The ornamental design for a racquetball racquet, as shown.

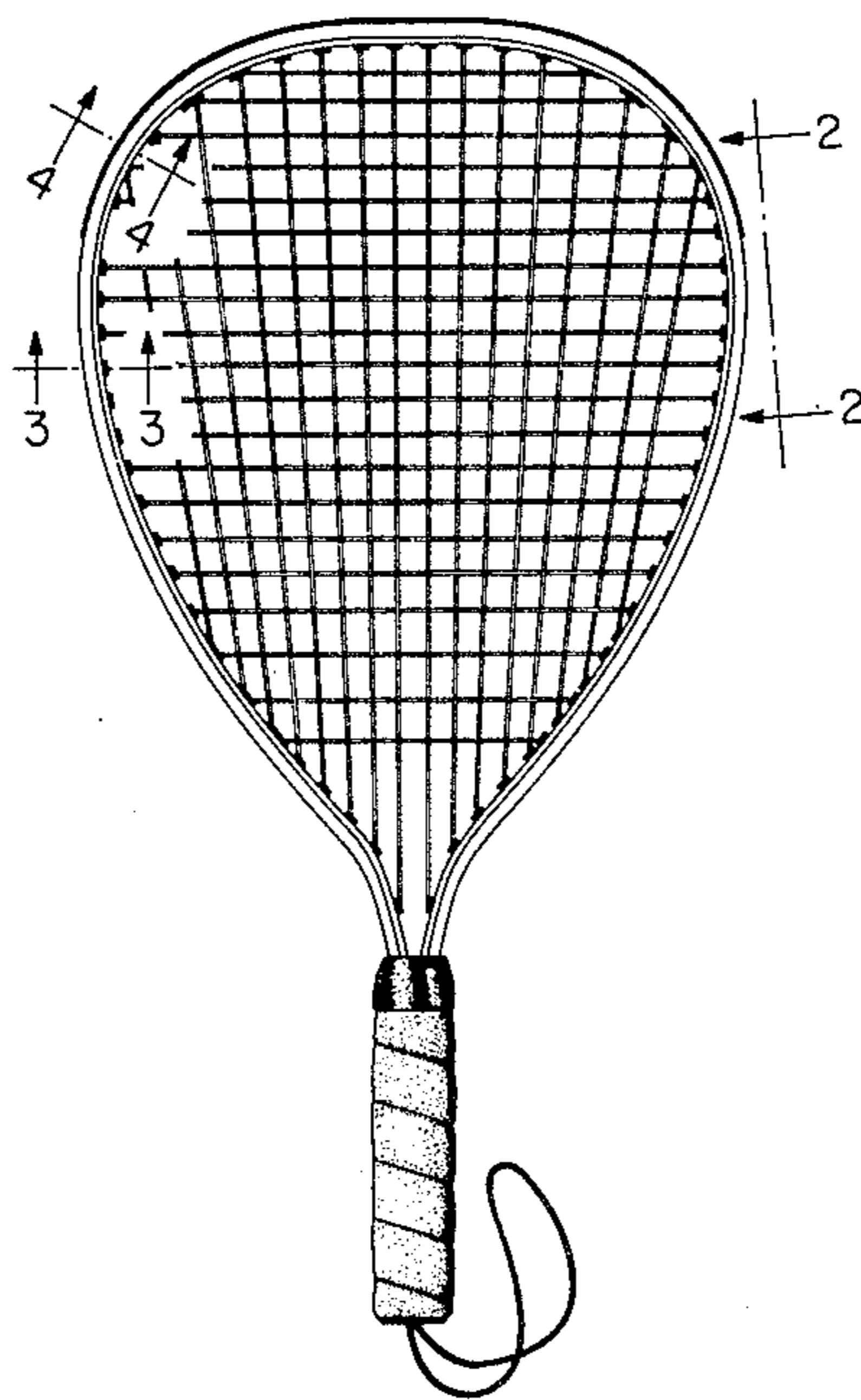
DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a top plan view of the racquet showing our new design;

FIG. 2 is a sectional view of the edge of the racquet of FIG. 1 taken along the line 2—2;

FIG. 3 is a cross-sectional view of the edge of the racquet of FIG. 1 taken along the line 3—3; and

FIG. 4 is a cross-sectional view of the racquet of FIG. 1 taken along the line 4—4.



