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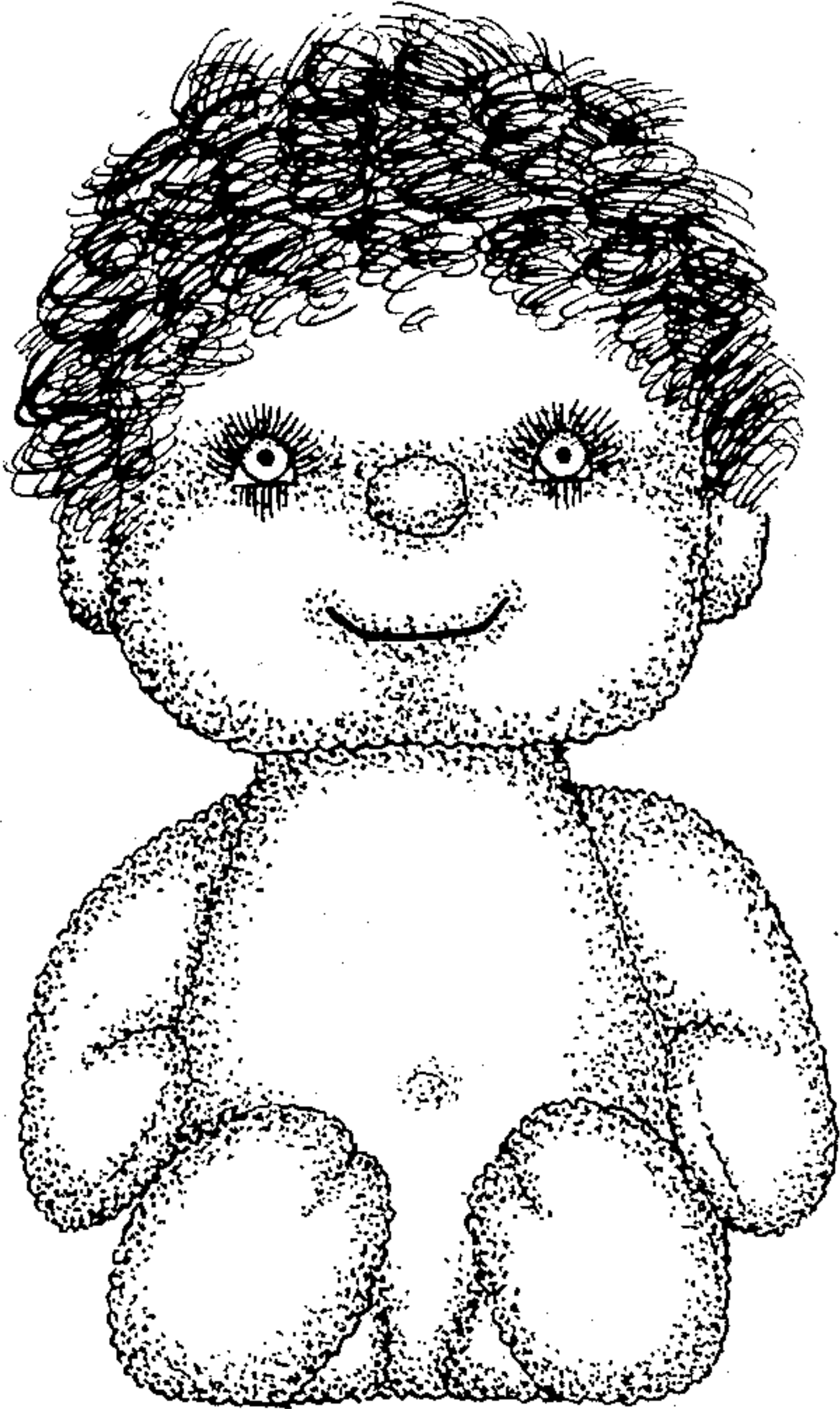
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[57] CLAIM

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a front elevational view of a doll showing our new design;  
FIG. 2 is a side elevational view thereof, the opposite side being substantially a mirror image thereof;  
FIG. 3 is a rear elevational view thereof;  
FIG. 4 is a top plan view thereof;  
FIG. 5 is a bottom plan view thereof;  
FIG. 6 is a perspective view showing the doll with its hands joined together; and  
FIG. 7 shows another embodiment thereof.  
