FIG. 1 is a perspective view of a combined spoiler and light showing our new design.

FIG. 2 is a top plan view.

FIG. 3 is a rear elevational view.

FIG. 4 is an enlarged side elevational view taken along line 4—4 of FIG. 2.

FIG. 5 is an enlarged sectional view taken along line 5—5 of FIG. 2.

FIG. 6 is an enlarged sectional view taken along line 6—6 of FIG. 2.

FIG. 7 is an enlarged sectional view taken along line 7—7 of FIG. 2.

FIG. 8 is an enlarged fragmentary sectional view taken along line 8—8 of FIG. 2, and

FIG. 9 is an enlarged fragmentary sectional view taken along line 9—9 of FIG. 2.
