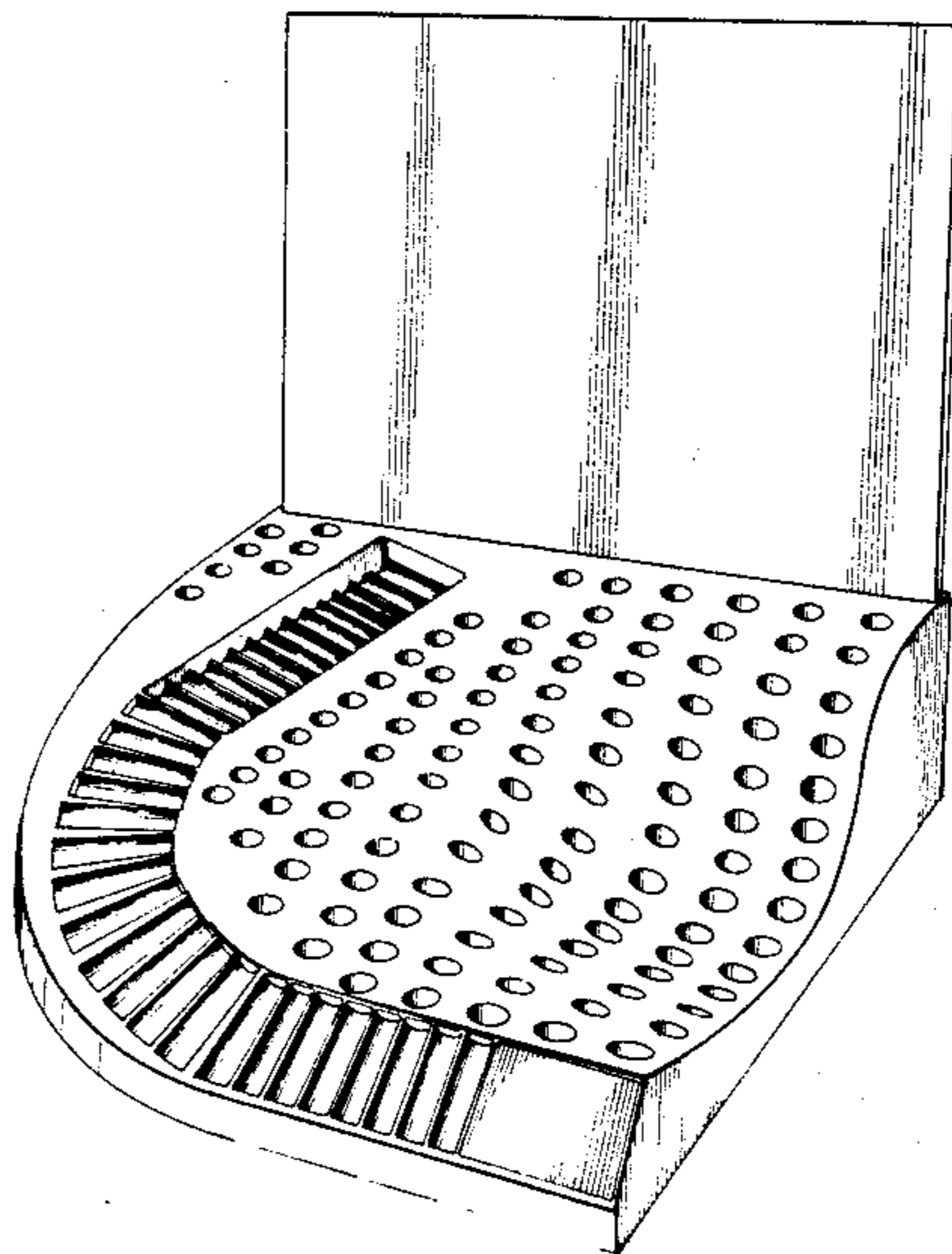
The ornamental design for a merchandising display, as shown and described.