FIG. 8 shows another embodiment thereof.



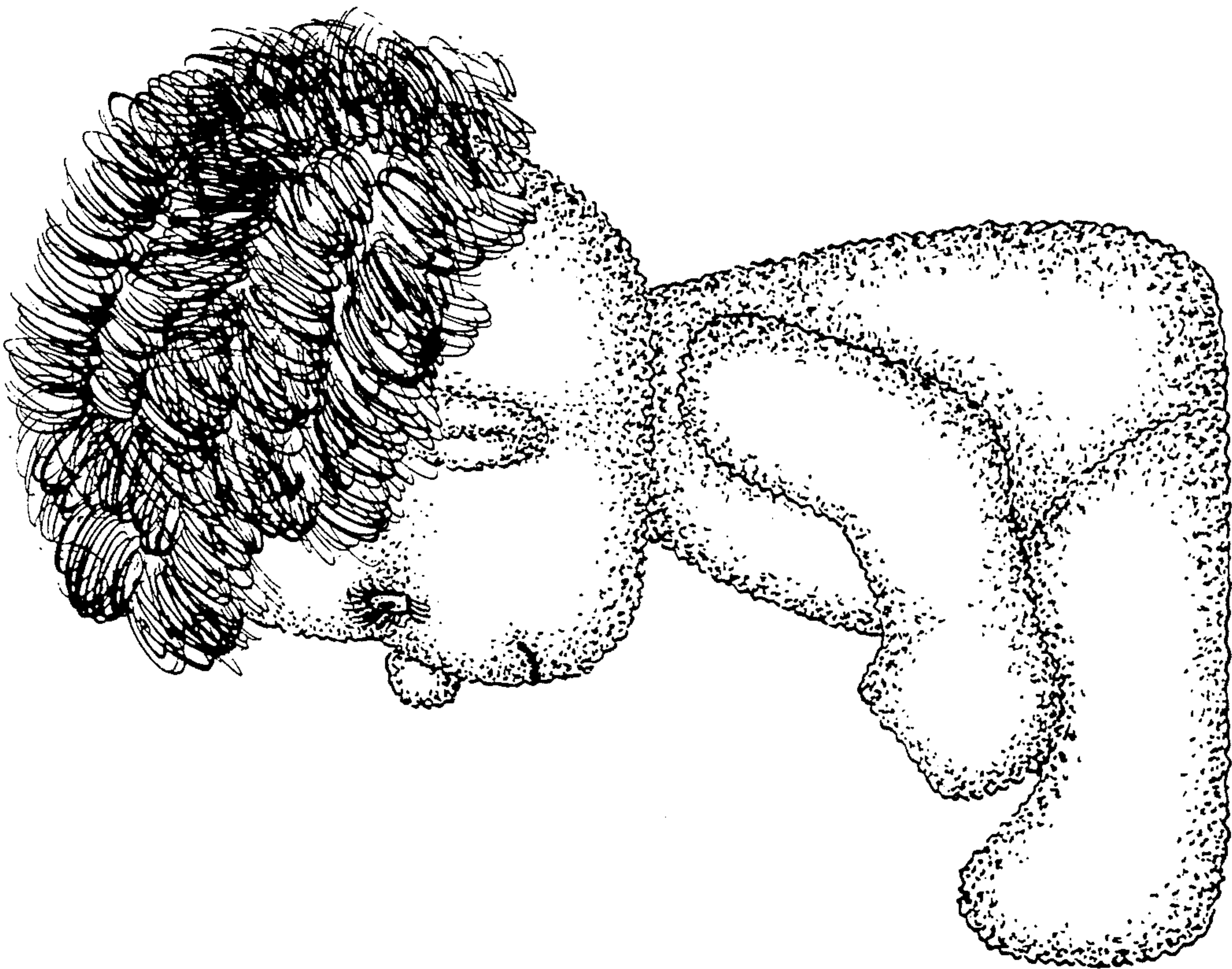

