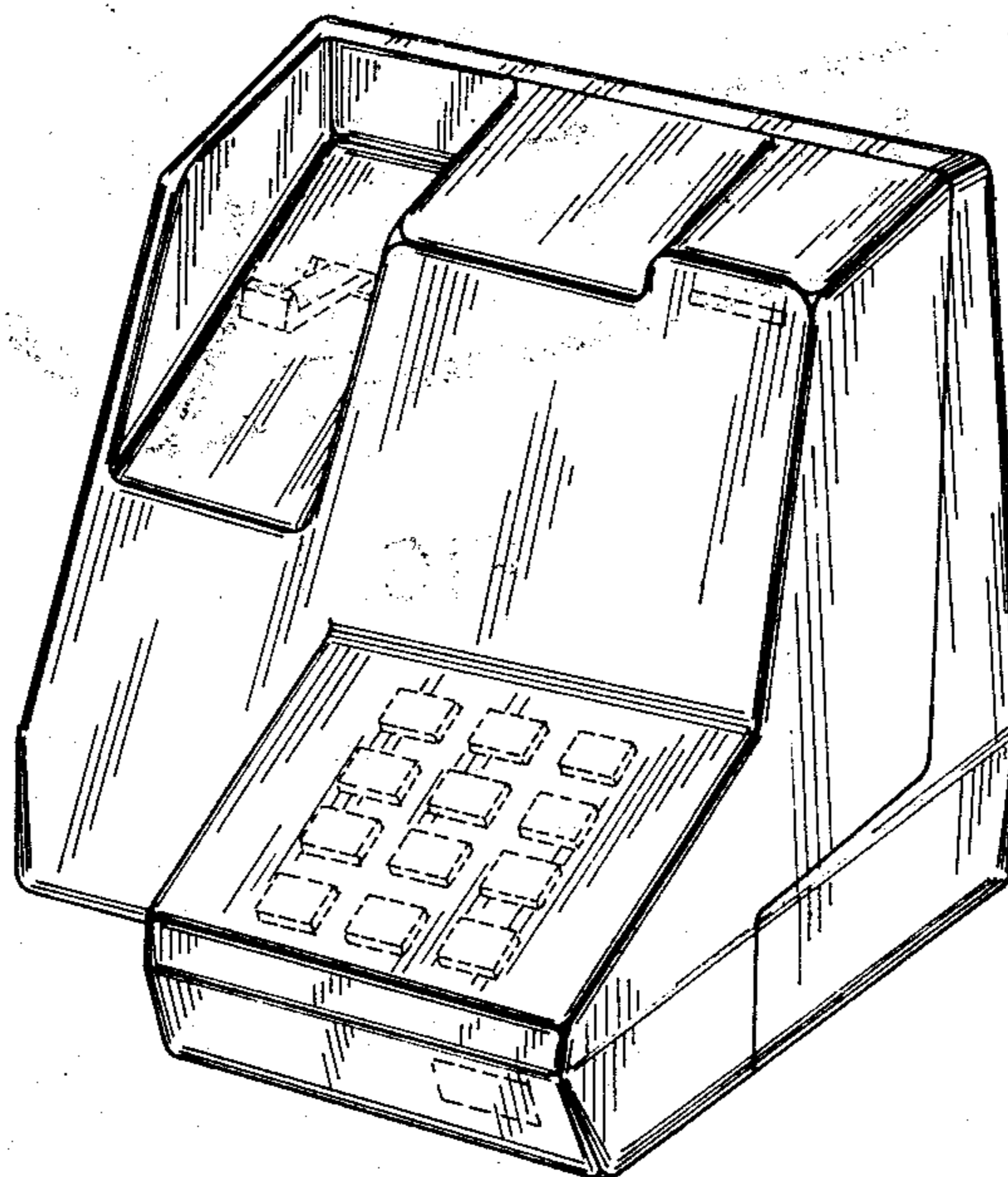

The ornamental design for a housing for a desk telephone paystation base, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a front, top and right side perspective view of a housing for a desk telephone paystation base showing my new design;
FIG. 2 is a top plan view thereof;
FIG. 3 is a front elevational view thereof;
FIG. 4 is a left side elevational view thereof; and
FIG. 5 is a right side elevational view thereof.
