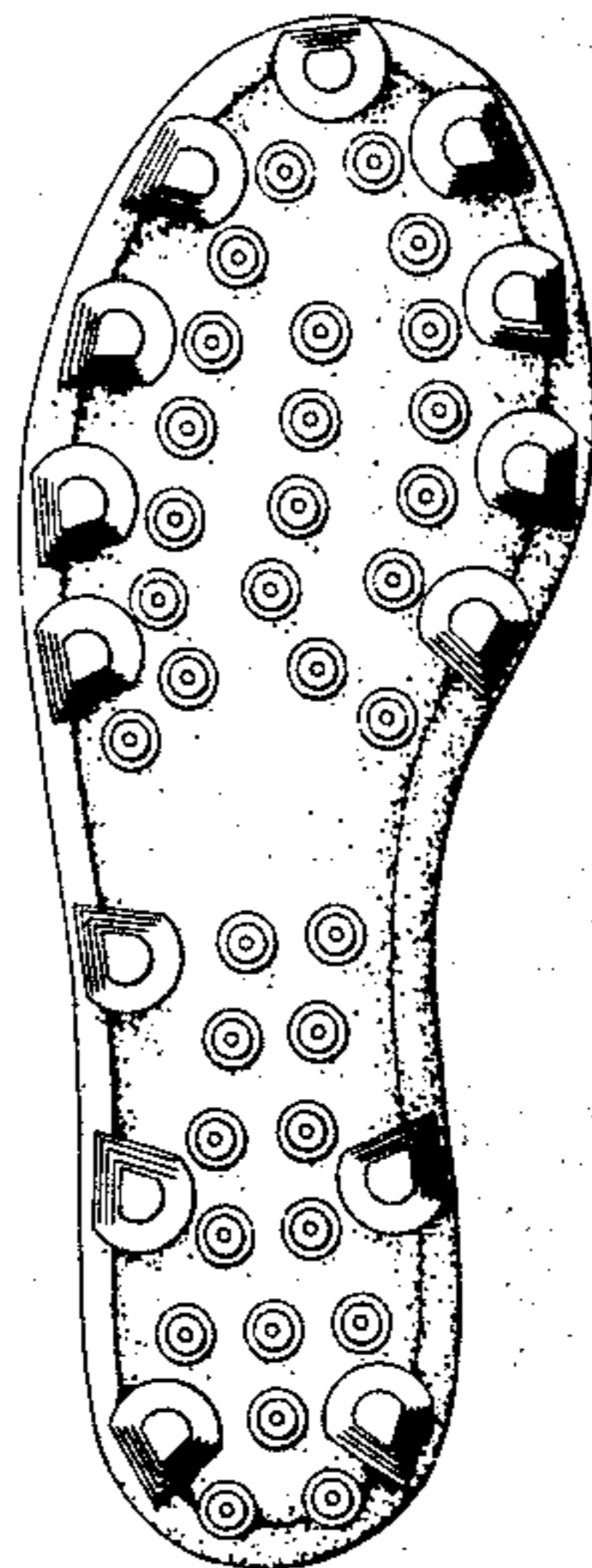

[57] **CLAIM**

The ornamental design for an athletic shoe outsole, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a bottom plan view of an athletic shoe outsole showing my new design;
FIG. 2 is an enlarged partial perspective view of one peripheral traction element of the FIG. 1 outsole;
FIG. 3 is a top plan view of FIG. 2;
FIG. 4 is a left side elevational view of FIG. 2;
FIG. 5 is an enlarged partial perspective view of one of the inner traction elements of the FIG. 1 outsole;
FIG. 6 is a top plan view thereof;
FIG. 7 is a top and left front perspective view thereof, the broken-line showing of a shoe upper is environmental only and forms no part of the claimed design.



