The ornamental design for a door security brace, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a perspective view of a door security brace showing our new design, with the brace being shown in the retracted position;

FIG. 2 is a perspective view thereof, with the brace being shown in the extended position;

FIG. 3 is a front elevational view thereof;

FIG. 4 is a rear elevational view thereof;

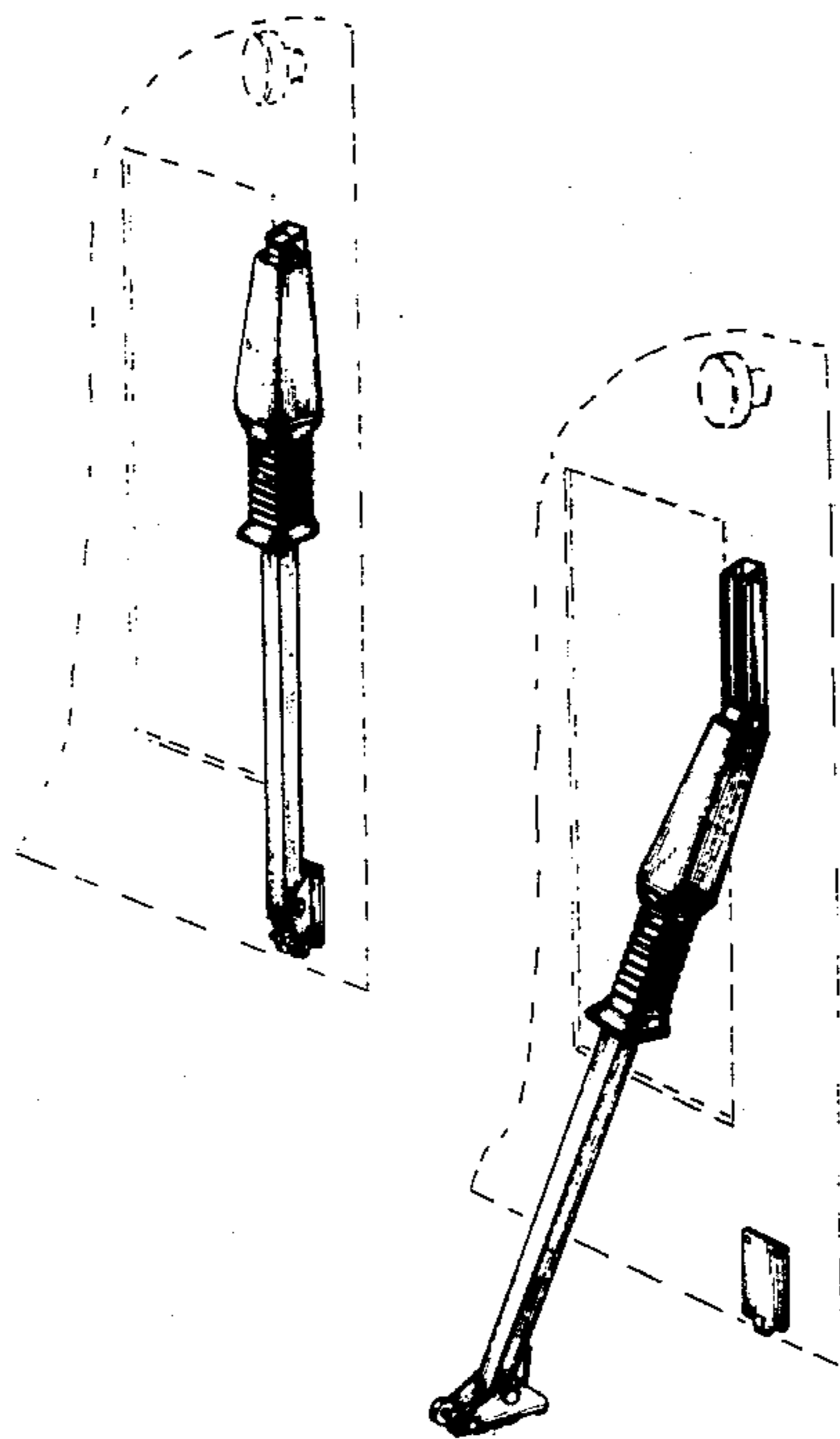
FIG. 5 is a top plan view thereof;

FIG. 7 is a left side elevational view thereof; and

The broken-line showing of a portion of a door in FIGS. 1 and 2 is for illustrative purposes only, and forms no part of the claimed design.



