DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a top, front, left side perspective view showing my new design, the rear view being a mirror image of the front;

FIG. 2 is a left side elevational view thereof;

FIG. 3 is a bottom plan view thereof;

FIG. 4 is a top plan view thereof;

FIG. 5 is a right side elevational view thereof;

FIG. 6 is a top, front, left side perspective view of a second embodiment of that shown in FIG. 1, the rear view being a mirror image of the front;

FIG. 7 is a bottom plan view thereof; and

FIG. 8 is a right side elevational view thereof.

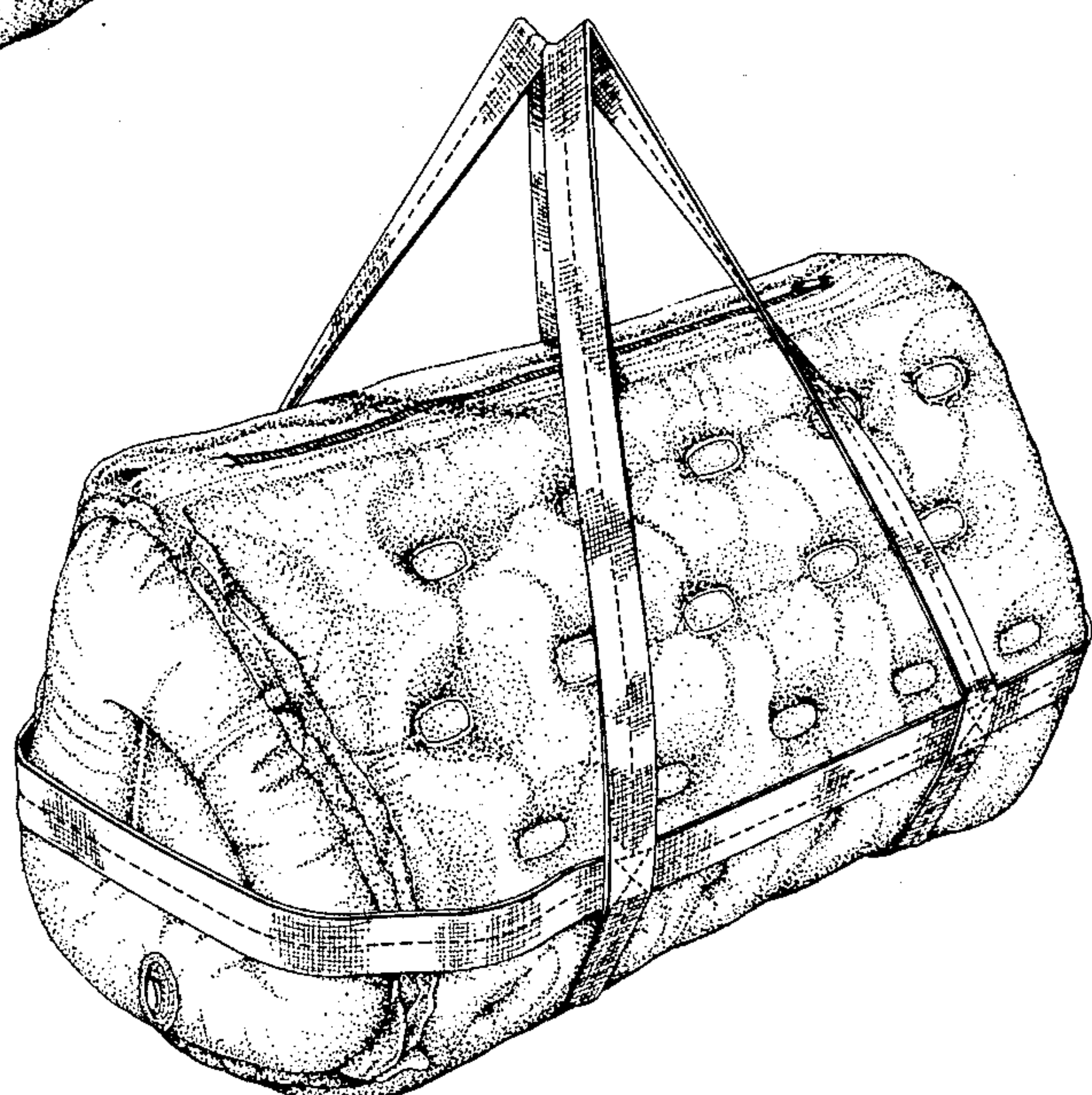