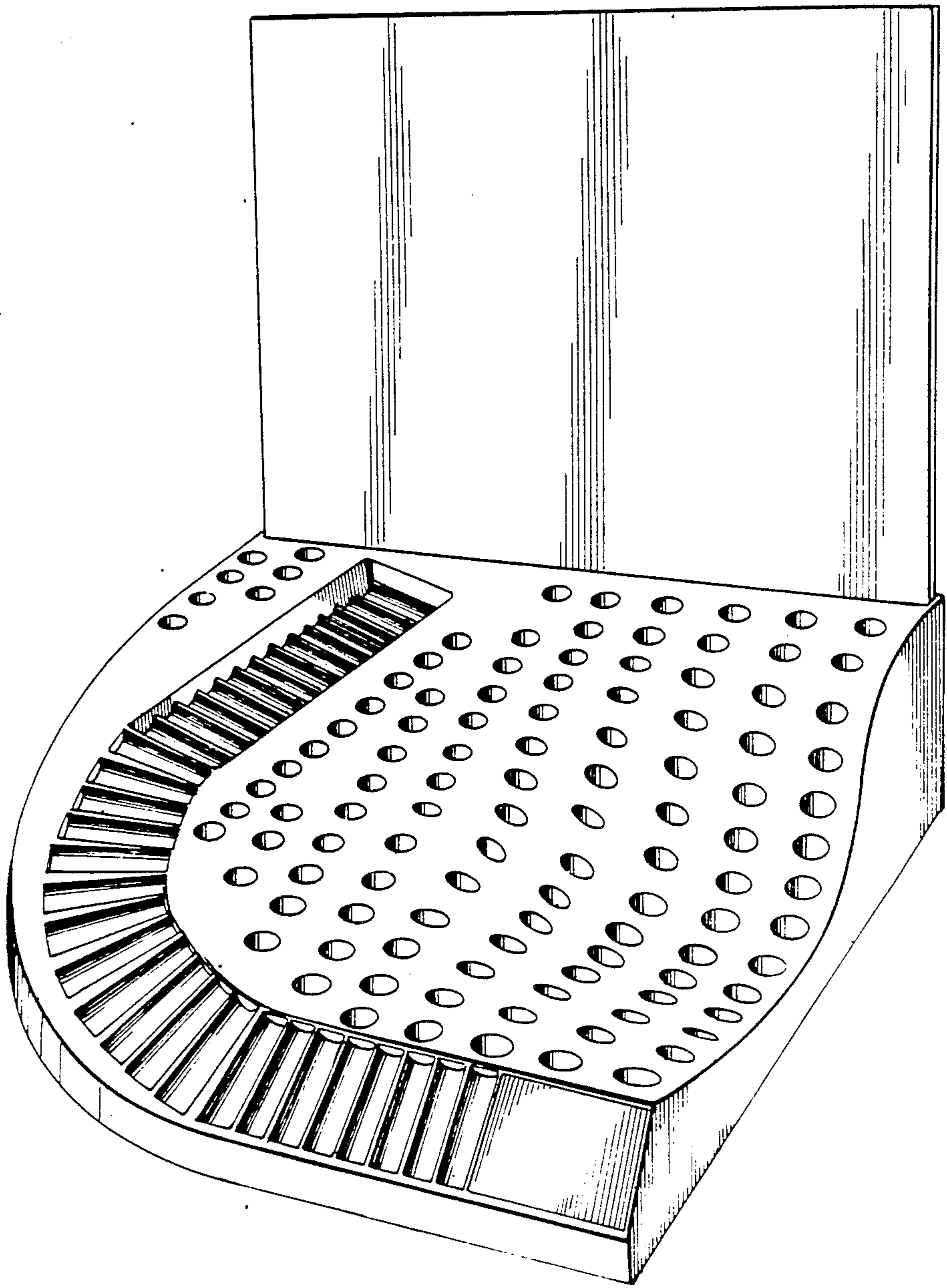

