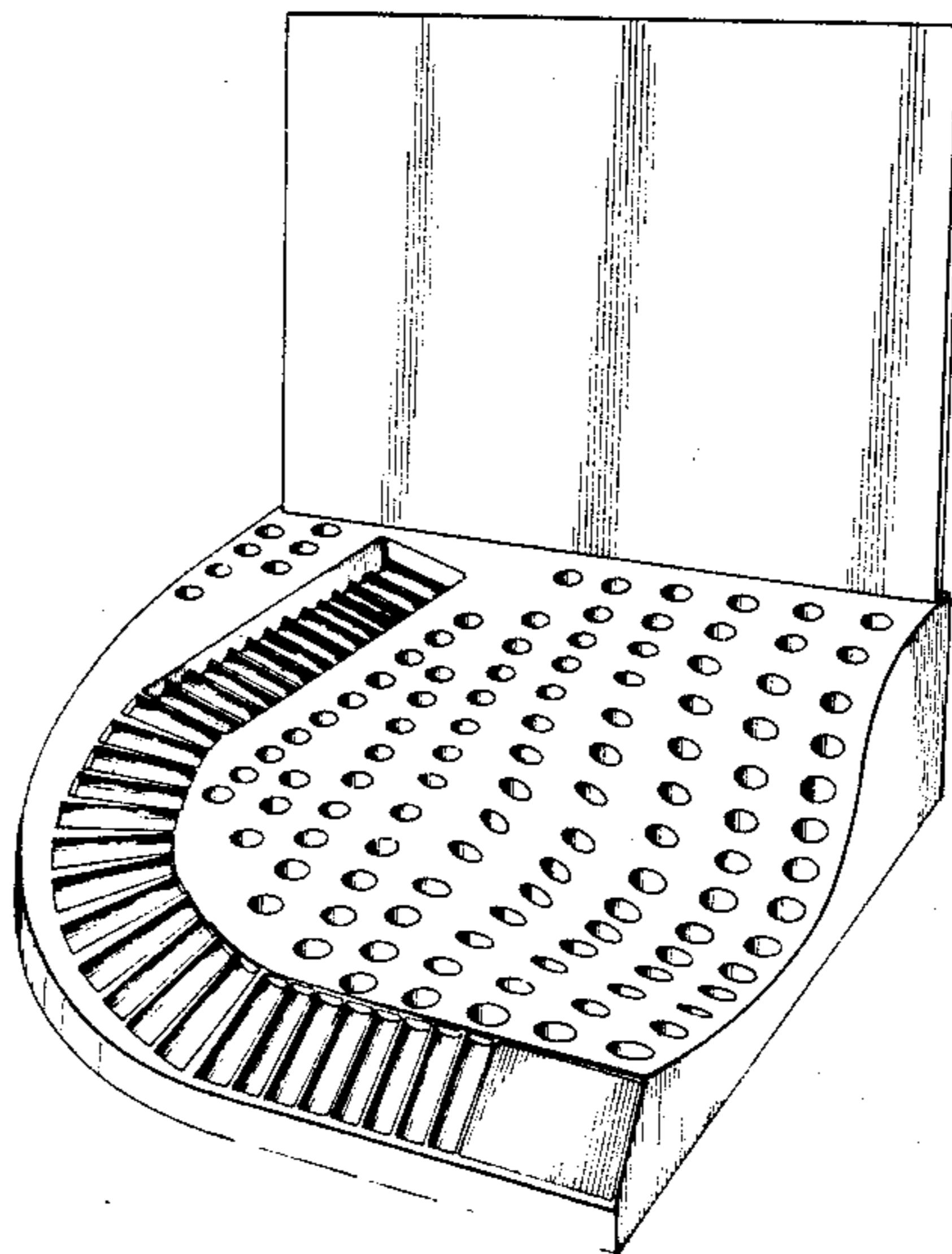

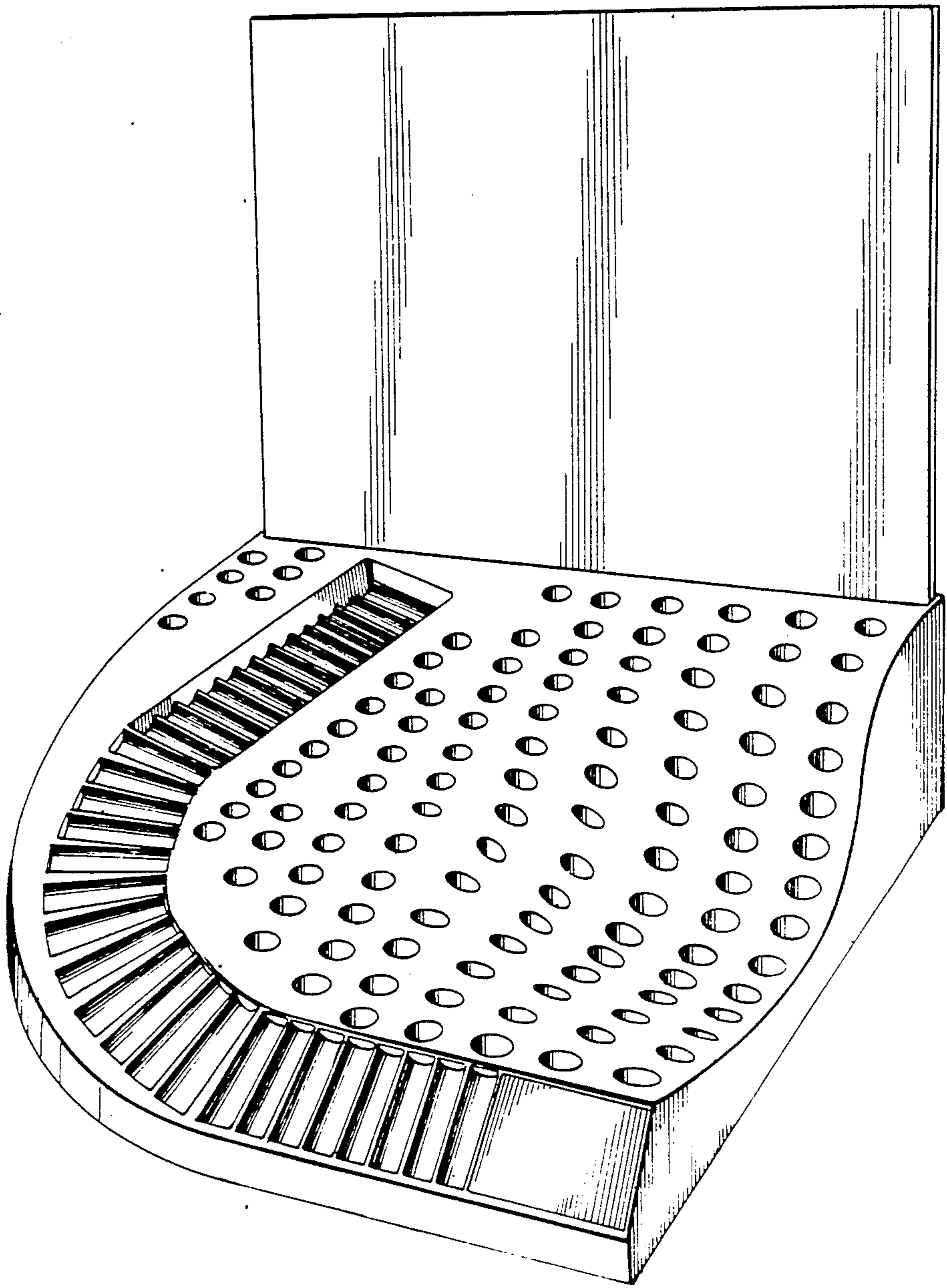

