FIG. 3 is a bottom plan view thereof;

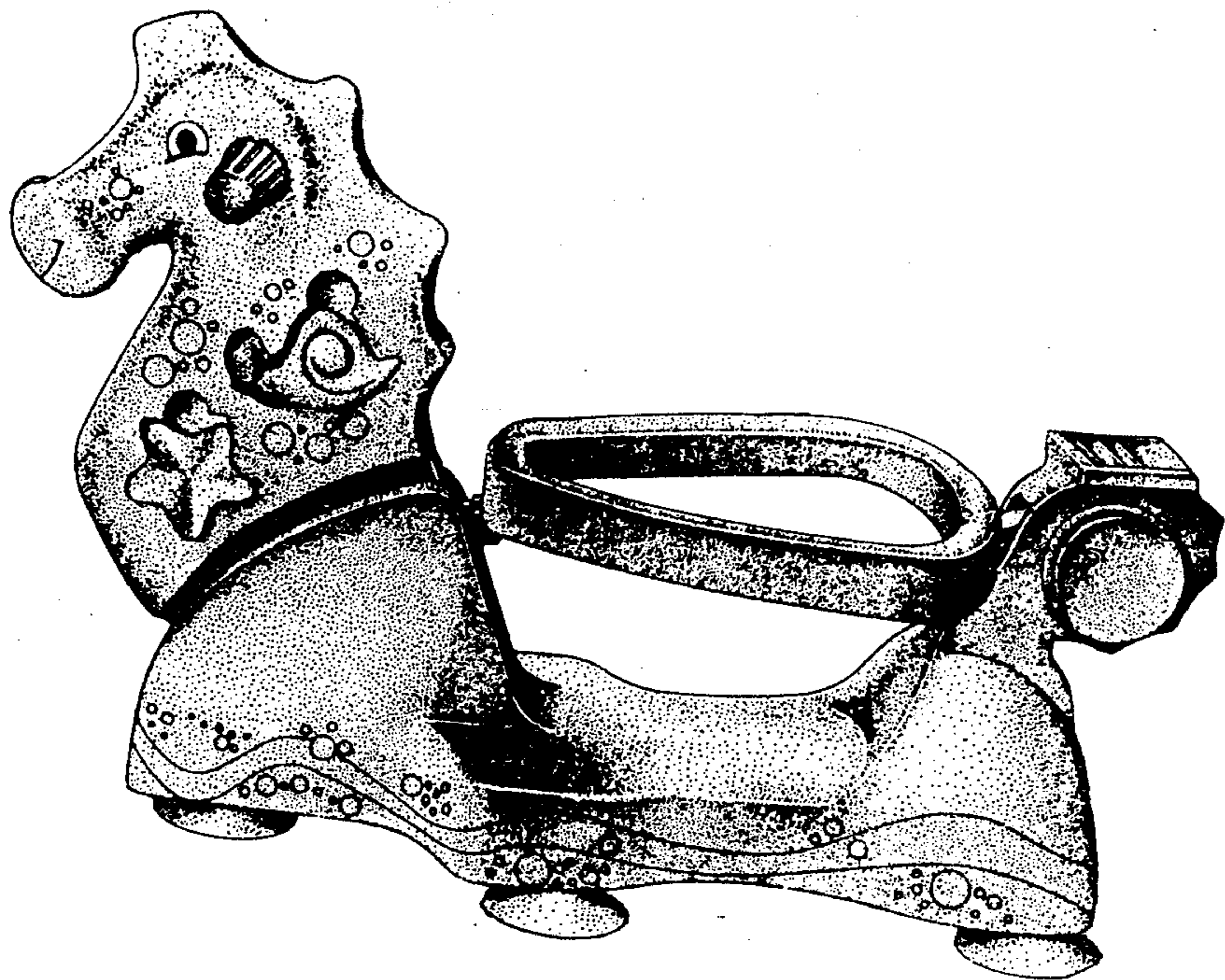
