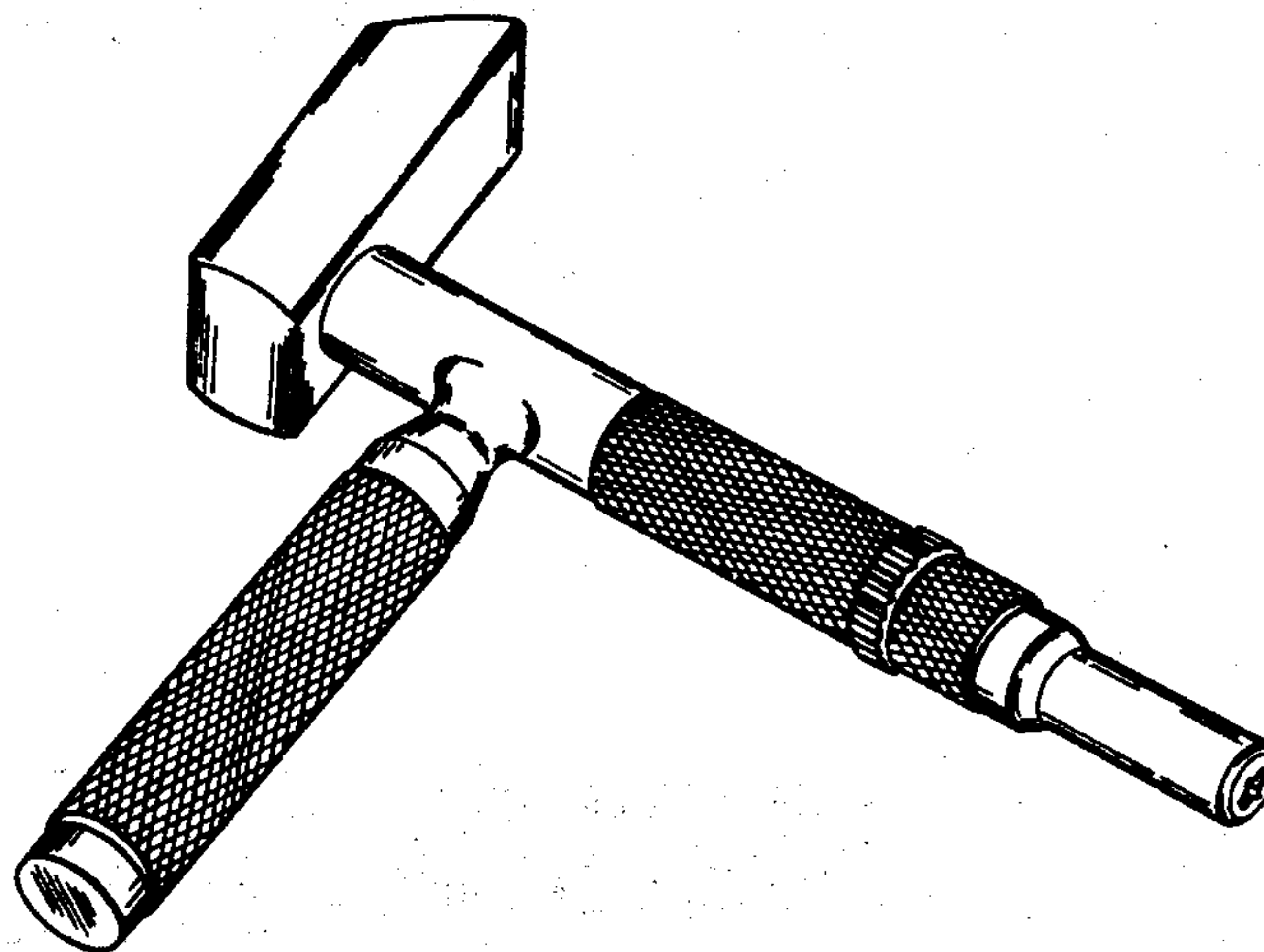
The ornamental design for a combined driver and ex-

FIG. 3 is a front end elevational view thereof.



