FIG. 3 is a top plan view;

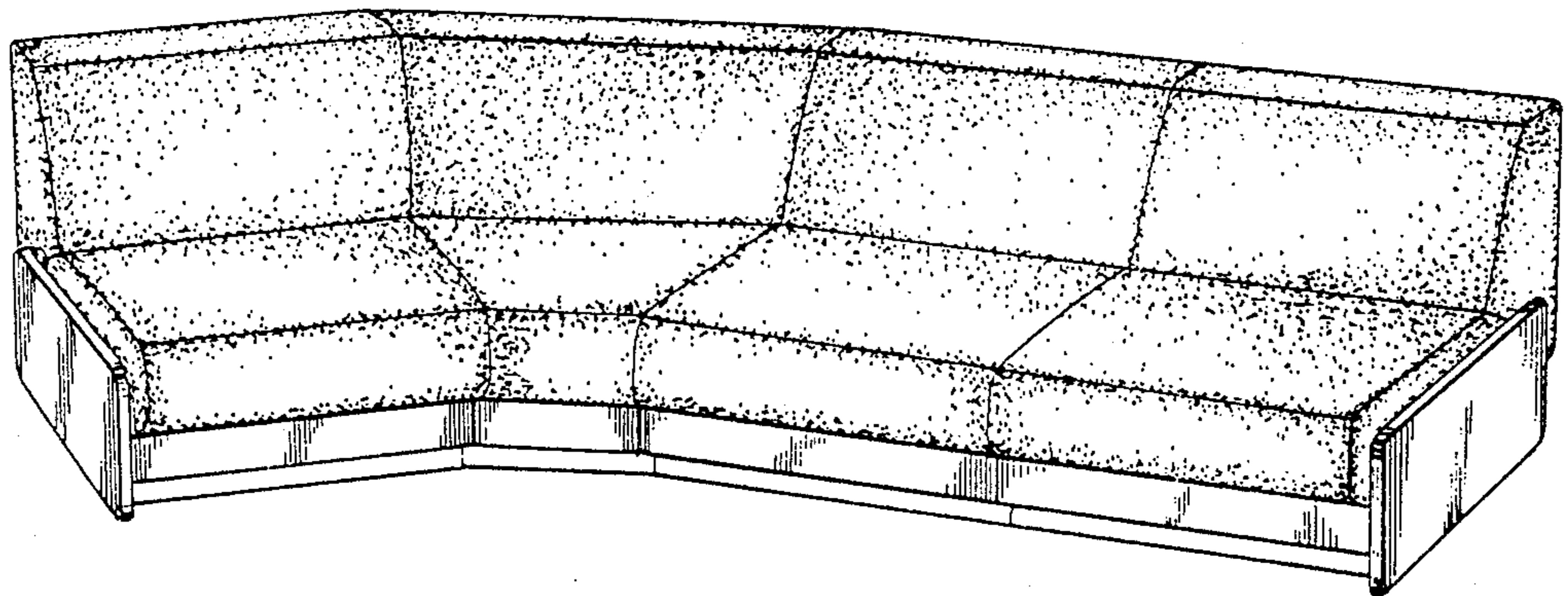
FIG. 4 is a front elevational view;

FIG. 8 is a rear perspective view thereof.