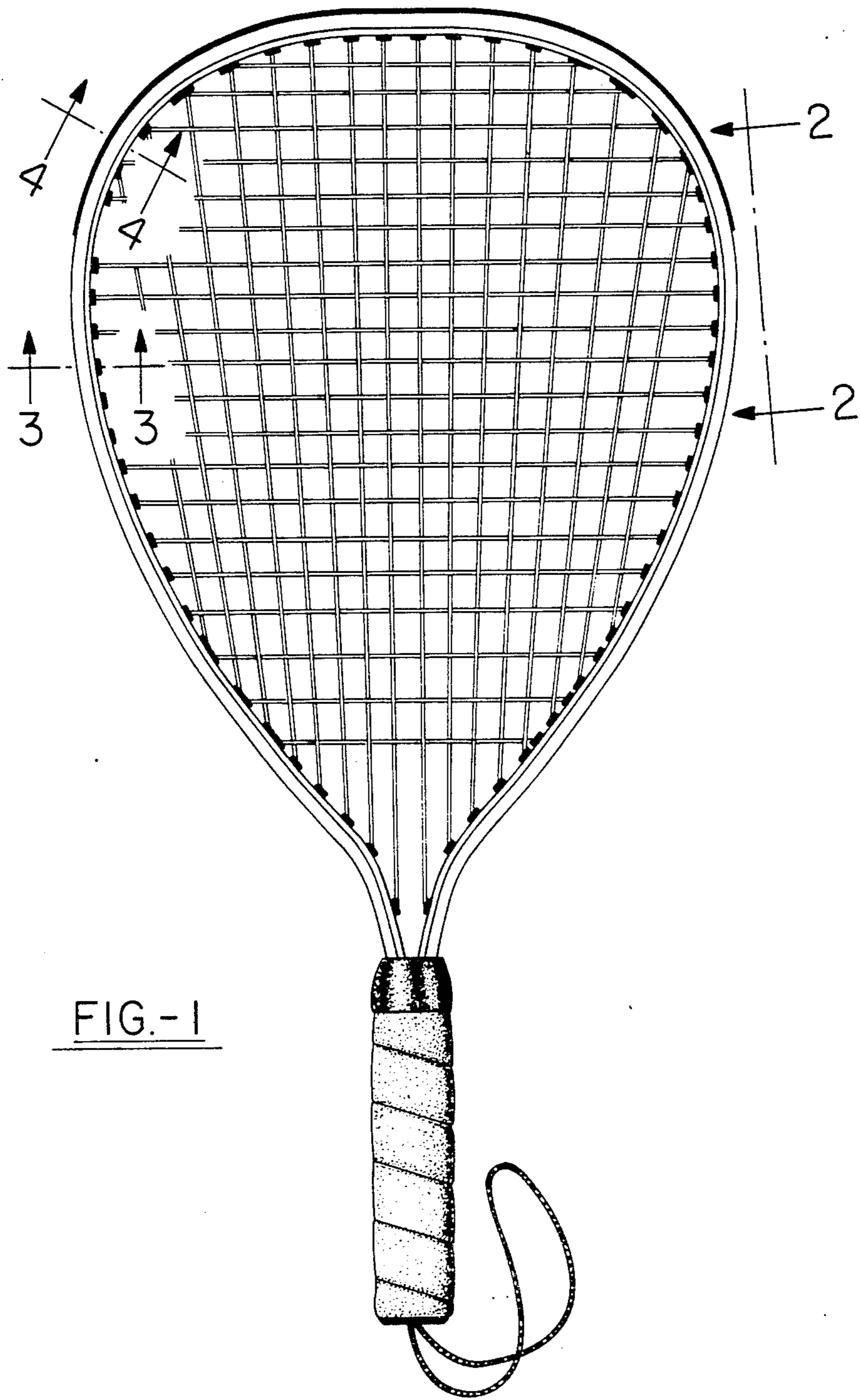

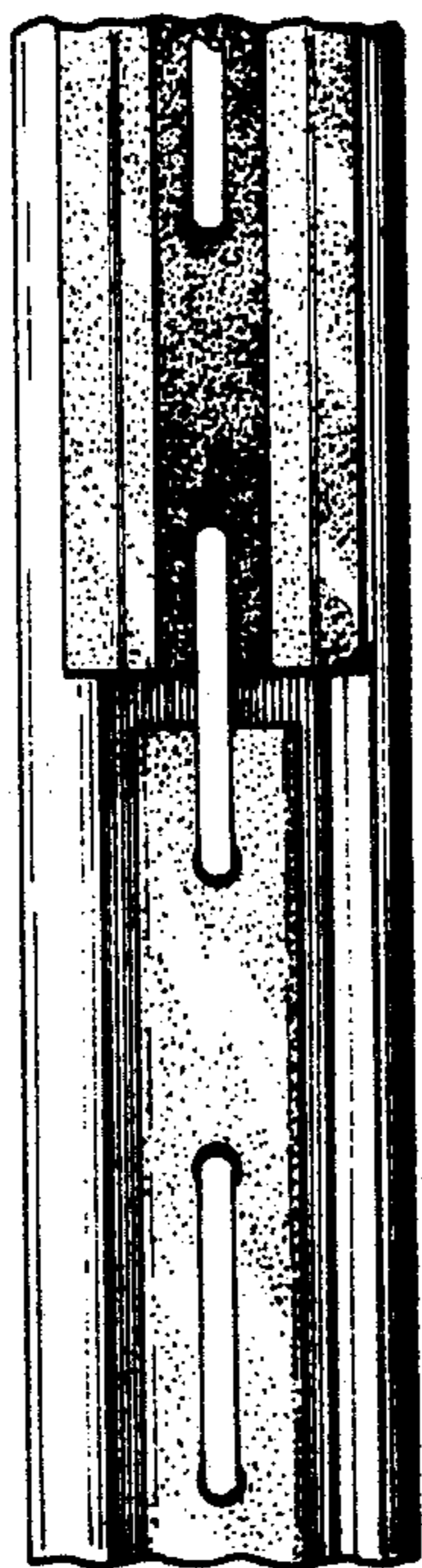