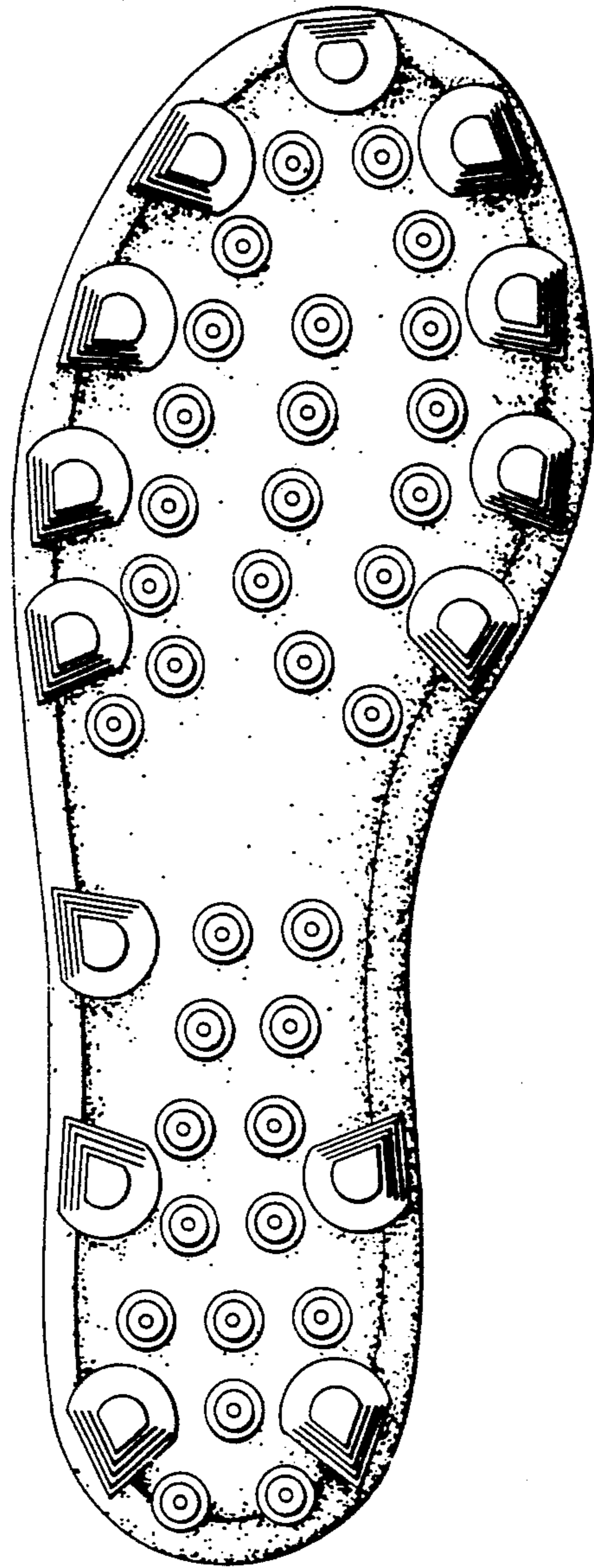