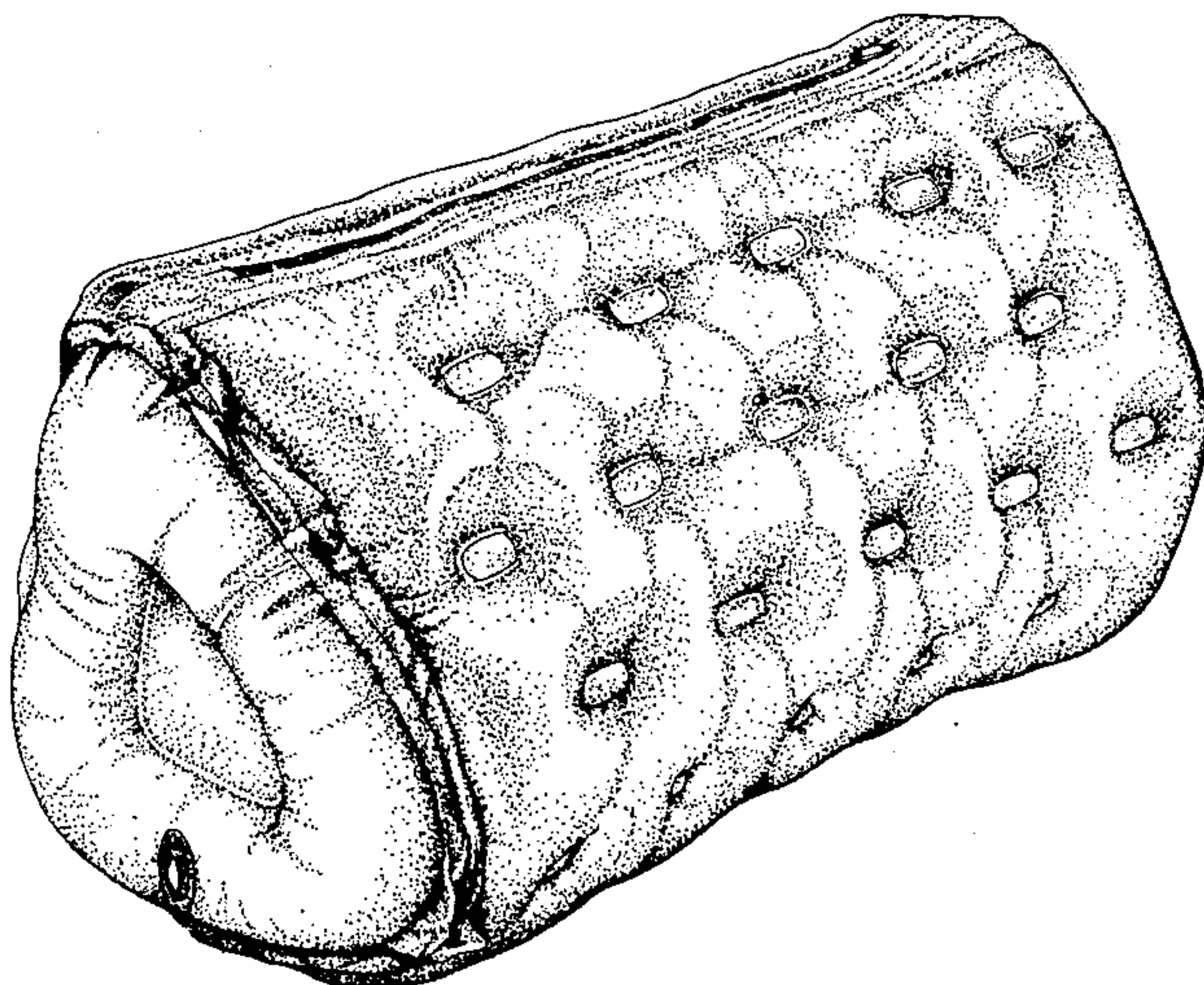

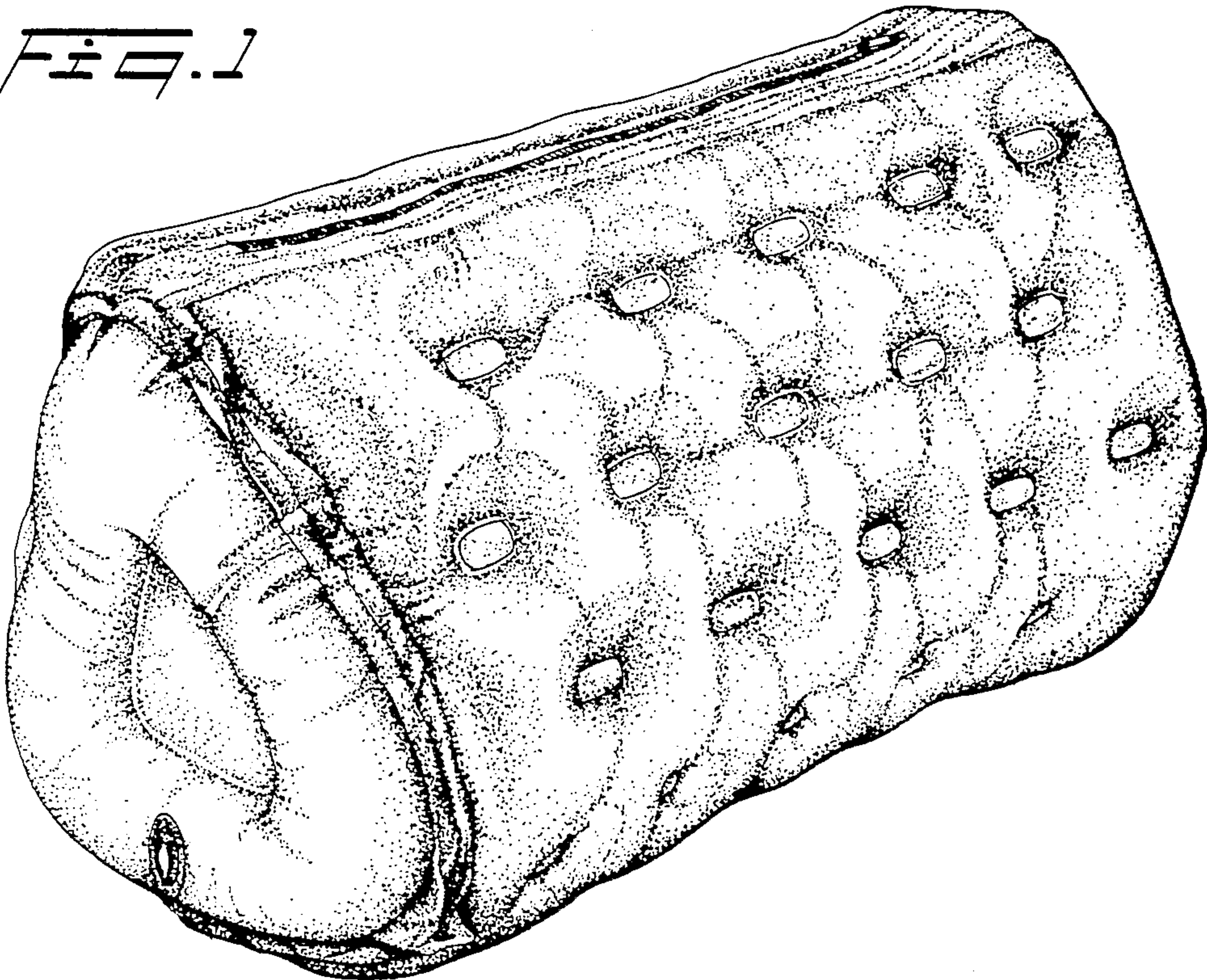

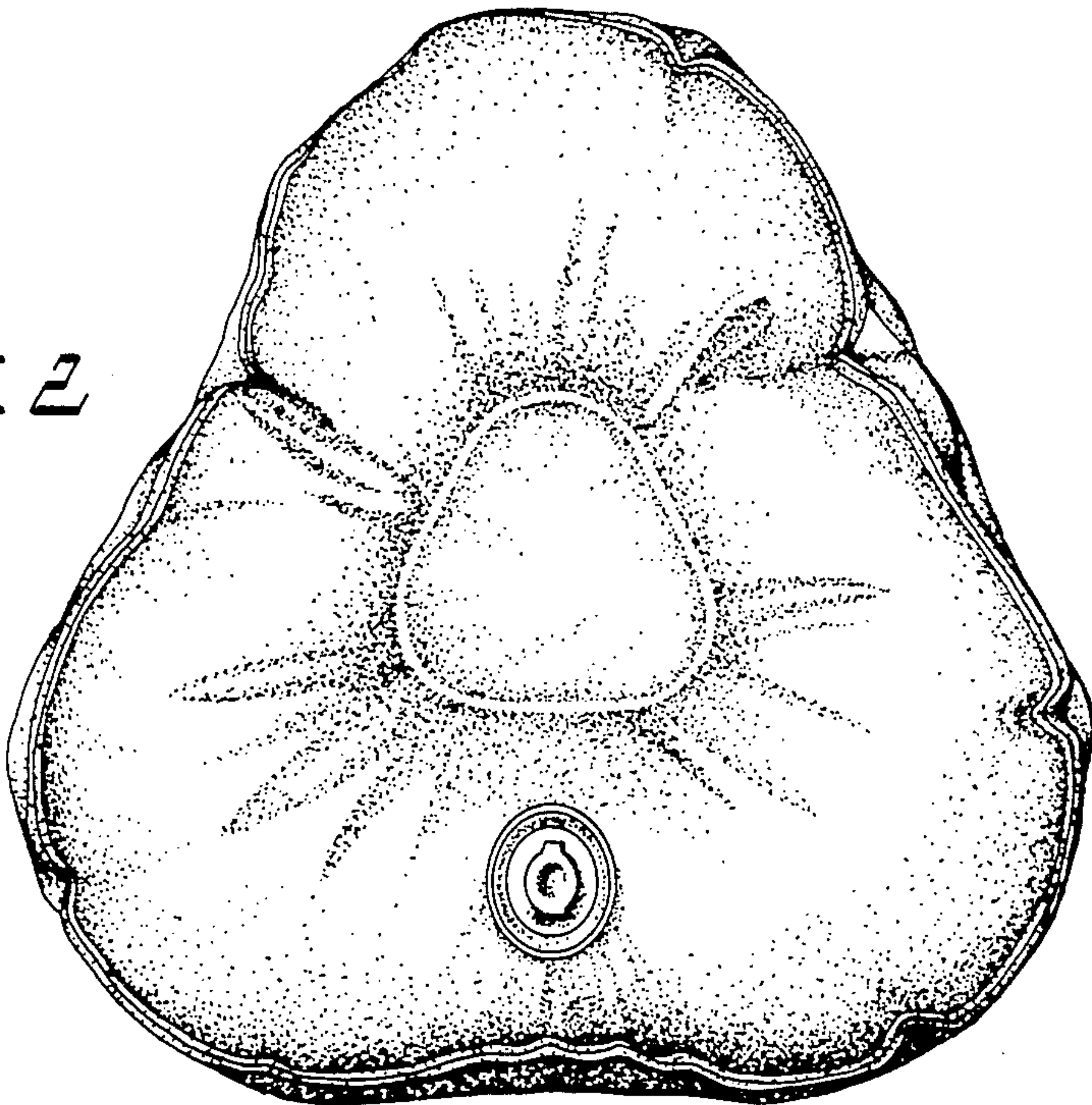

