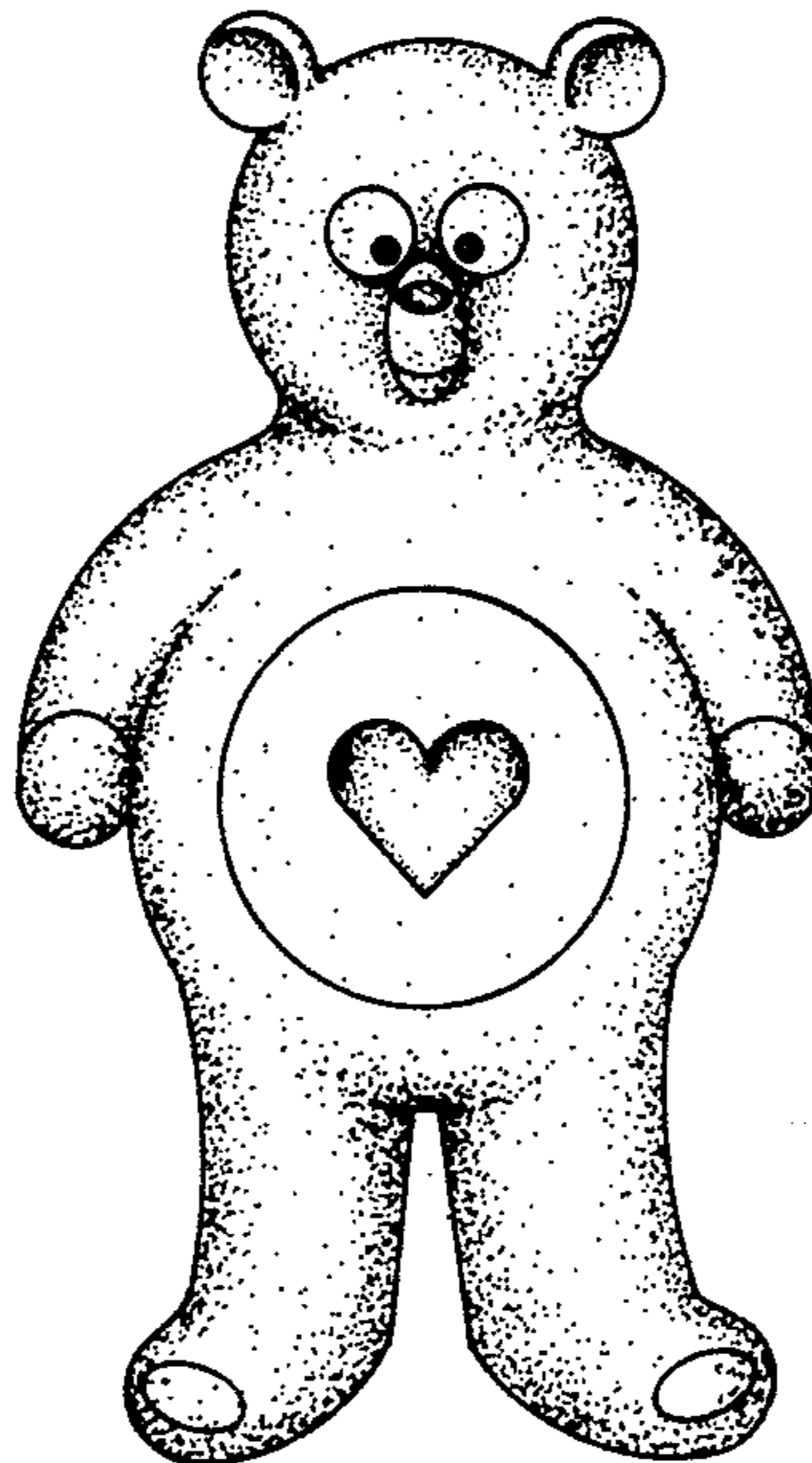

FIG. 3 is a rear elevation view thereof.