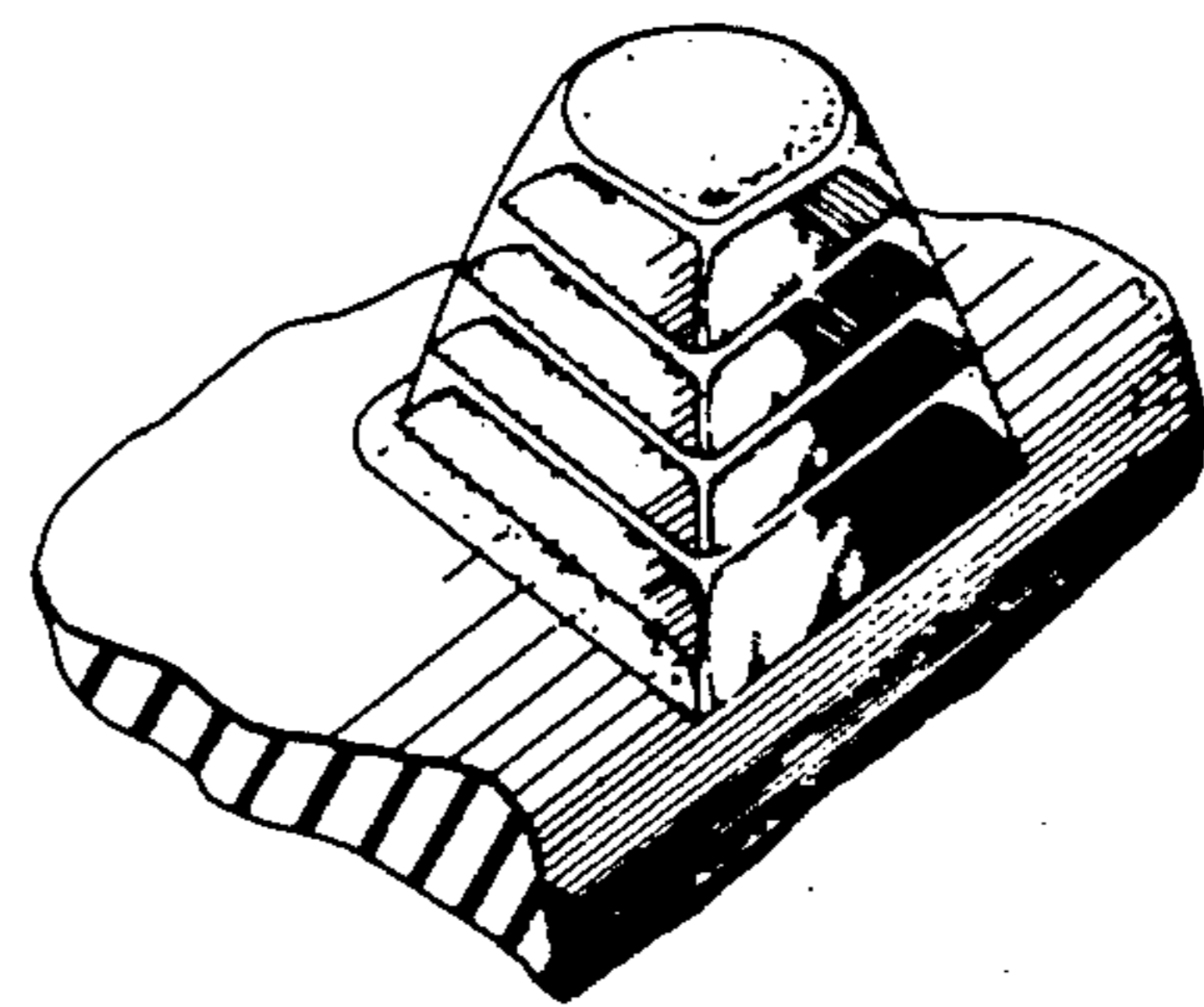