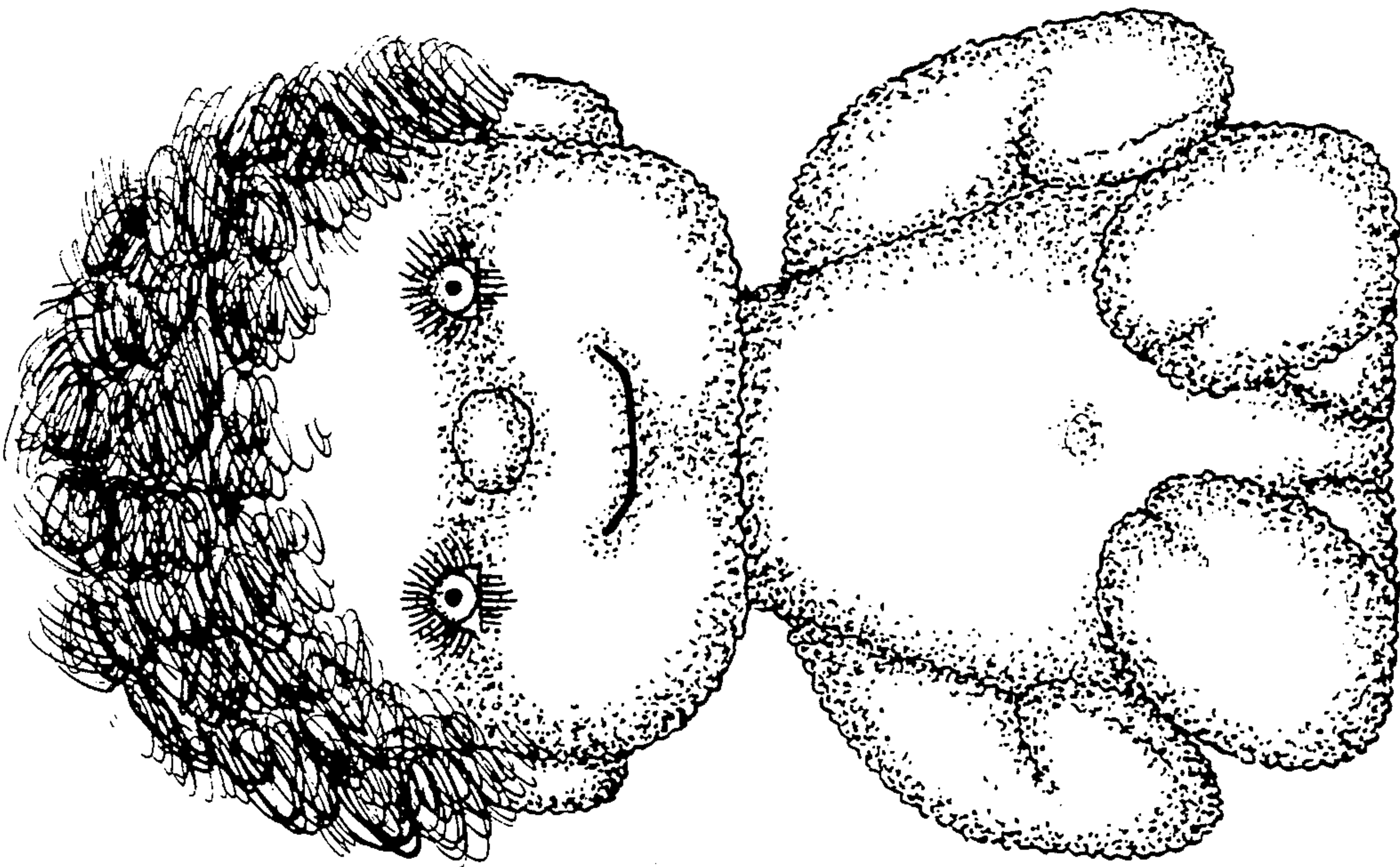

