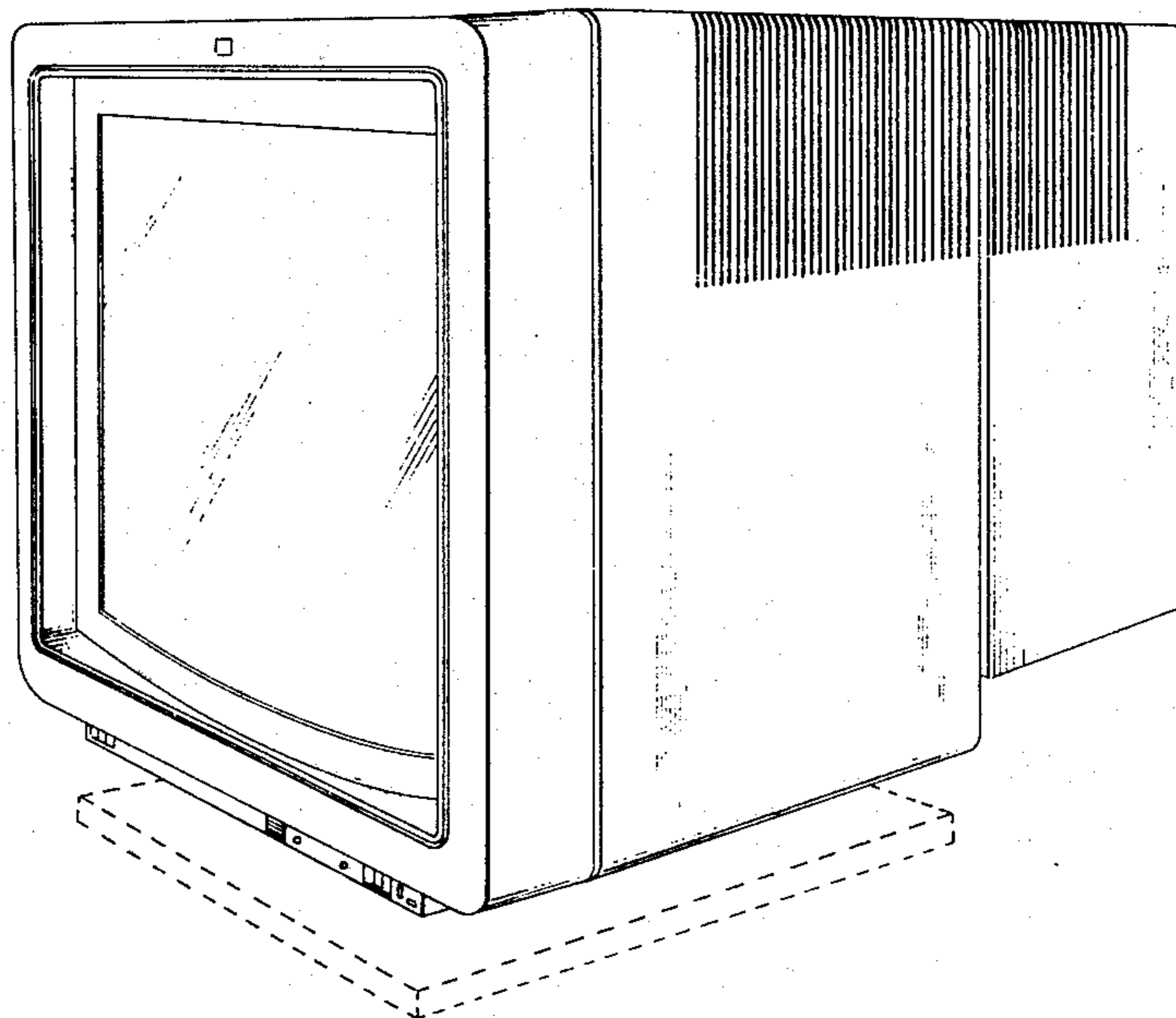

[57] CLAIM

The ornamental design for a computer display or the like, substantially as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is an orthographic front view of the computer display or the like showing our new design; FIG. 2 is an orthographic rear view thereof; FIG. 3 is an orthographic right side view thereof, the left side being a mirror image; FIG. 4 is an orthographic top view thereof; FIG. 5 is a front perspective view thereof; FIG. 6 is a rear perspective view thereof. The base is shown in broken lines for illustrative purposes only.



