The ornamental design for a collapsible chair, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a front perspective view of a collapsible chair showing our design;
FIG. 2 is a rear perspective view thereof;
FIG. 3 is a front elevation view thereof;
FIG. 4 is a rear elevation view thereof;
FIG. 5 is a side elevation view thereof, the opposite side being substantially a mirror image of the side shown;
FIG. 6 is a top plan view thereof;
FIG. 7 is a bottom plan view thereof; and,
FIG. 8 is a perspective view of the chair in collapsed condition.

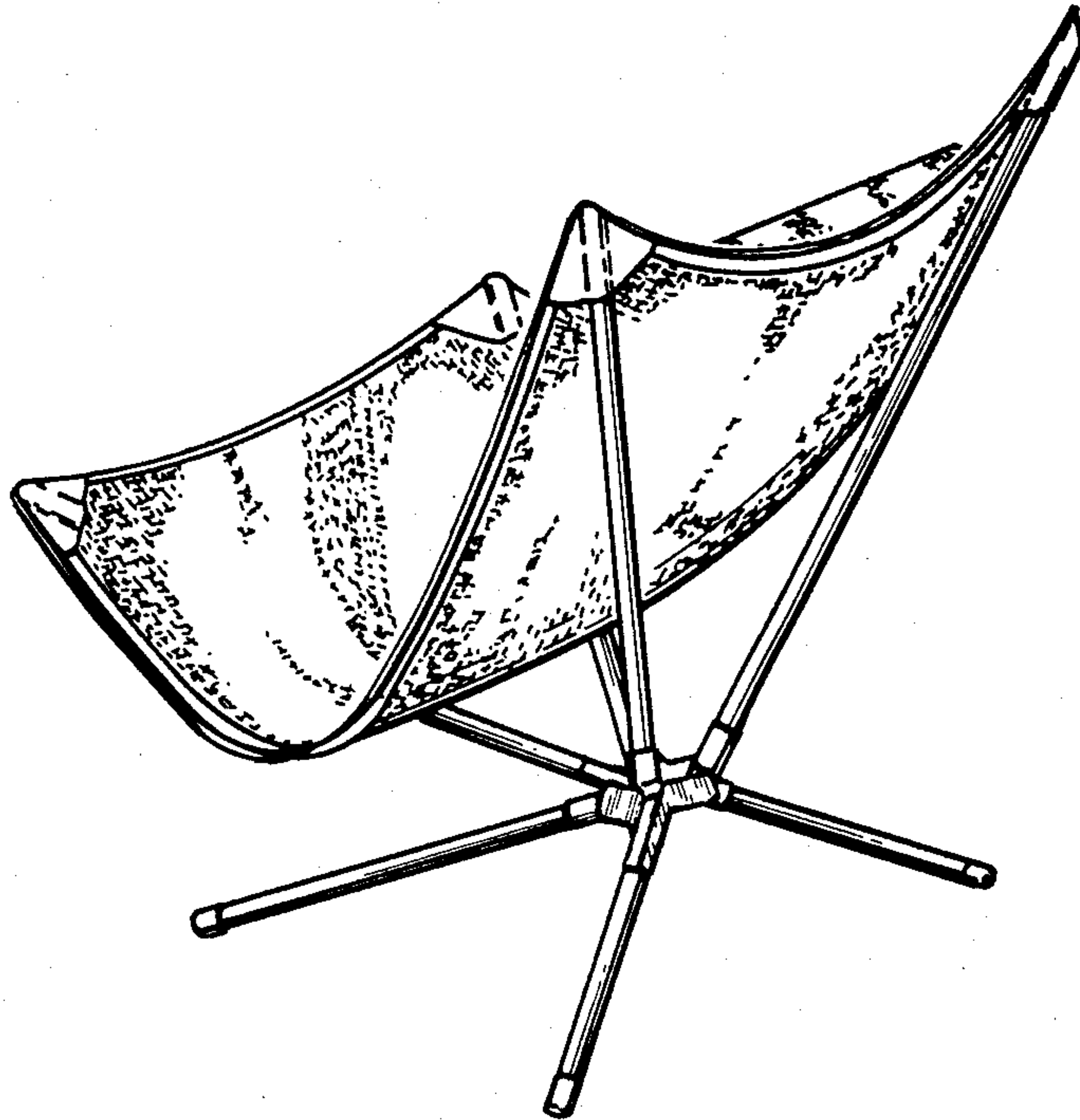