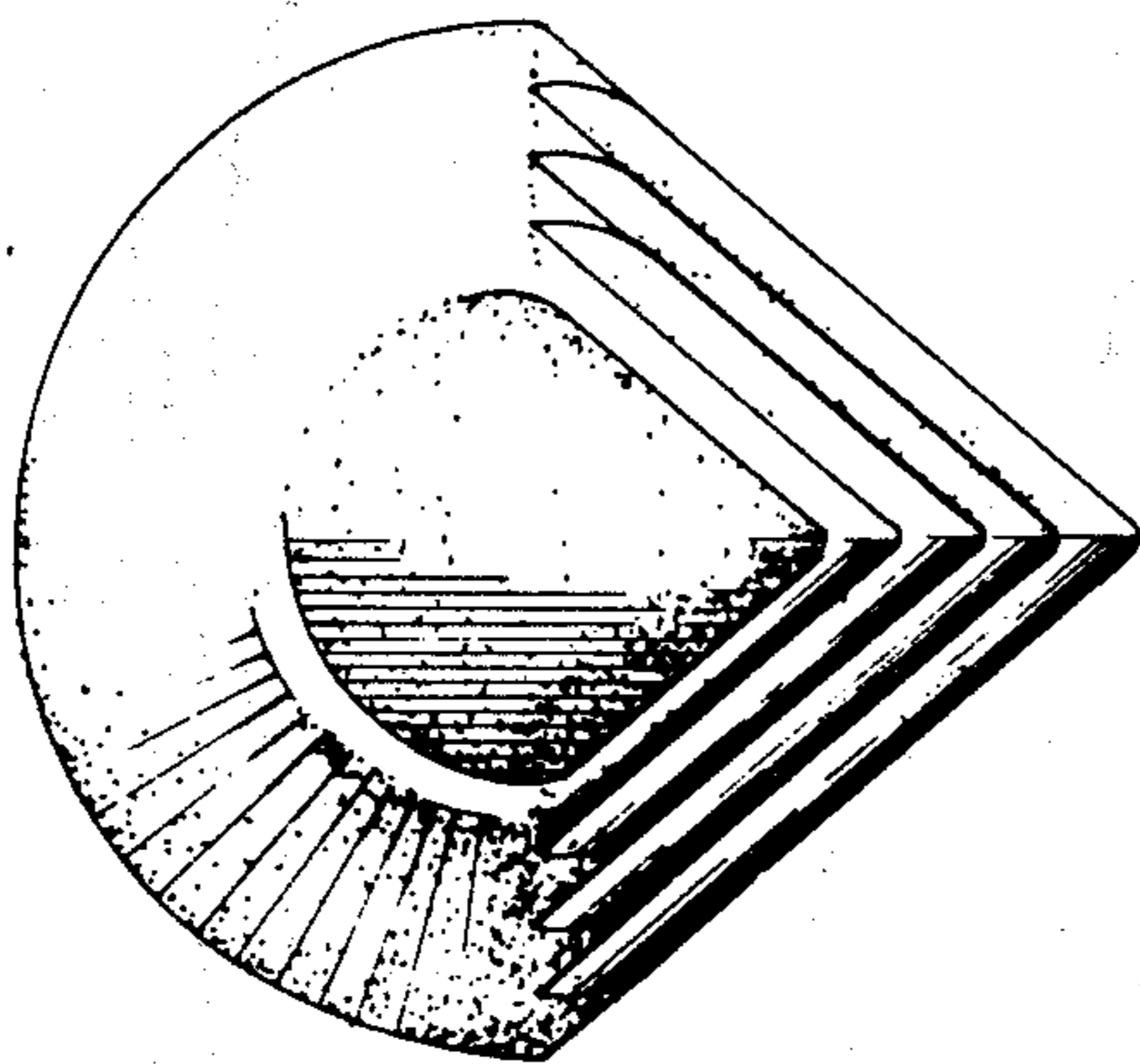

