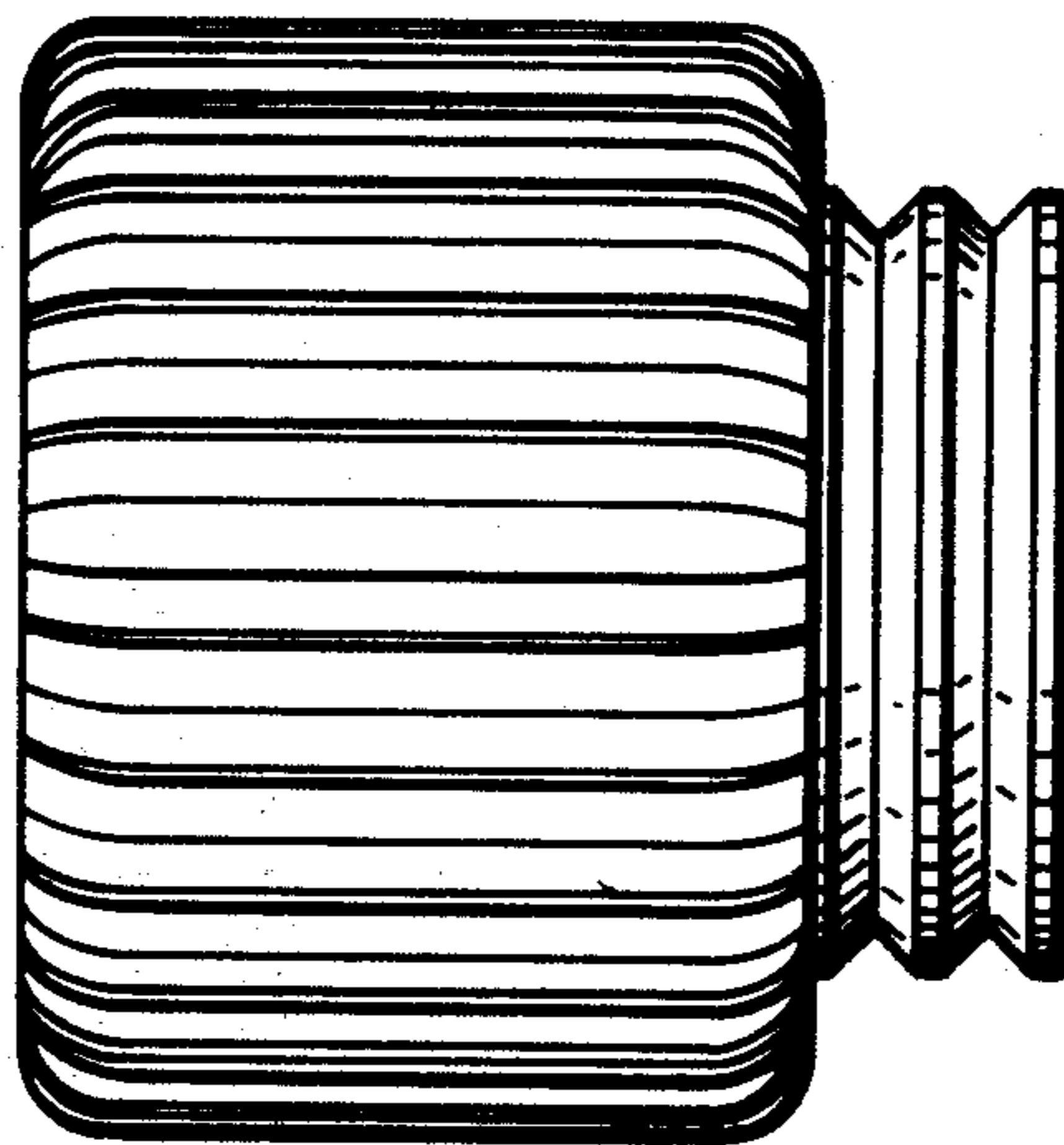

[57] CLAIM

The ornamental design for a toy tire and wheel assembly, substantially as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a front elevational view of a toy tire and wheel assembly showing my new design, the top and bottom plan views being identical; and the rear elevational view being a mirror image;
FIG. 2 is a left-side elevational view thereof; and
FIG. 3 is a right-side elevational view thereof.



