The ornamental design for a bottle, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is an elevational view of a bottle embodying my new design, the opposite side being substantially the same in appearance;
 FIG. 2 is a view looking from the right of FIG. 1, the opposite side being substantially the same in appearance;
 FIG. 3 is a top plan view thereof; and
 FIG. 4 is a bottom plan view thereof.

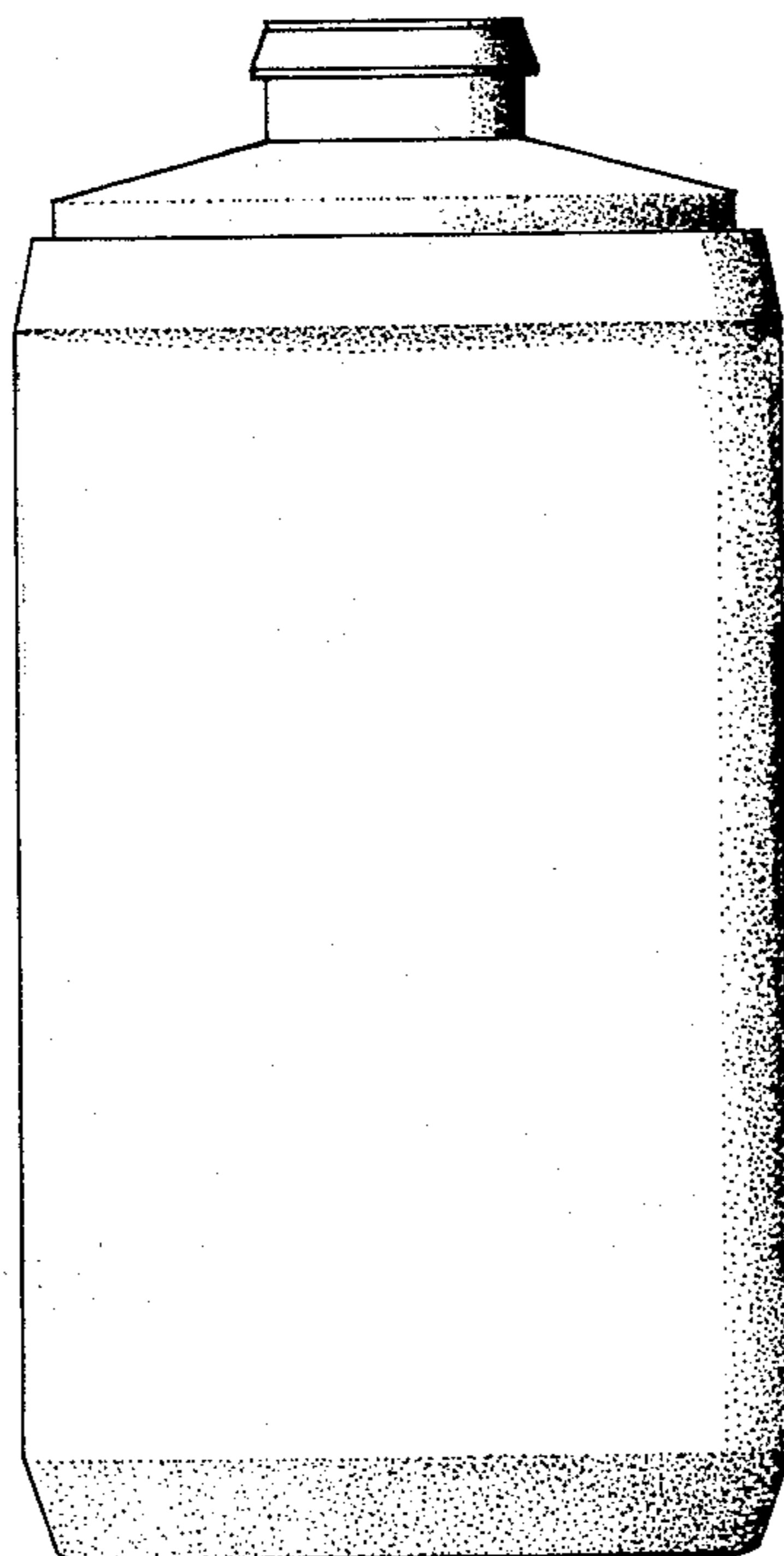

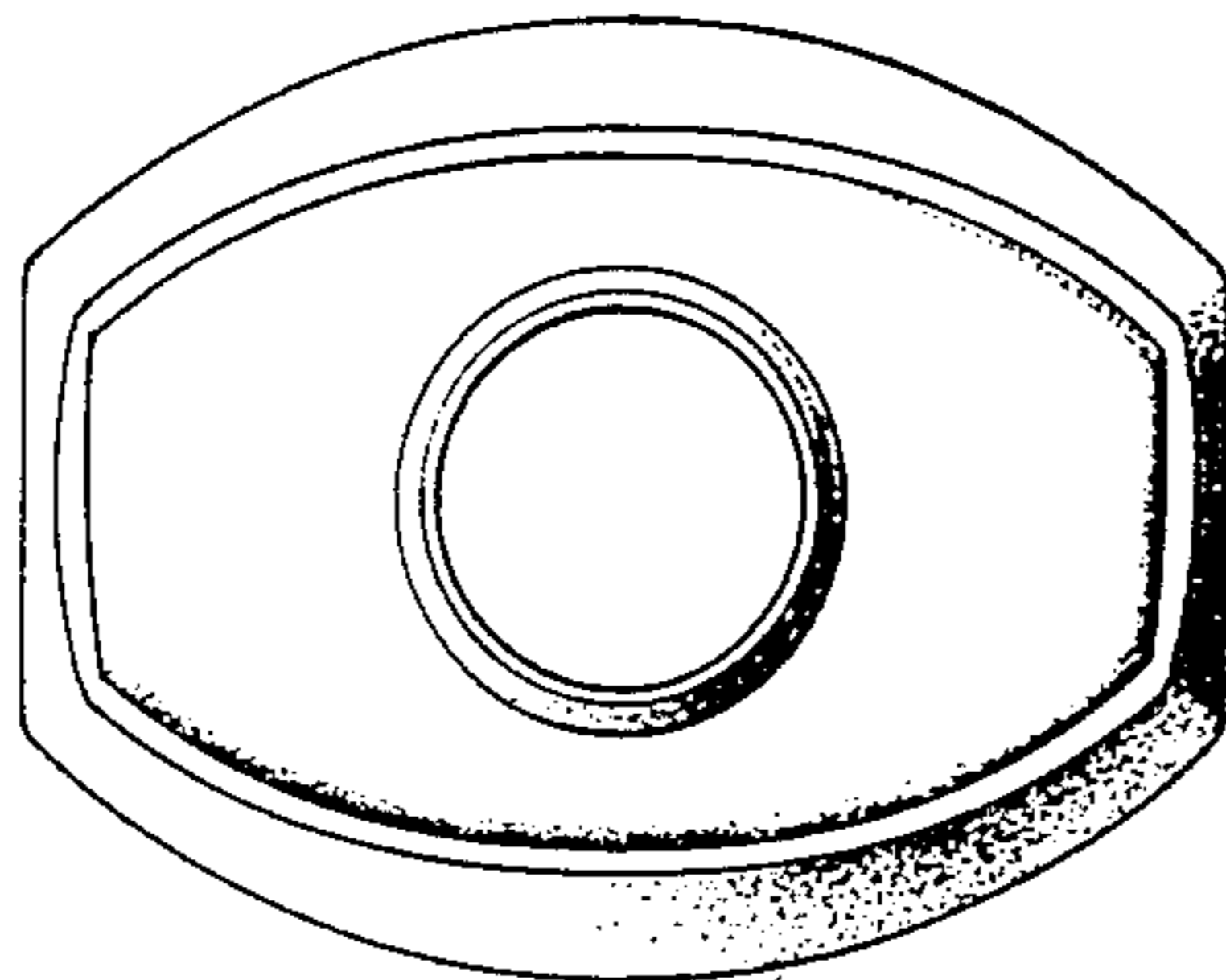

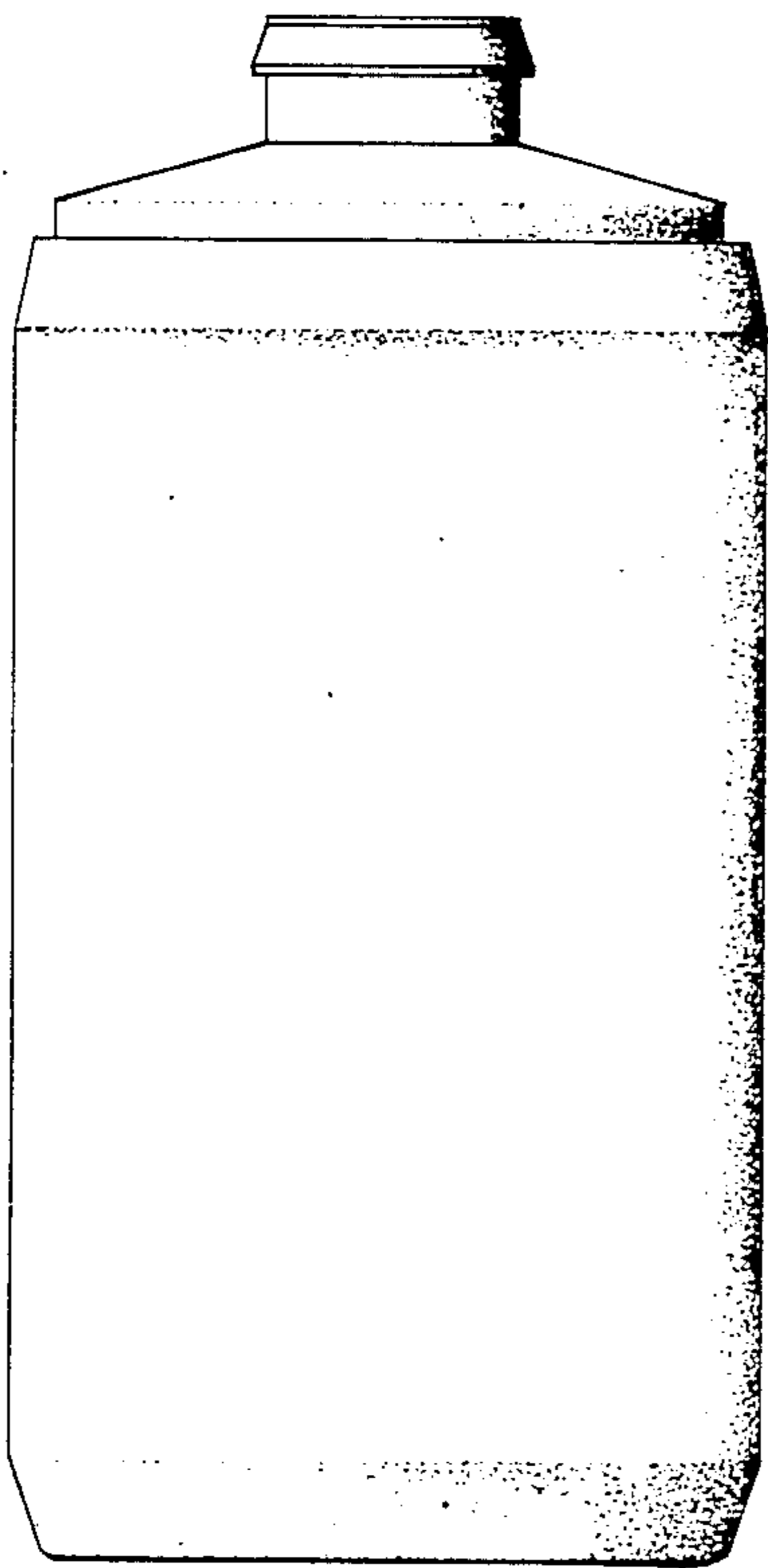

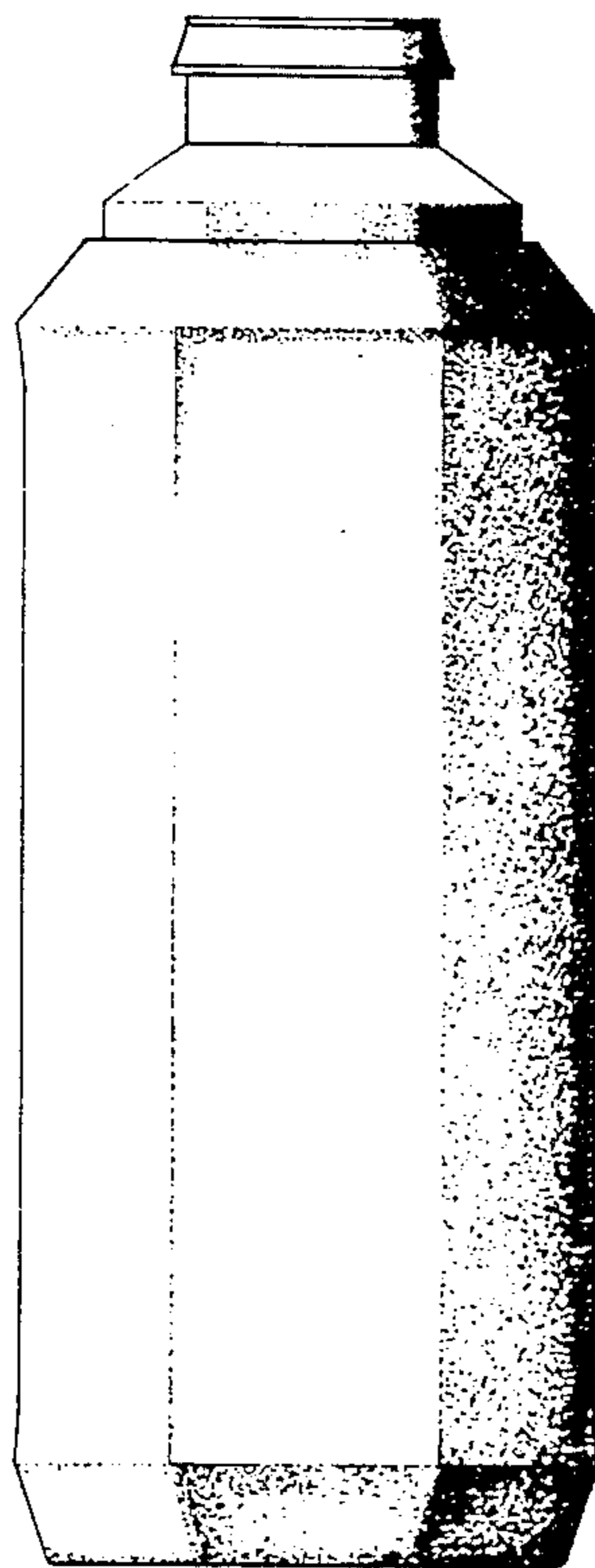