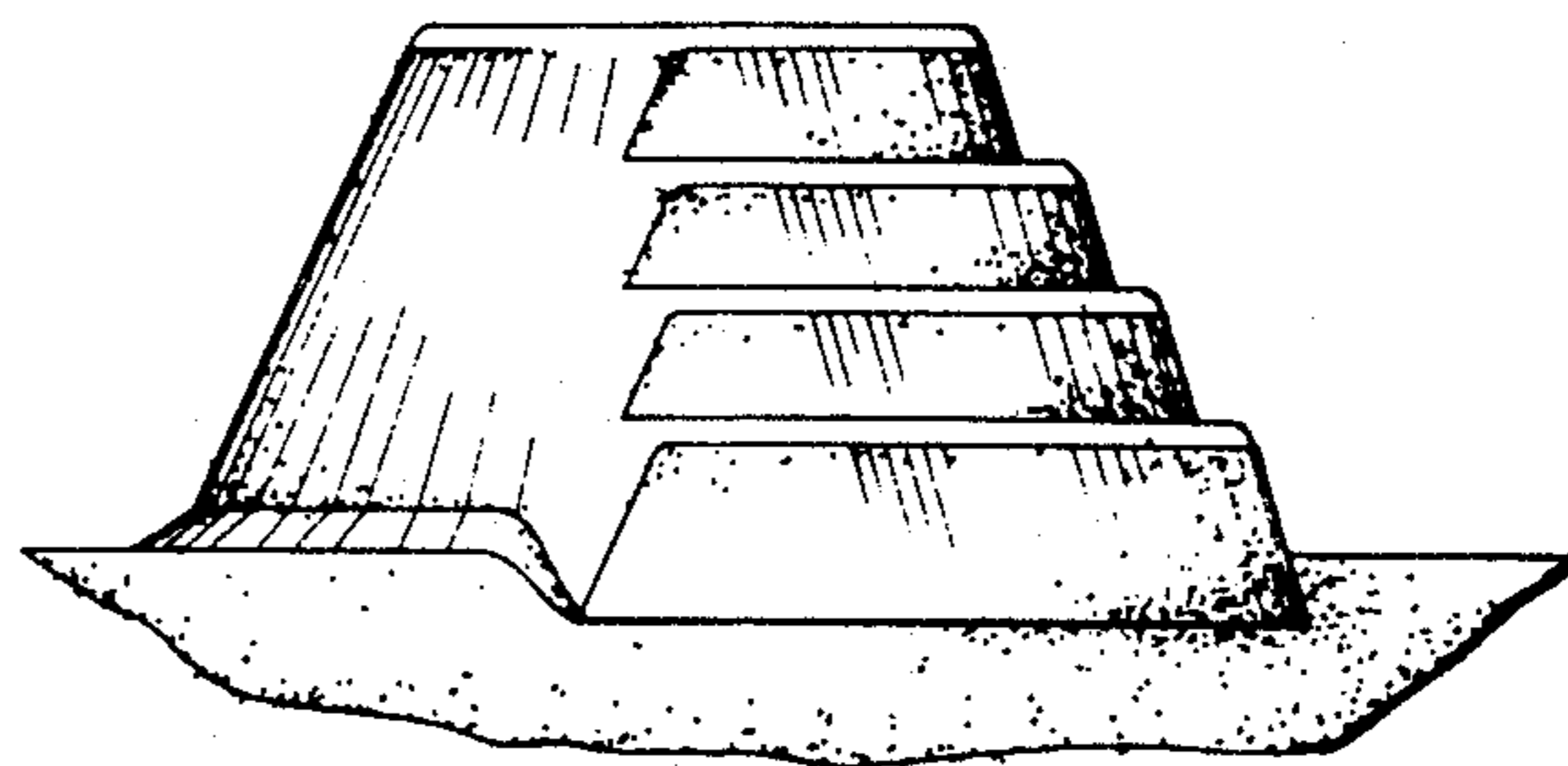

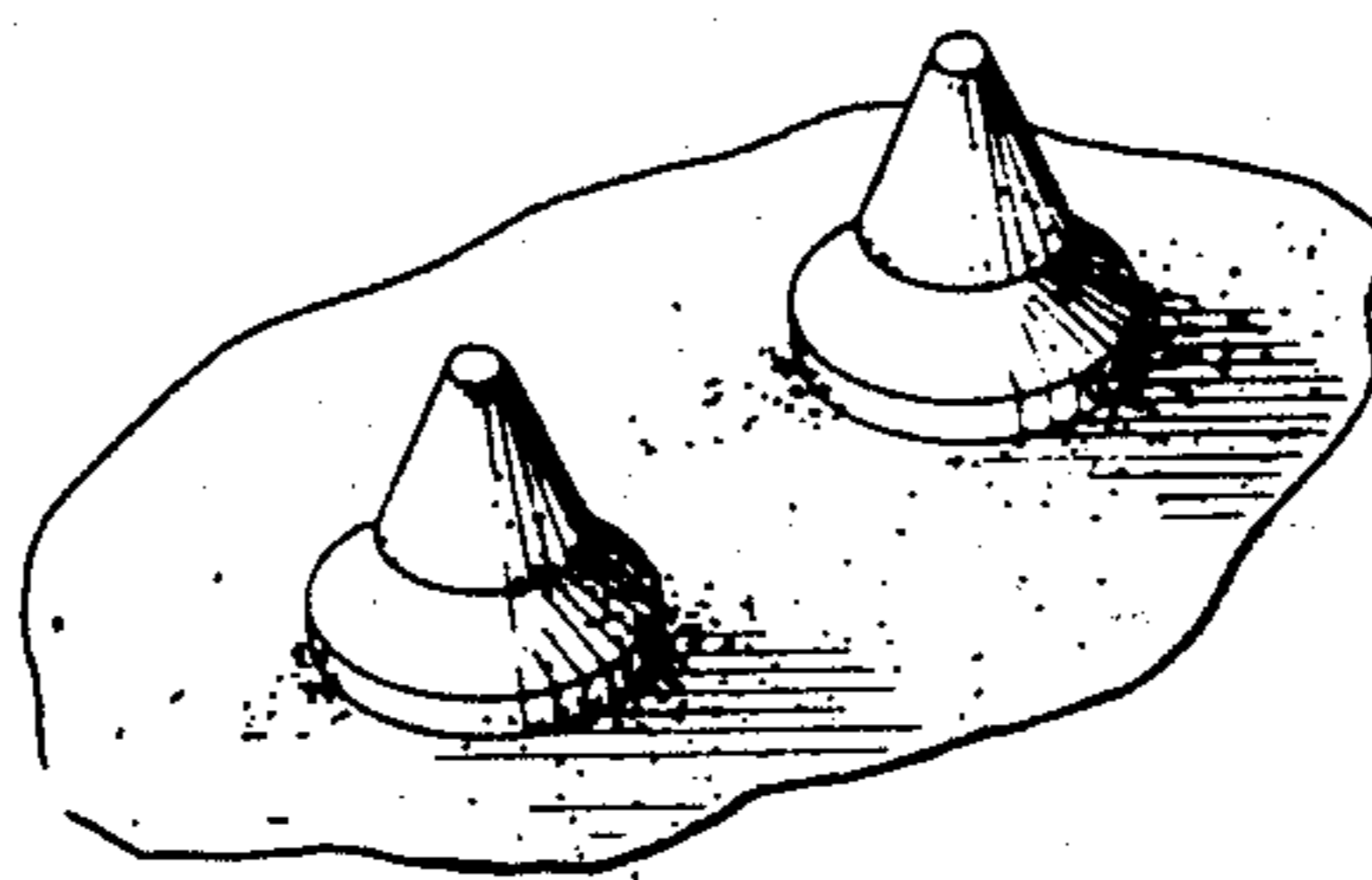

