[57] CLAIM

The ornamental design for a pick-up unit for animal droppings, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a perspective view of a pick-up unit for animal droppings showing my new design;
 FIG. 2 is an elevational view taken from one end thereof;
 FIG. 3 is an elevational view taken from the end opposite that shown in FIG. 2;
 FIG. 4 is a side elevational view thereof, the opposite side being the same as the side shown;
 FIG. 5 is a top plan view thereof; and
 FIG. 6 is a bottom plan view thereof;
 The broken line representation of litter and a litter bag in FIG. 1 is for purposes of illustration only.

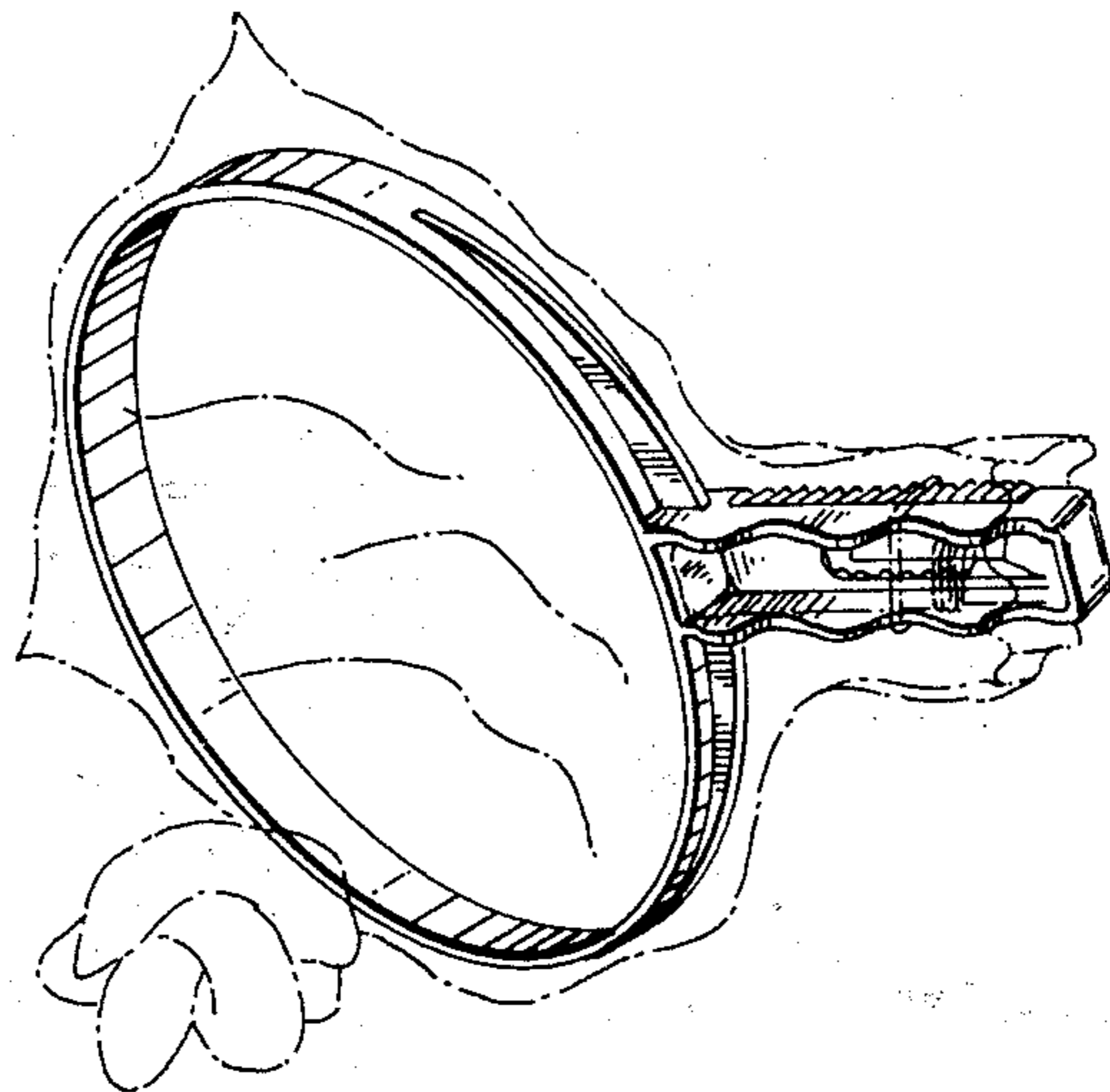

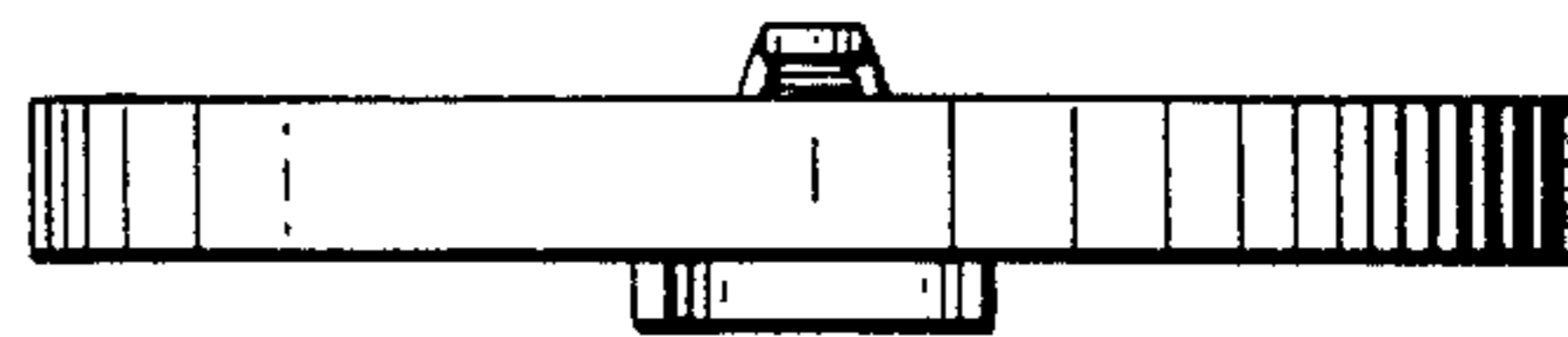
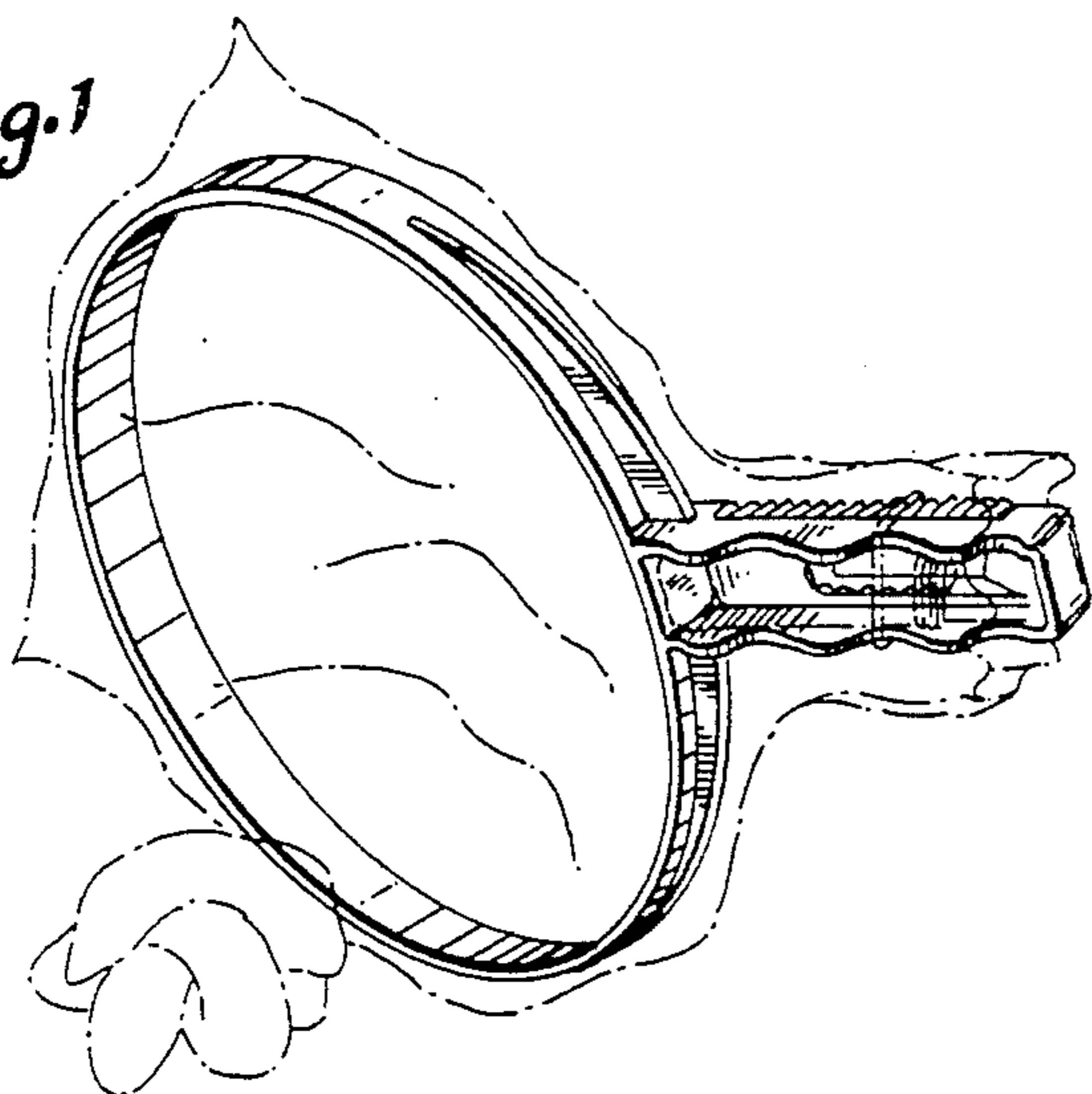