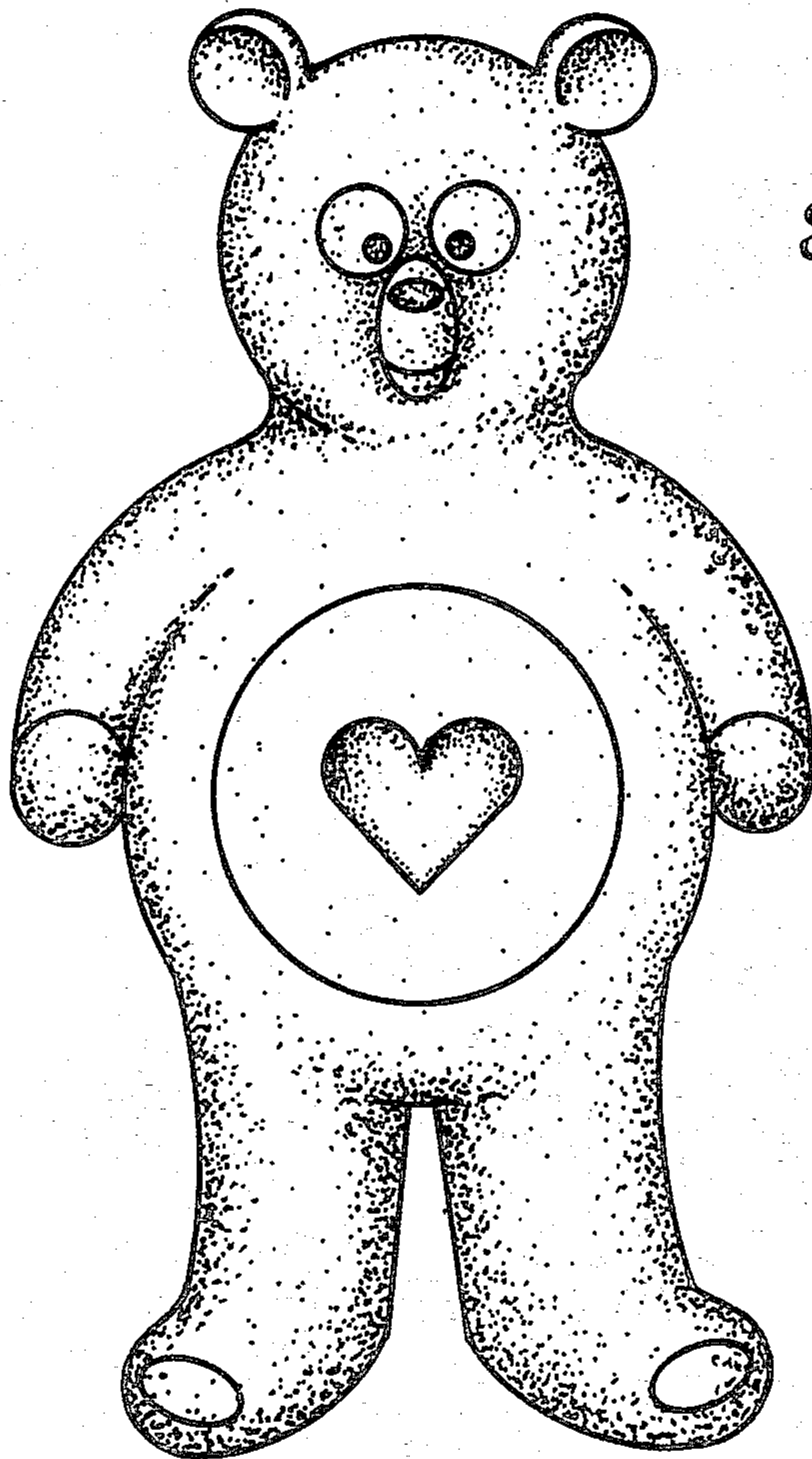