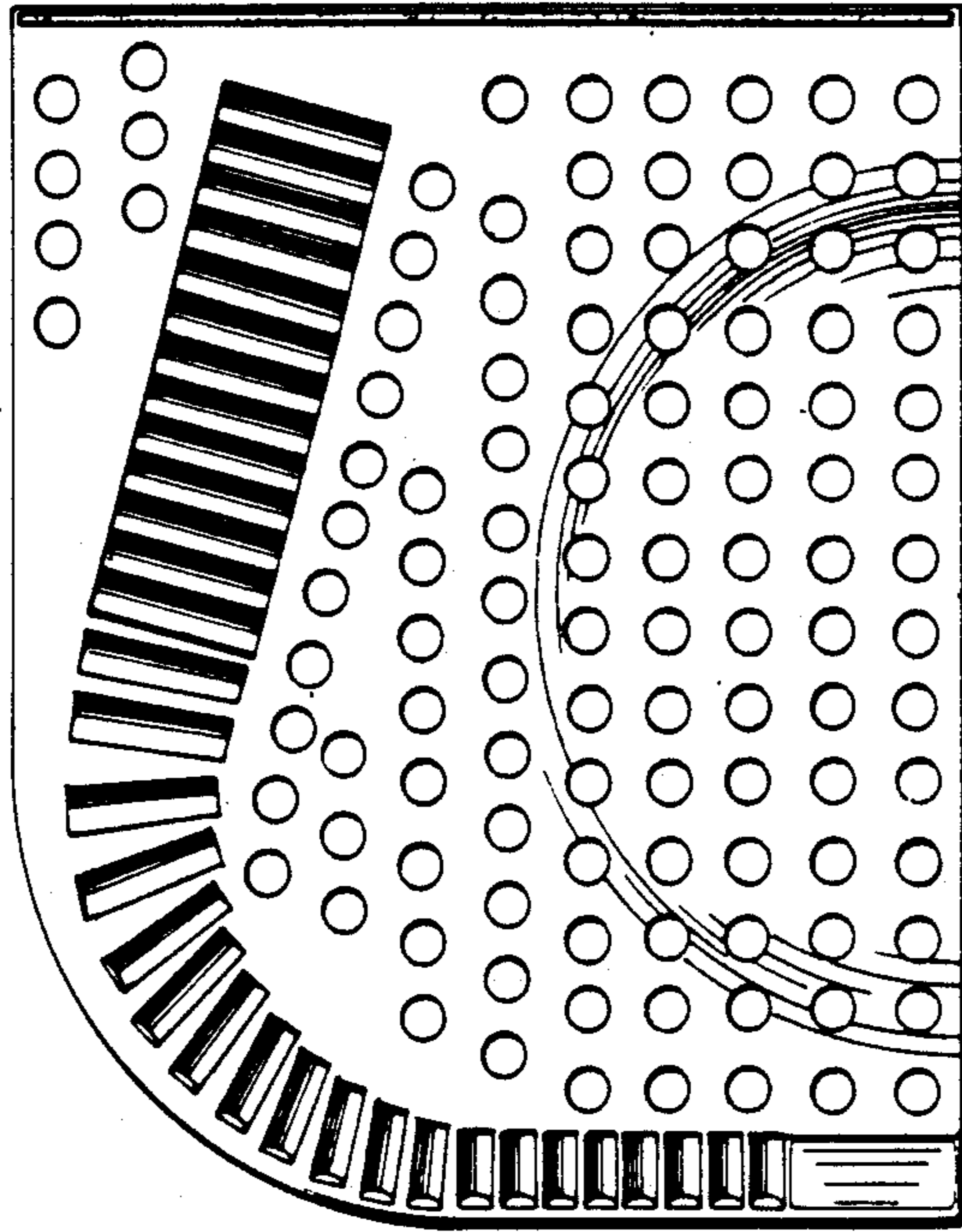