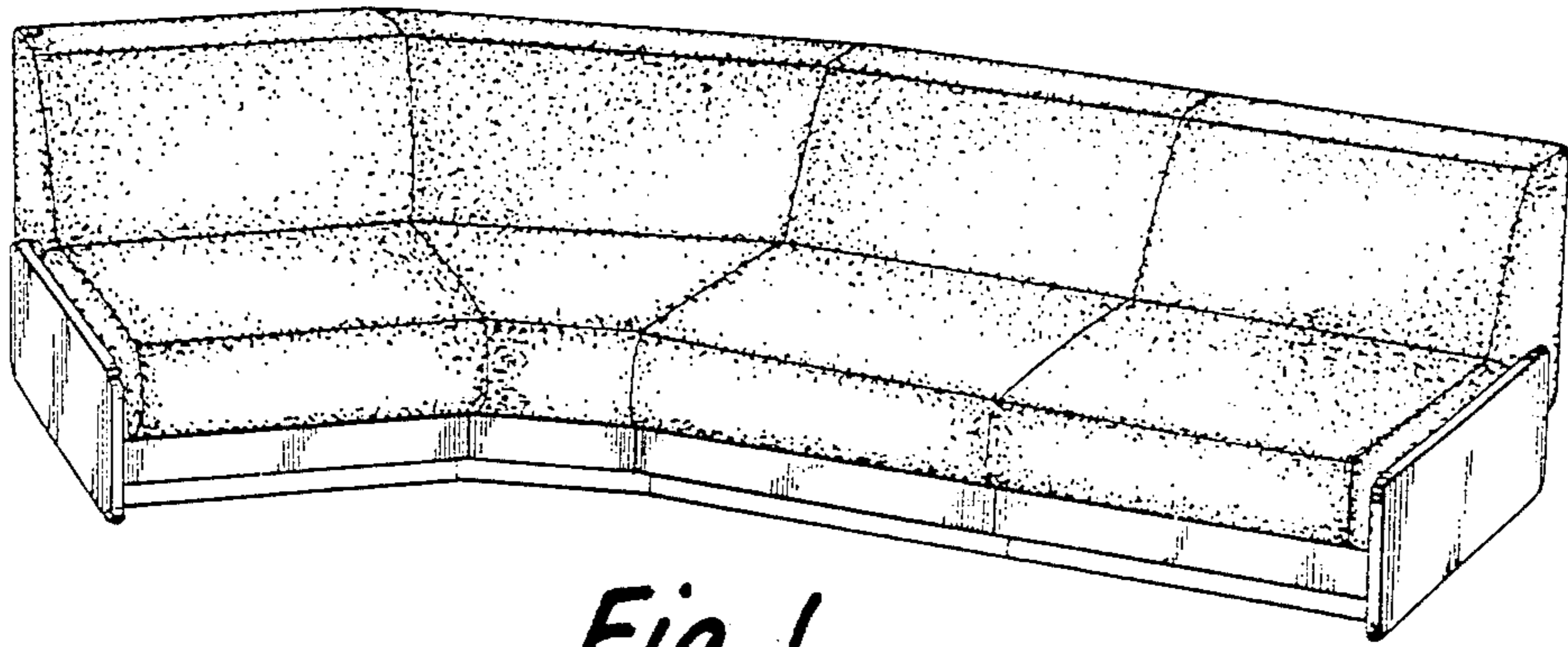