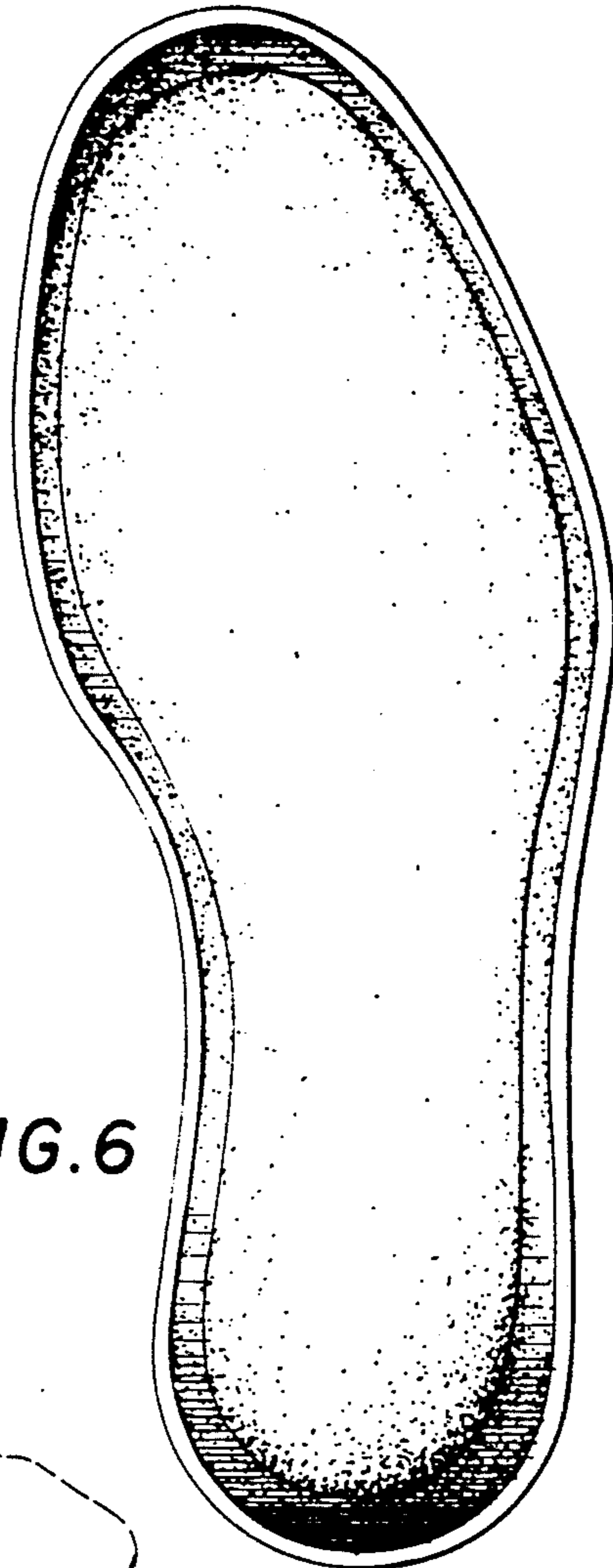