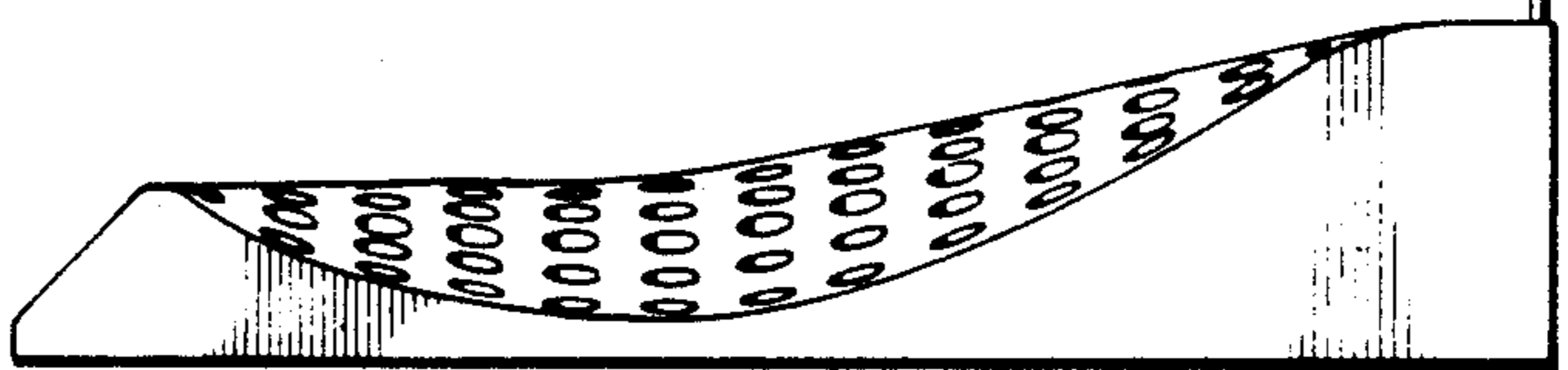