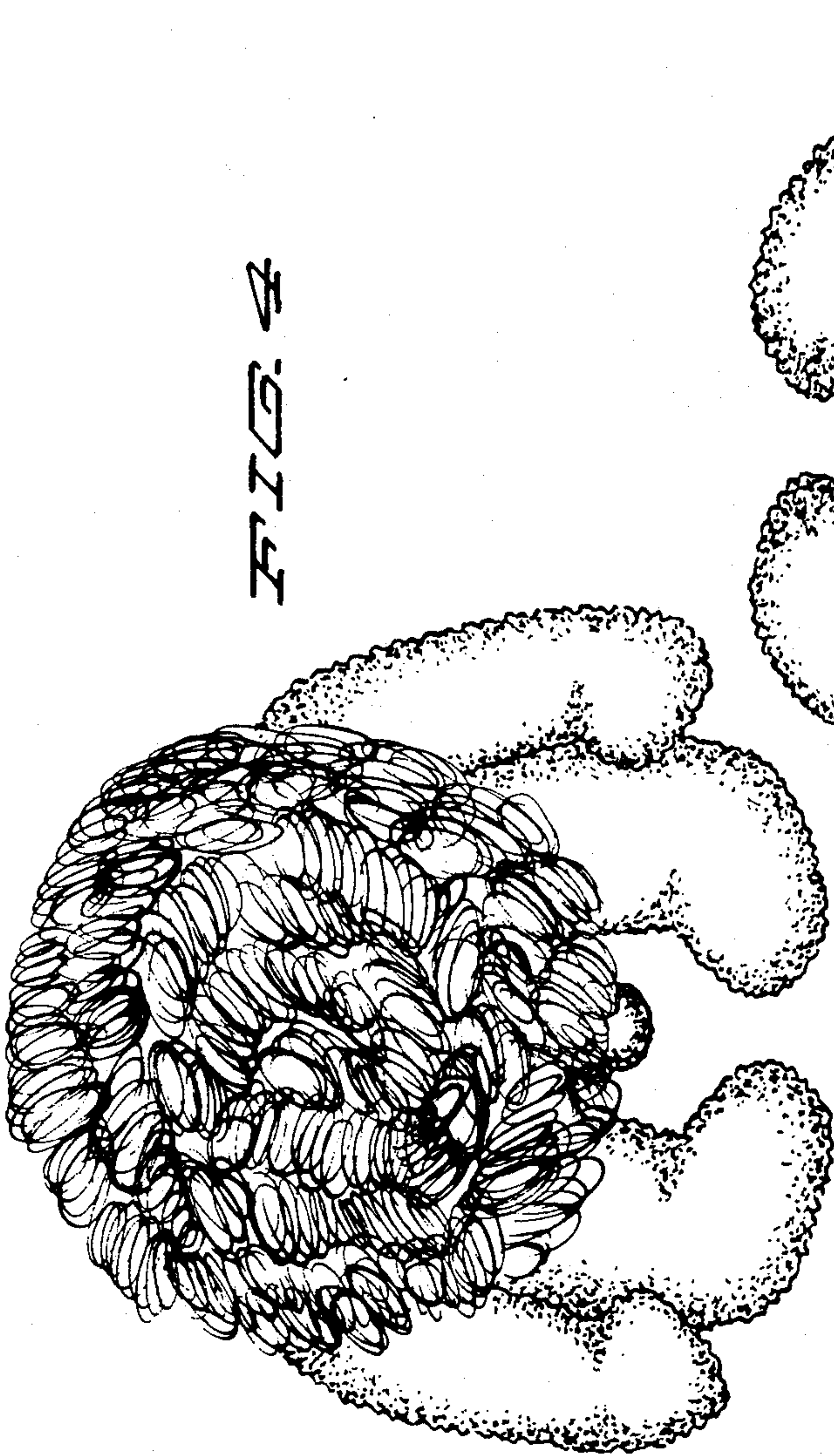

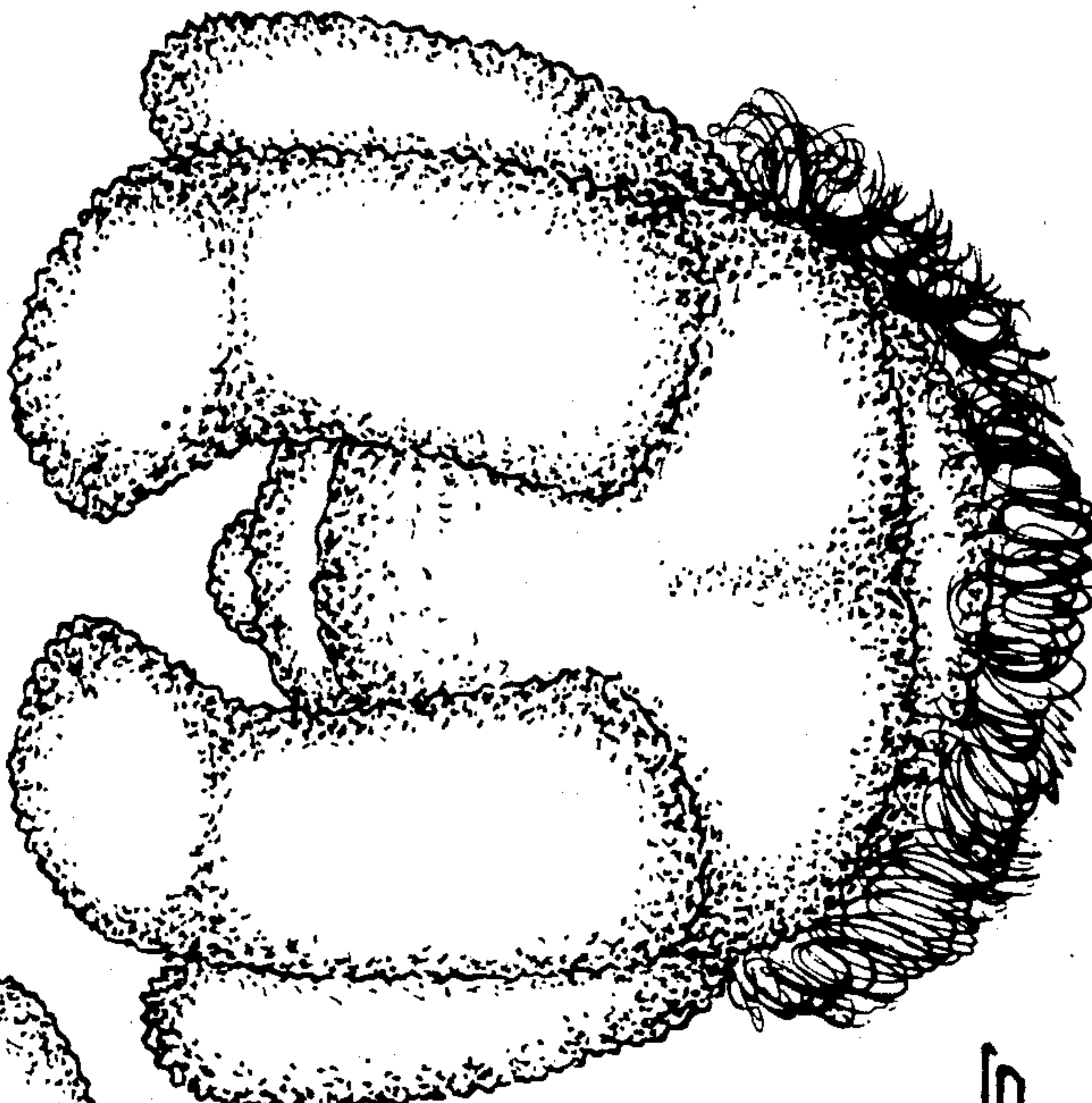

