[57] CLAIM

The ornamental design for an exposed outer cover for an in-the-ear hearing aid, substantially as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a side elevational view of an exposed outer cover for an in the ear hearing aid showing my new design.

FIG. 2 is a top plan view of the embodiment of FIG. 1; FIG. 3 is a side elevational view of the embodiment of FIGS. 1 and 2;

FIG. 4 is a perspective view of the embodiment of FIGS. 1-3;

FIG. 5 is a side elevational view of a second embodiment of the invention;

FIG. 6 is a top plan view of the embodiment of FIG. 5; FIG. 7 is a side elevational view of the embodiment of FIGS. 5 and 6;

FIG. 8 is a perspective view of the embodiment of FIGS. 5-7;

FIG. 9 is a side elevational view of a third embodiment of the invention;

FIG. 10 is a top plan view of the embodiment of the invention of FIG. 9;

FIG. 11 is a side elevational view of the embodiment of FIGS. 9 and 10;

FIG. 12 is a perspective view of the embodiment of FIGS. 9-11;


FIG. 13 is a side elevational view of a fourth embodiment of the invention;


FIG. 14 is a top plan view of the embodiment of FIG. 13;





