FIG. 4 is a perspective view thereof with the toy figures in an attached position; and,

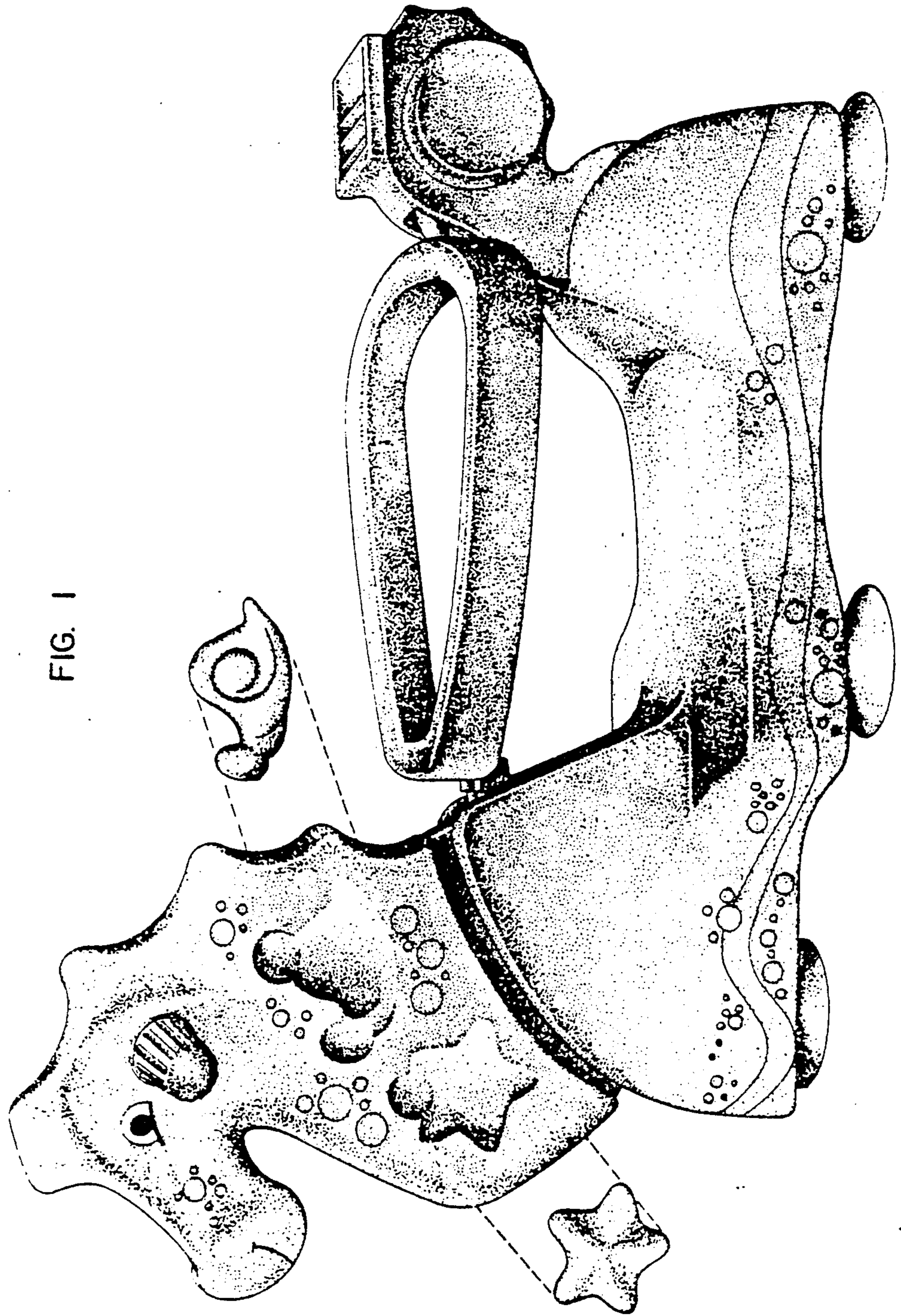

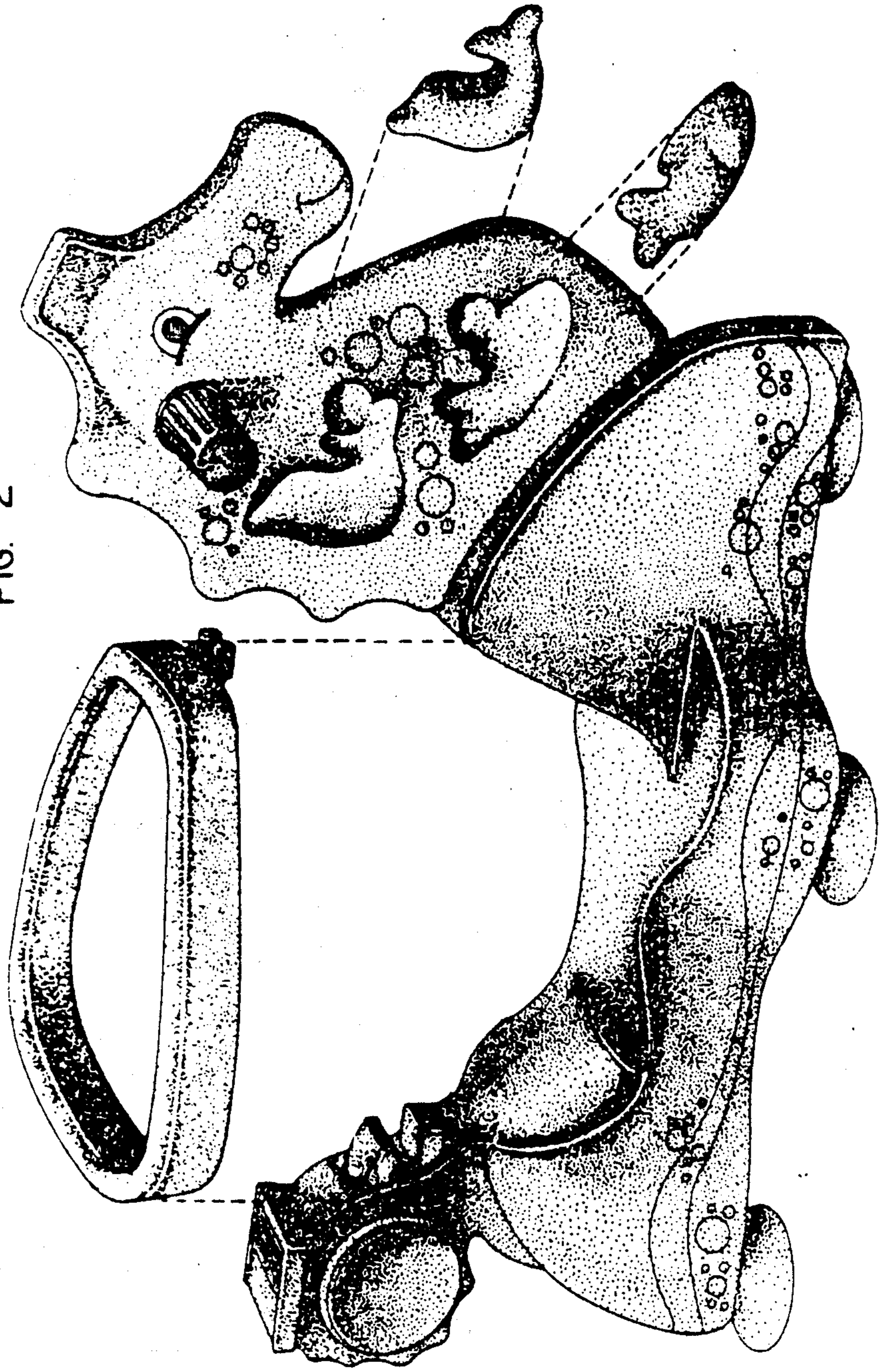

