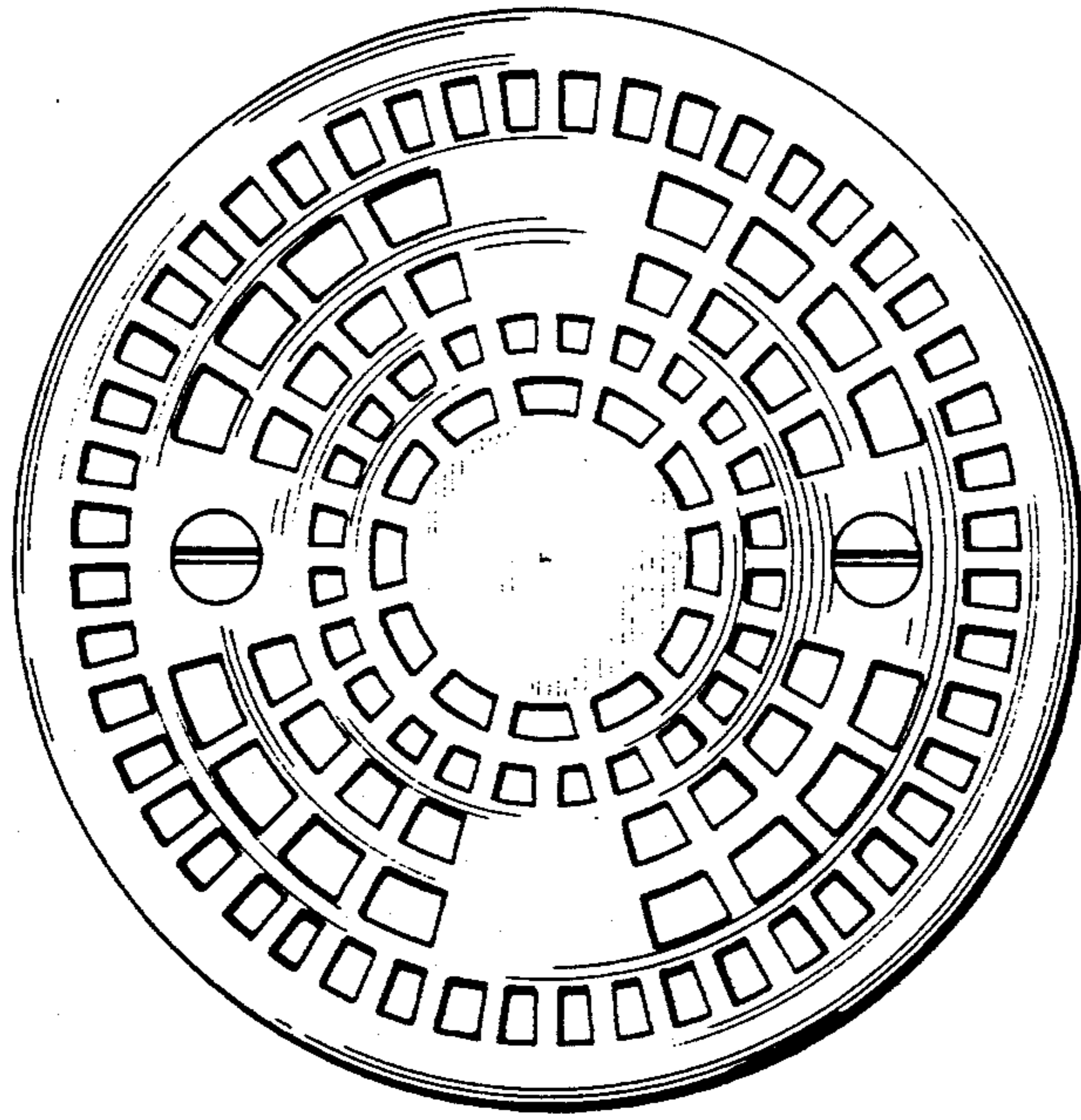