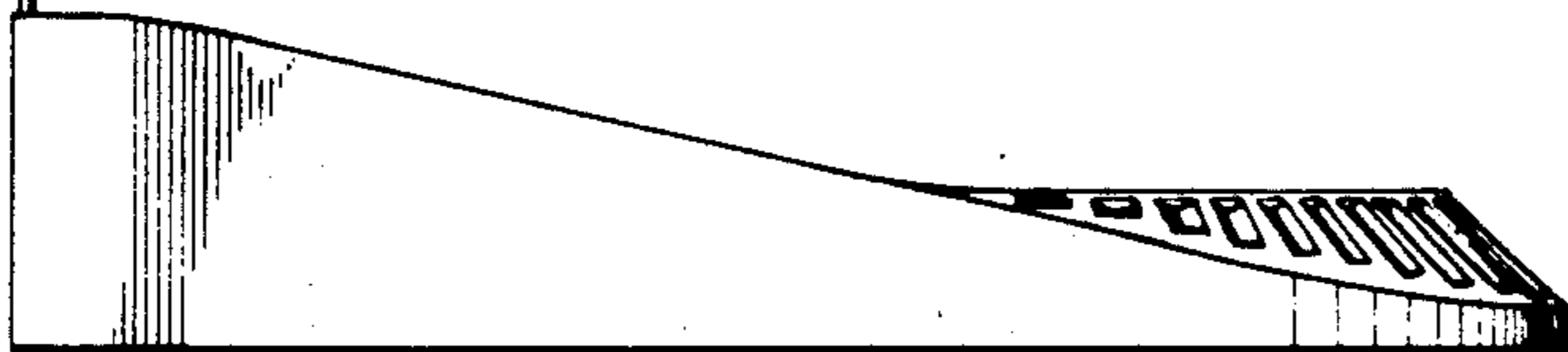

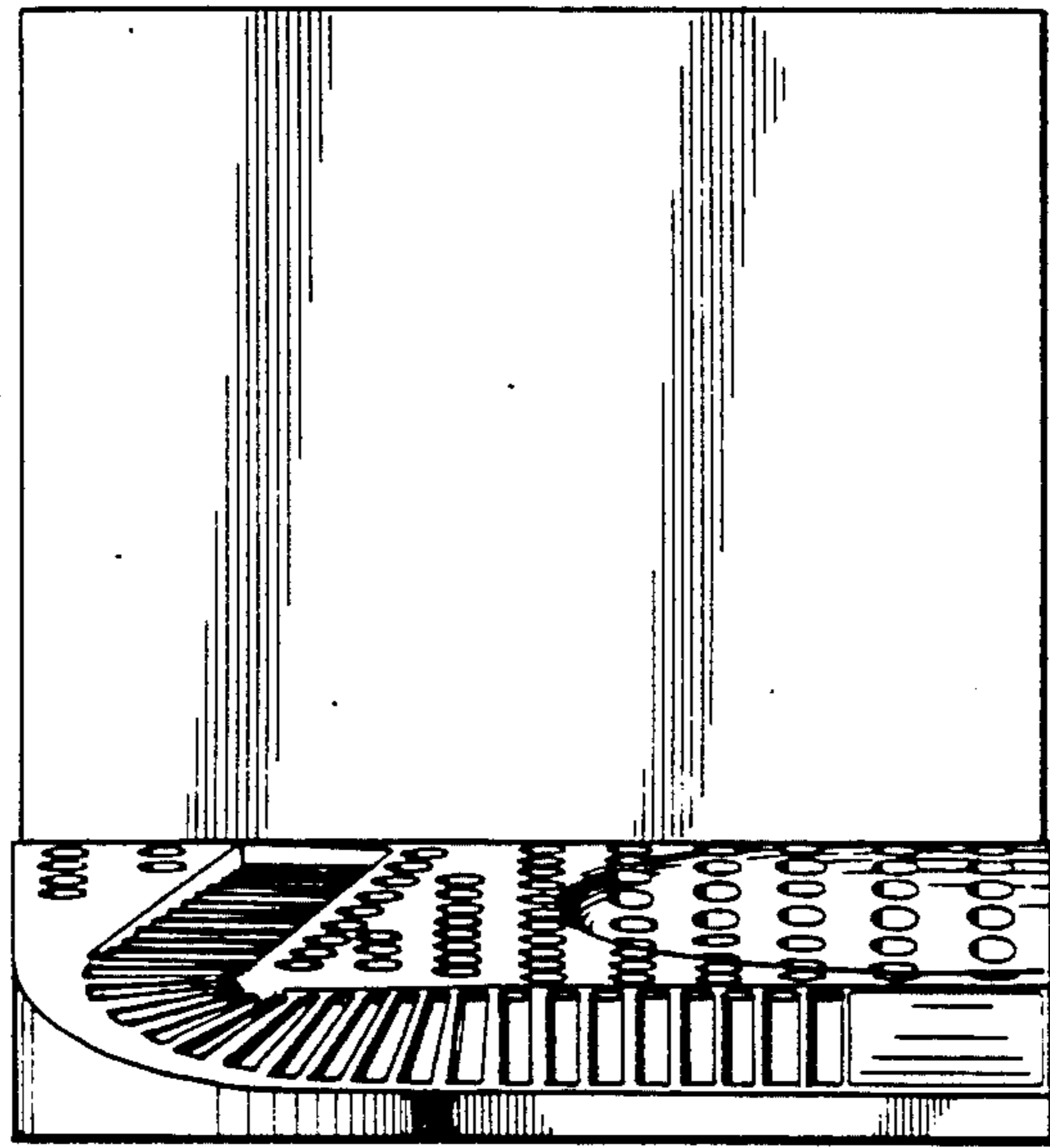