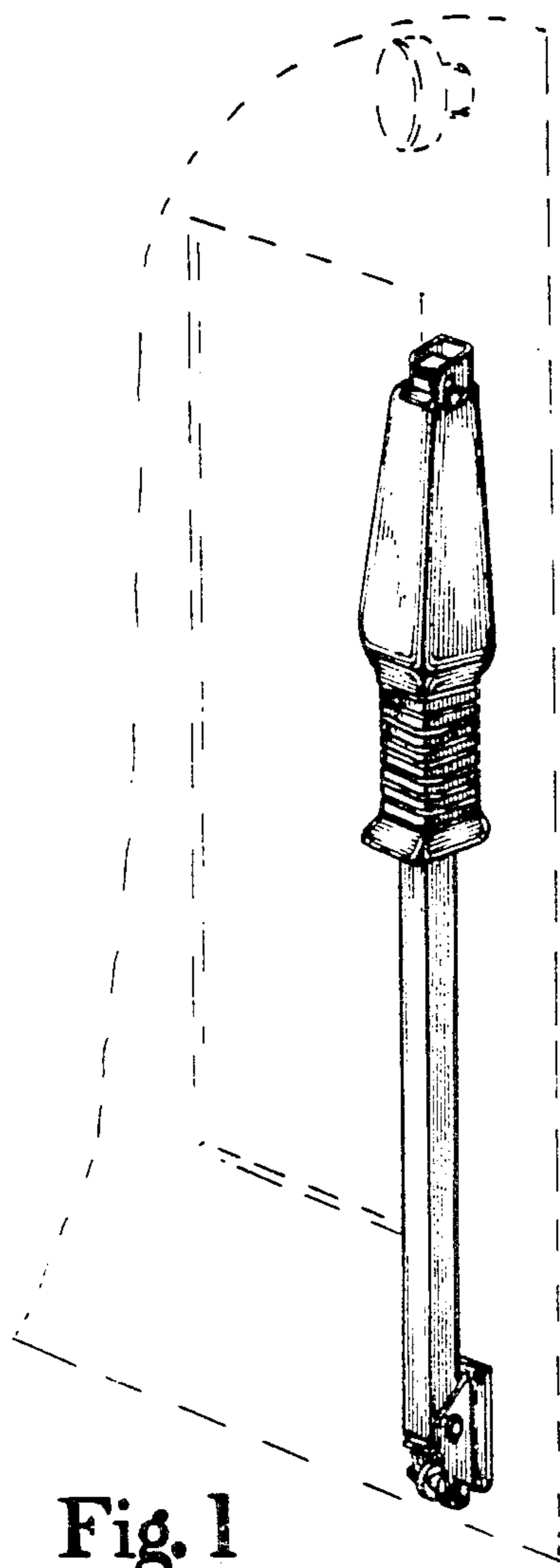

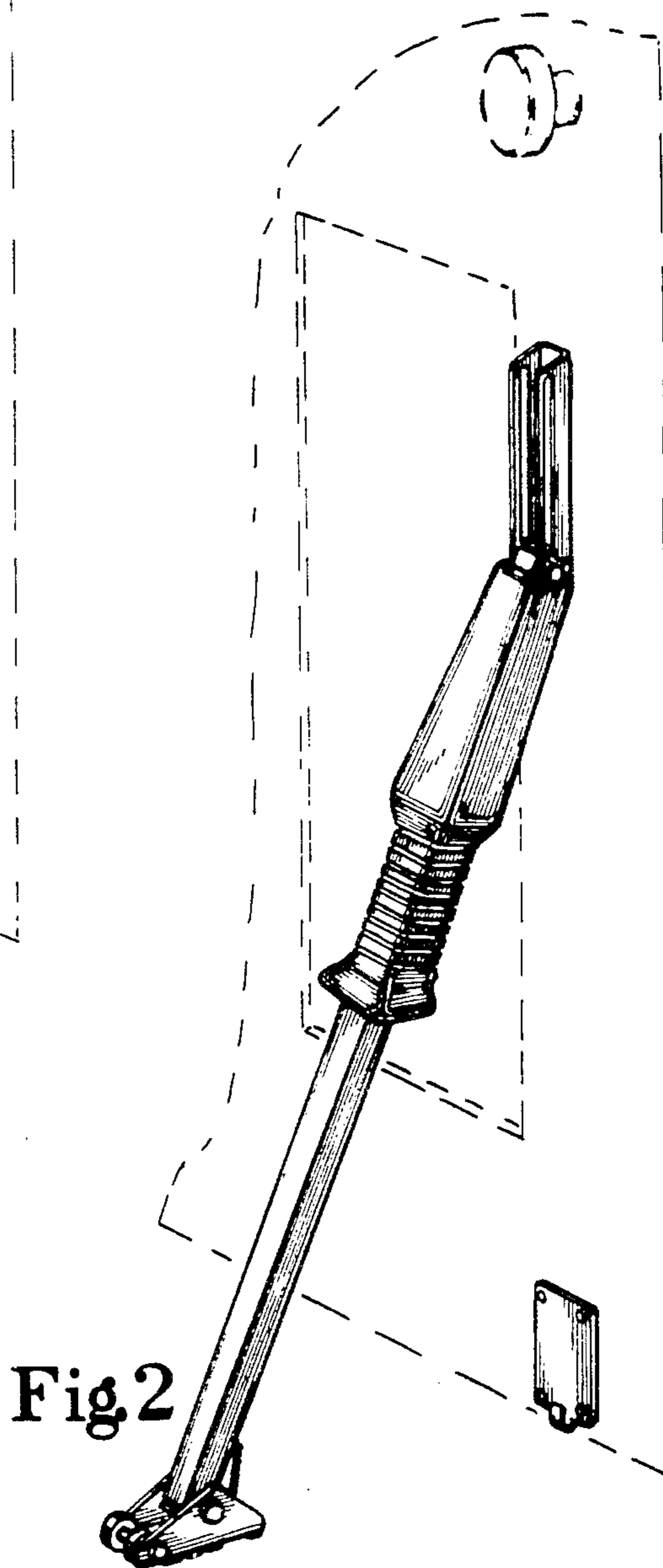

