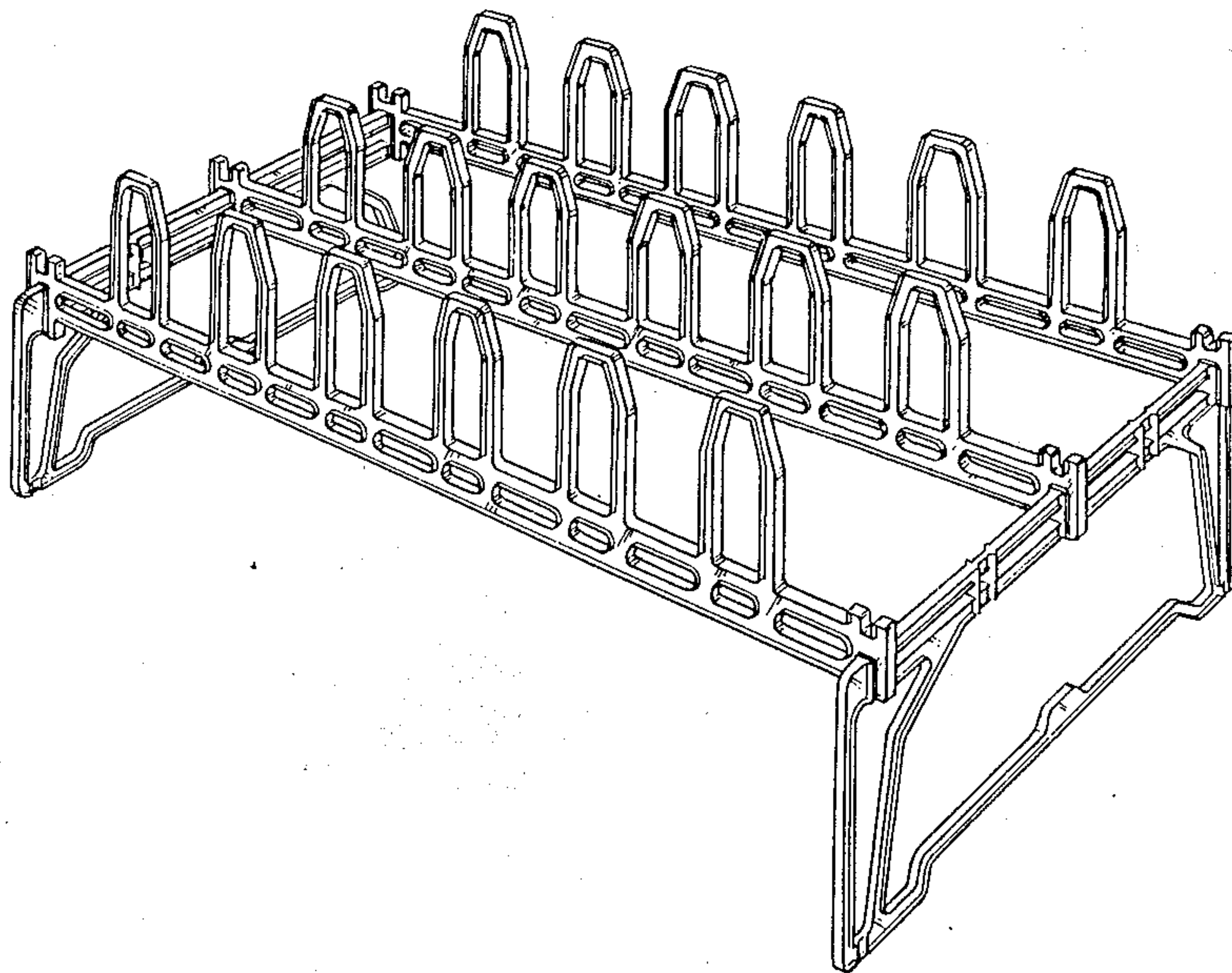

[57] CLAIM

The ornamental design of a stackable and adjustable shoe rack, substantially as shown and described.

