[57] CLAIM

The ornamental design for a floor lamp, substantially as shown and described.

## DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a perspective view of a floor lamp embodying my new design.

FIG. 2 is an enlarged fragmentary top plan view of the base, the supporting standard, arm and reflector being omitted for convenience of illustration.

FIG. 3 is an enlarged side elevational view of the base, the standard, arm and reflector being omitted for convenience of illustration.

FIG. 4 is a top plan view of the floor lamp.

FIG. 5 is a side elevational view thereof as seen from the left of FIG. 3, the opposite side being a mirror image.

The Lines on the top and bottom ends of the supporting arm indicate flexible sections. The convex extrusions on the base are fragmentarily shown for convenience of illustration, it being understood that the elements are continuous around the section of the base on which they are partially shown.