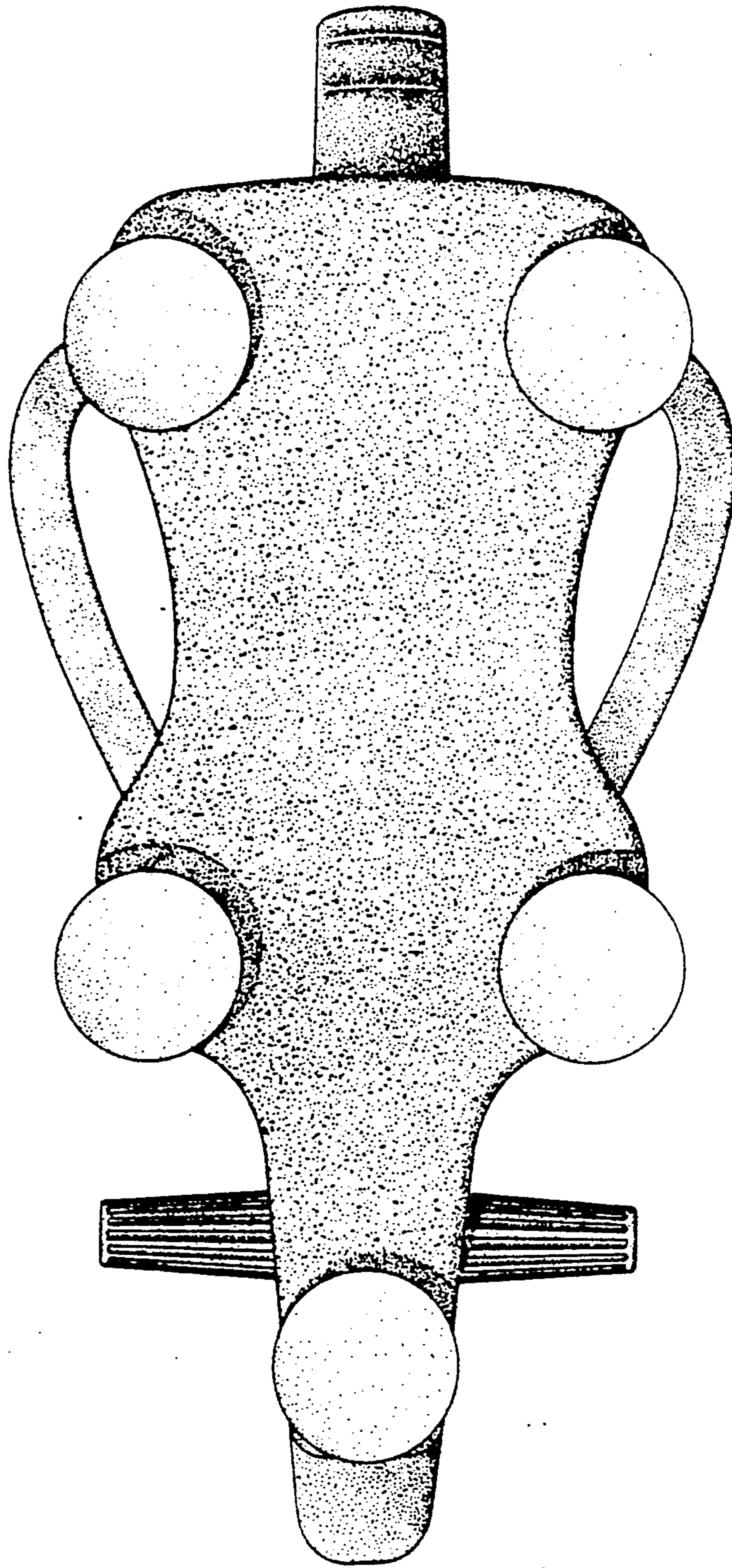