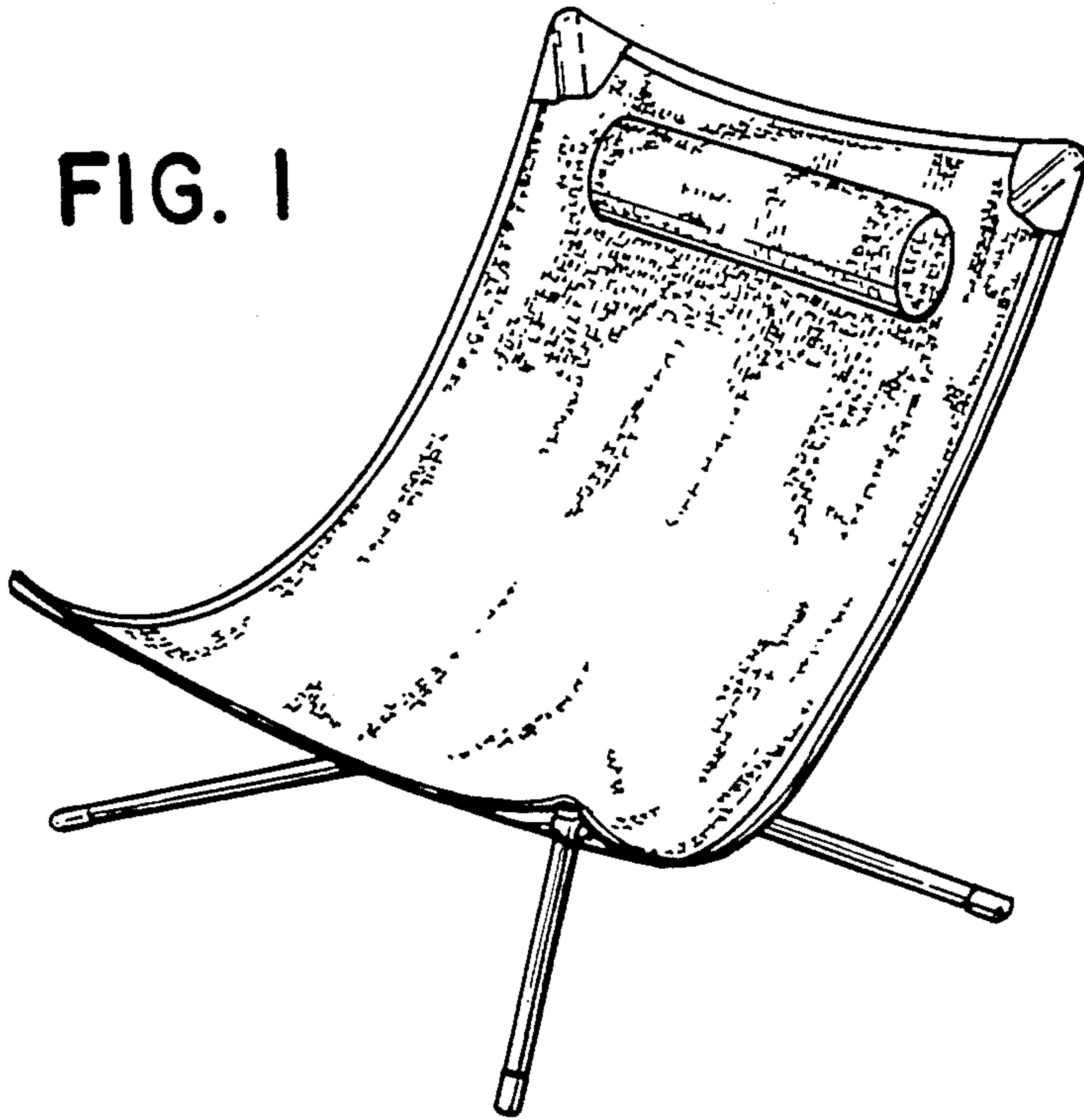
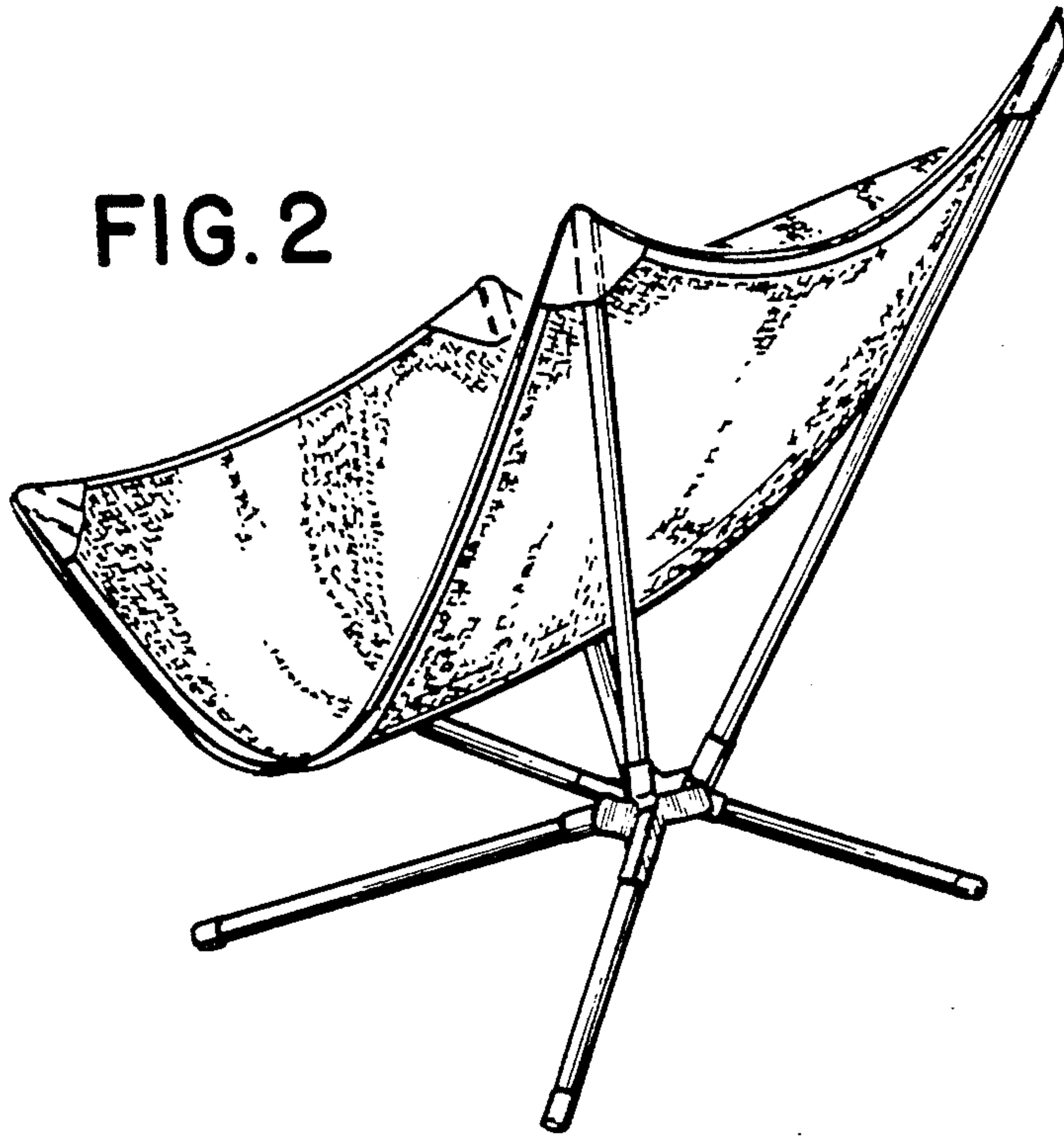