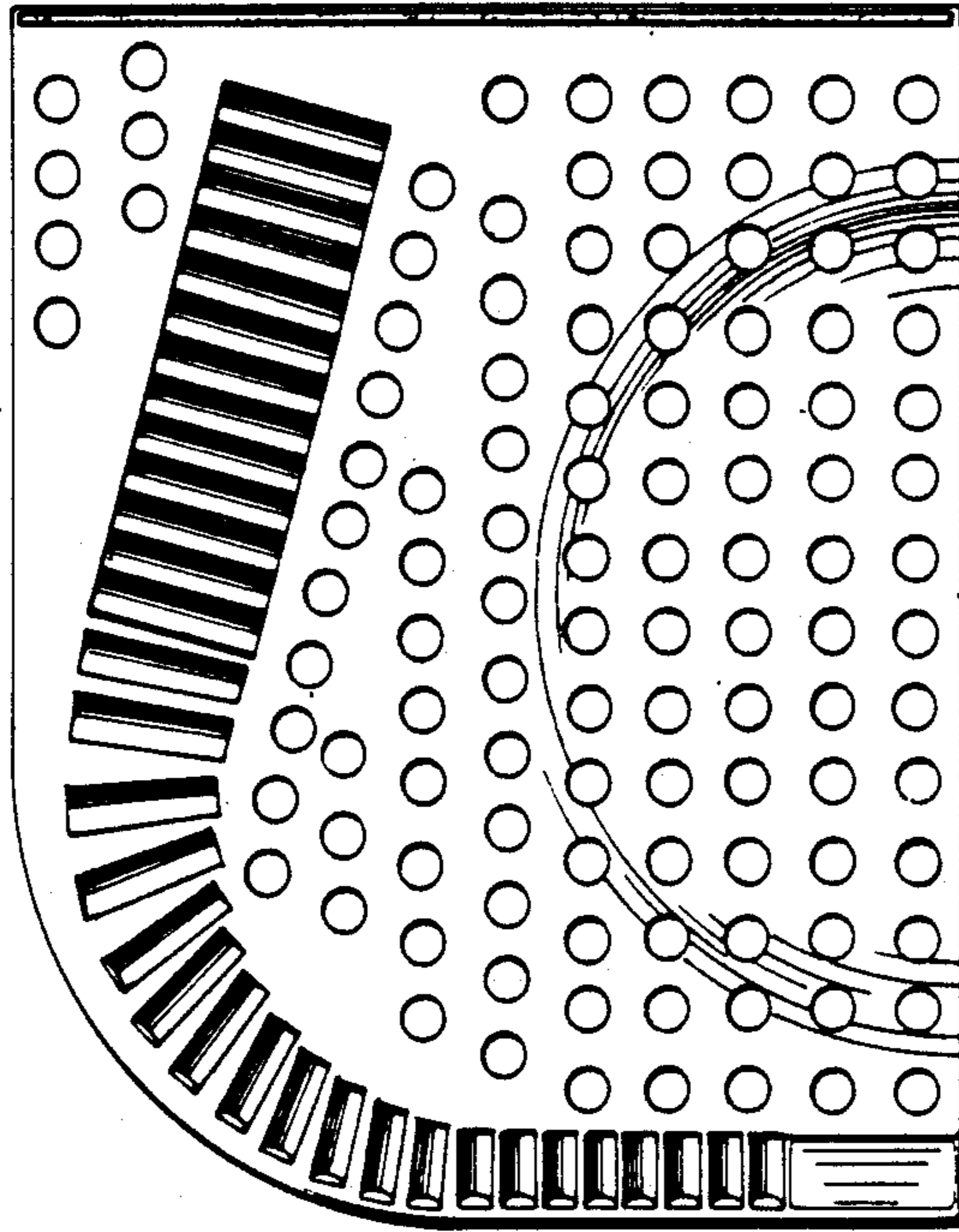

FIG. 7 is an exploded perspective view, the display products shown in broken lines for illustrative purposes only.