The broken line showing of a switch hook, coin apertures and dial pushbutton is for illustrative purposes only and forms no part of the claimed design.



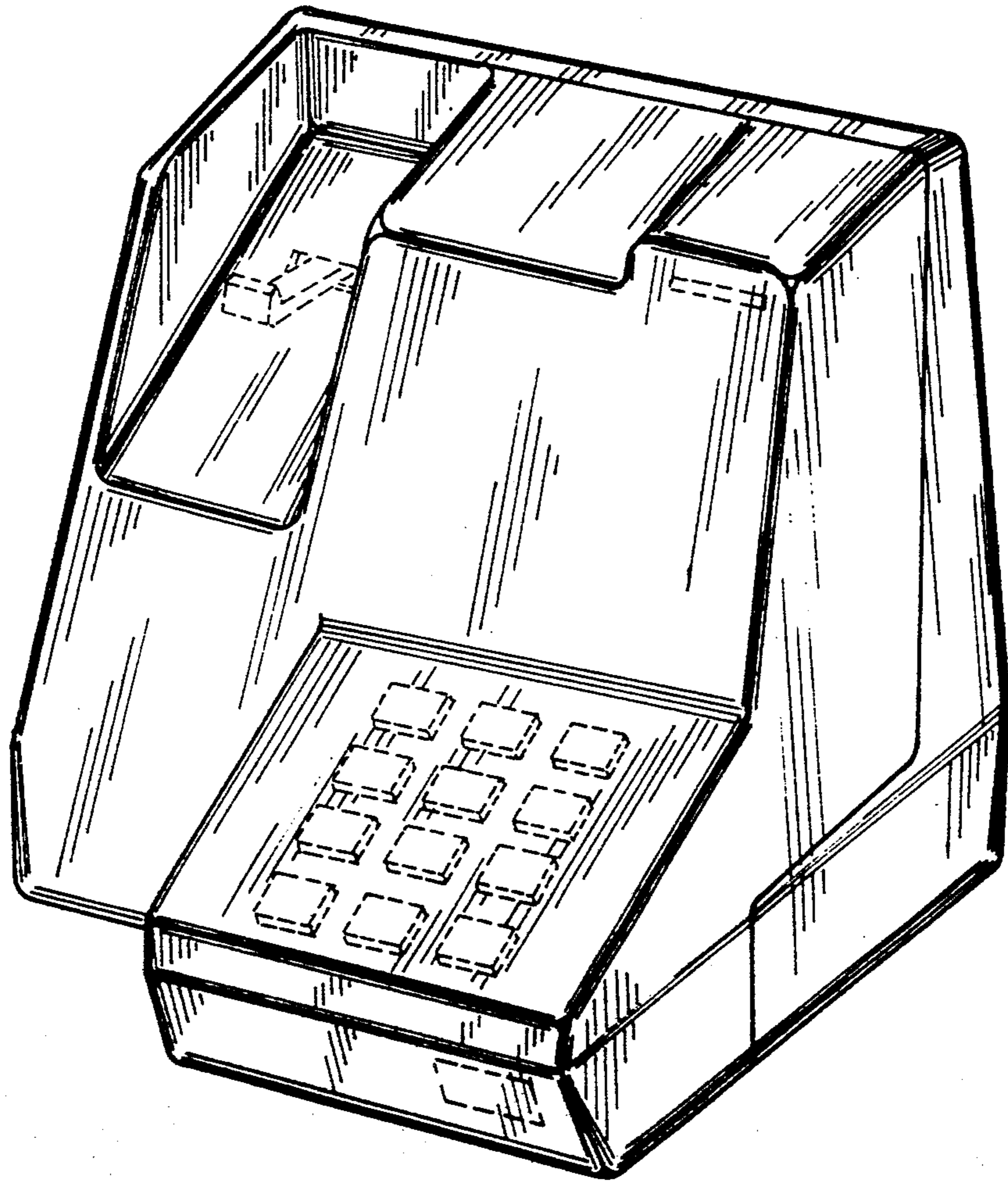

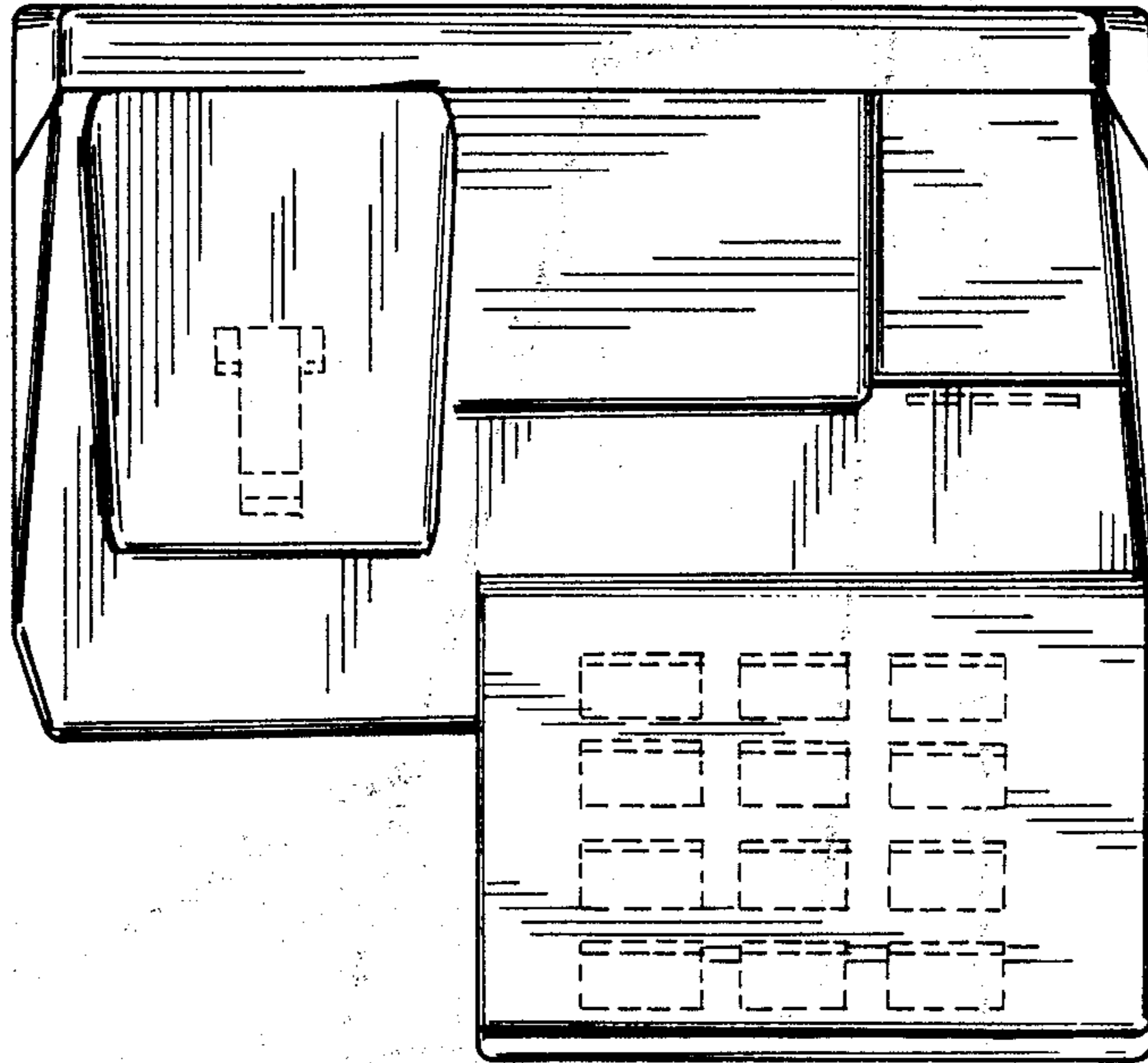