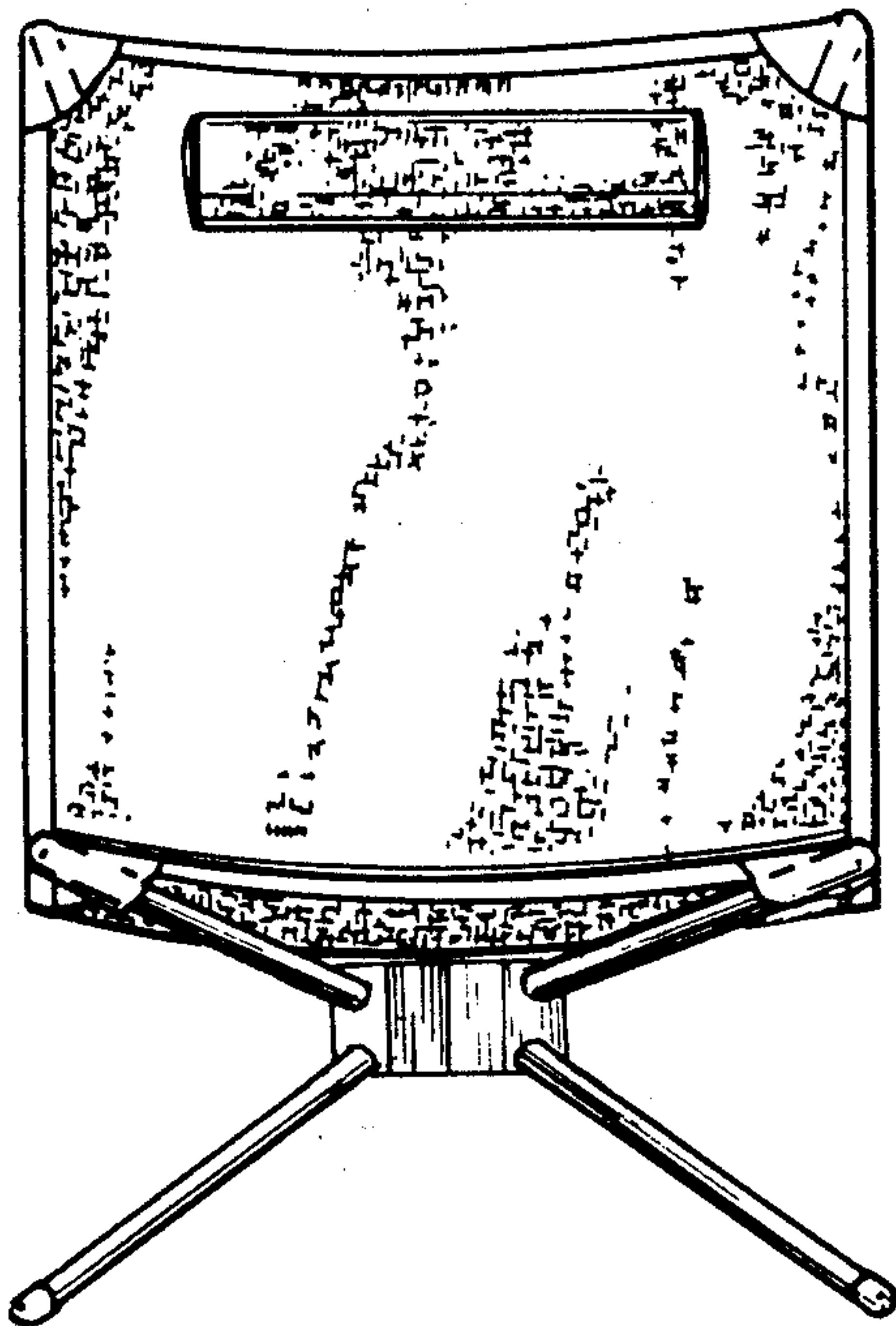

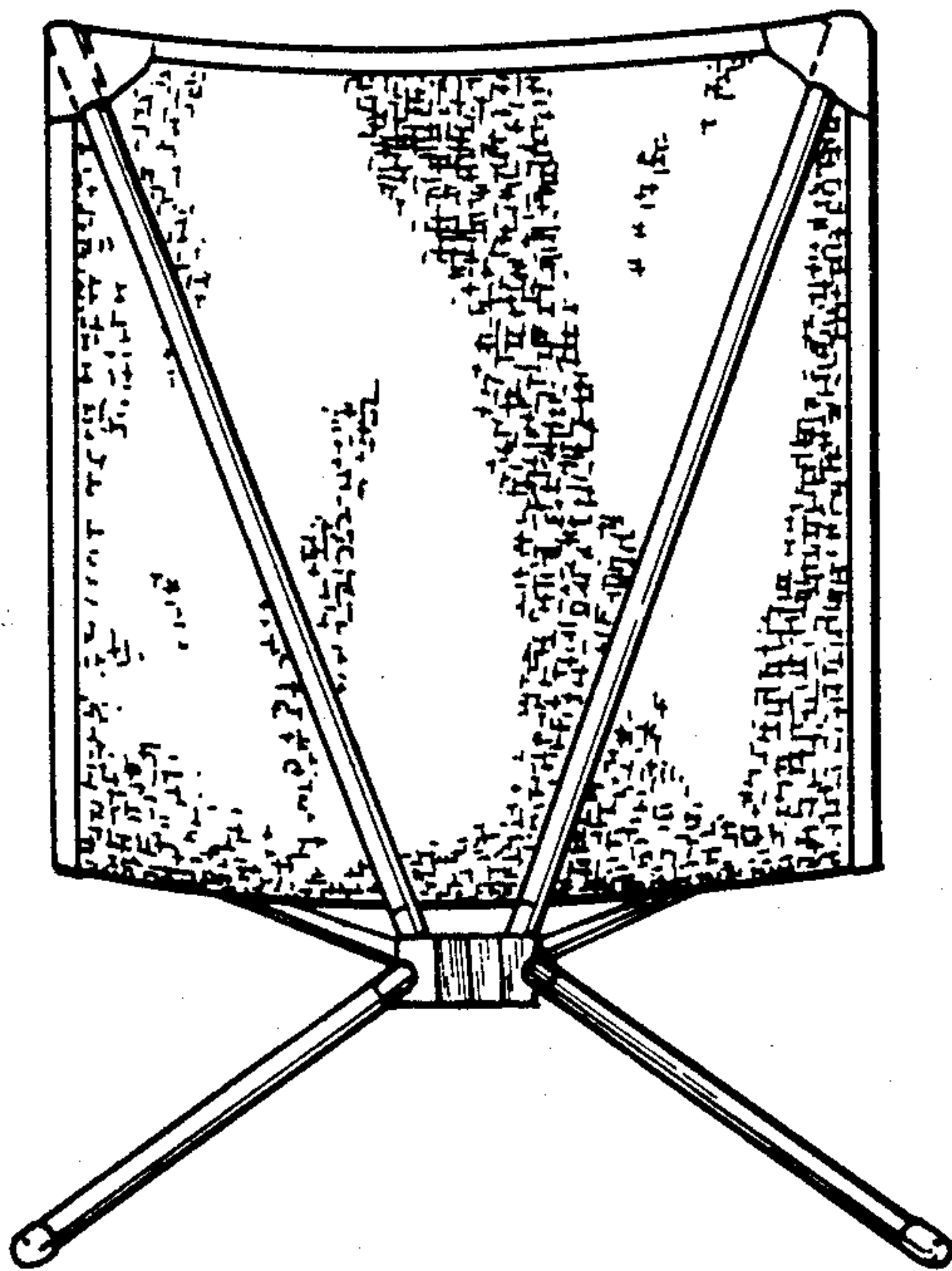

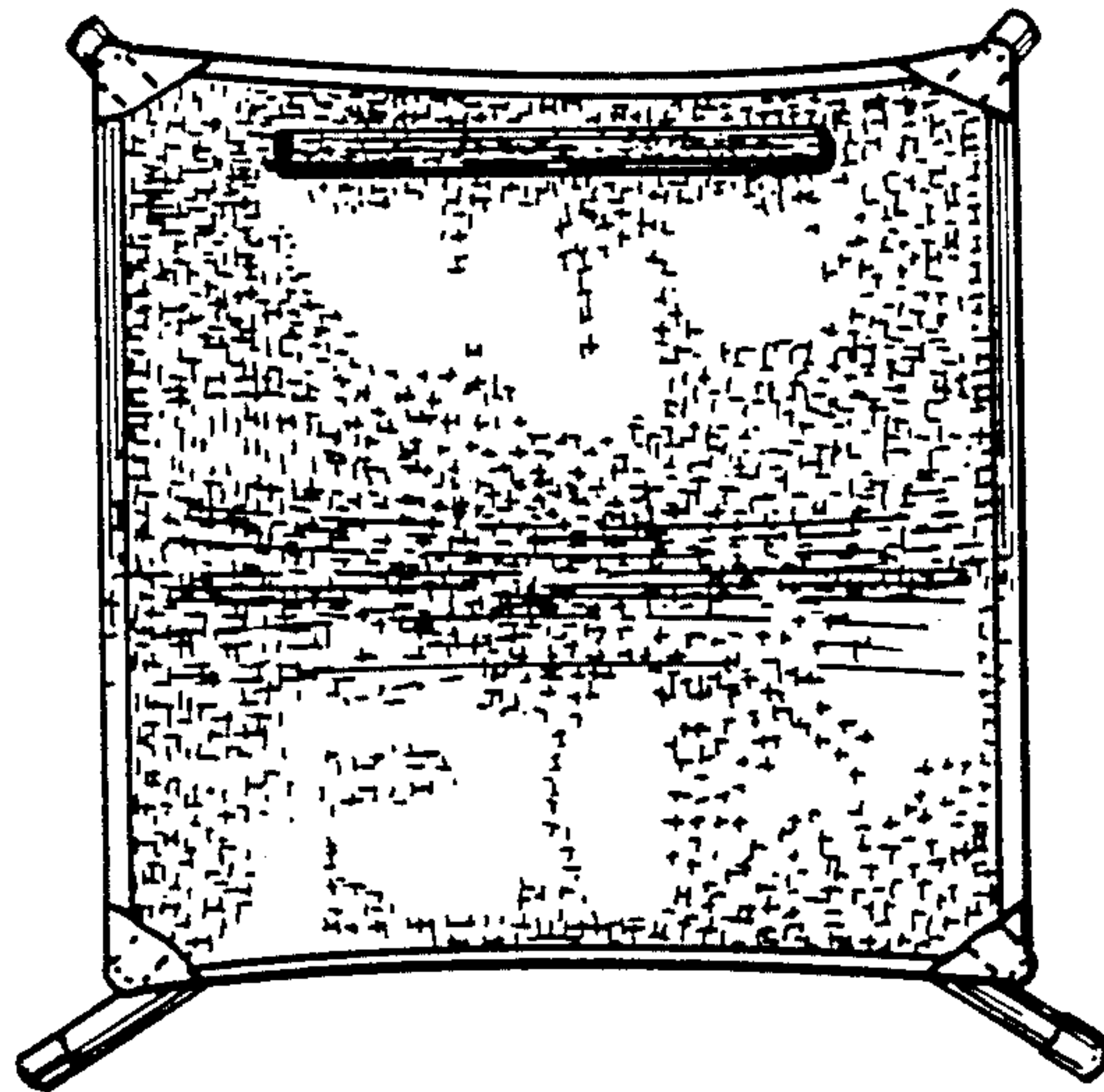