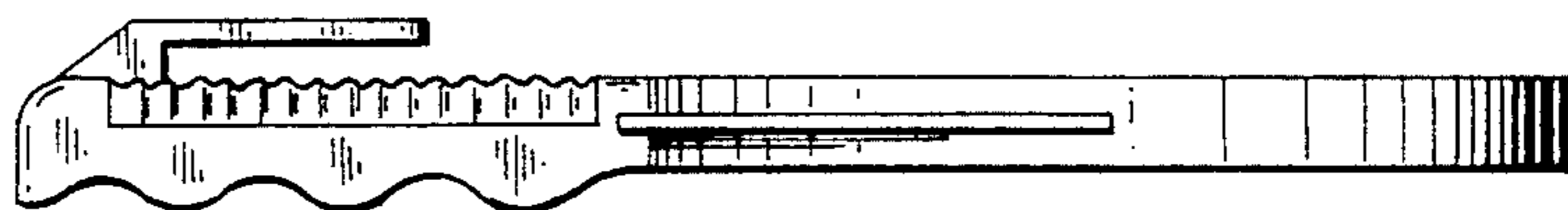

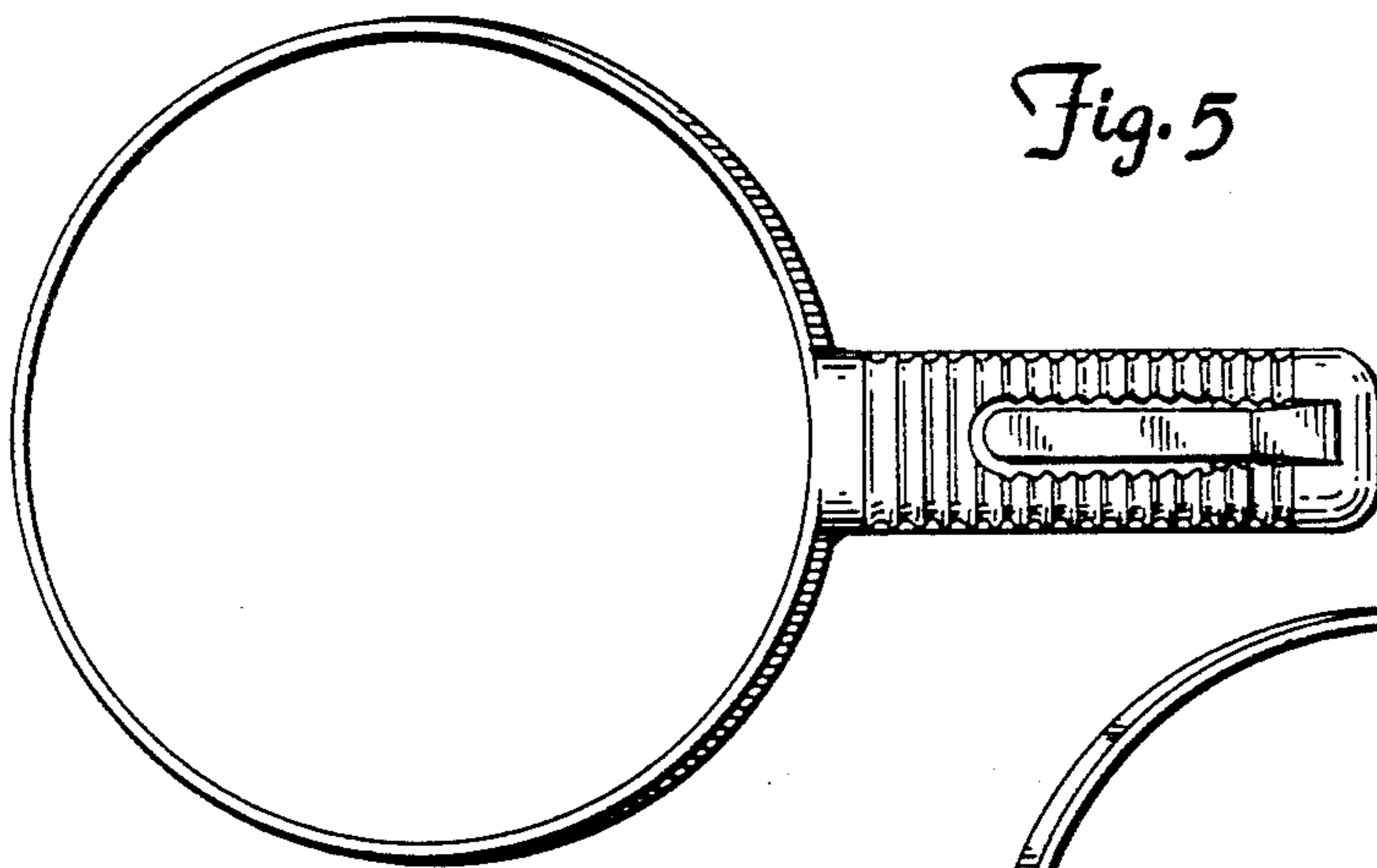