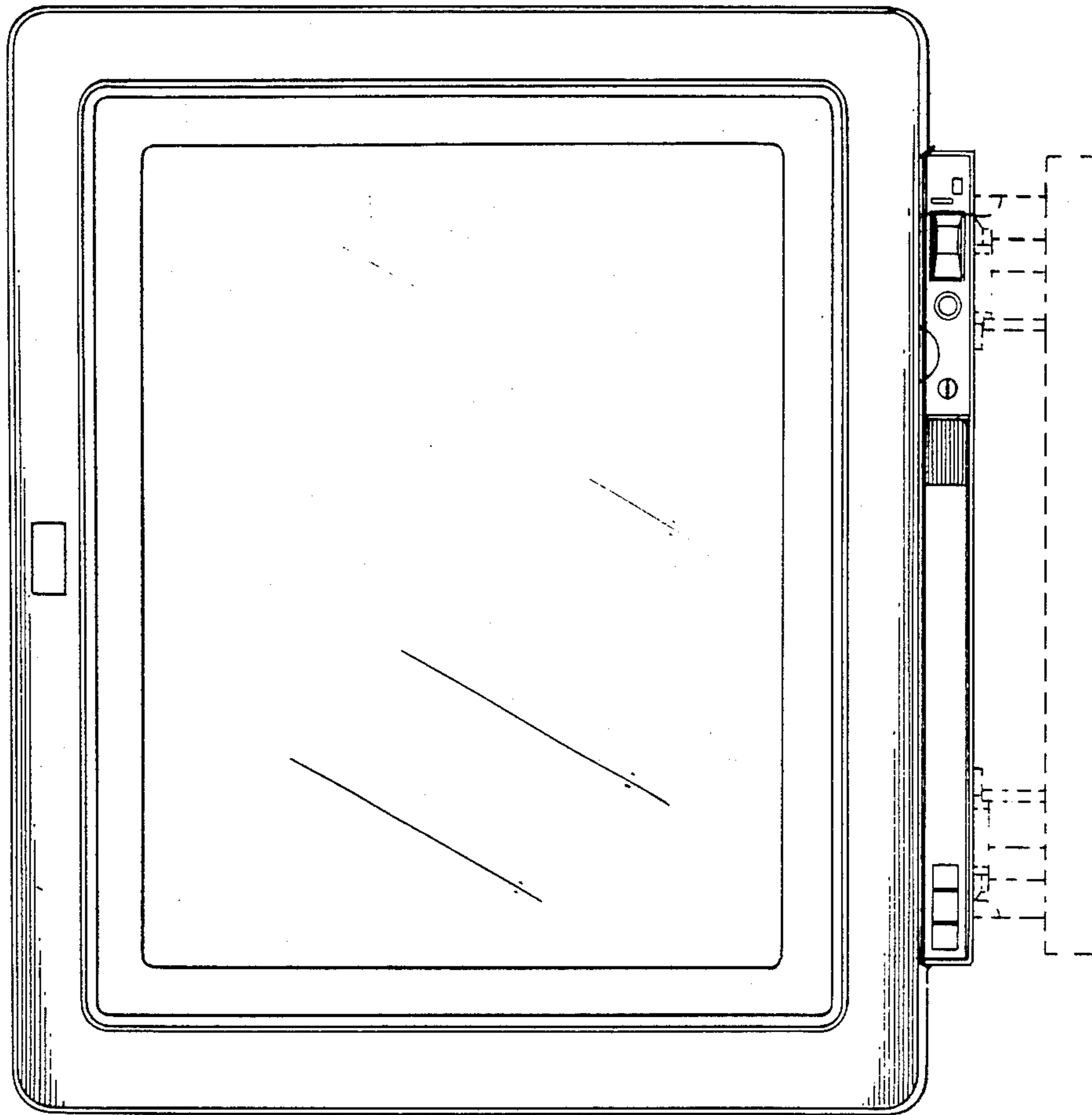