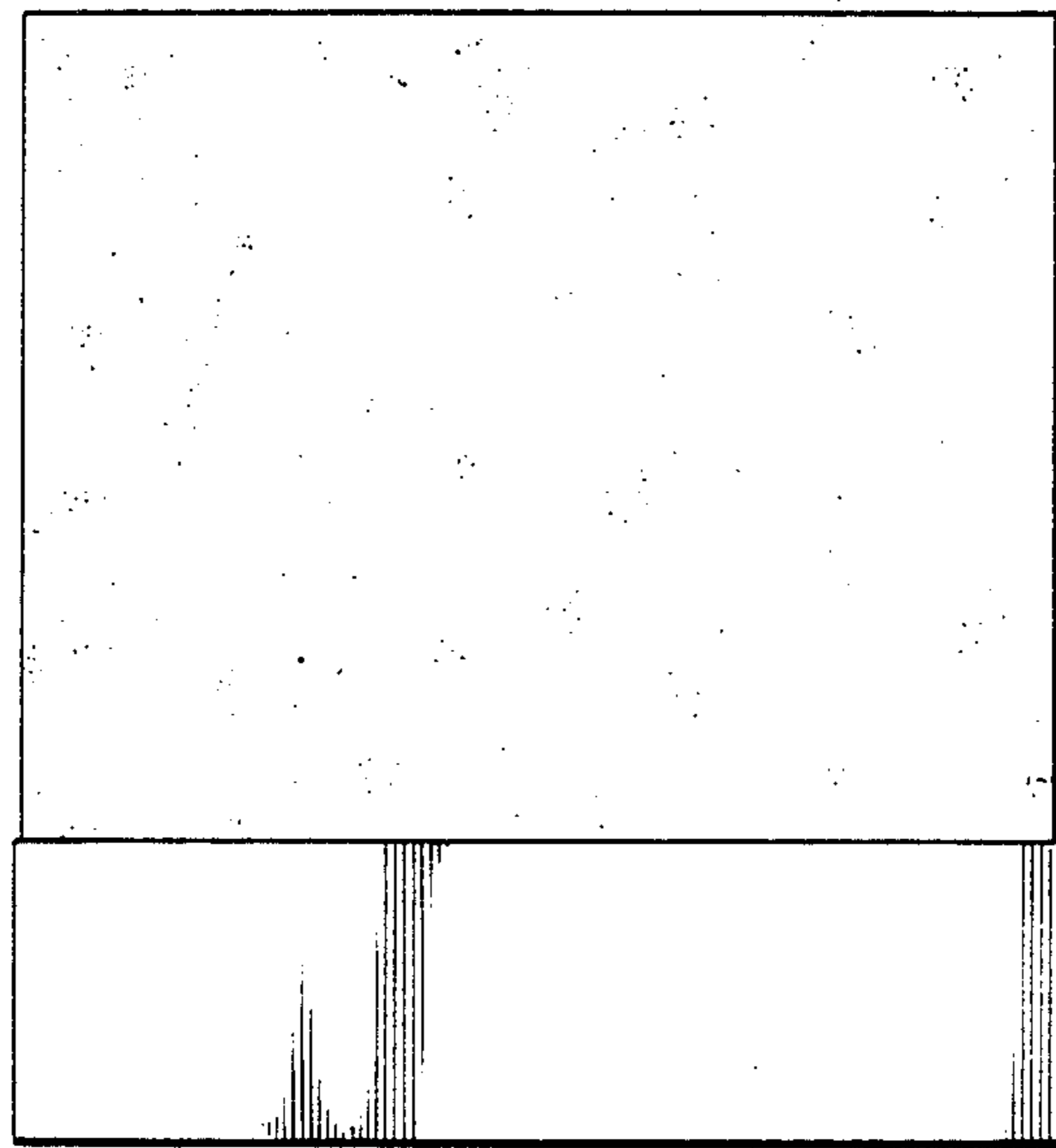

