The ornamental design for a water purifier or similar article, substantially as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a front elevational view of a water purifier or similar article showing my new design; FIG. 2 is a top plan view thereof; FIG. 3 is a bottom plan view thereof; FIG. 4 is a rear elevational view thereof; and FIG. 5 is a right side elevational view thereof, the left side being a mirror image.

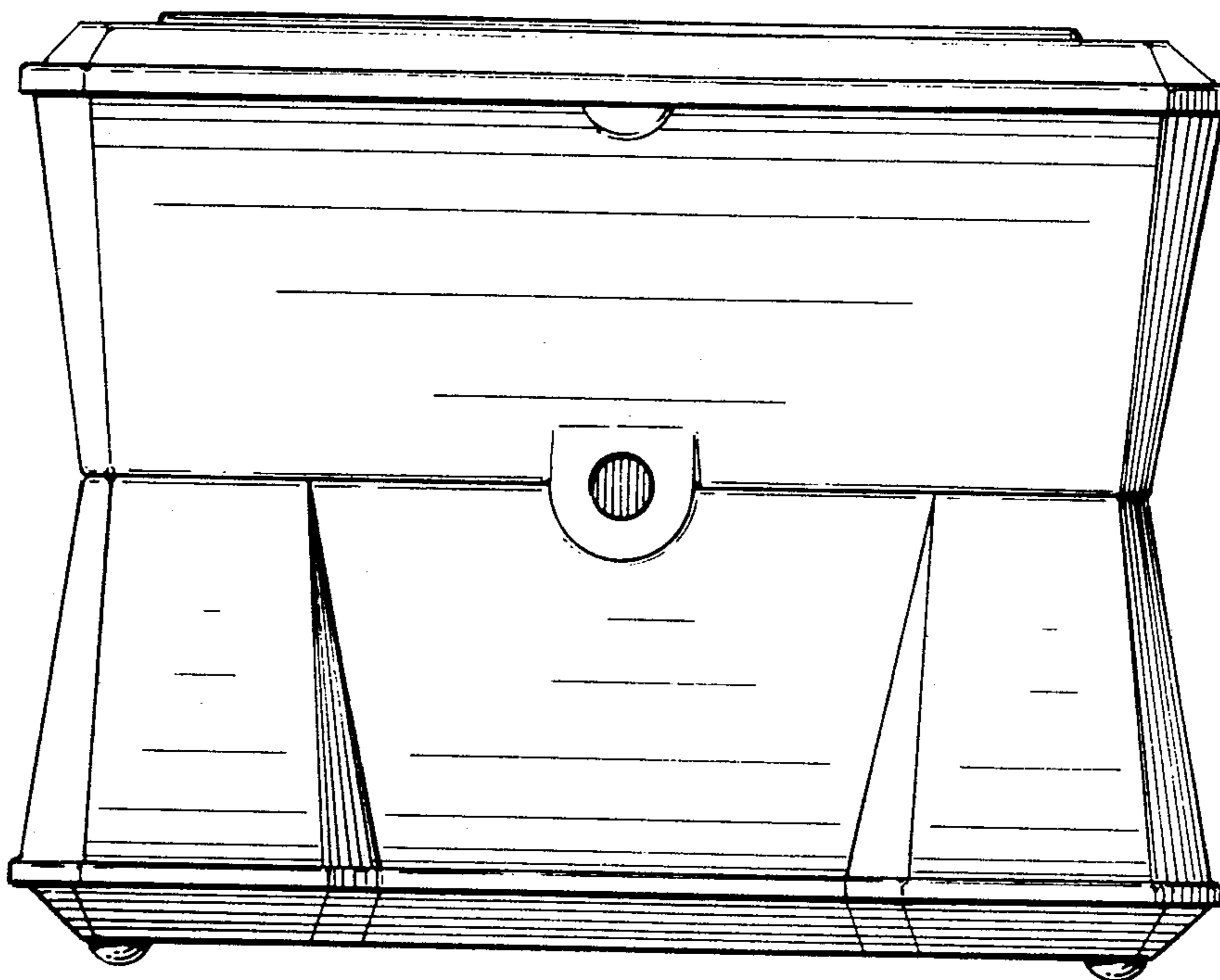

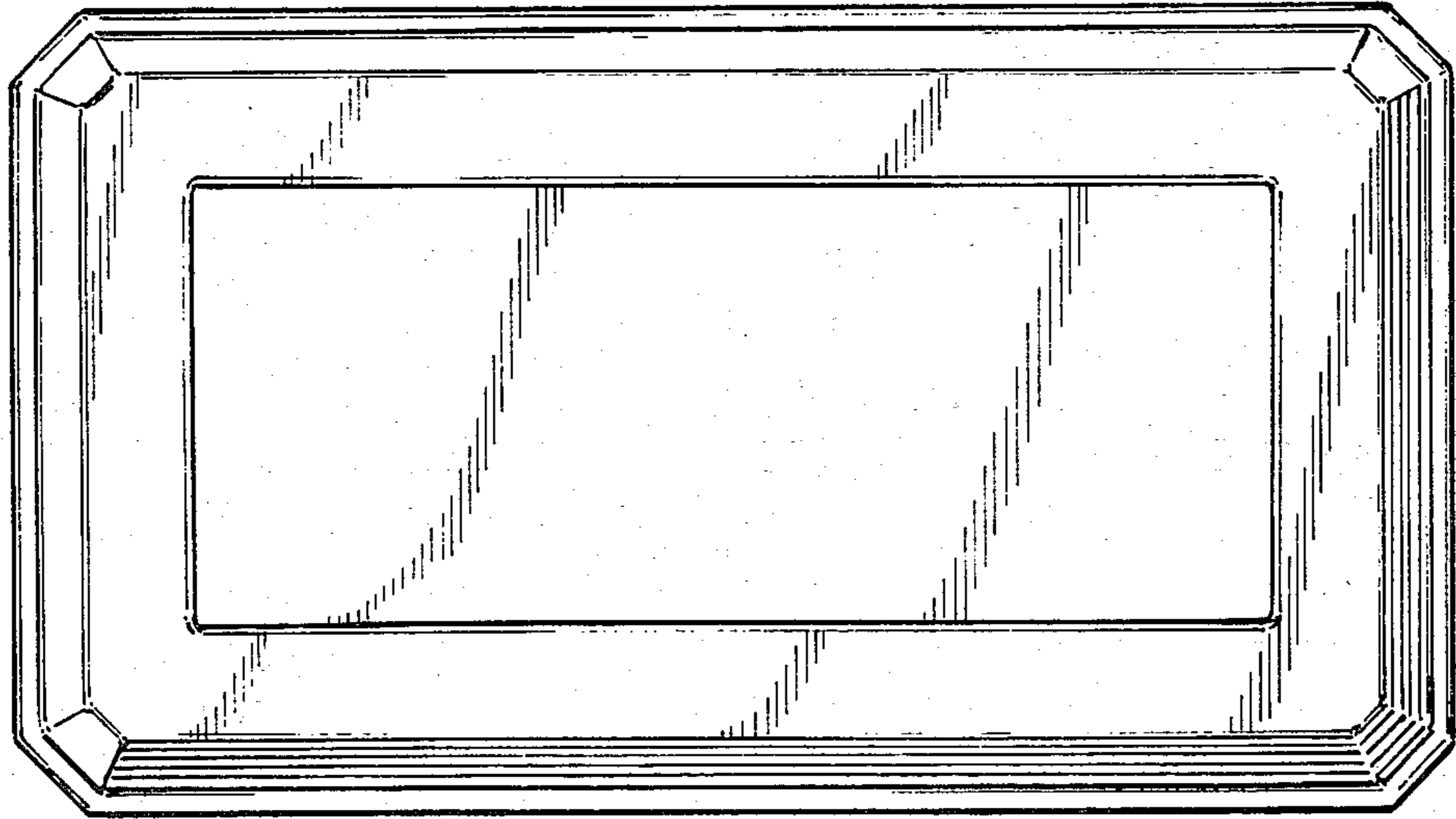