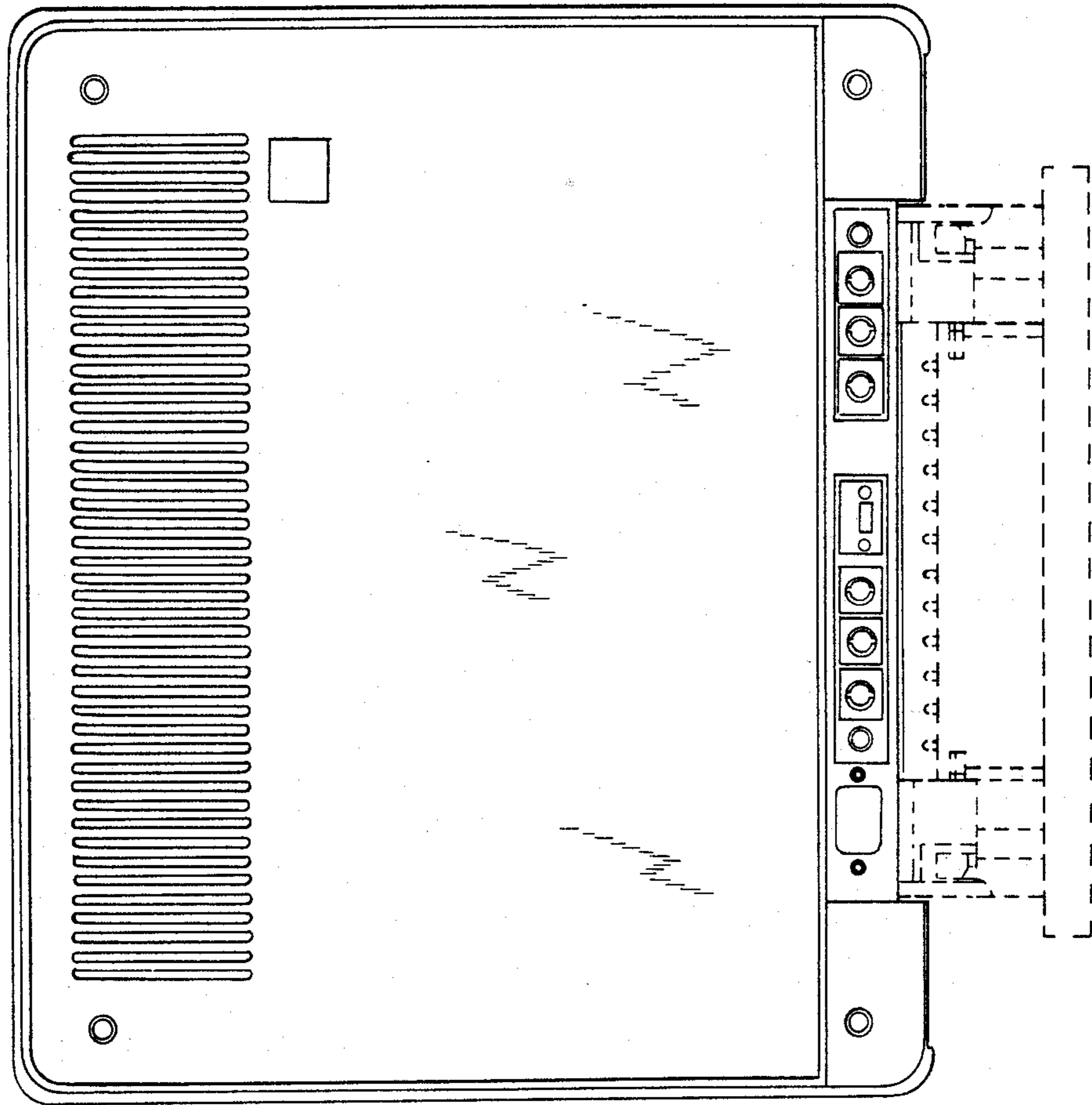