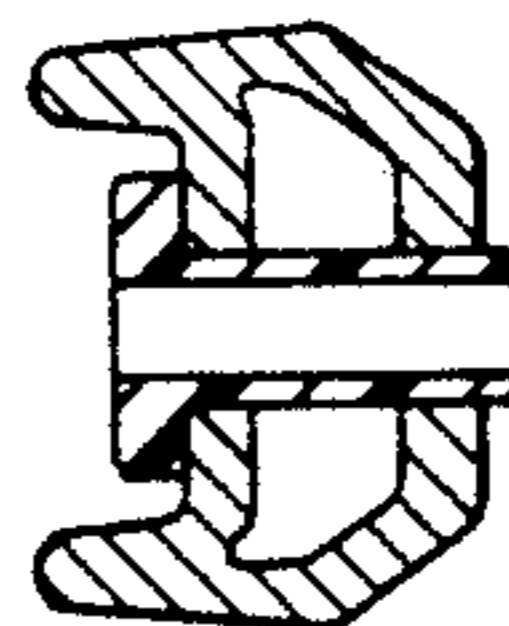

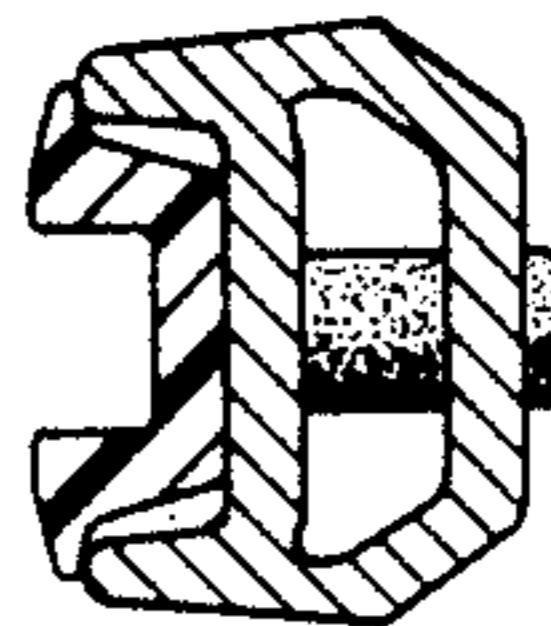