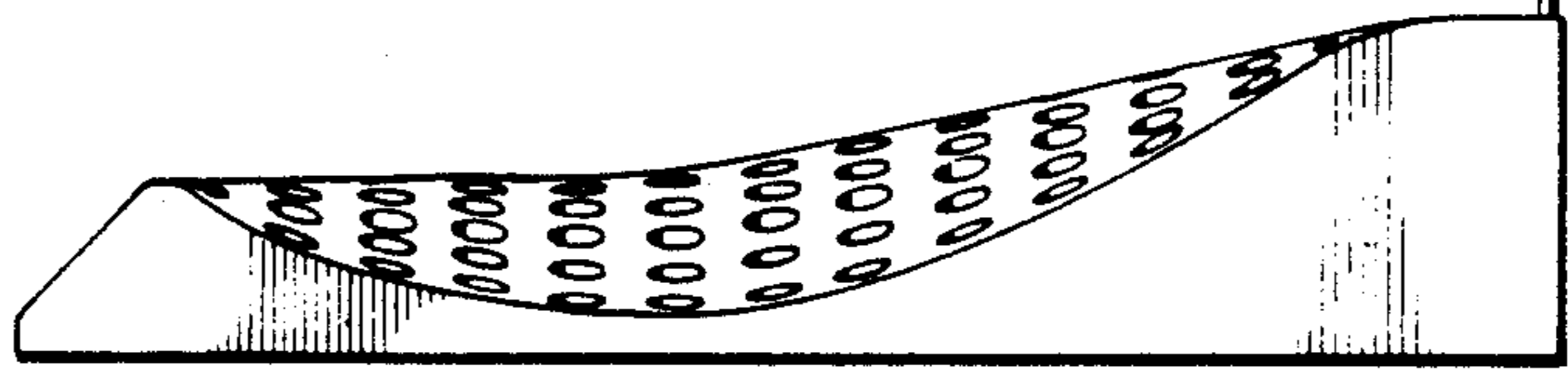