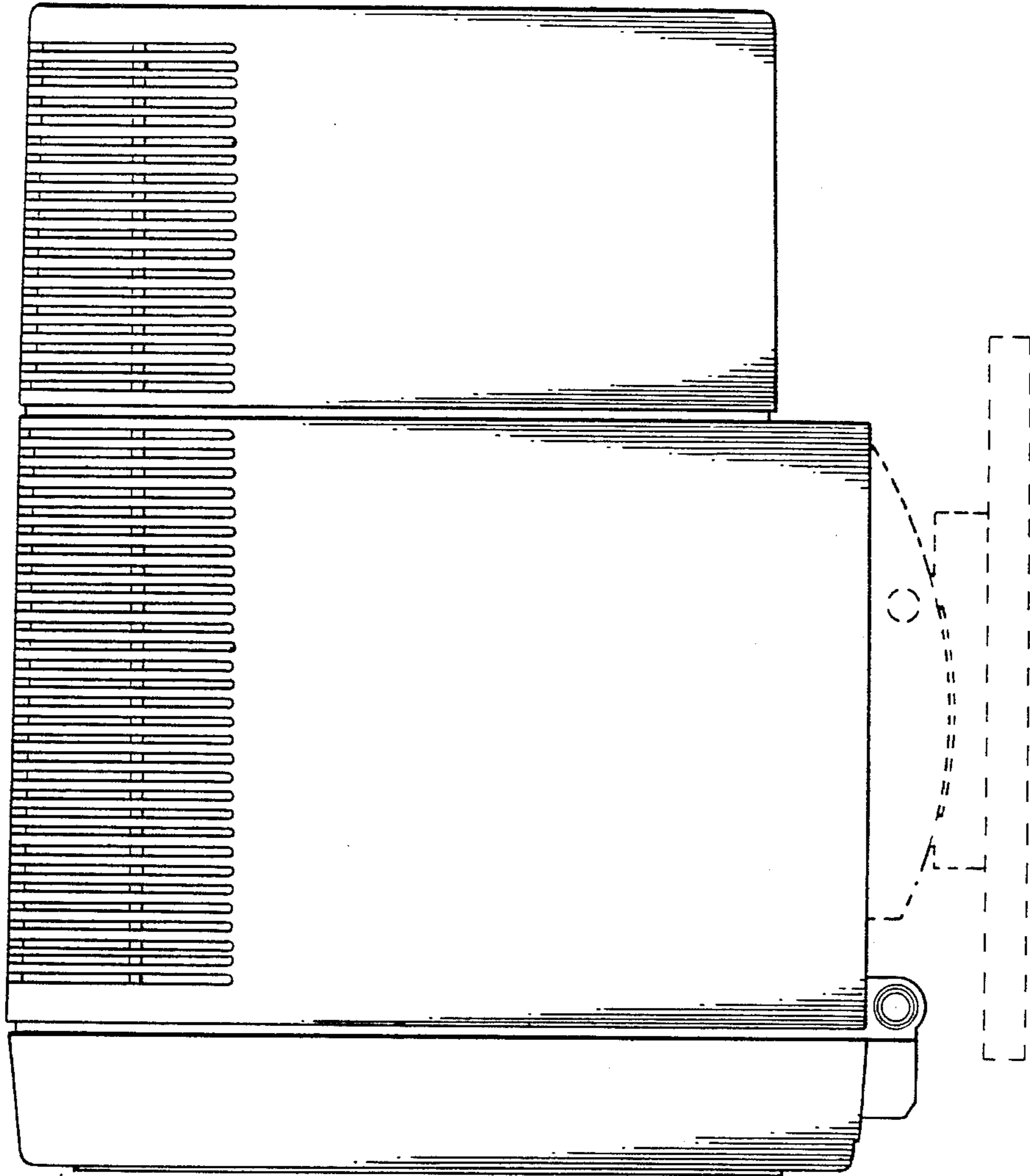