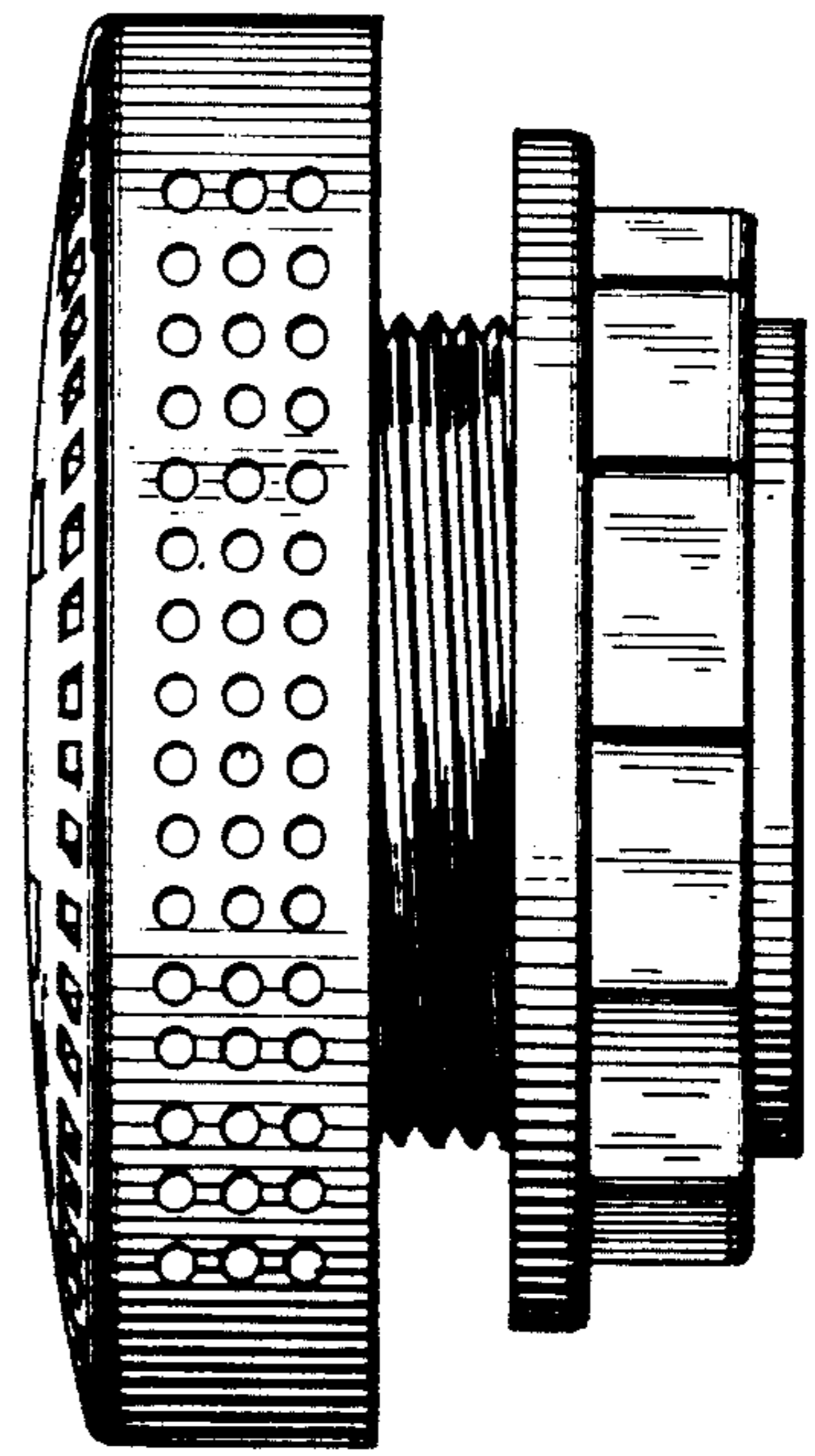