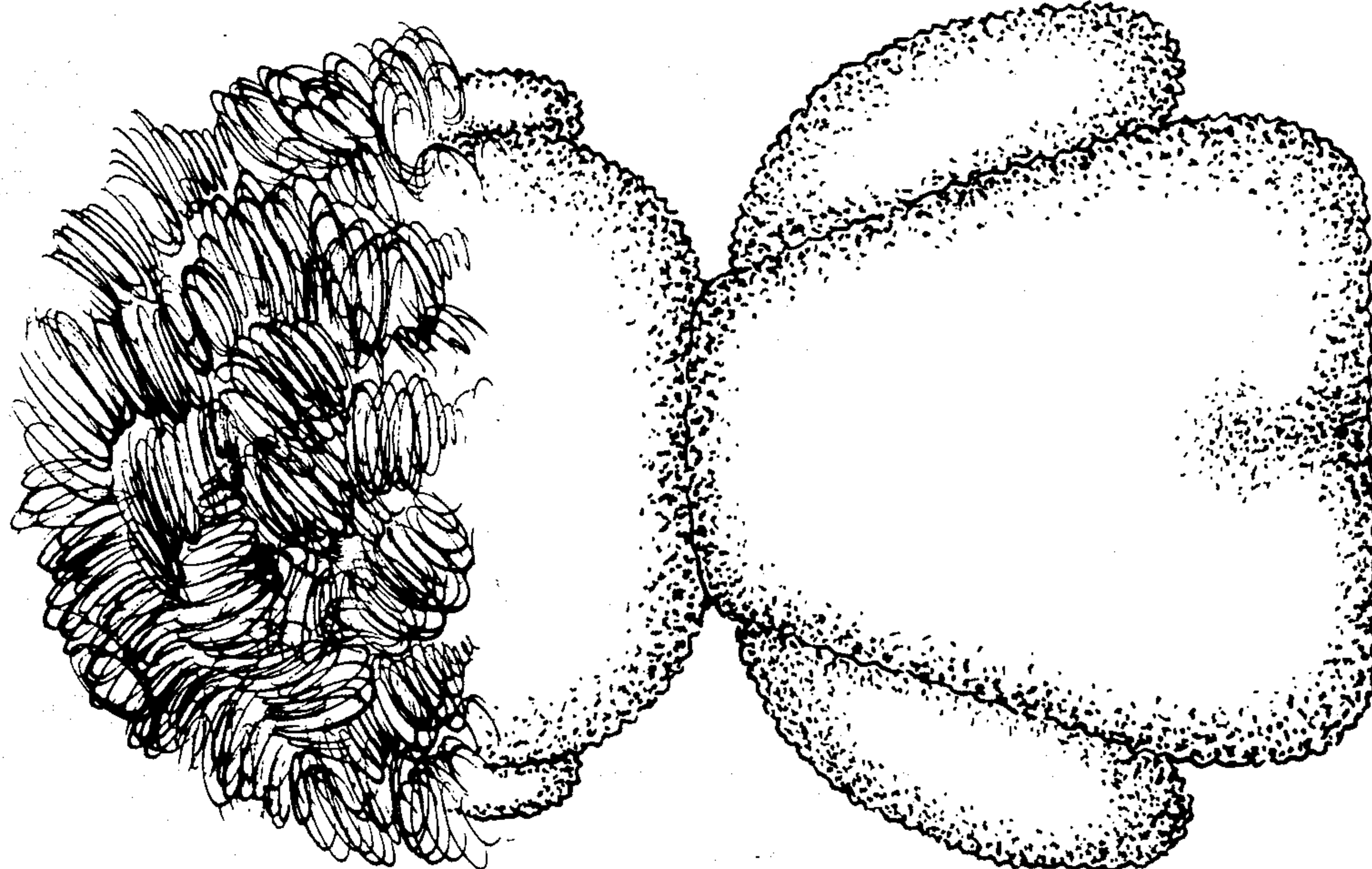