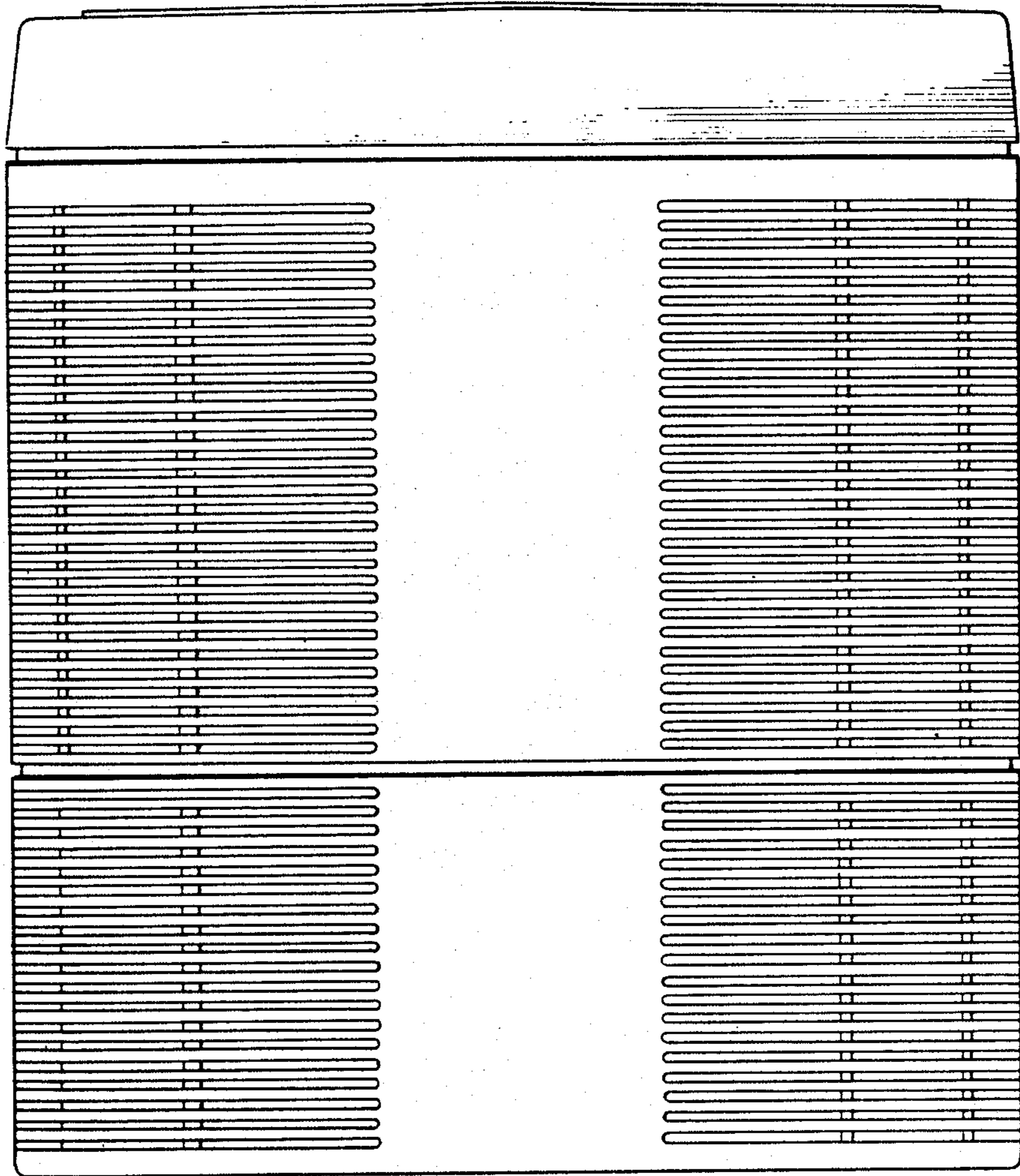