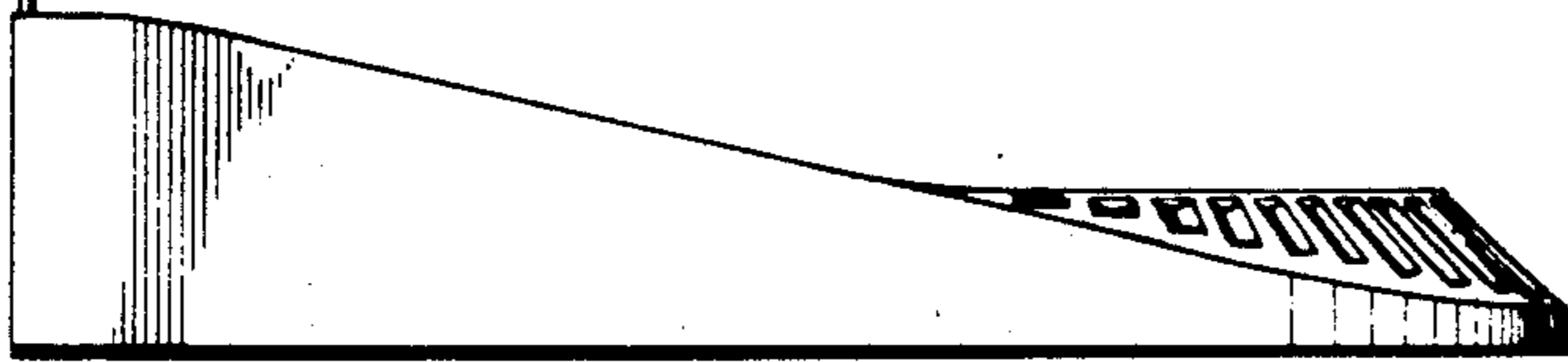