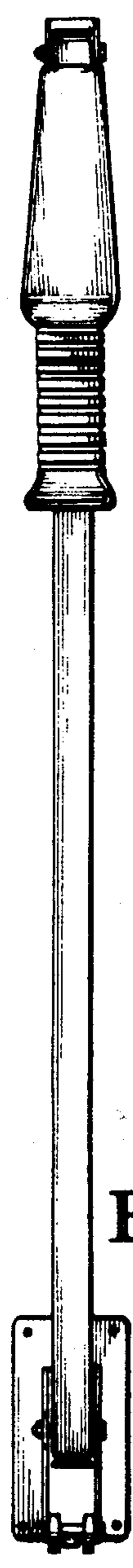

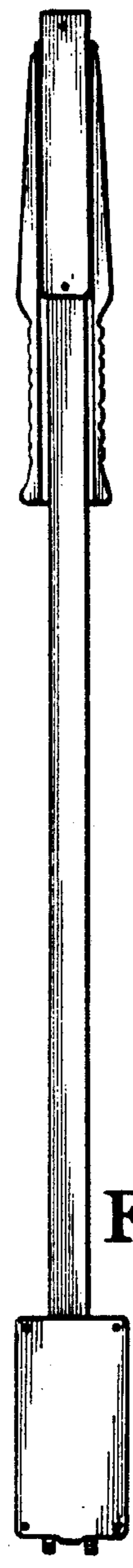

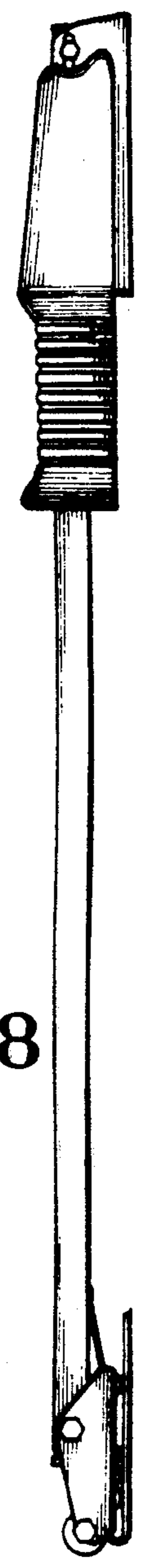