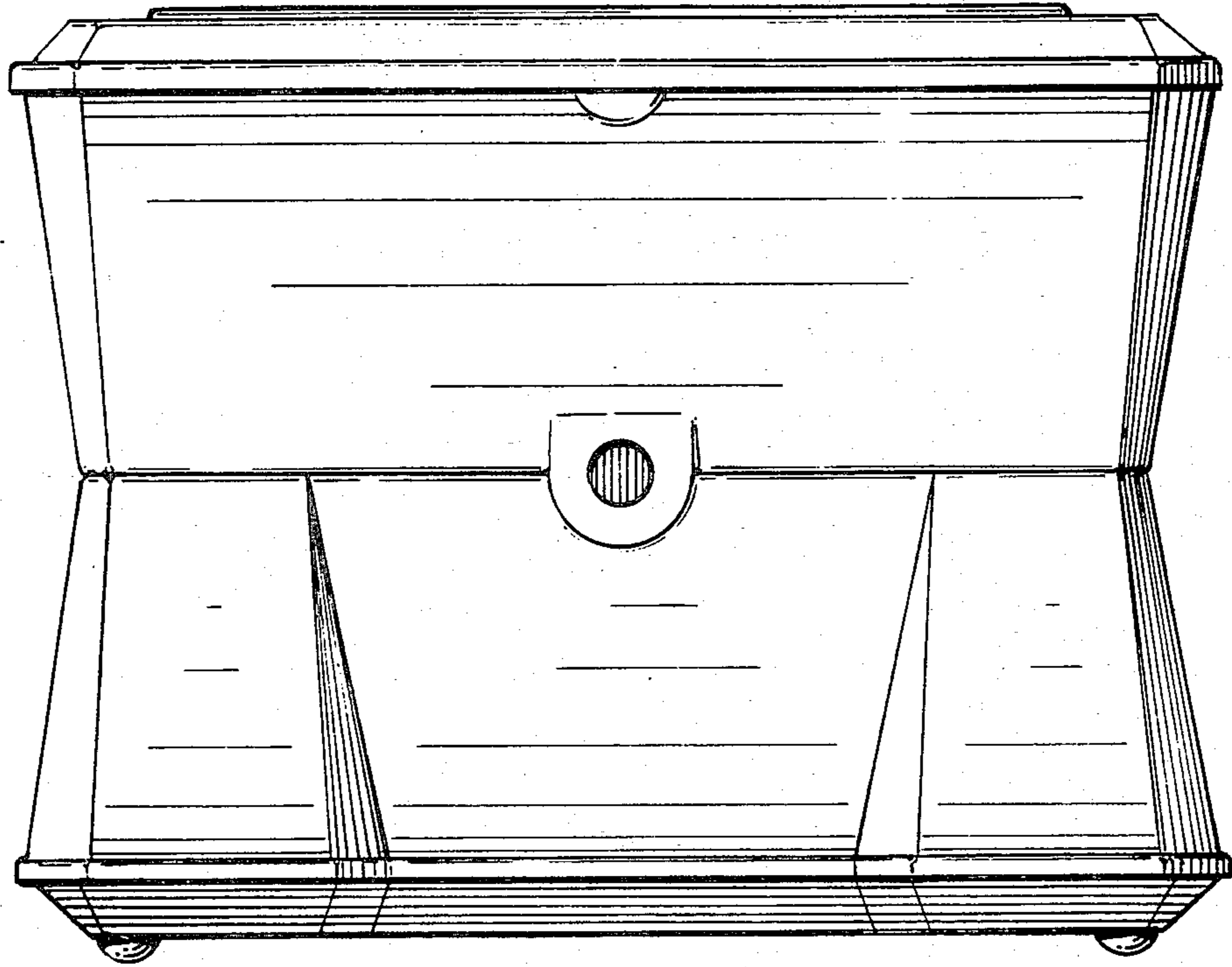

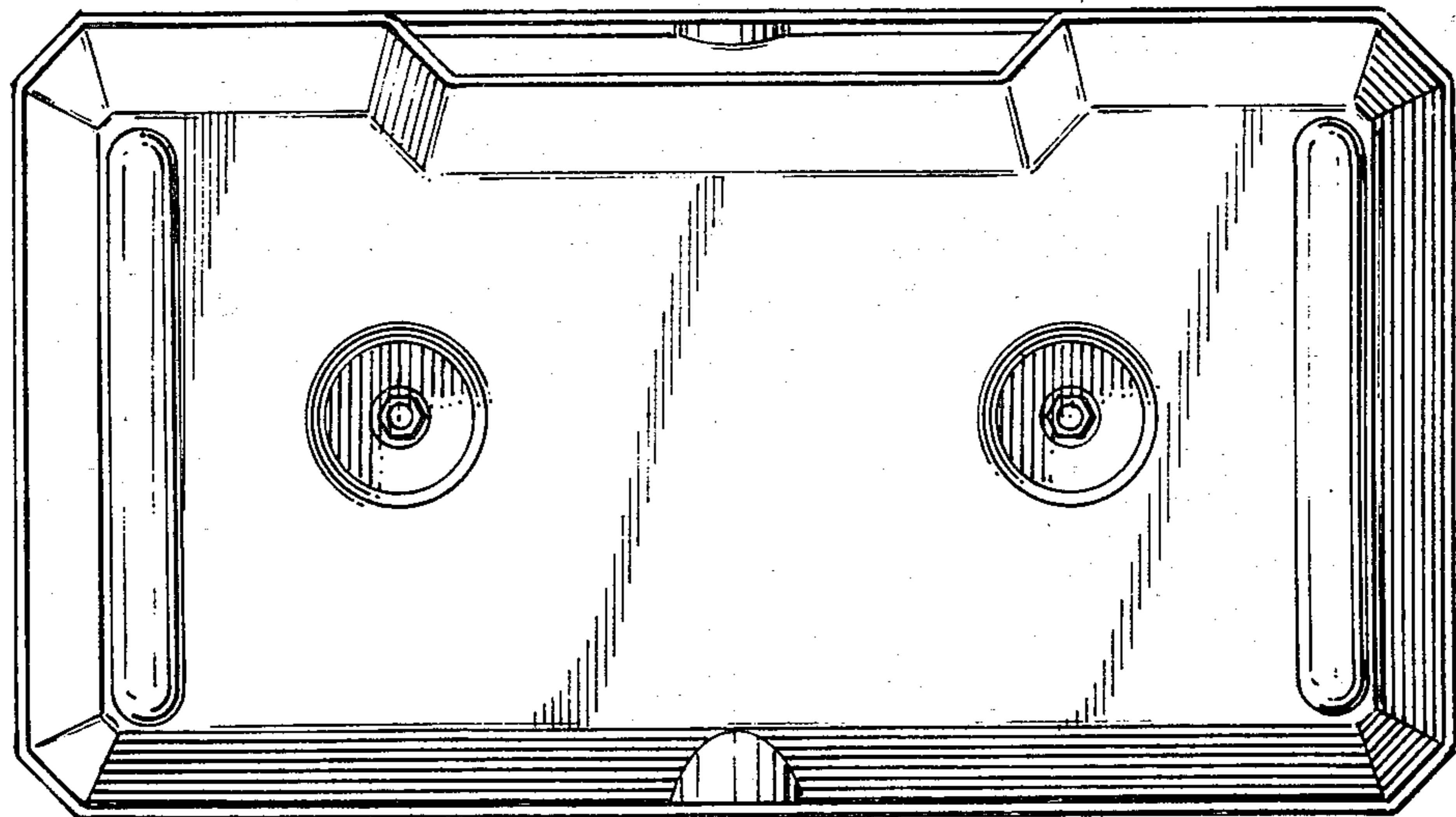

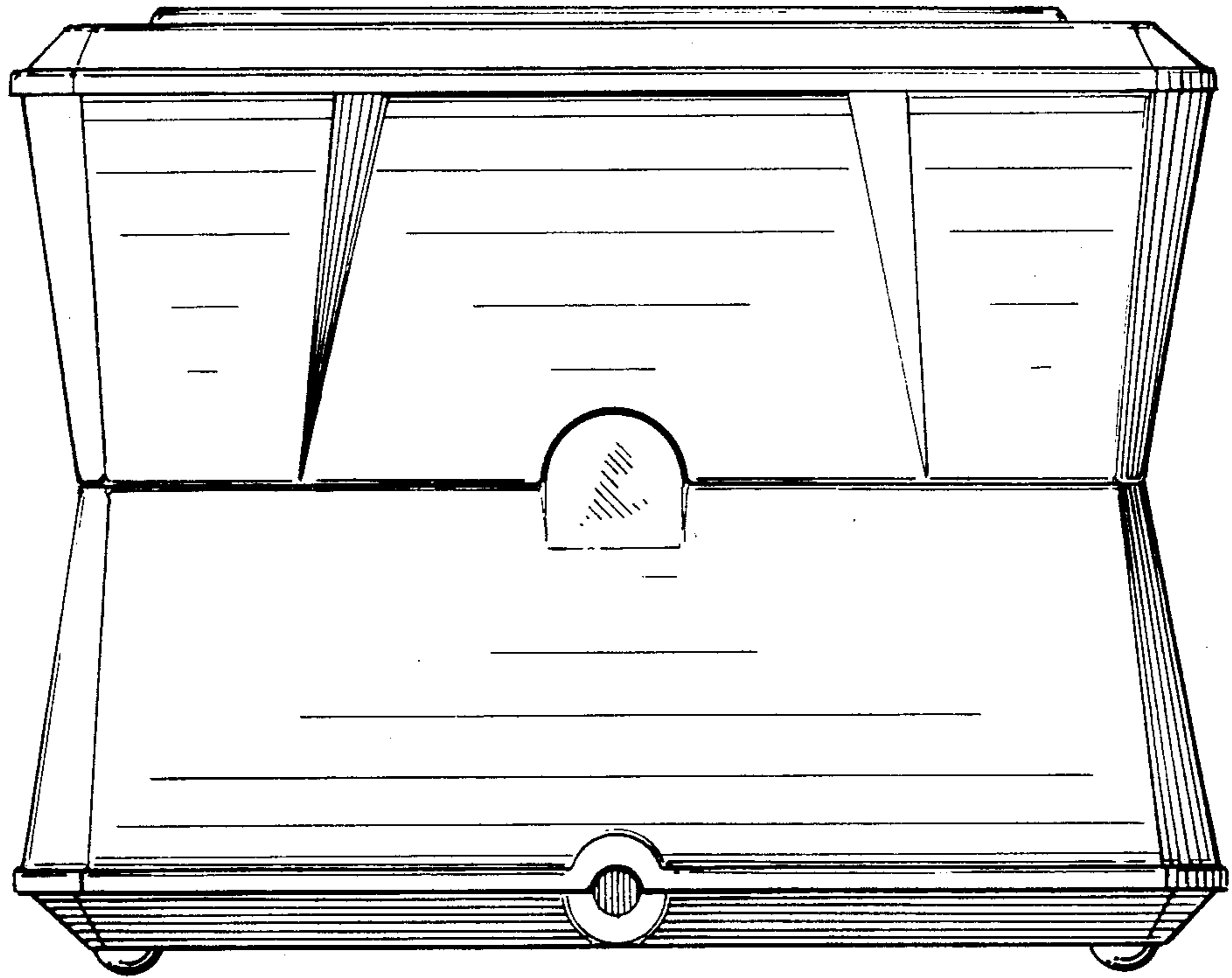
