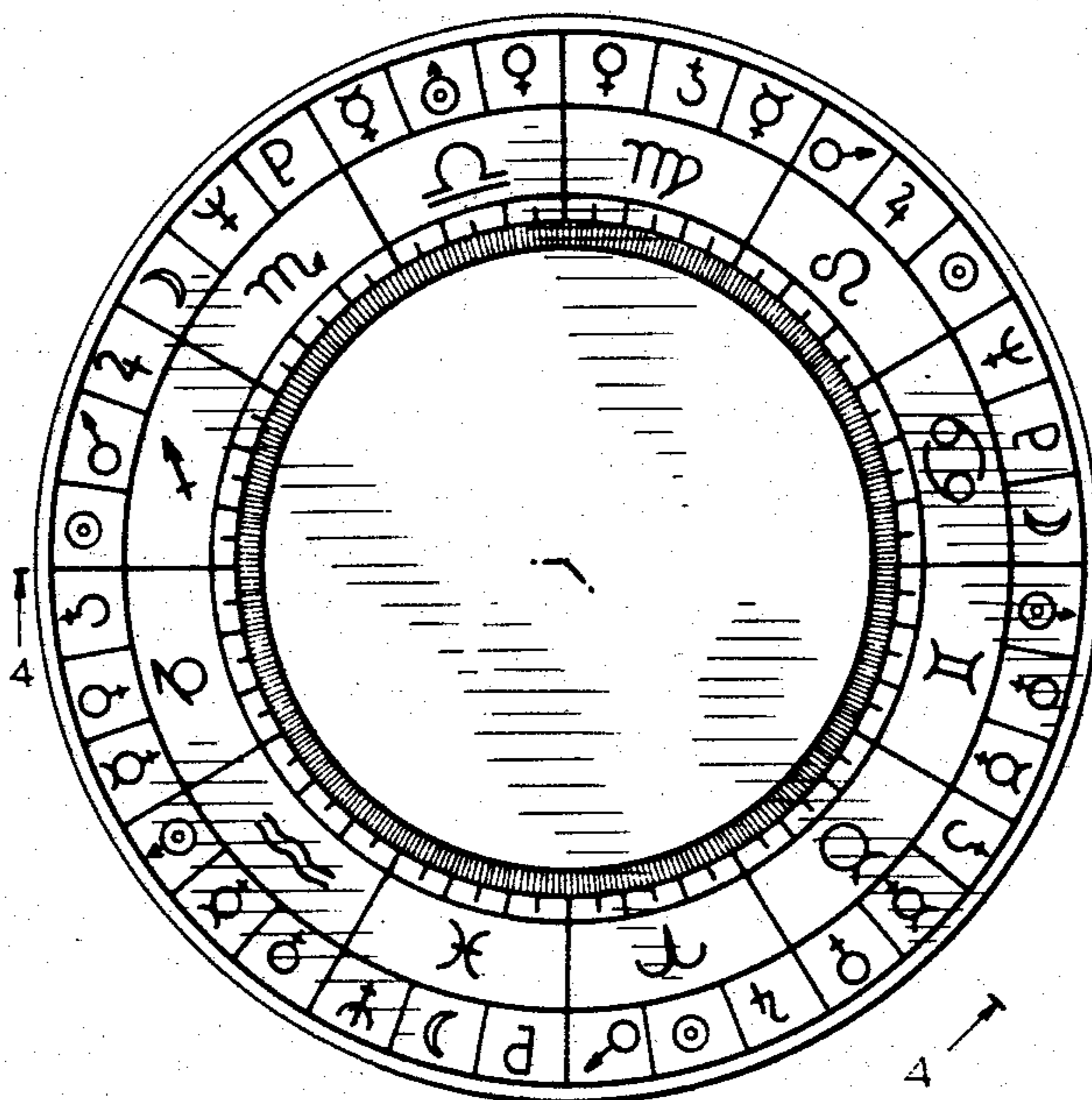

[57] **CLAIM**

The ornamental design for a jewel, substantially as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a front elevational view of a jewel embodying my new design;
 FIG. 2 is a side elevational view of the FIG. 1 jewel;
 FIG. 3 is a rear view, on a reduced scale, of the FIG. 1 jewel;
 FIG. 4 is a fragmentary, sectional view, on an enlarged scale, of the FIG. 1 jewel taken along line 4—4 of FIG. 1; and
 FIG. 5 is a fragmentary perspective view, on an enlarged scale, of the FIG. 1 jewel.