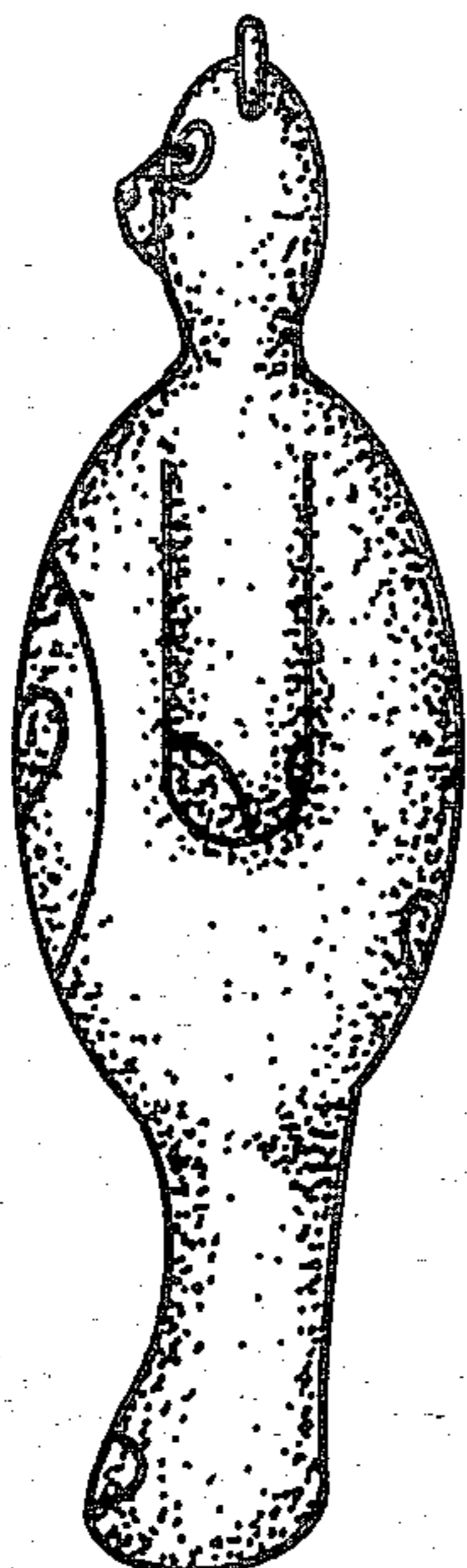

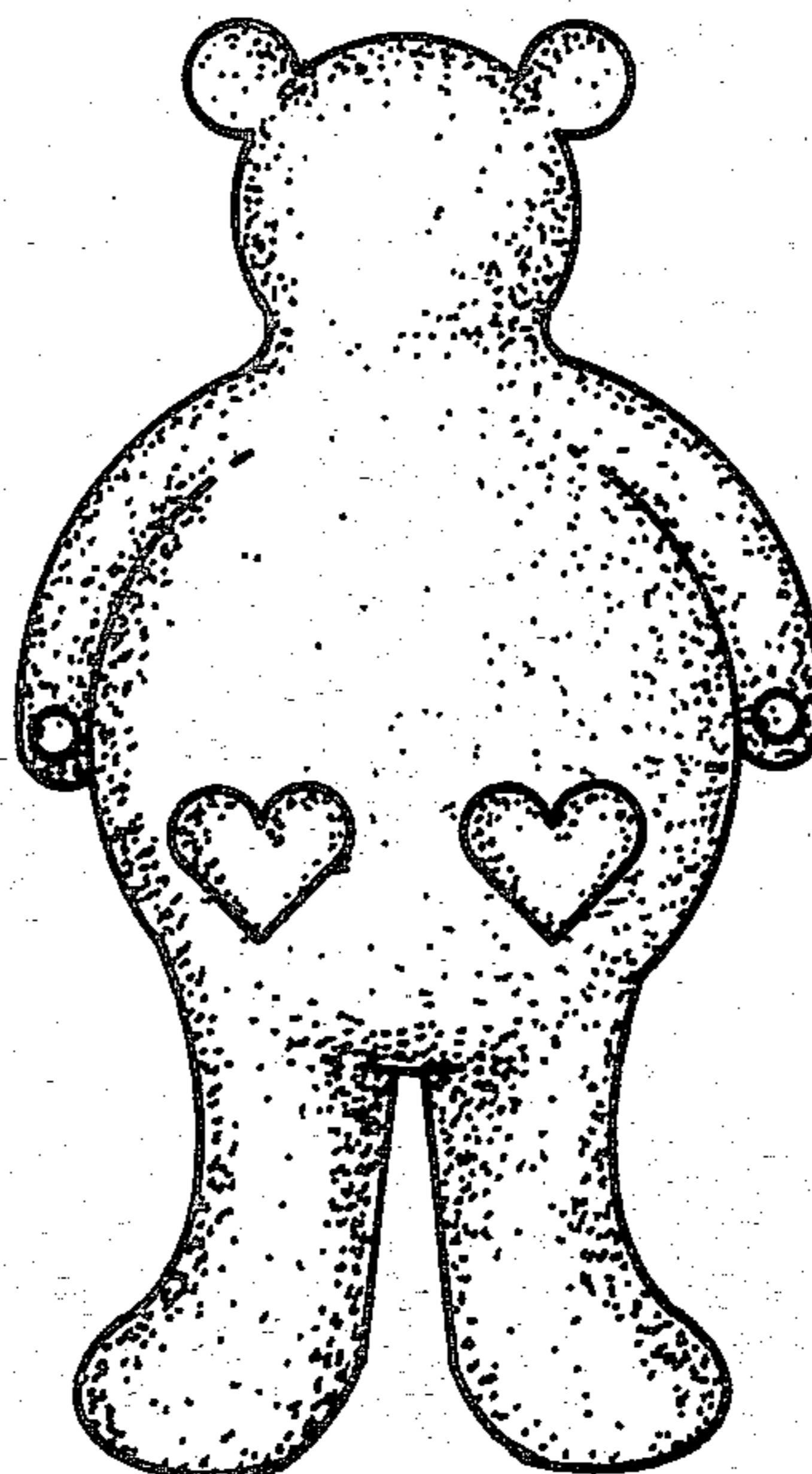