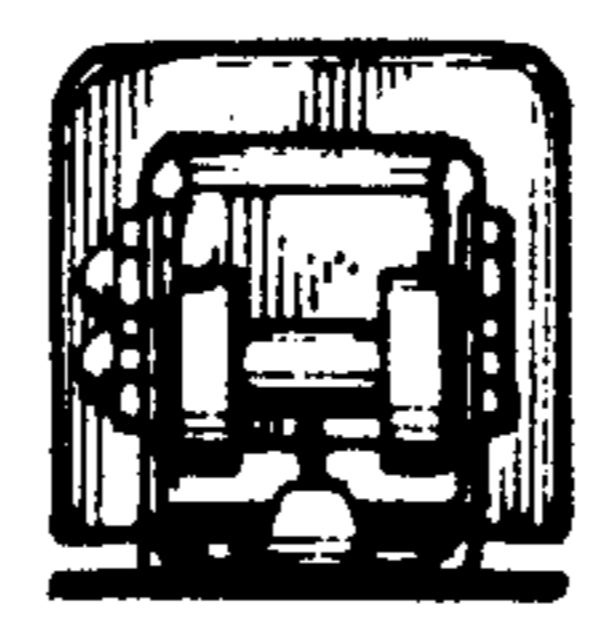

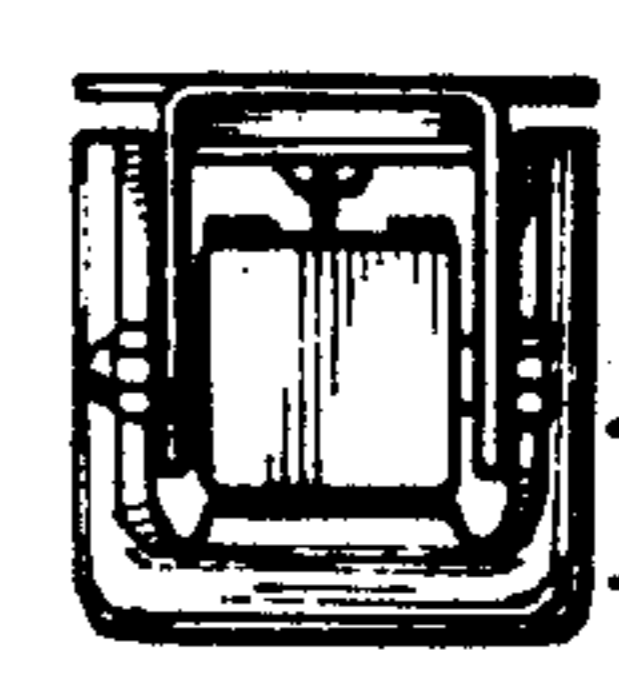