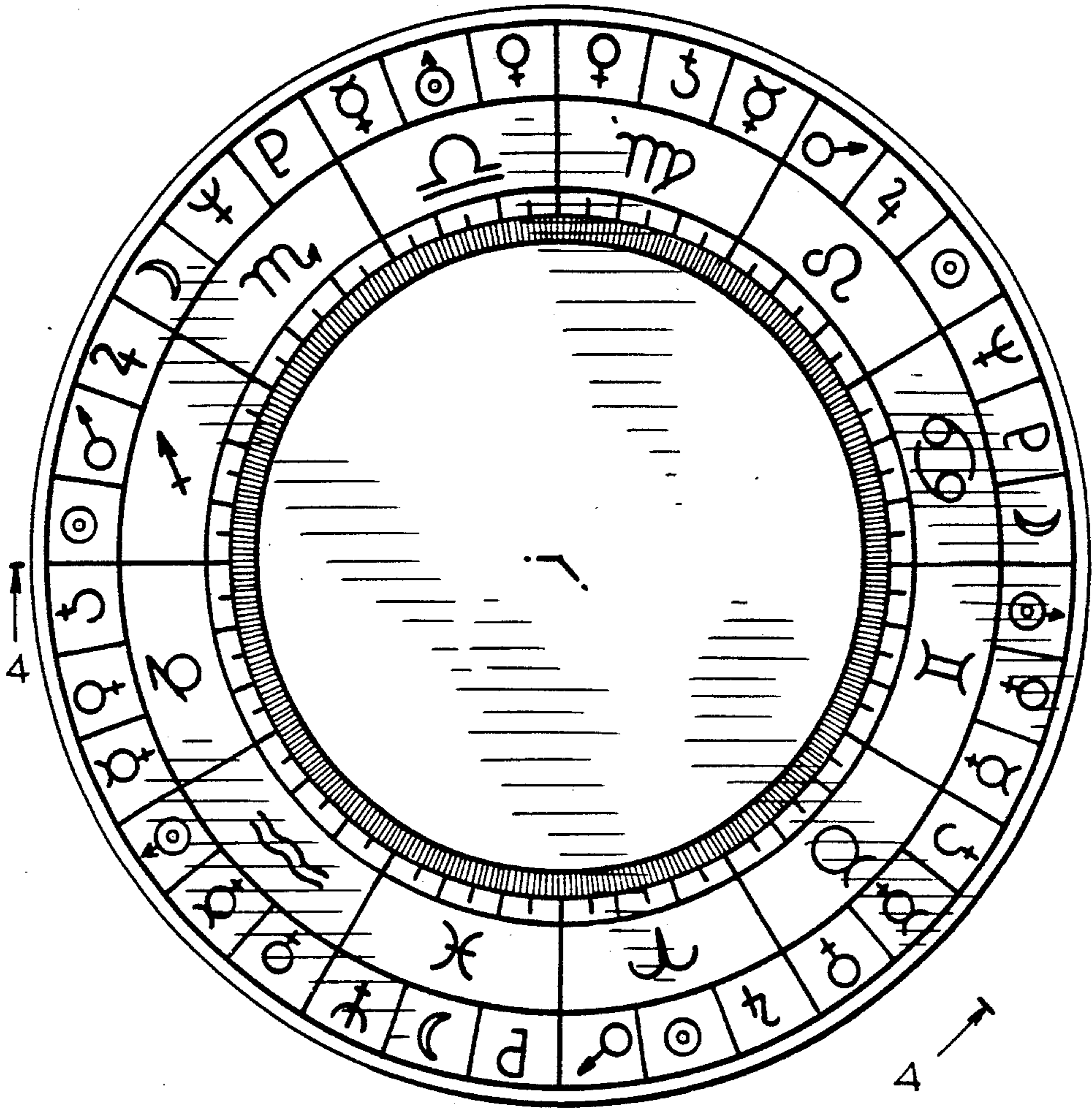

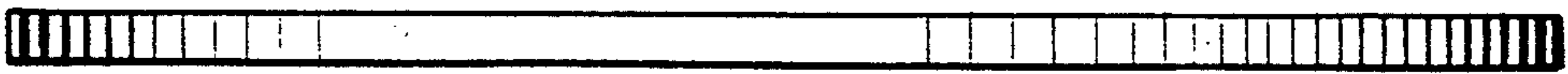