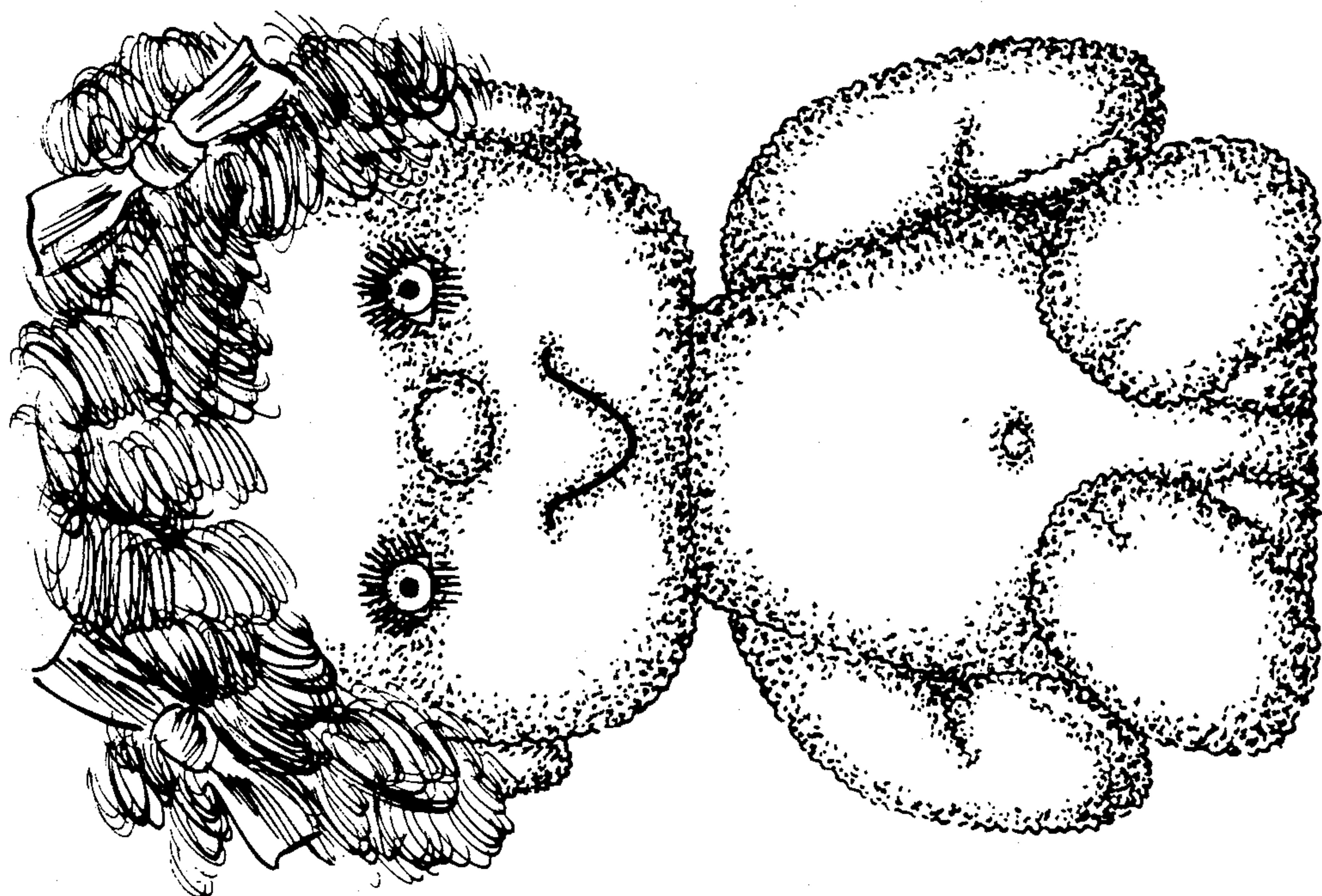