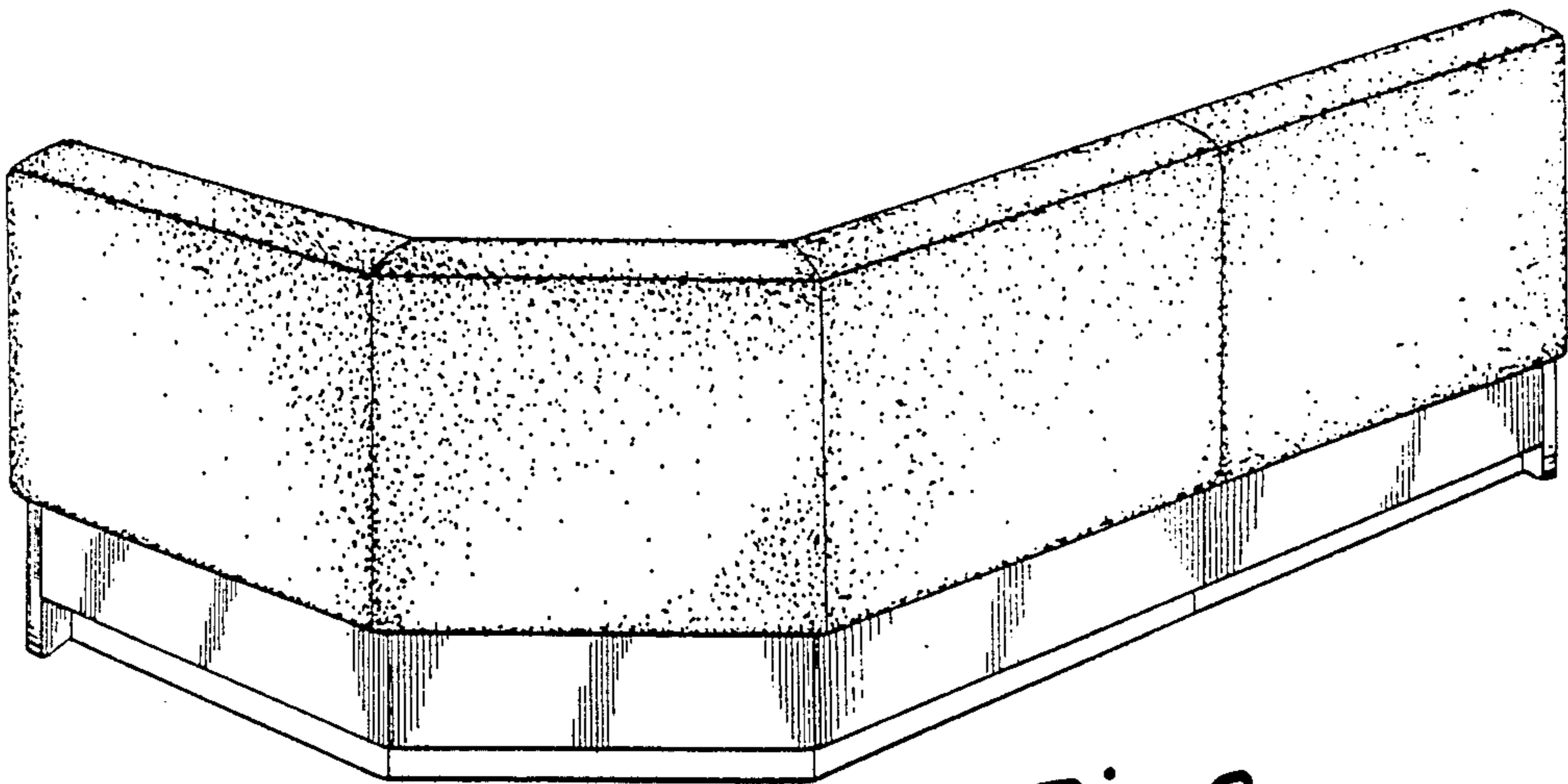

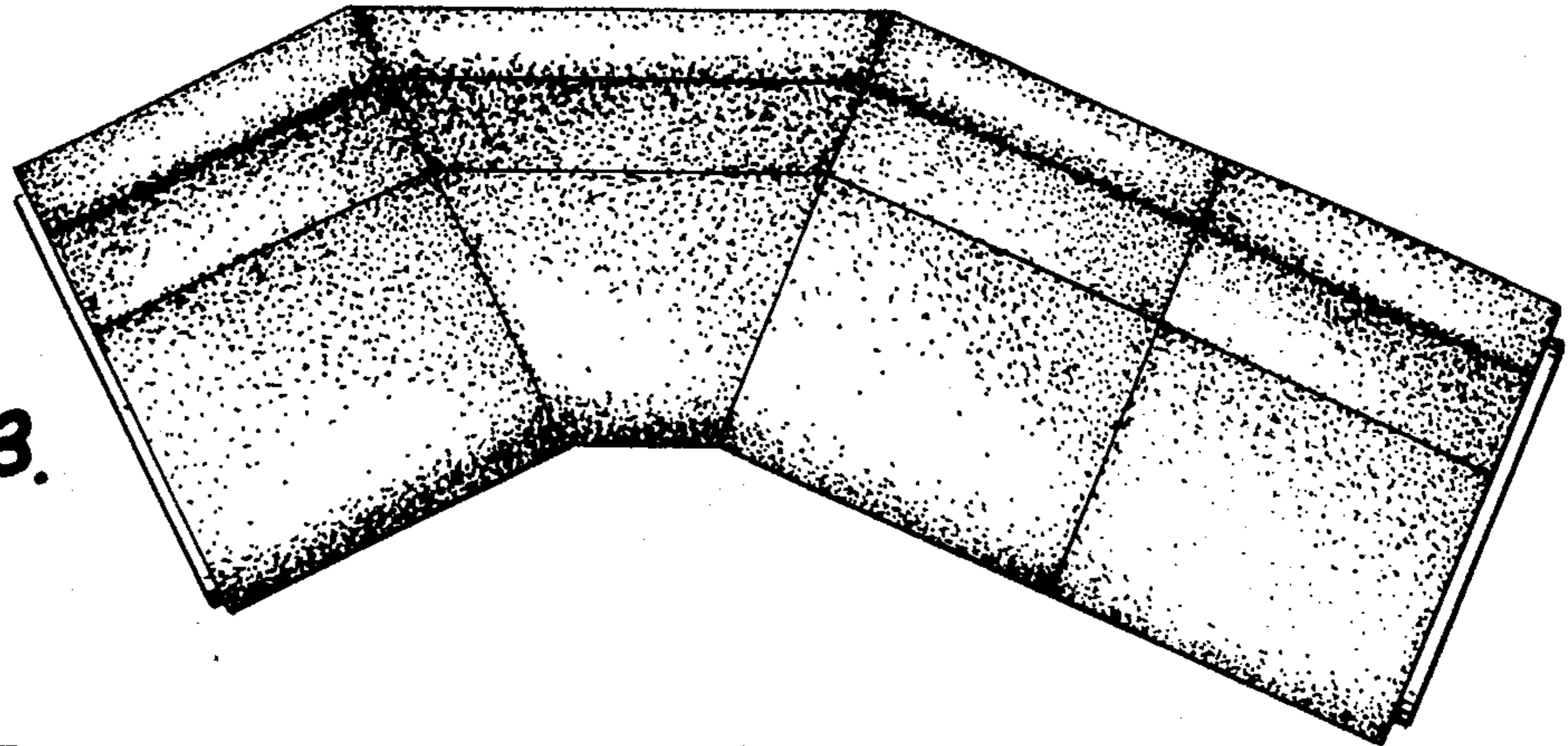