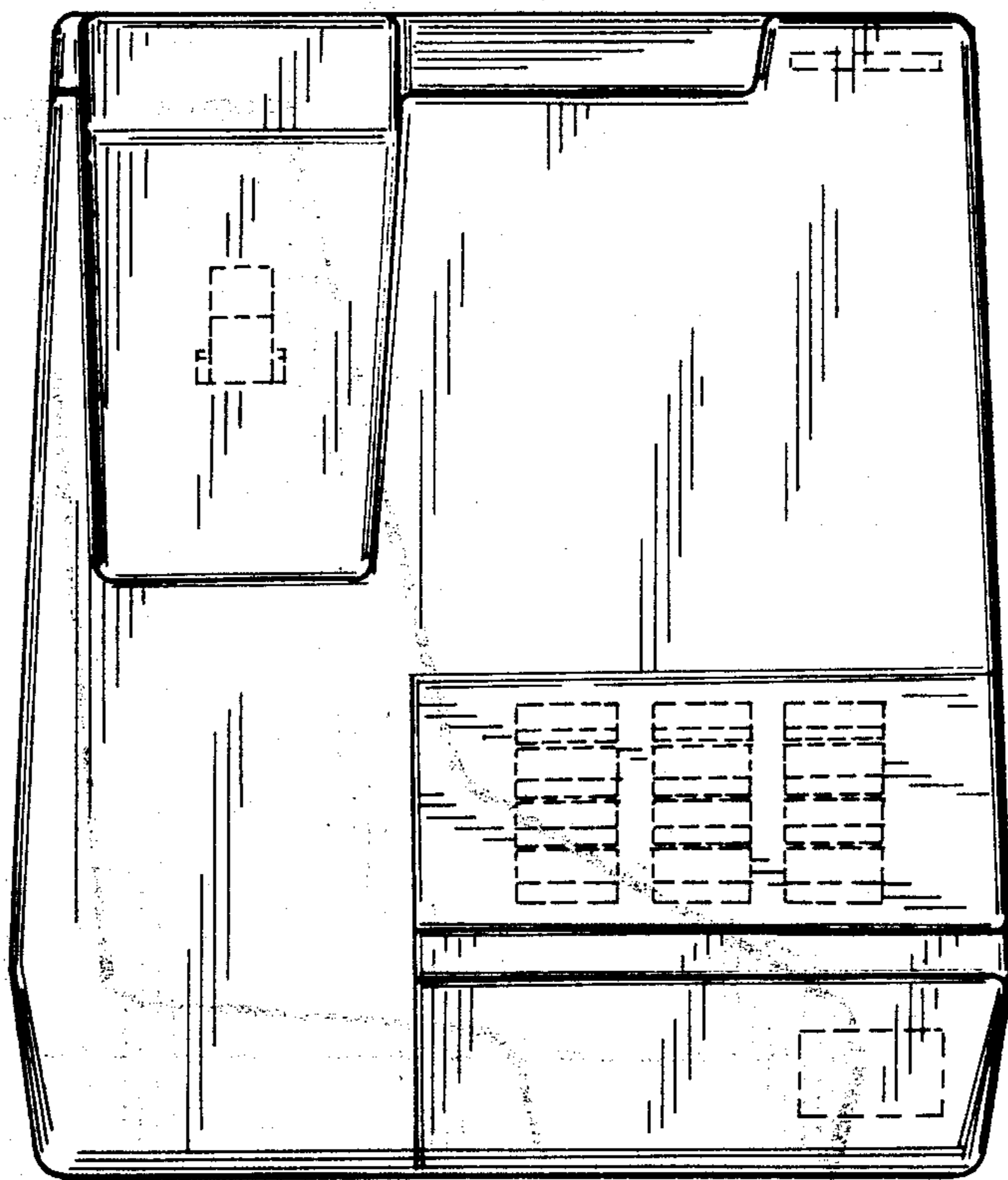