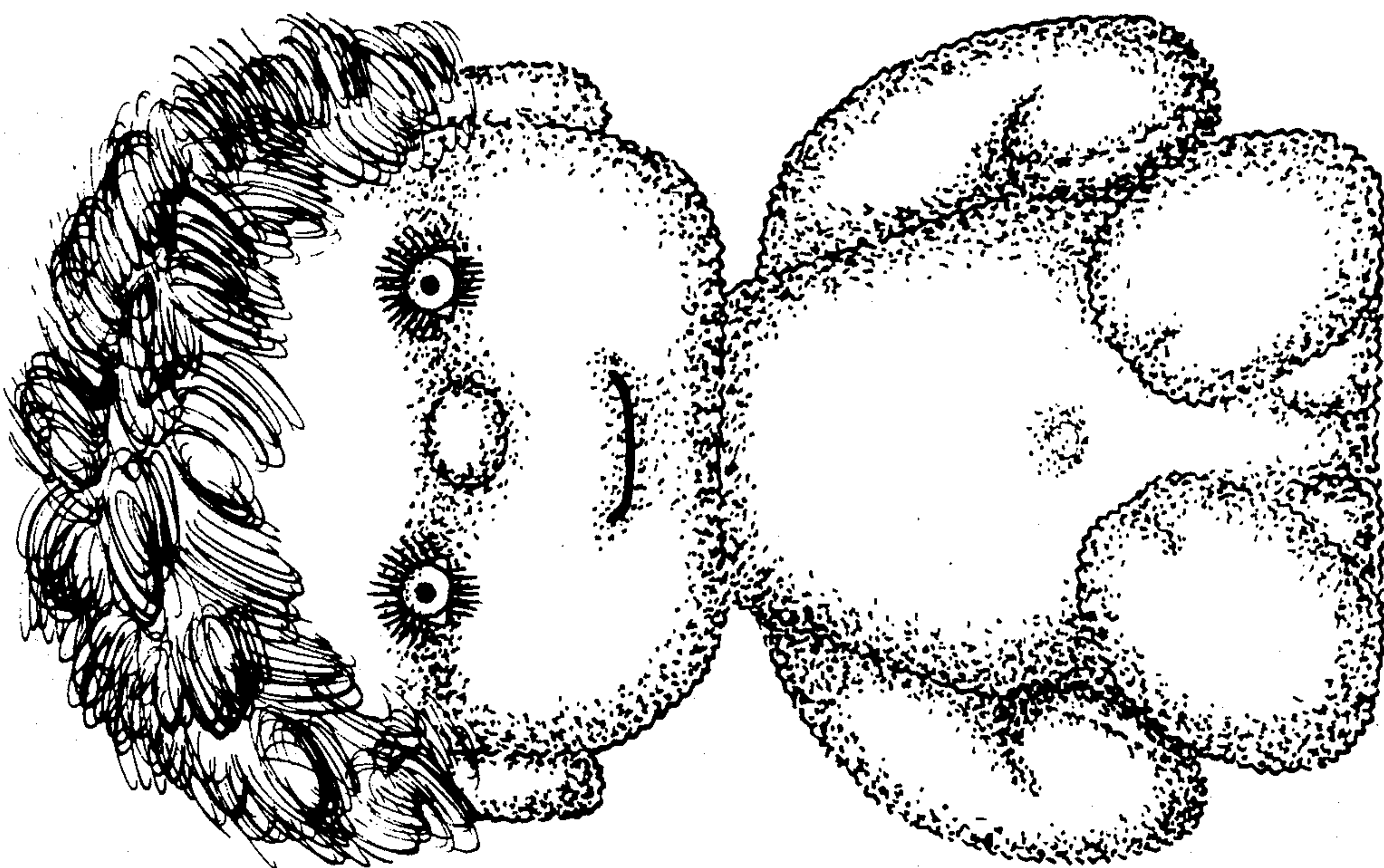