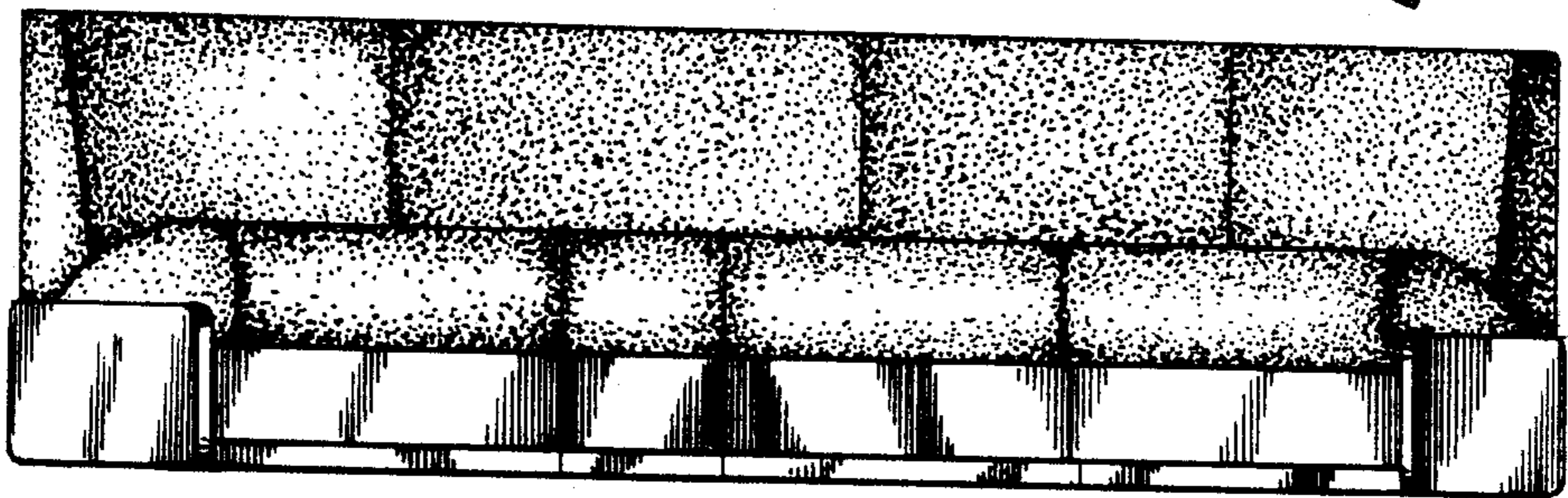