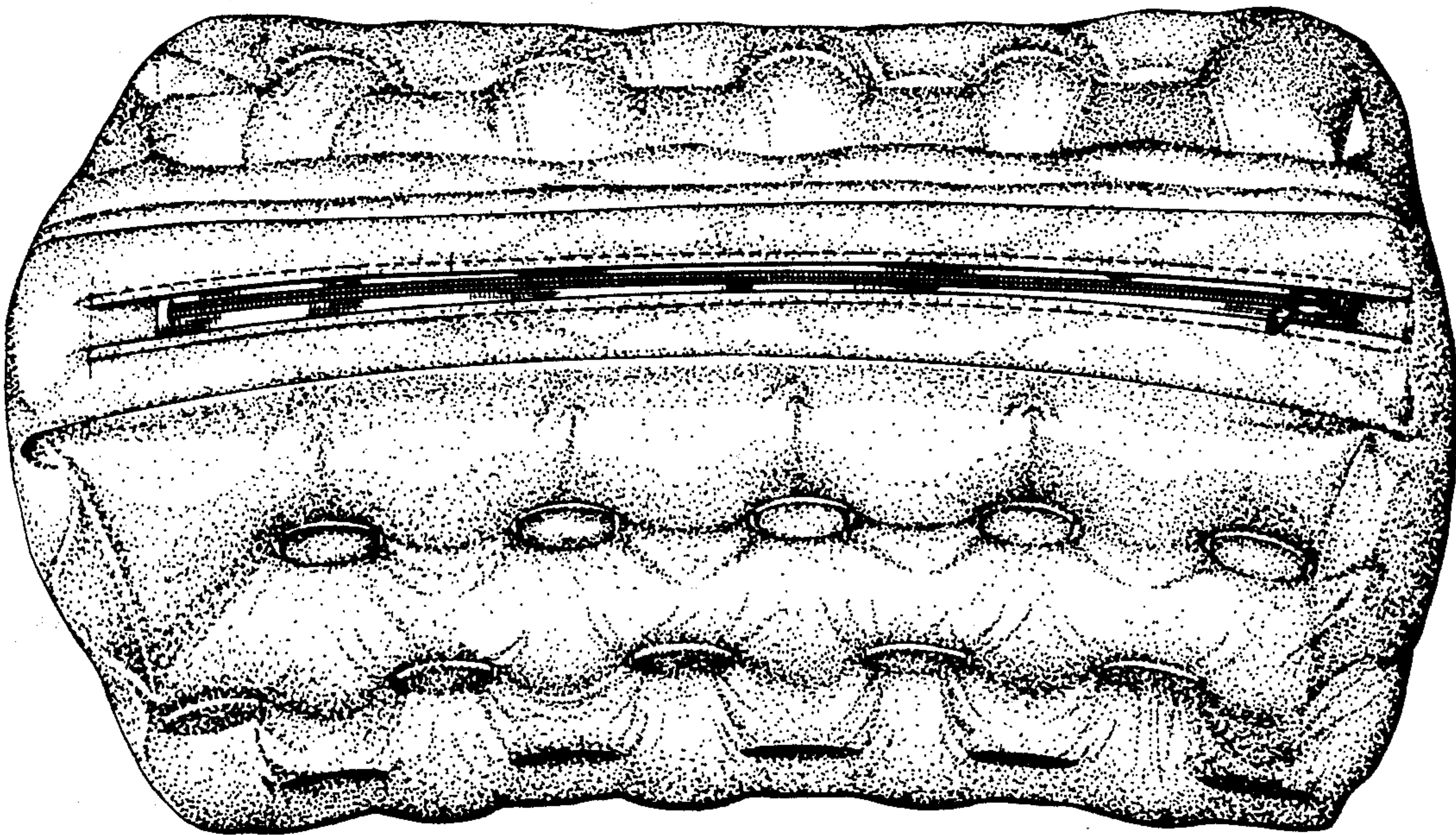
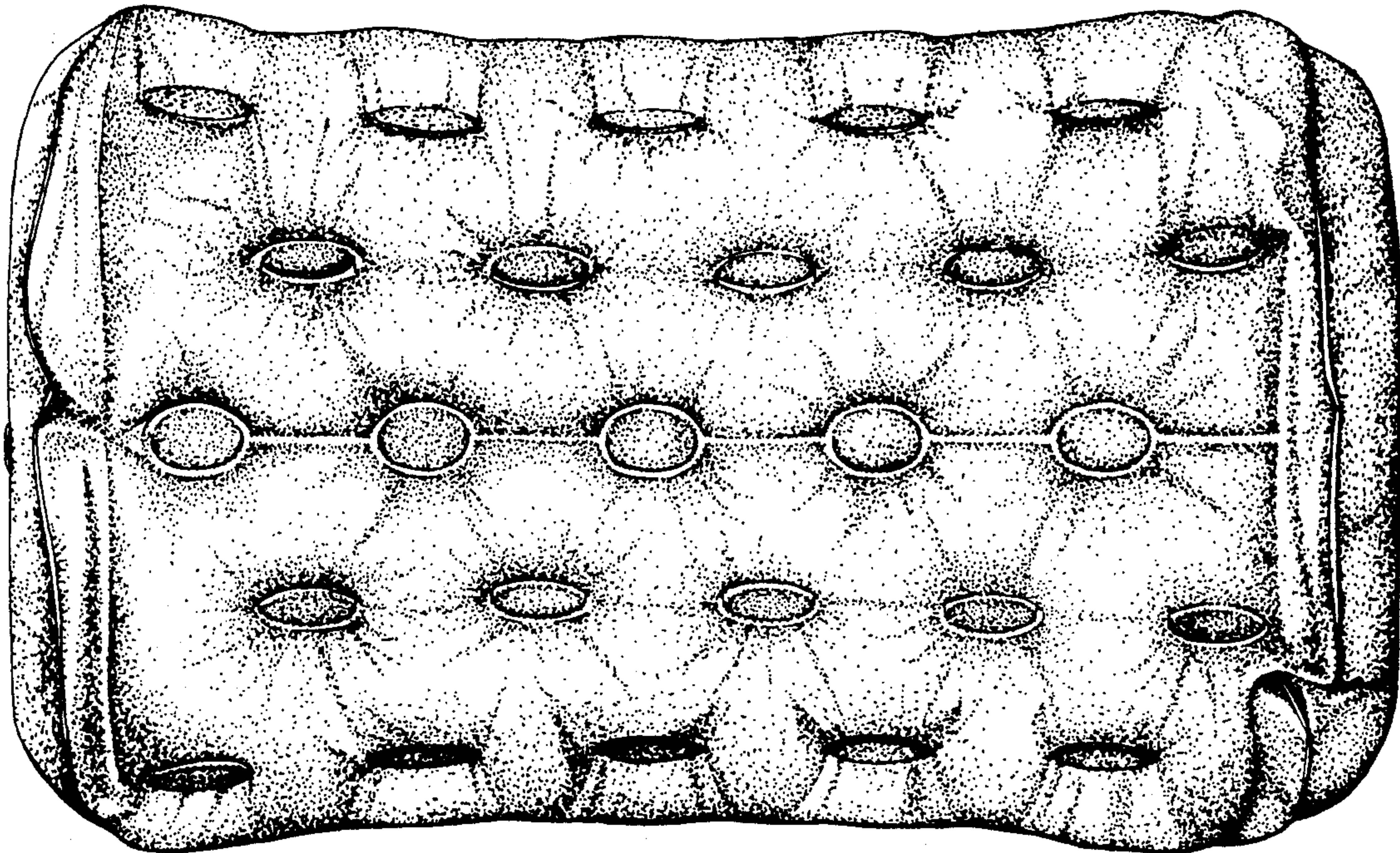
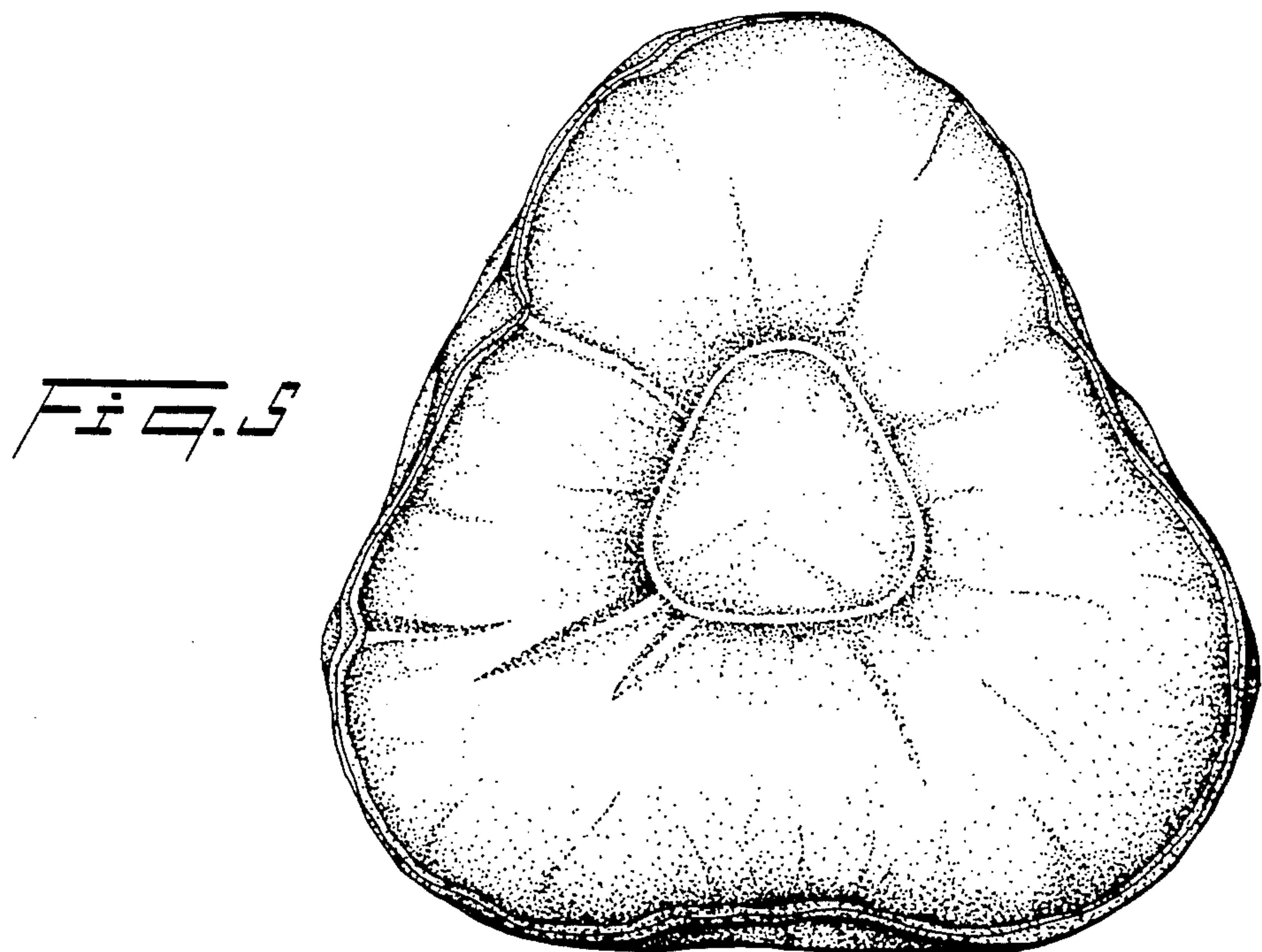