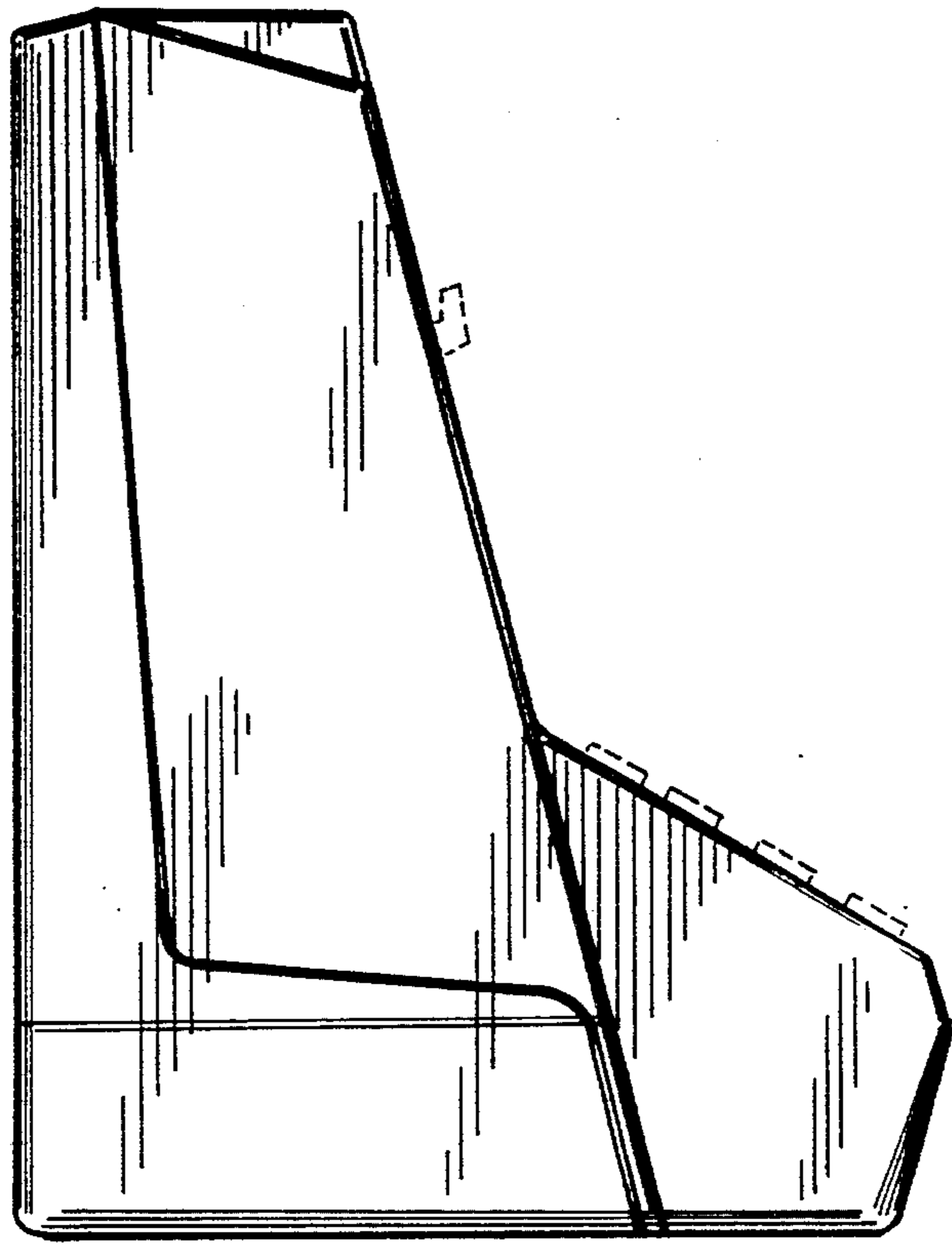

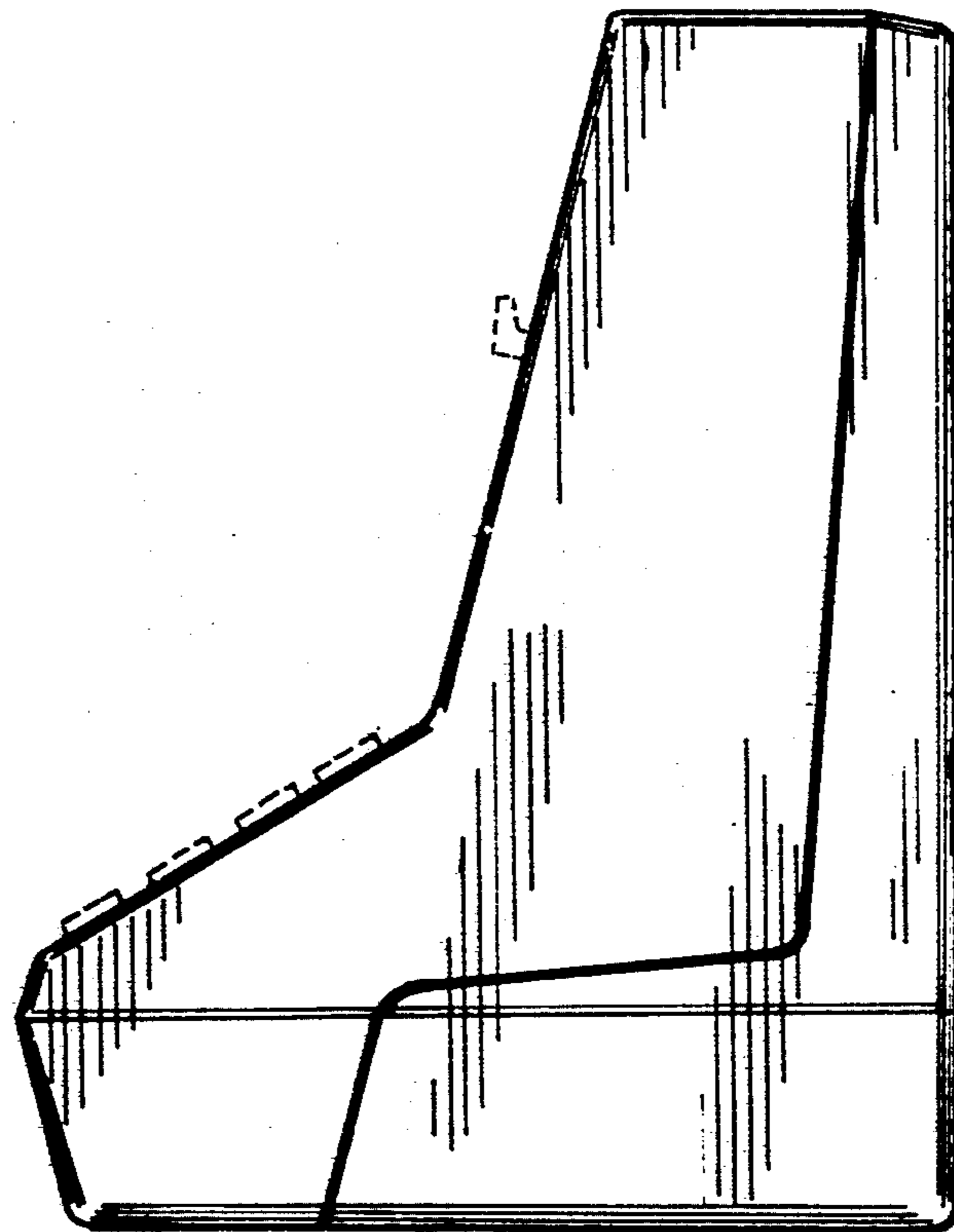