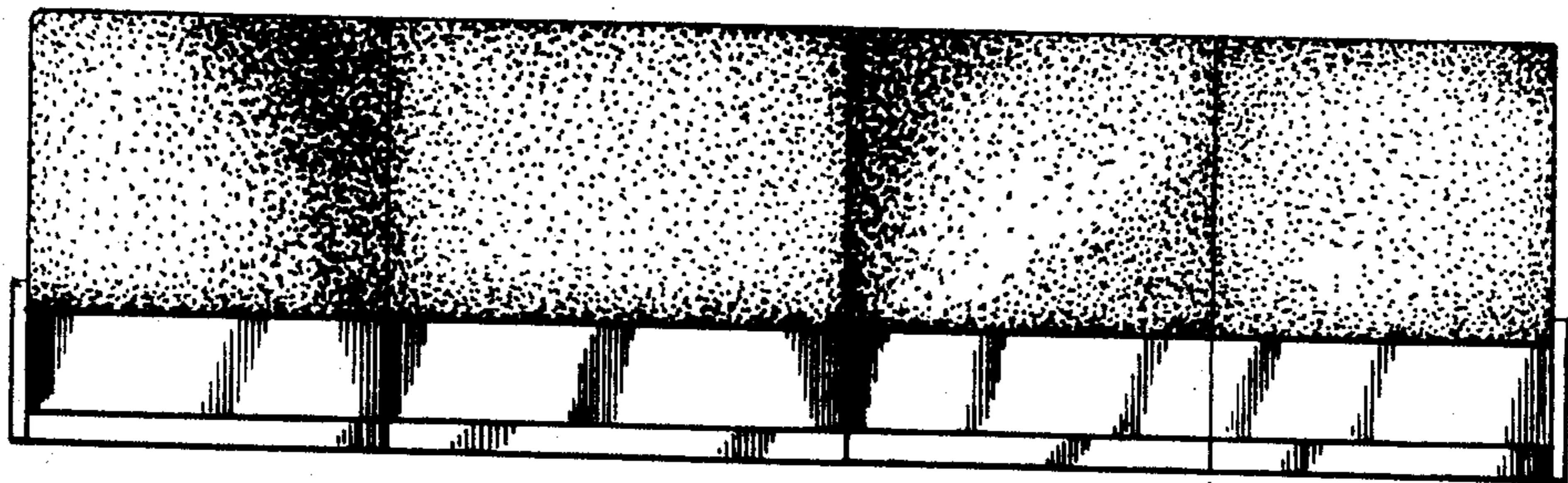