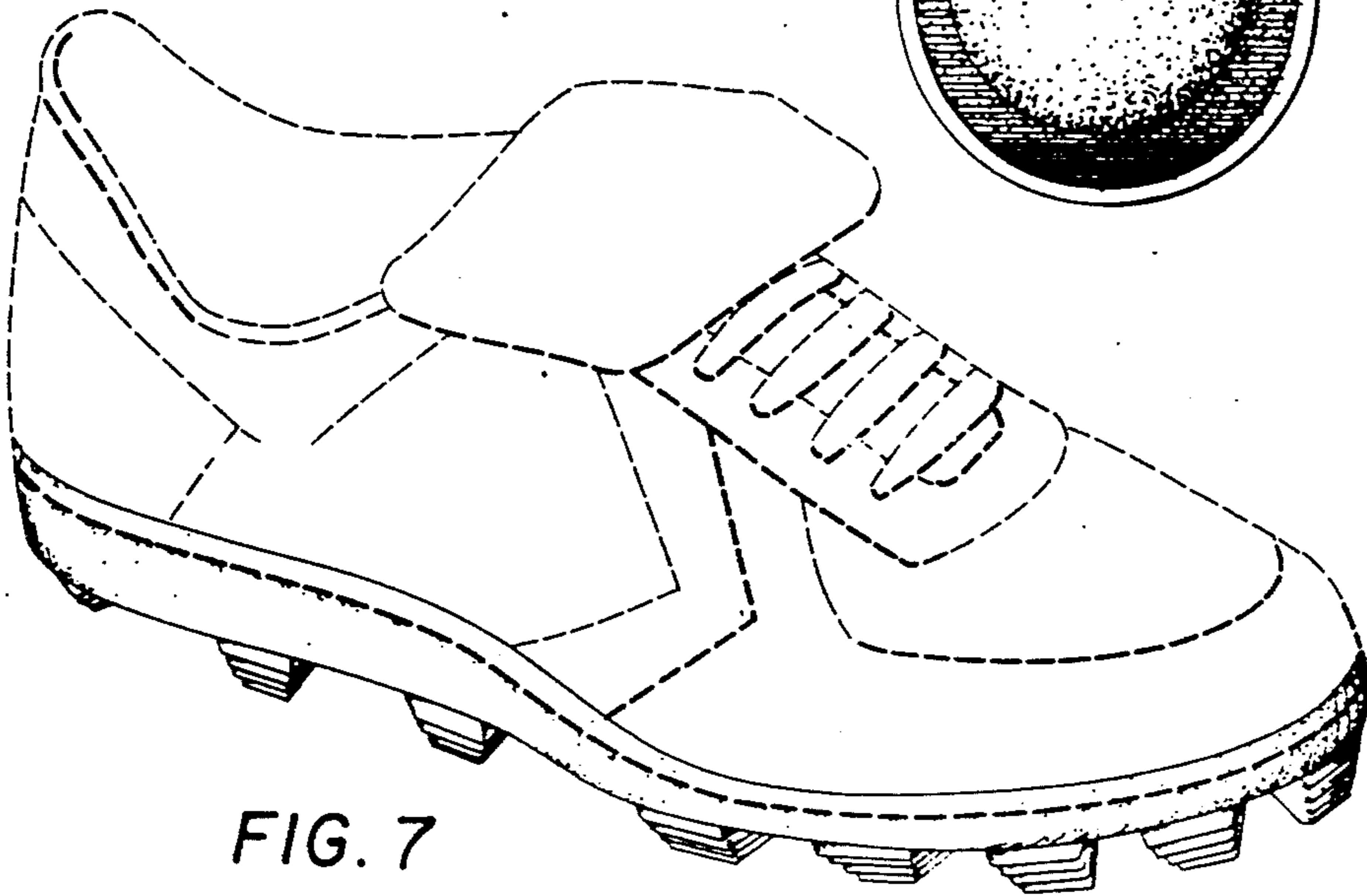
