[57] CLAIM

The ornamental design for a bear sleeping bag and rug, as shown.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a top perspective view of a bear sleeping bag and rug showing my new design in the closed condition; FIG. 2 is a top perspective view thereof in the open condition;

FIG. 3 is a bottom perspective view of FIG. 1; and FIG. 4 is a bottom perspective view of FIG. 2.

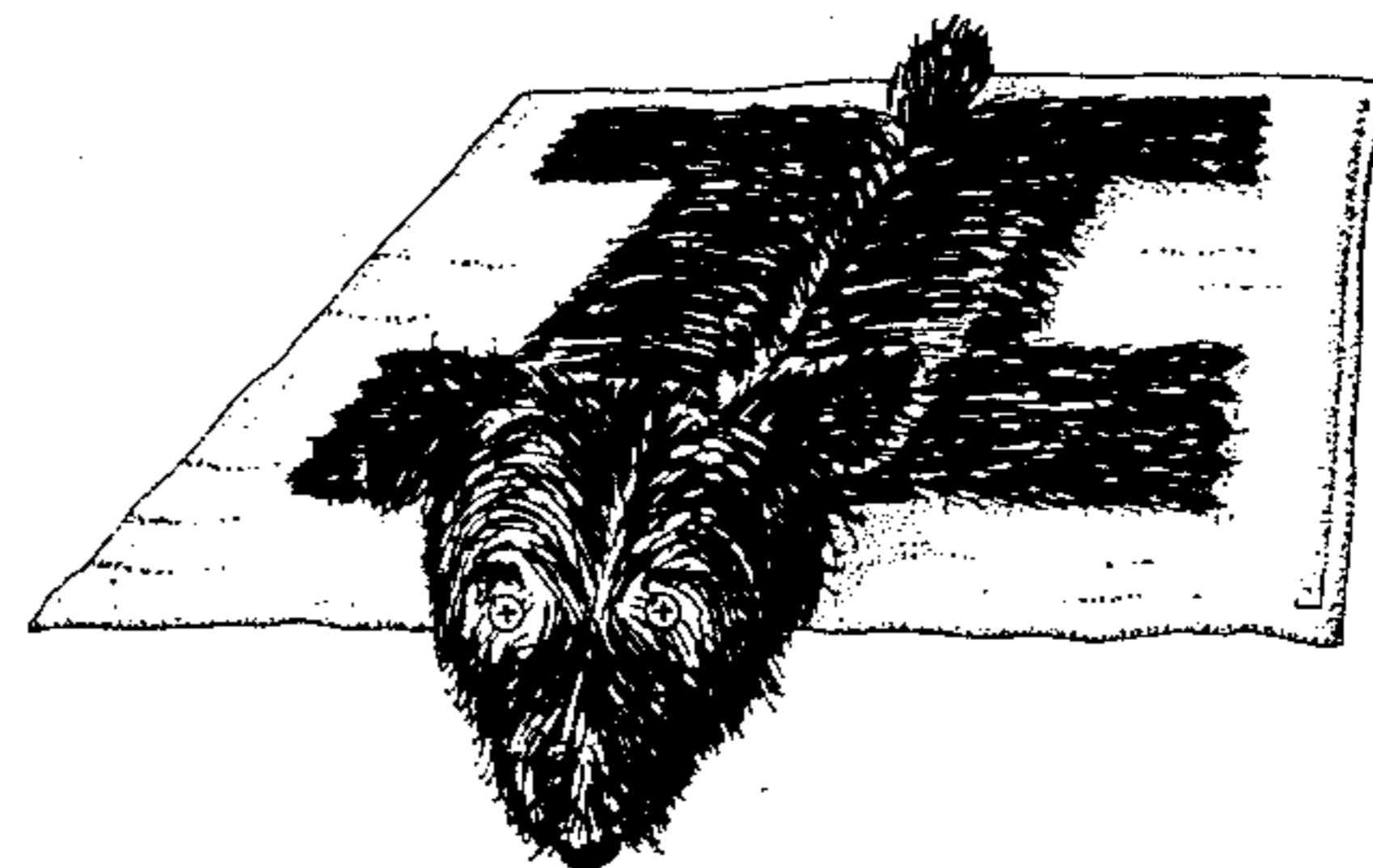
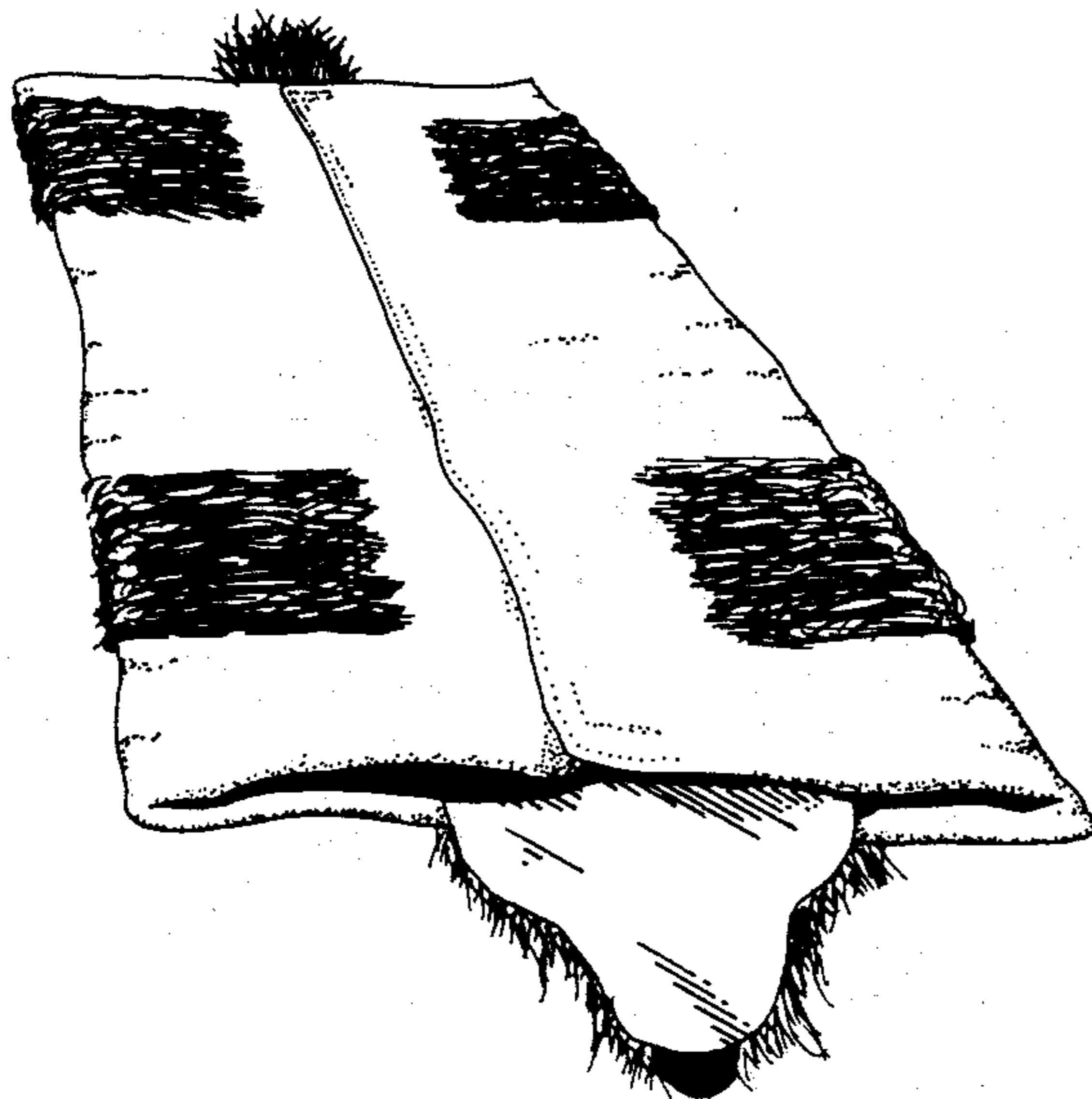