FIG. 1 is a perspective view of a stackable and adjustable shoe rack showing my new design; FIG. 2 is a front elevational view, the rear being identical thereto; and FIG. 3 is a side elevational view, the opposite side being identical thereto.



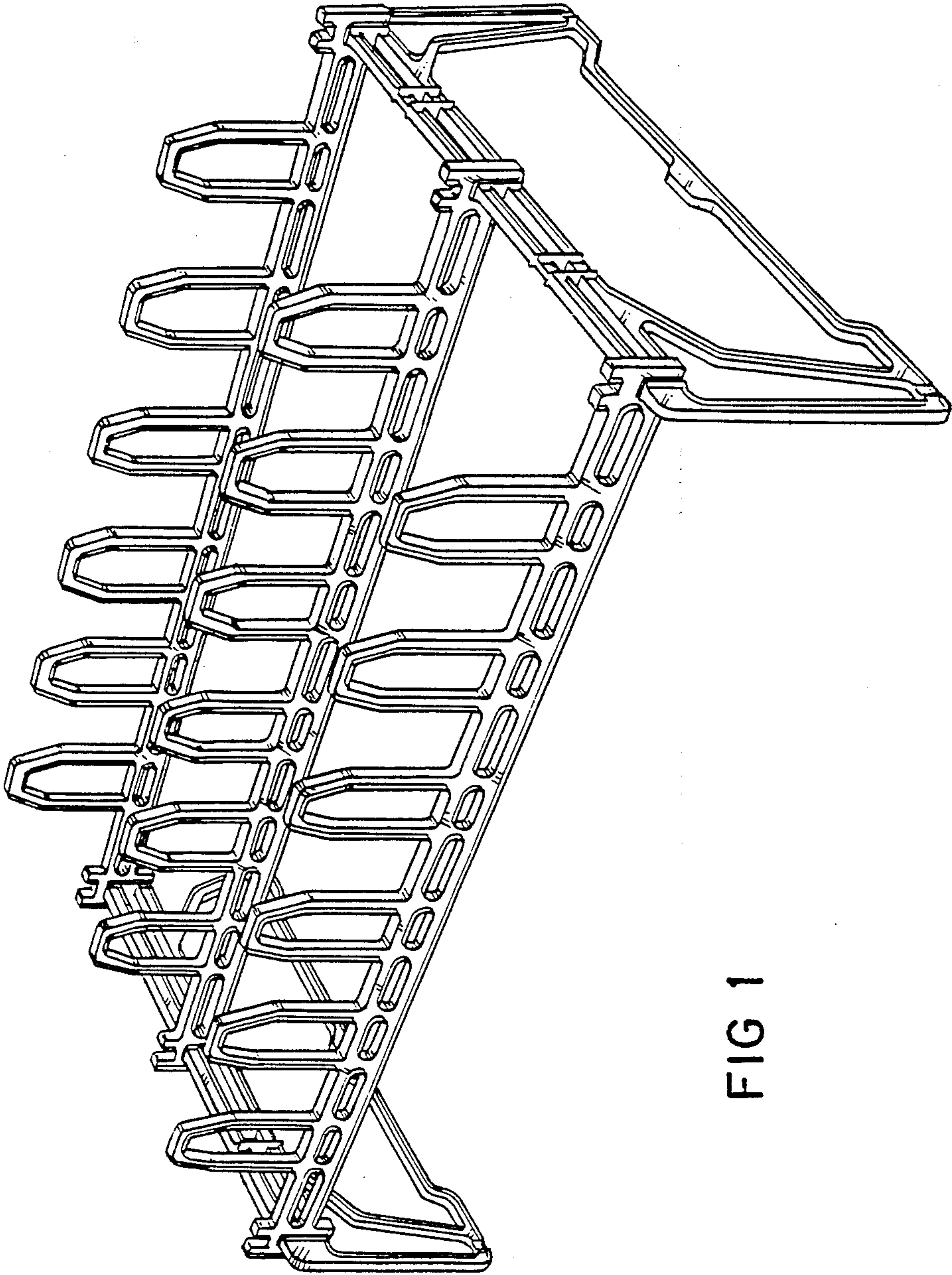

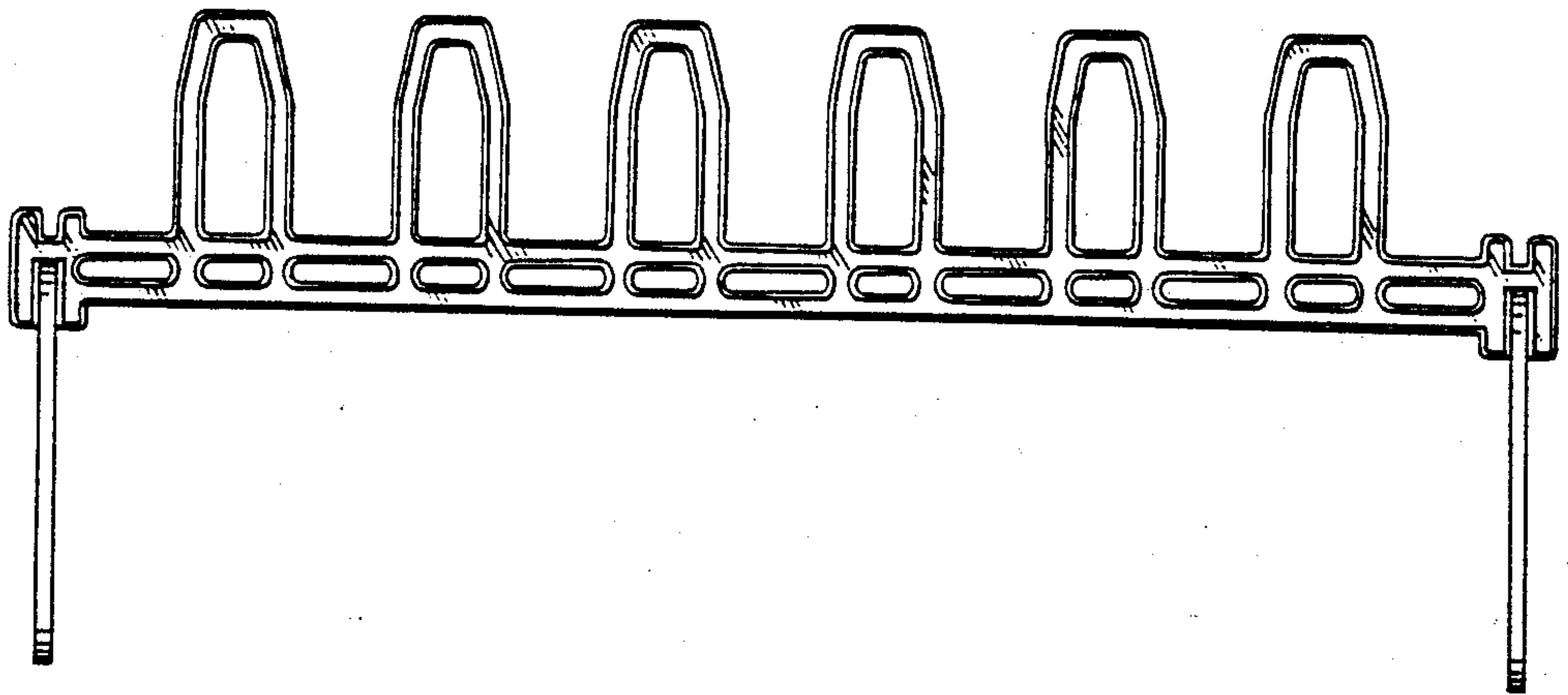

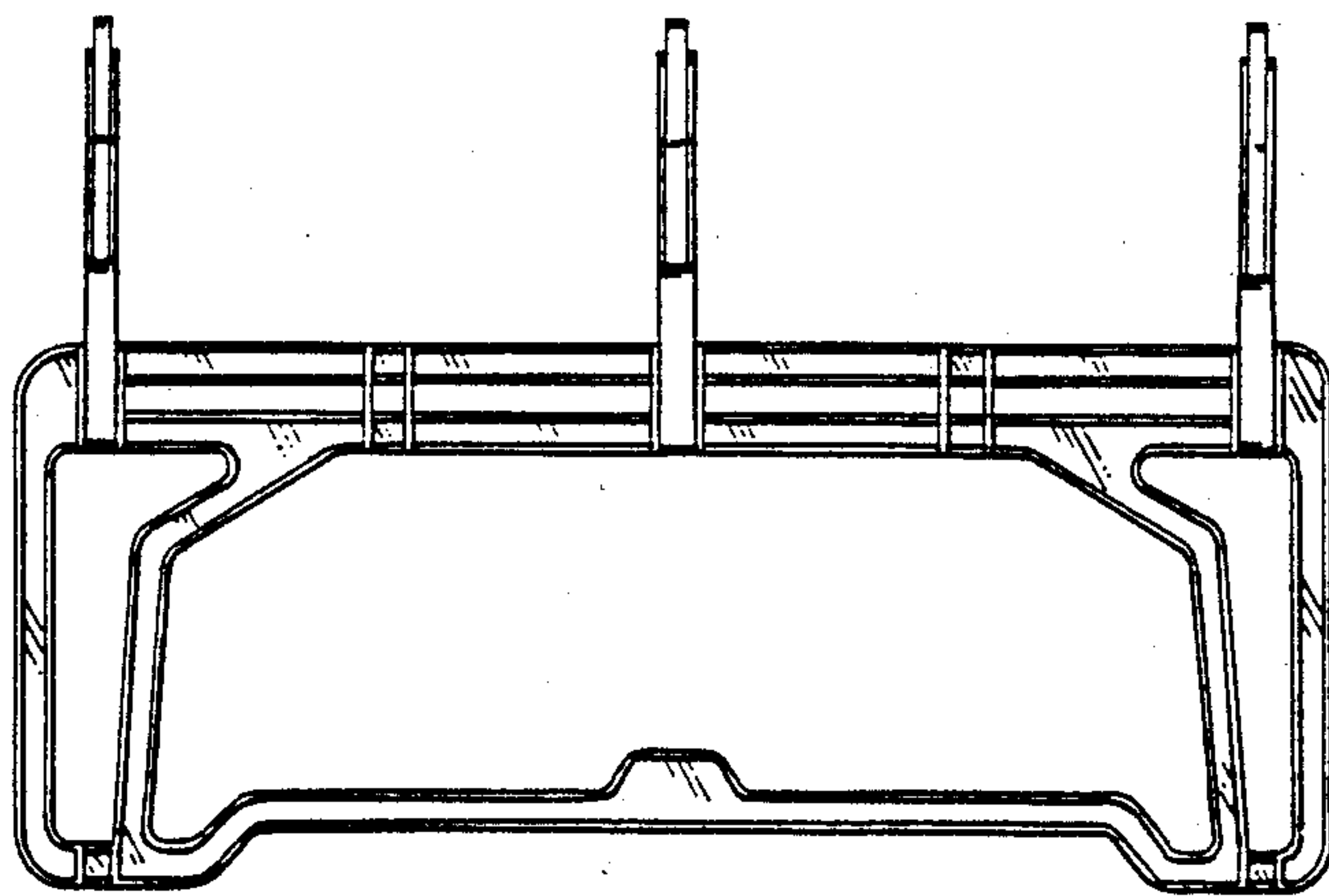