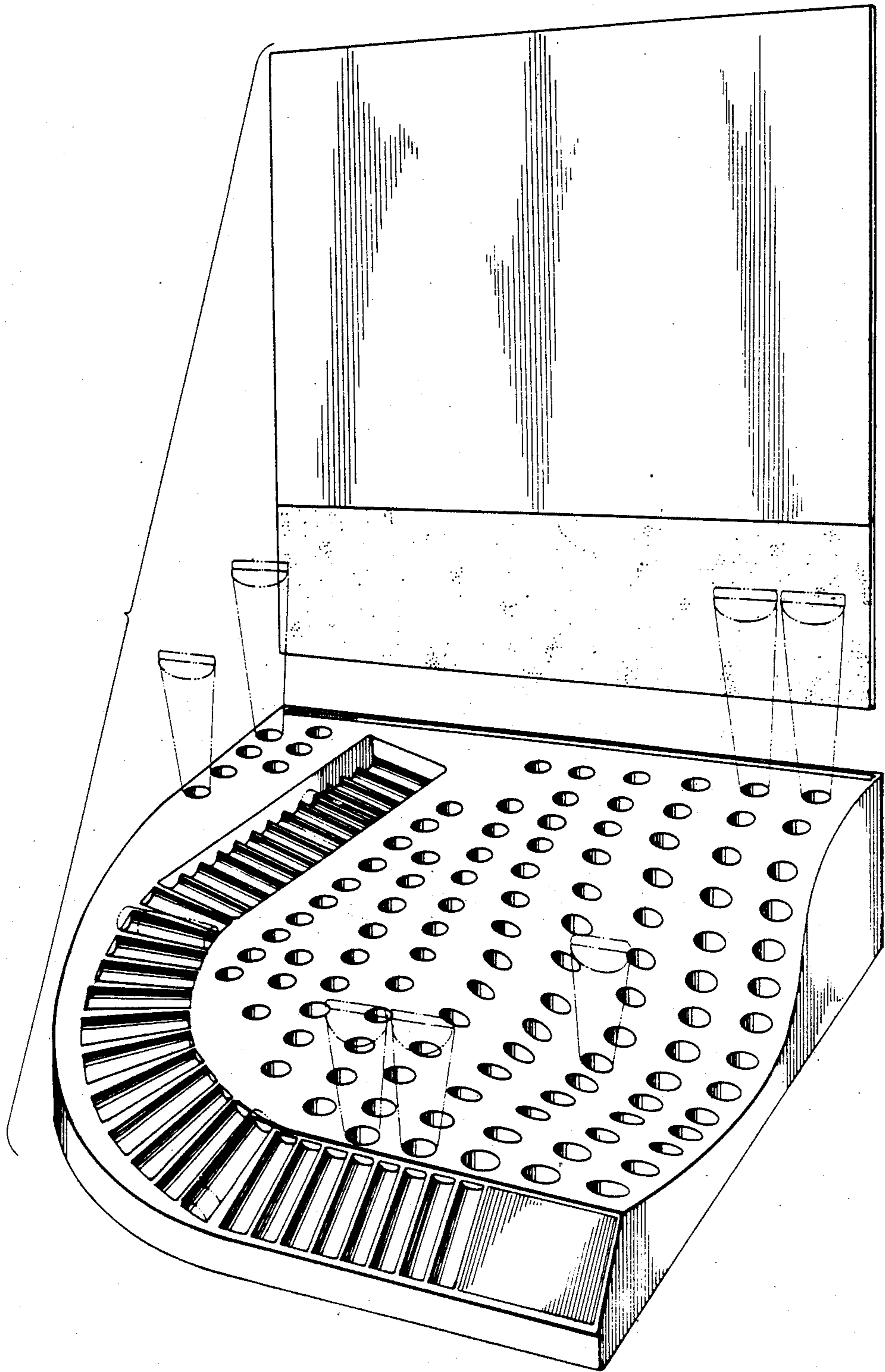