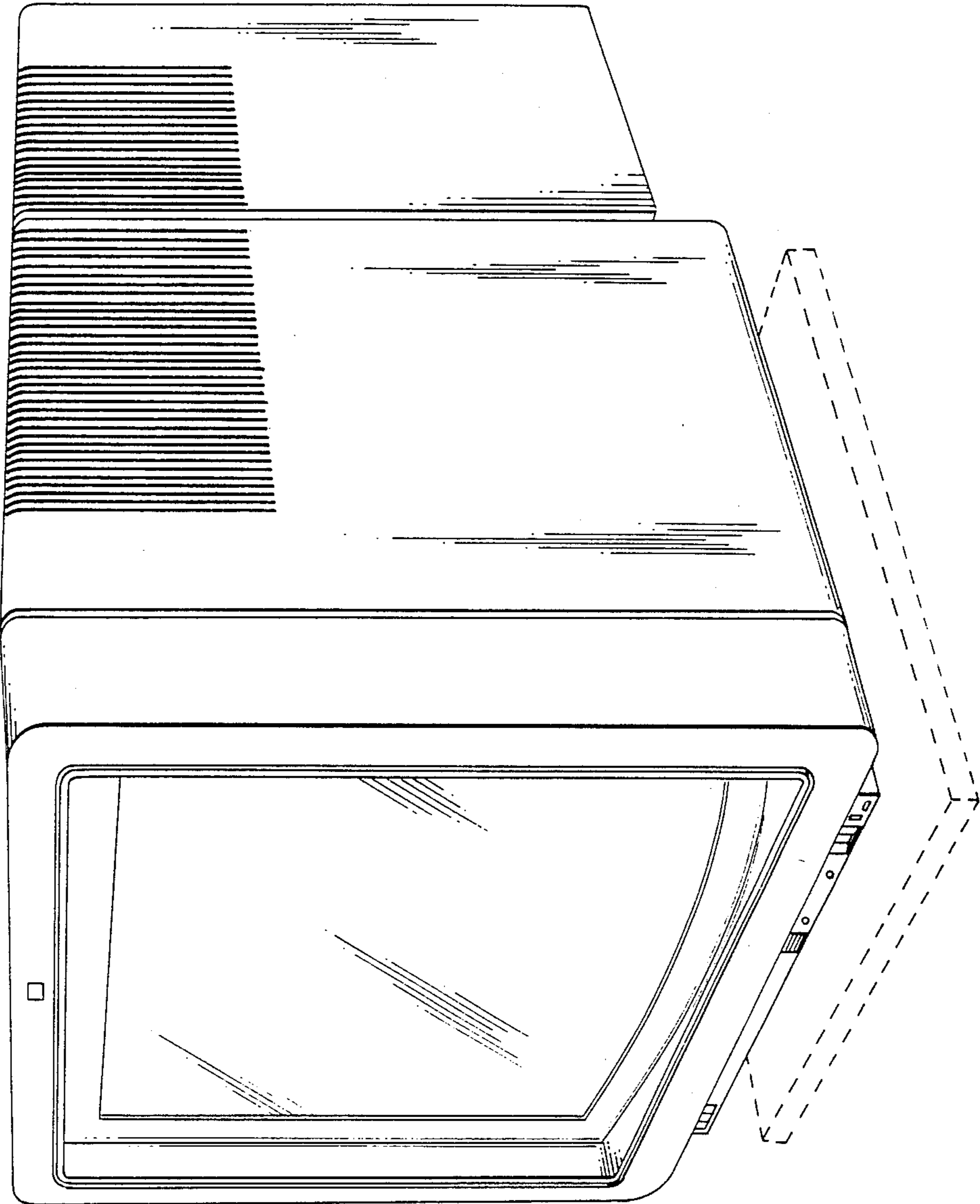

