The ornamental design for a crib end, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a front elevational view of a crib end or similar article showing our design;

FIG. 2 is a top view of the crib end in FIG. 1;


FIG. 3 is a left side elevational view of the crib end in FIG. 1;


FIG. 4 is a bottom view of the crib end in FIG. 1;

FIG. 5 is a sectional view on an enlarged scale and taken along lines 5—5 of FIG. 1.

The invention is characterized by the distinctive shape of the top rail as best shown by FIGS. 3, 4 and 5, and the inclination of the spindles as best shown by FIGS. 3 and 5.