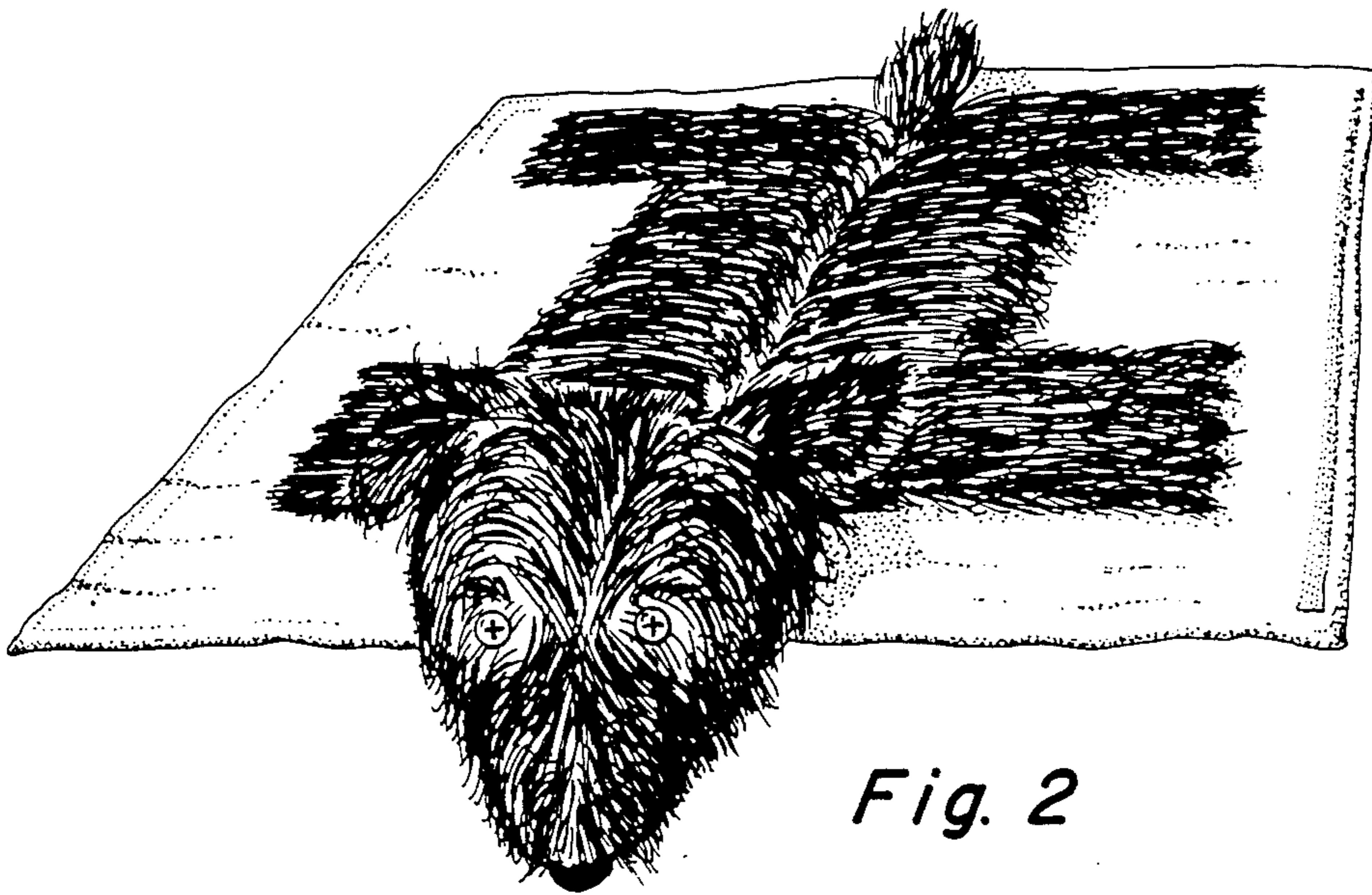

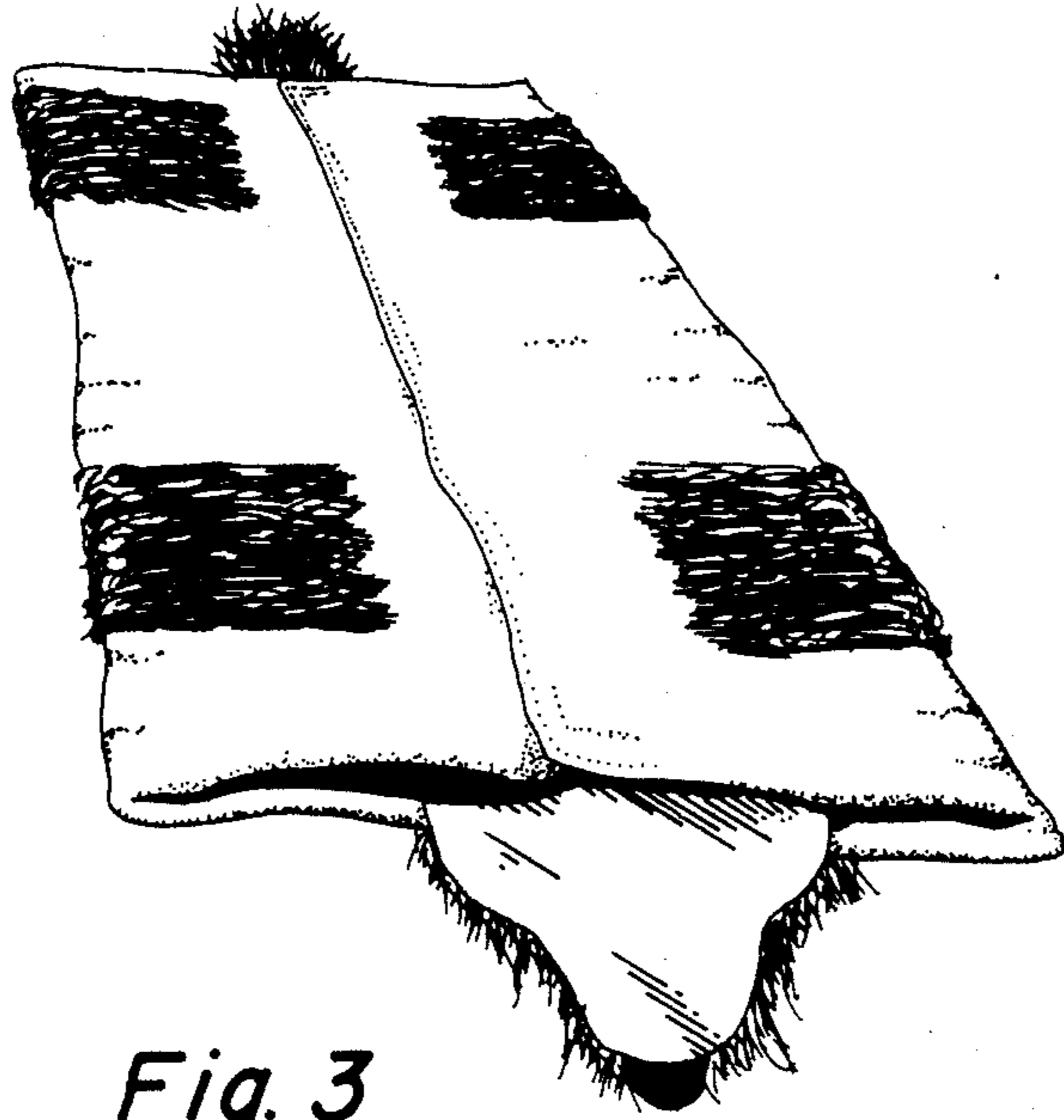

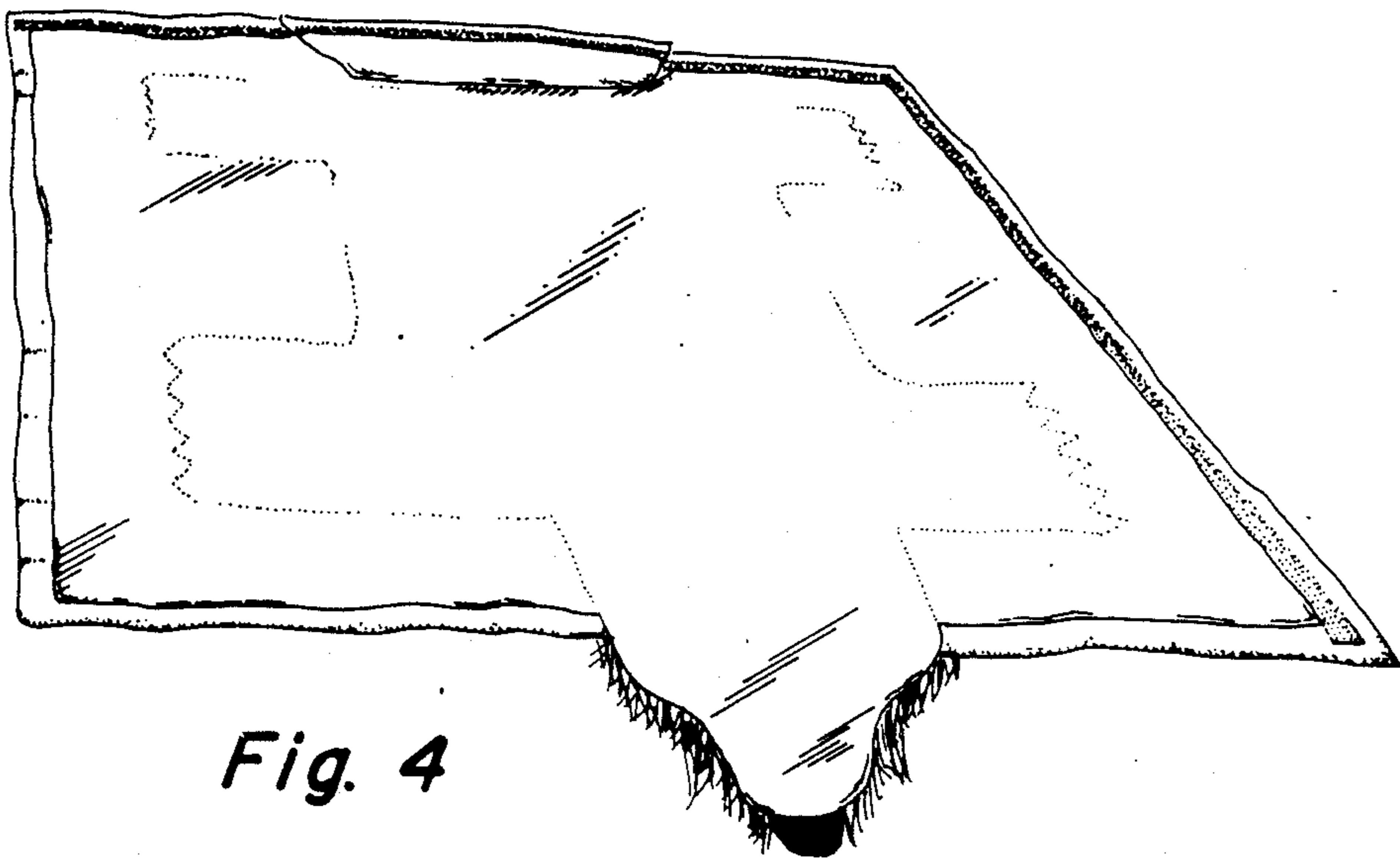