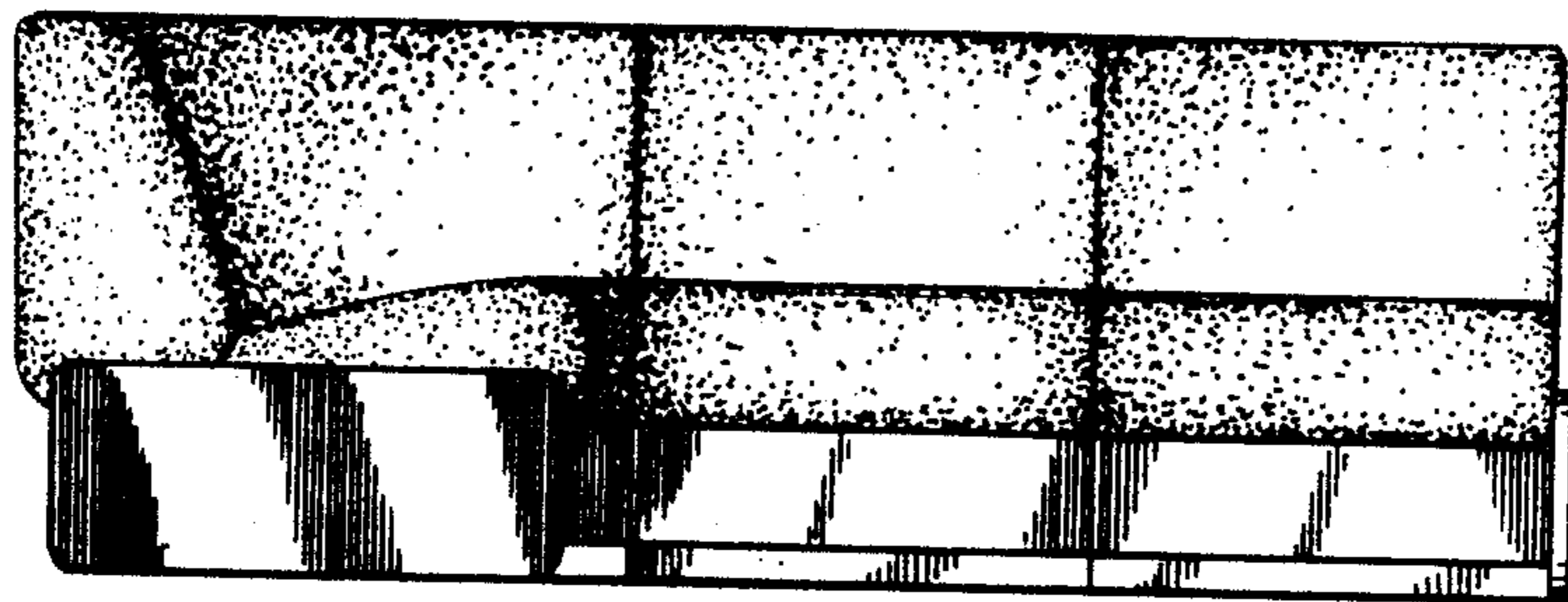

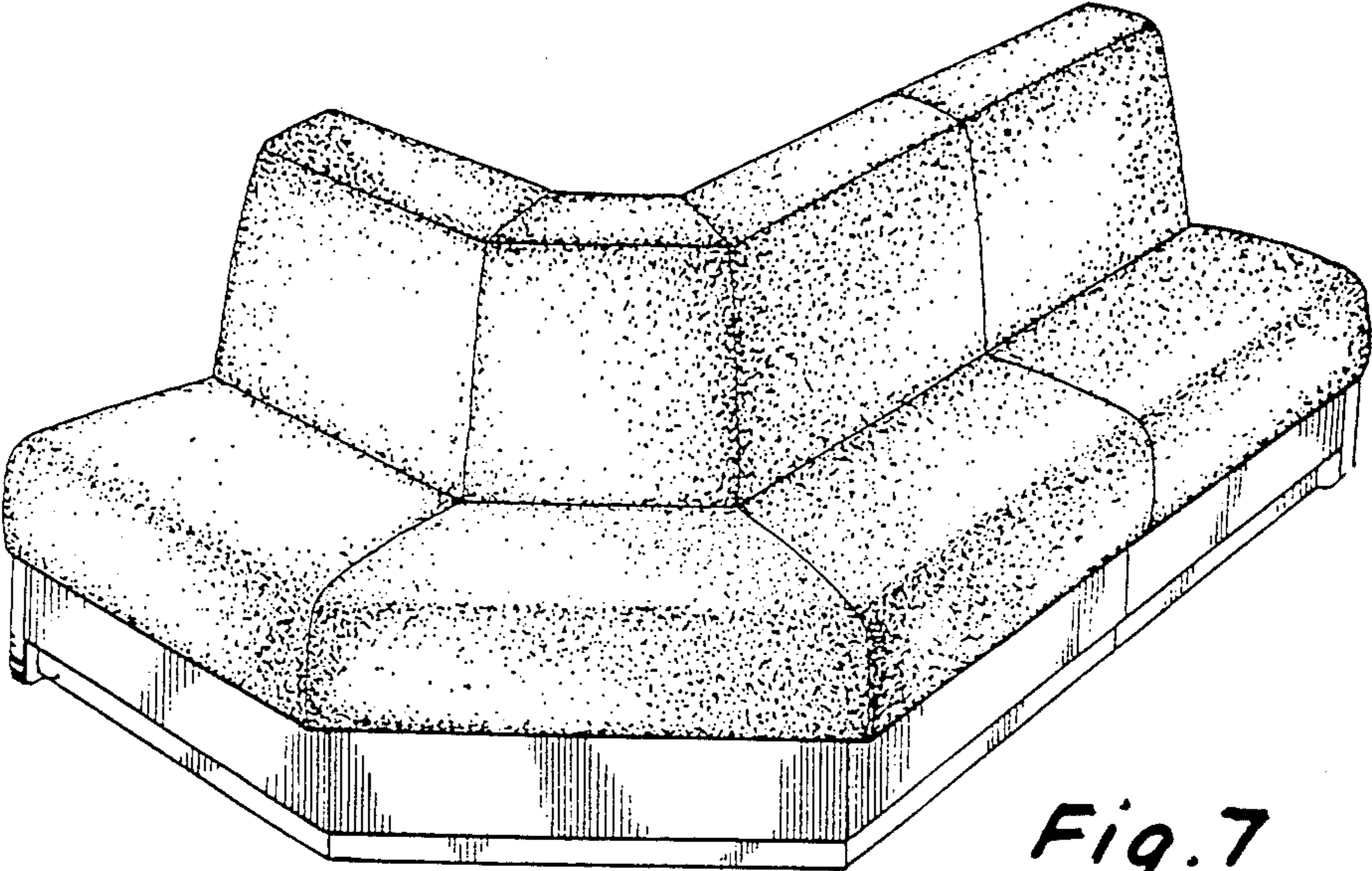