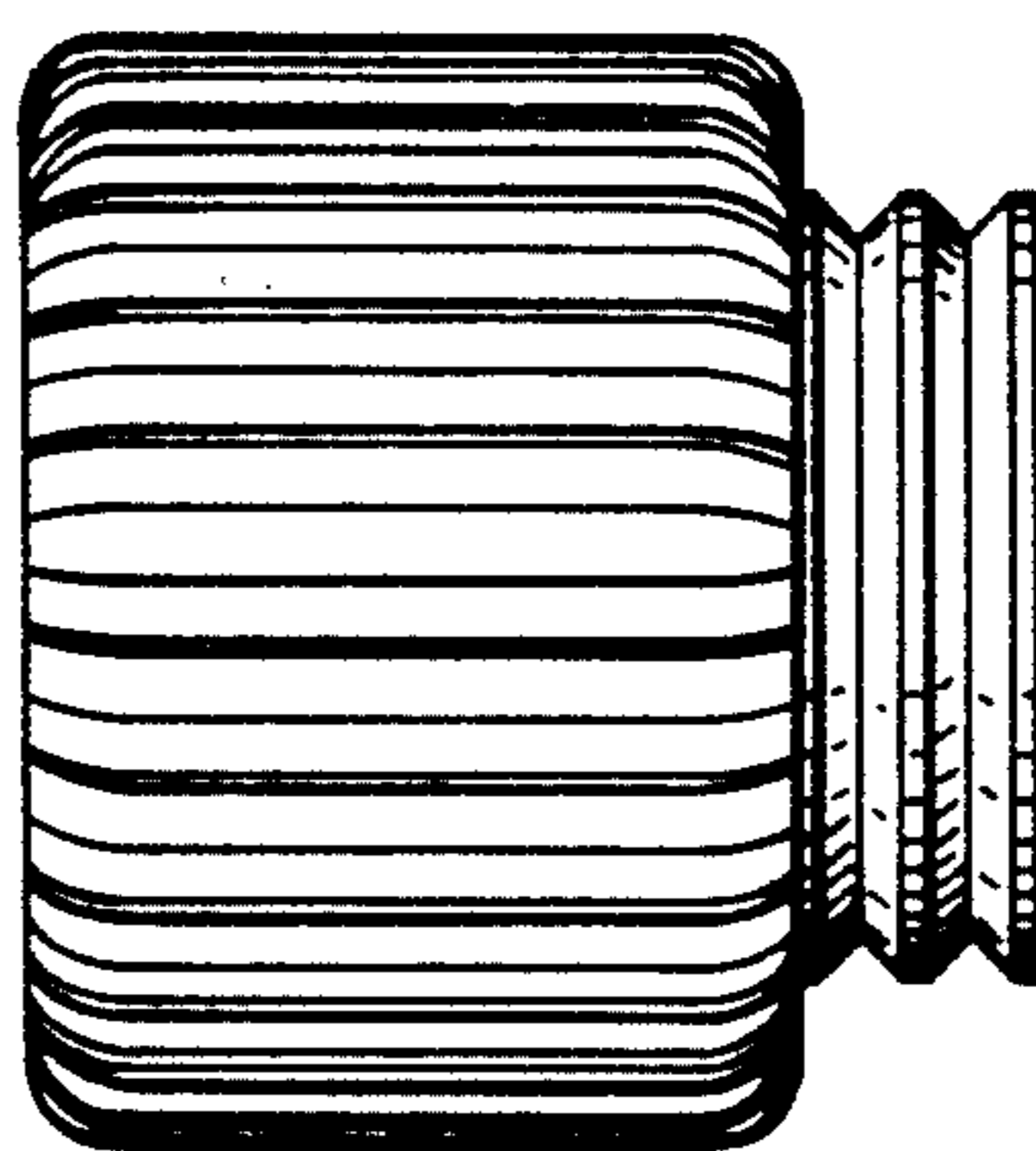