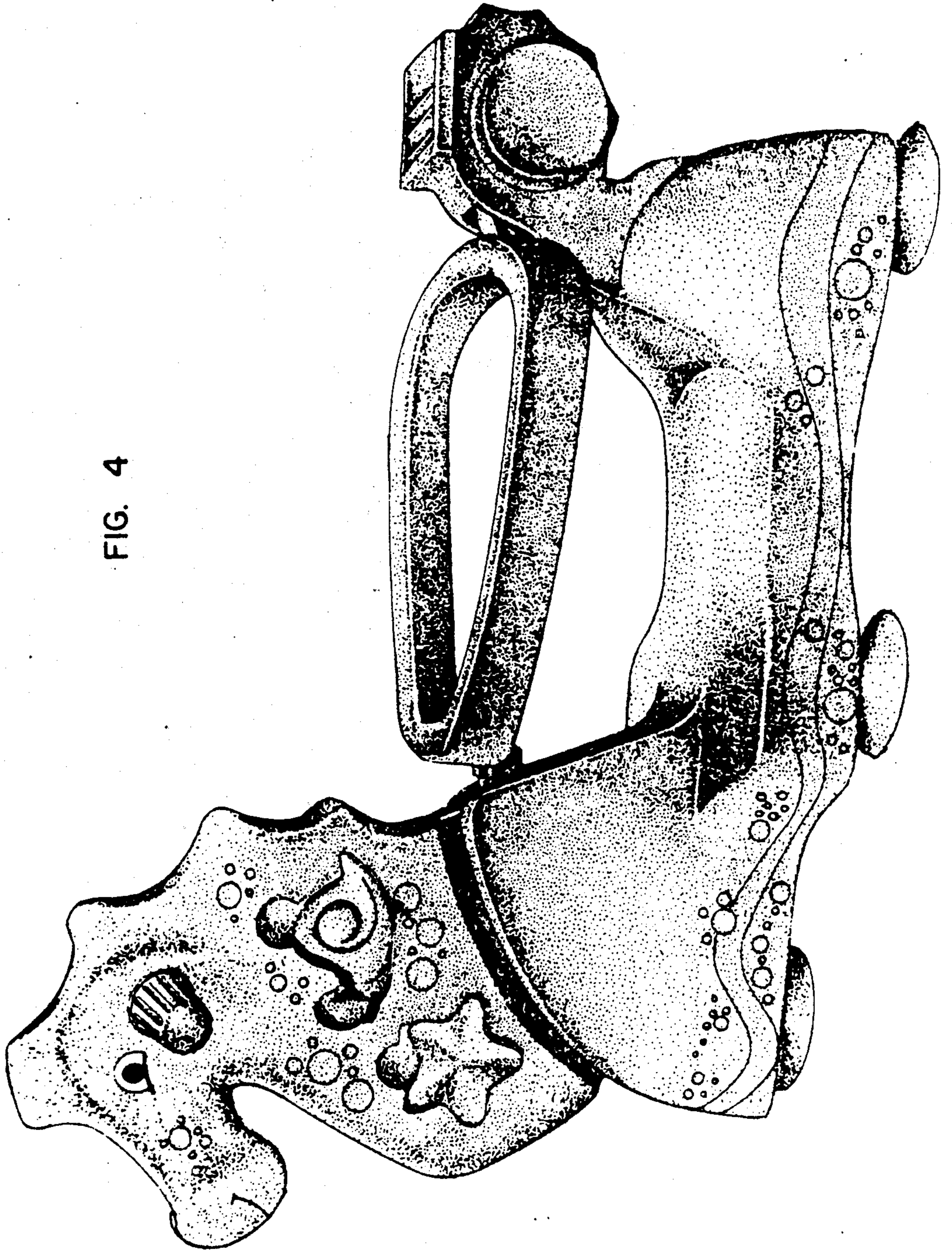

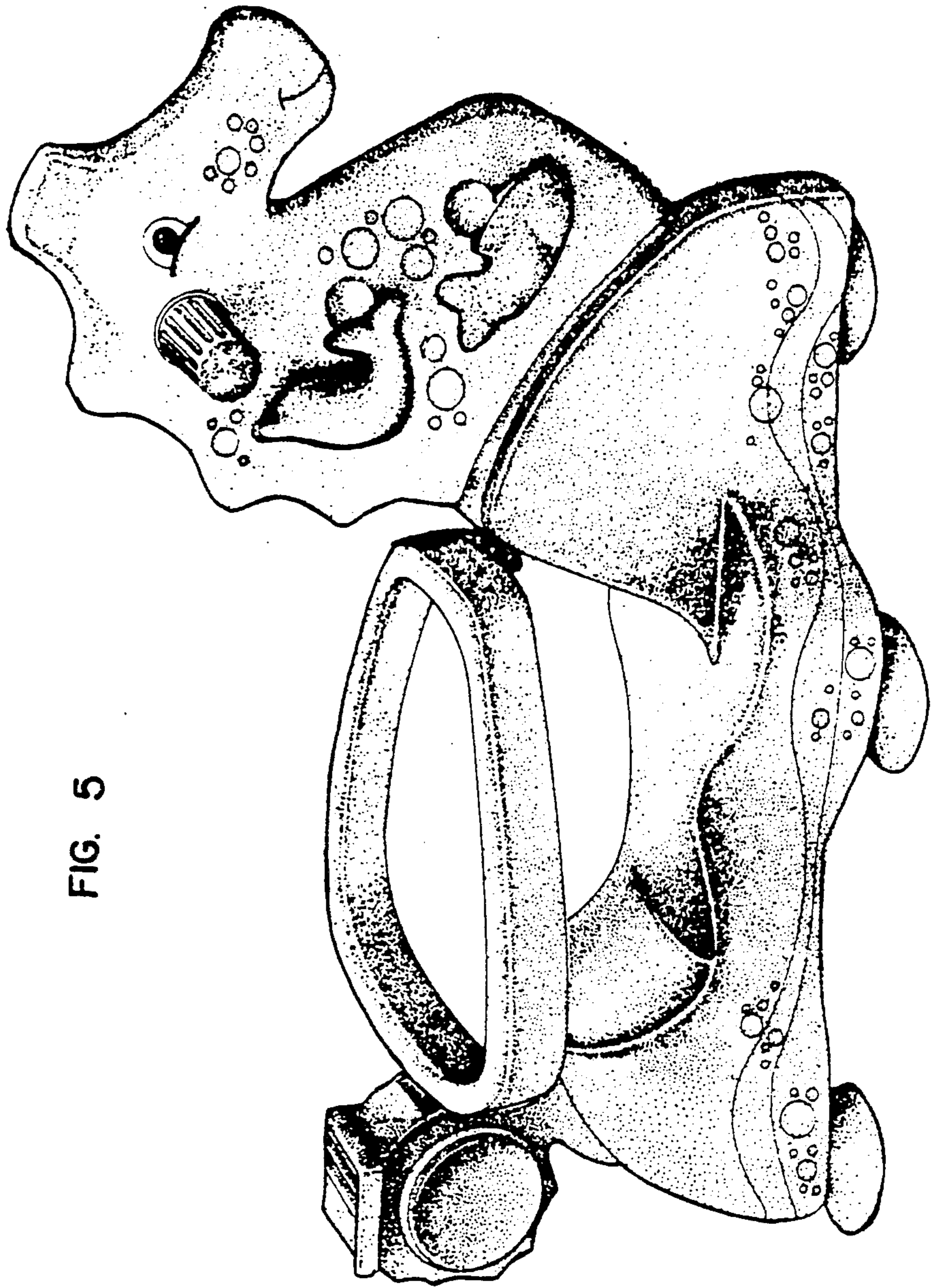