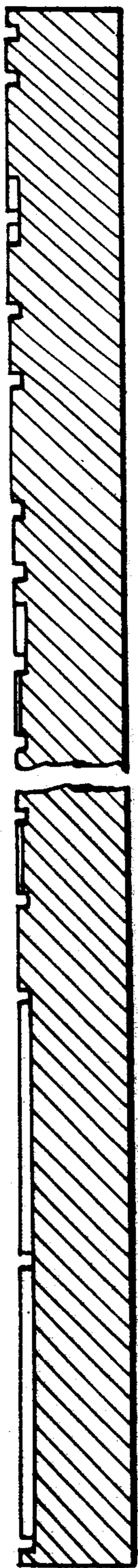

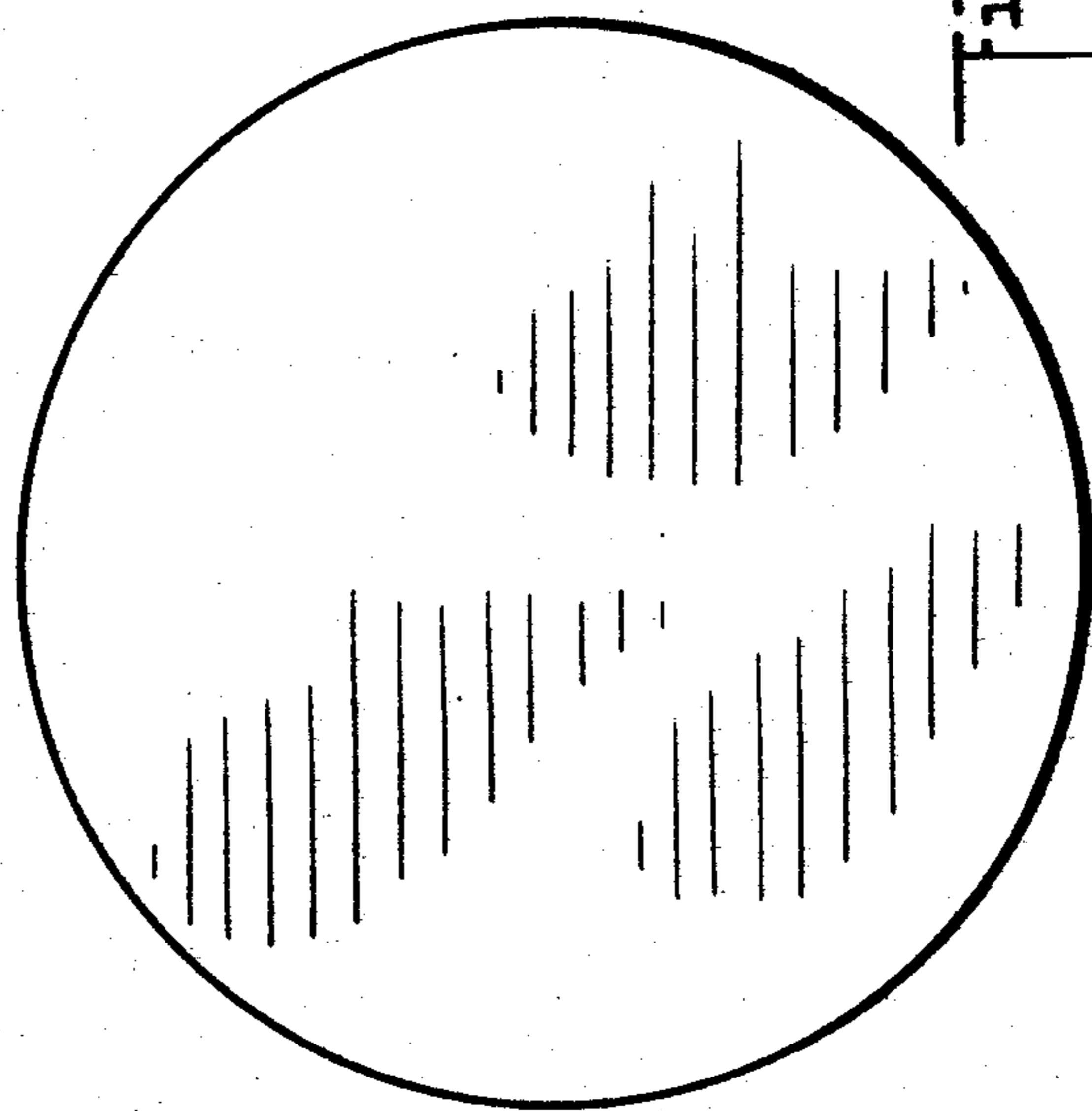

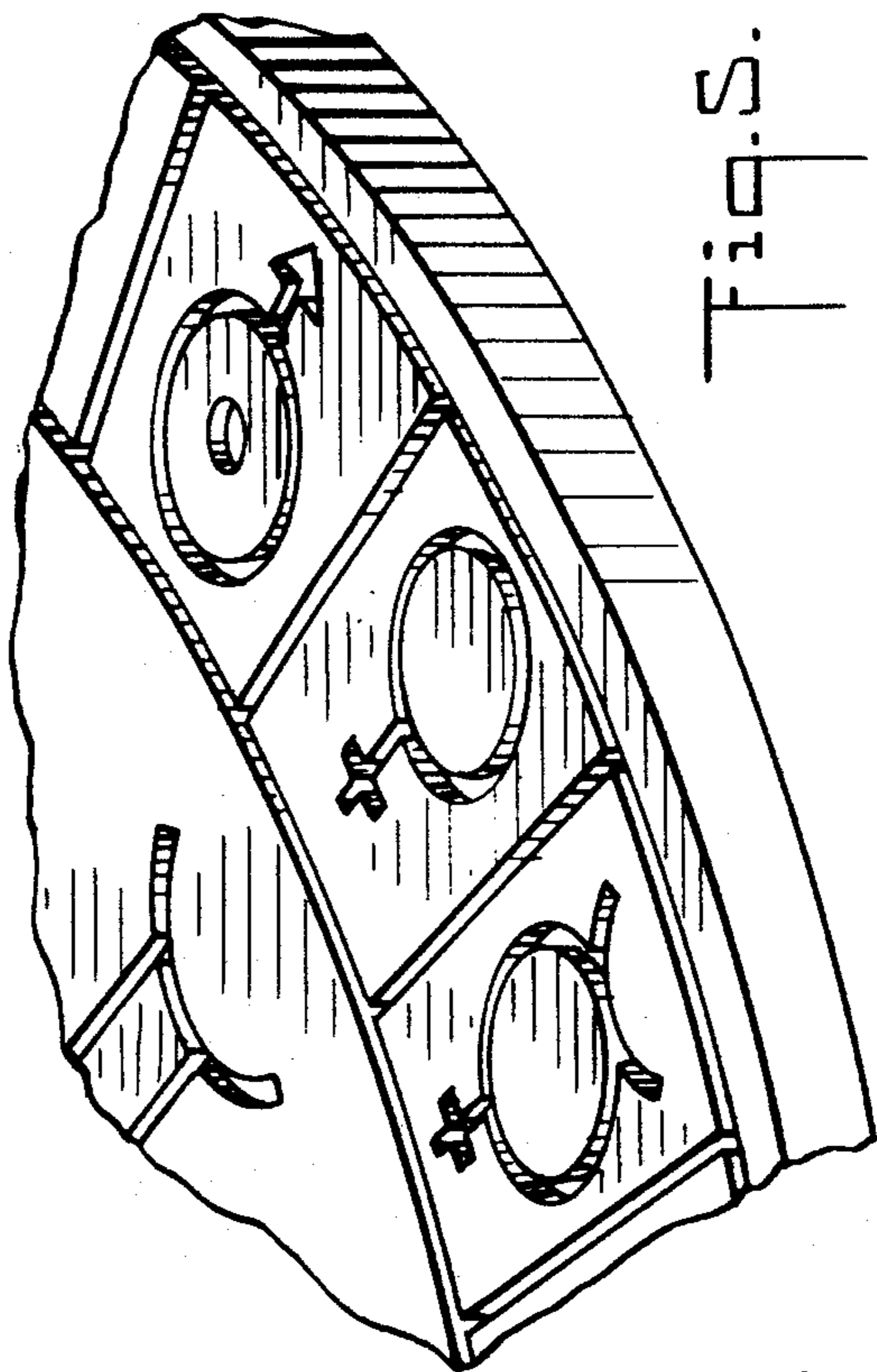