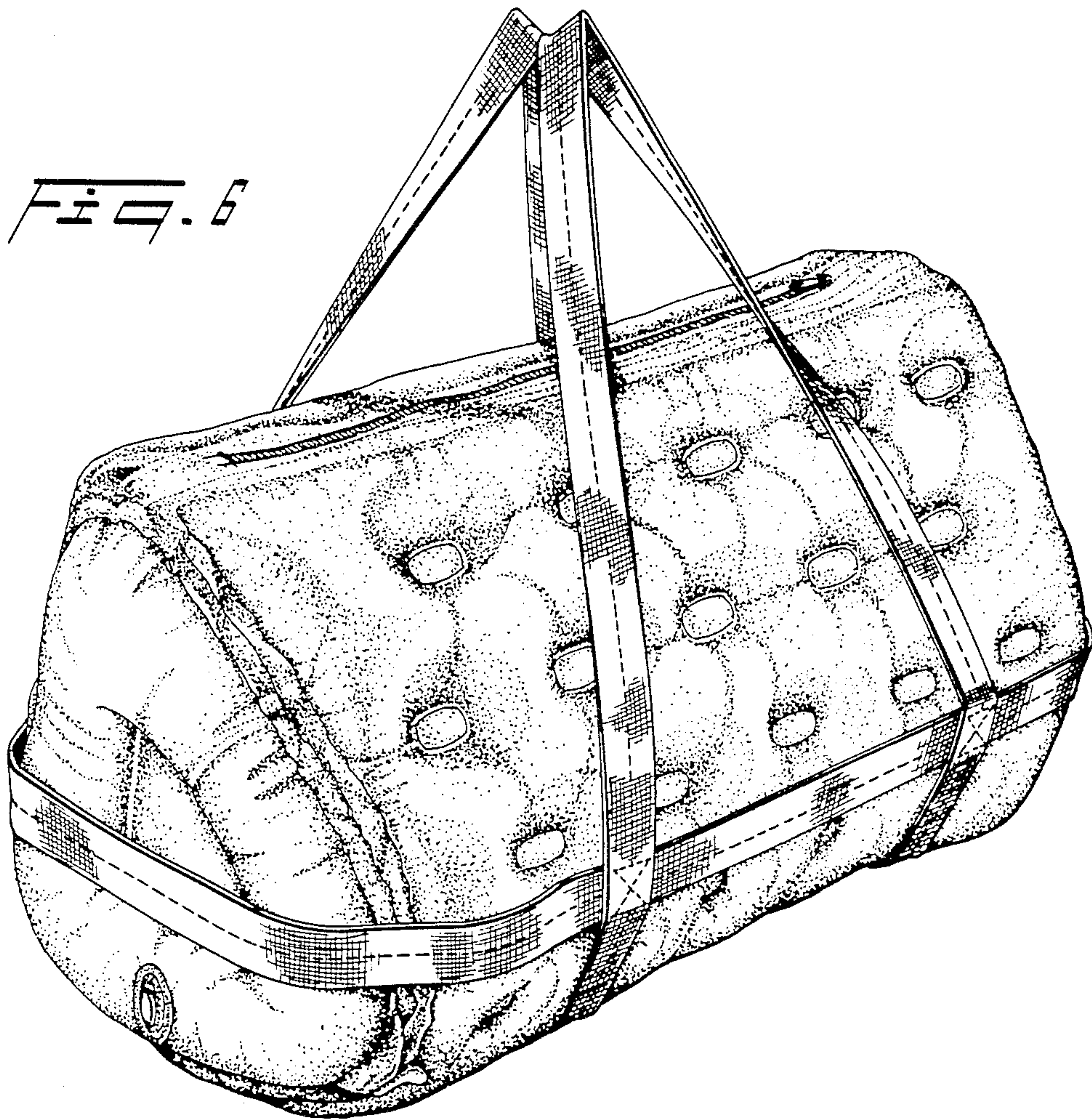

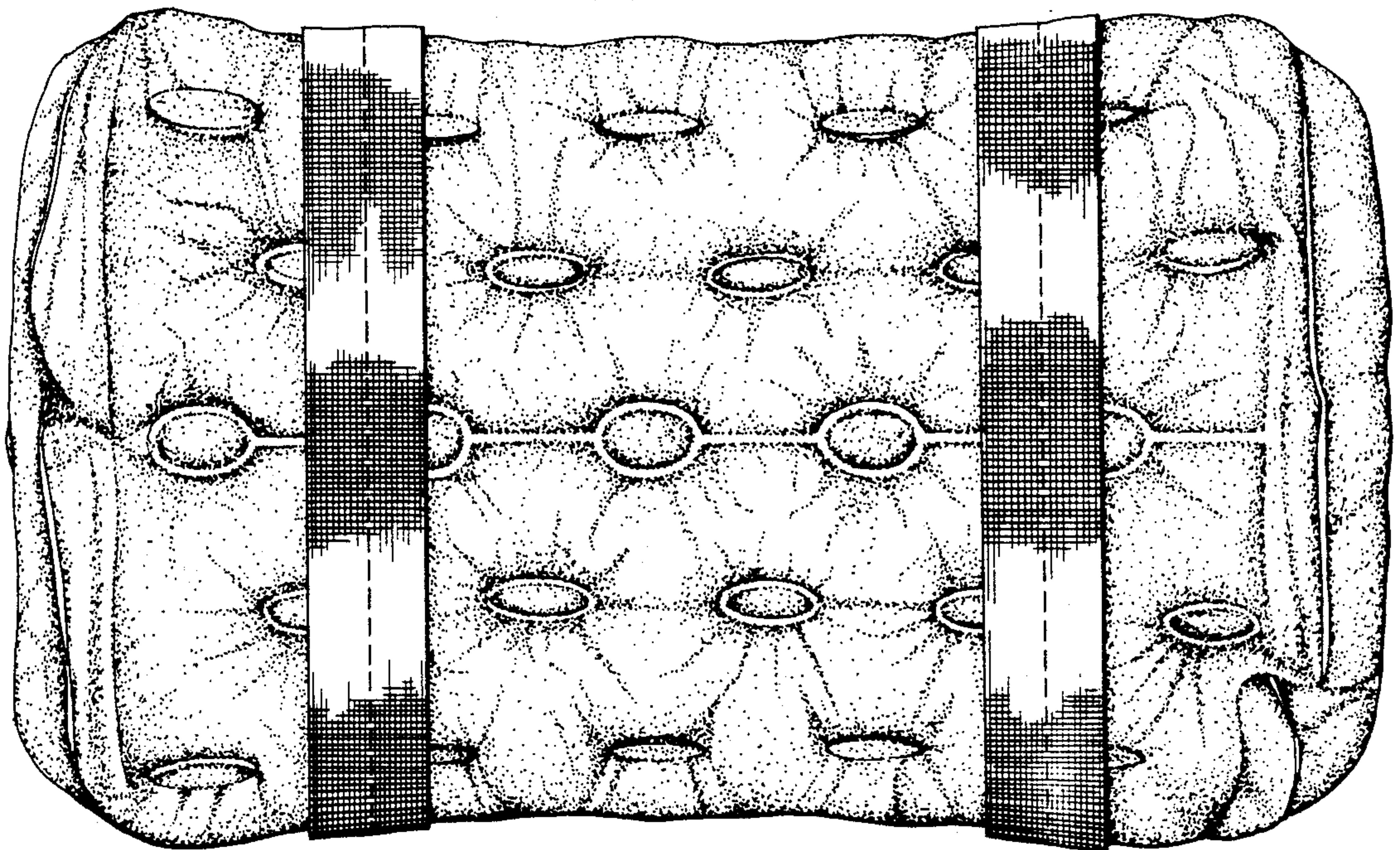

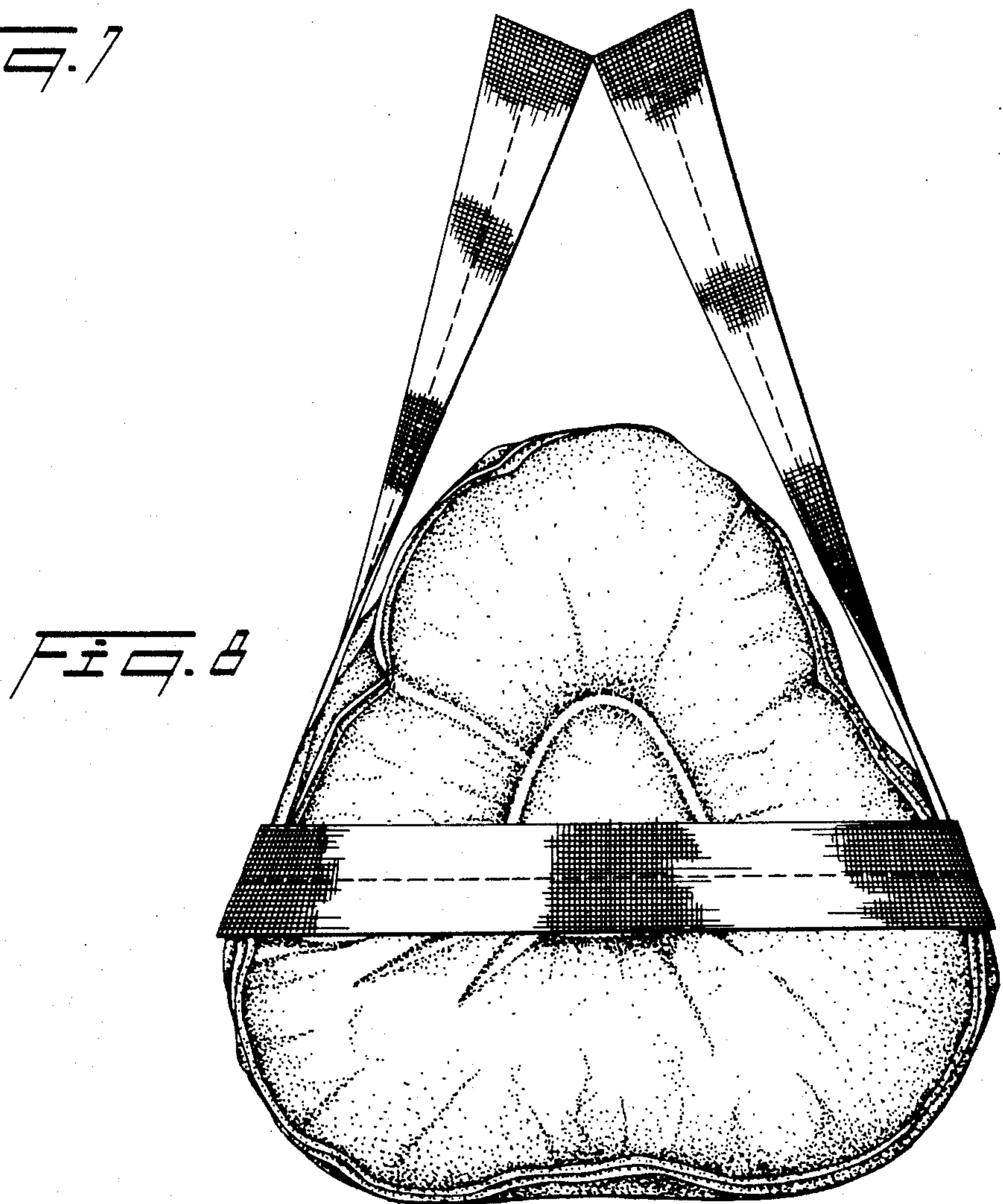