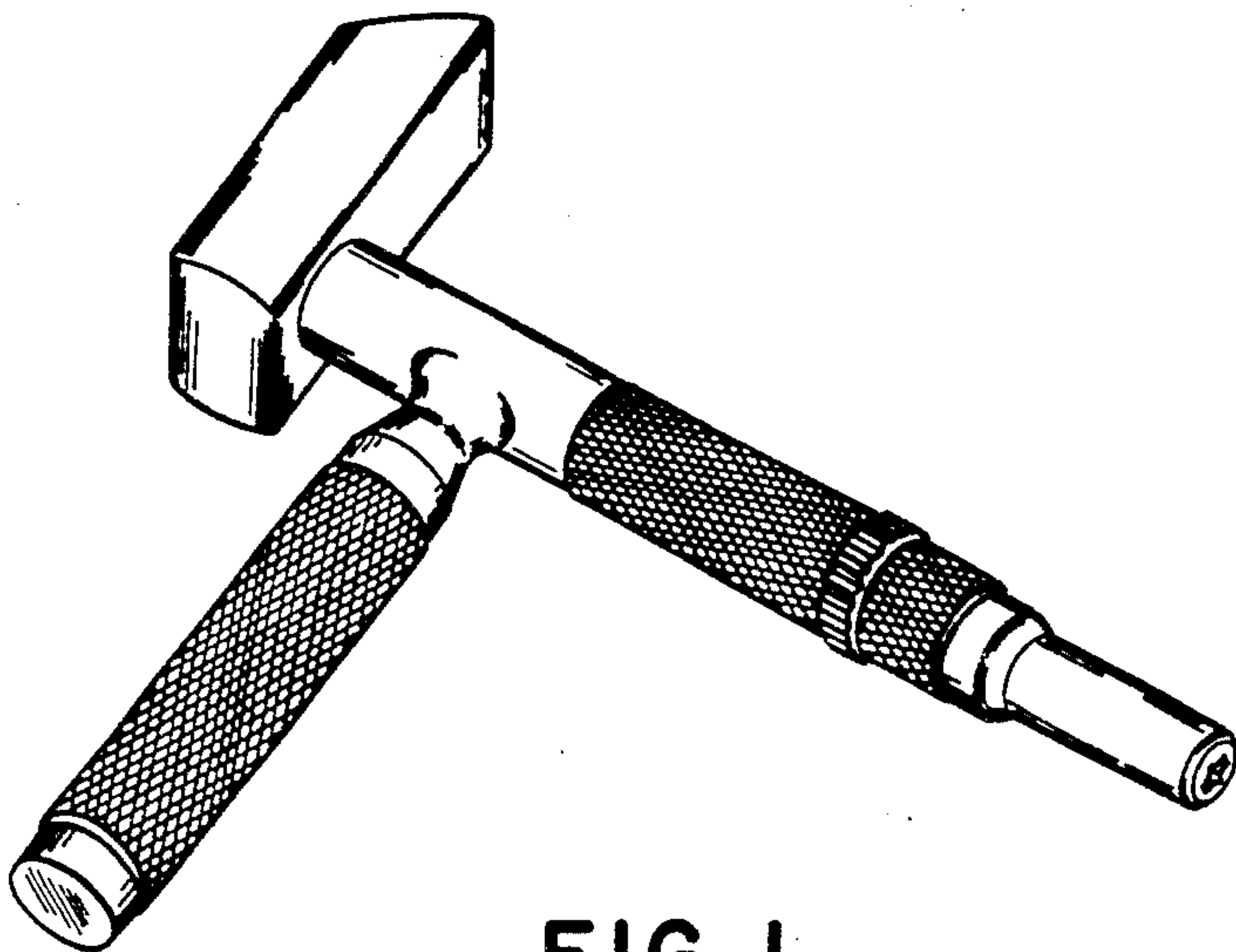

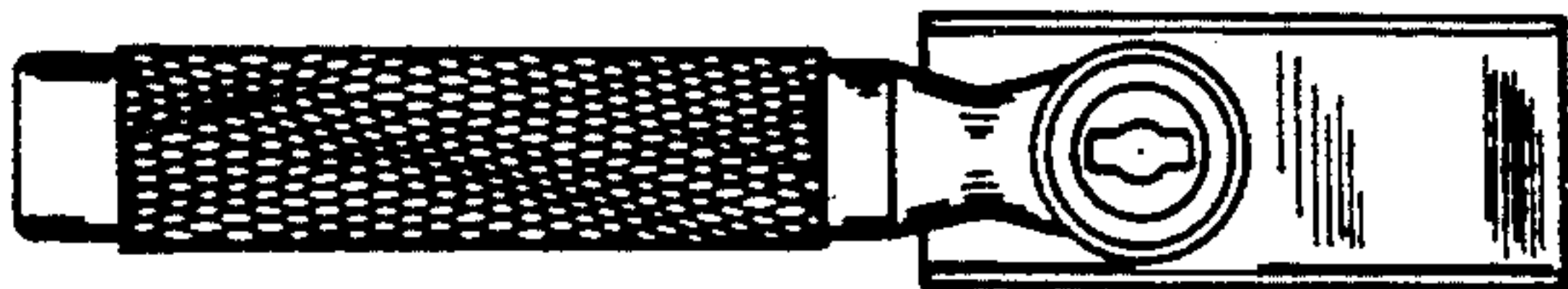