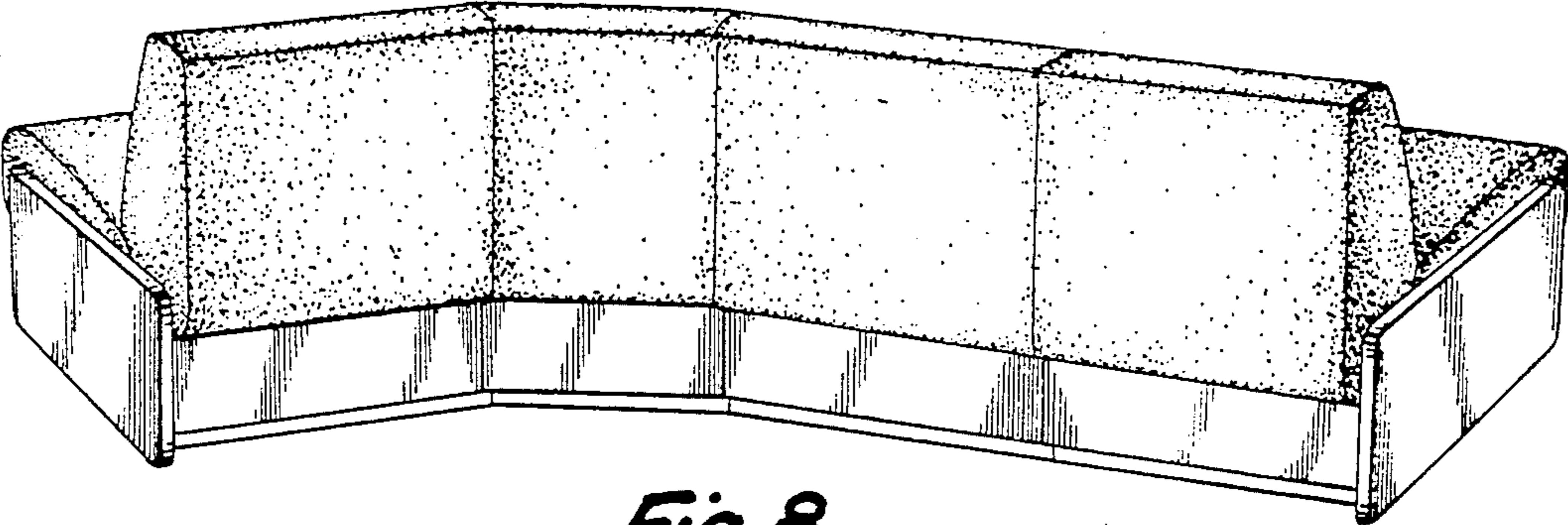