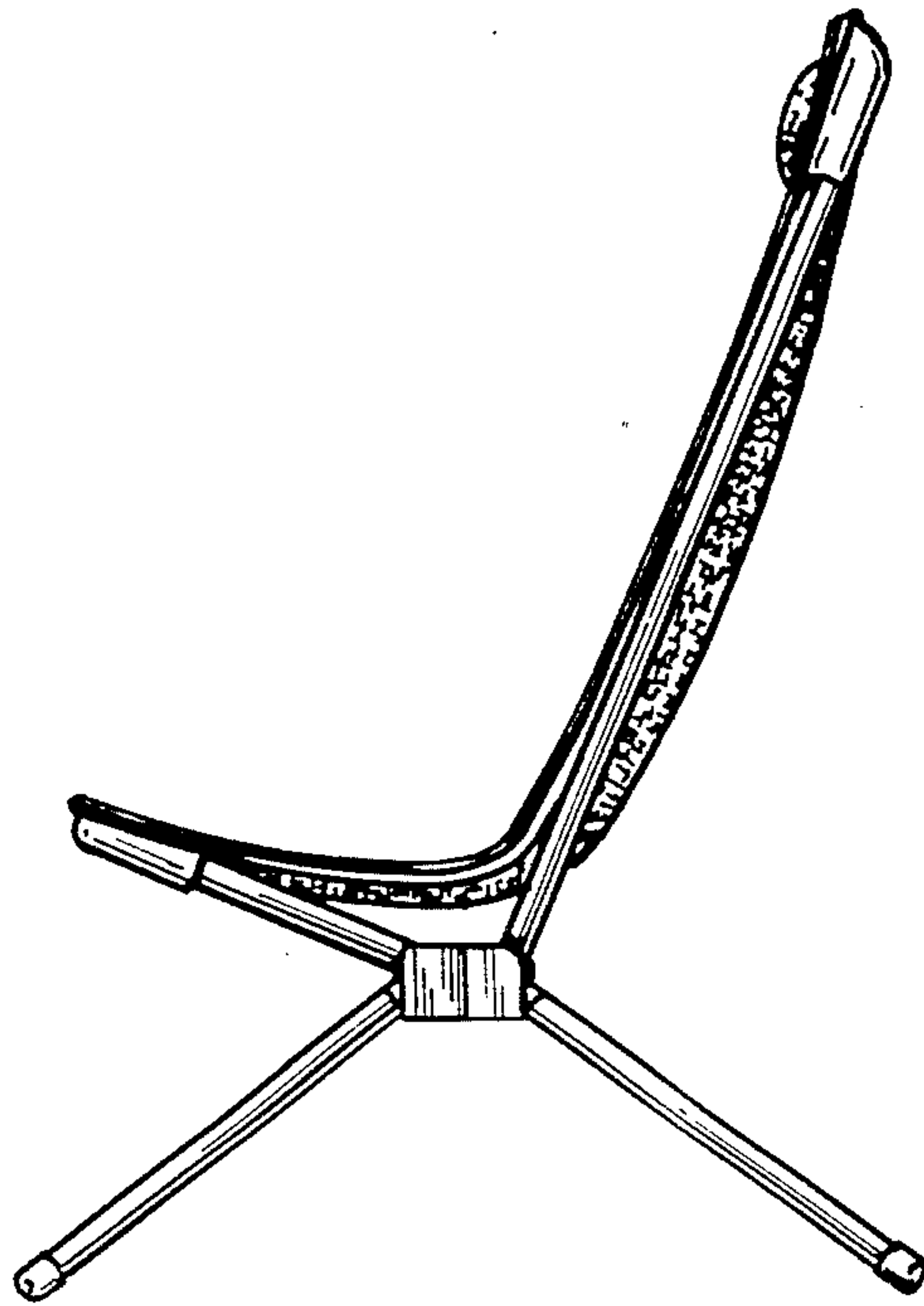

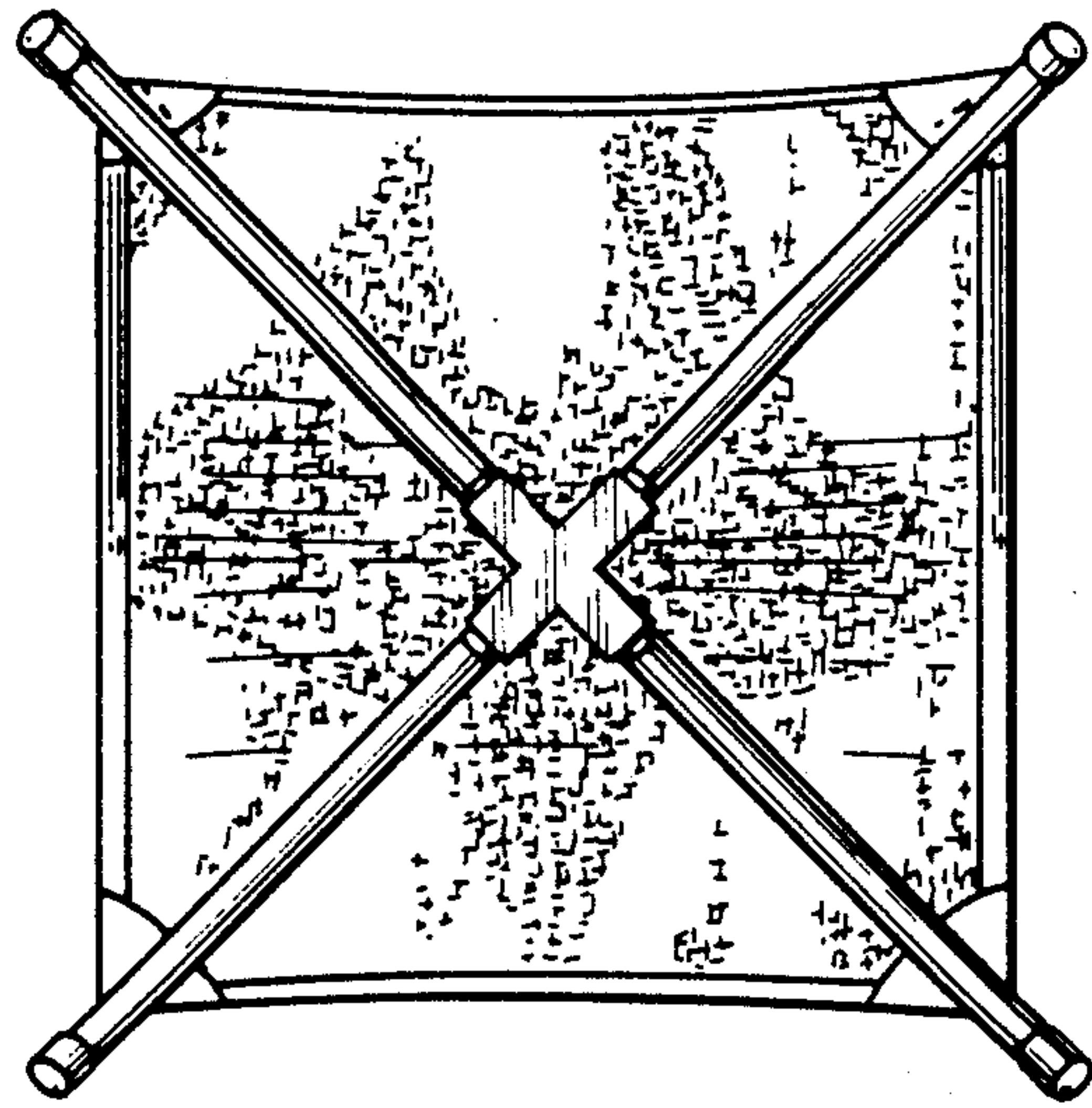

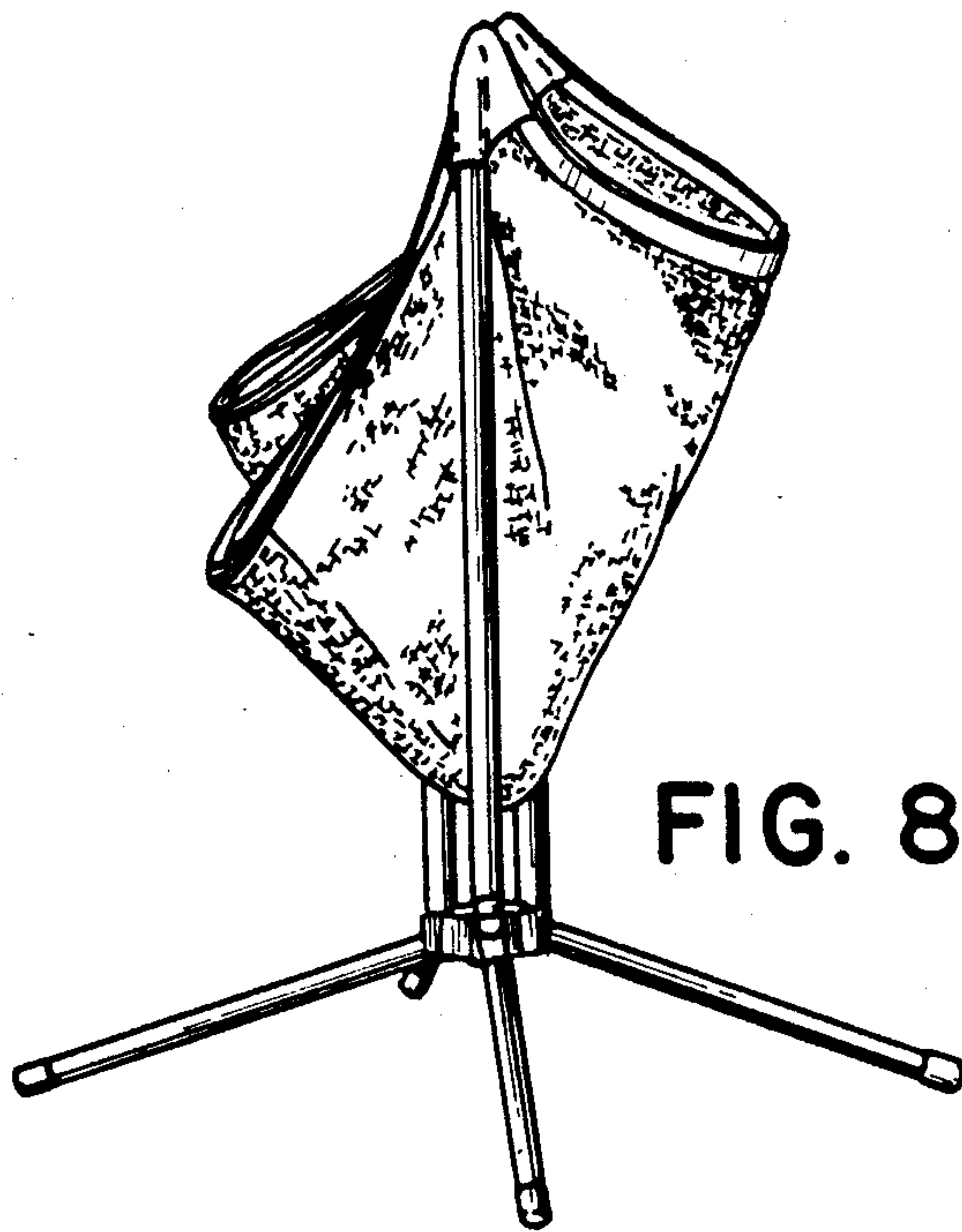