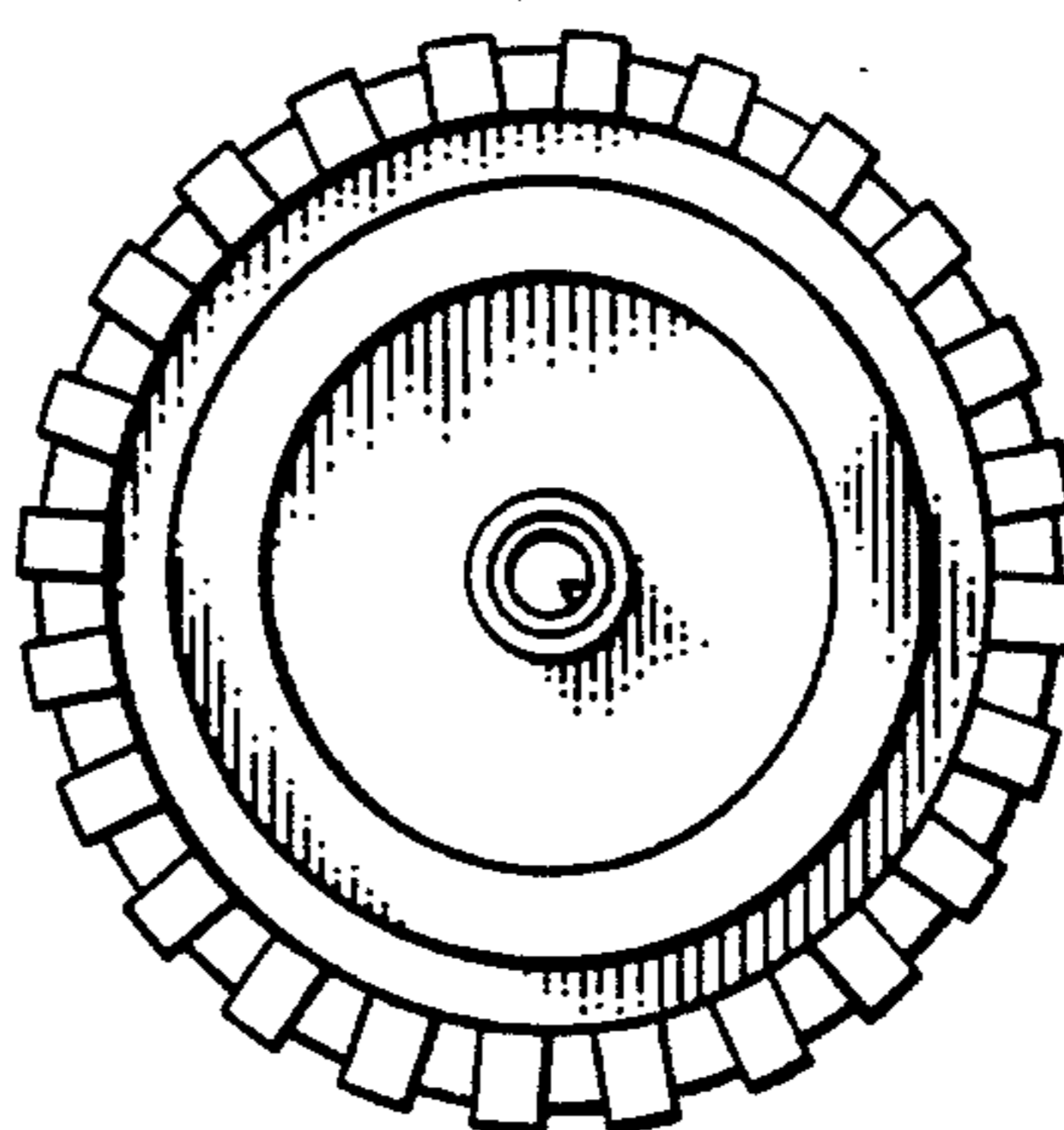