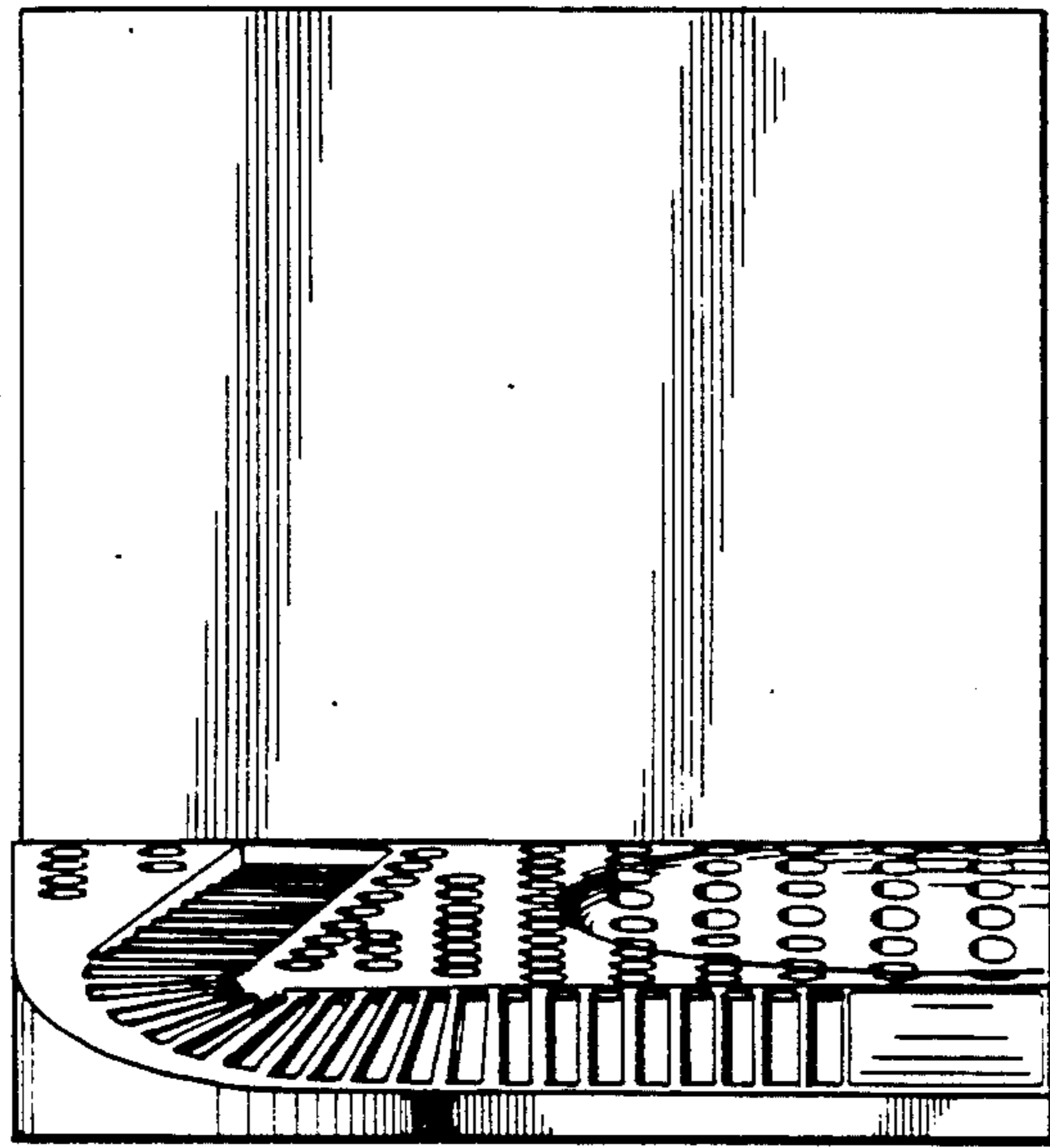

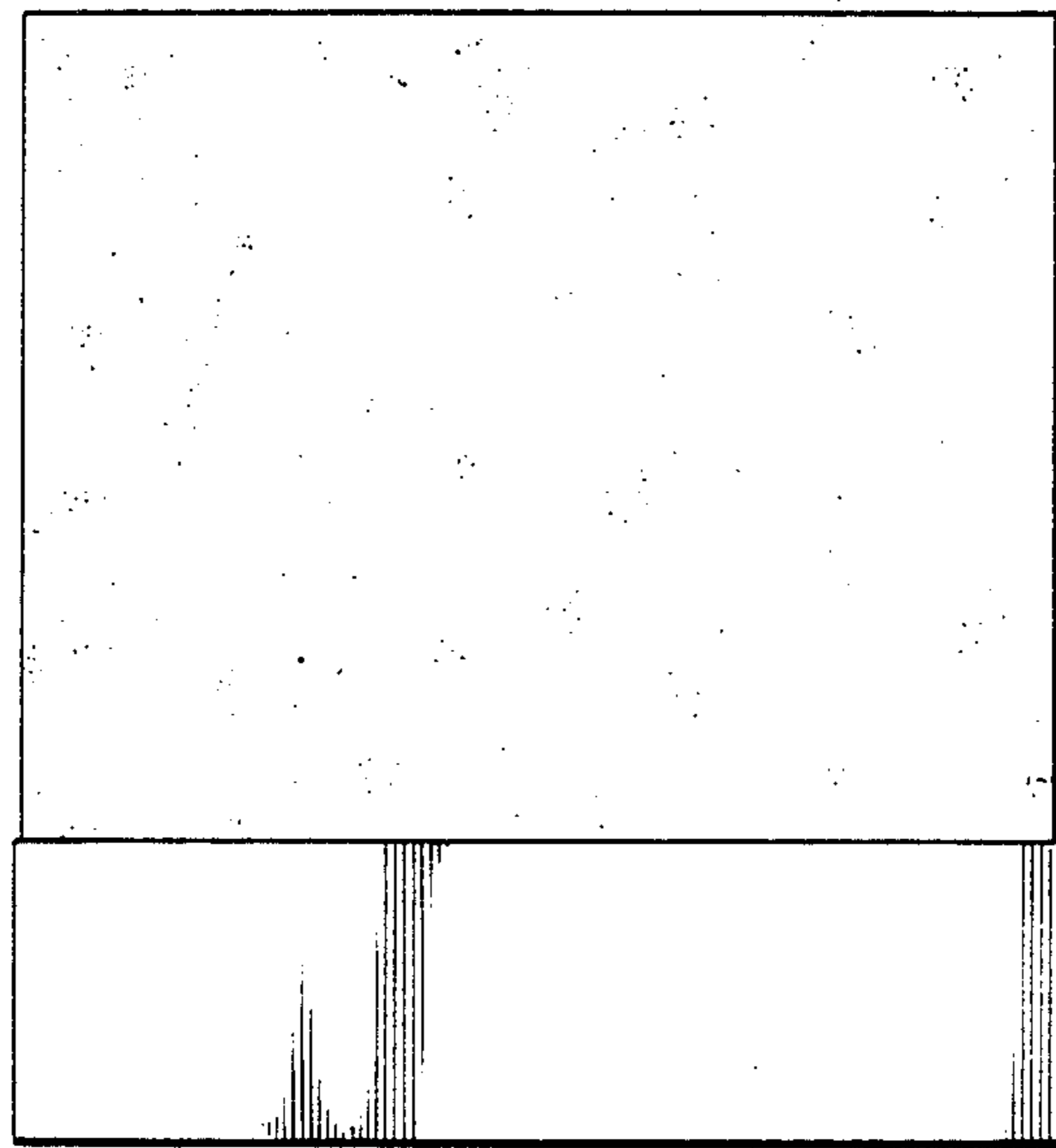