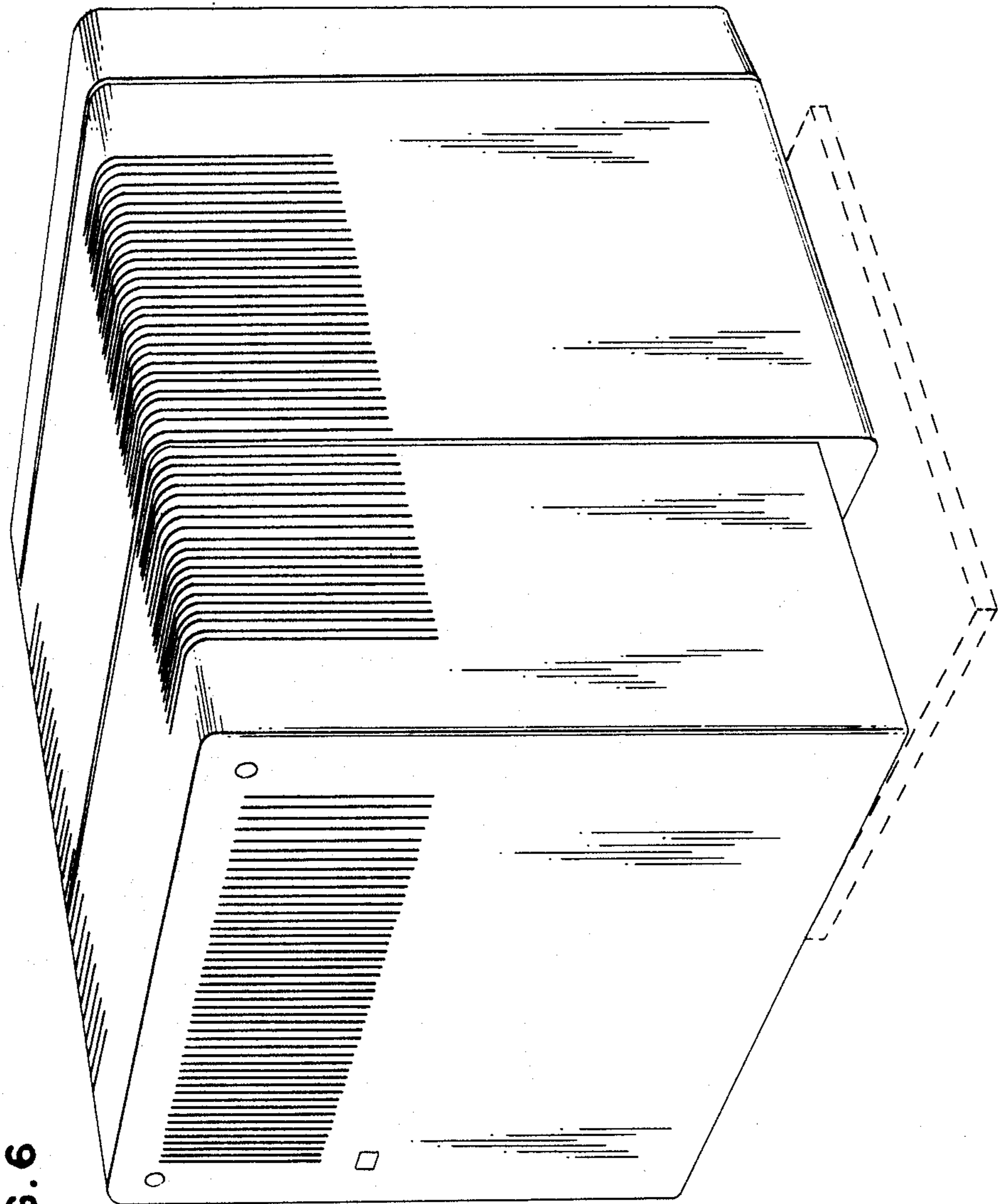