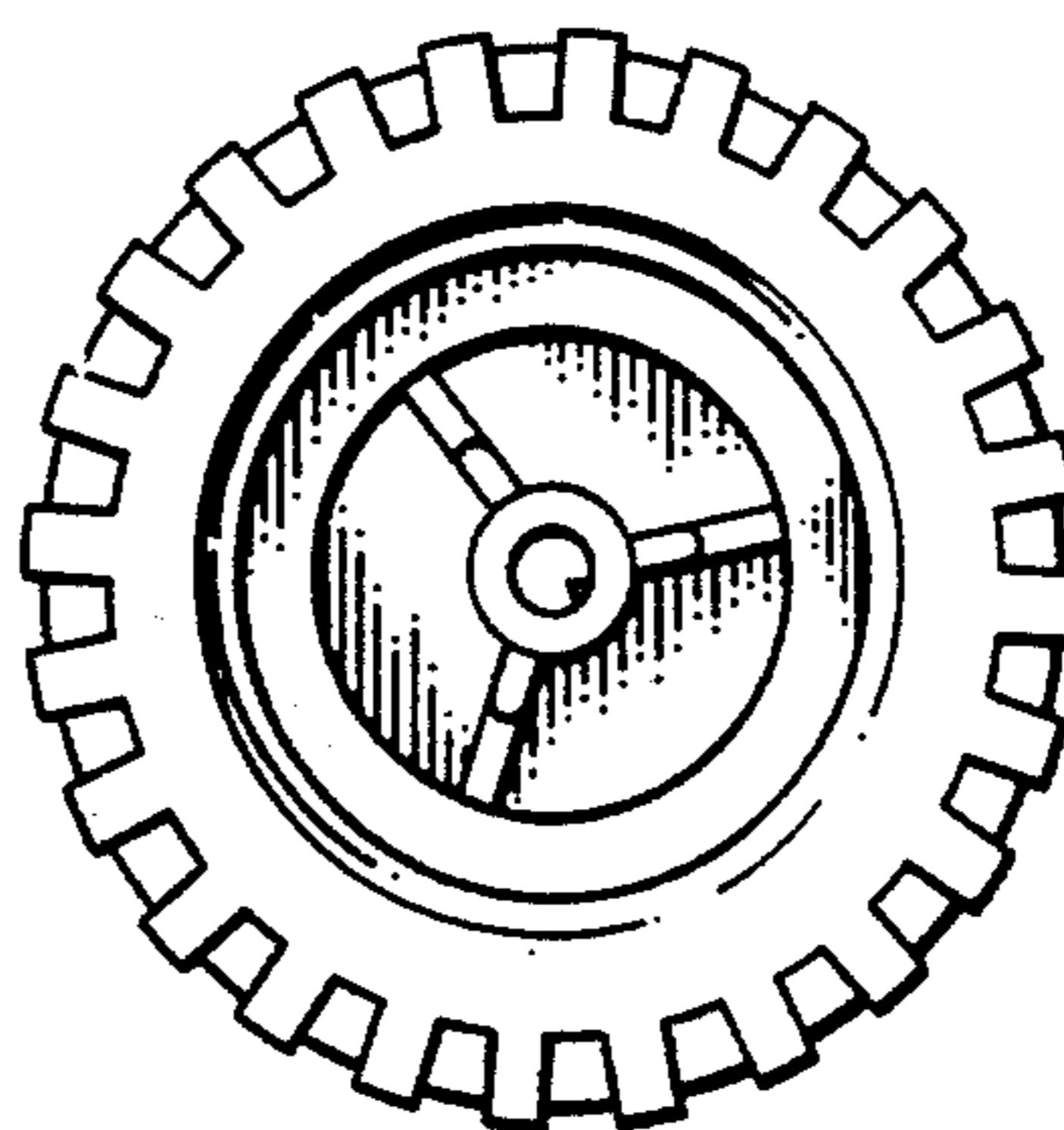