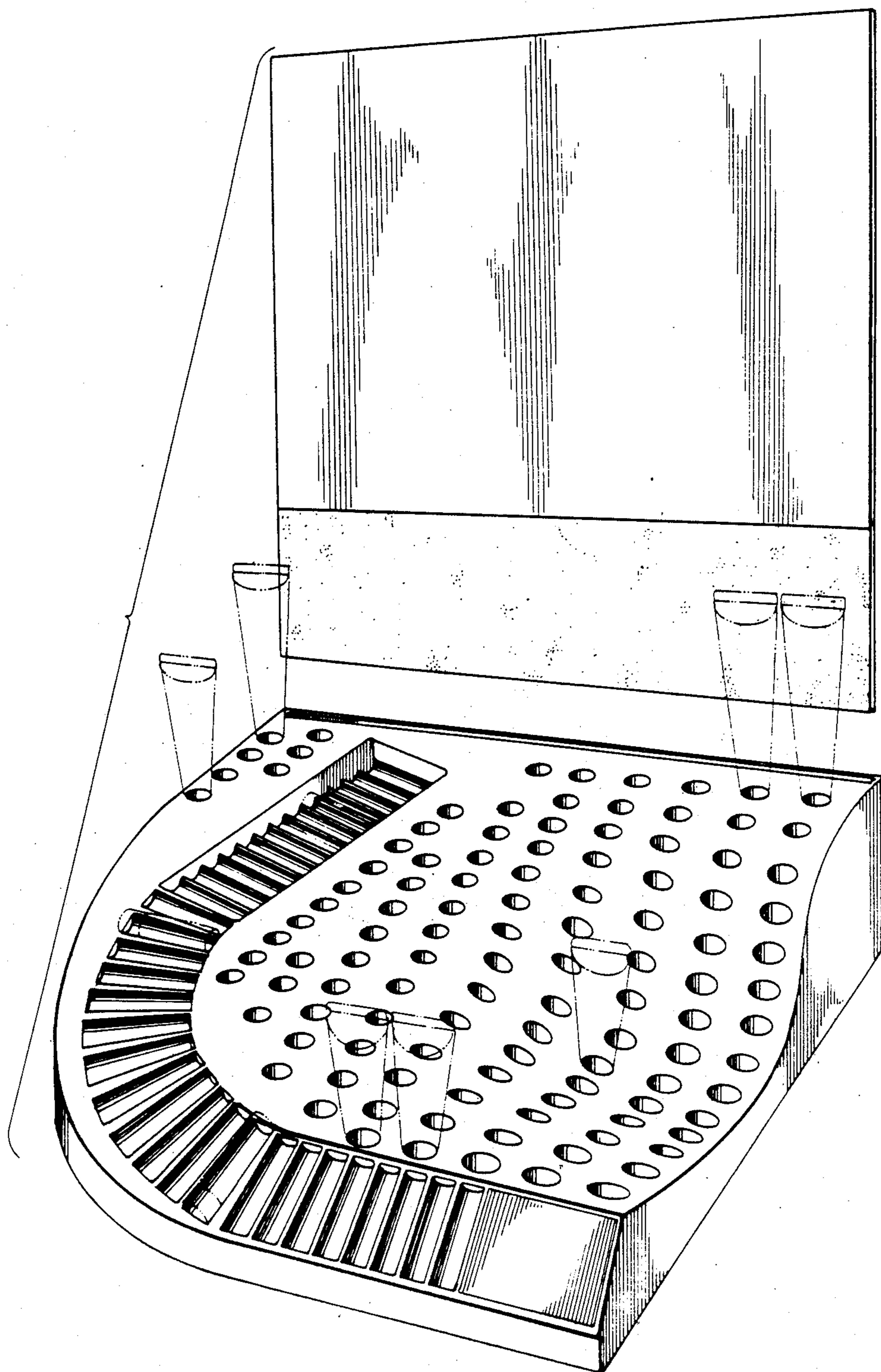
